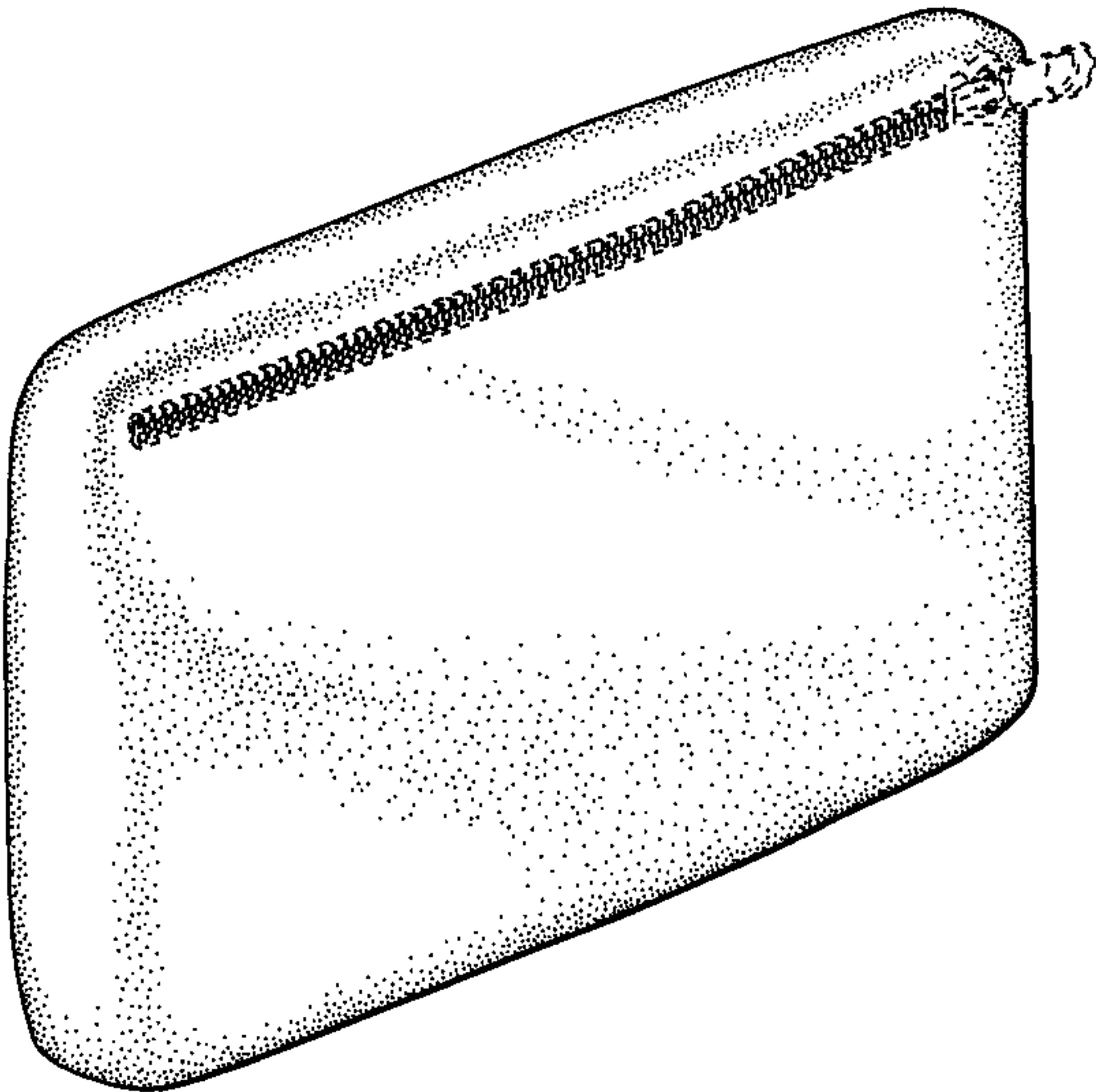
The ornamental design for a belt worn pouch, as shown and described.

