FIG. 5 is a back view thereof.

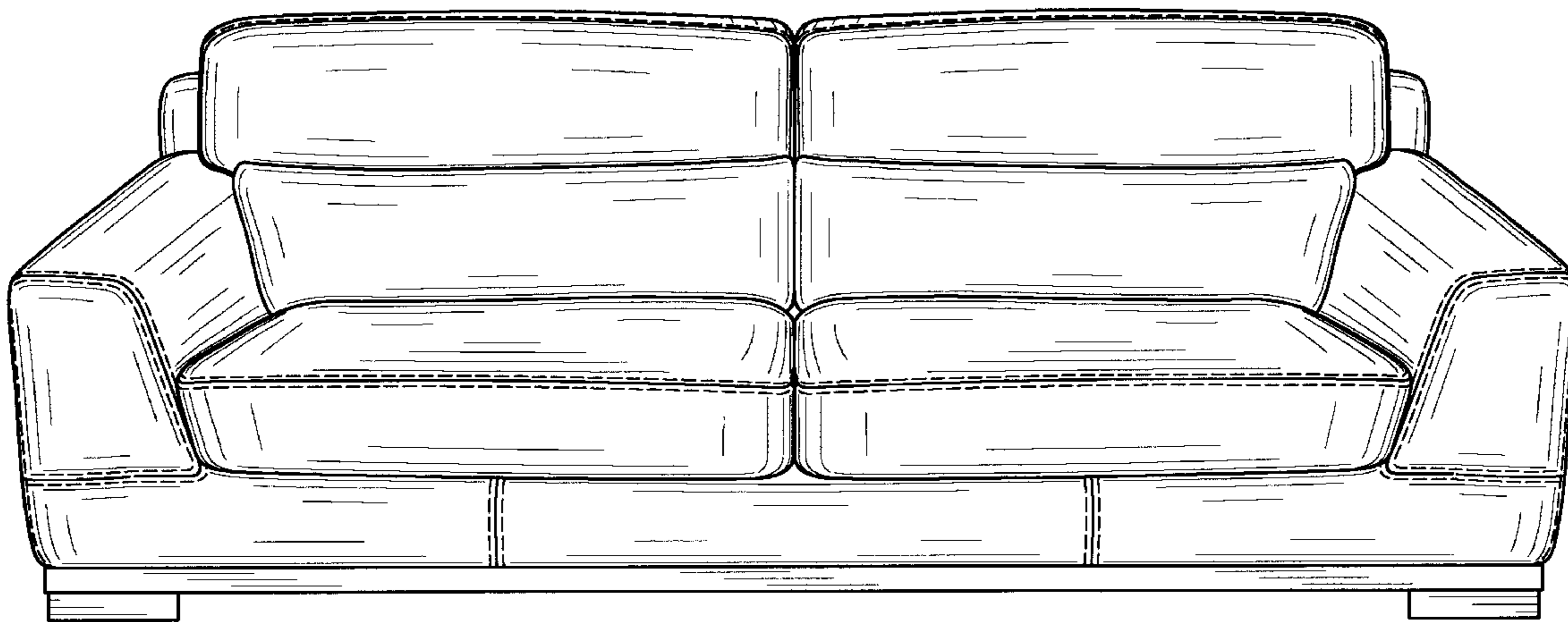
The broken lines shown on the sofa are understood to represent stitching.

