(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a kitchen tool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a fragmented spoon defining a kitchen tool, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a fragmented top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a fragmented bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a fragmented left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a fragmented right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a fragmented front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a fragmented rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of a fragmented slotted spoon defining a kitchen tool, showing our new design;

FIG. 9 is a fragmented top plan view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a fragmented bottom plan view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a fragmented right side elevational view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 12 is a fragmented left side elevational view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 13 is a fragmented front elevational view of FIG. 8; and,

FIG. 14 is a fragmented rear elevational view of FIG. 8.

The broken line showings of a handle of a spoon in FIG. 1 and of a handle of a slotted spoon in FIG. 8 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

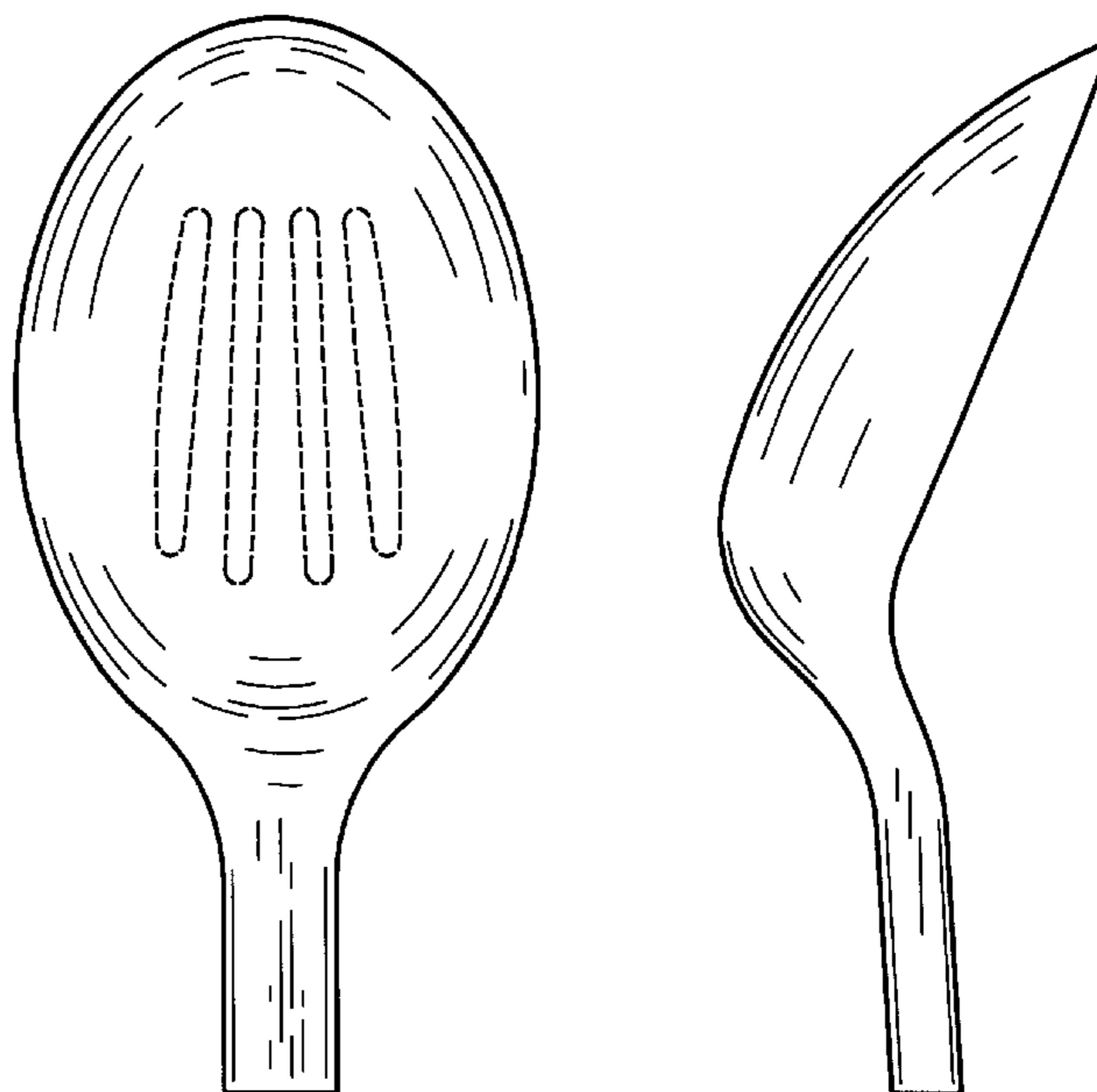

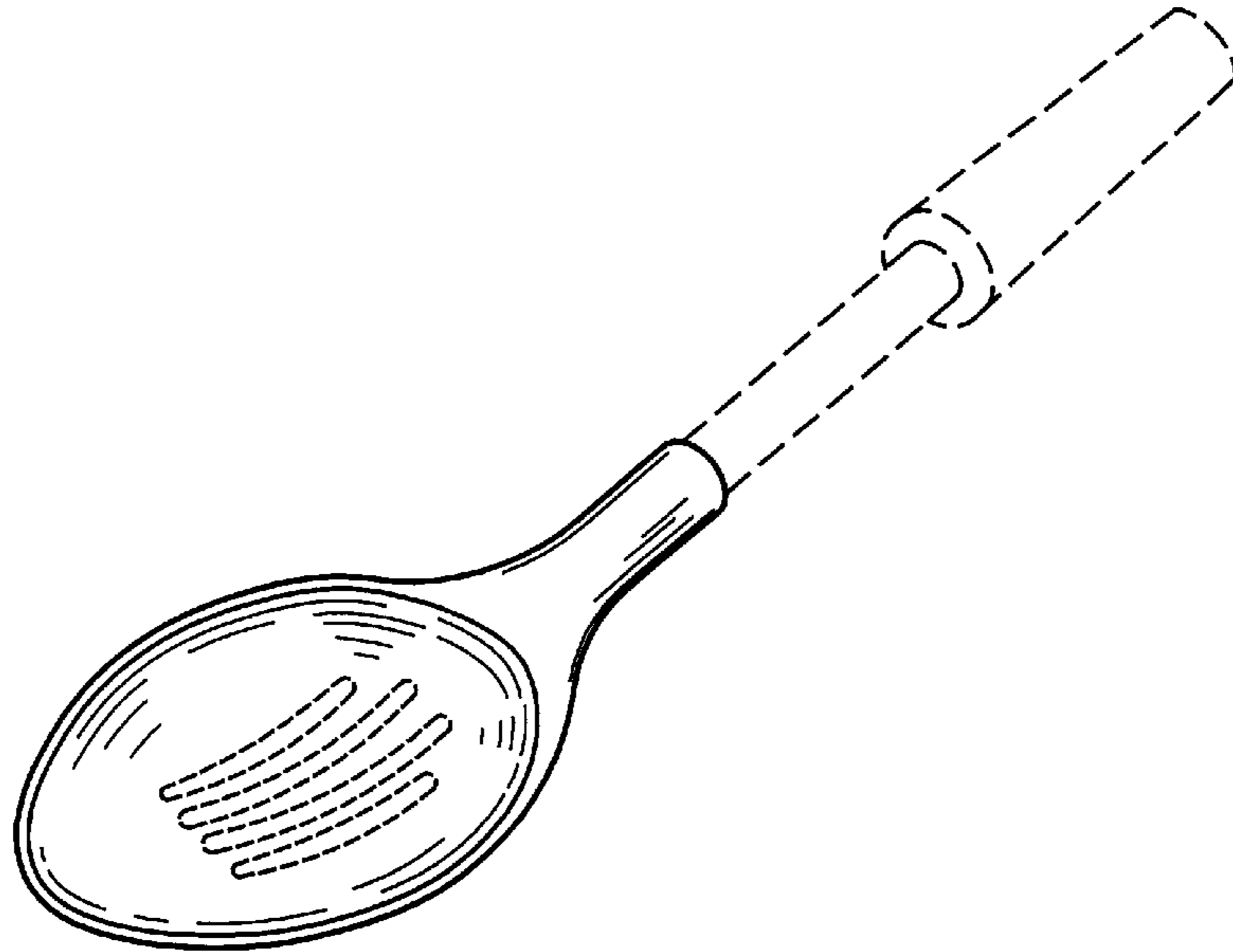

