DESCRIPTION

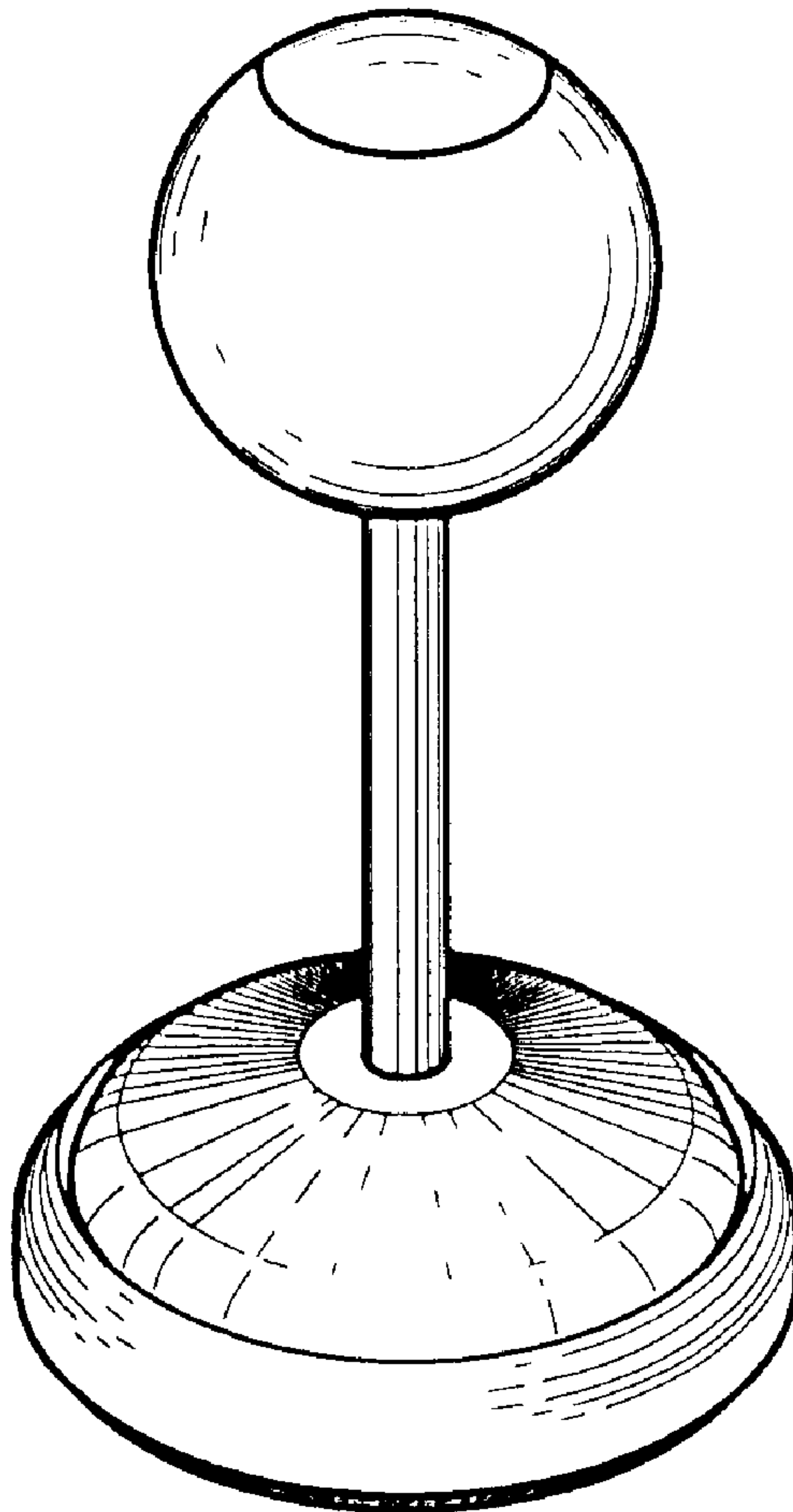
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of lighted jewelry showing my new design.

