(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fish shaped wall hook, as shown  
and described.

FIG. 1 is a front view of a fish shaped wall hook according  
to the present invention, with a suction cup not forming a  
part of the invention shown in phantom lines.

FIG. 2 is a rear view of the fish shaped wall hook shown in  
FIG. 1, with a suction cup not forming a part of the invention  
shown in phantom lines.

FIG. 3 is a top view of the fish shaped wall hook shown in  
FIGS. 1–2, with a suction cup not forming a part of the  
invention shown in phantom lines.

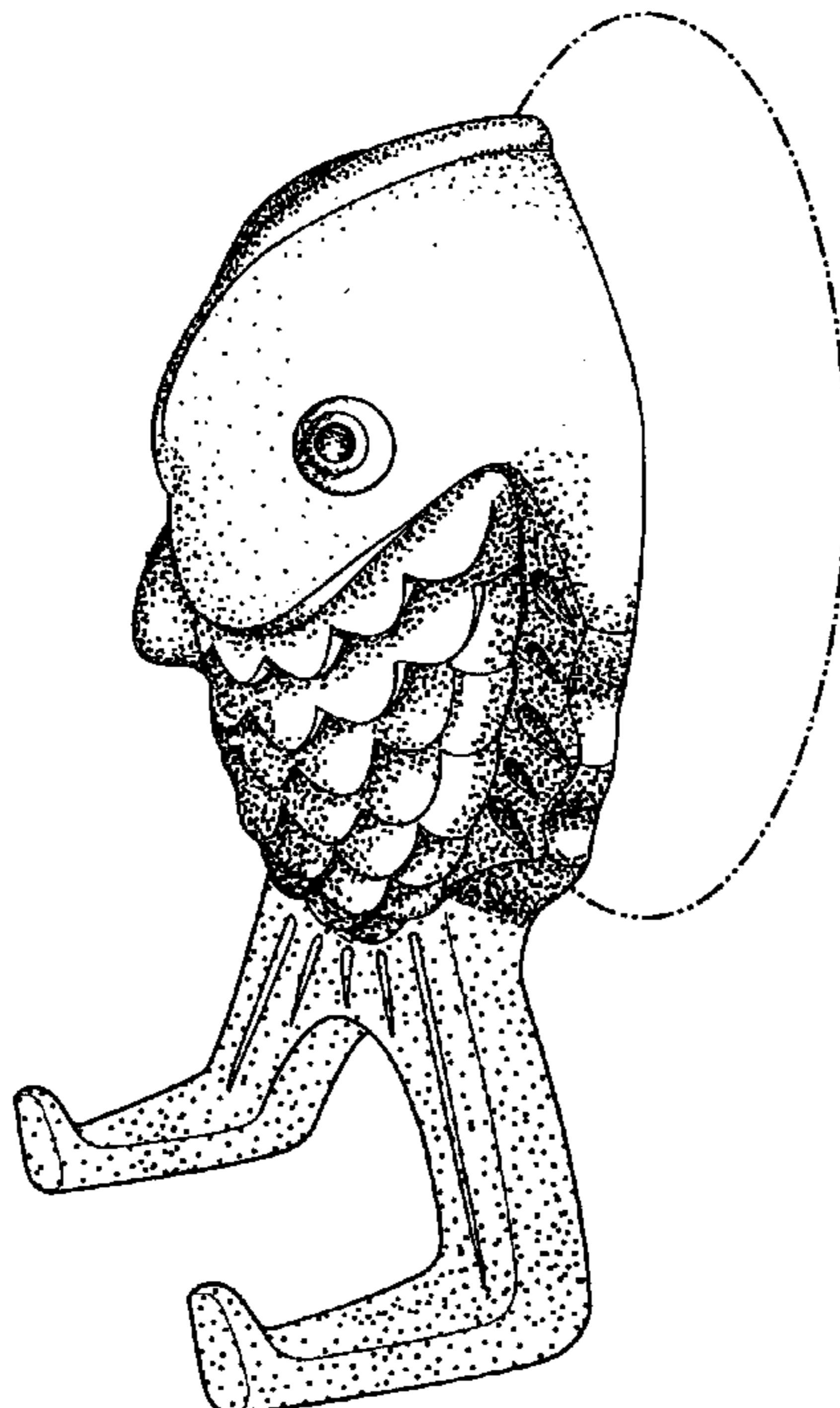
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the fish shaped wall hook shown  
in FIGS. 1–3, with a suction cup not forming a part of the  
invention shown in phantom lines.

