FIG. 2 is another front view thereof;

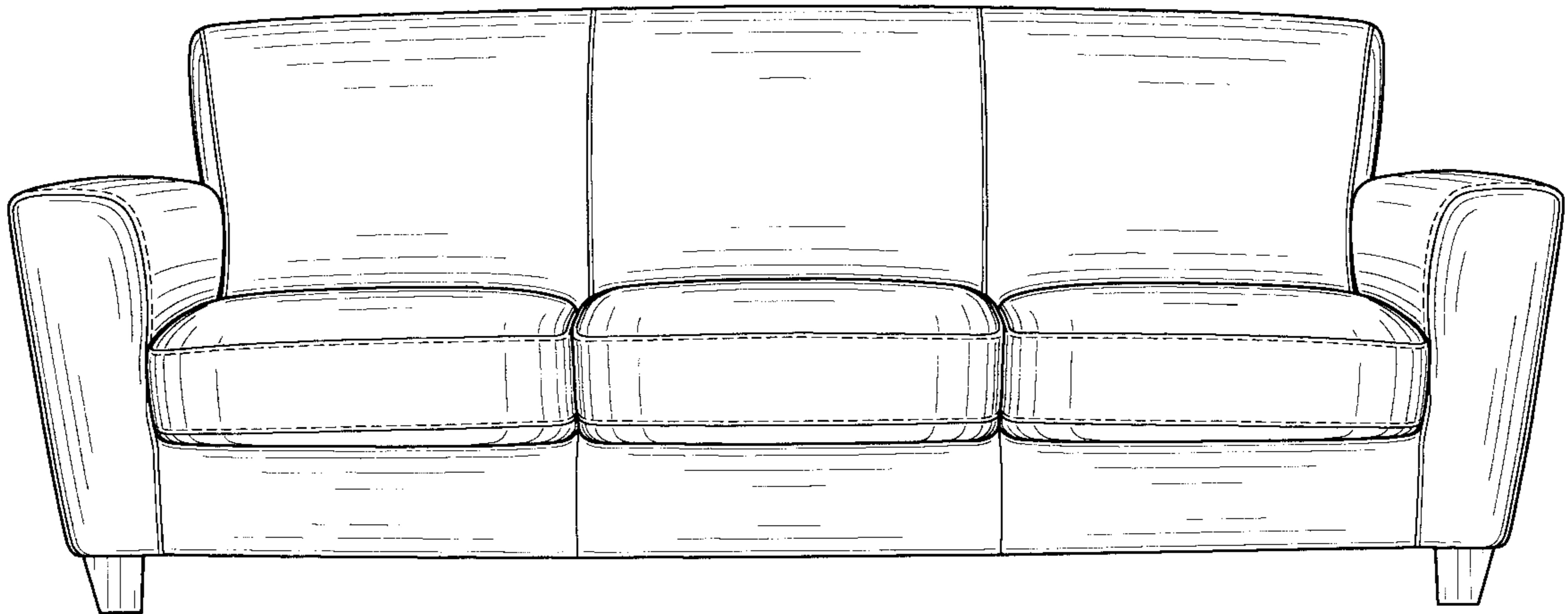
