(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a solitaire ring, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

The present invention relates generally to the field of jewelry. In particular, a solitaire ring that may be worn on a digit of a hand or a foot.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a solitaire ring showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

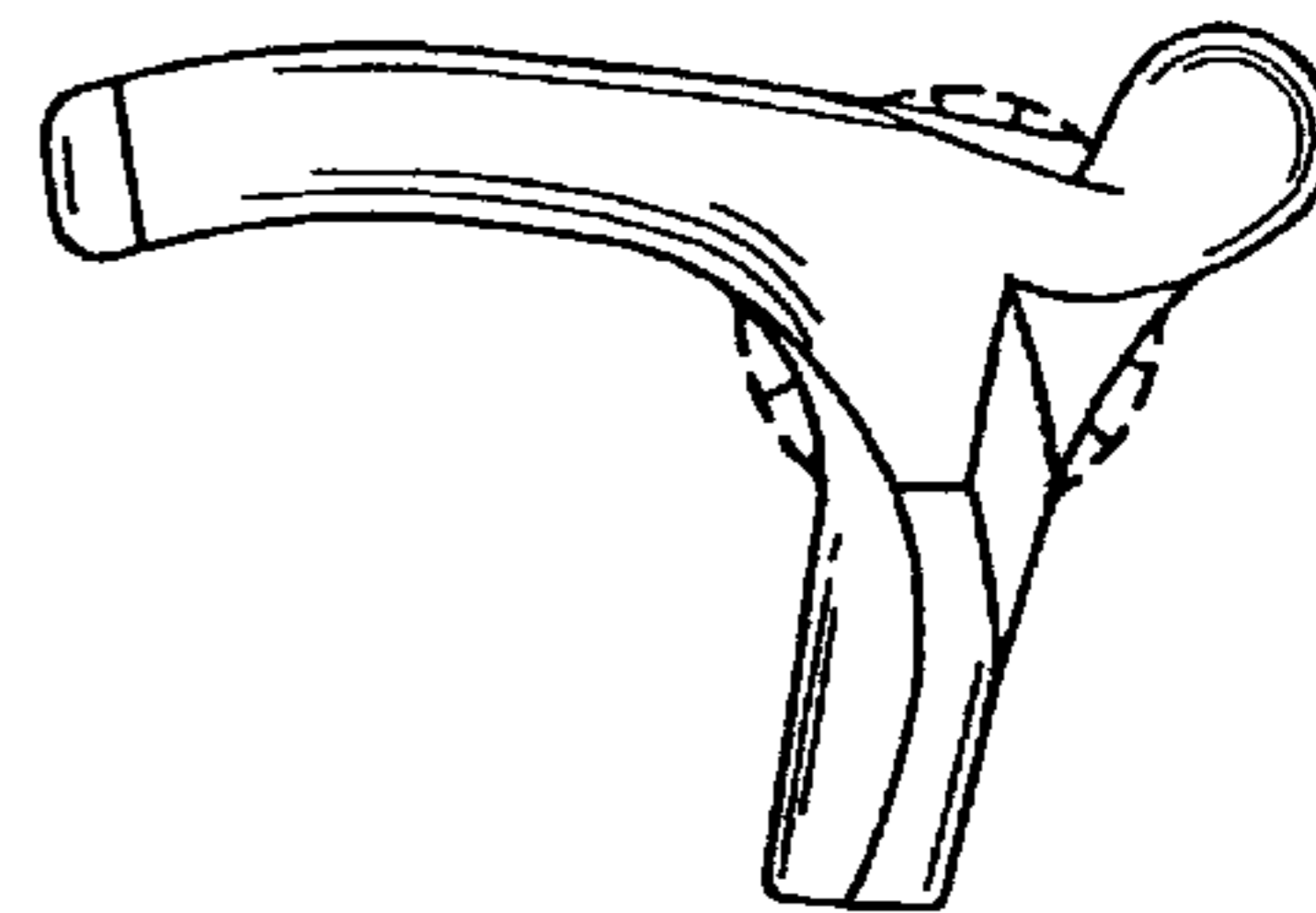
