**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a side view thereof, having an opposite side view being a mirror image thereof; and,

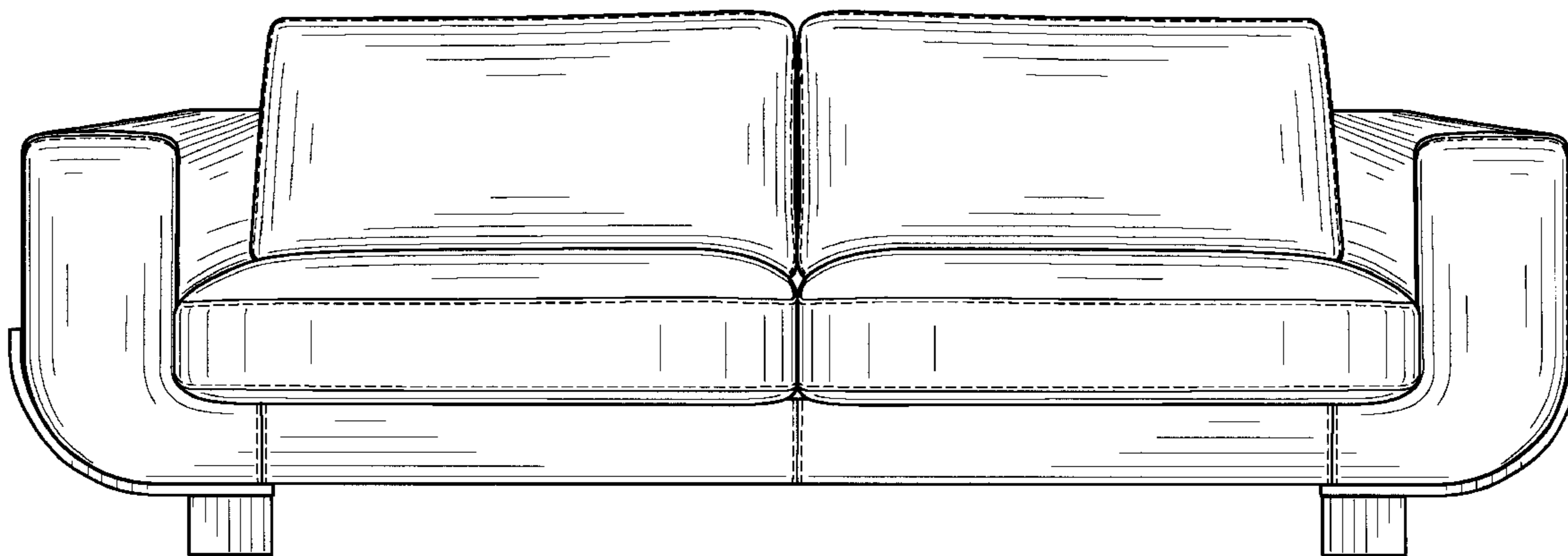
FIG. 5 is a back view thereof.

