(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a housing for an electrical device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a first embodiment of the housing.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the first embodiment of the housing.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the first embodiment of the housing.

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the first embodiment of the housing. The right side elevational view (not shown) is a mirror image of the left side elevational view.

FIG. 5 is a top elevational view of the first embodiment of the housing.

FIG. 6 is a bottom elevational view of the first embodiment of the housing.

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of the housing. The front and rear elevational views of the second embodiment of the housing are identical, respectively, to the front and rear elevational views of the first embodiment as shown in FIGS. 2 and 3.

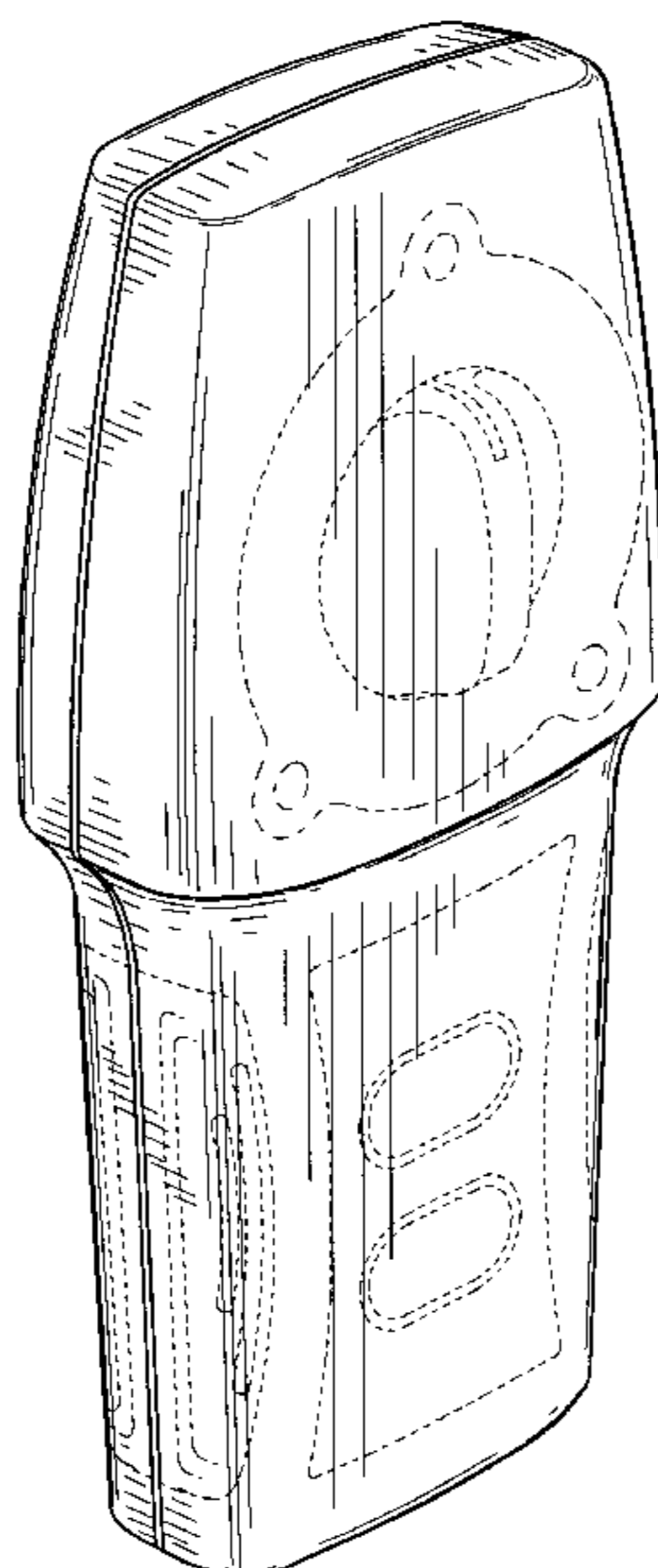
FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view of the second embodiment of the housing. The right side elevational view (not shown) is a mirror image of the left side elevational view.

FIG. 9 is a top elevational view of the second embodiment of the housing; and,

FIG. 10 is a bottom elevational view of the second embodiment of the housing.