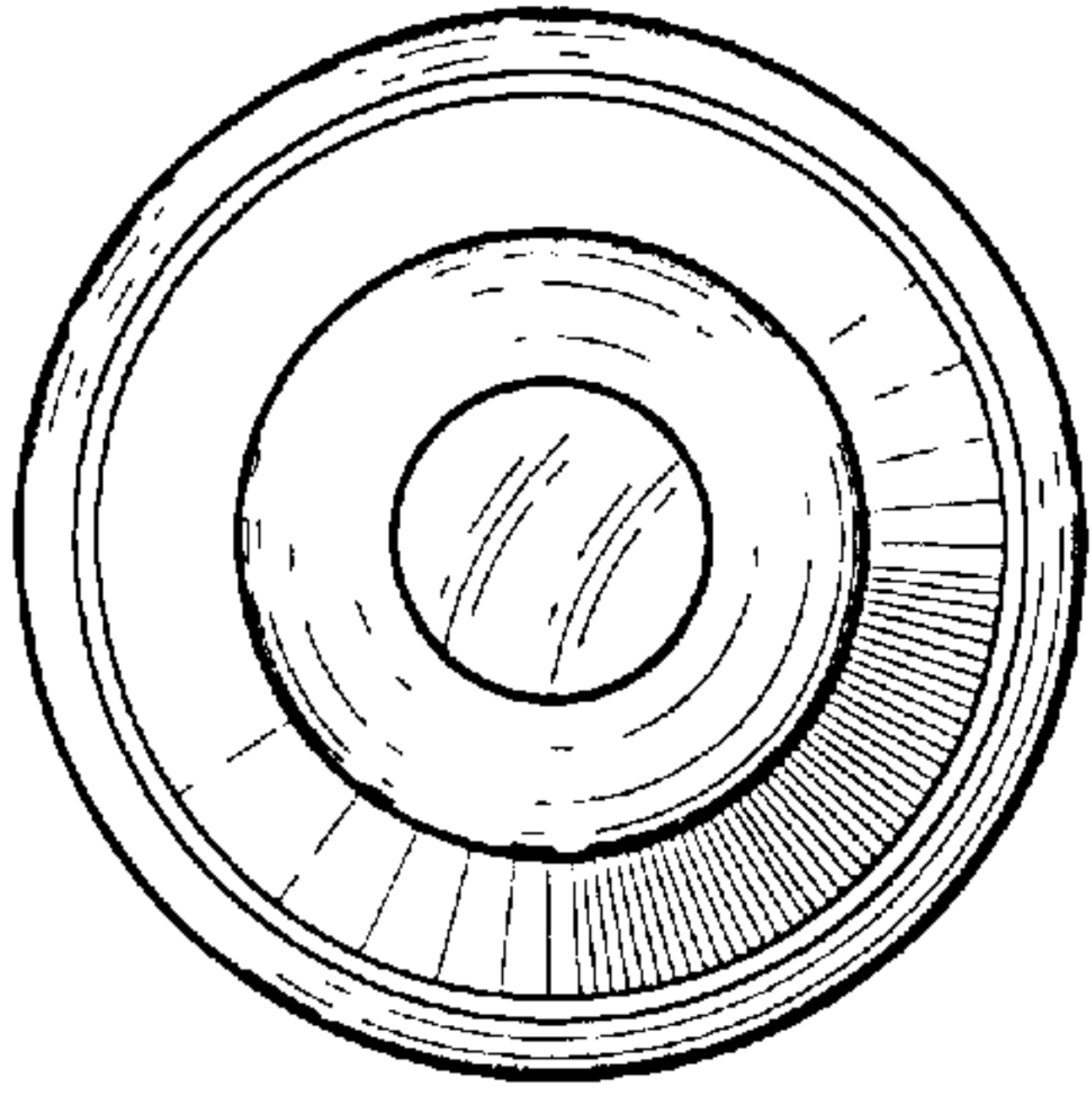

