DESCRIPTION

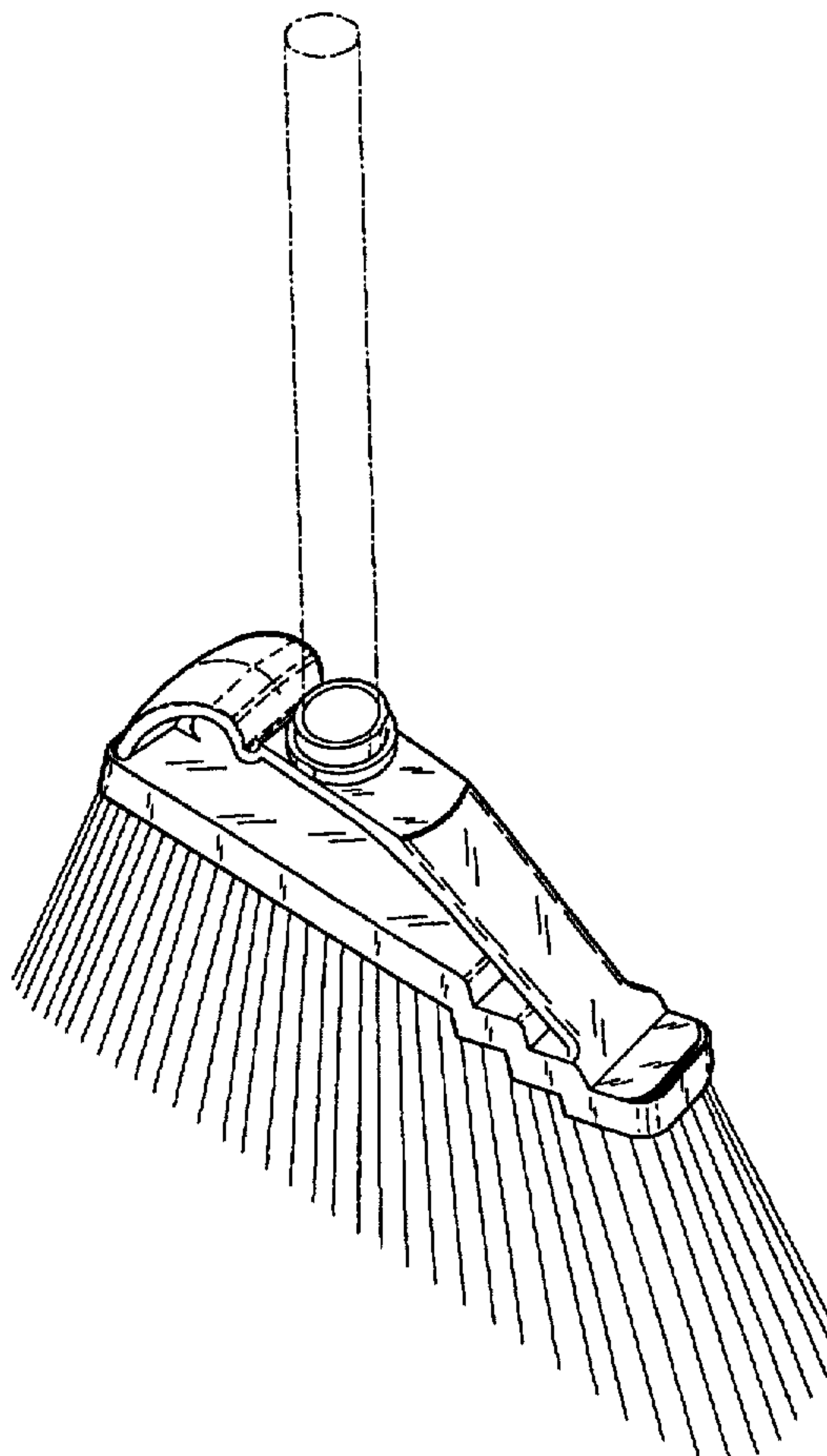