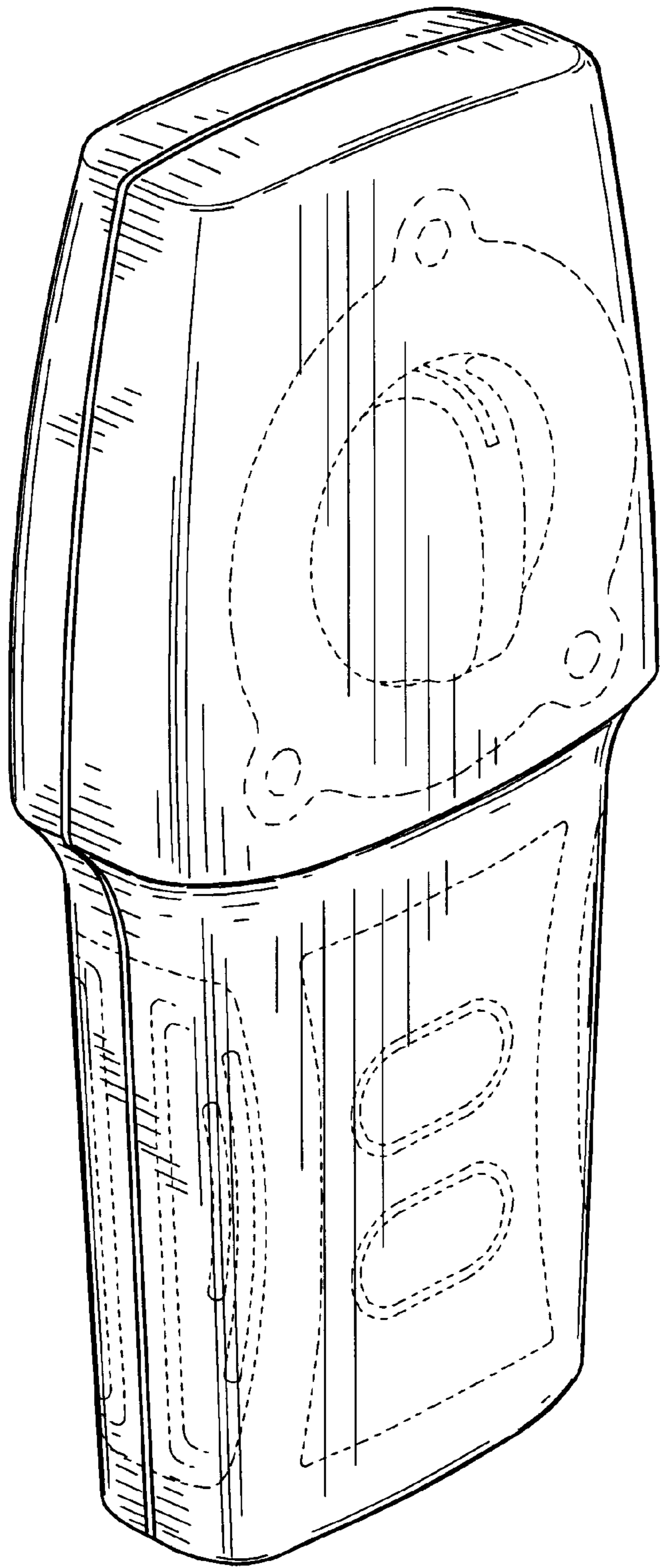