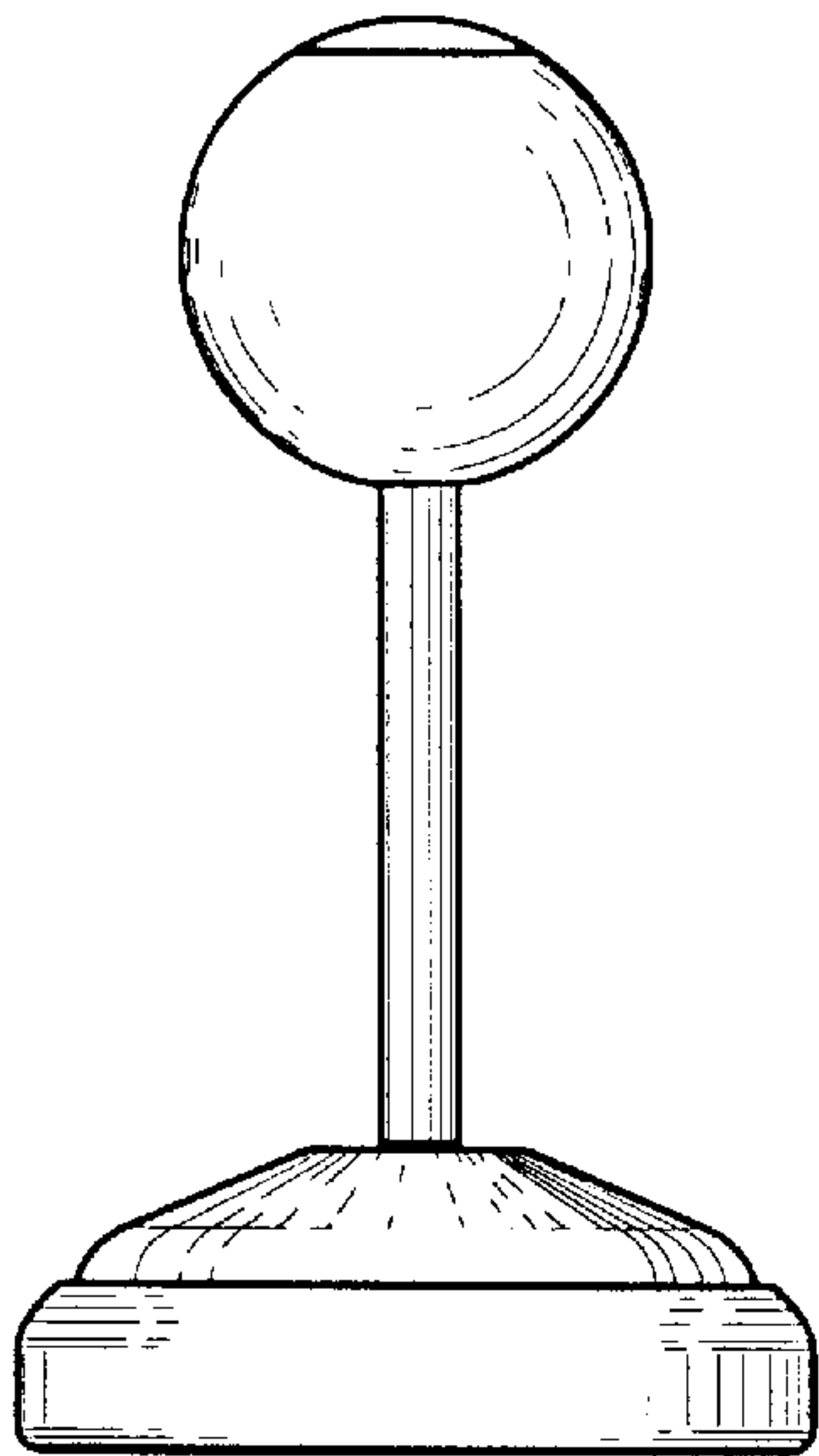

