FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan being a mirror image.

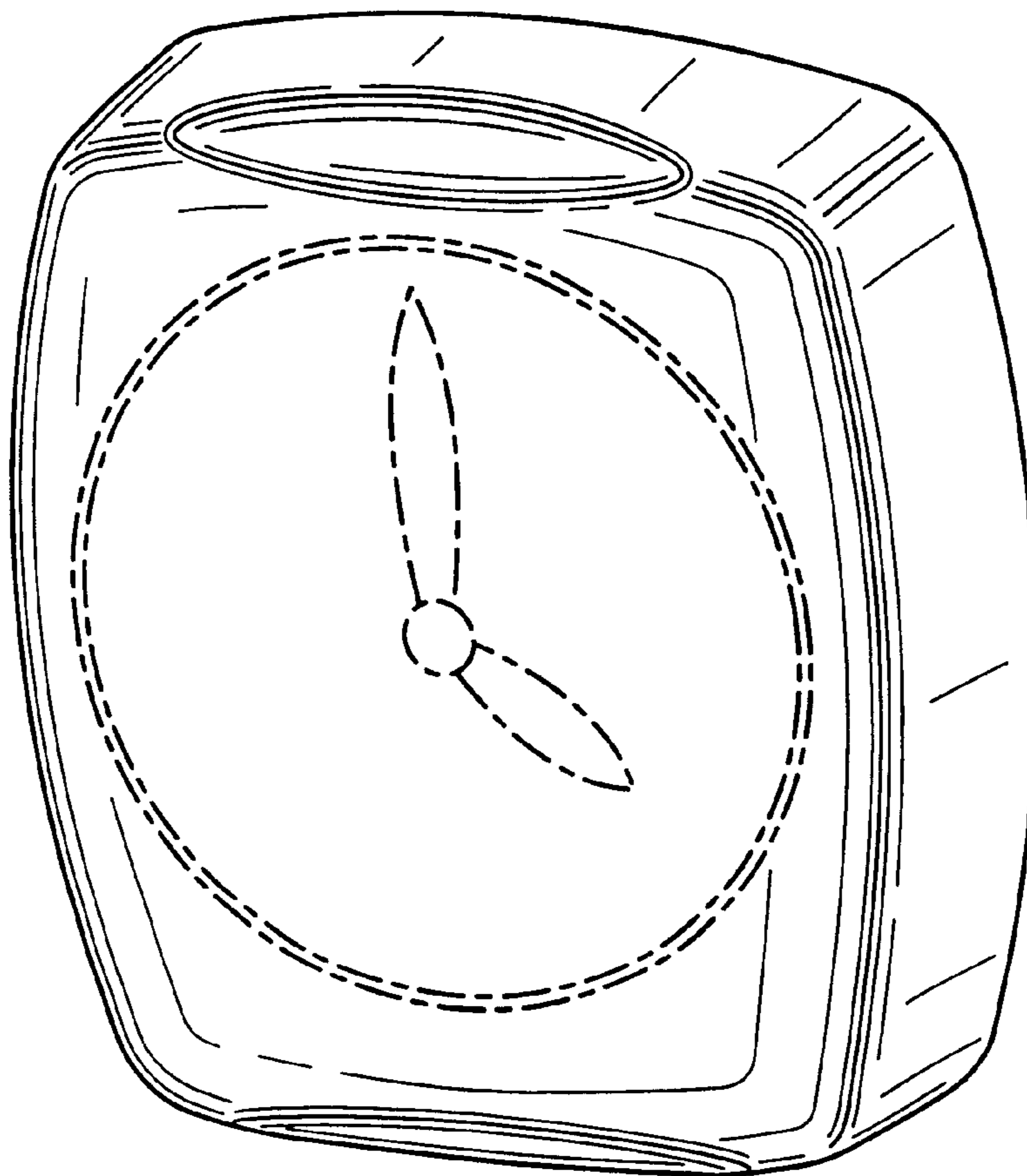

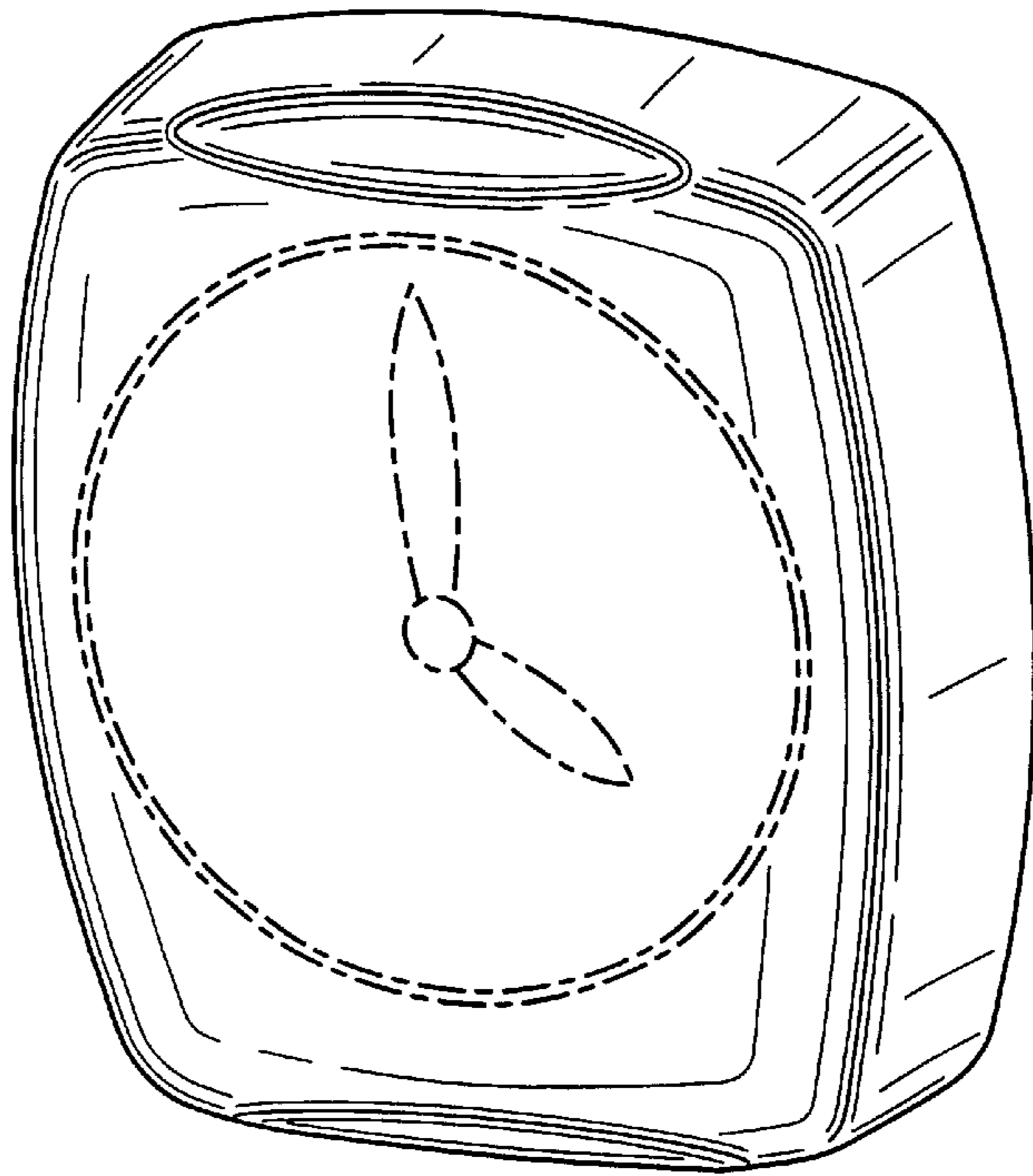