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

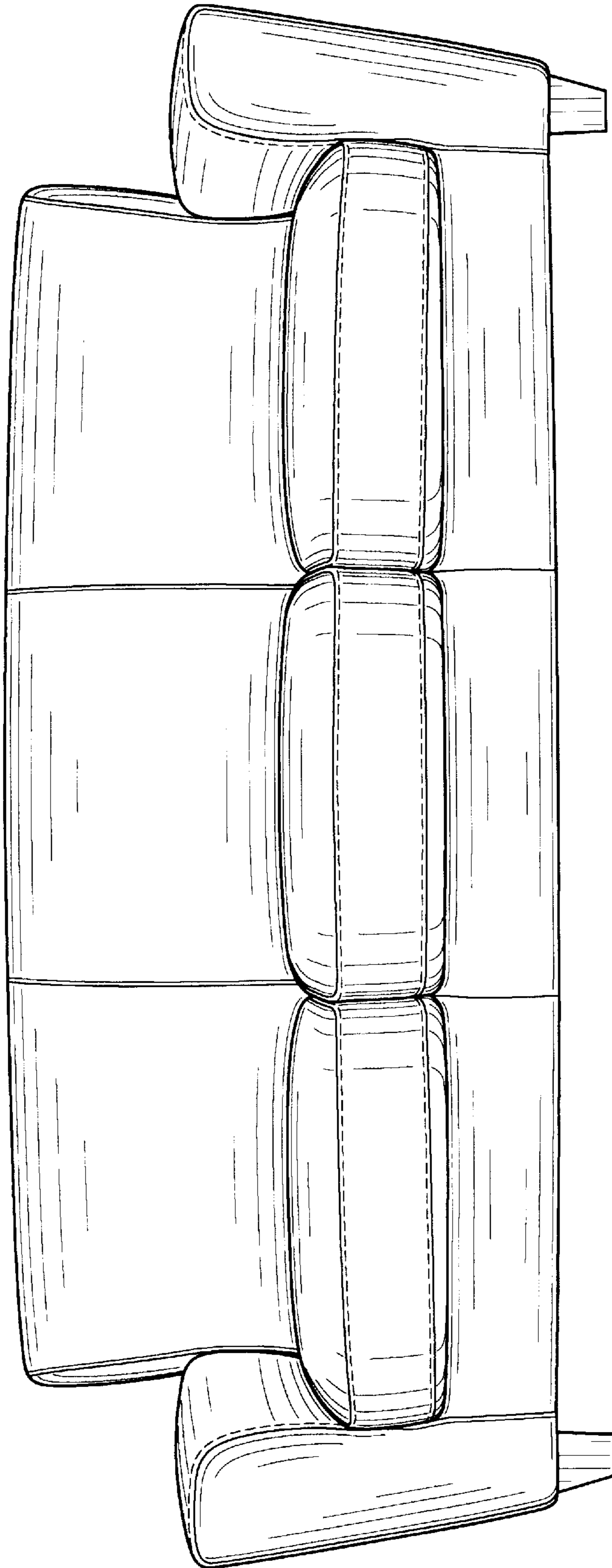
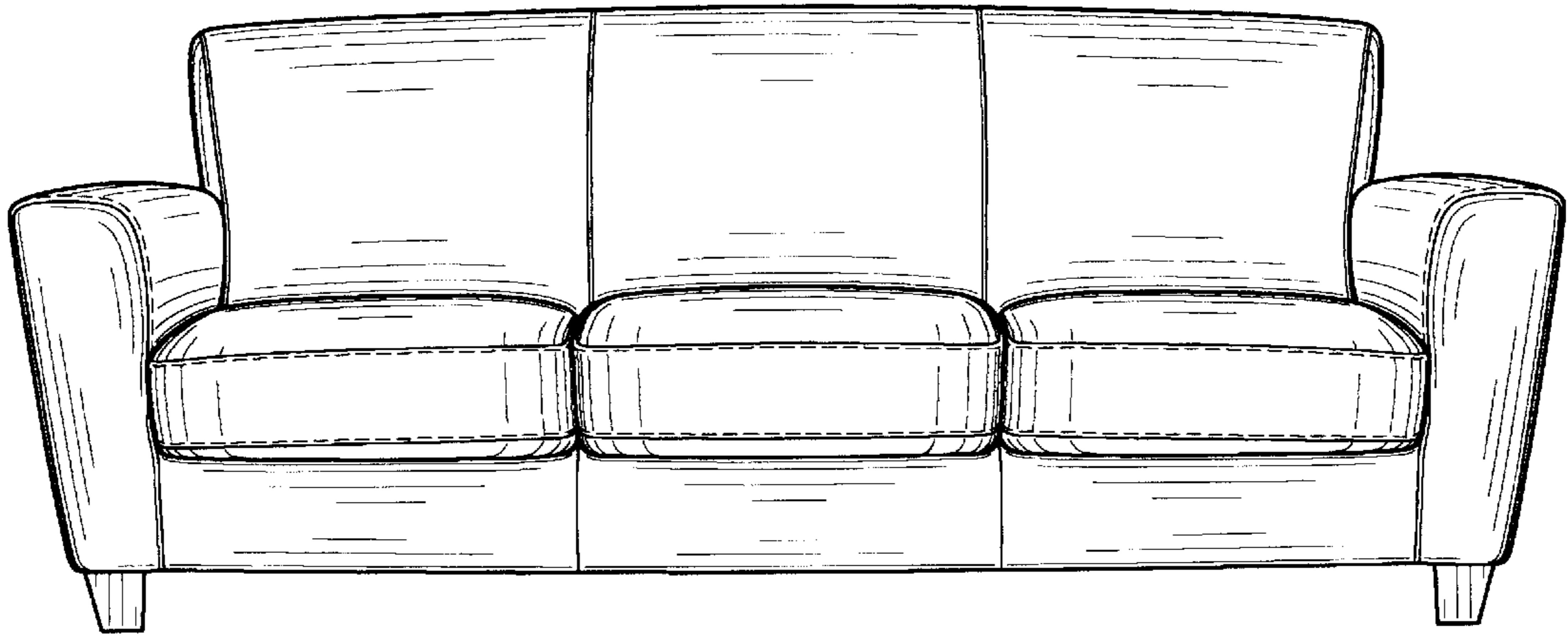