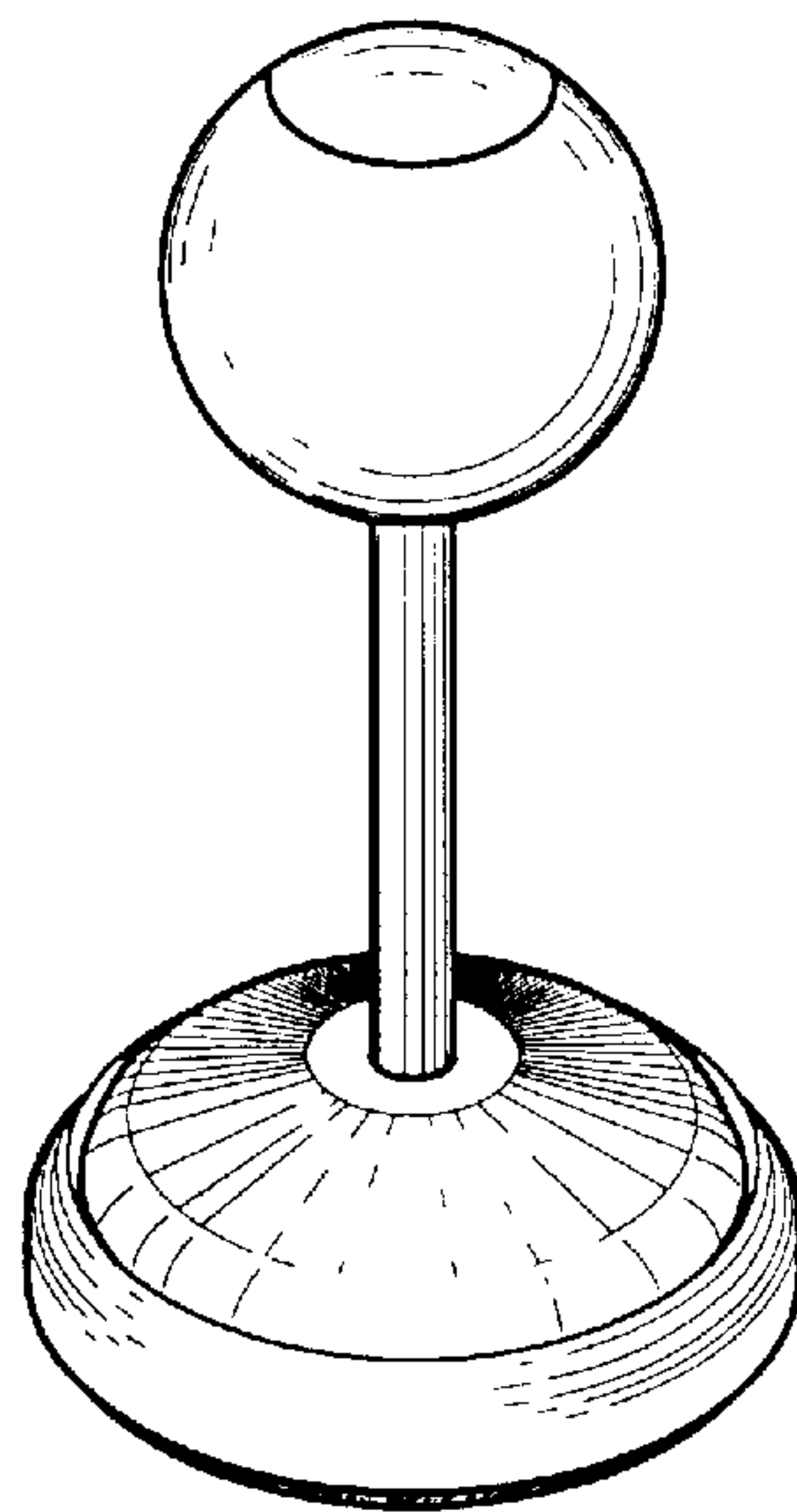

