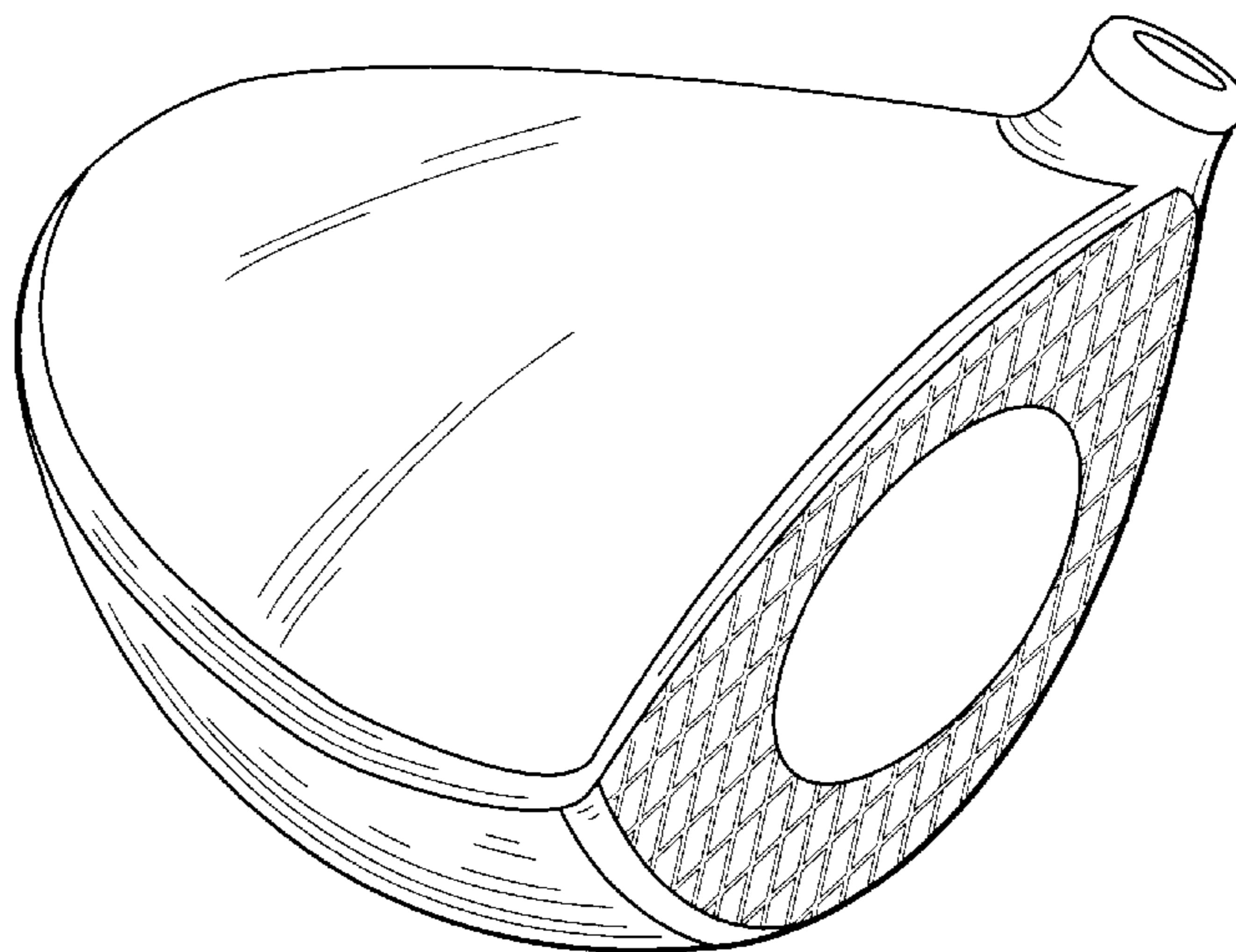
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf club head with dual grid
faceplate groove pattern, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing the top, front and toe
end sides of a golf club head embodying the new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a toe end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a heel end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a perspective showing the top, front and toe end
sides of a golf club head embodying a first alternative of the
new design;
FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of the embodiment of FIG.