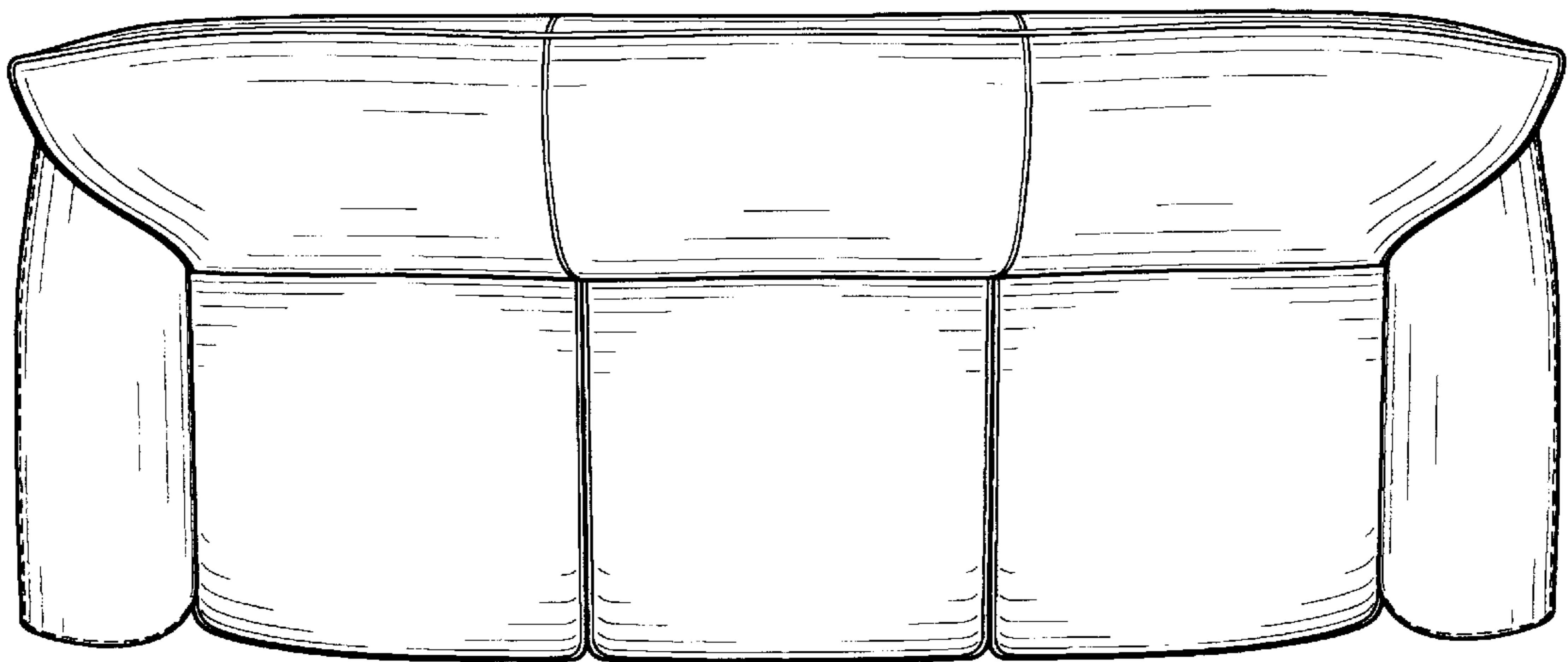


