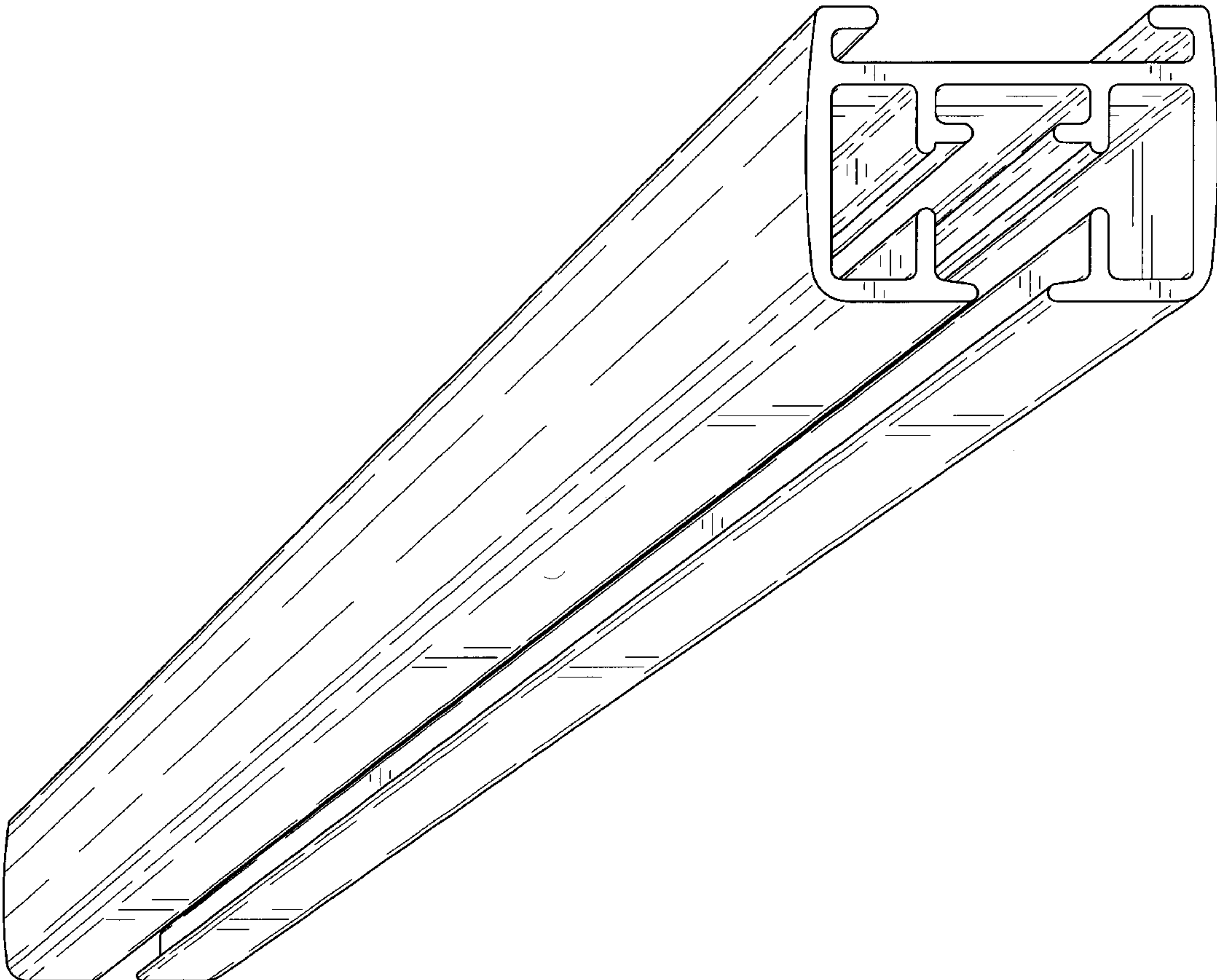

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a curtain rail showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a back elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof showing a portion broken away for ease of illustration;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof showing a portion broken away for ease of illustration;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof showing a portion broken away for ease of illustration; and,
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof showing a portion broken away for ease of illustration.