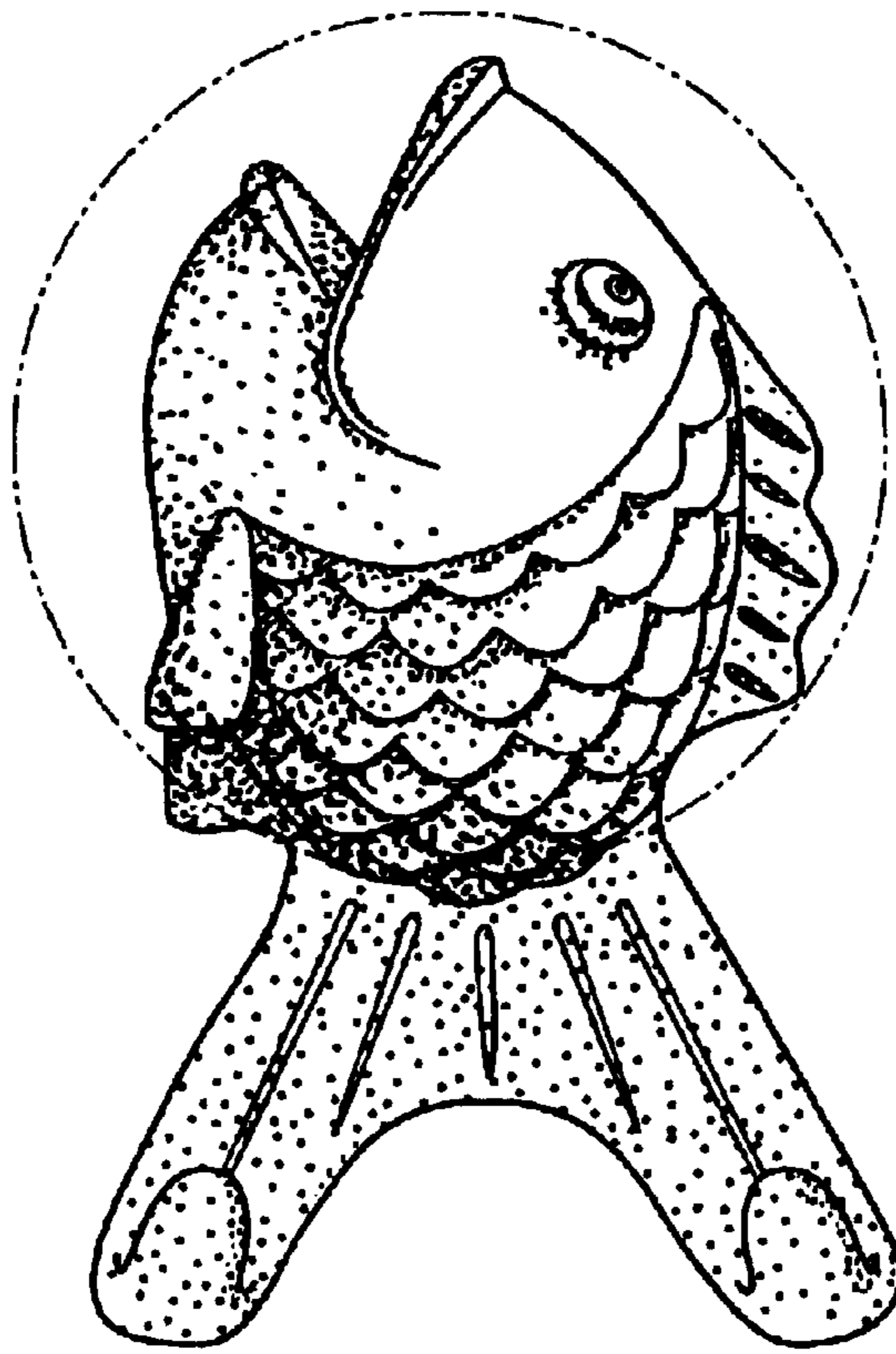
FIG. 5 is a left side view of the fish shaped wall hook shown

invention shown in phantom lines.