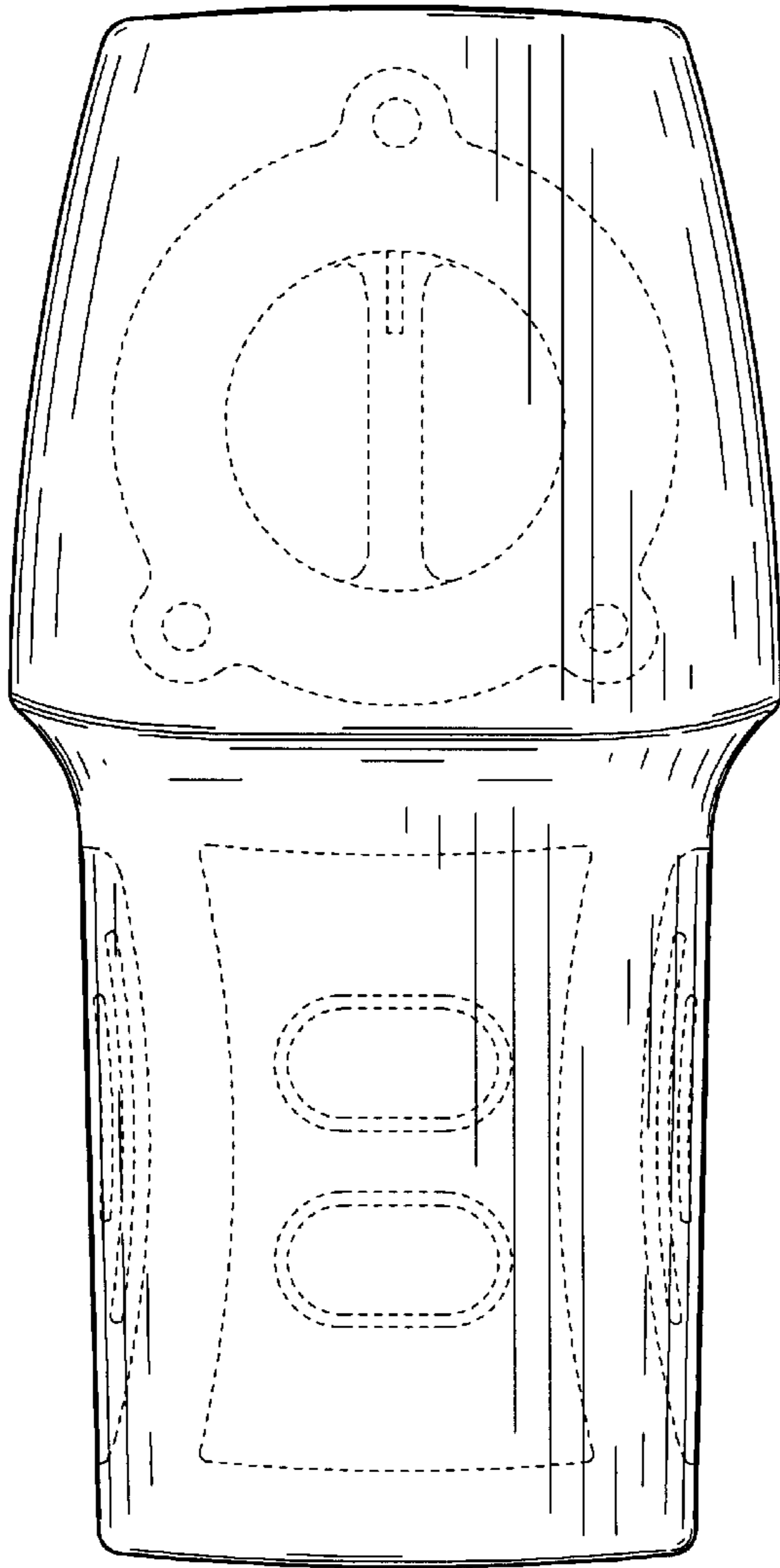

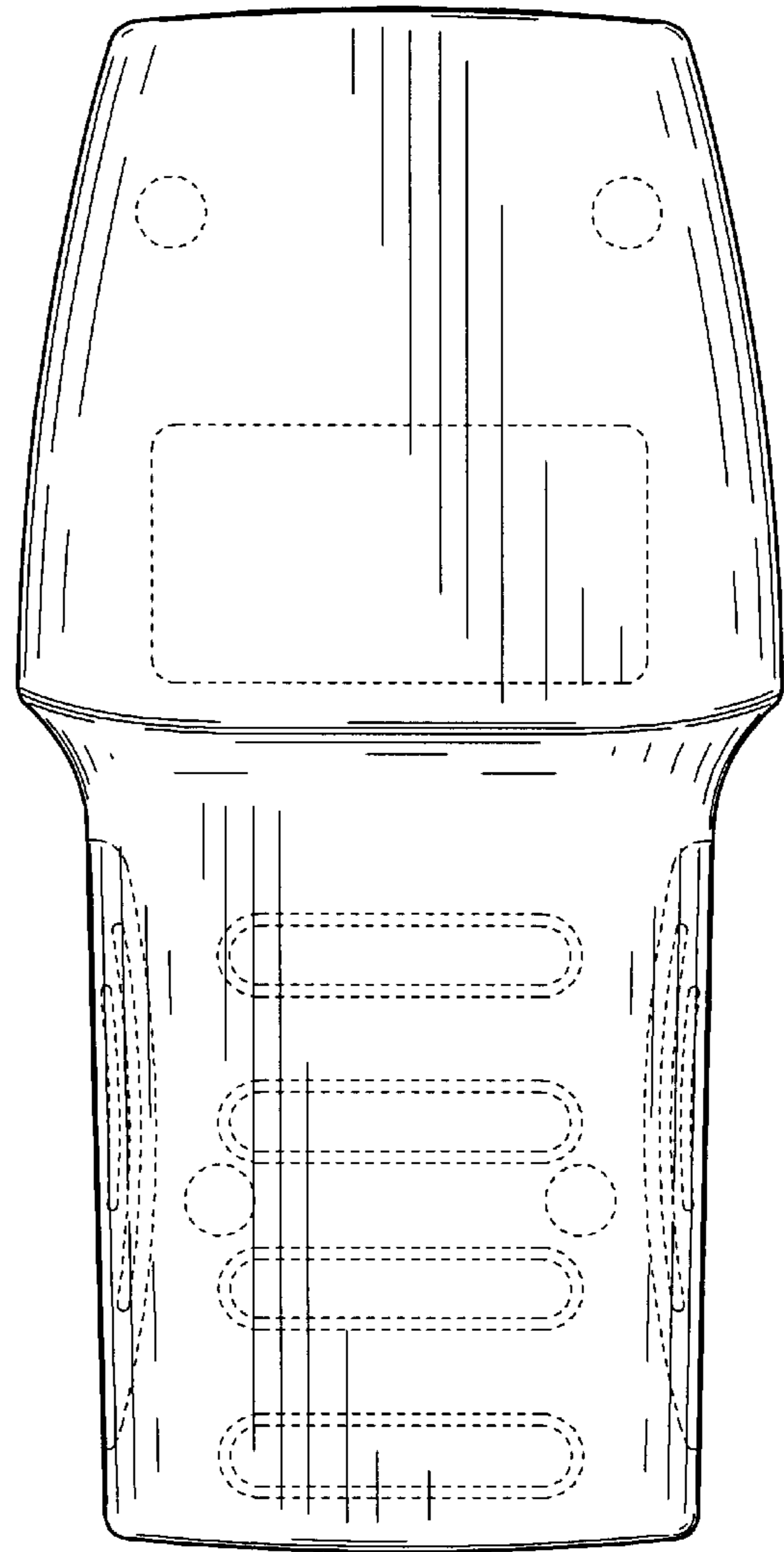

