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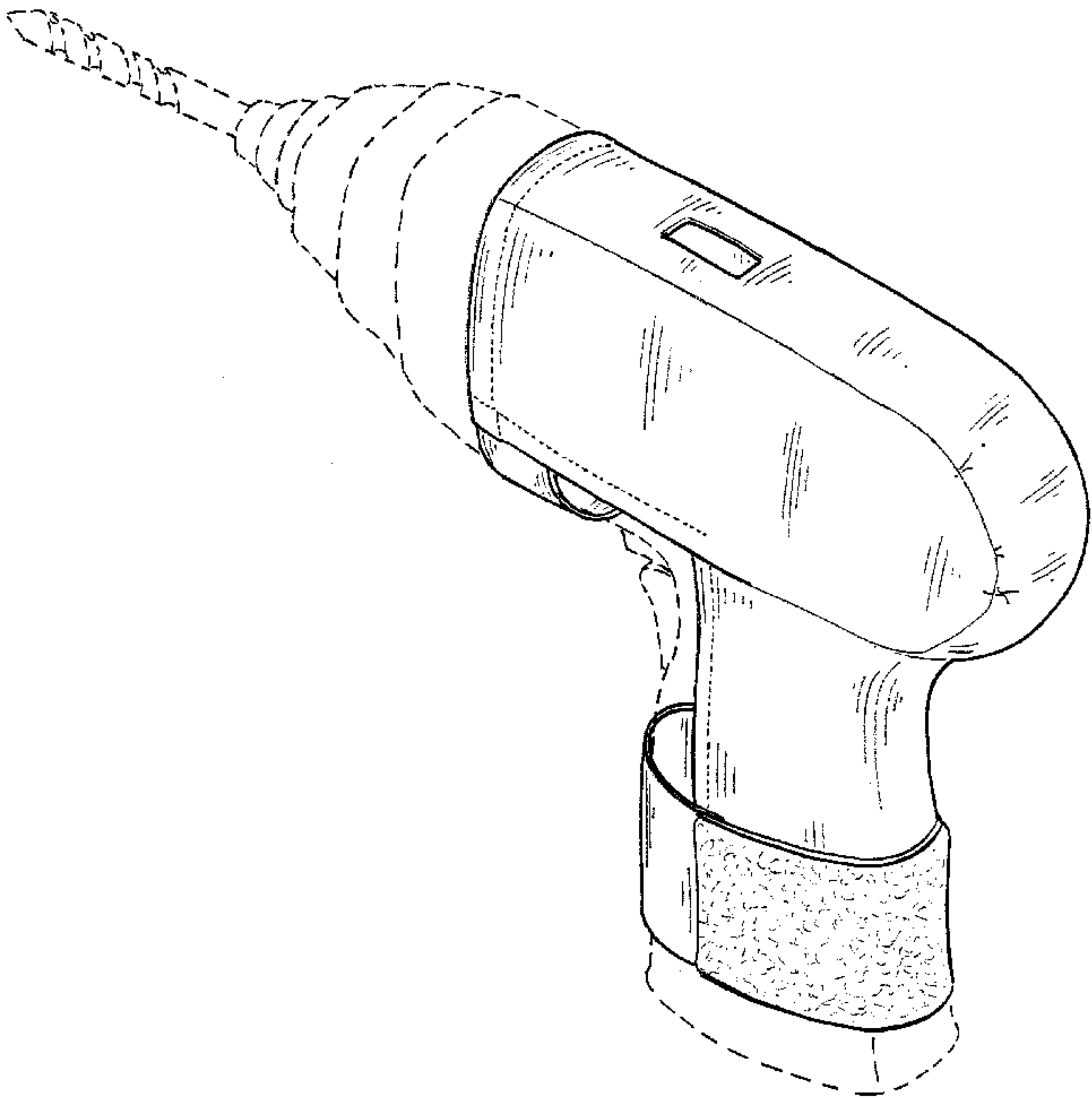
(57) CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of the tool cover of this invention;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the tool cover of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the tool cover of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of the tool cover of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the tool cover of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is an opposite side elevation view of the tool cover of FIG. 4; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the tool cover of FIG. 1.

