The ornamental design for a miniature automated teller machine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the miniature automated teller machine showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front view, all other views are plain and unornamented;
 FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along lines 3—3 of FIG. 2 and looking in the direction of the arrows; and,
 FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof.
 The broken lines in FIGS. 1 through 4 are for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

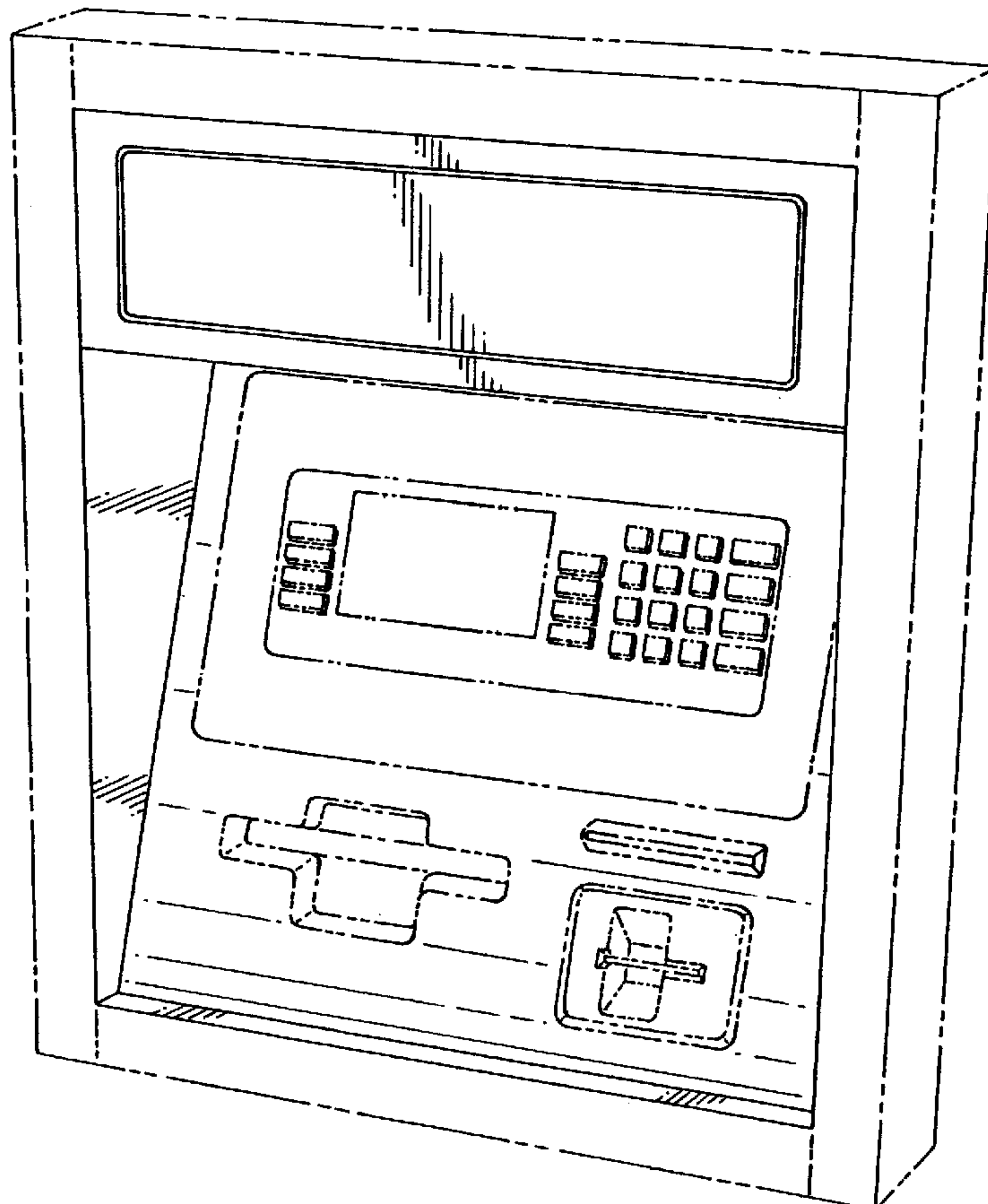

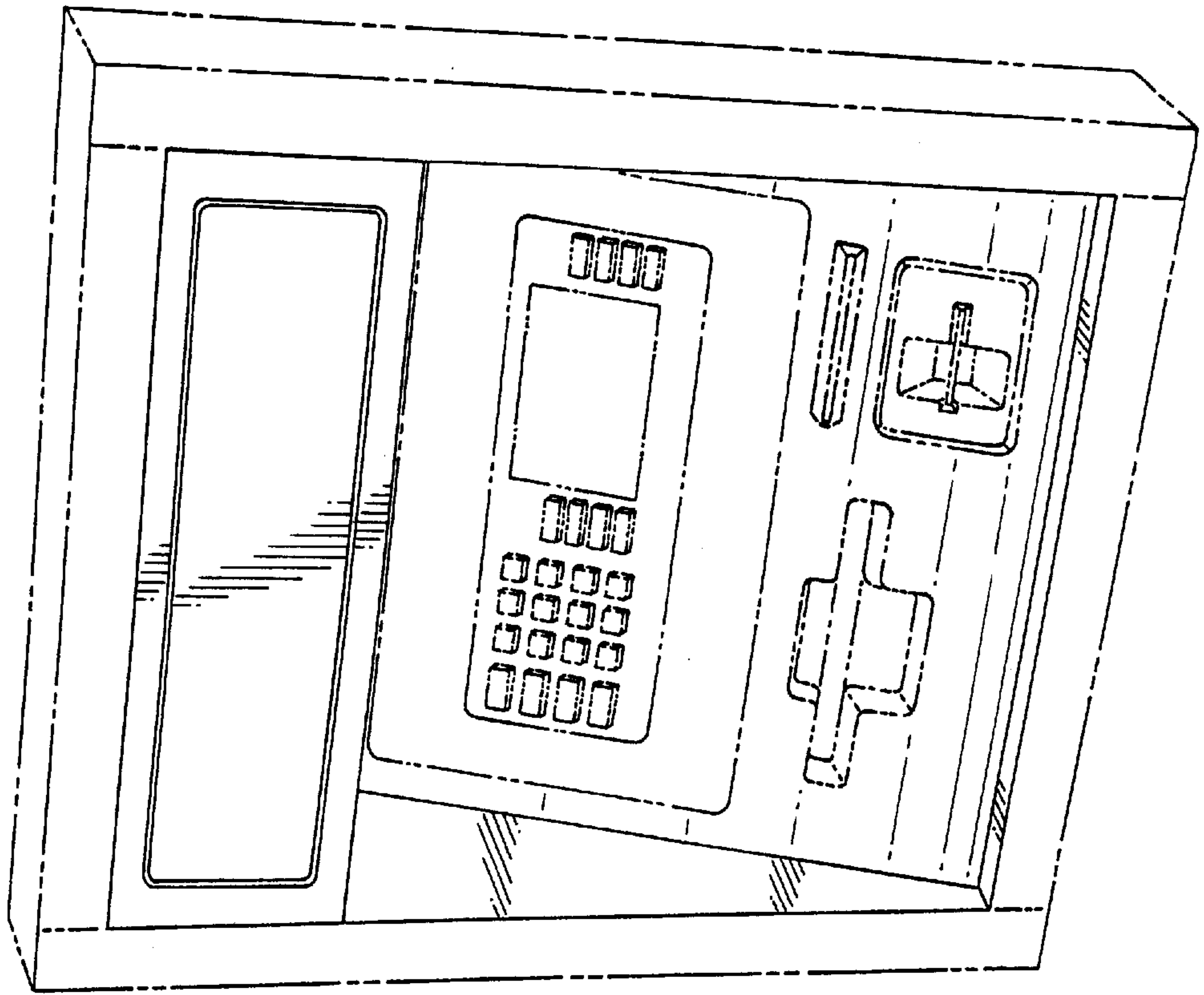

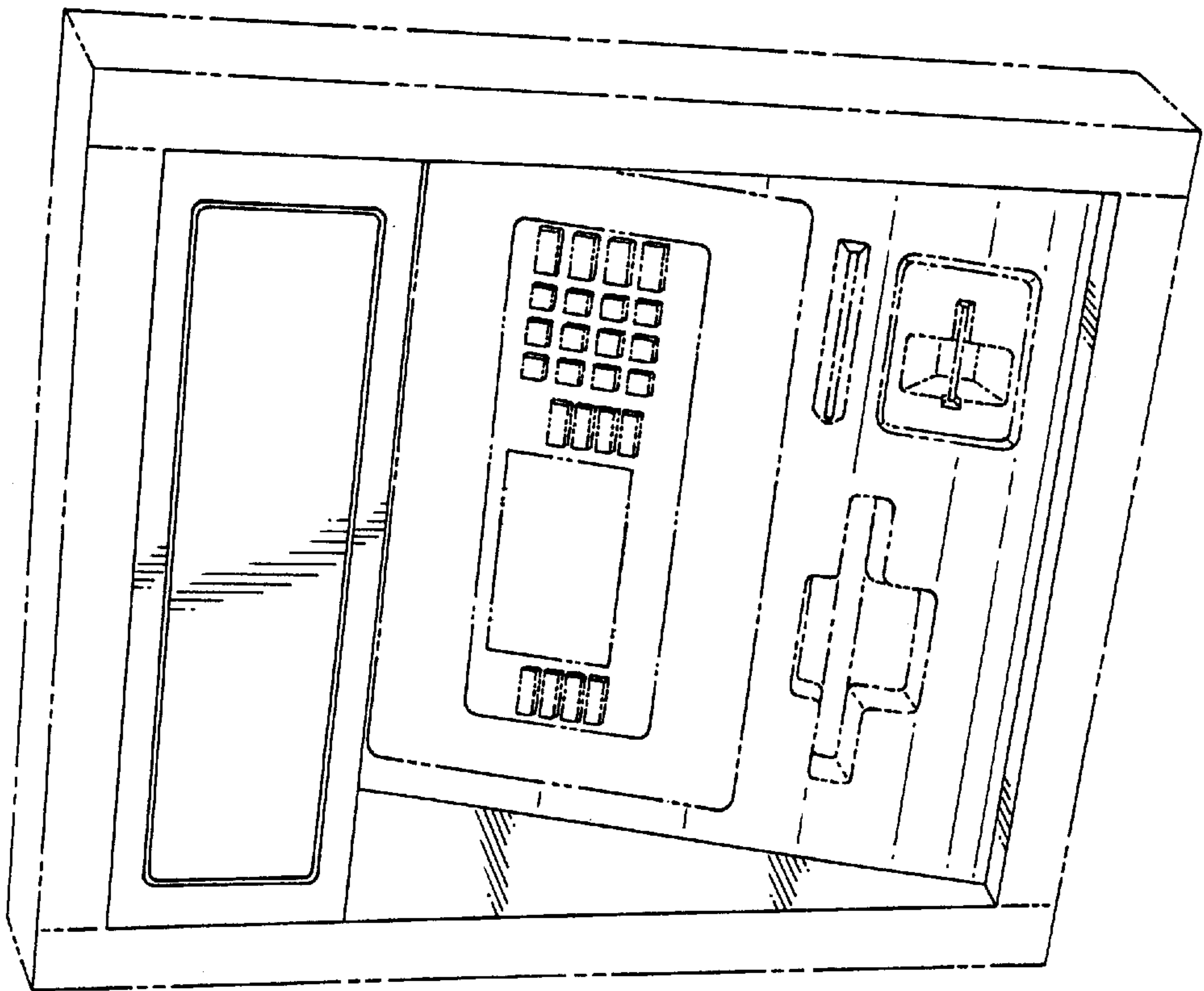

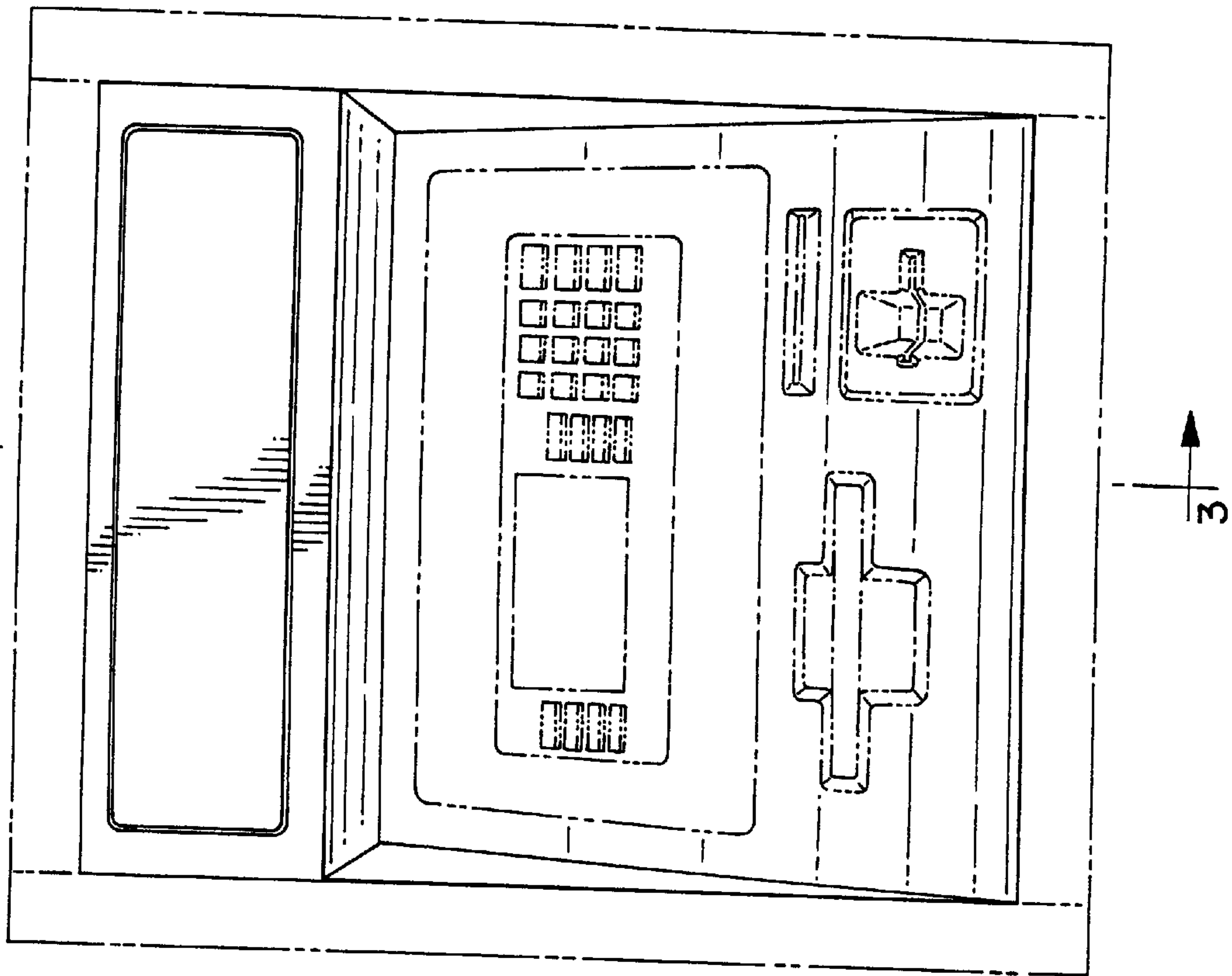