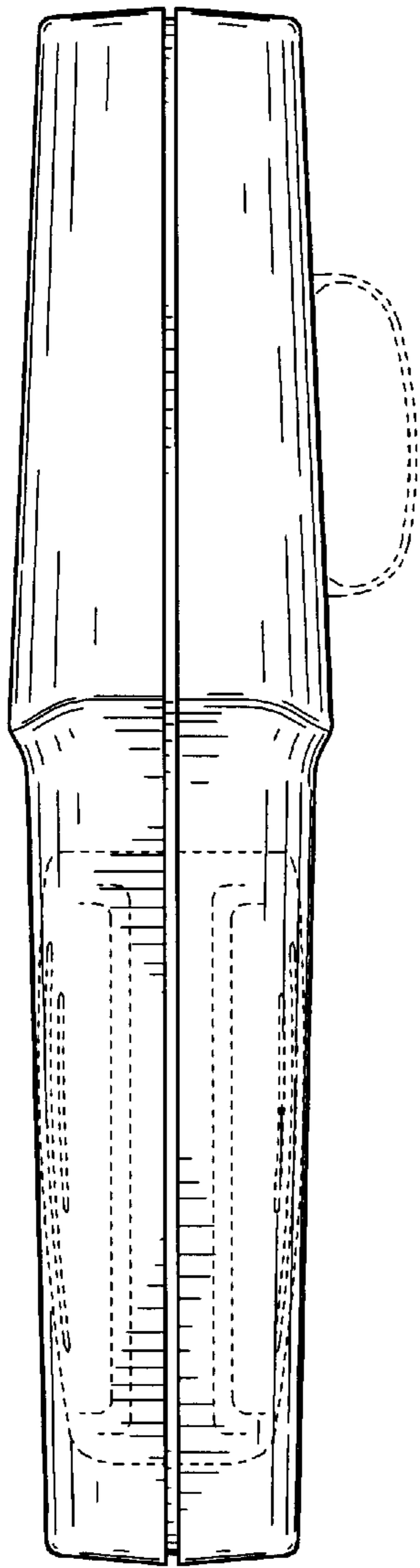