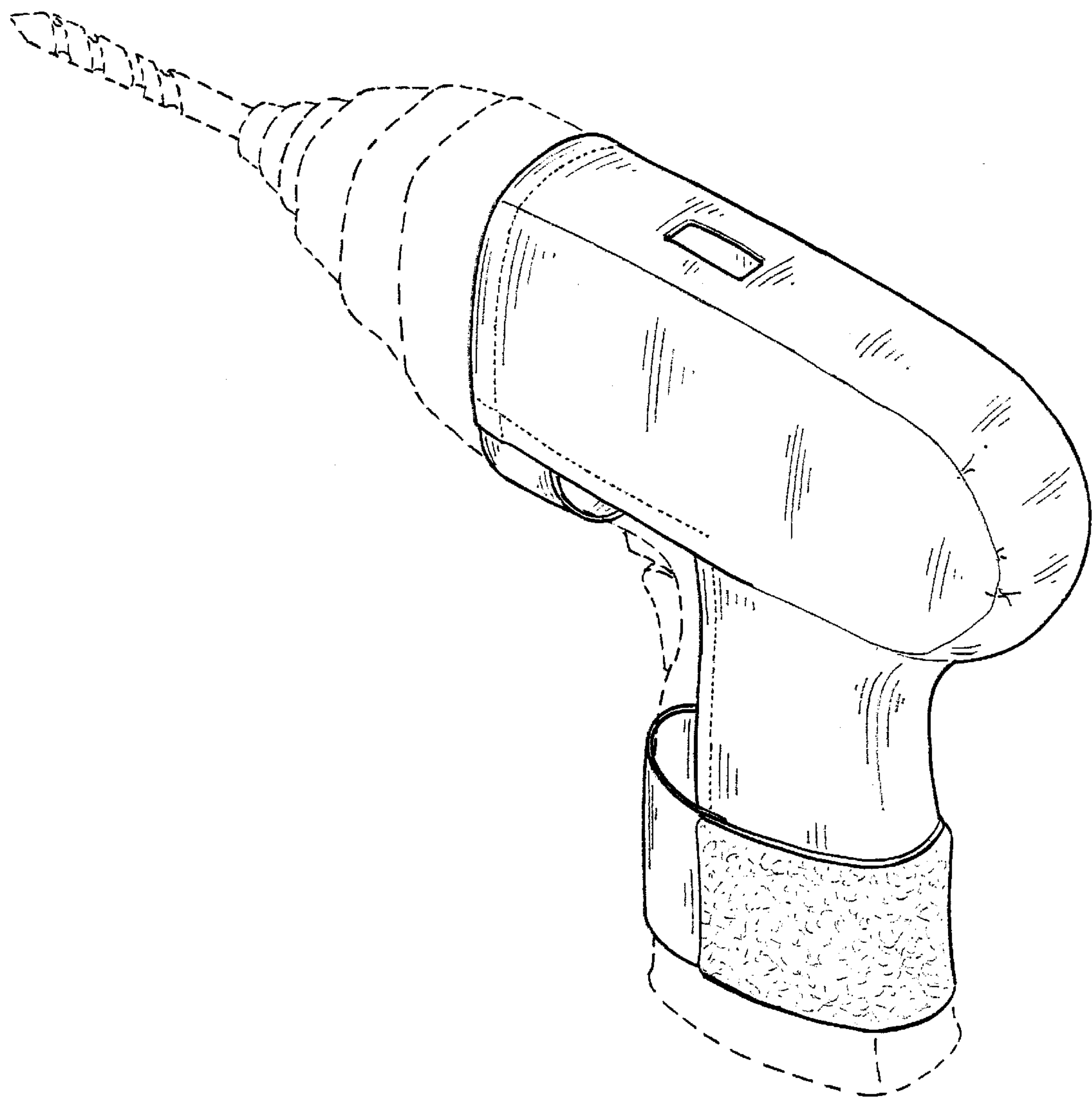