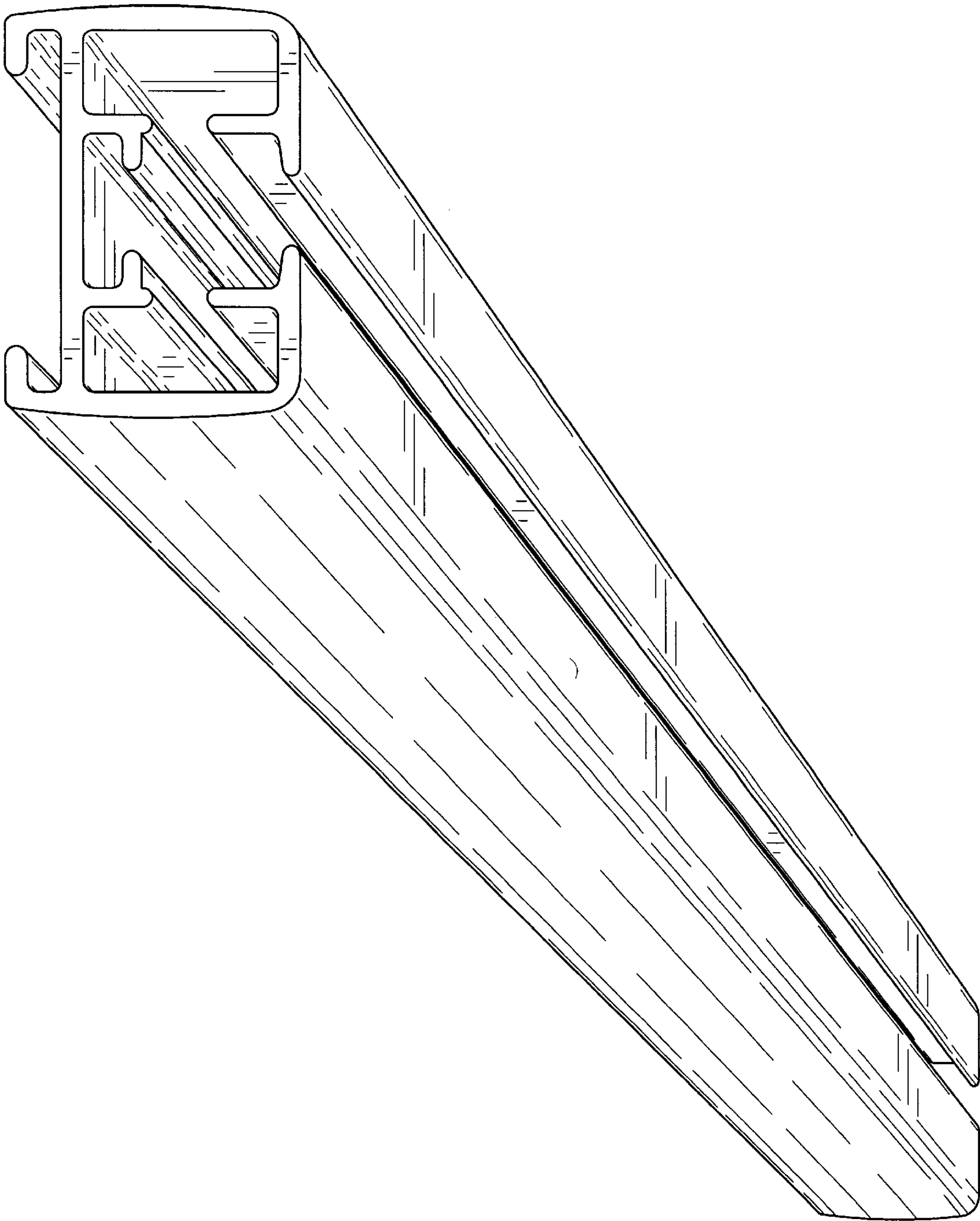

