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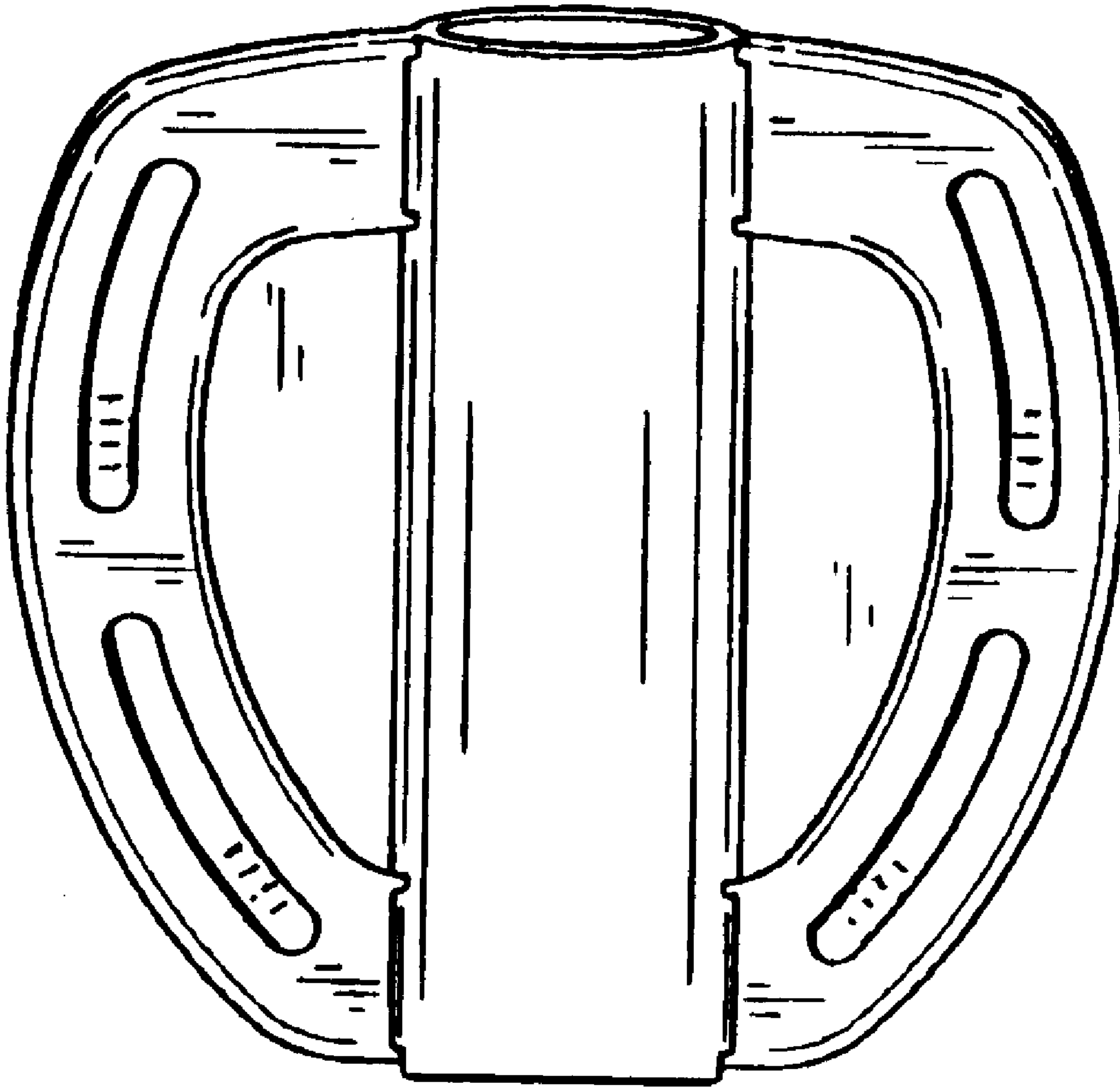

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a concealable baton
scabbard in accordance with our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the concealable baton
scabbard of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side
being identical;
FIG. 4 is a top plan thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.

