(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sofa, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the sofa showing my design.

FIG. 2 is another front view thereof;

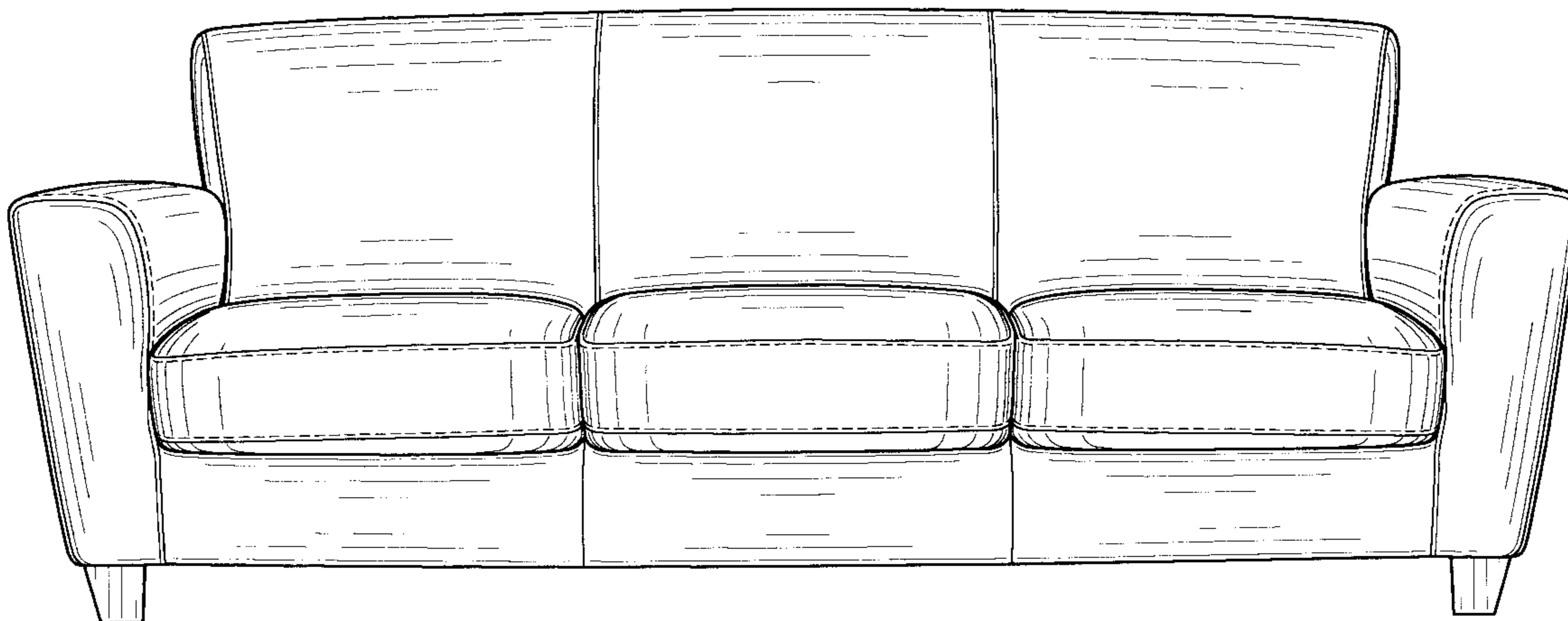
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