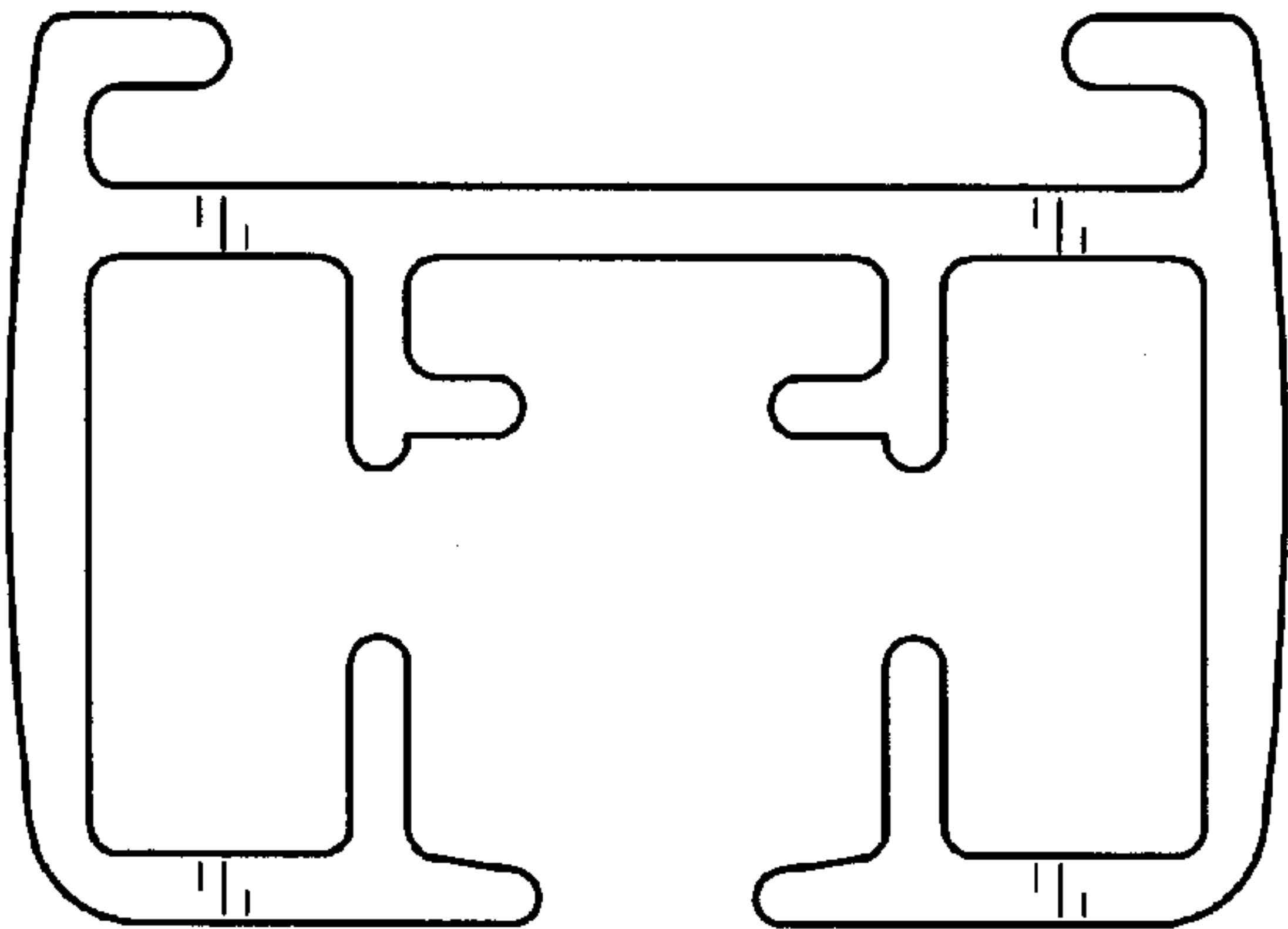