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the broom of the present invention;

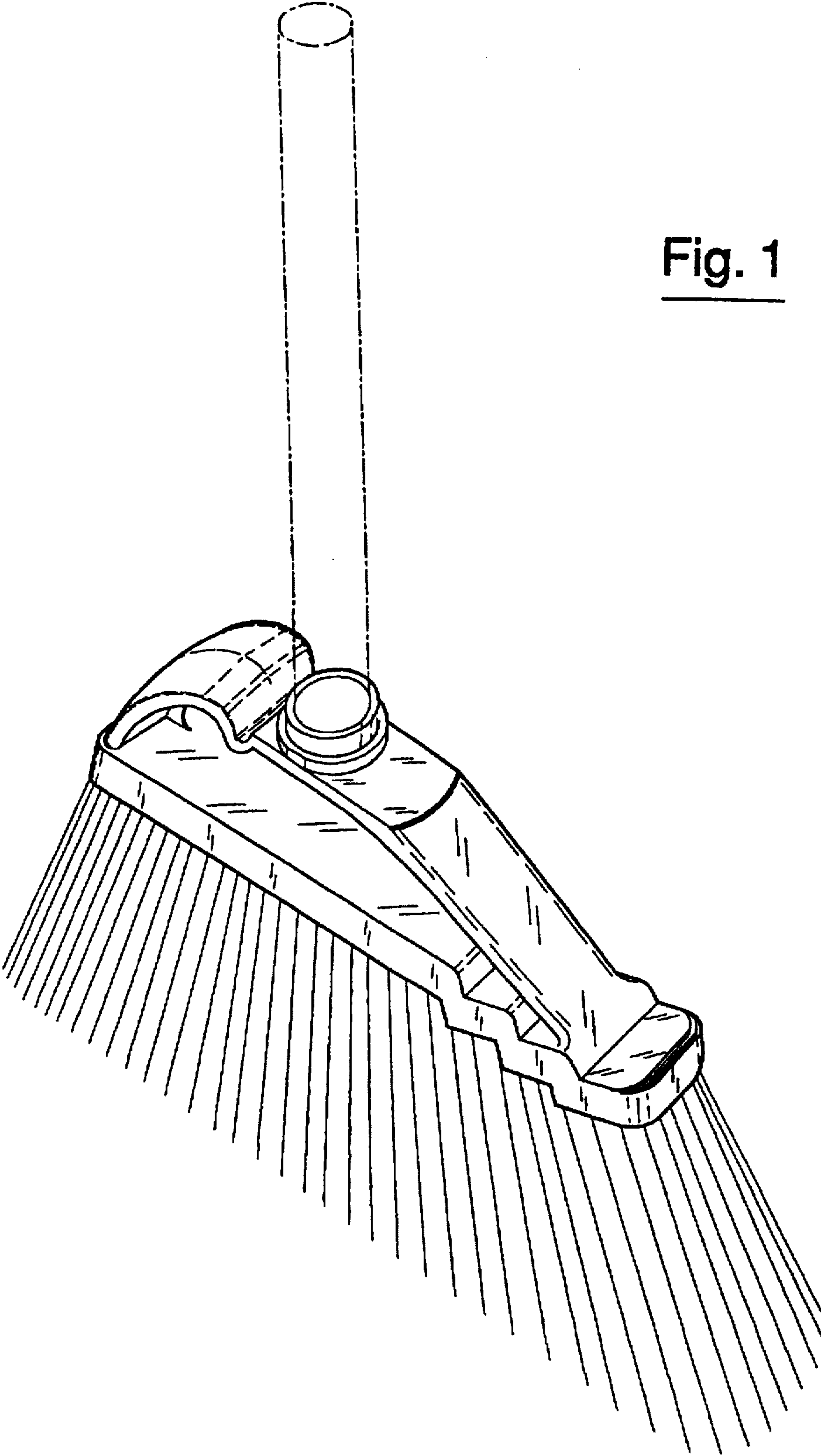

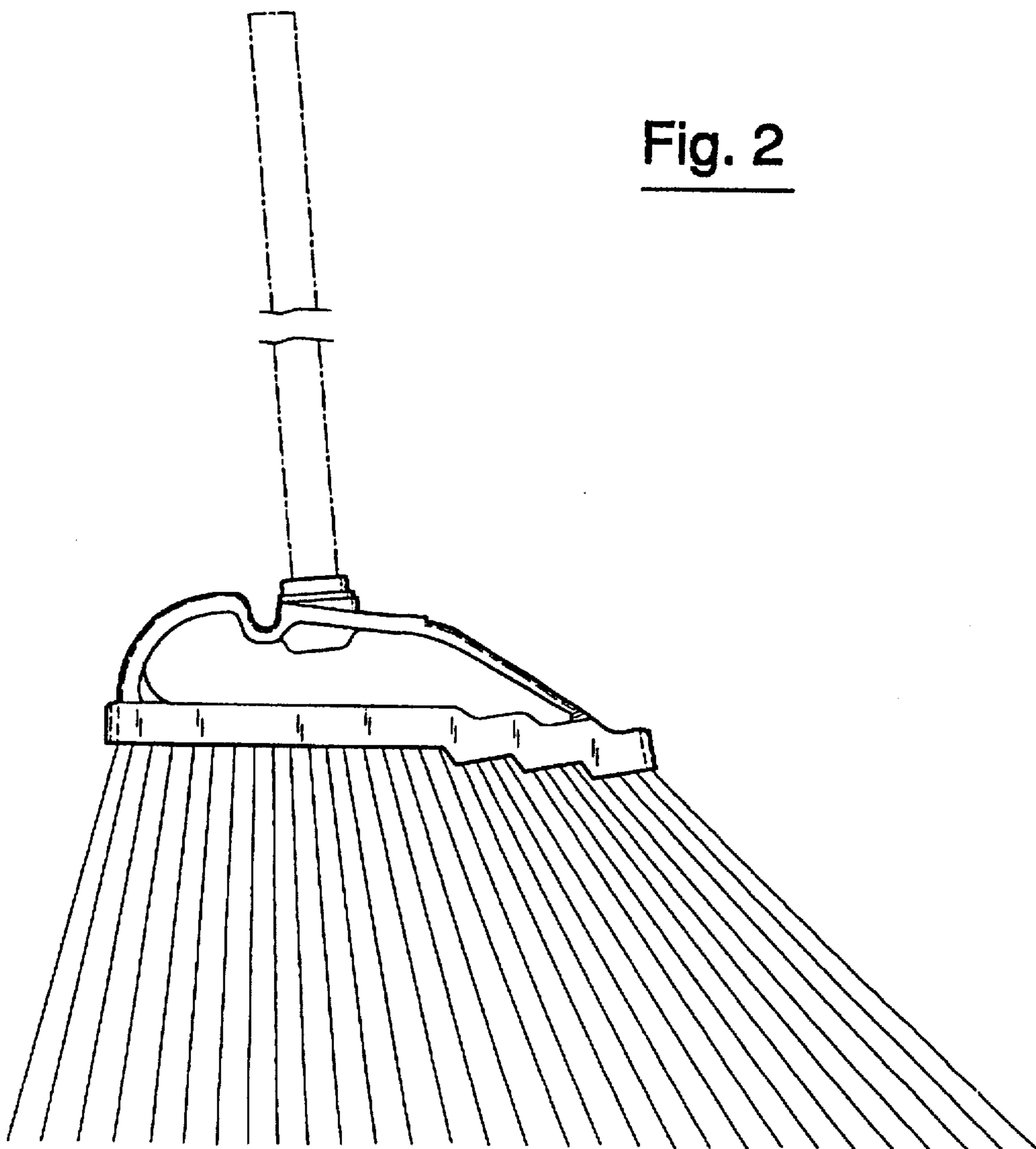