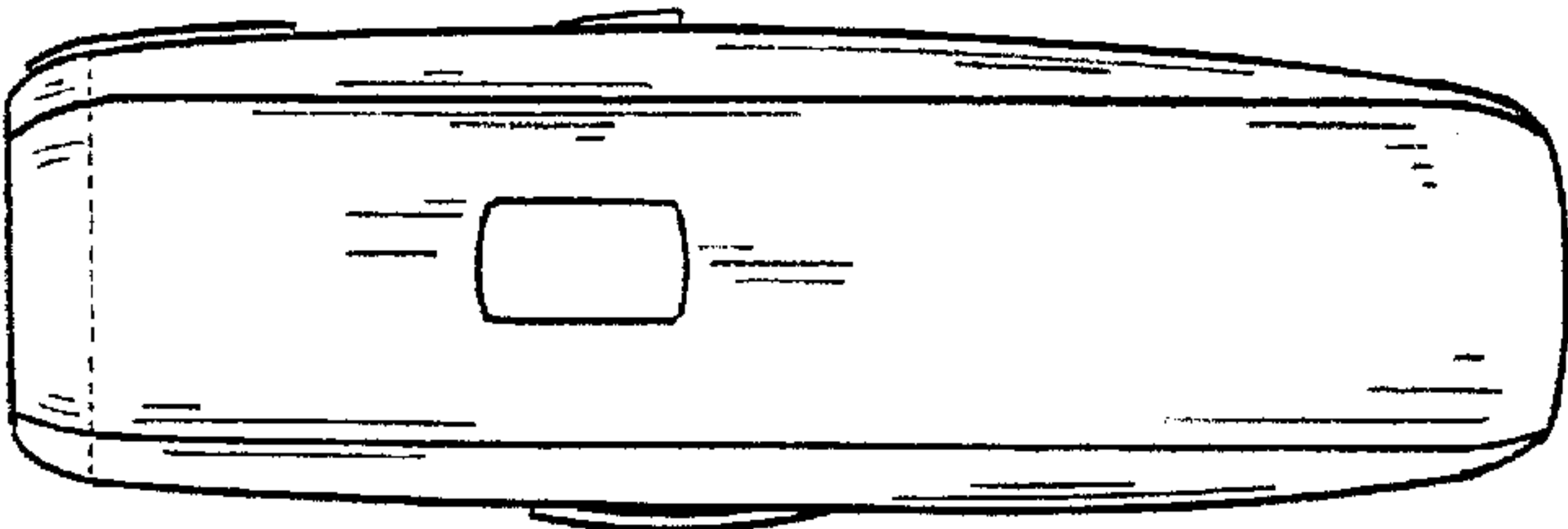

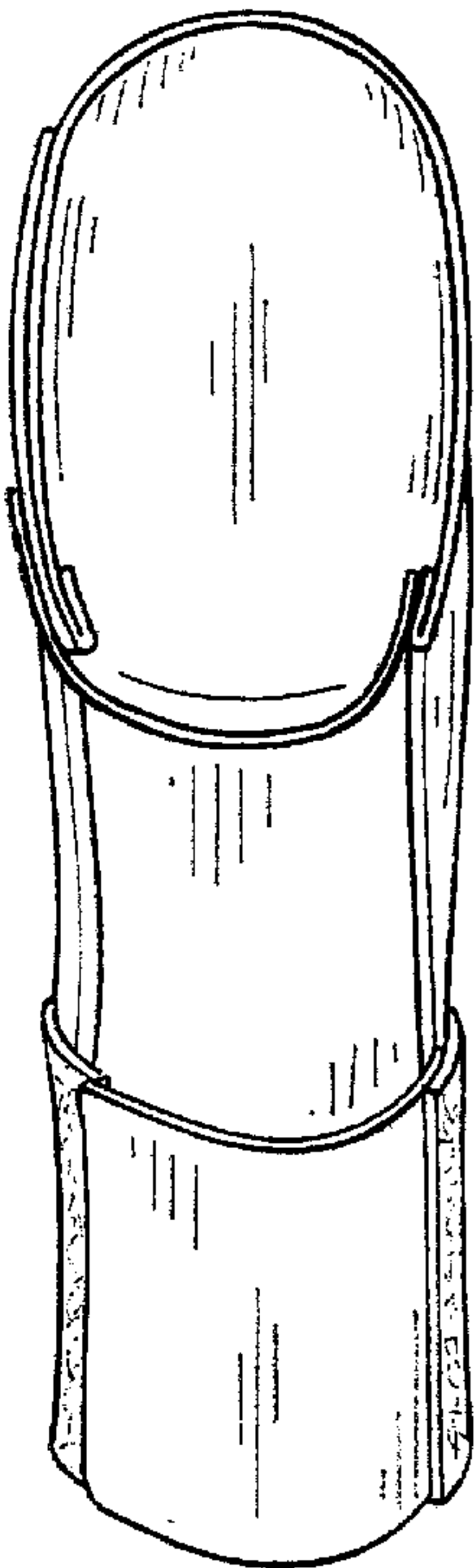