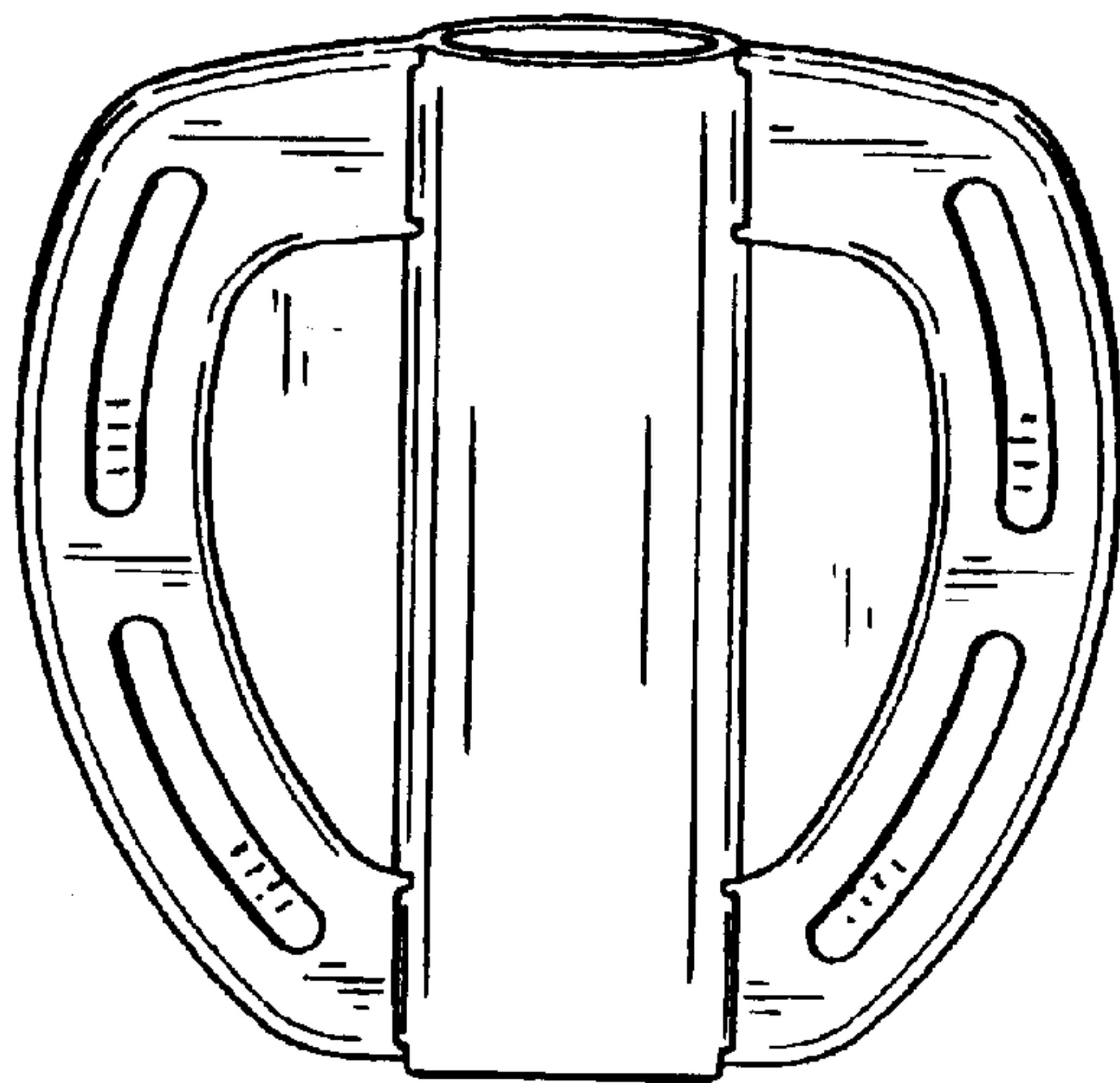