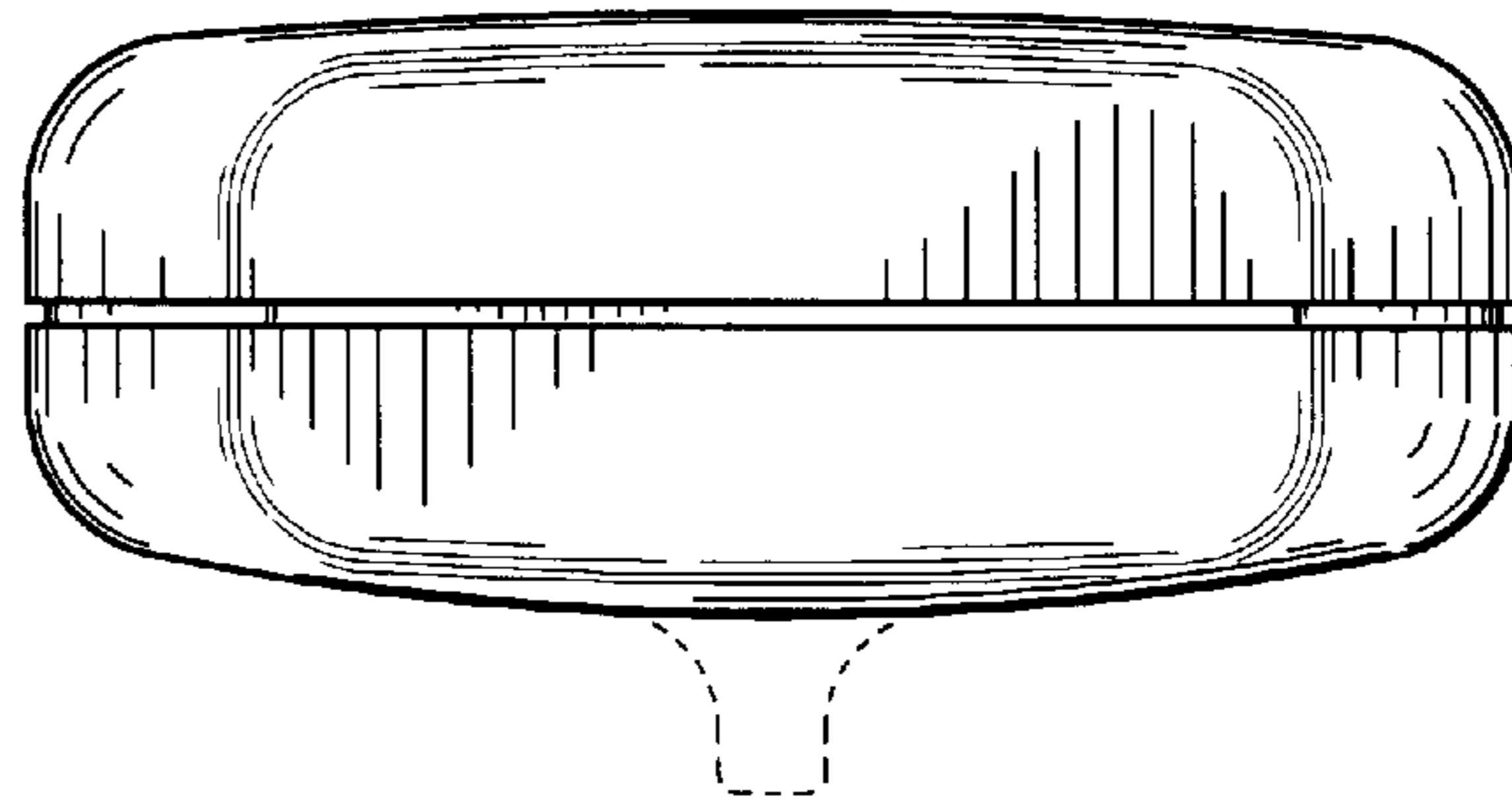

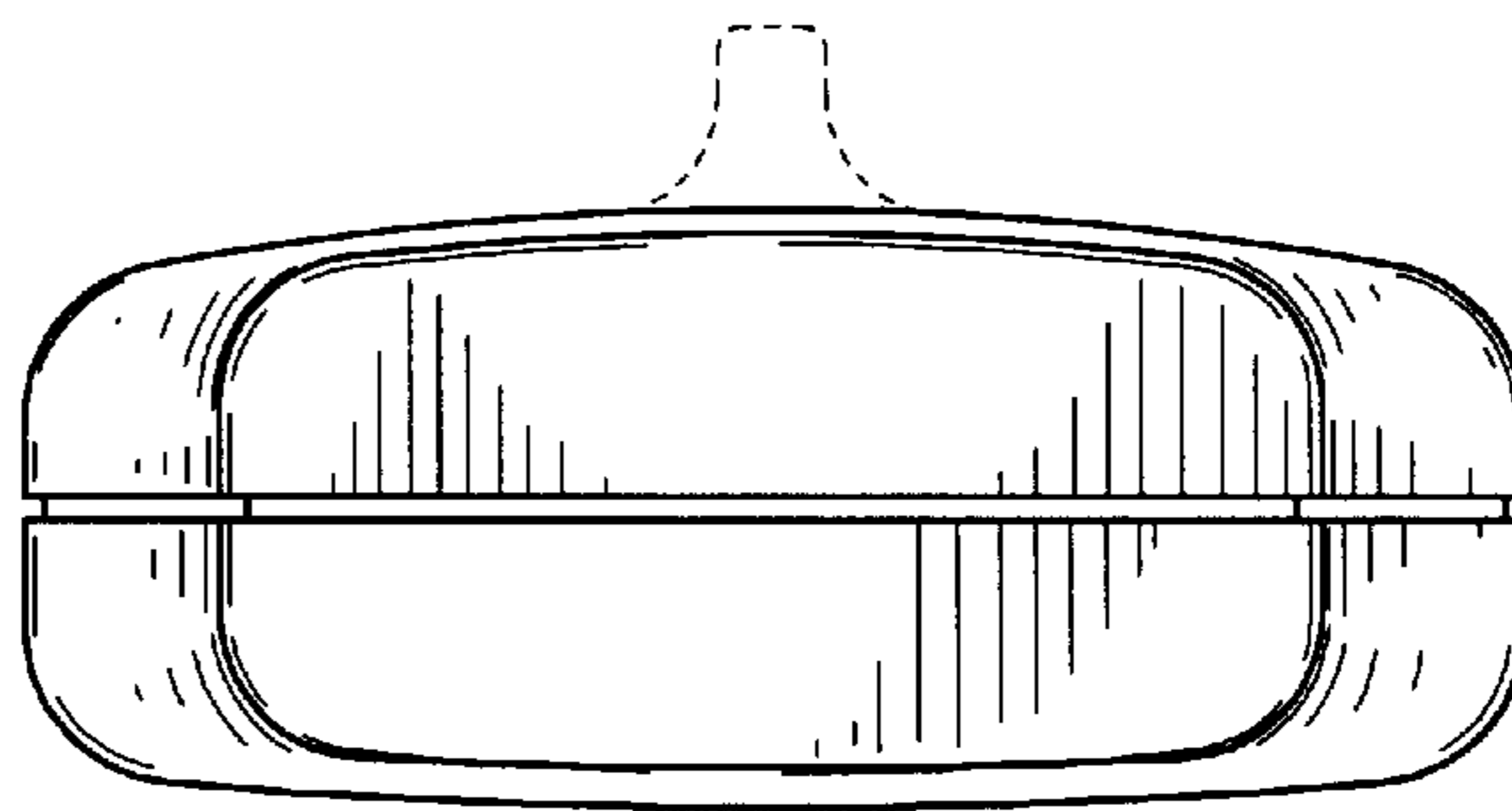