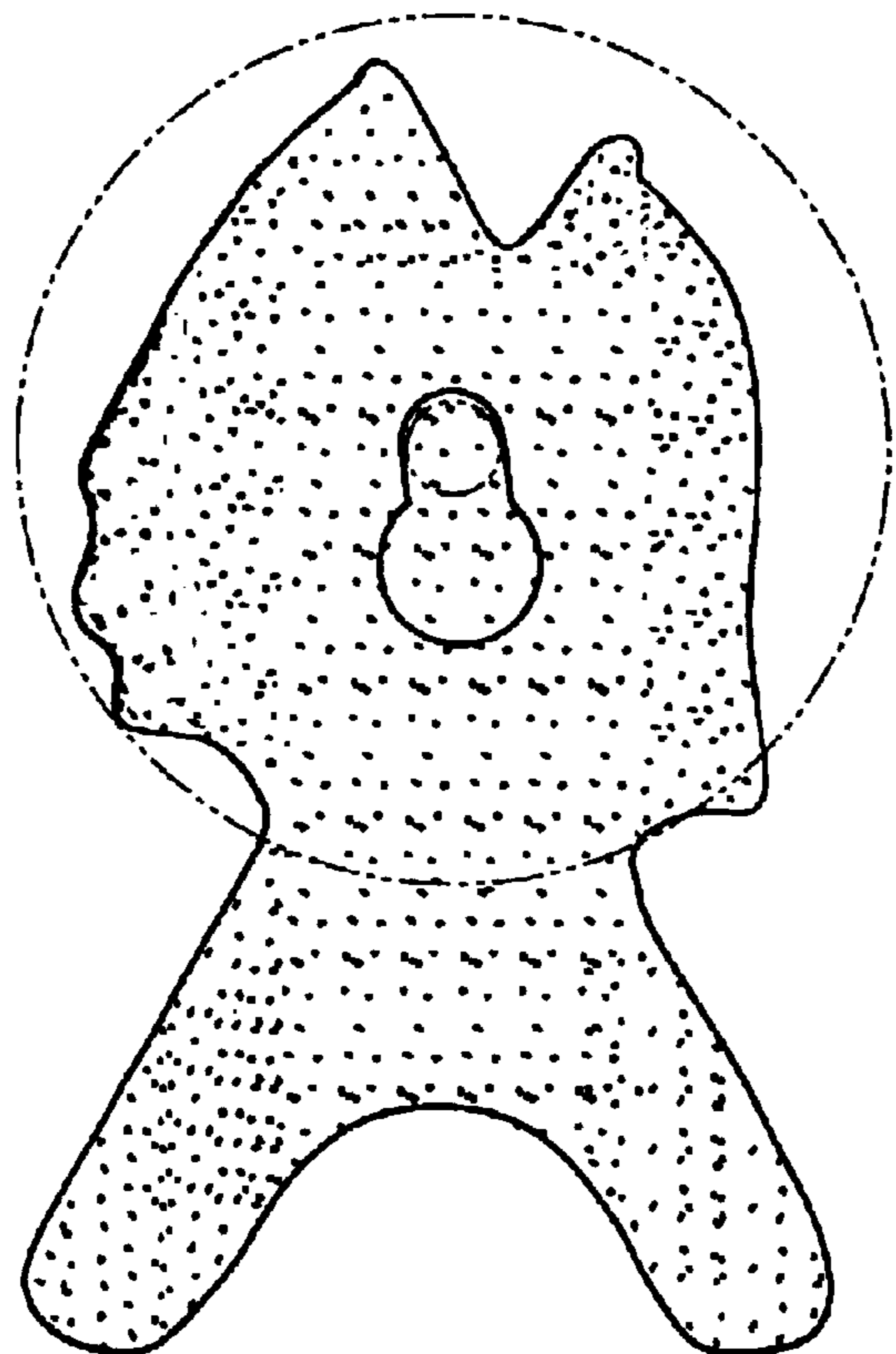
FIG. 7 is an