(57) **CLAIM**

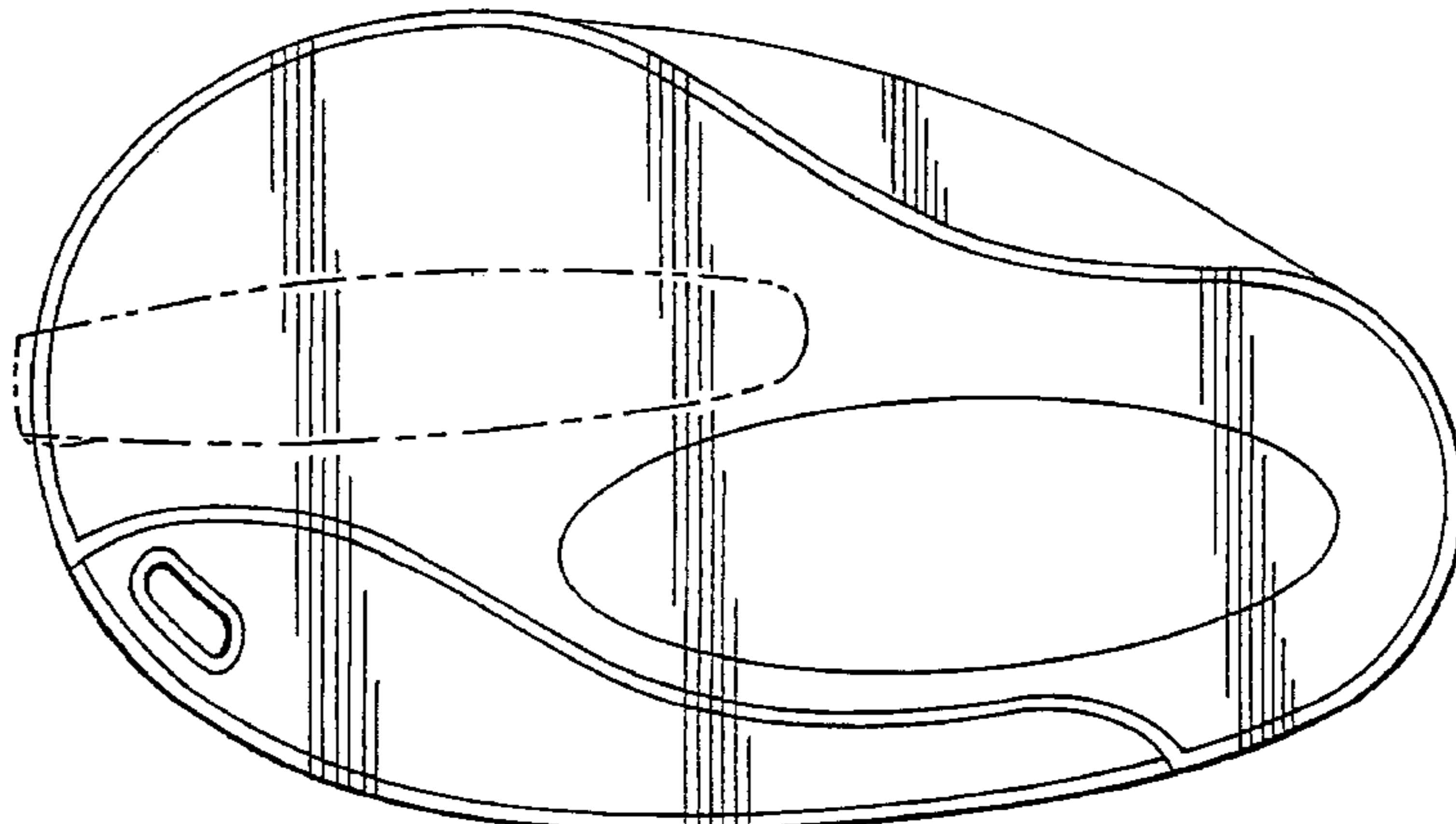
The ornamental design for a credit card and case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of the credit card and case of the present invention with the card in the fully closed position within the case; and,