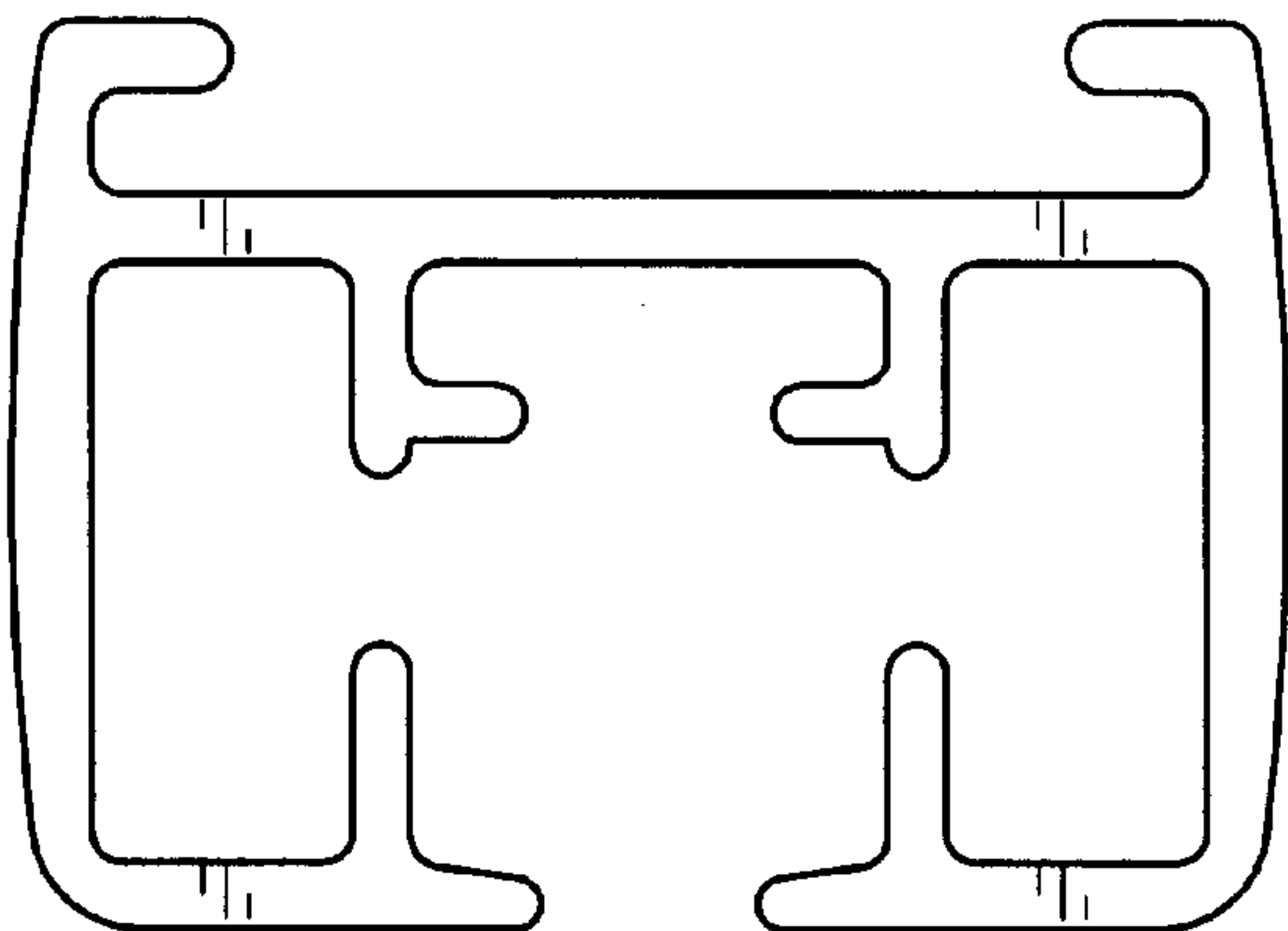

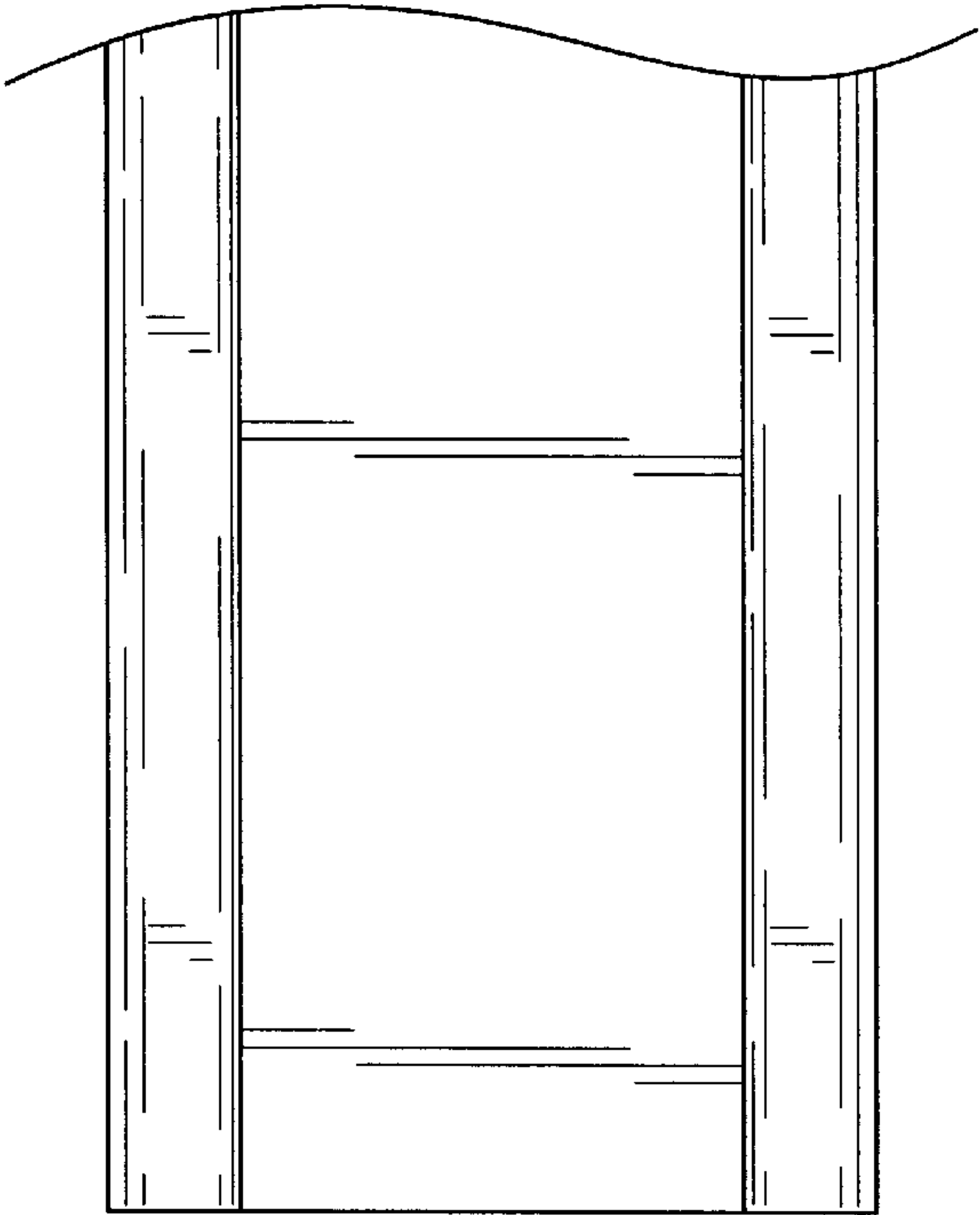