enlarged perspective view from the top right of

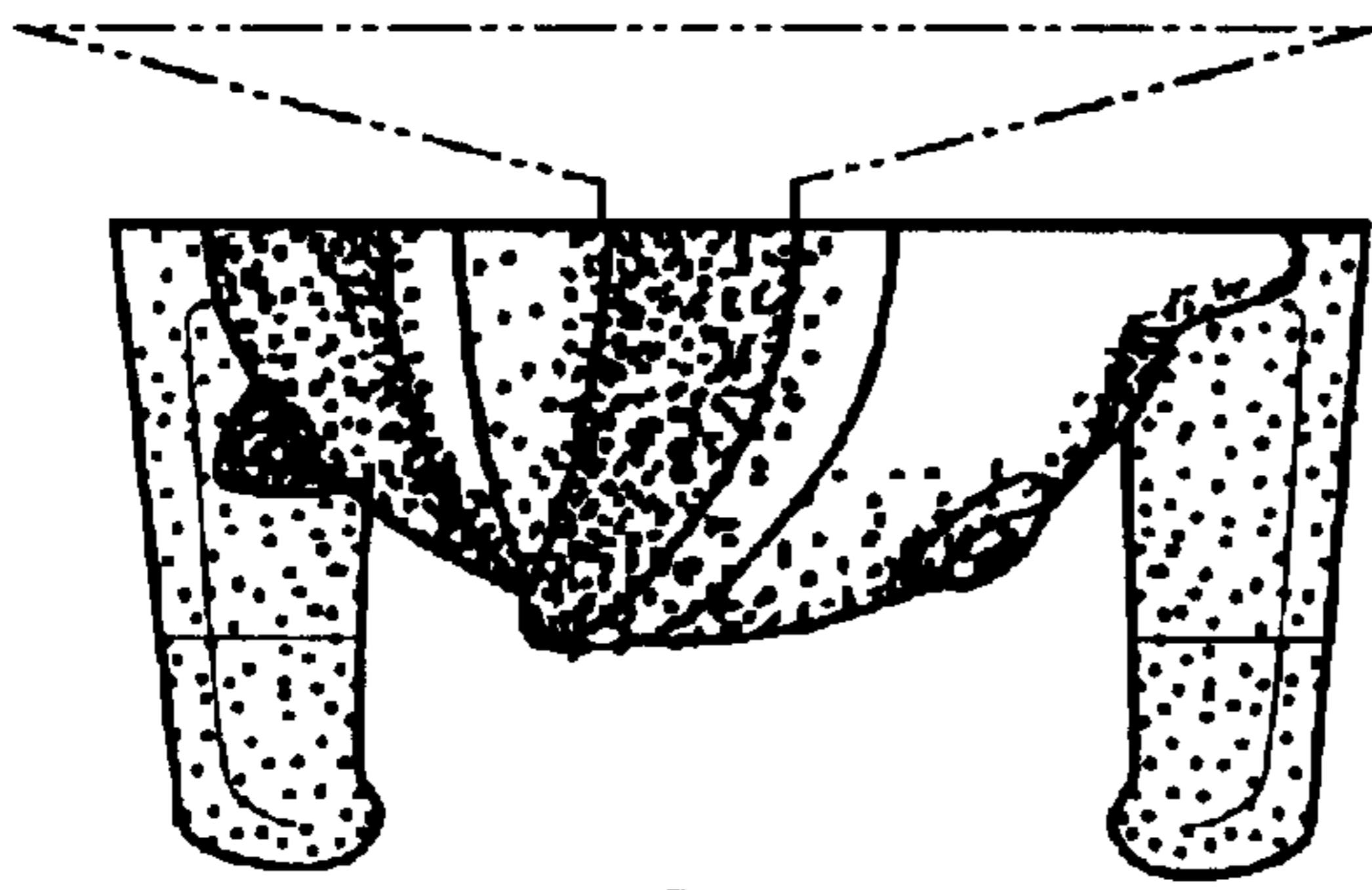




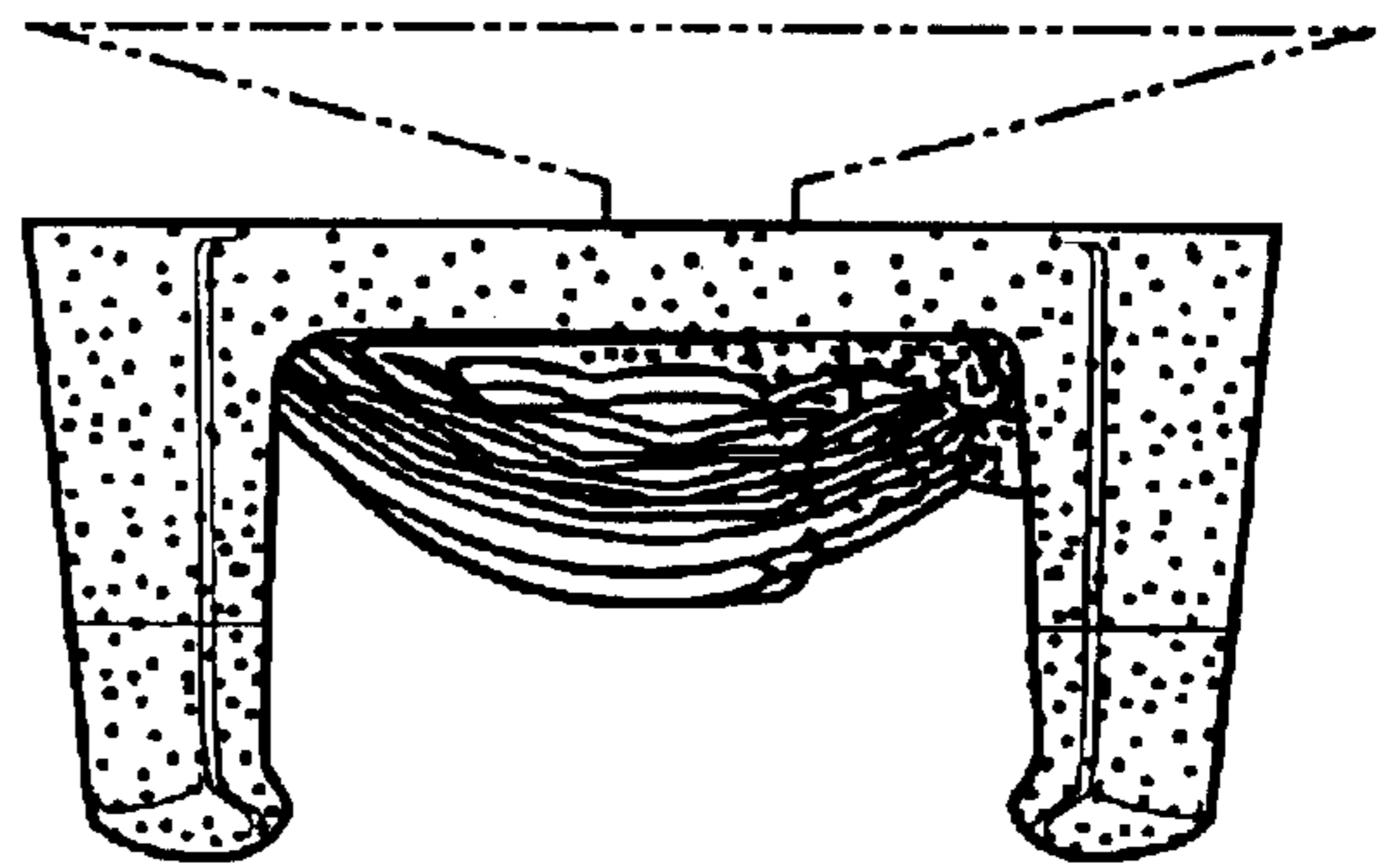