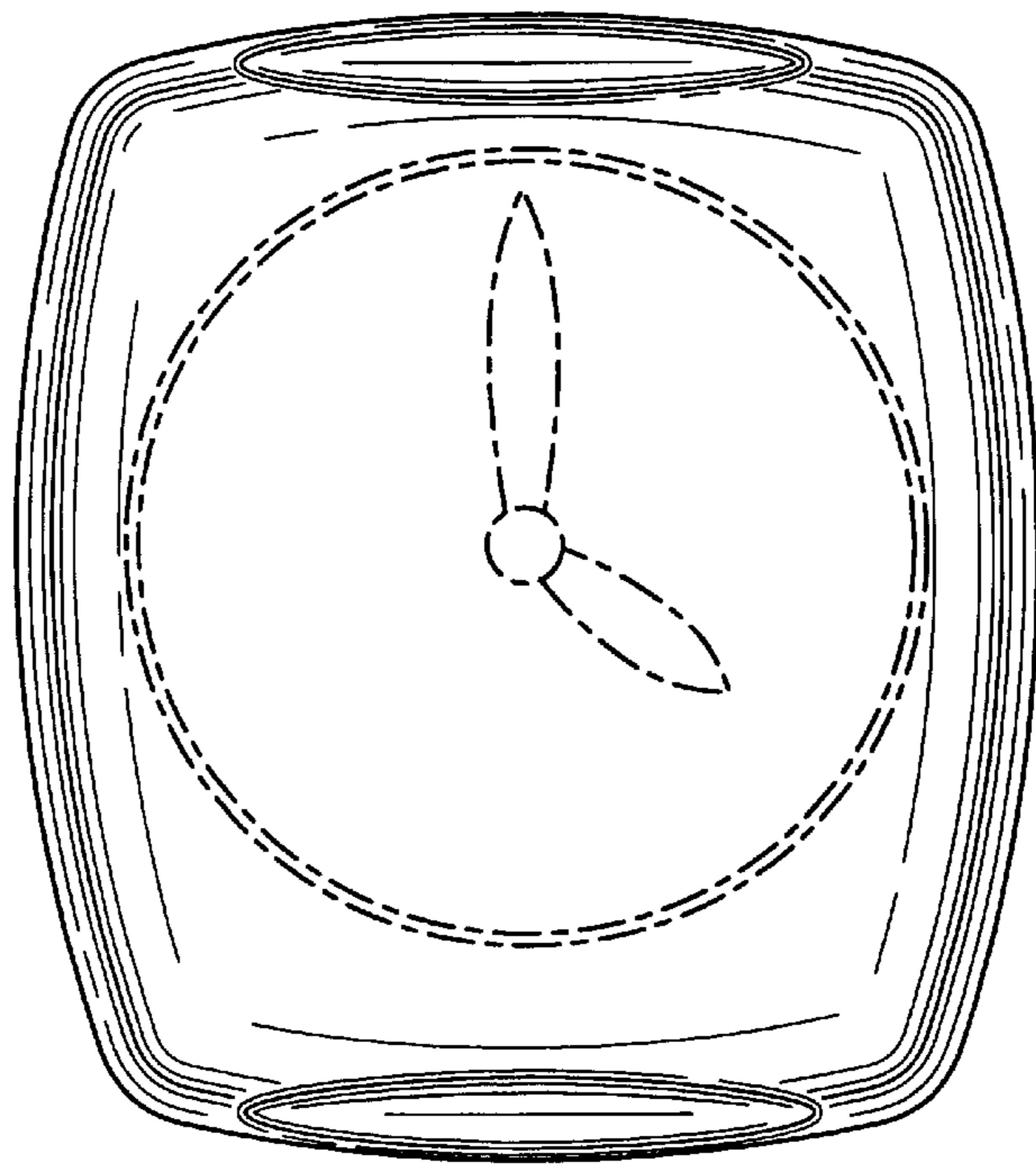

