DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a watchband showing my design;

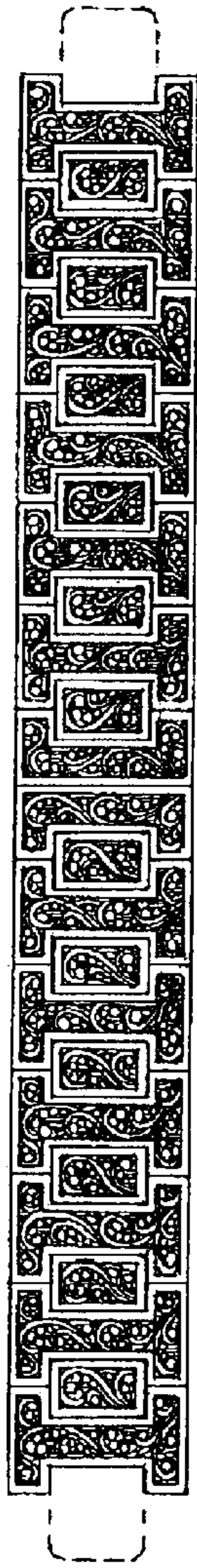

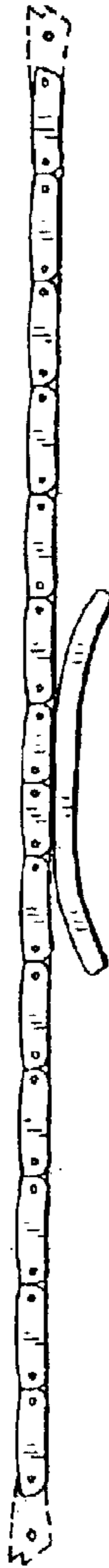

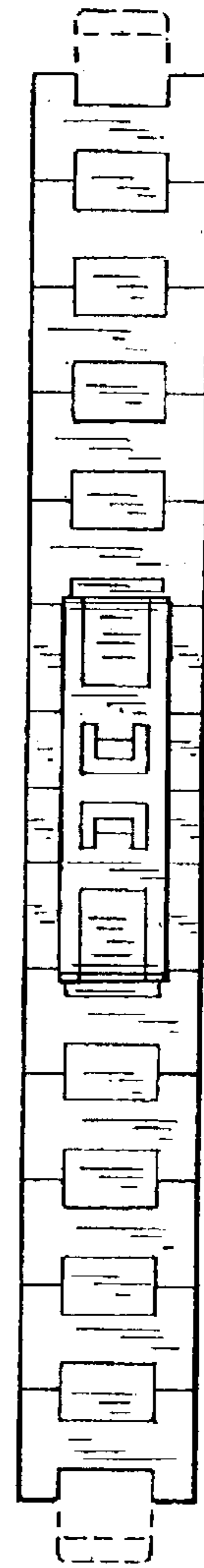

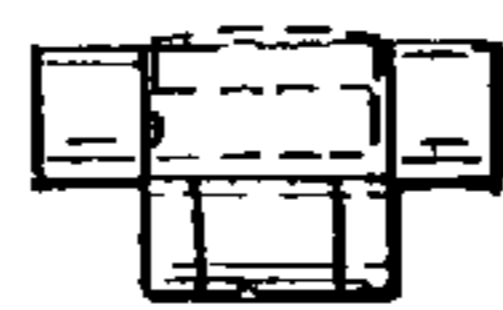