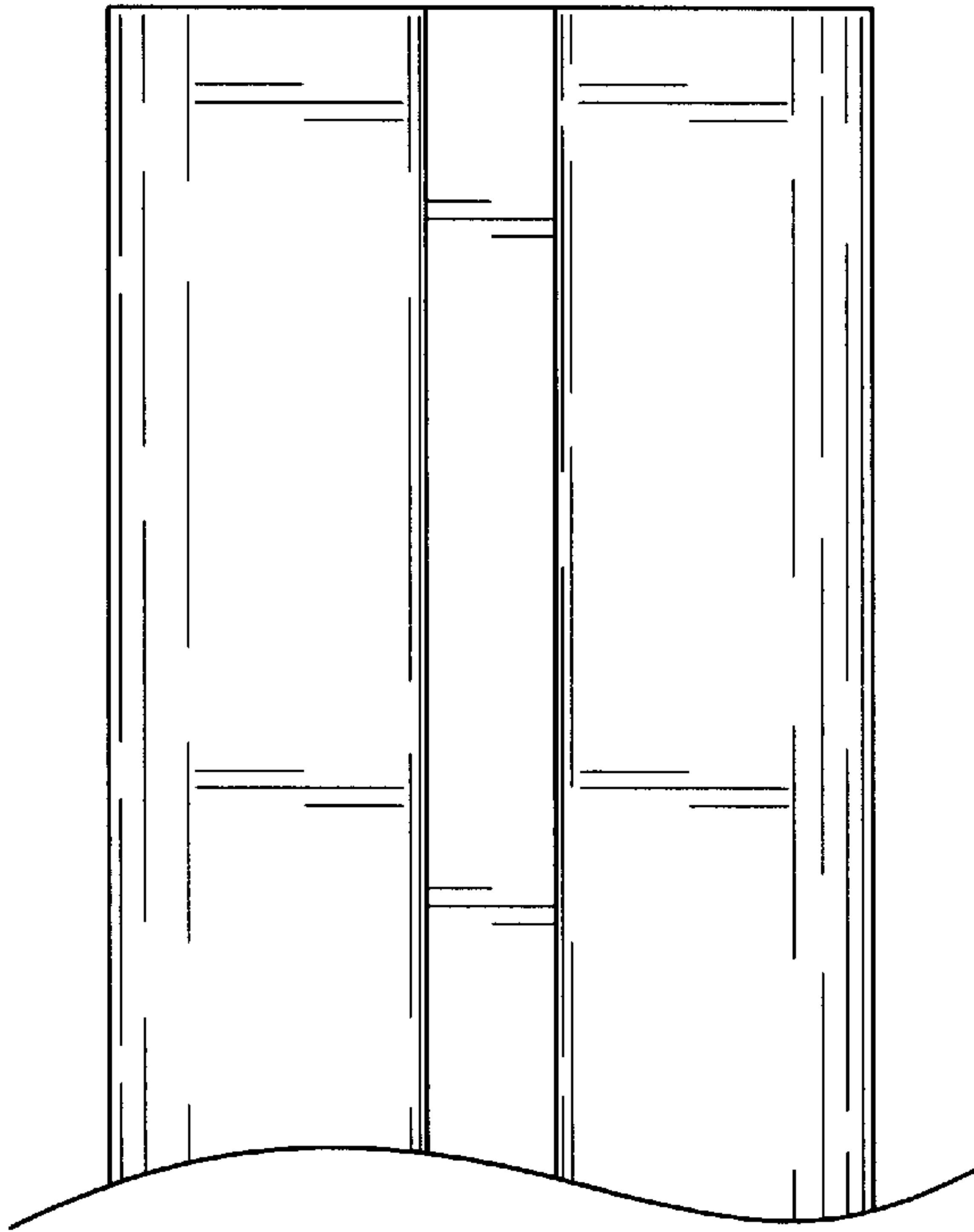