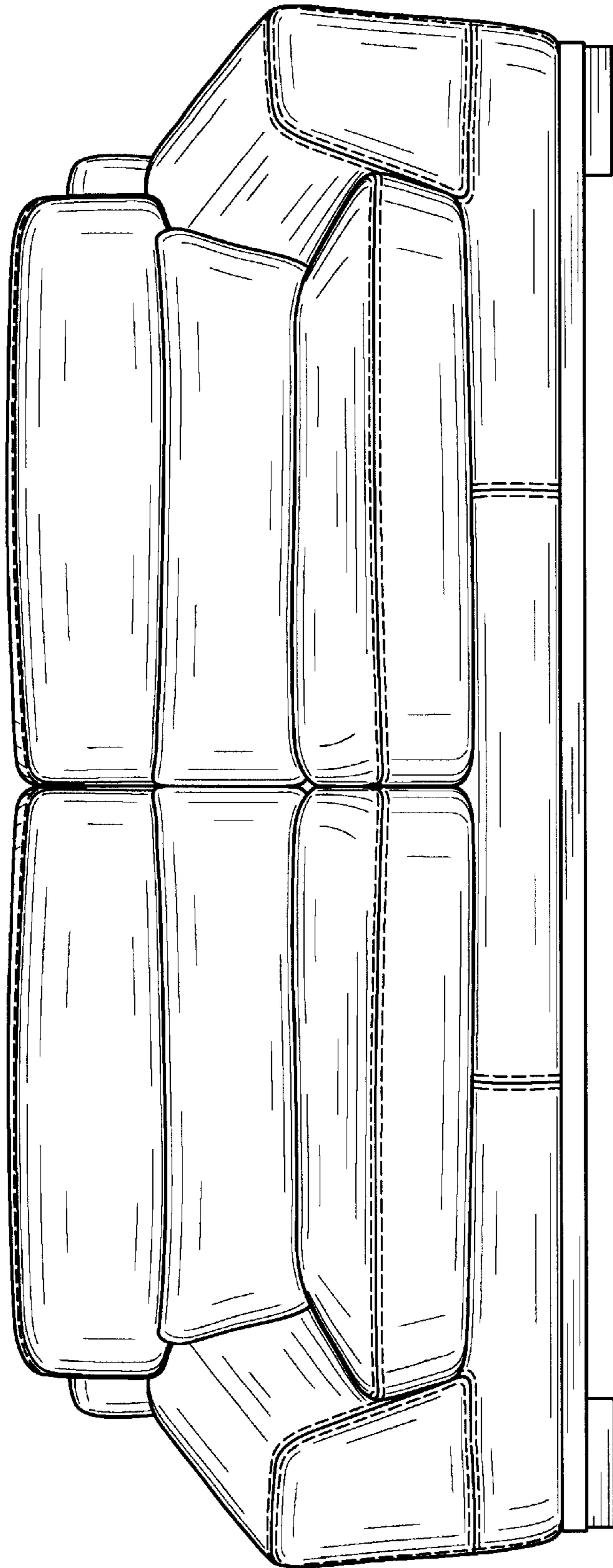