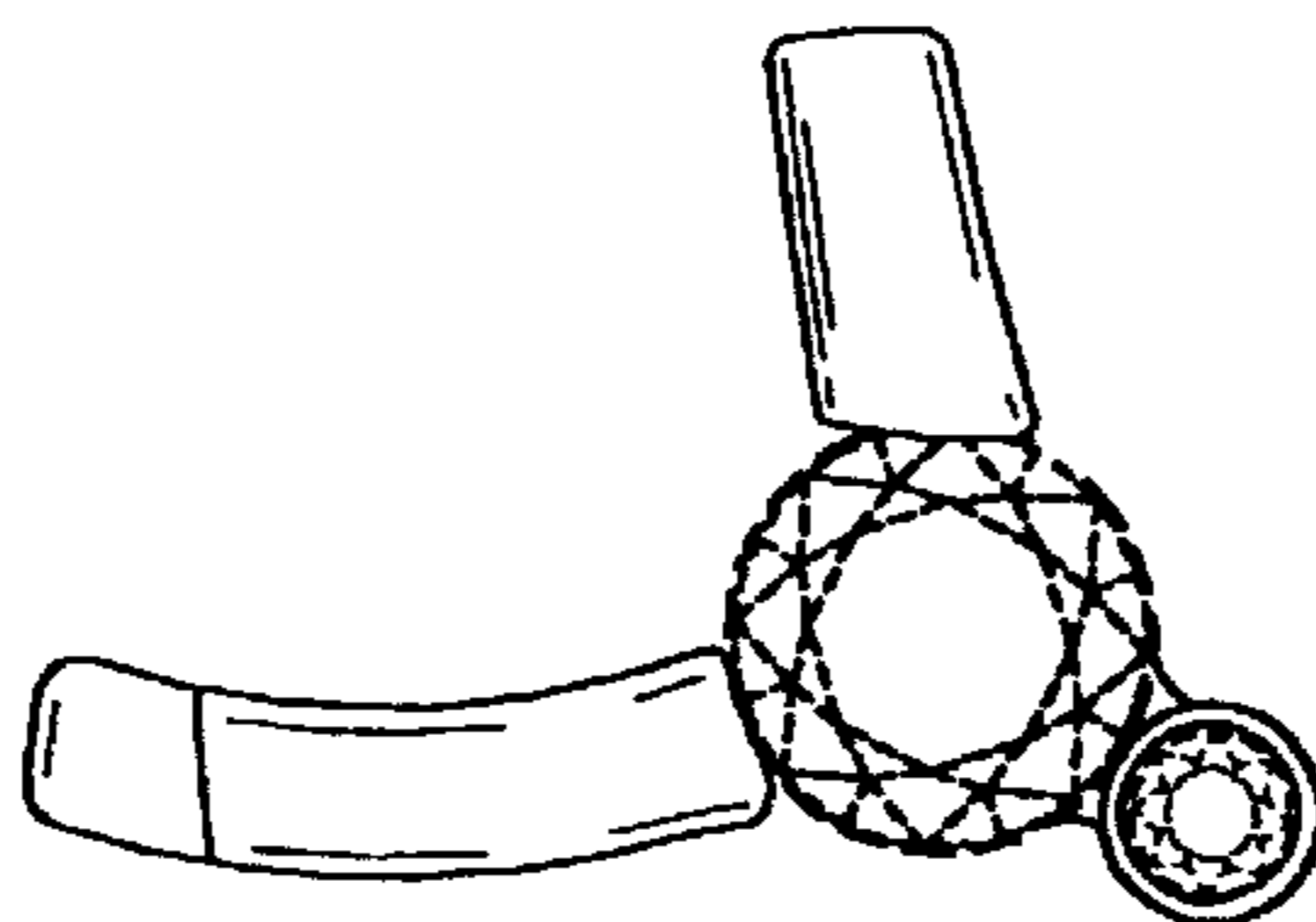
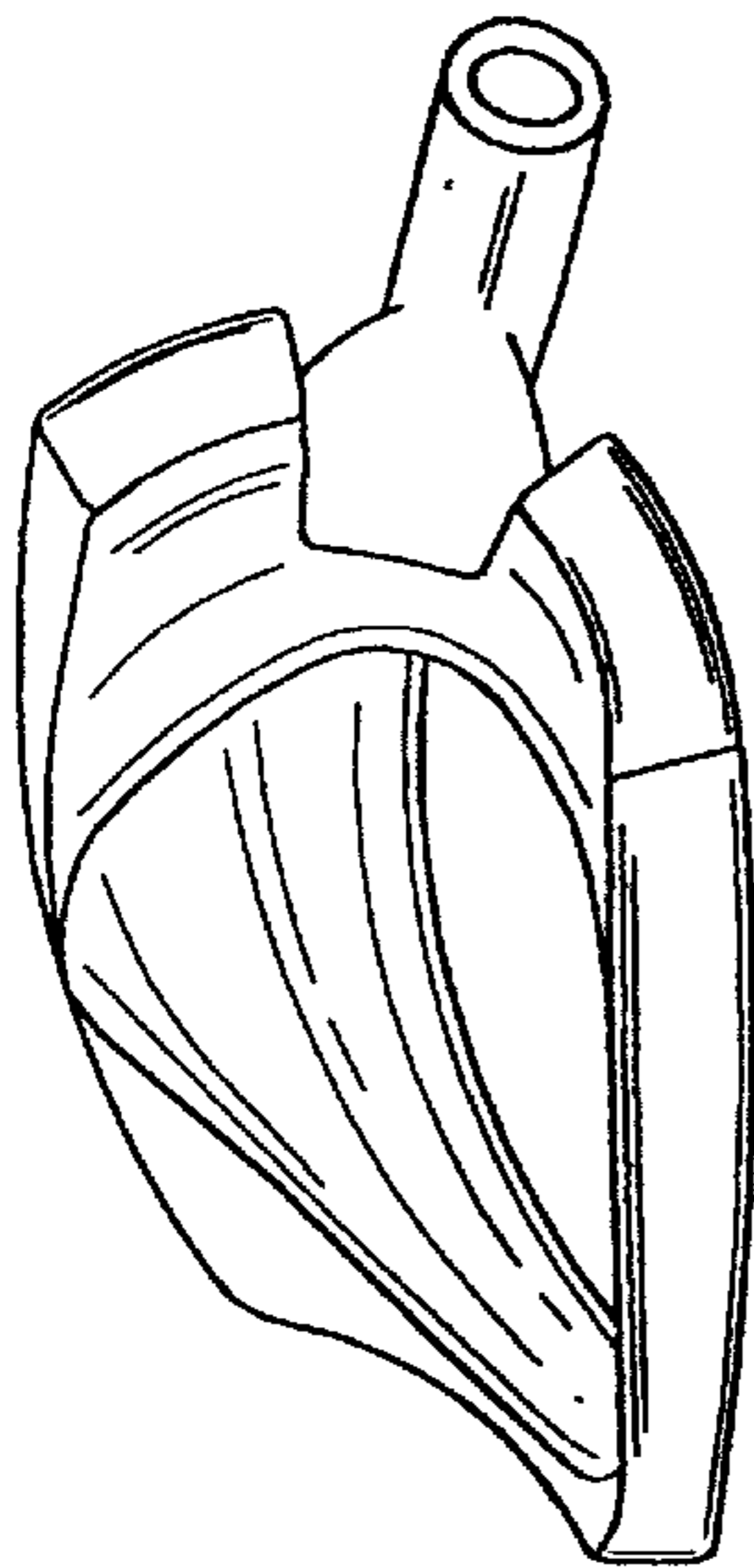