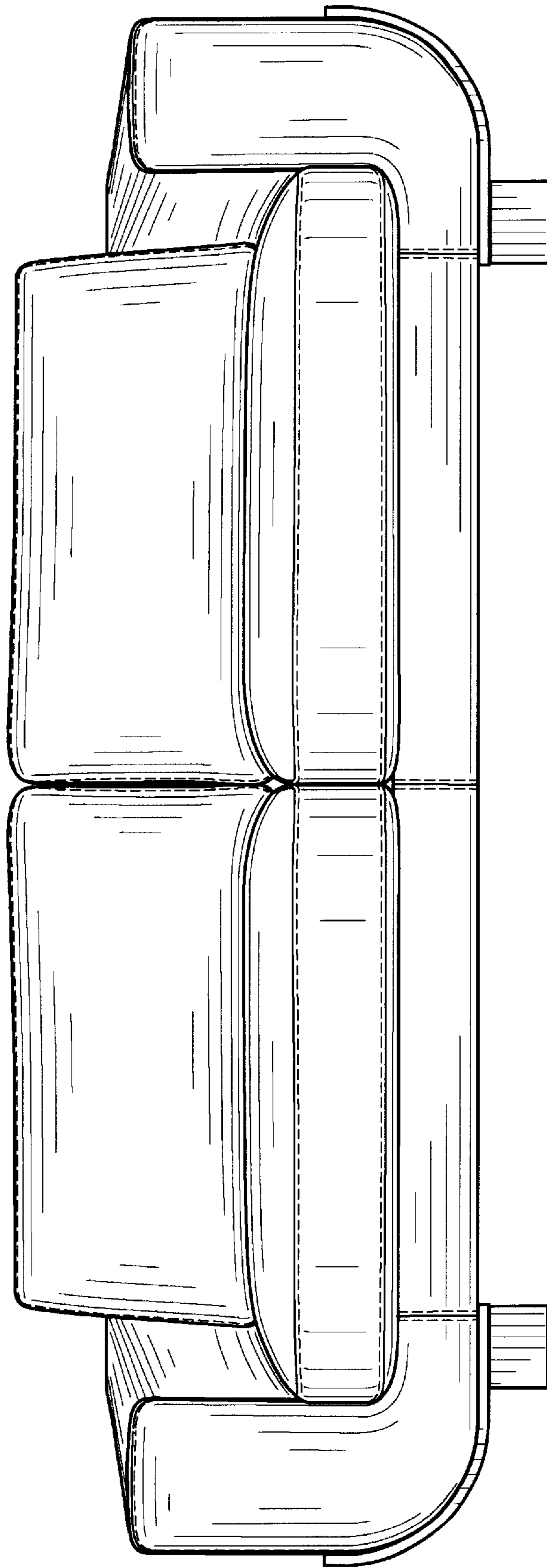
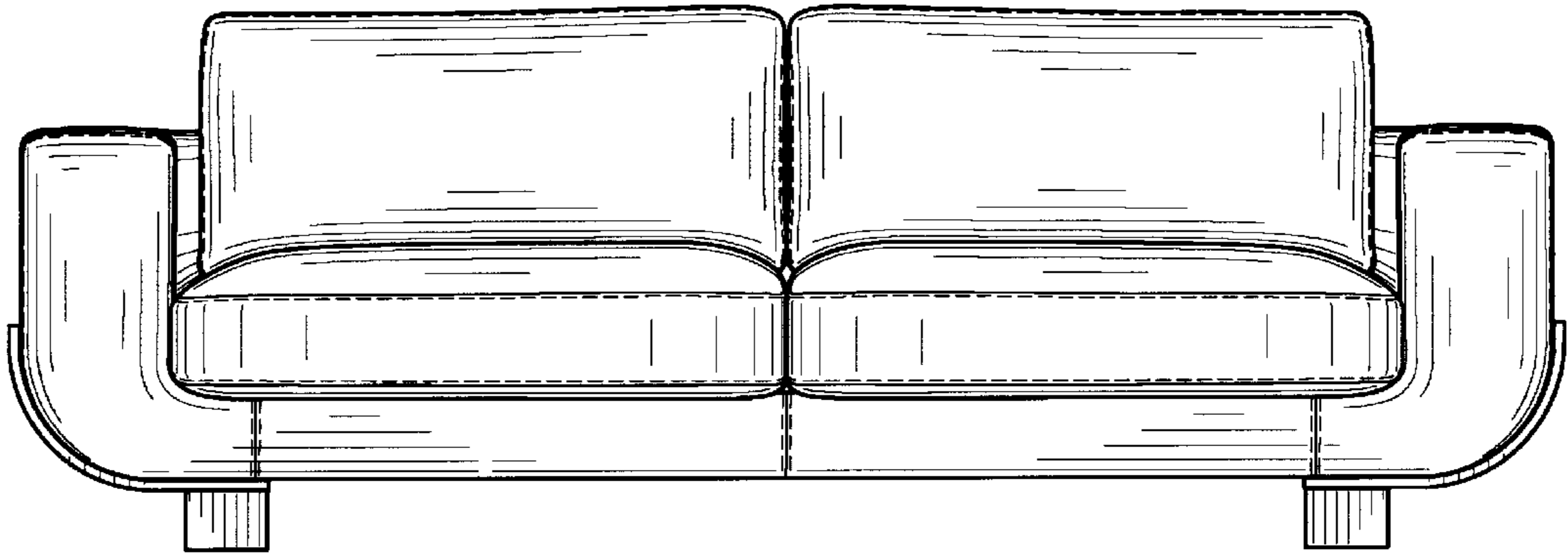