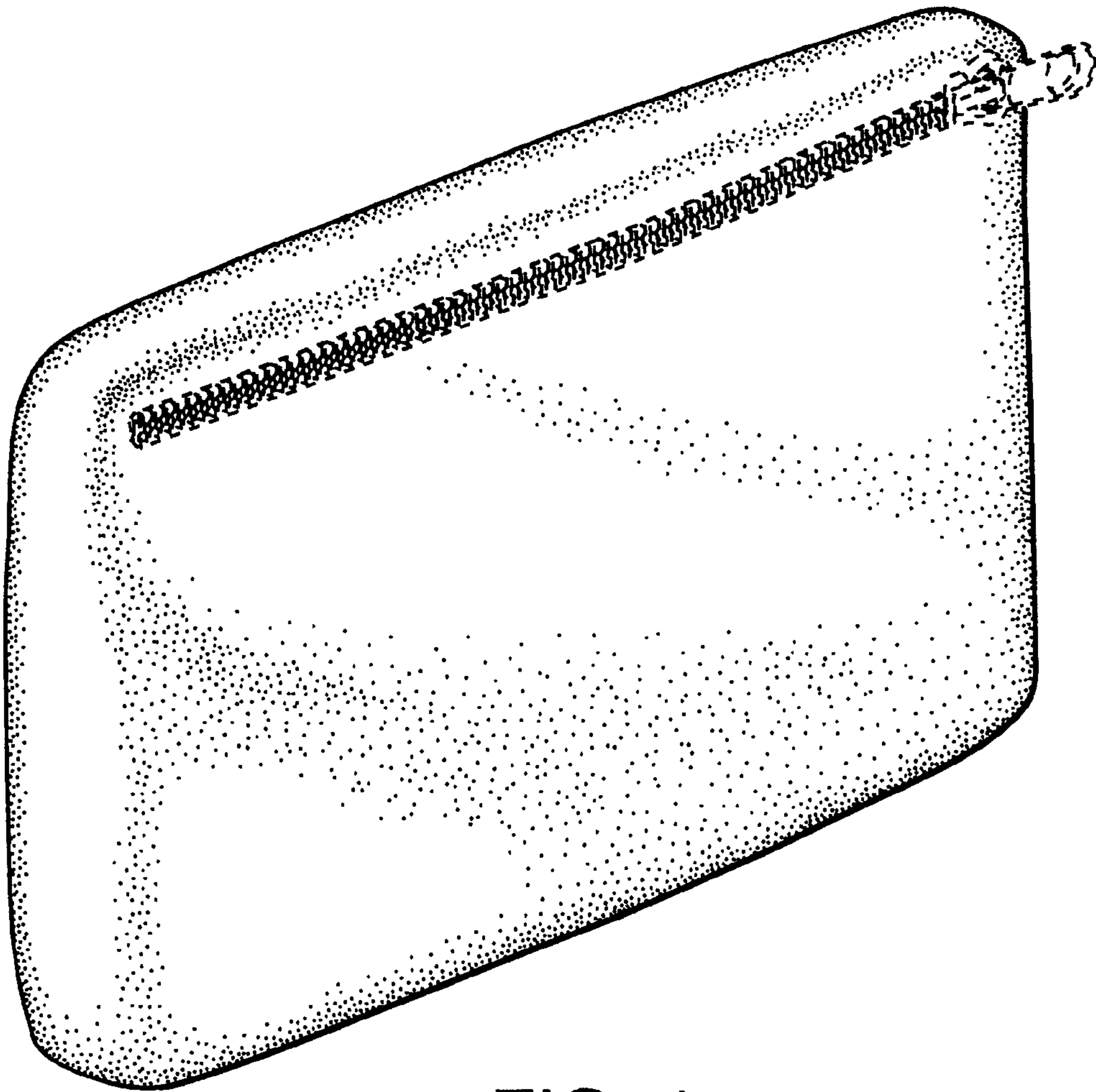

