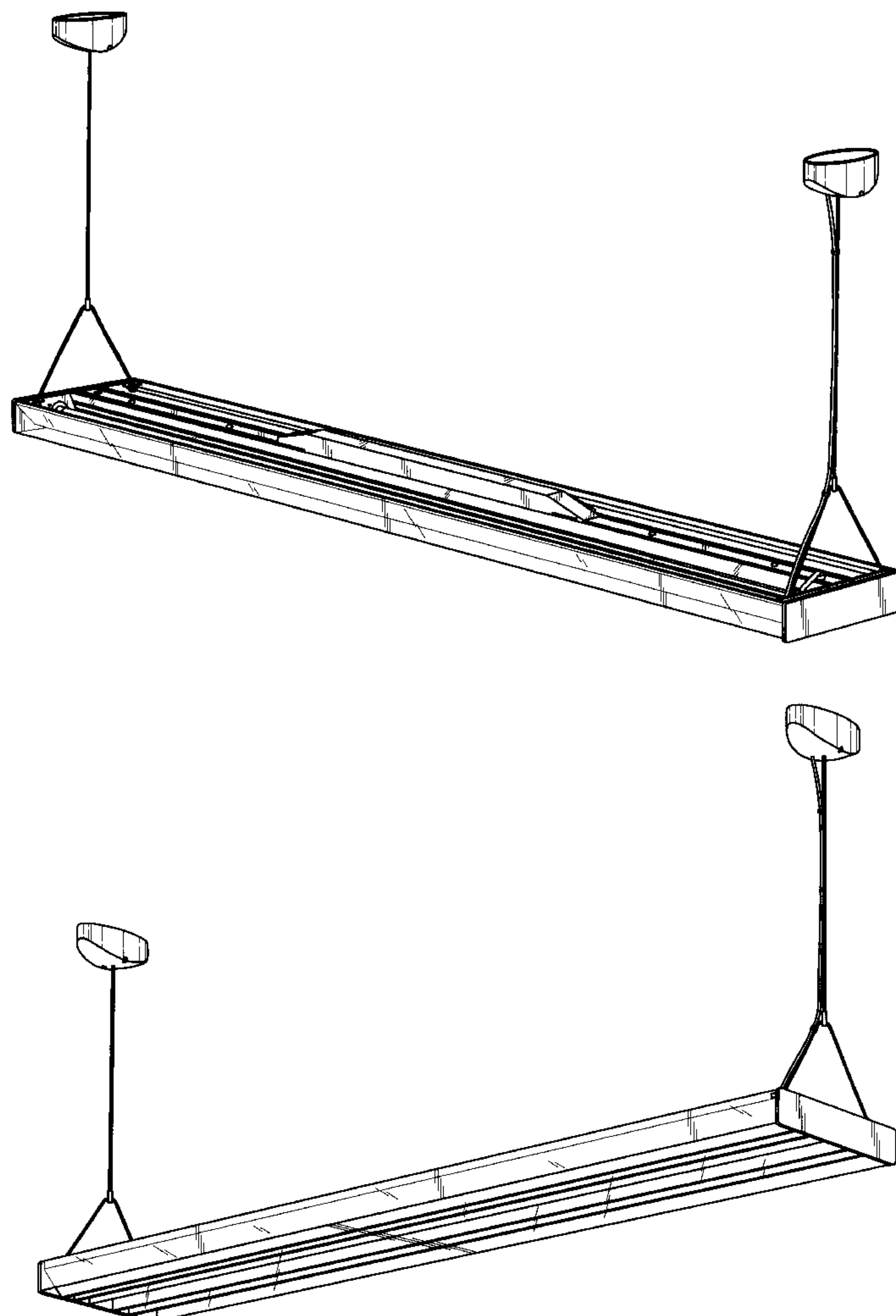

