The ornamental design for a plate, as shown and described.

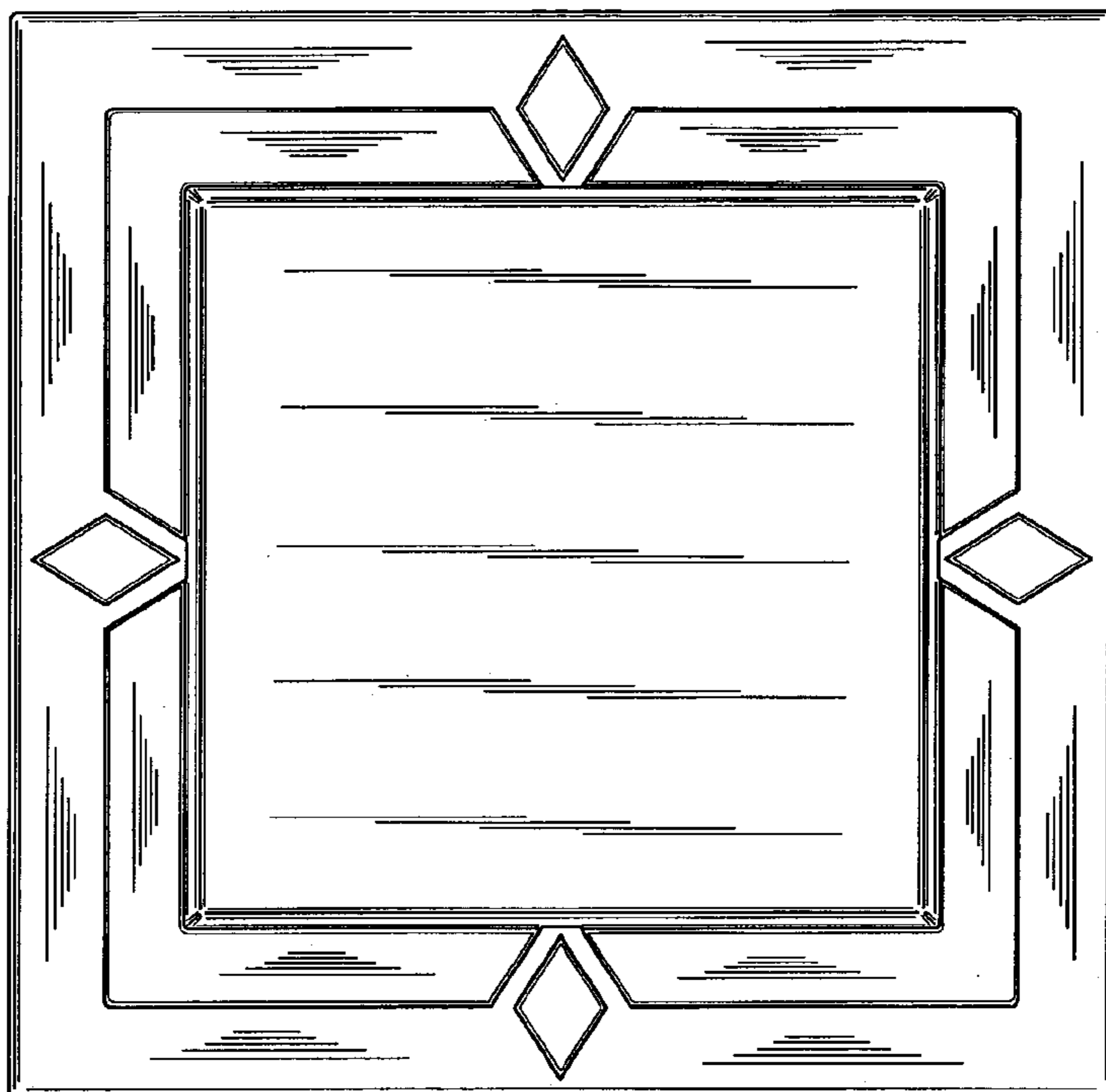
DESCRIPTION

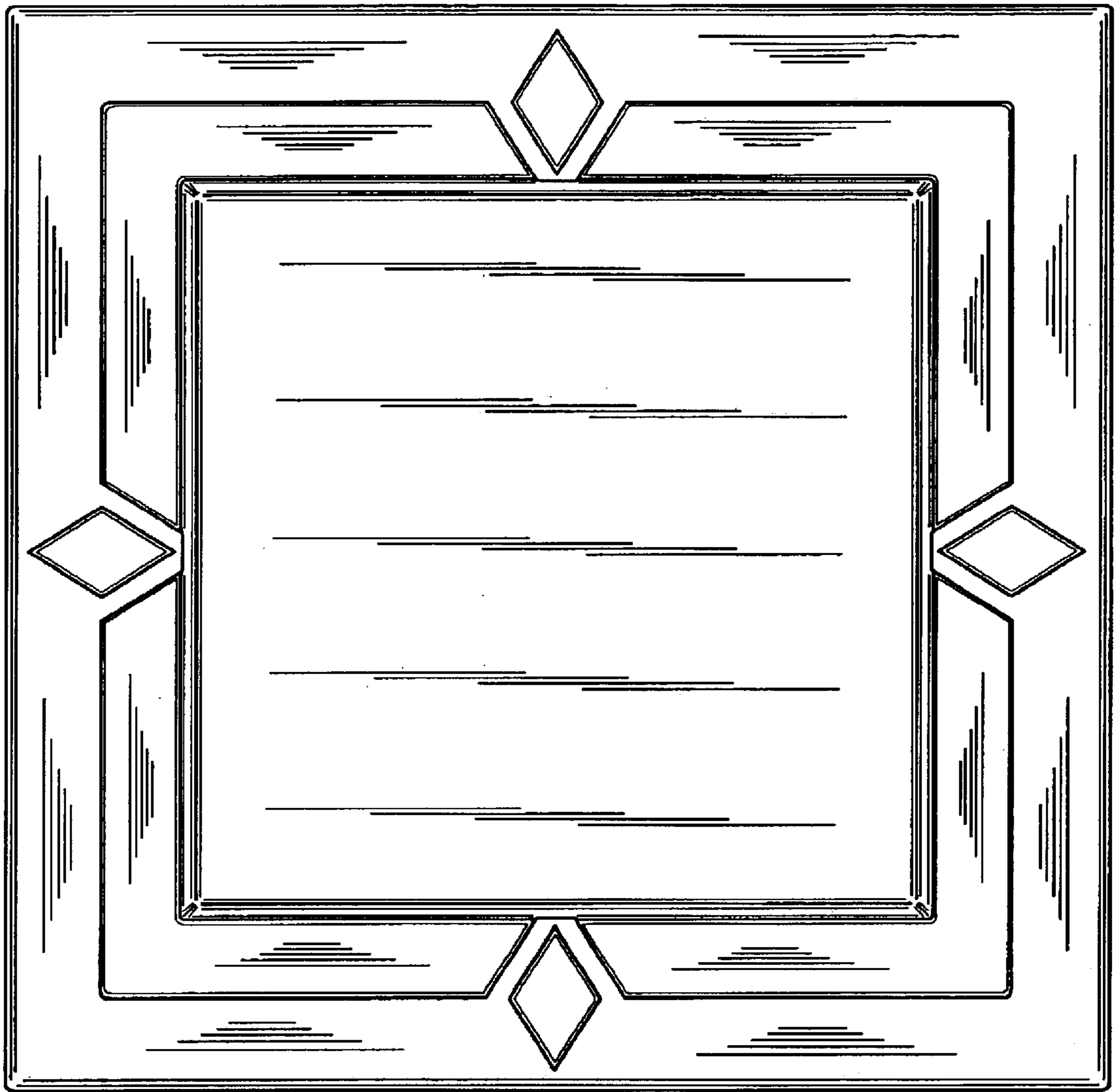
FIG. 1 is a top view of a plate according to the present design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; the back elevational view and the two side elevational views being the same; and,

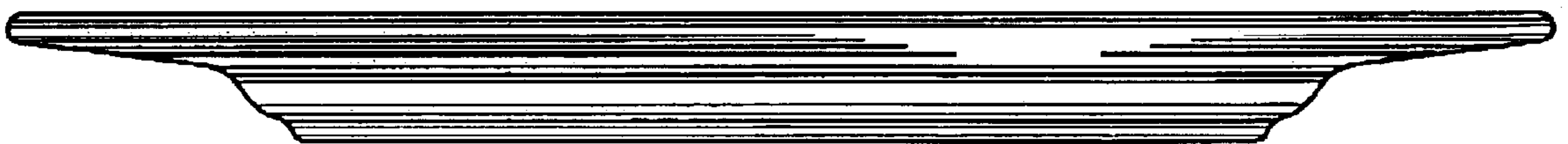
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof.