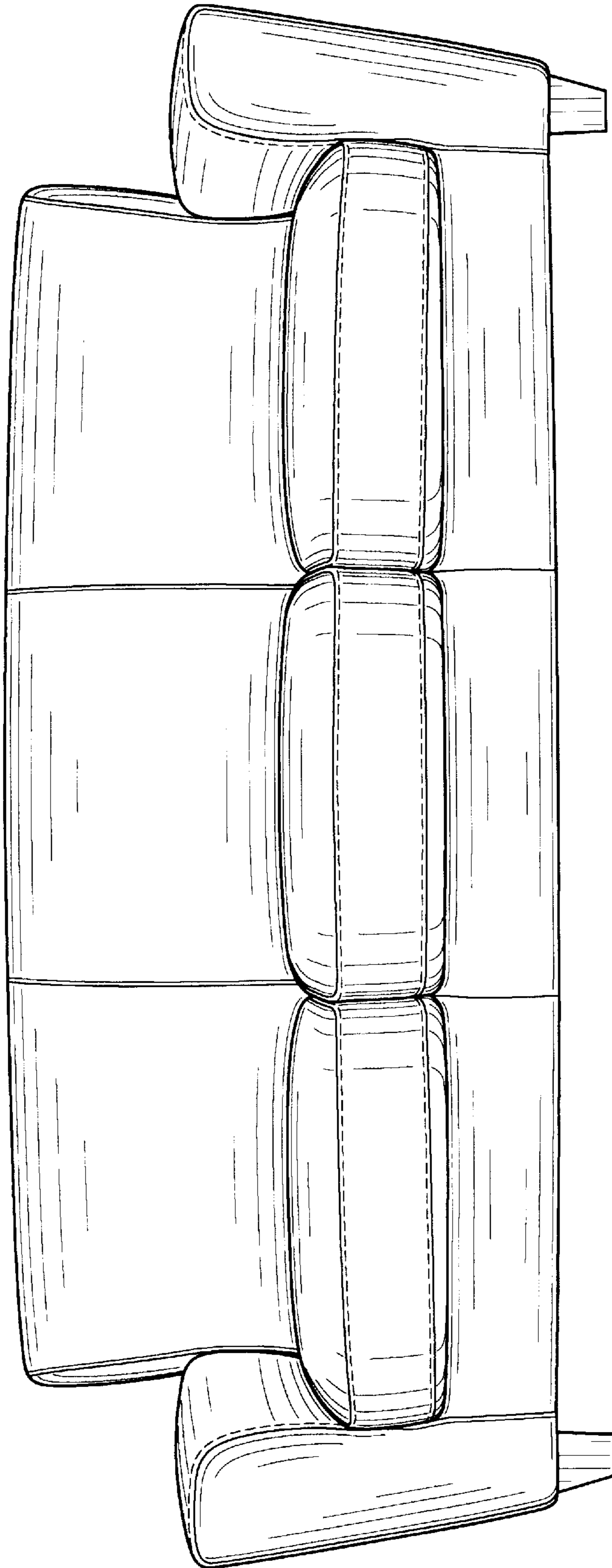

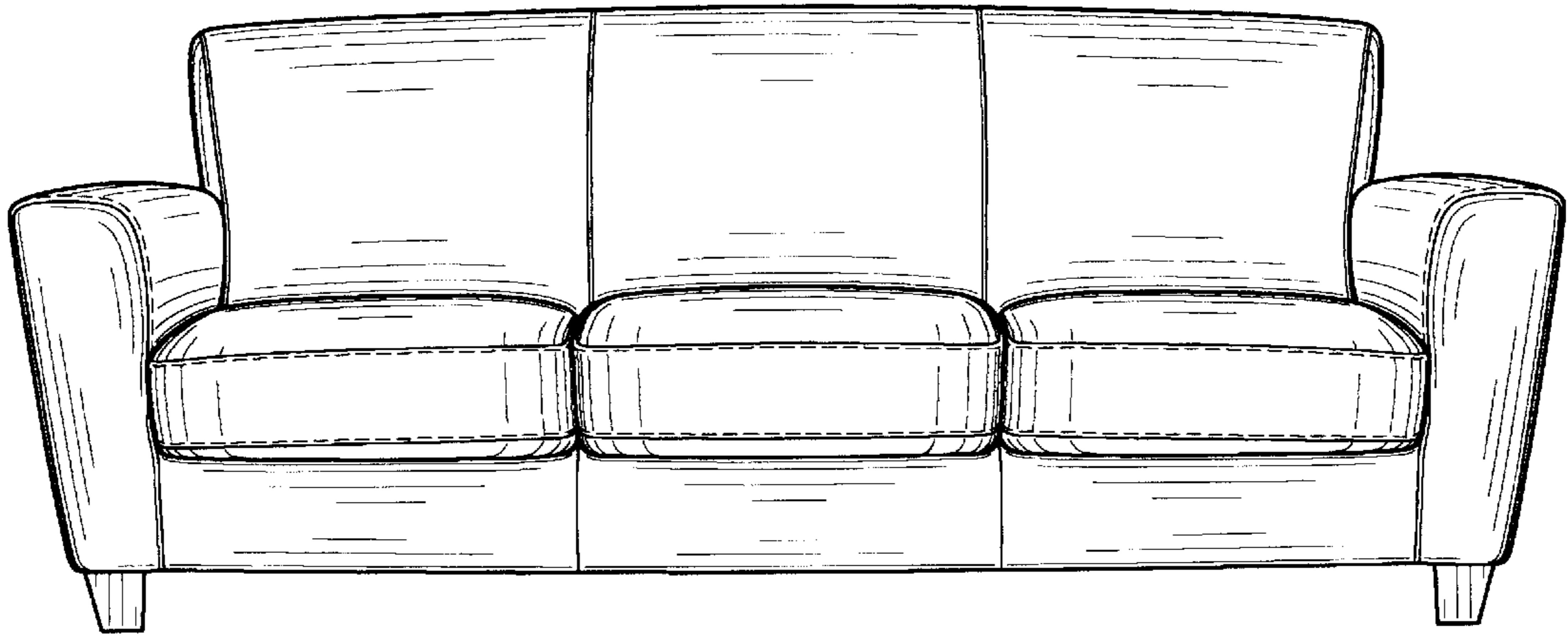

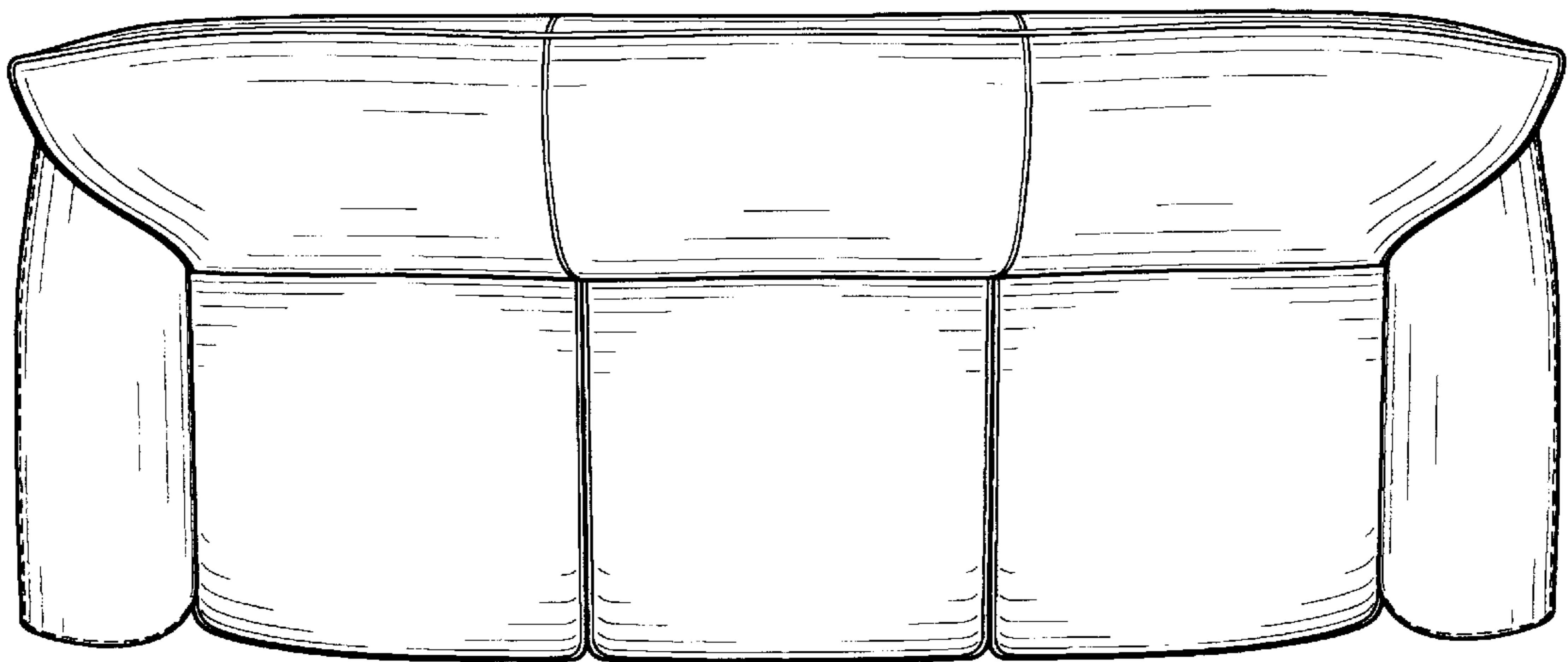