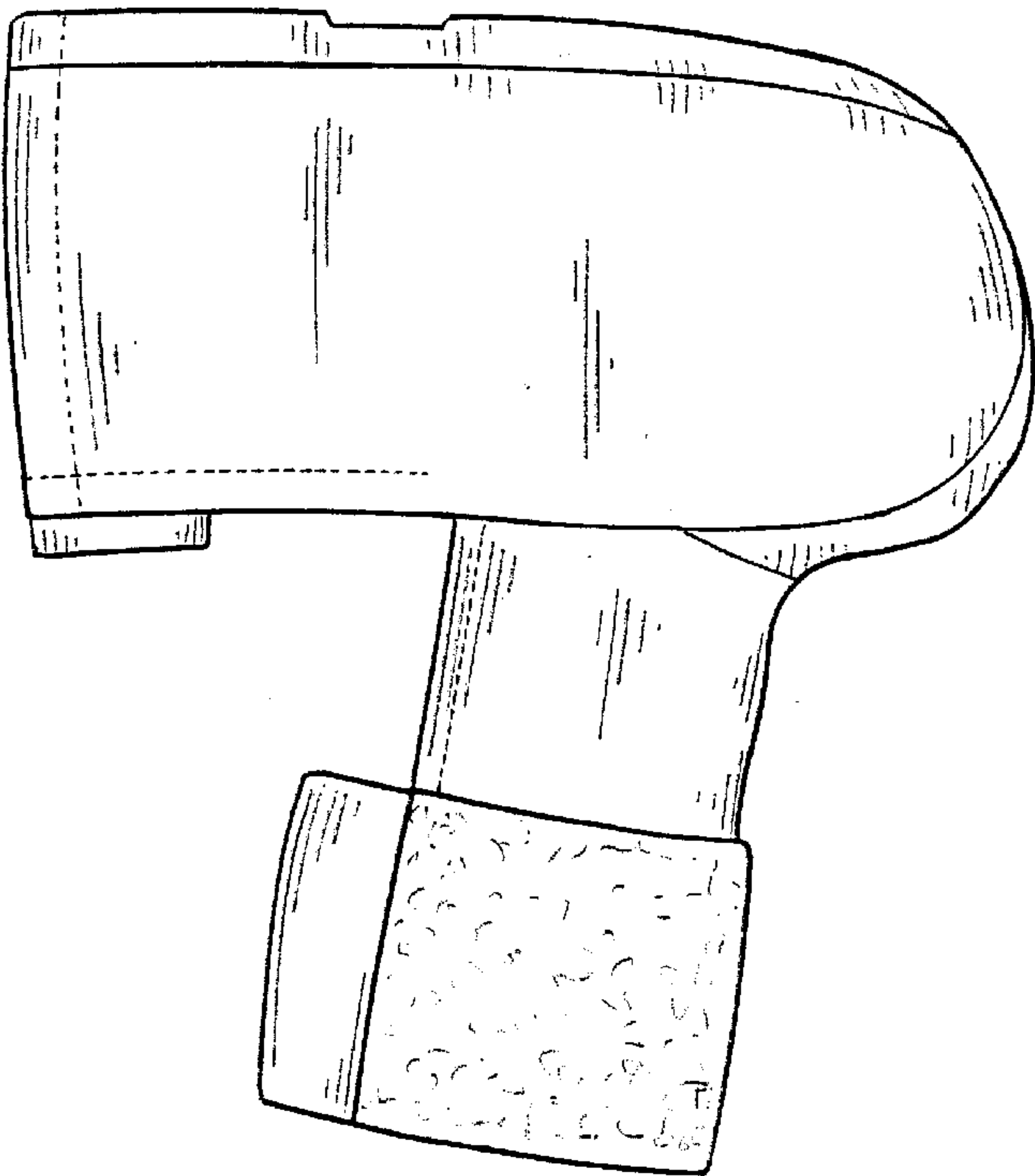