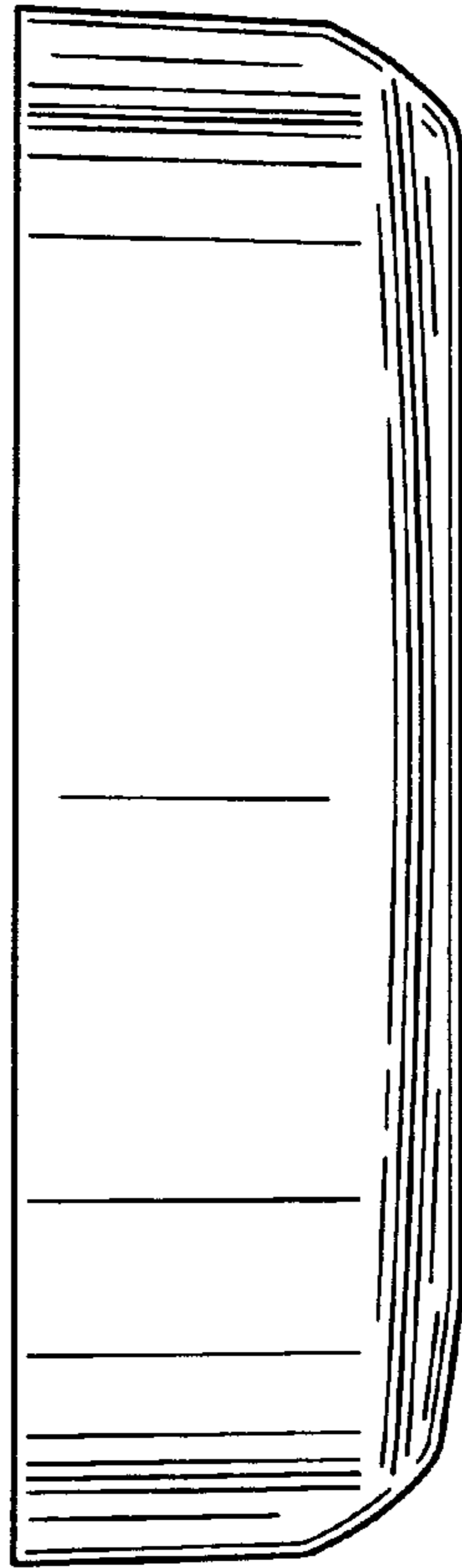

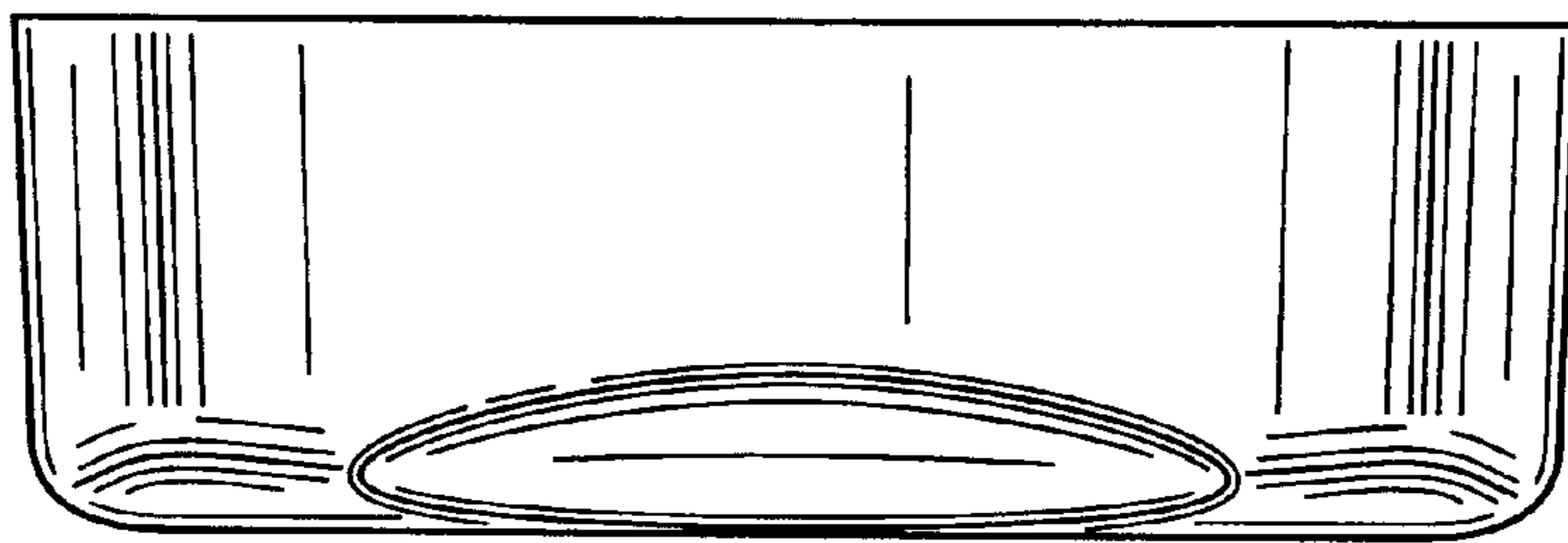