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

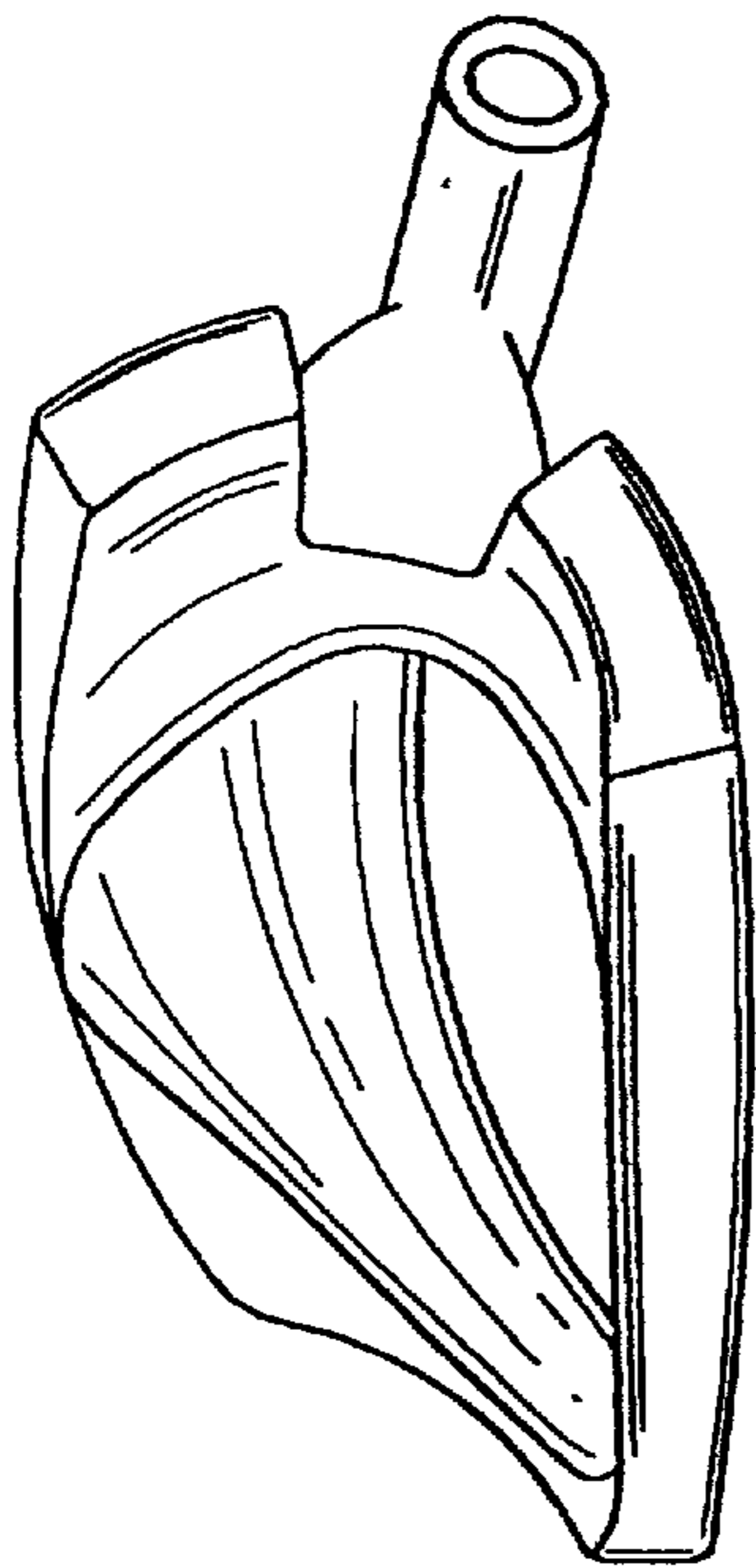

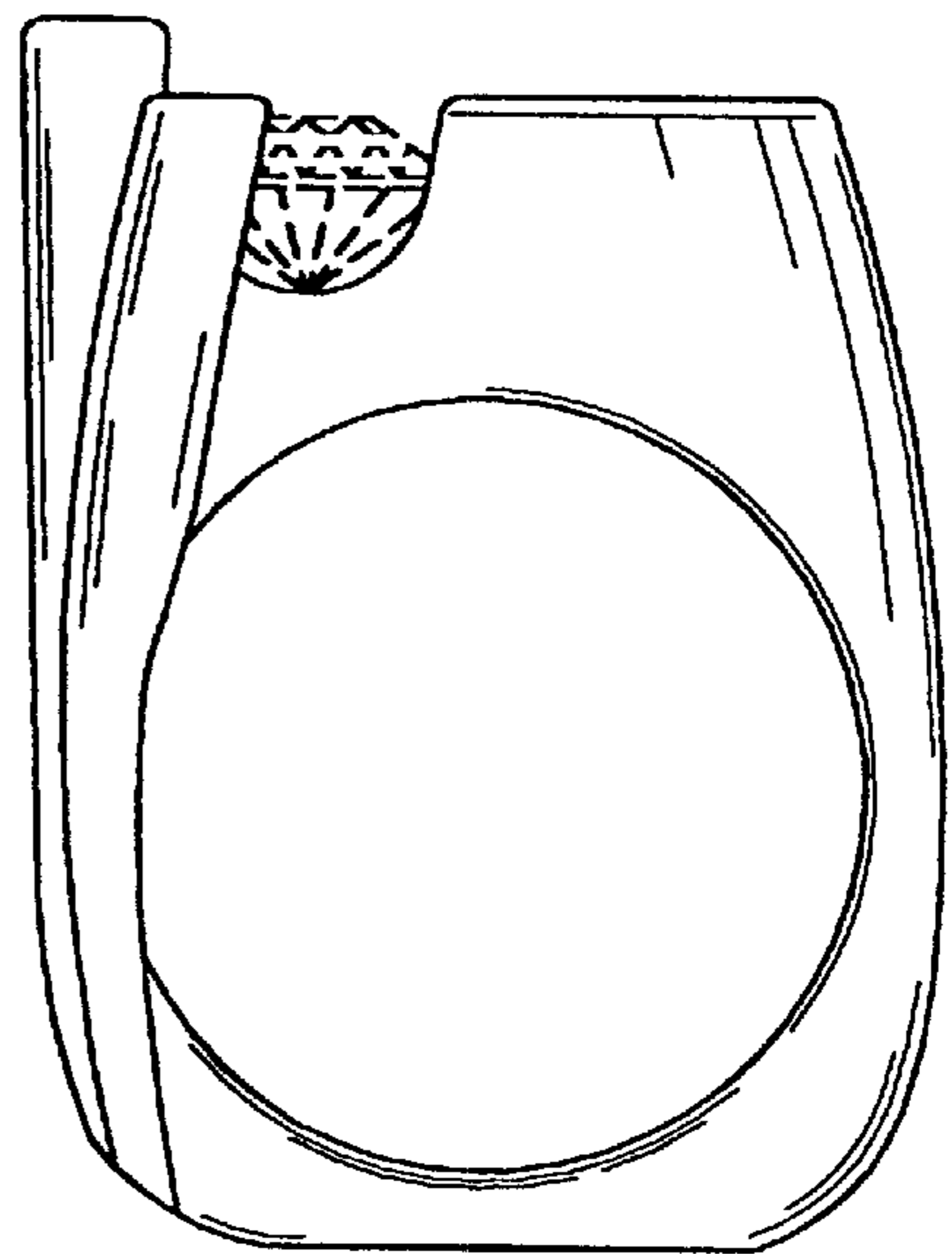