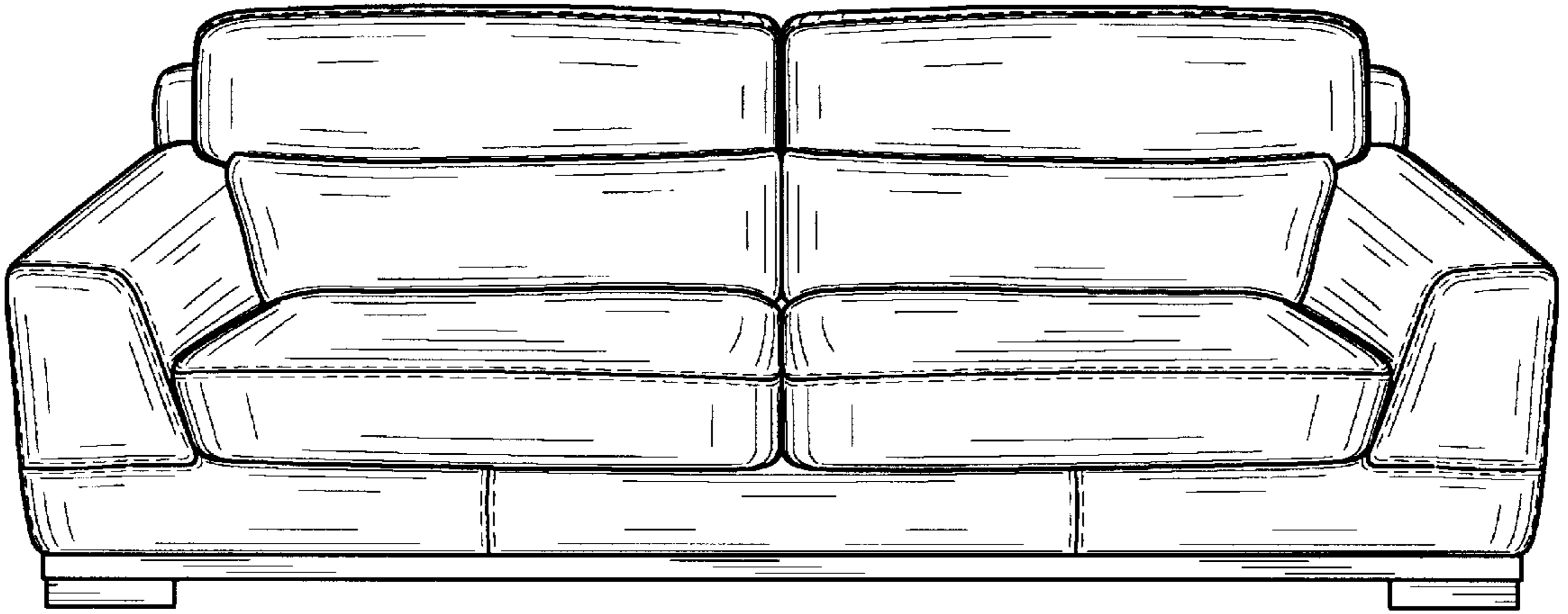