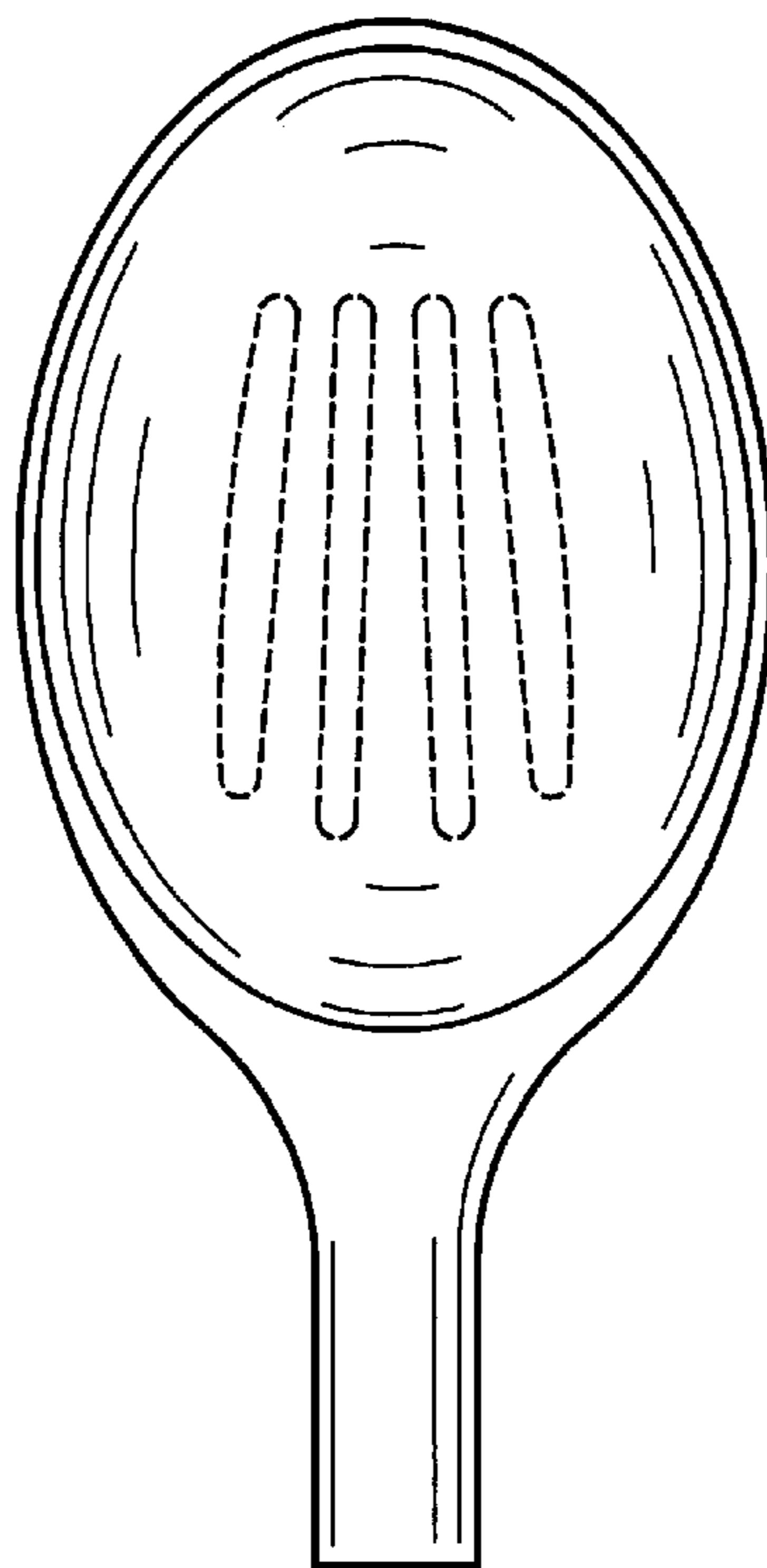

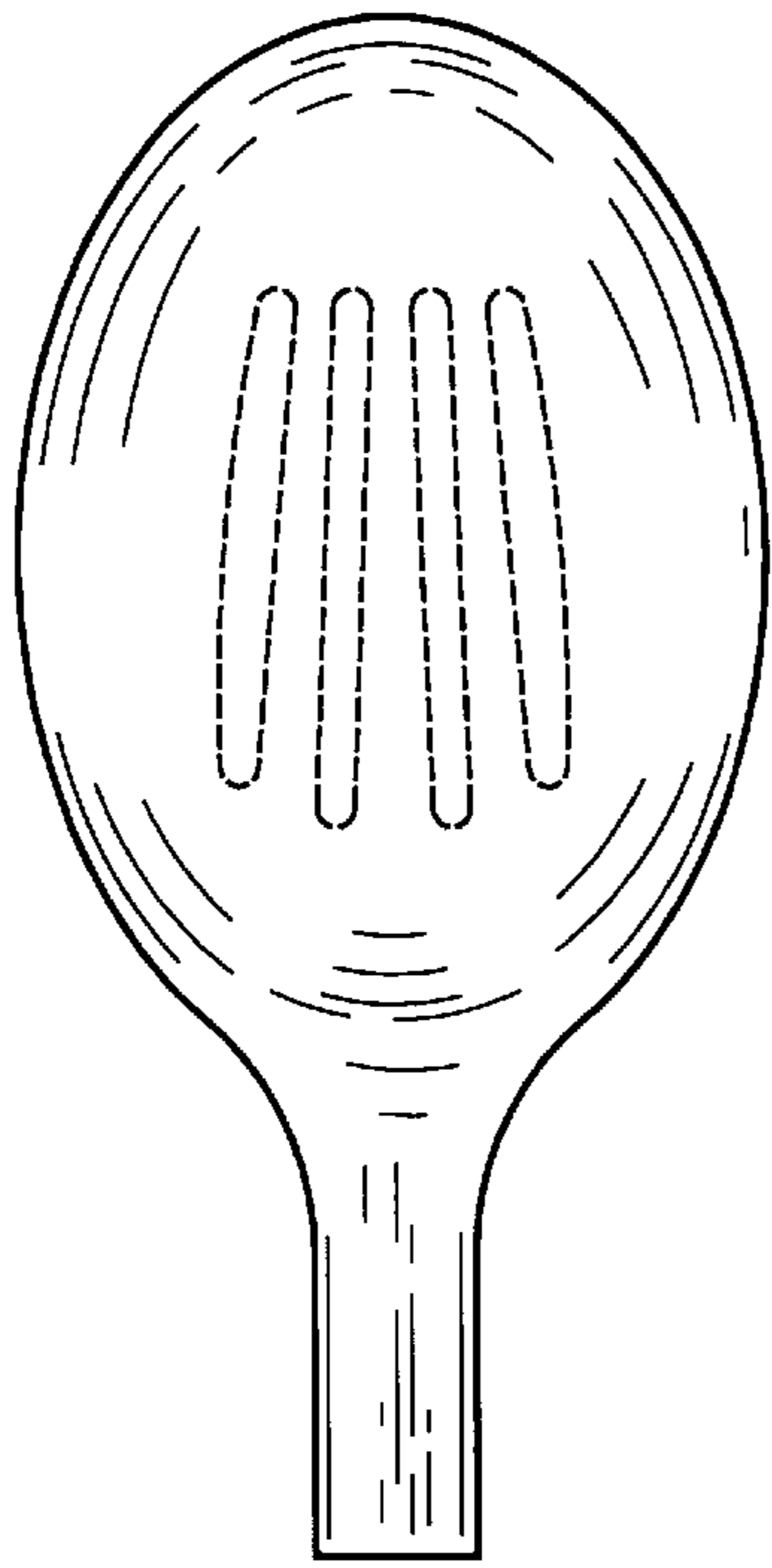

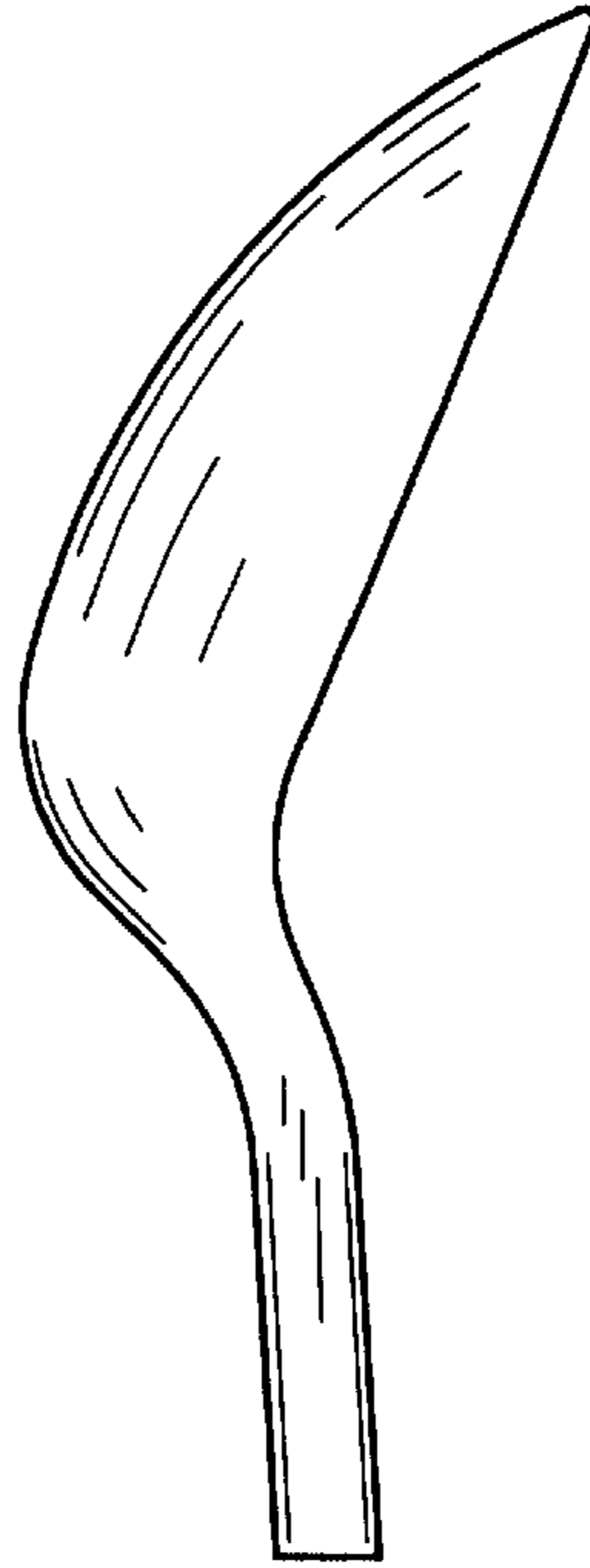

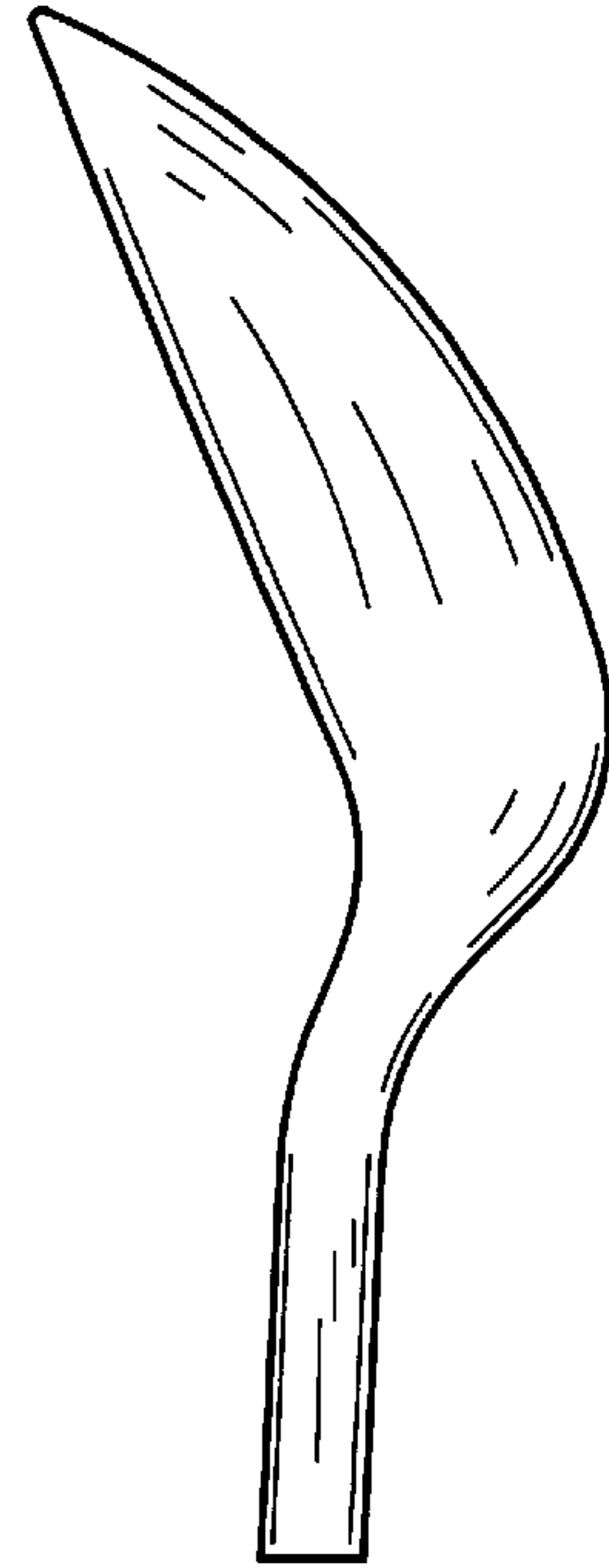

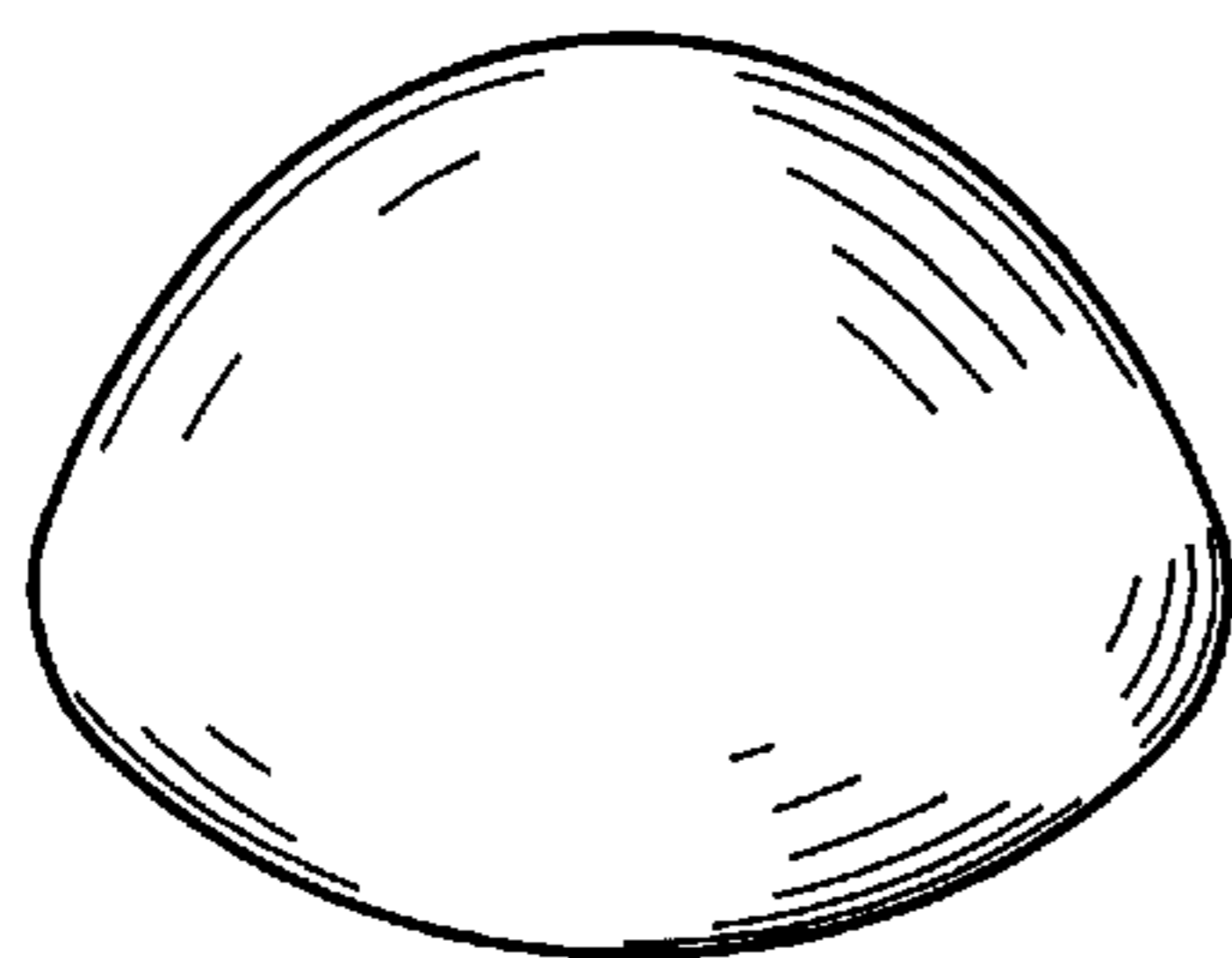

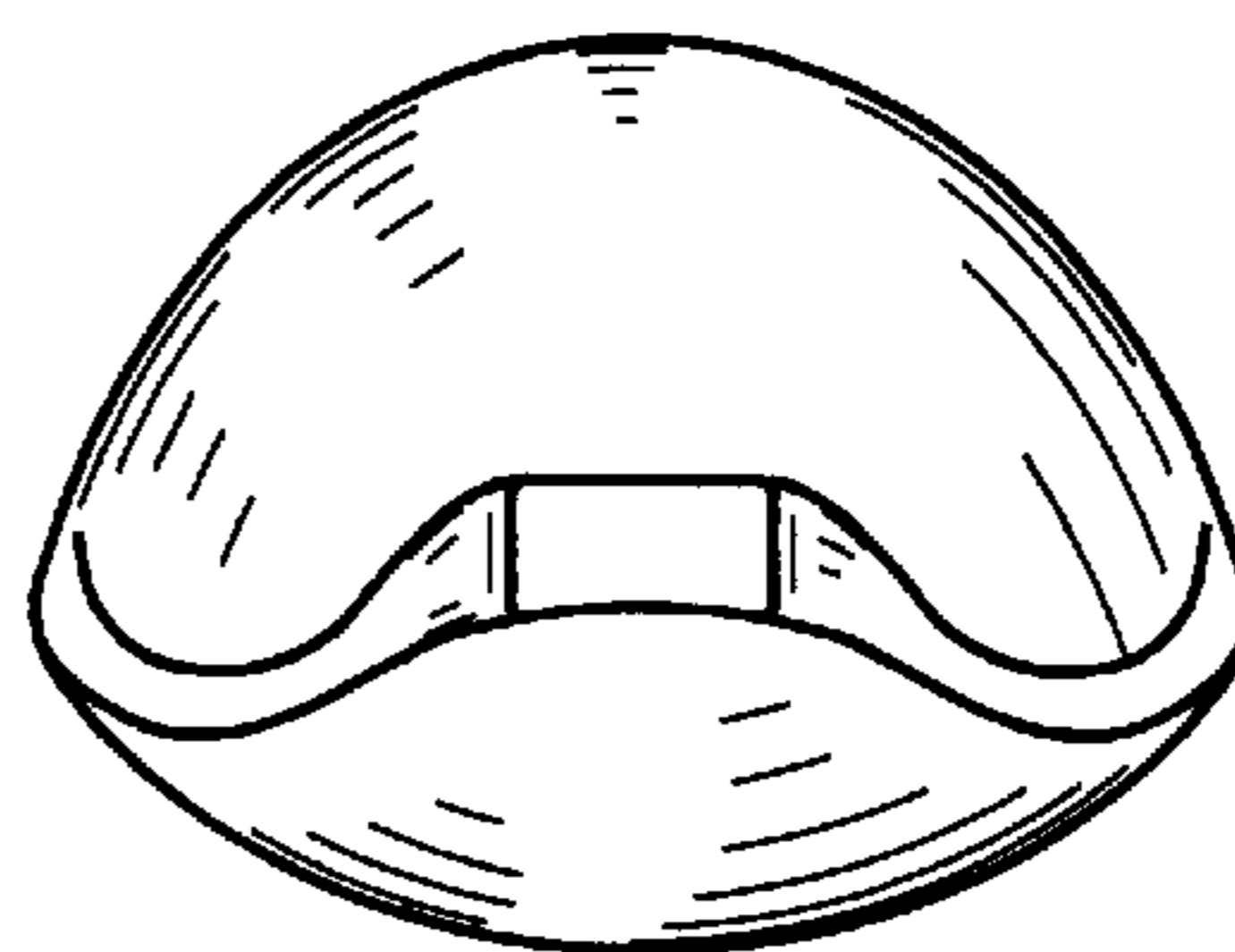