8;
FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;
FIG. 11 is a perspective view showing the top, front and toe
end sides of a golf club head embodying a second alternative
of the new design;
FIG. 12 is a front elevation view of the embodiment of FIG.
11;
FIG. 13 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 11;
FIG. 14 is a perspective view showing the top, front and toe
end sides of a golf club head embodying a third alternative
of the new design;
FIG. 15 is a front elevation view of the embodiment of FIG.
14; and,
FIG. 16 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 14.
The toe end, heel end, rear elevation, and bottom plan views
of each of the first, second and third alternative embodi-
ments shown in FIGS. 8-16 are identical to FIGS. 2, 3, 5 and
7, respectively.

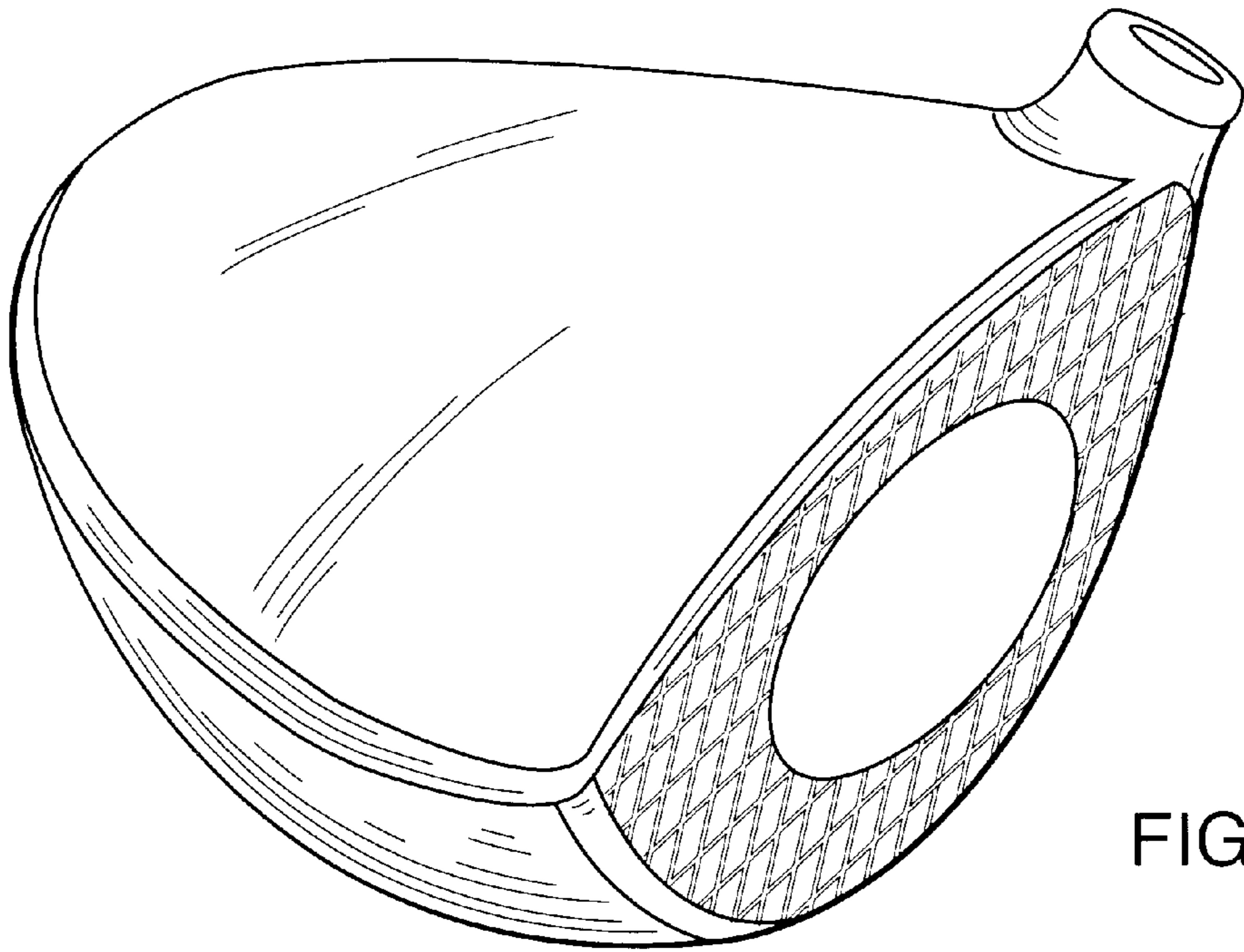

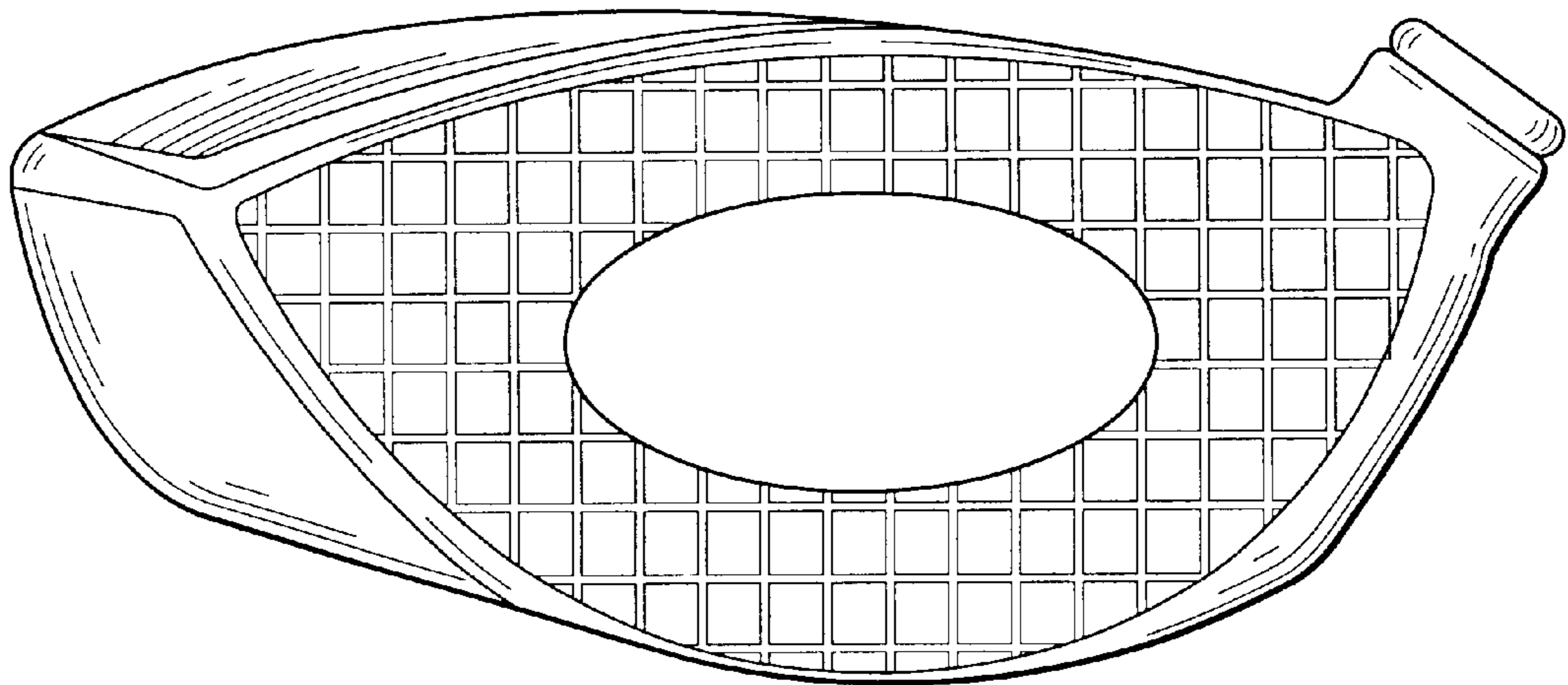