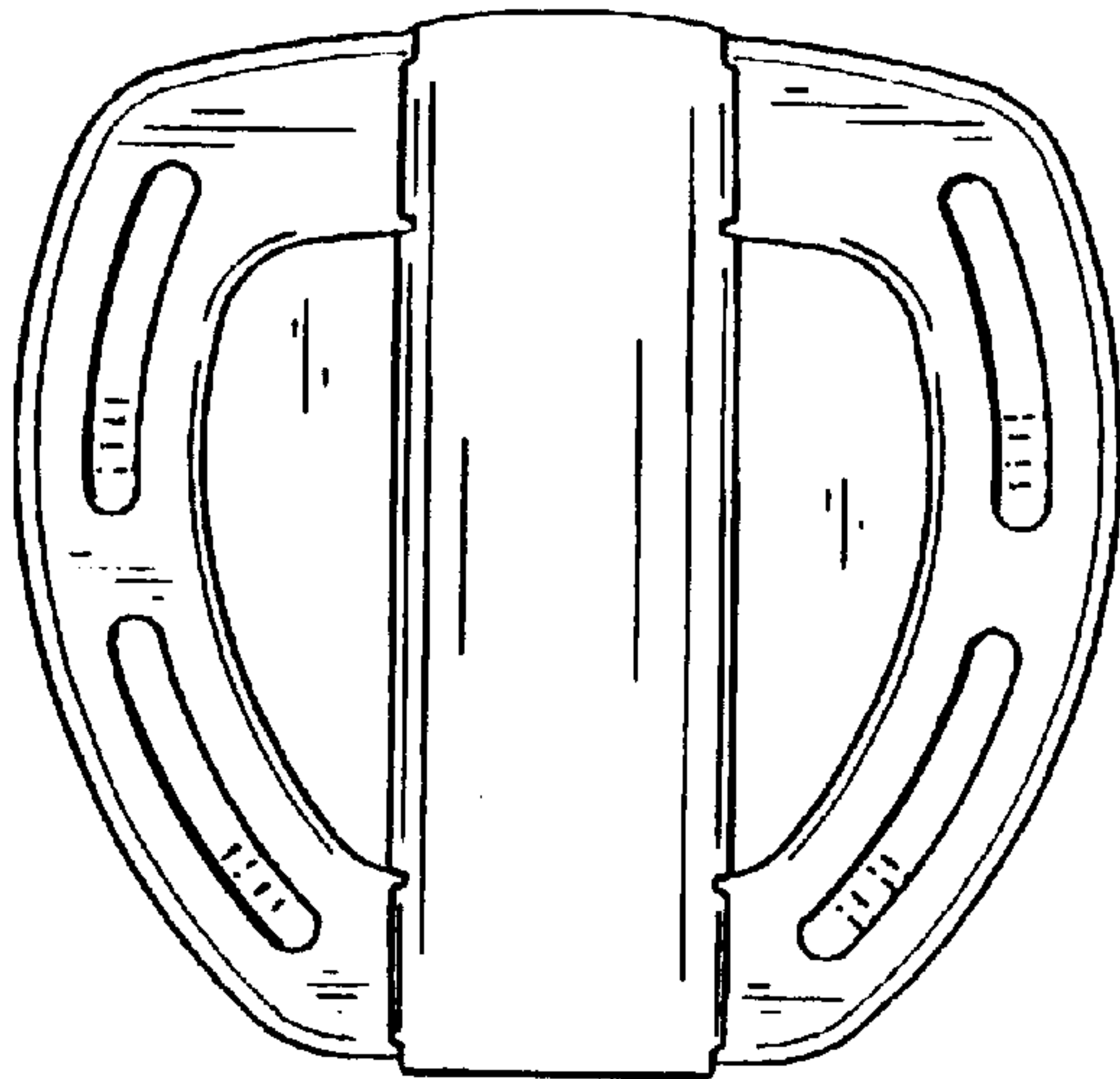

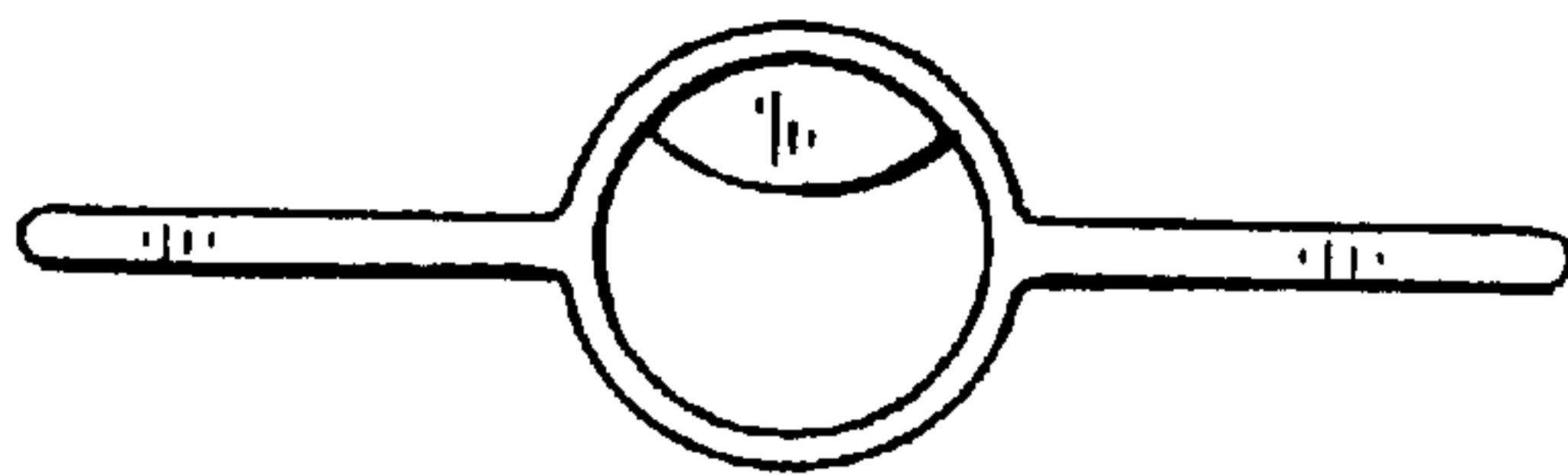