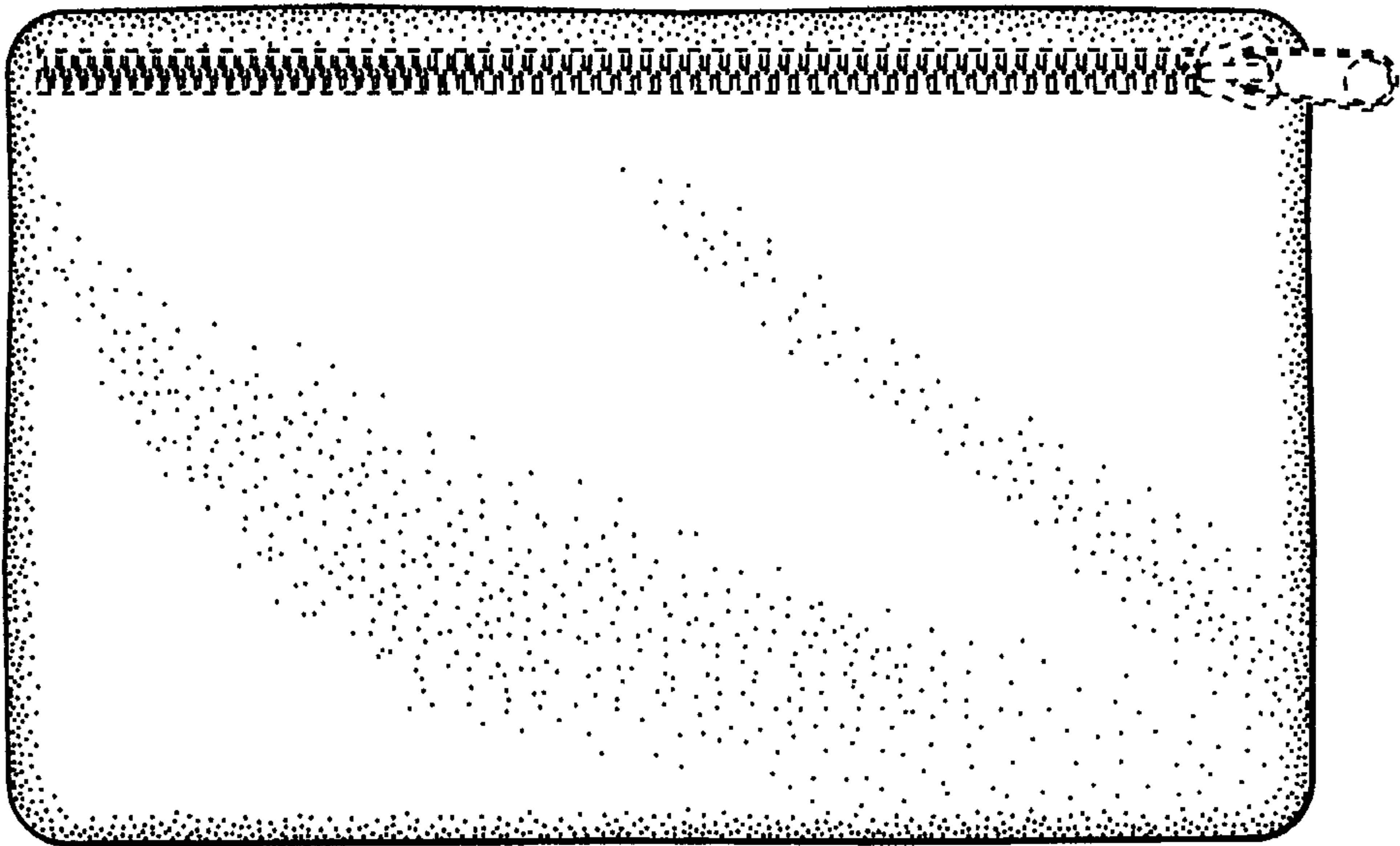

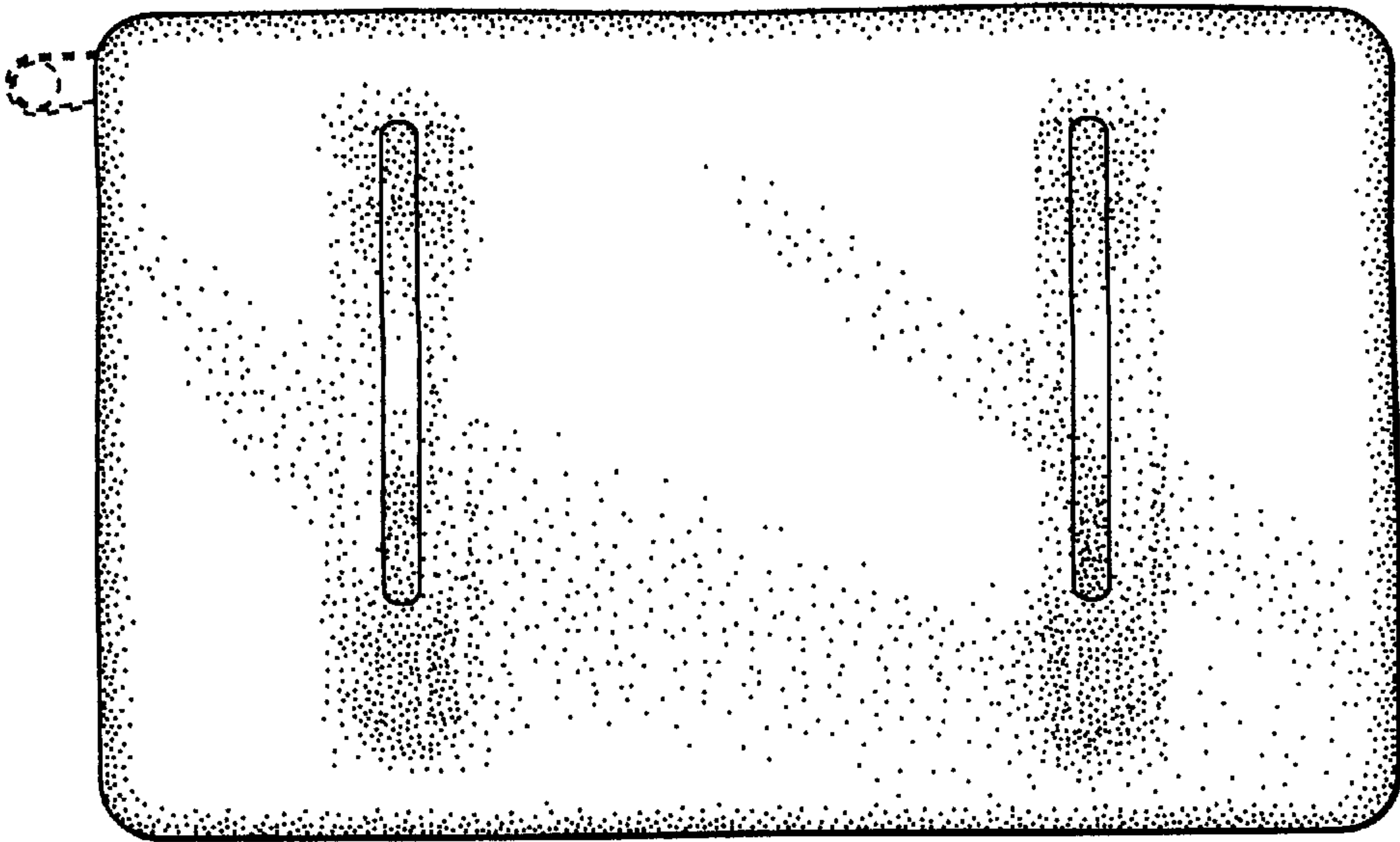