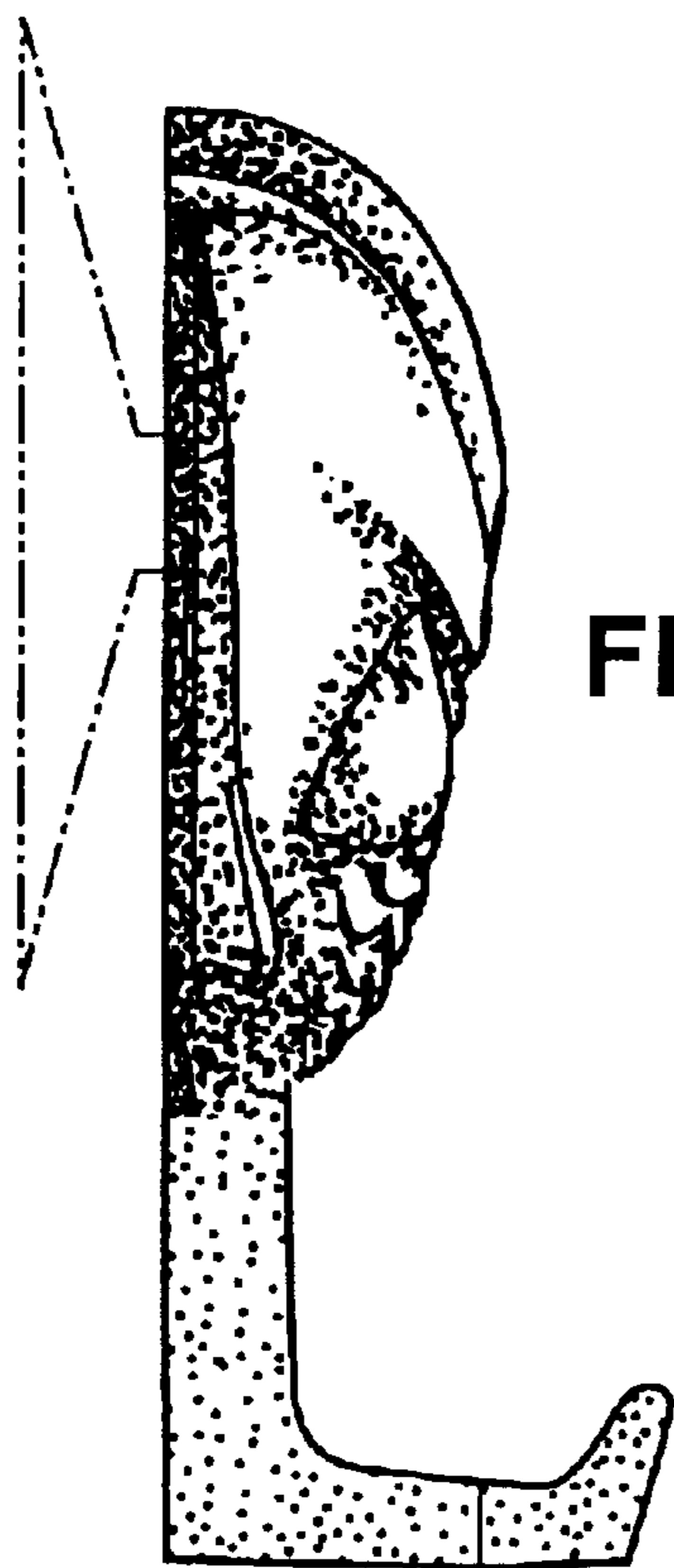