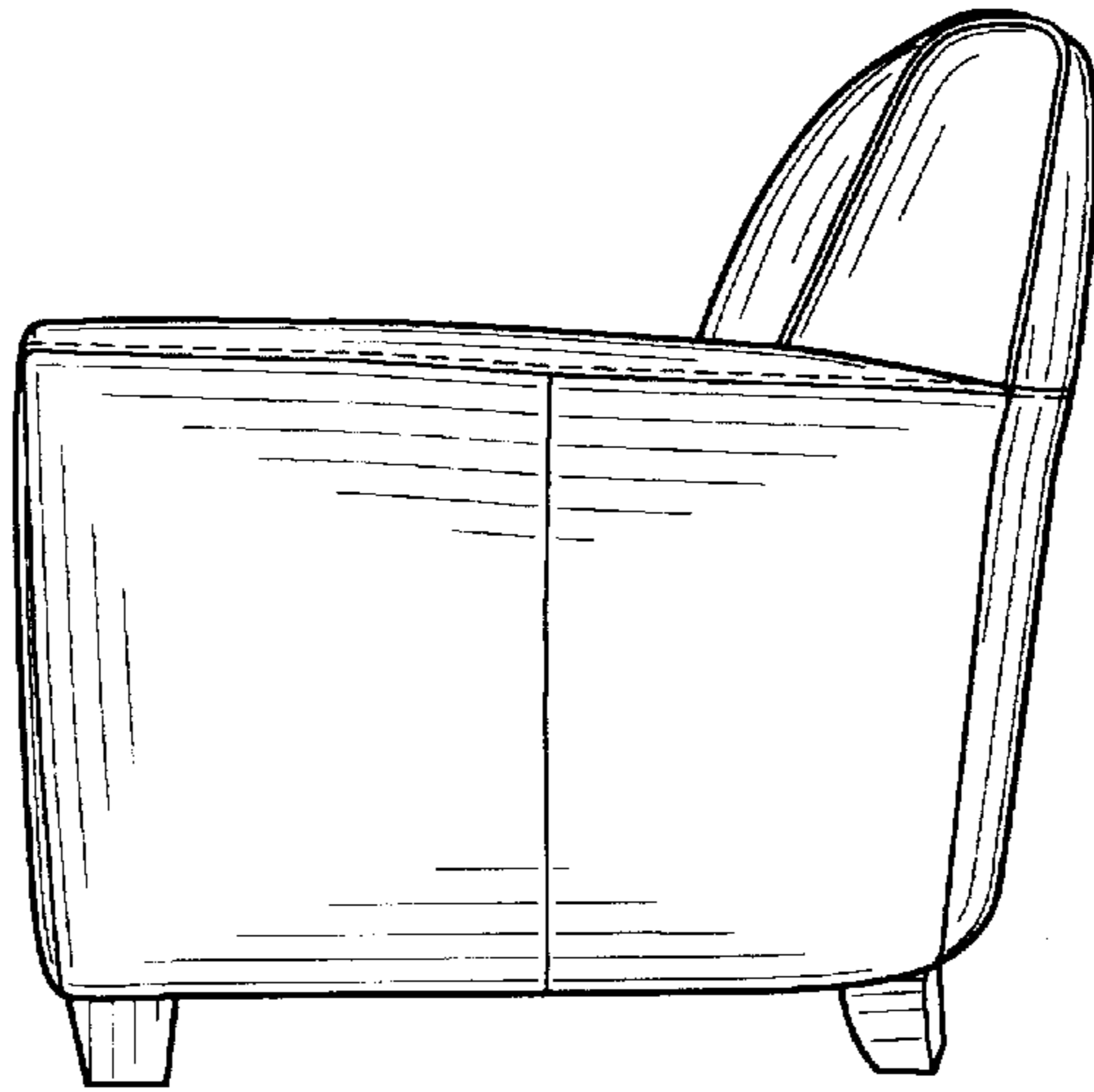

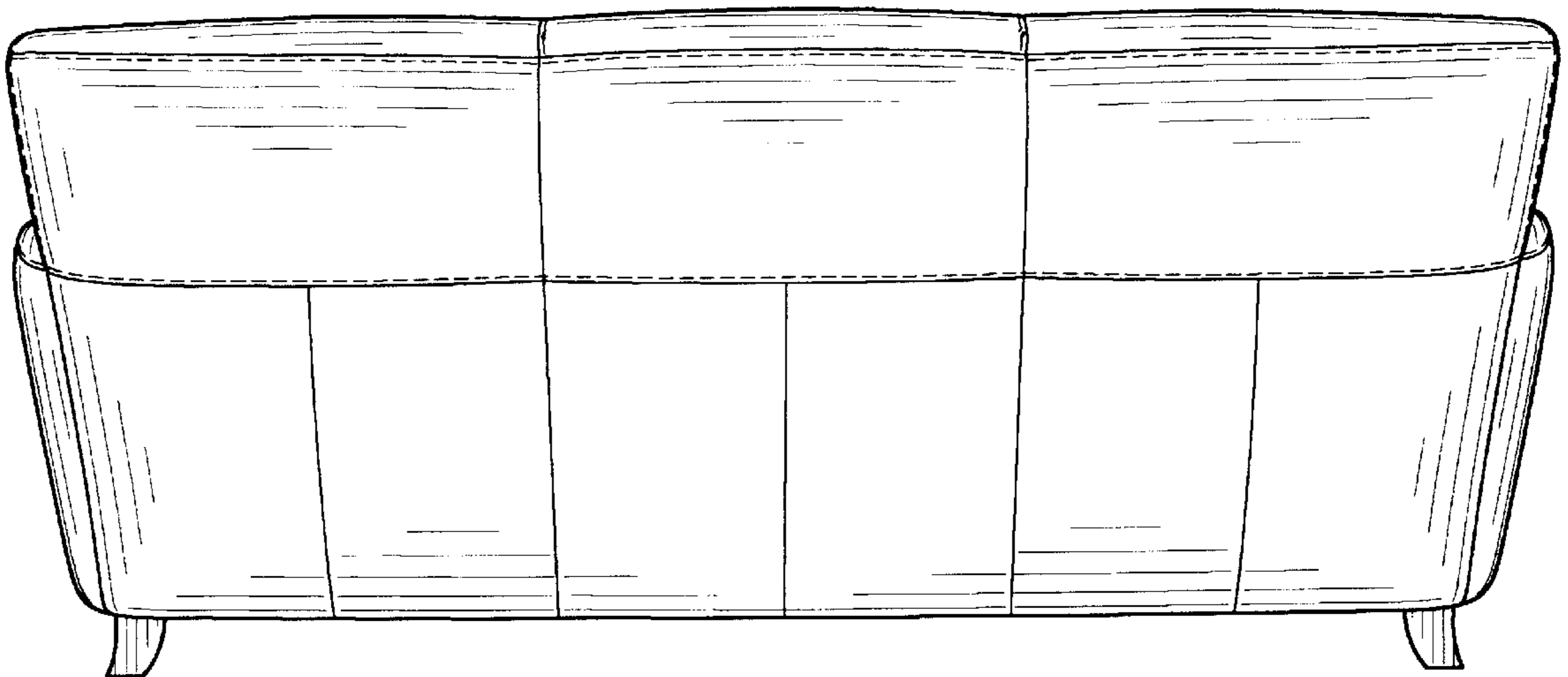
