The ornamental design for a hinge for an ankle walker brace,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view, of the hinge for an ankle
walker brace showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a left side elevation view thereof; and,

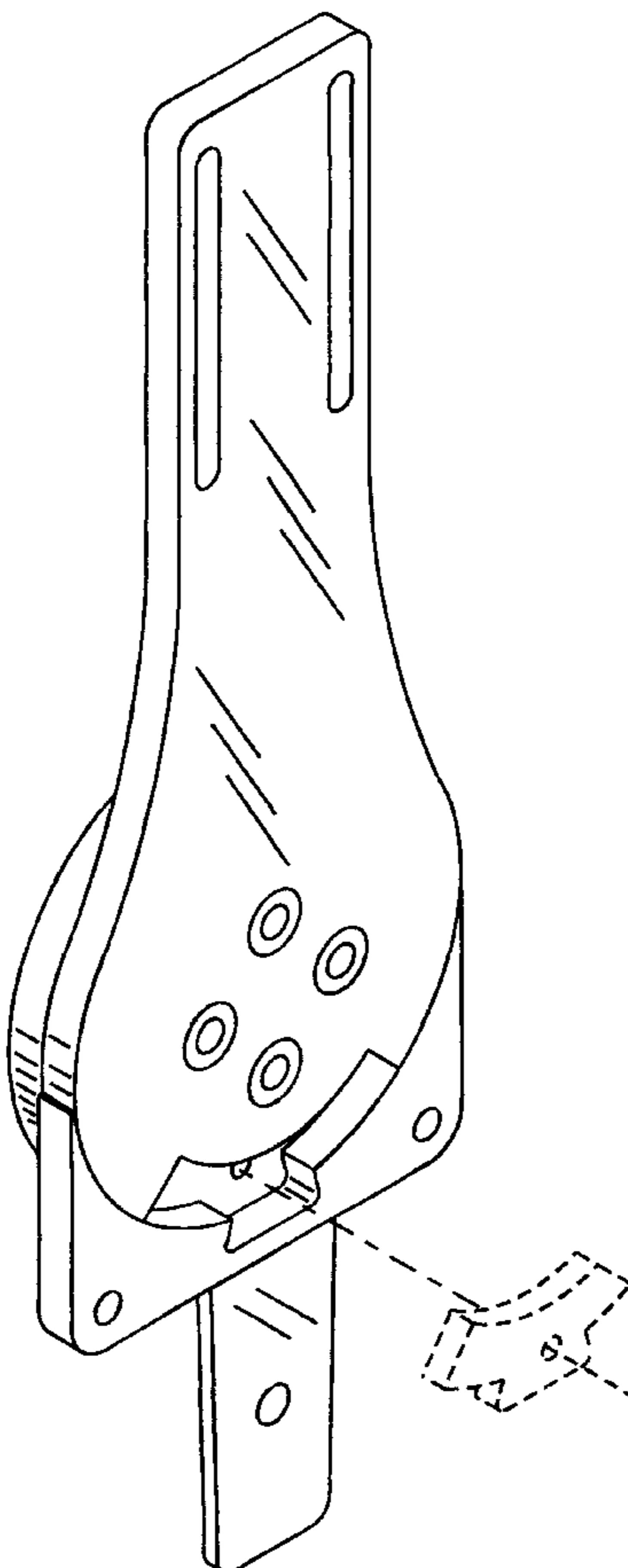

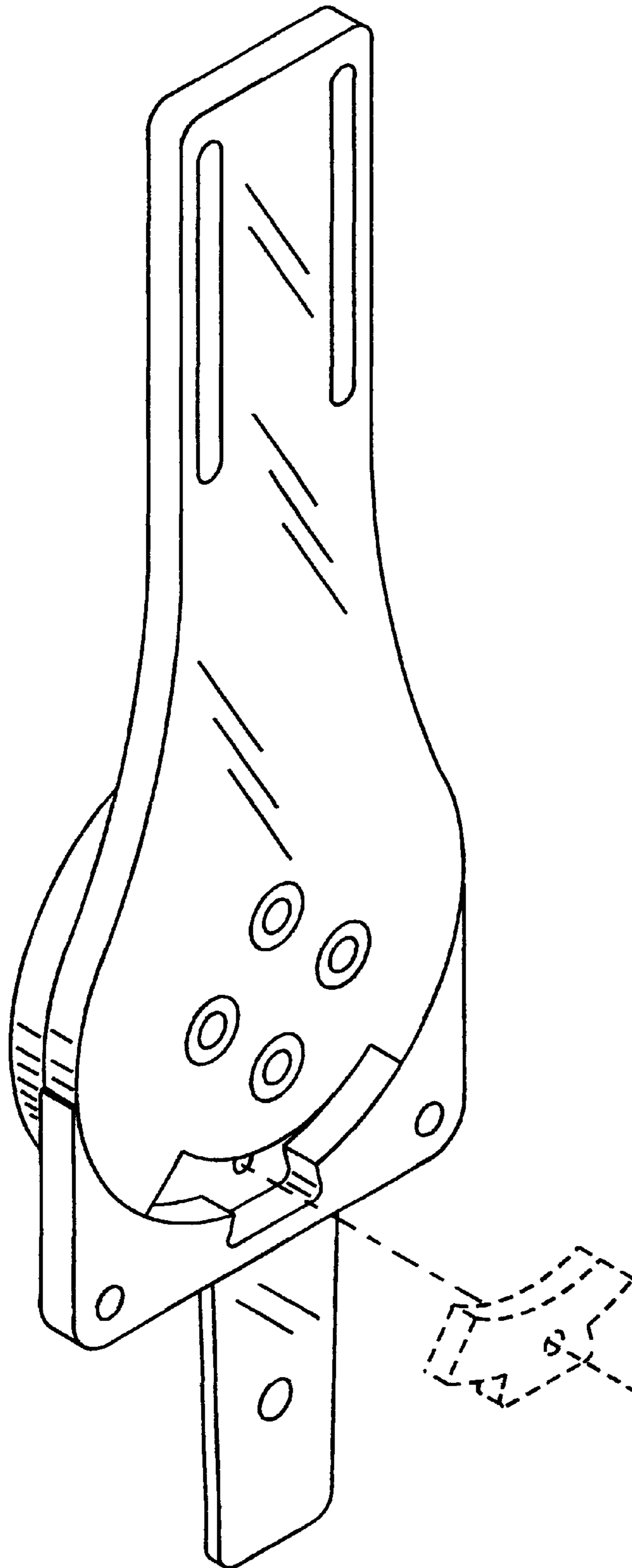
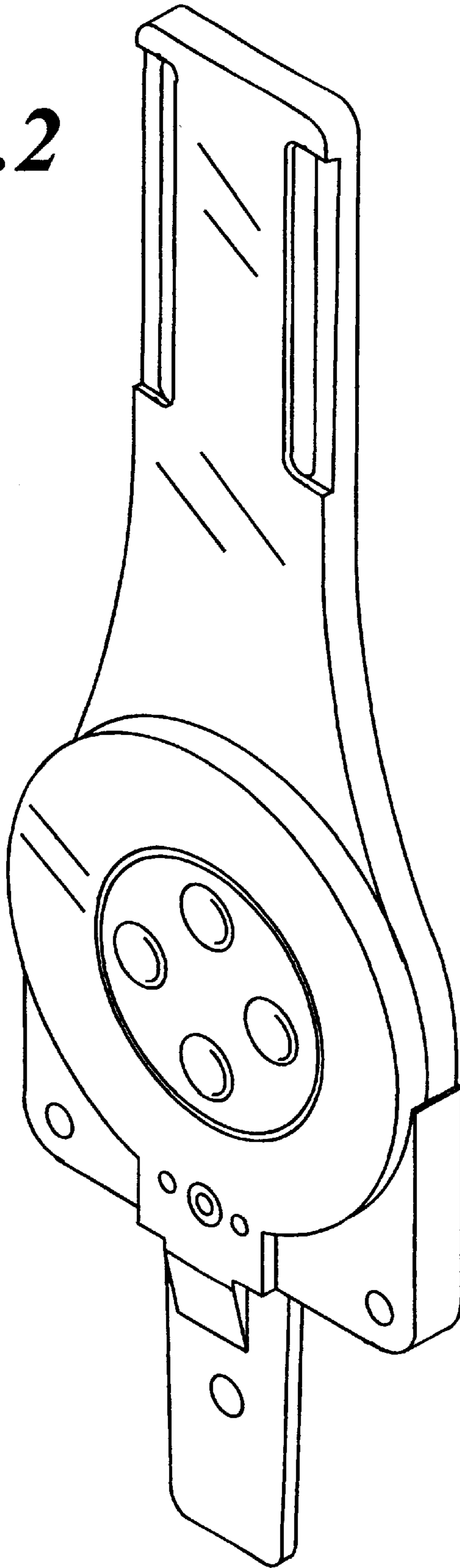

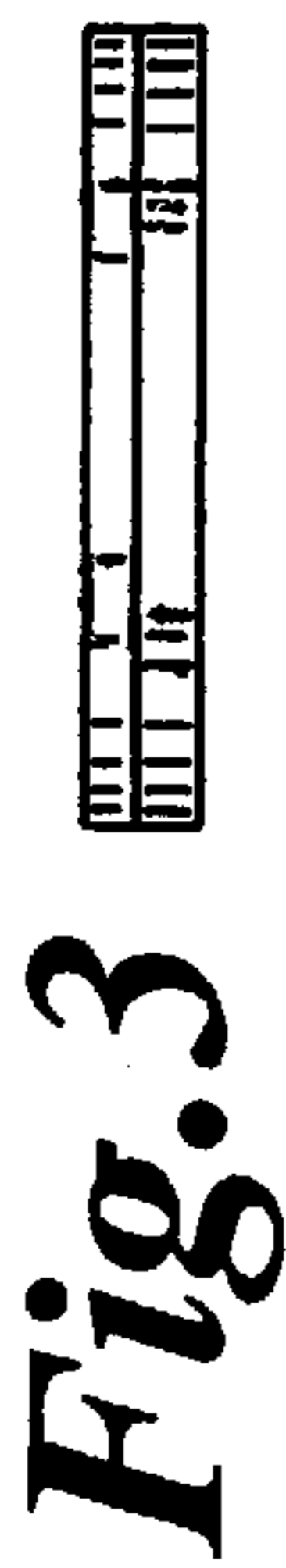