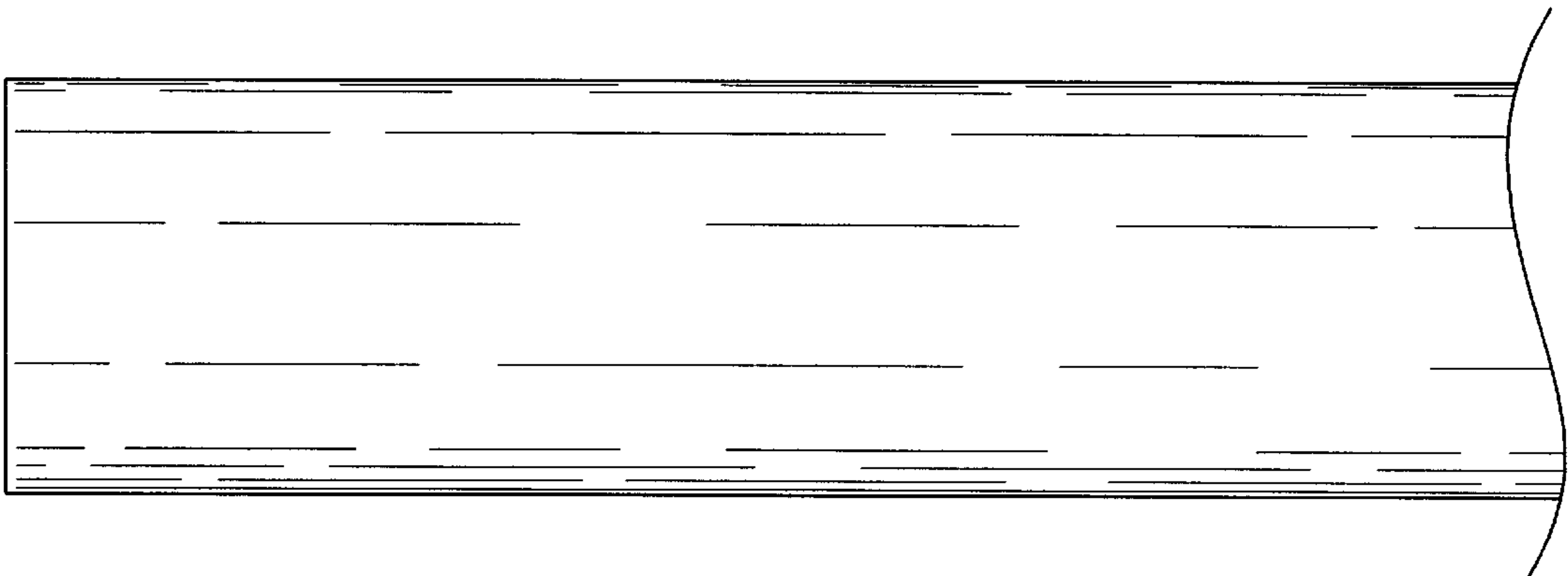