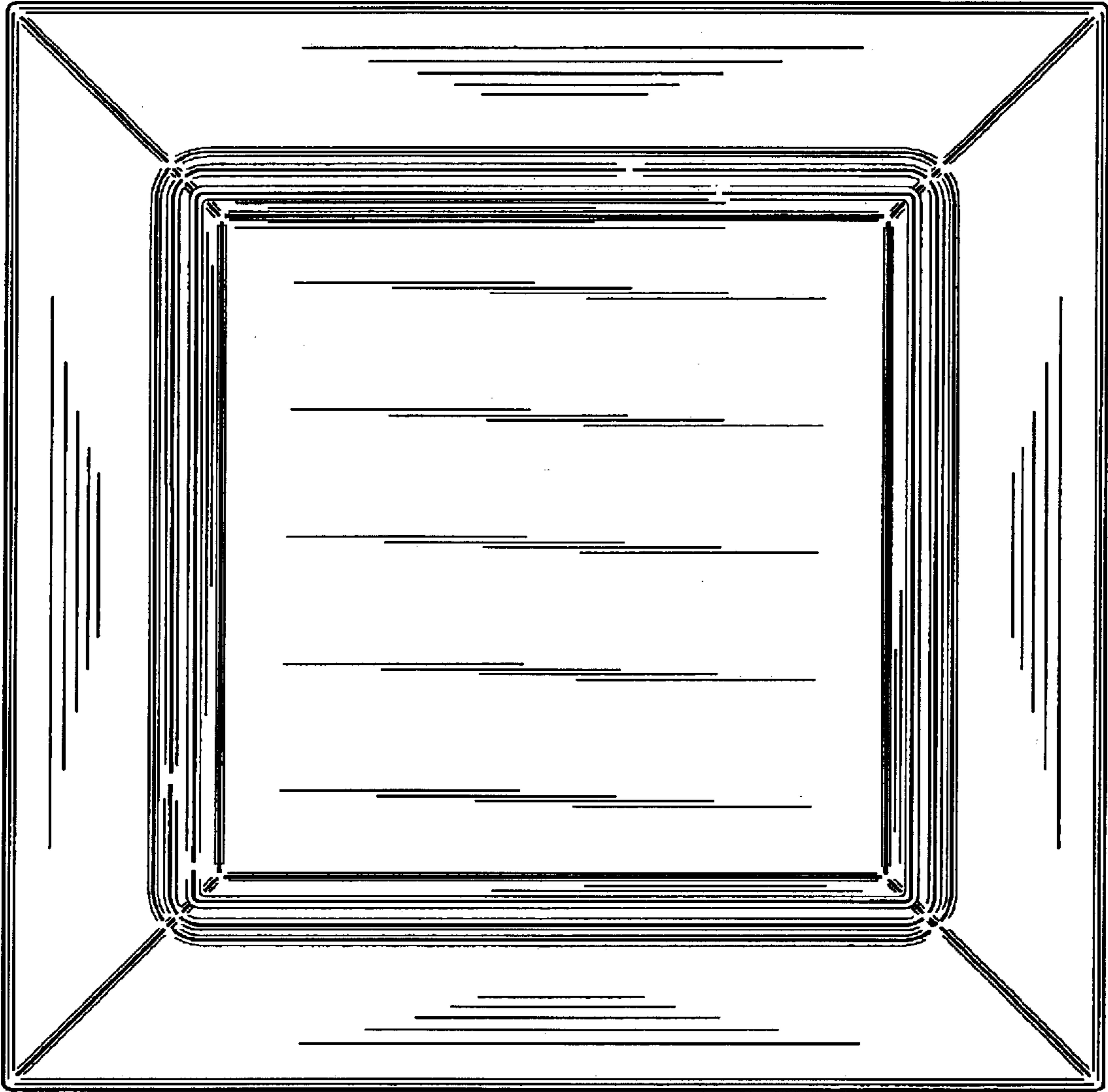