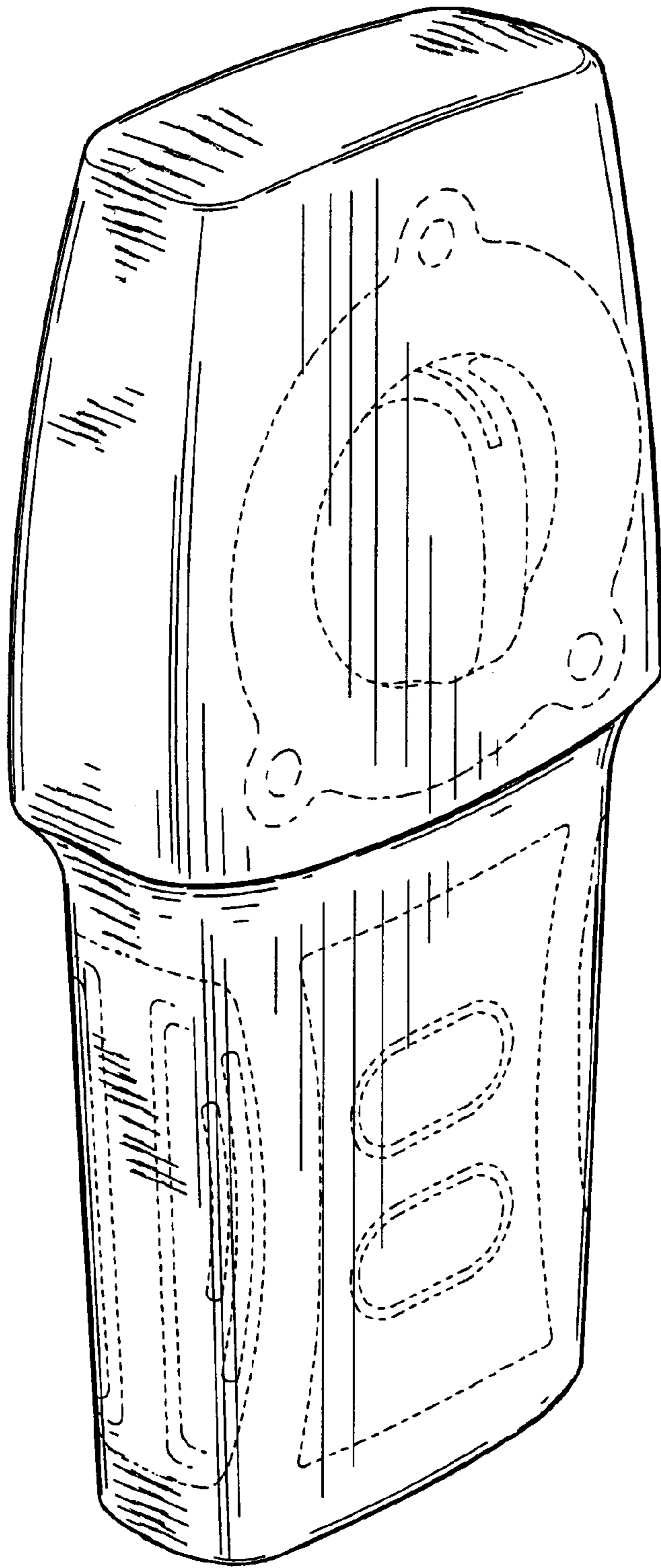