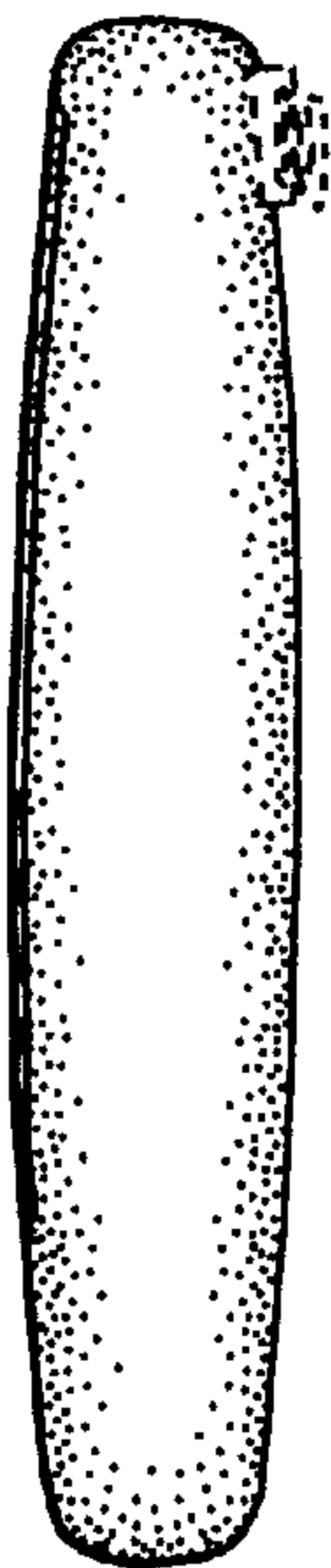