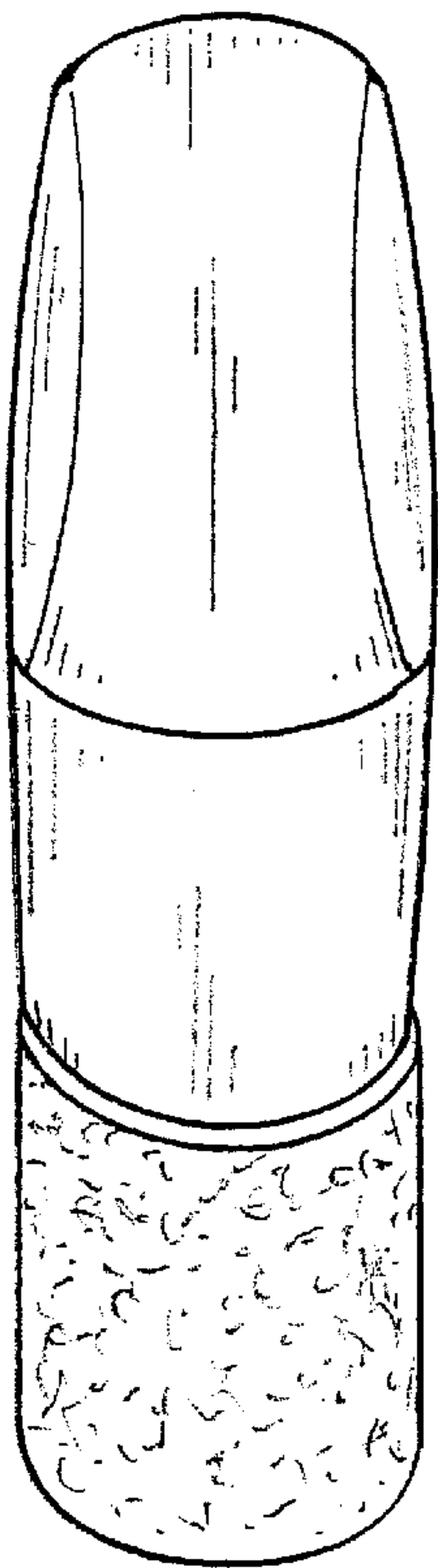

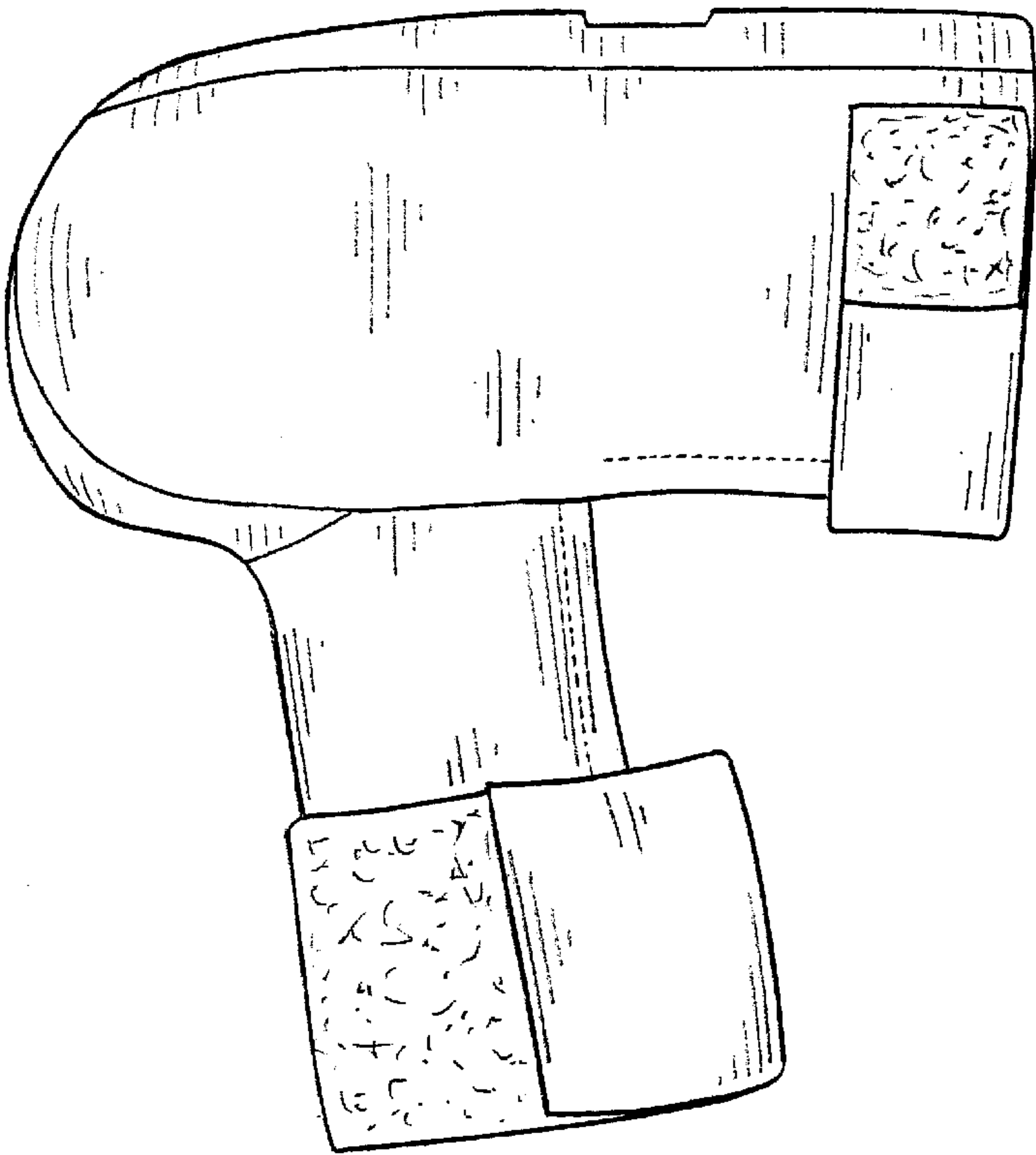