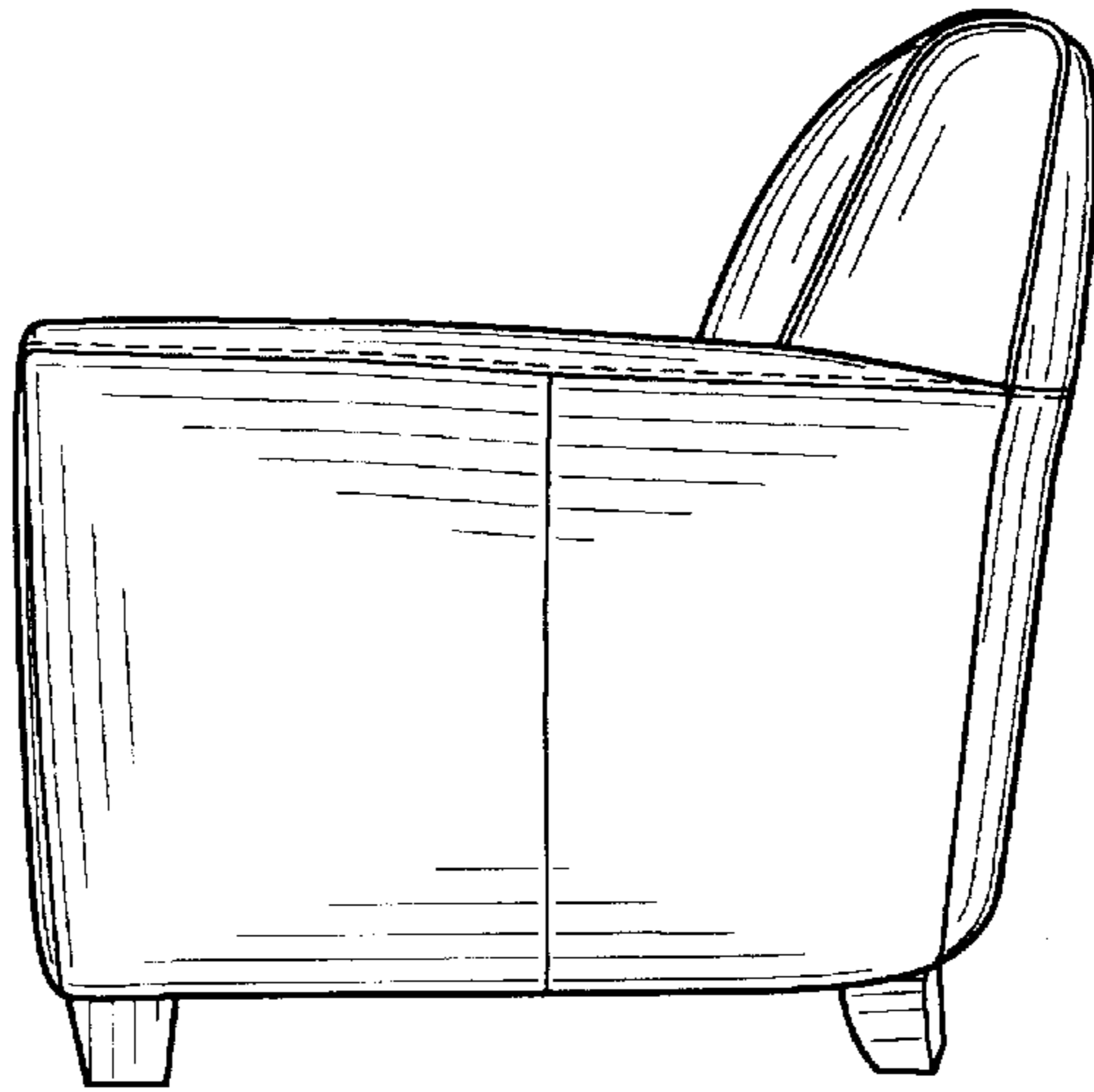

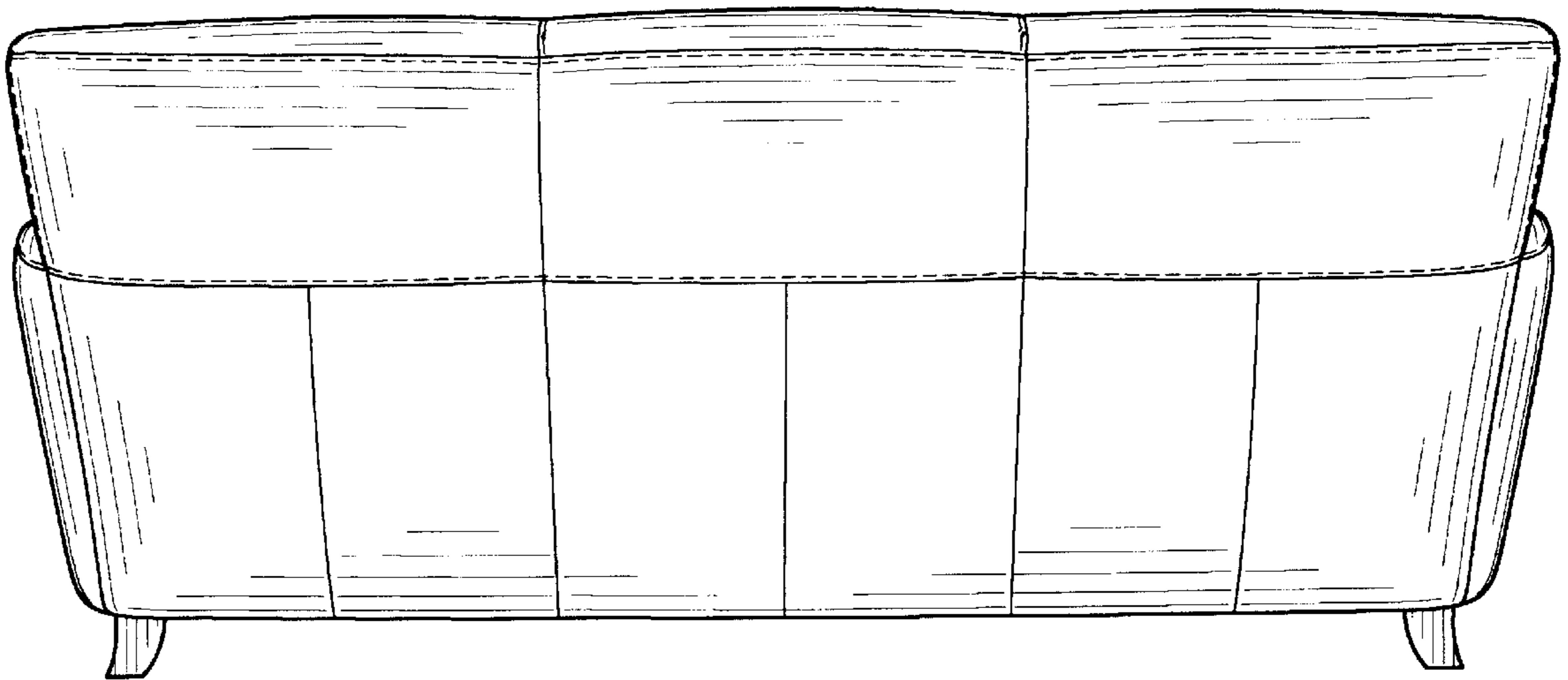