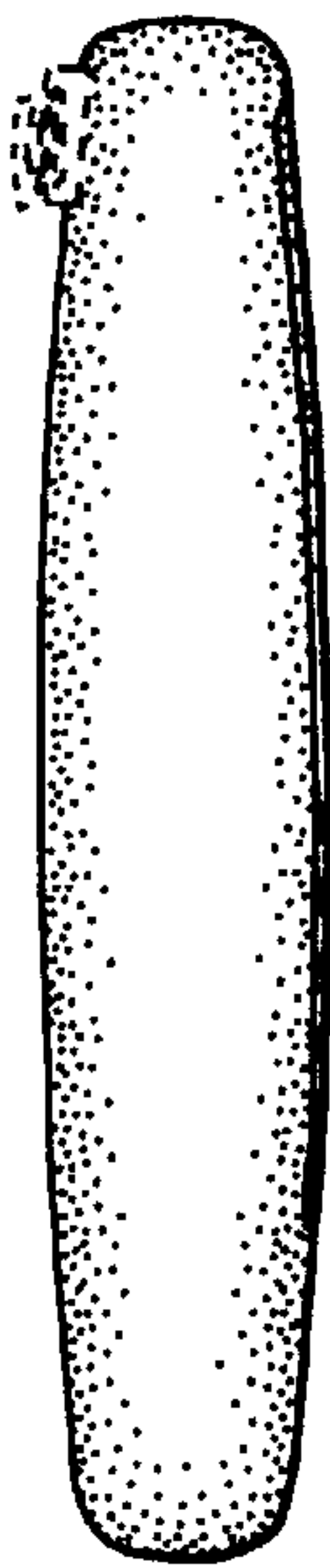

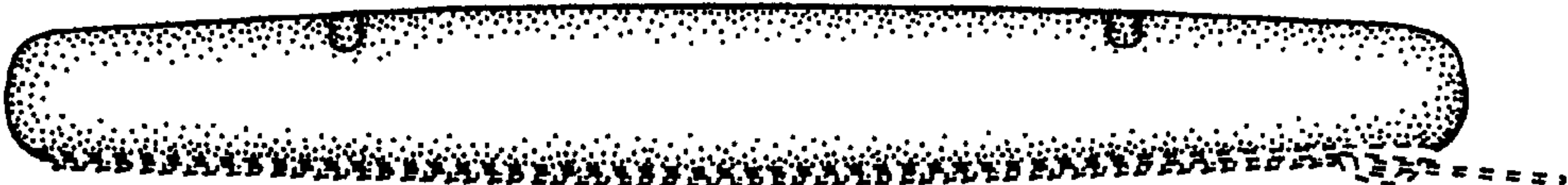