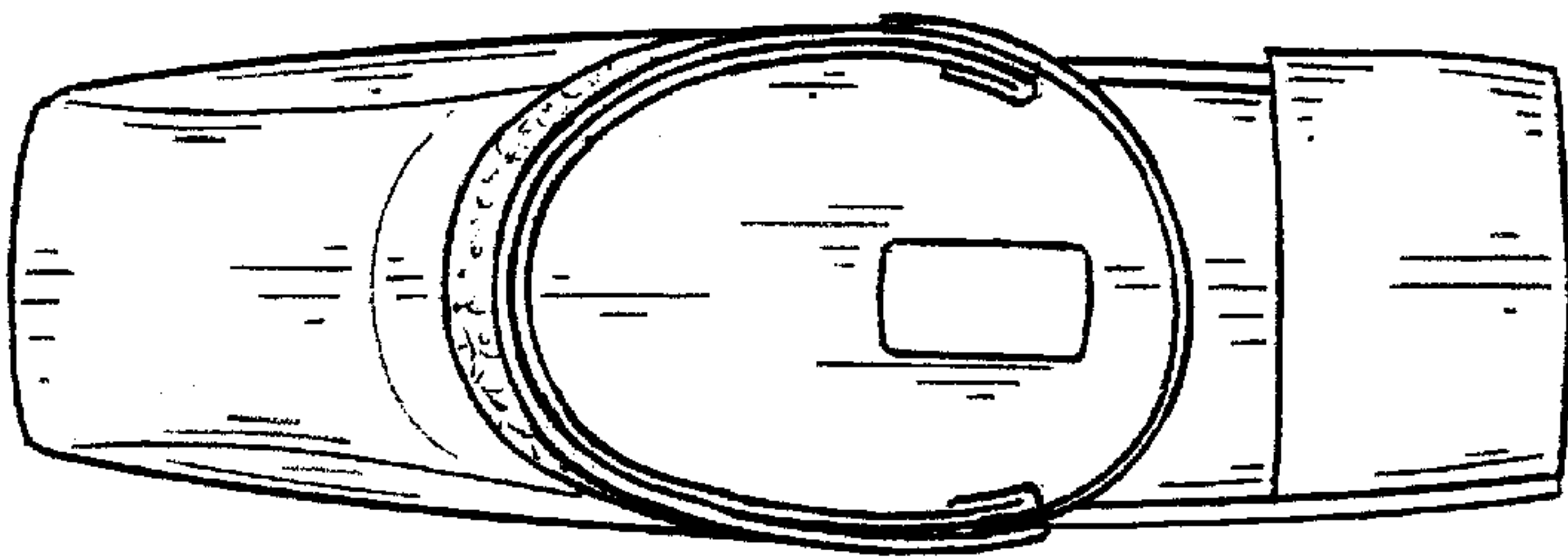