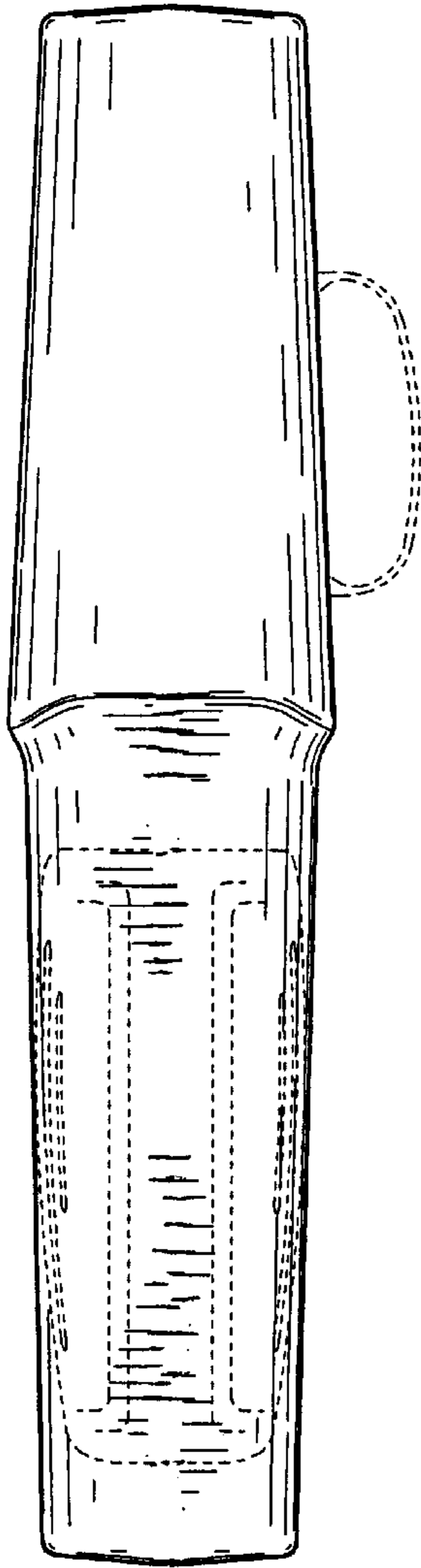

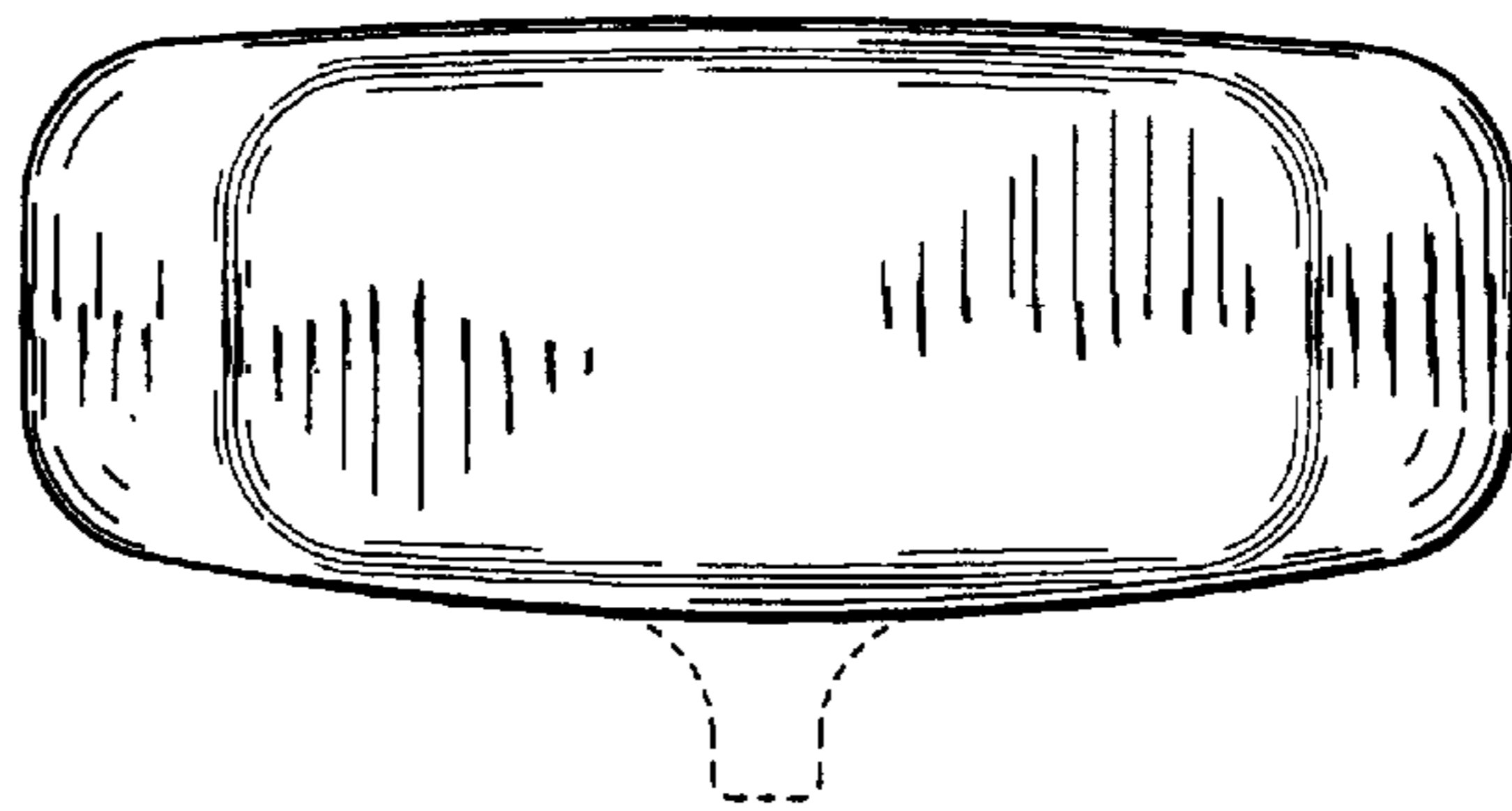