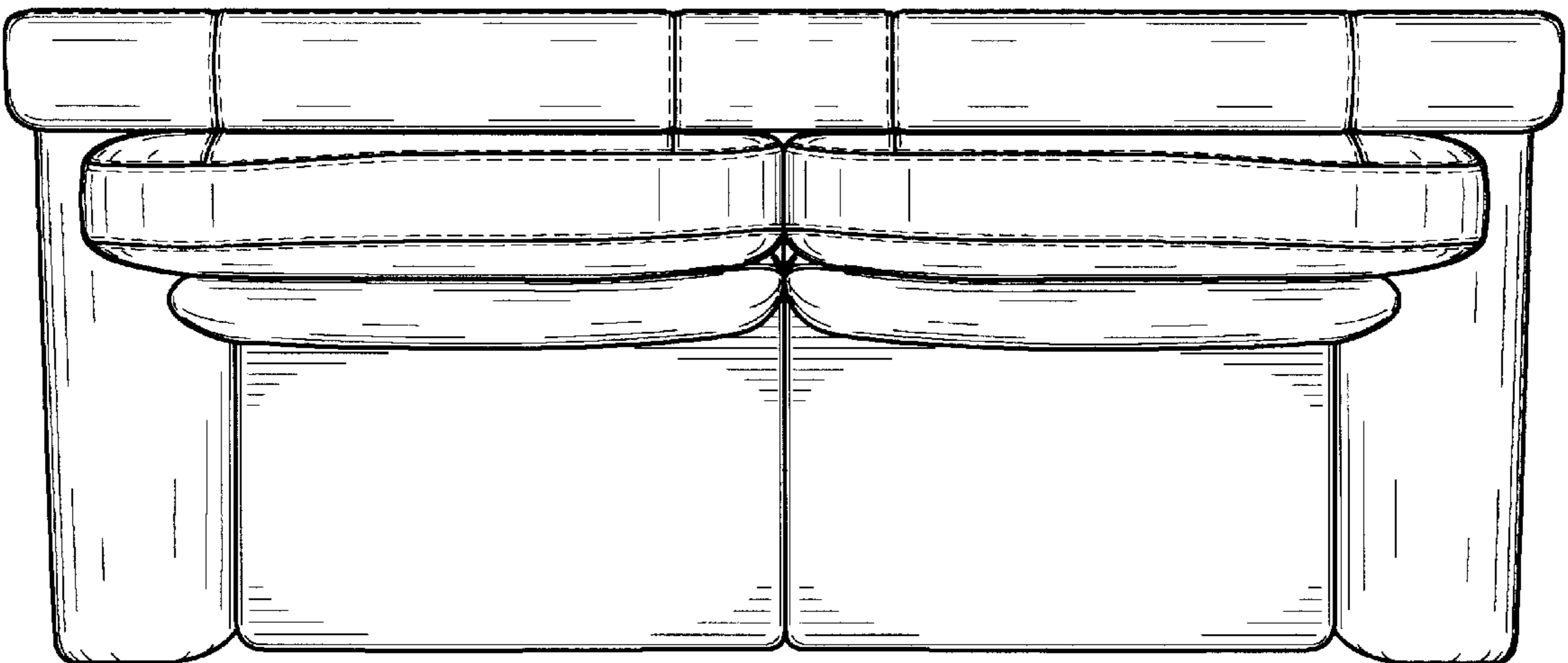

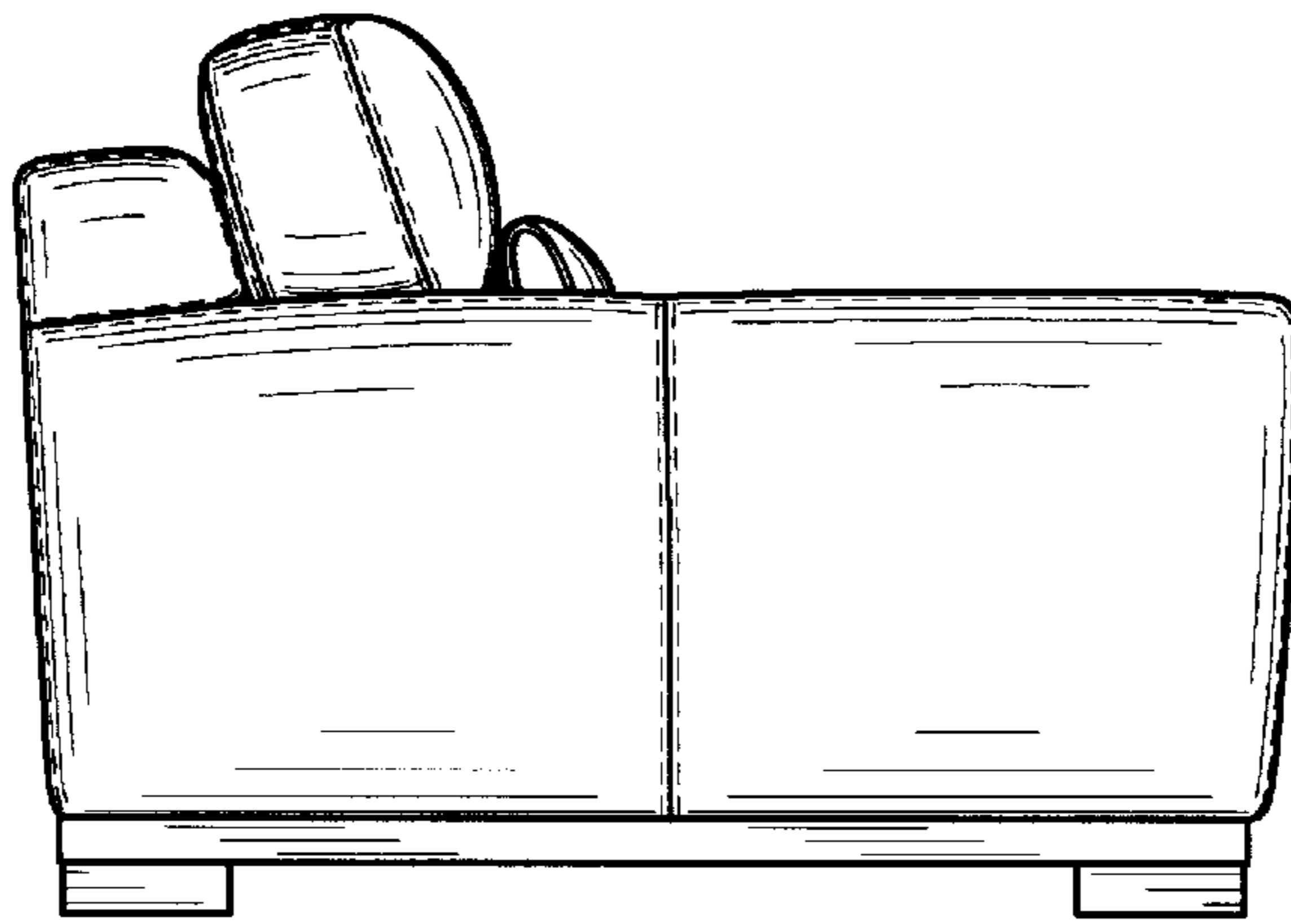