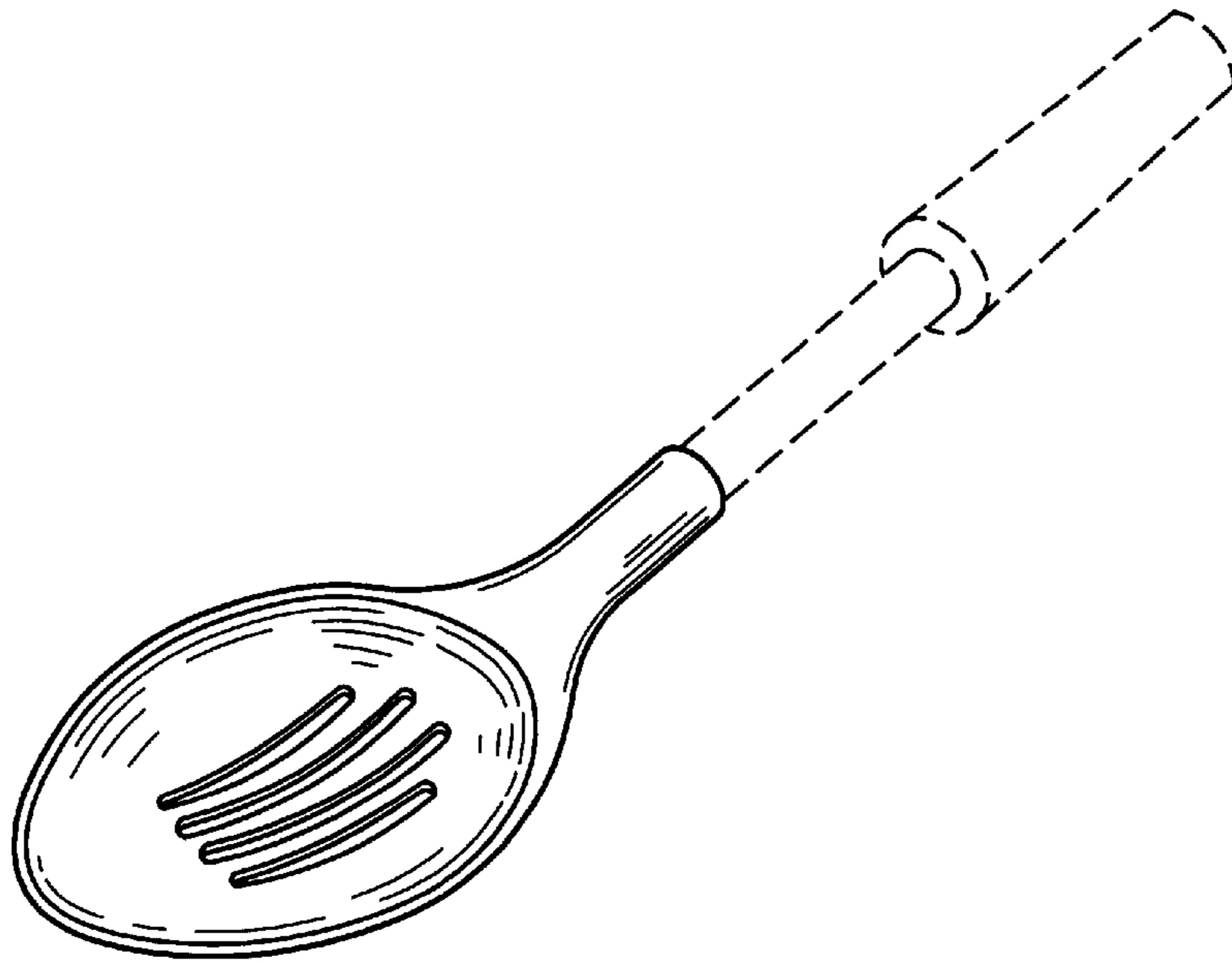

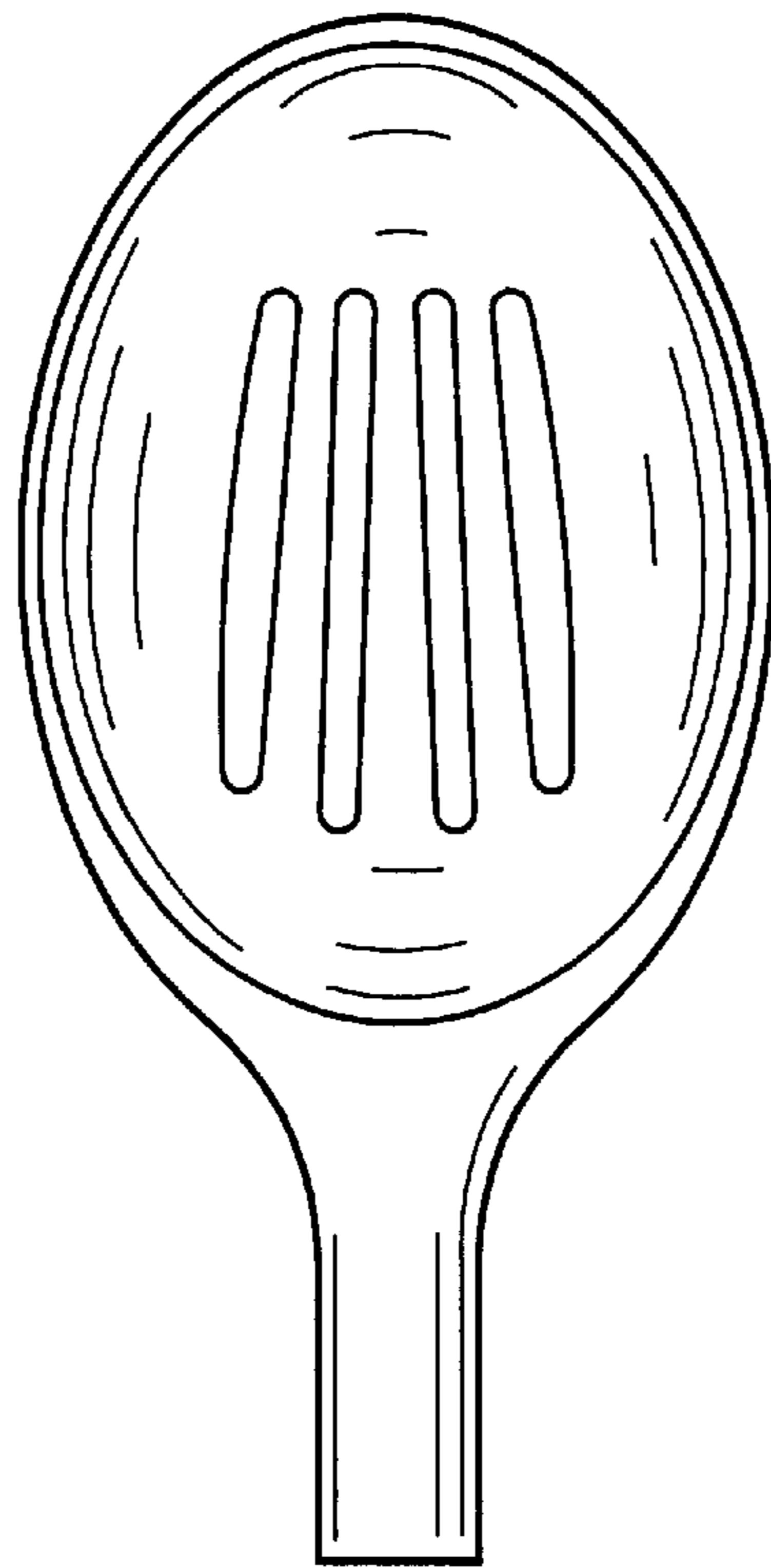

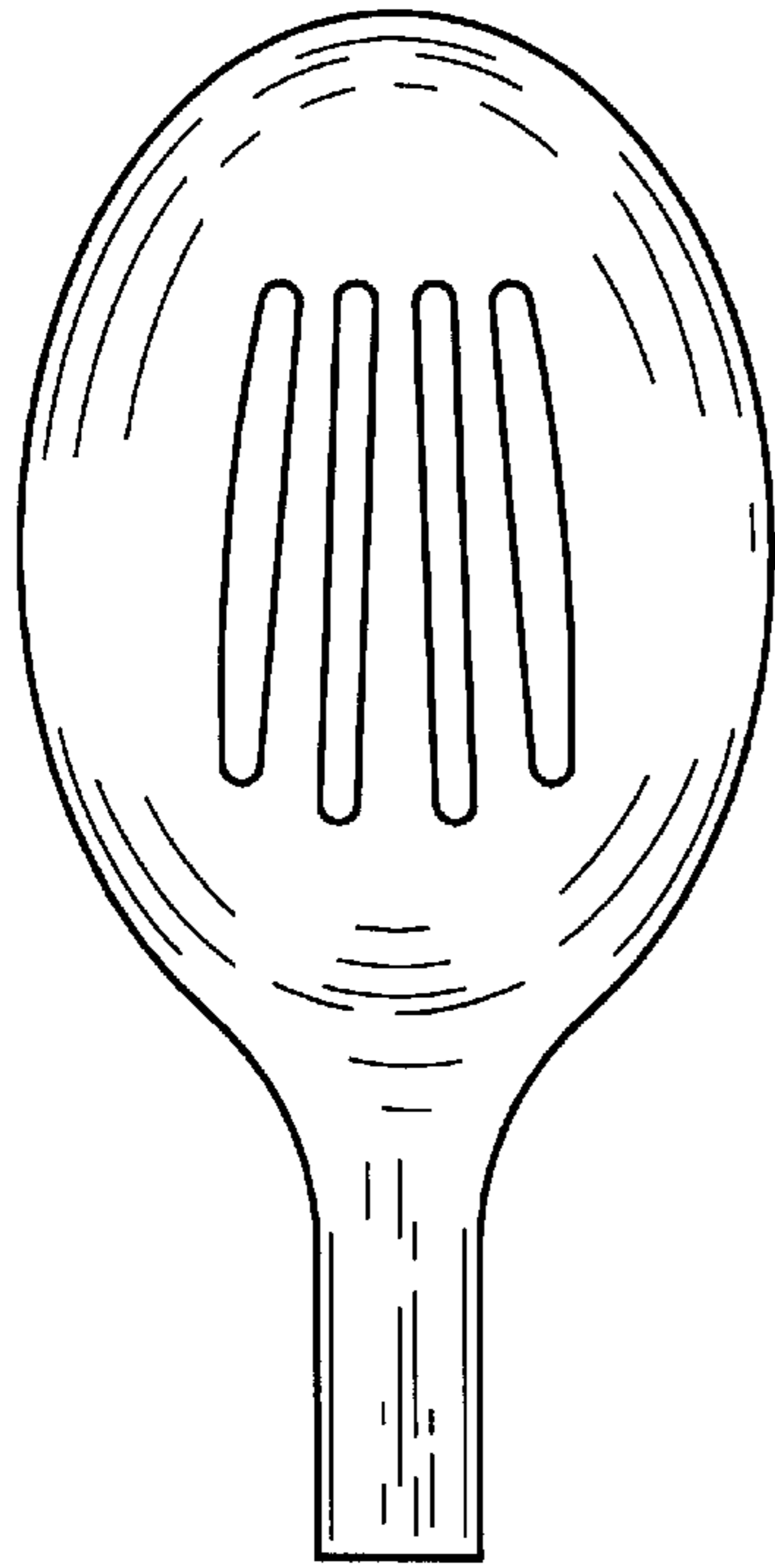

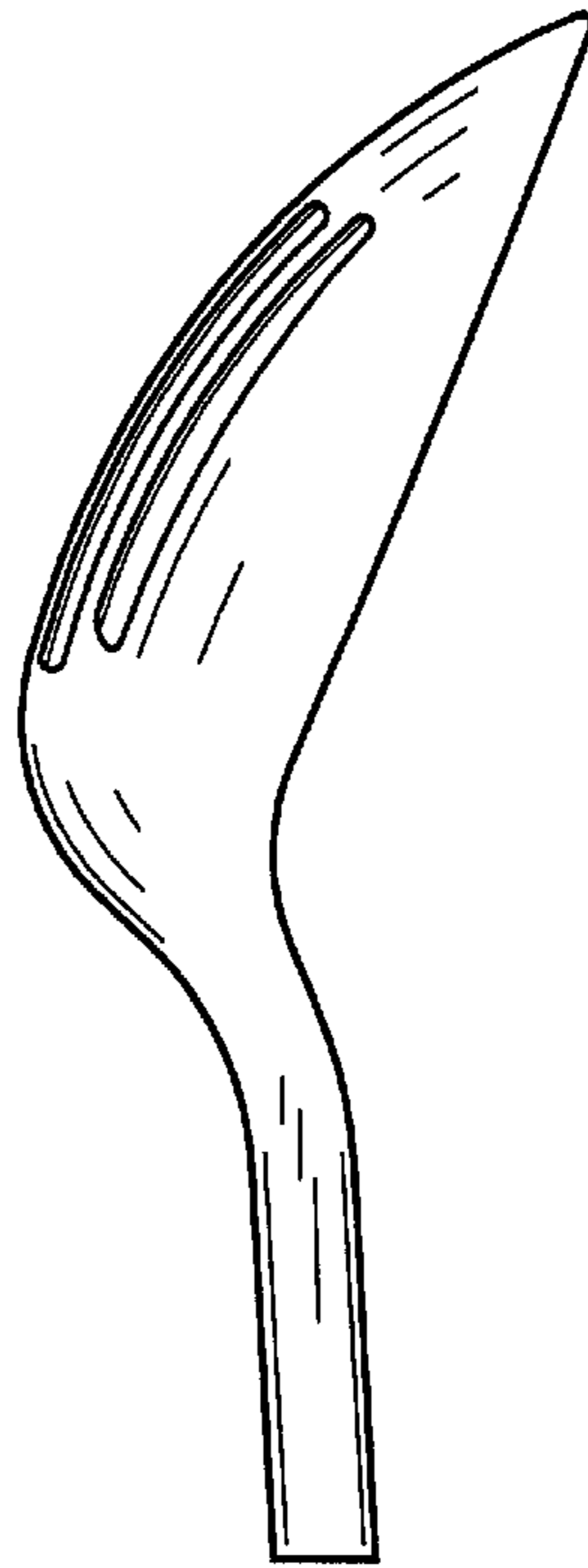

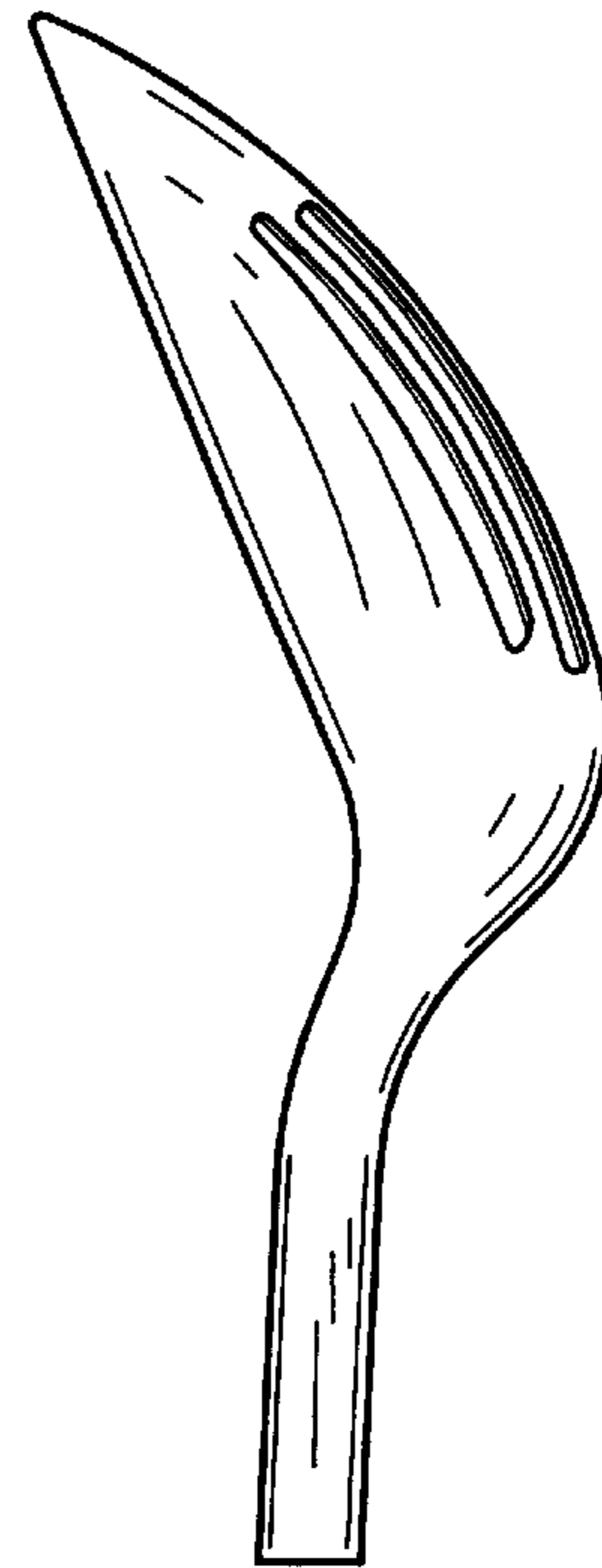

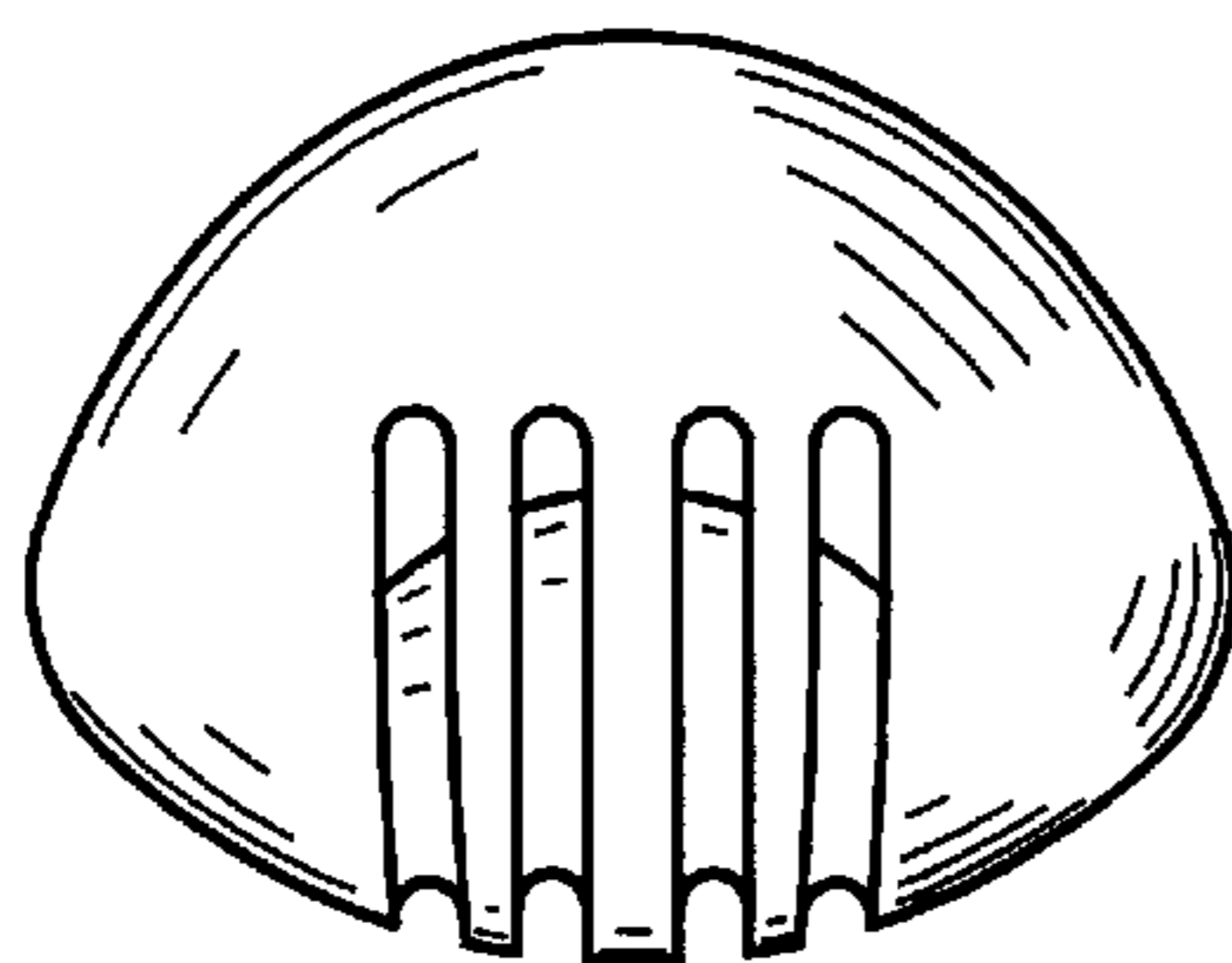