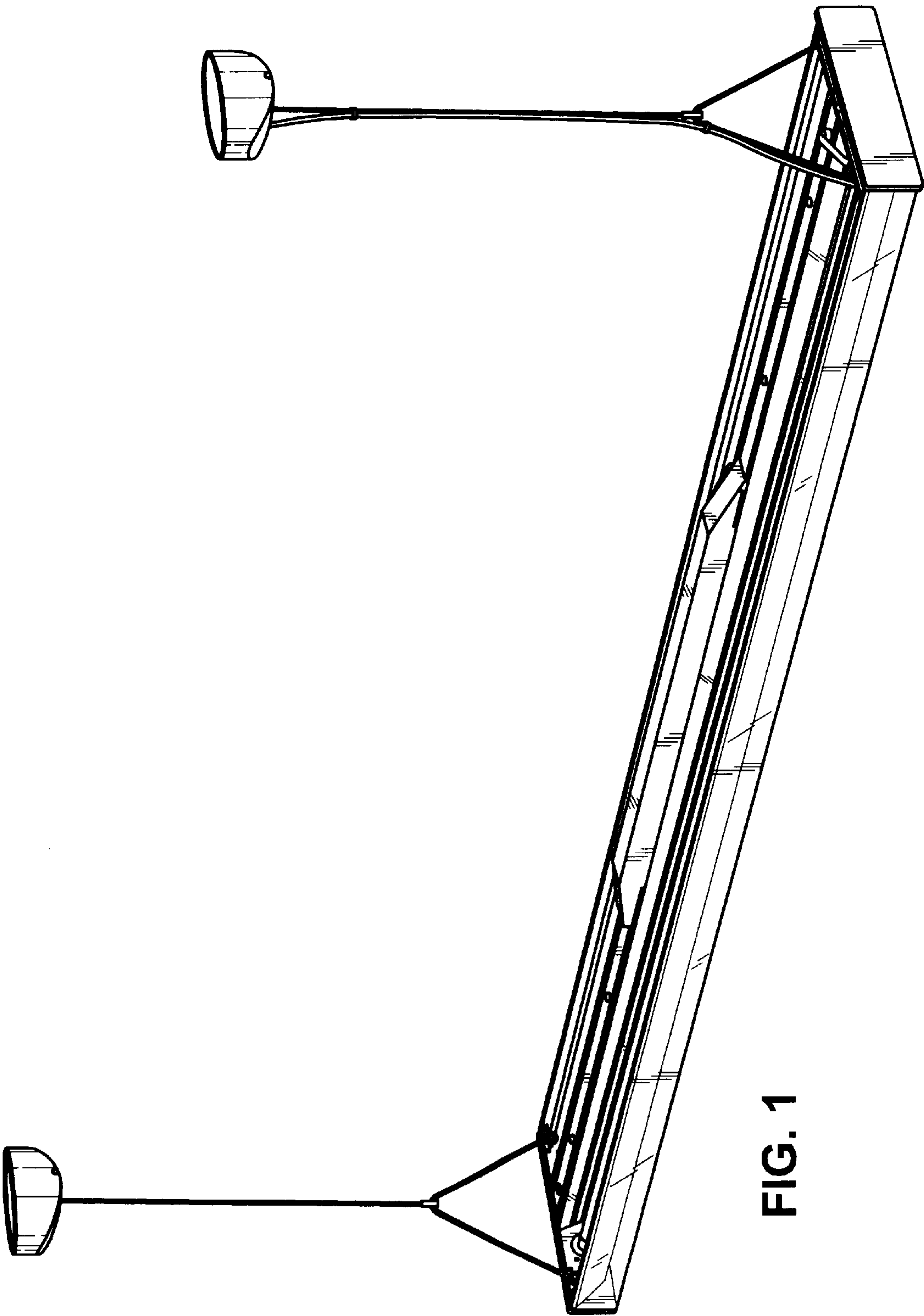
DESCRIPTION