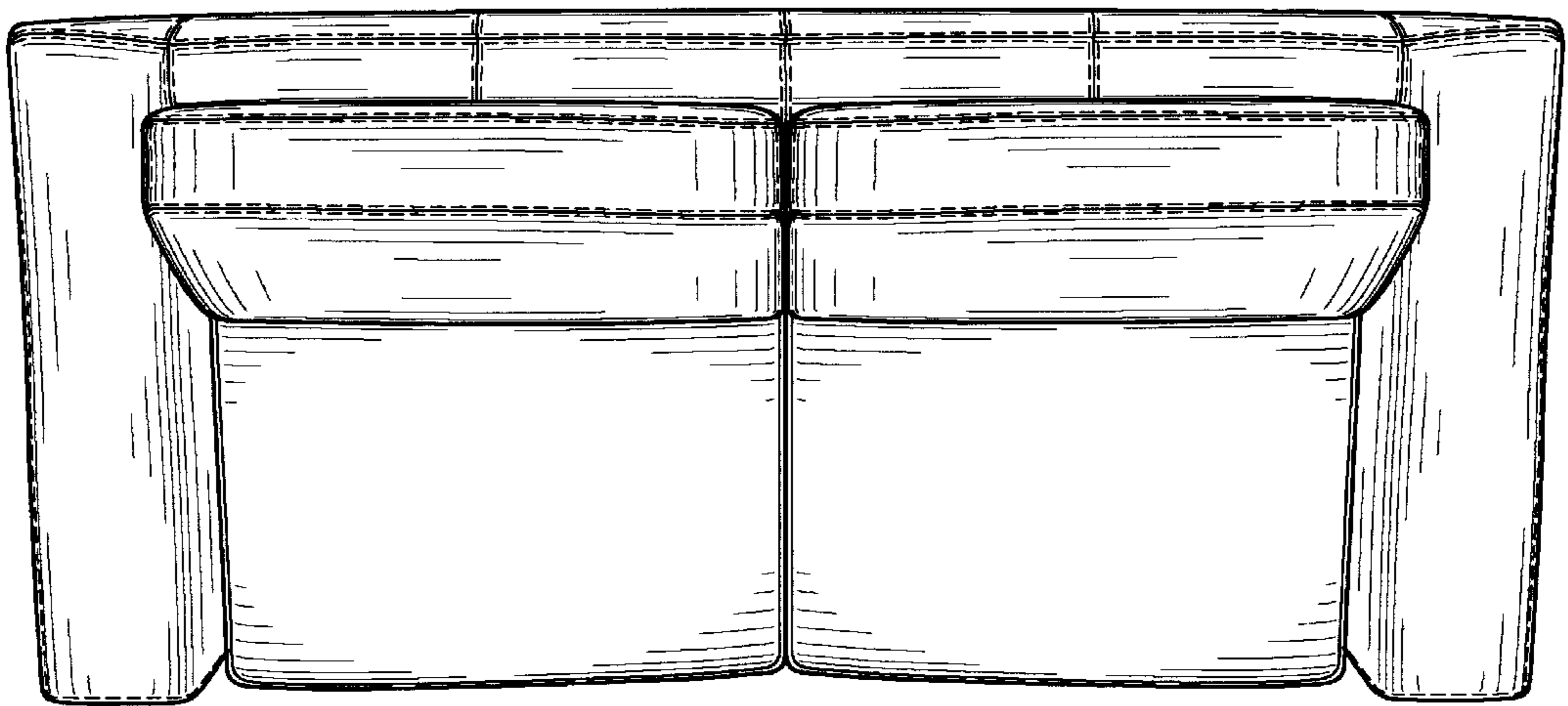


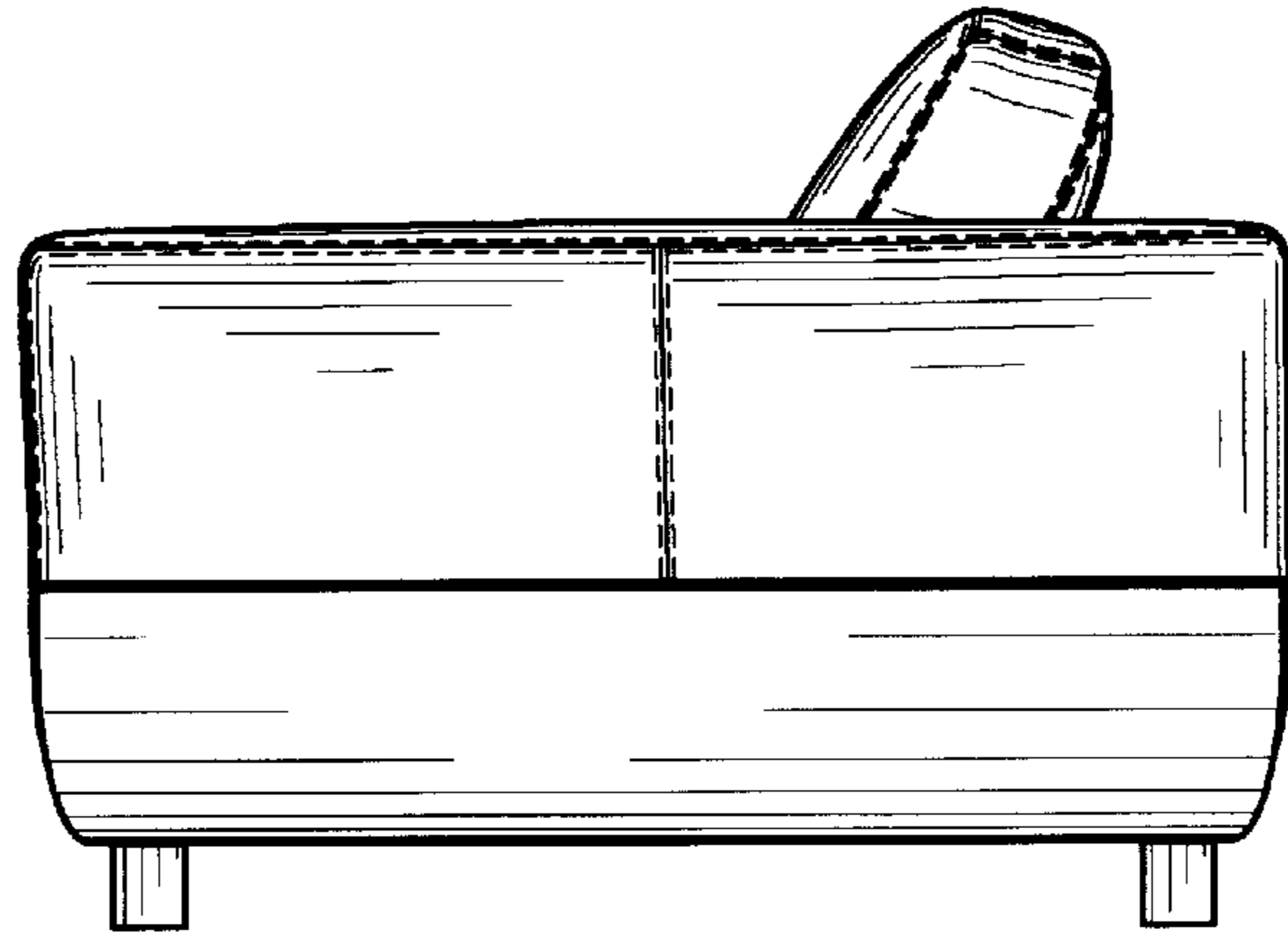

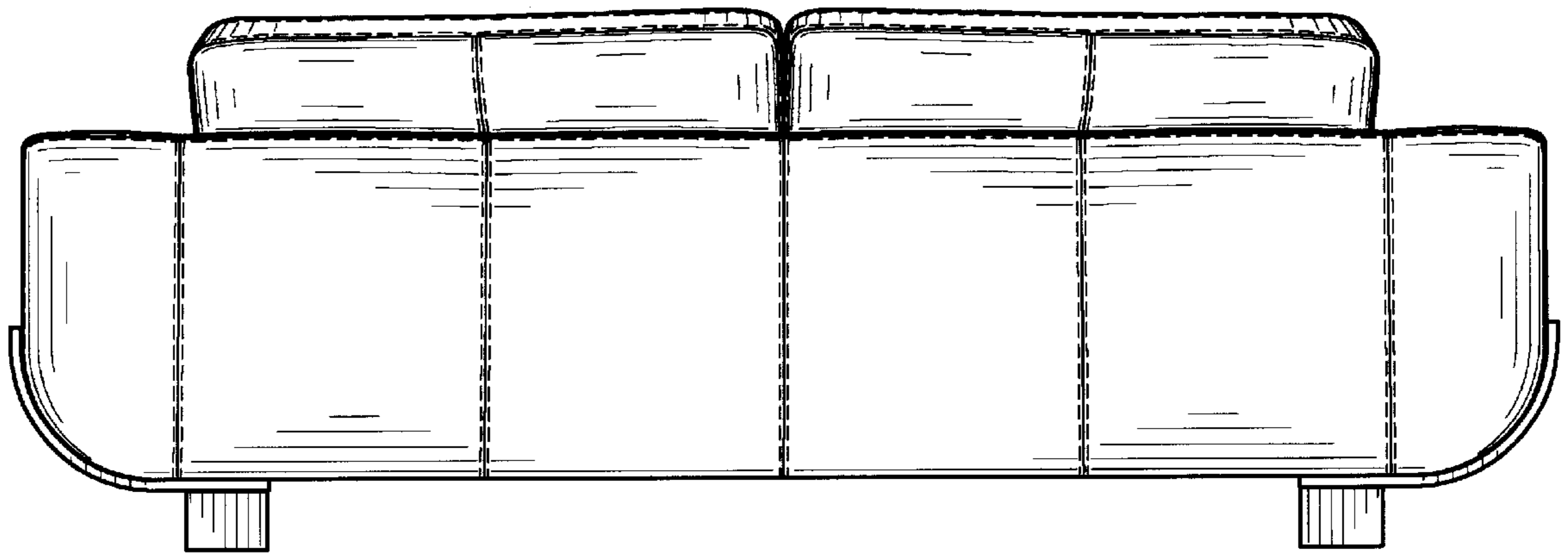
