FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a frame for a luggage container;


FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, with the opposite side being identical to that shown.


The broken line showing of luggage in the drawings is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.