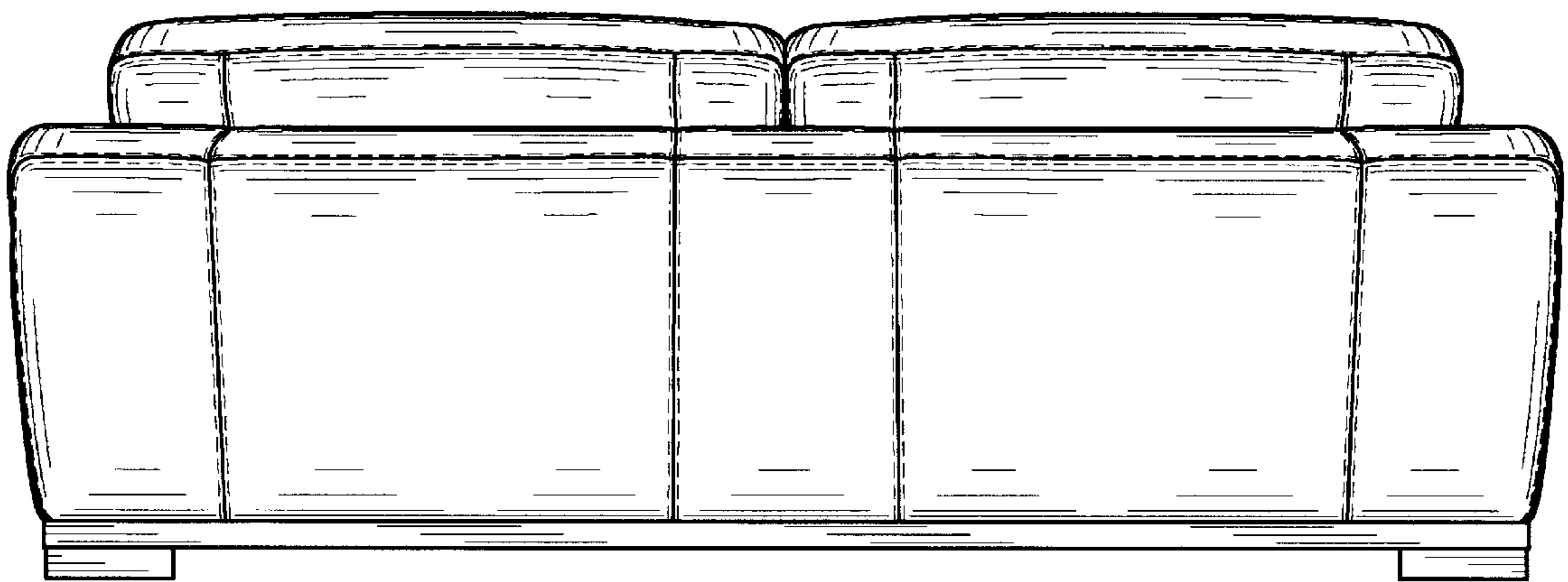