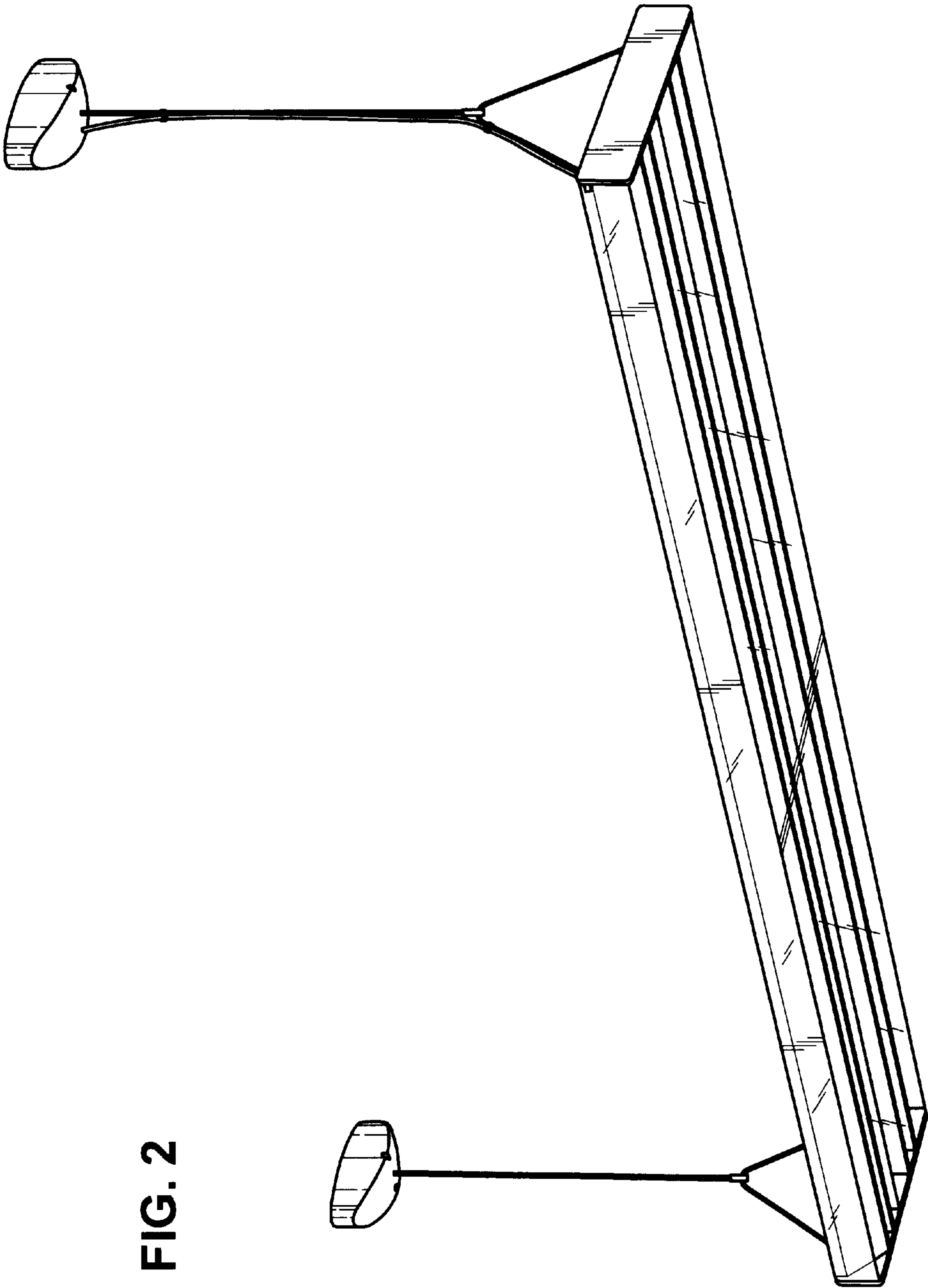