FIG. 2 is a bottom view of the credit card and case of FIG. 1, with the card in the fully closed position and showing in broken lines the location of a clip. The clip is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

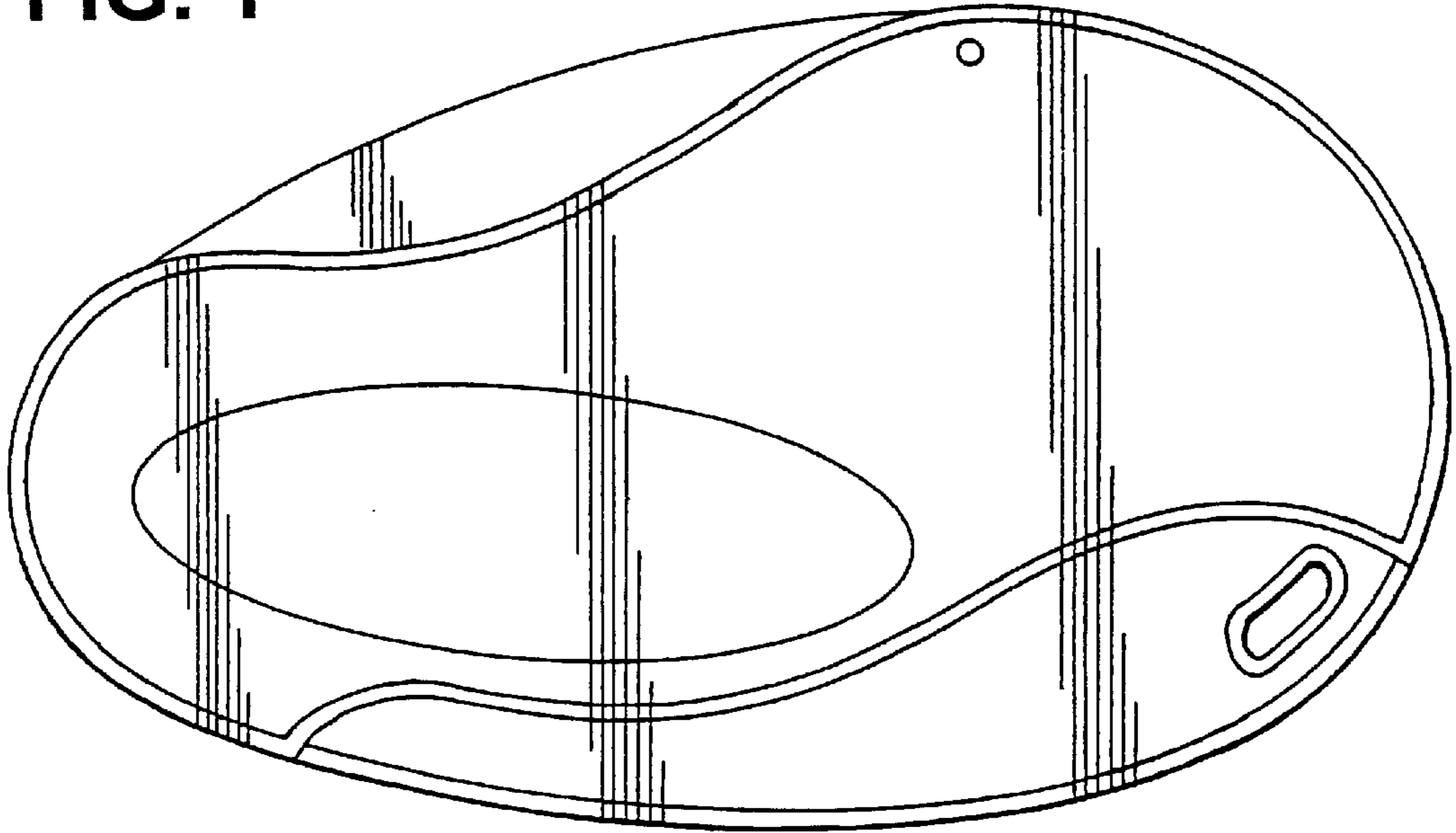
