DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a handle according to the invention.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a handle according to the invention.

FIG. **3** is a side elevational view of a handle according to the invention. The view from the other side is a mirror image of this view.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of a handle according to the invention; and,

FIG. **5** is an end view of a handle according to the invention. The view from the other end is a mirror image of this view. The portions of the article in broken lines are shown for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