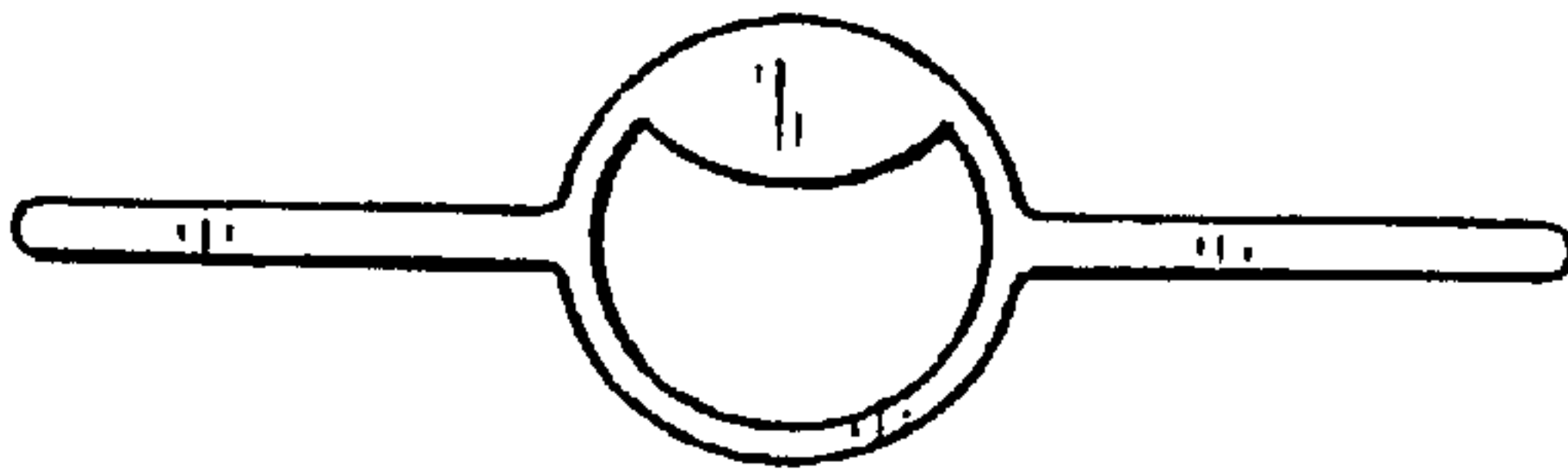
