(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a “fishing float”, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the upper left side of the “fishing float”;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the bottom half of the “fishing float” which is identical to the top half;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of one-half of the “fishing float”;

FIG. 4 is a plan view of one-half of the “fishing float” viewing the joining seam of the two halves that make up the design; and,

FIG. 5 is an end view of one-half of the design.

The right side is a mirror image of the left side and the opposite end view is a mirror image.