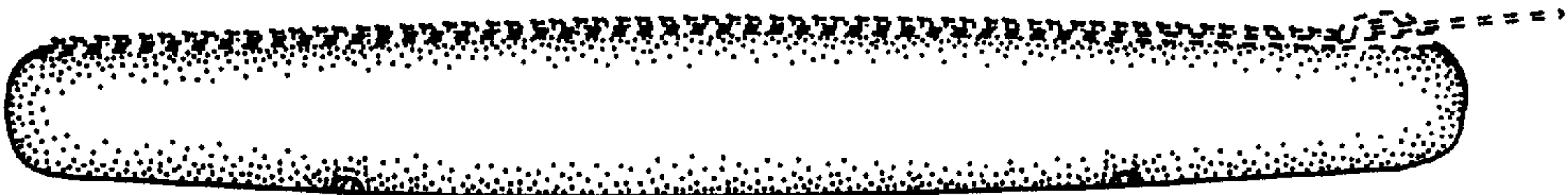

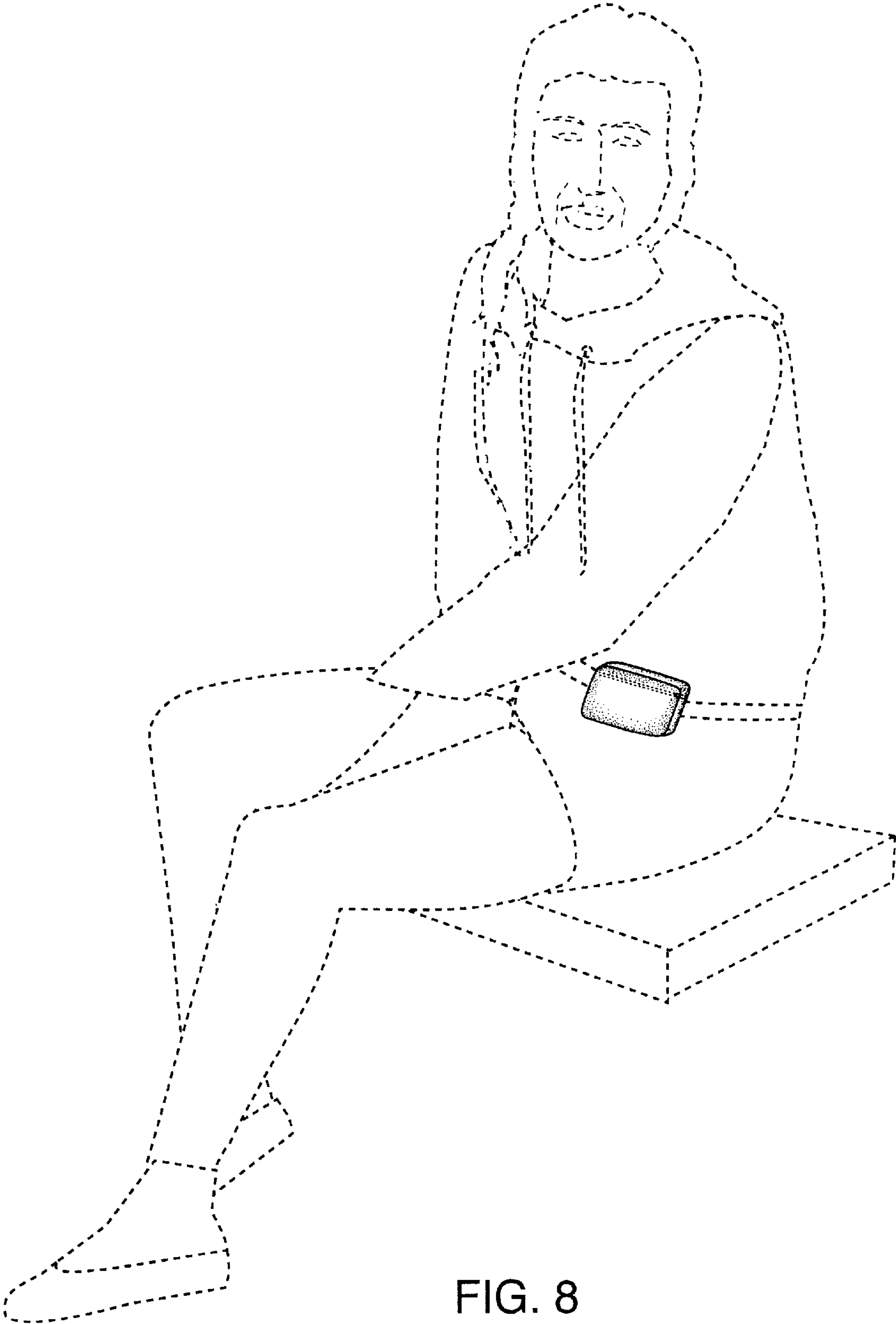

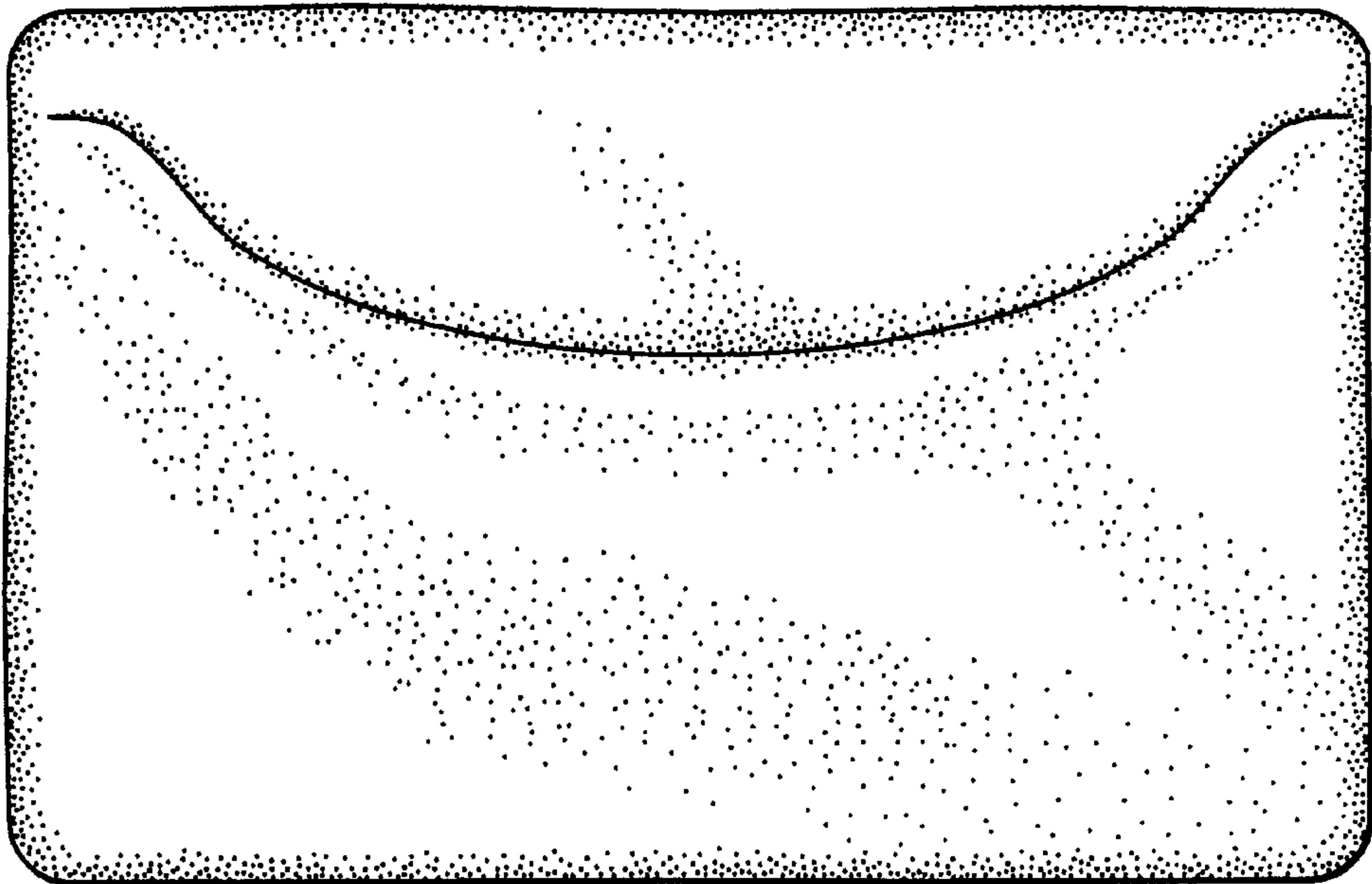