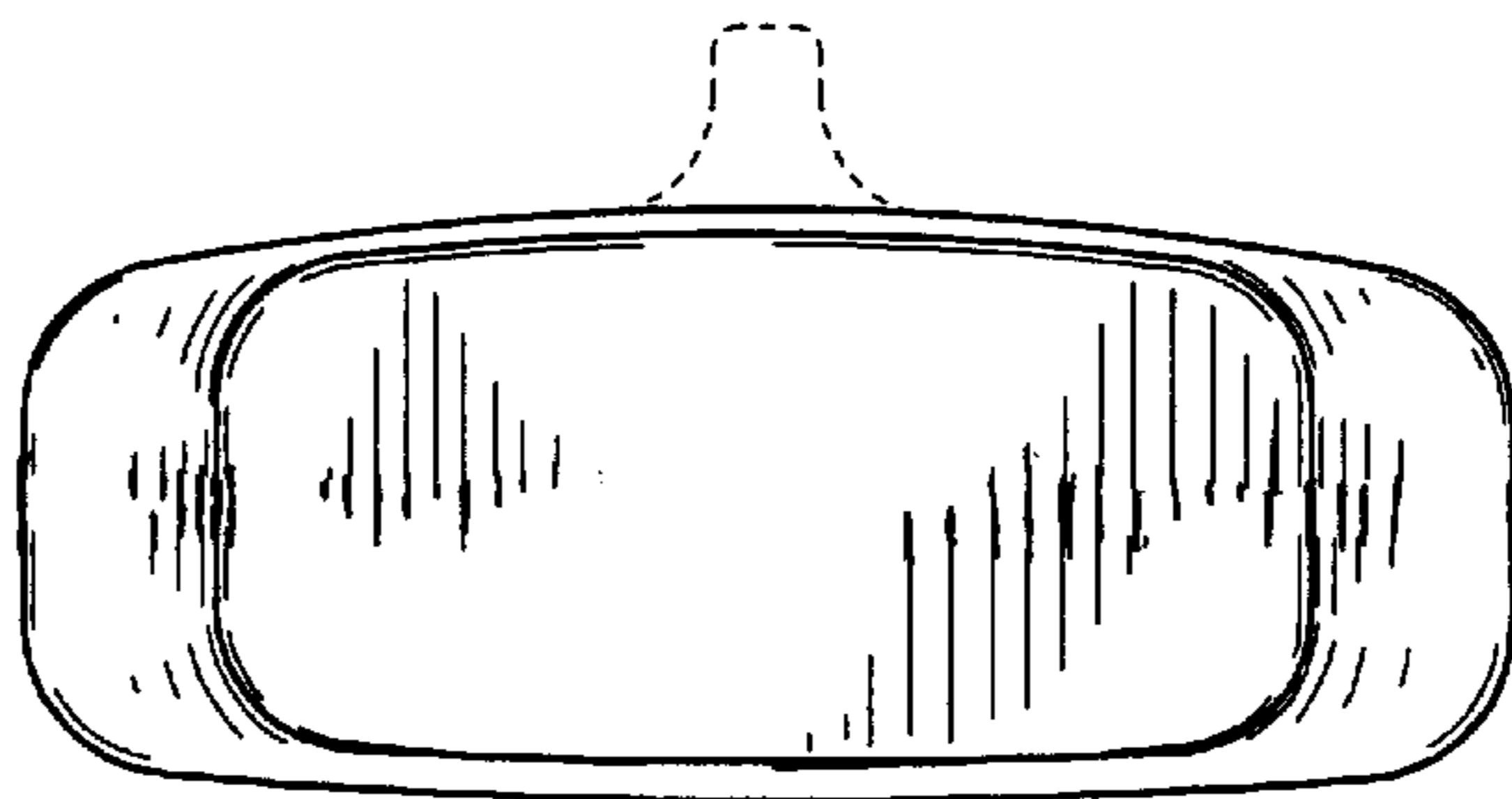