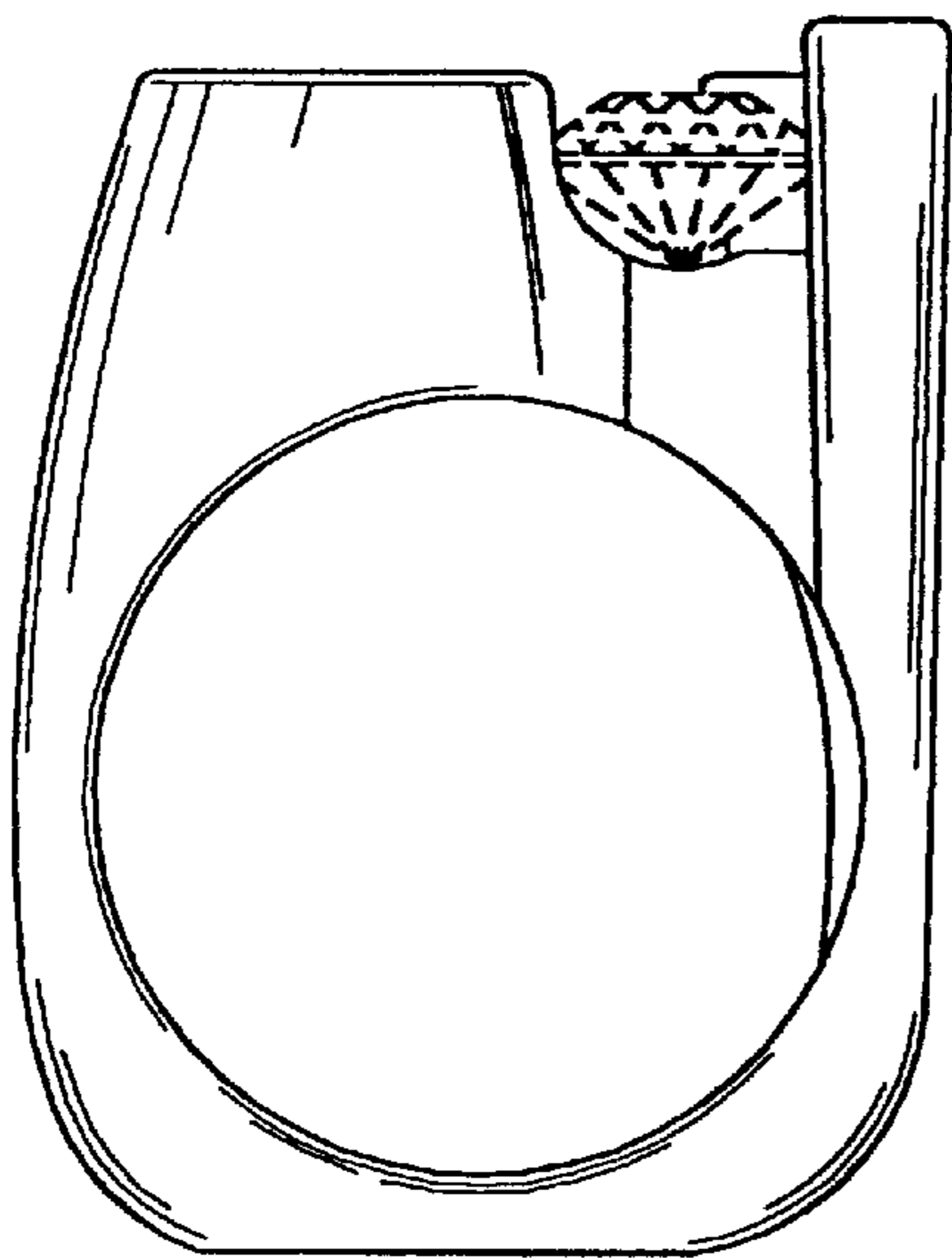

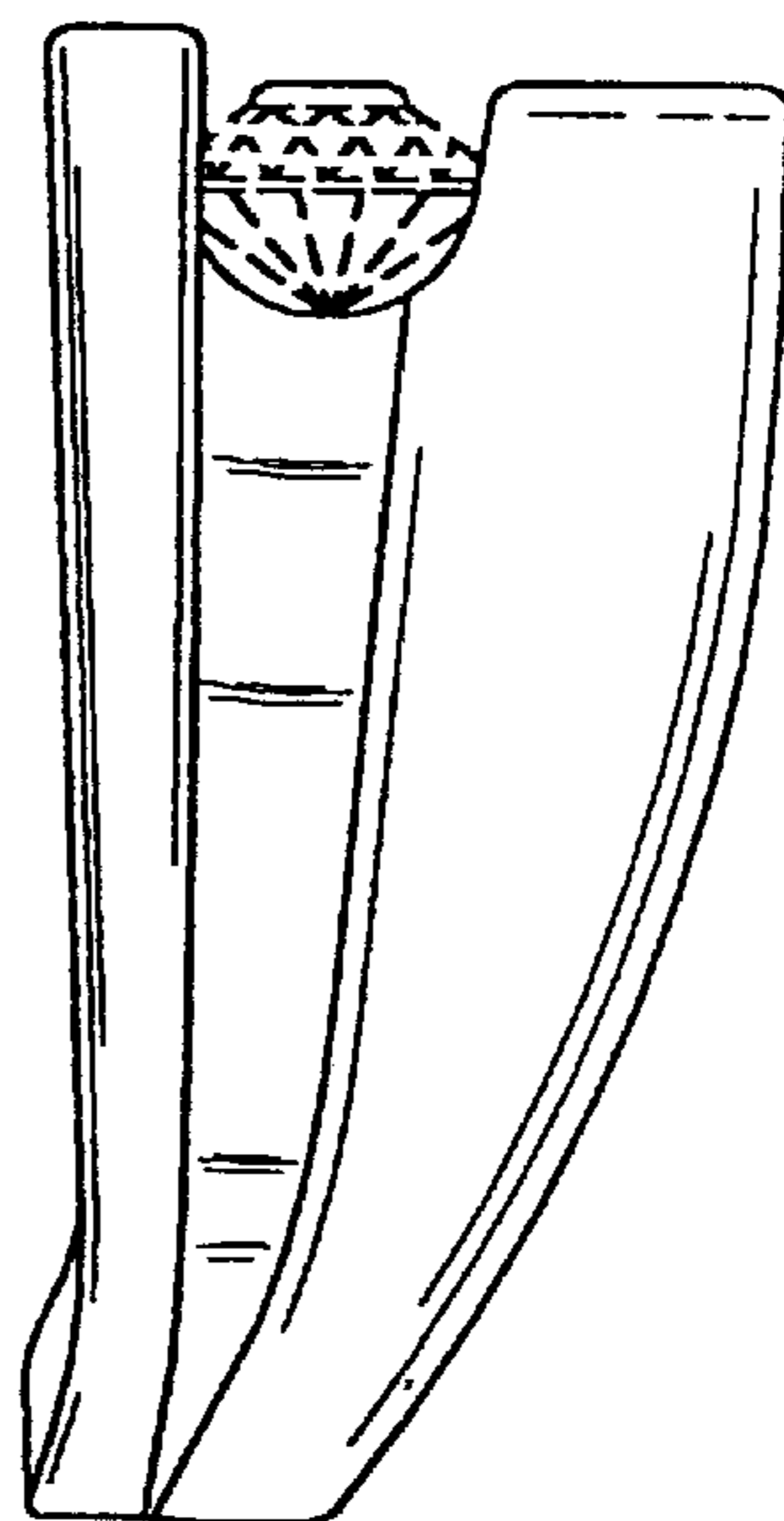