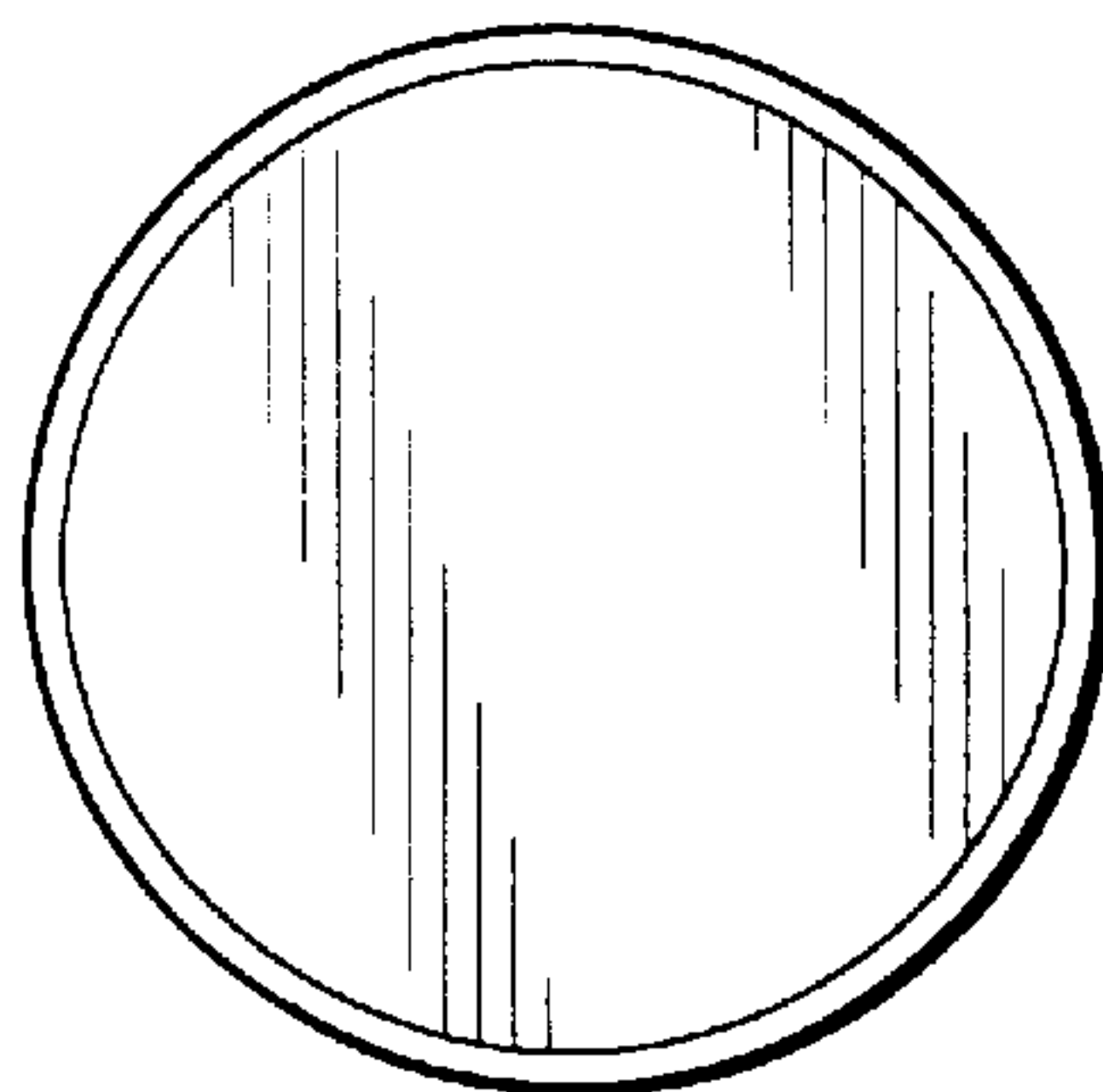