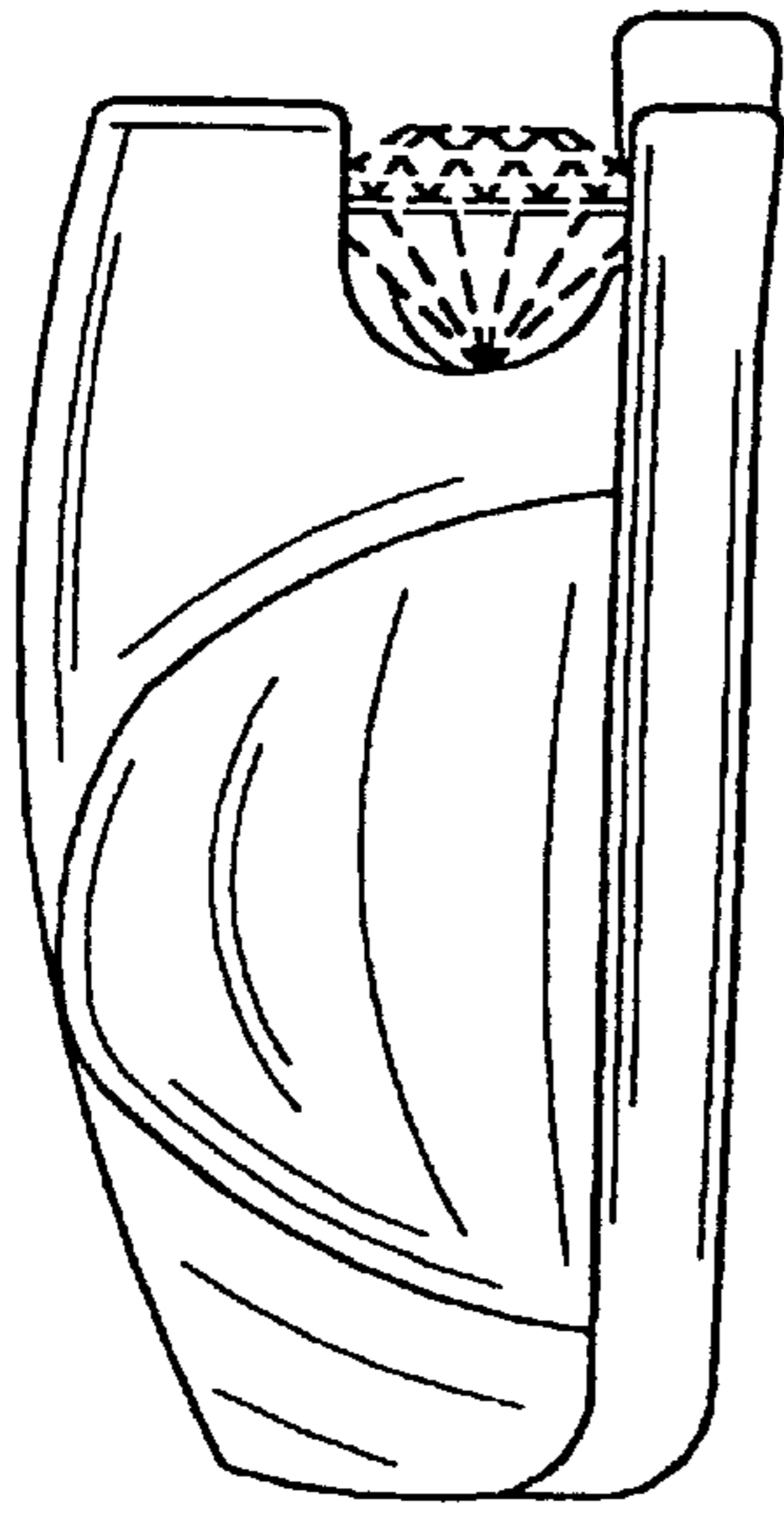

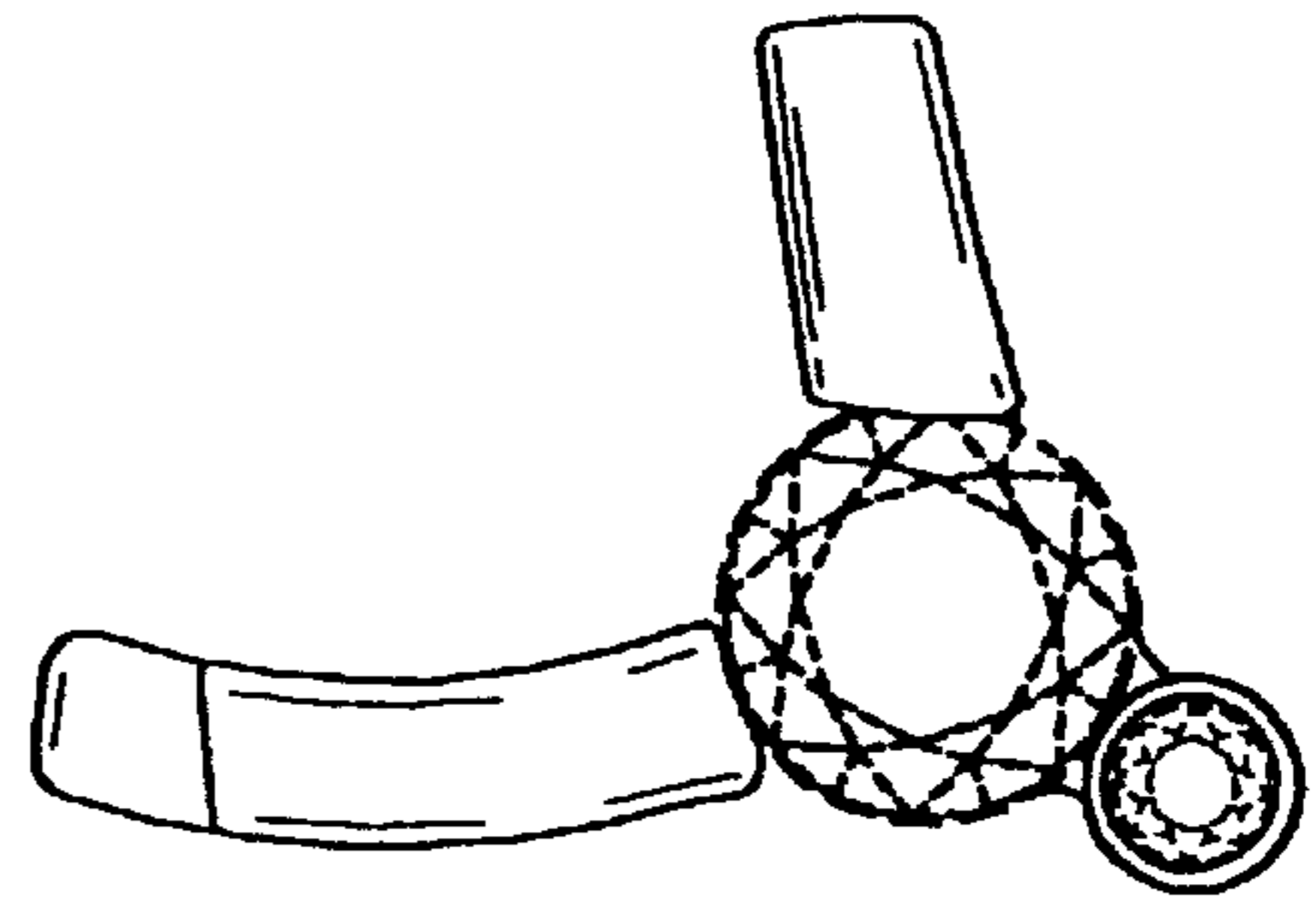

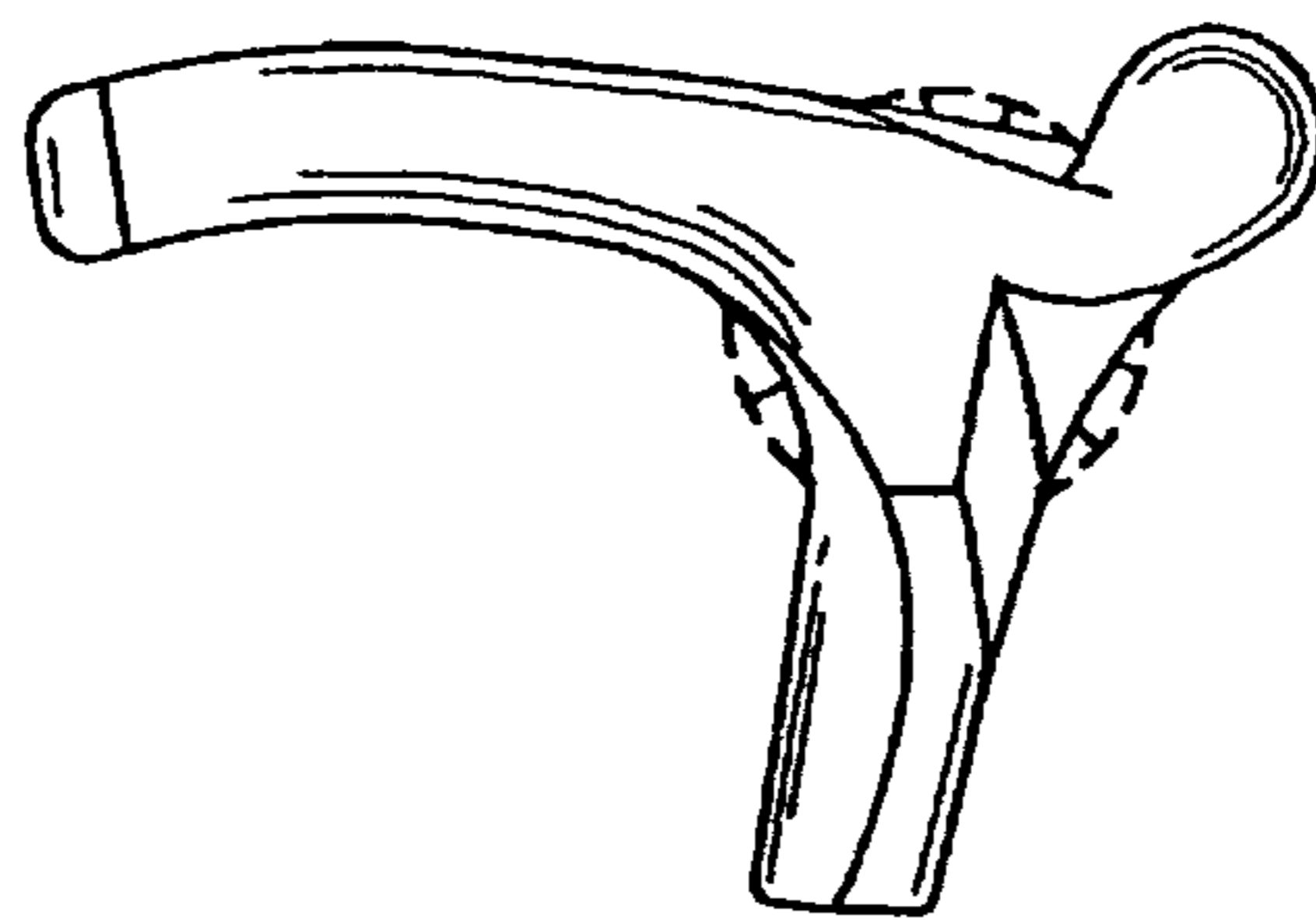