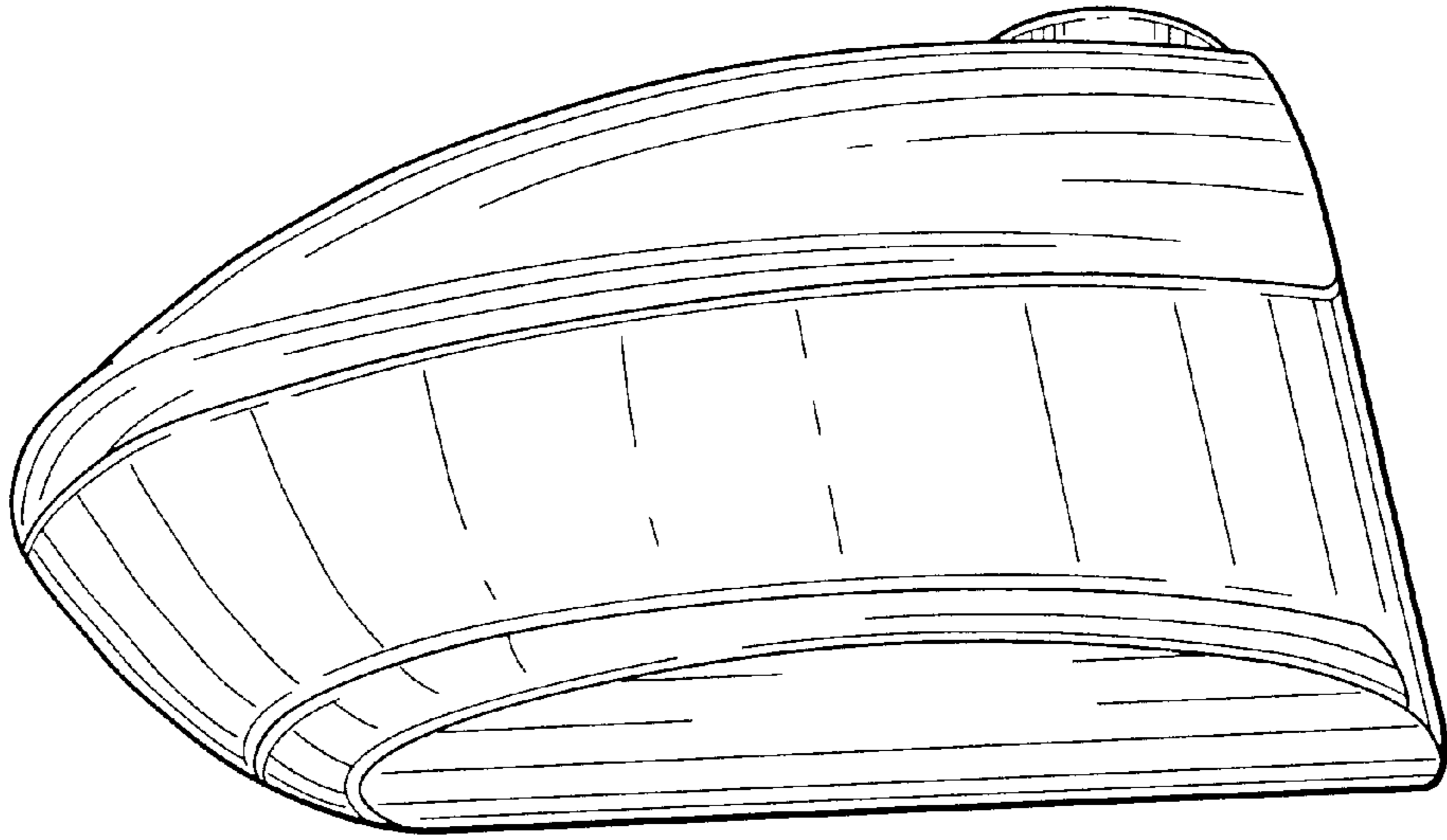

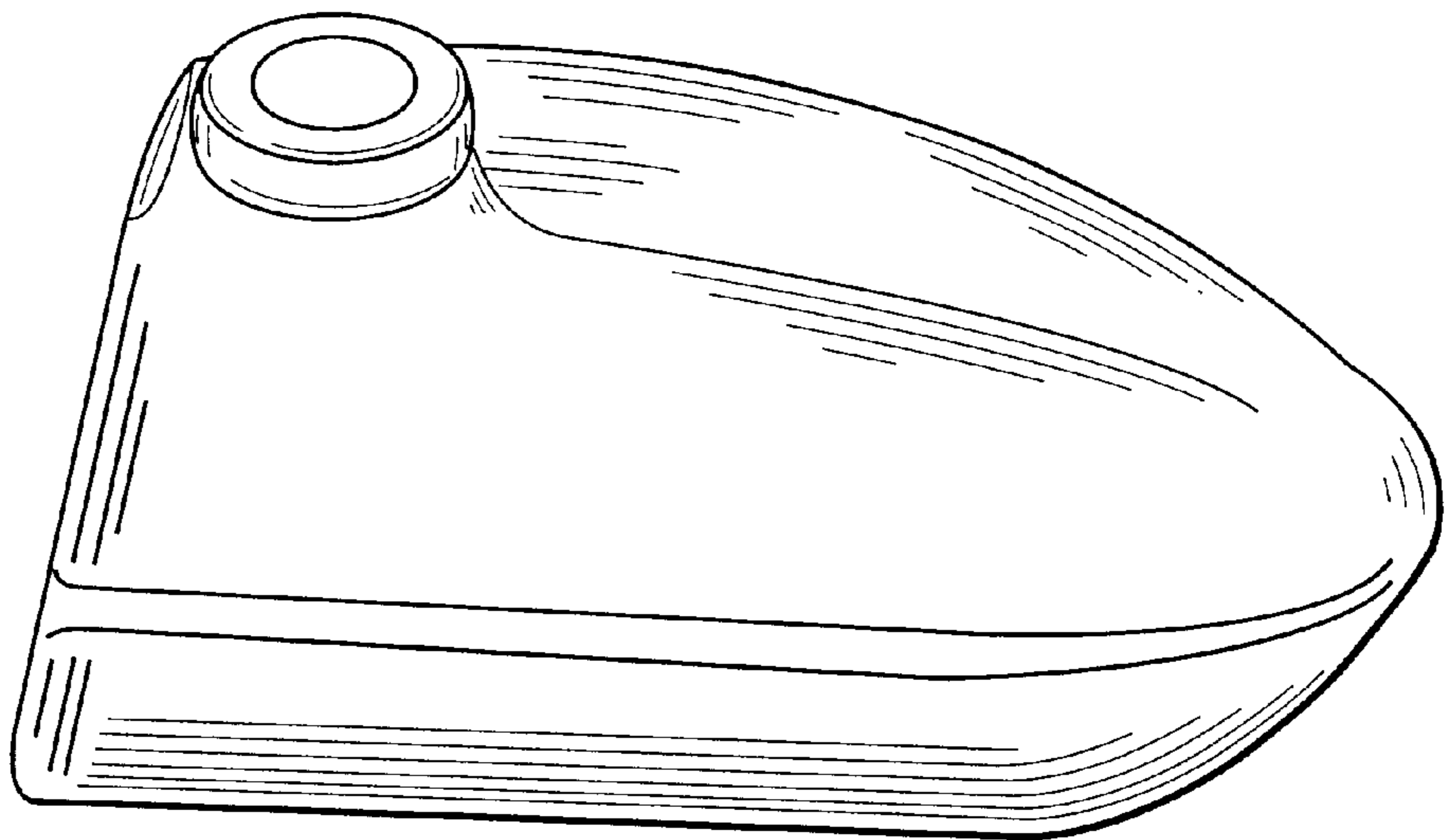

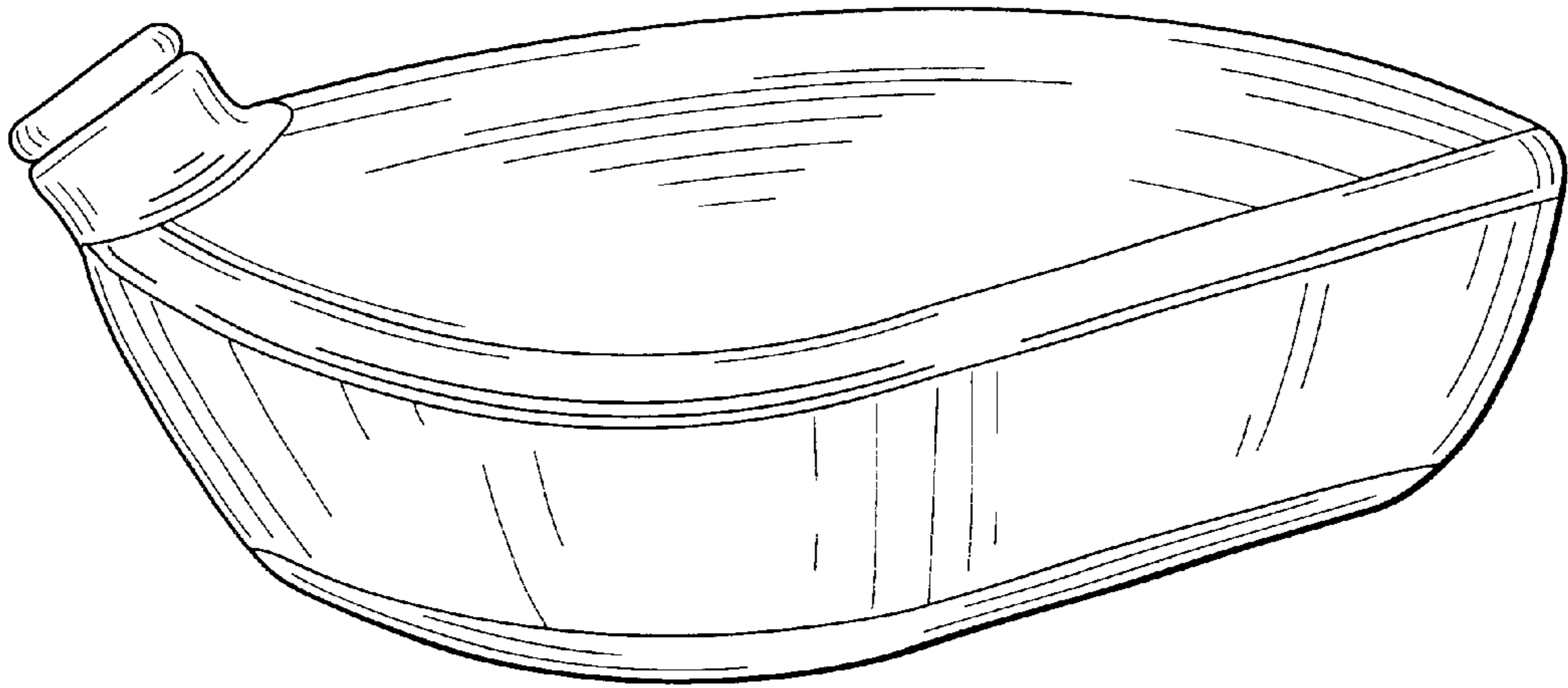

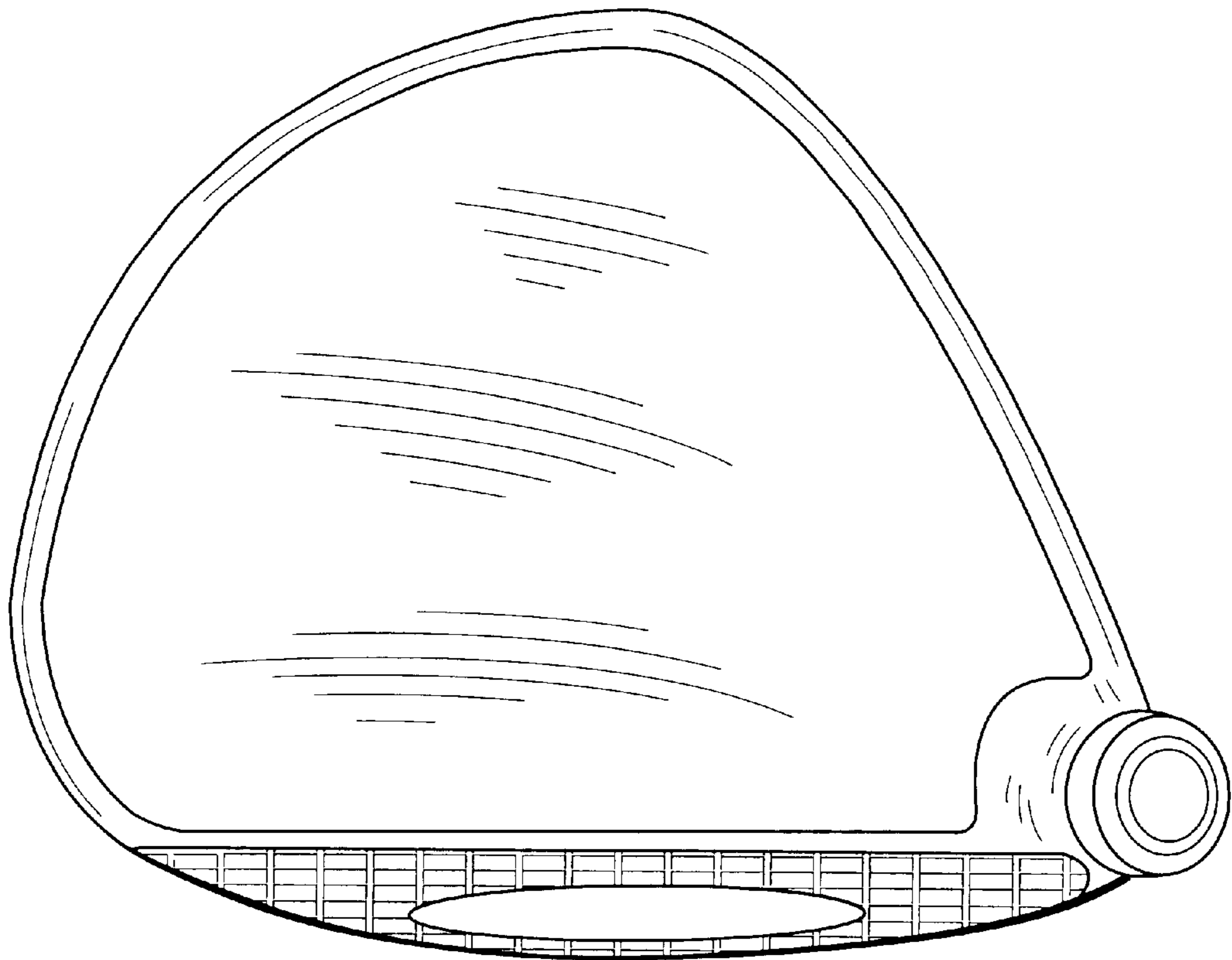

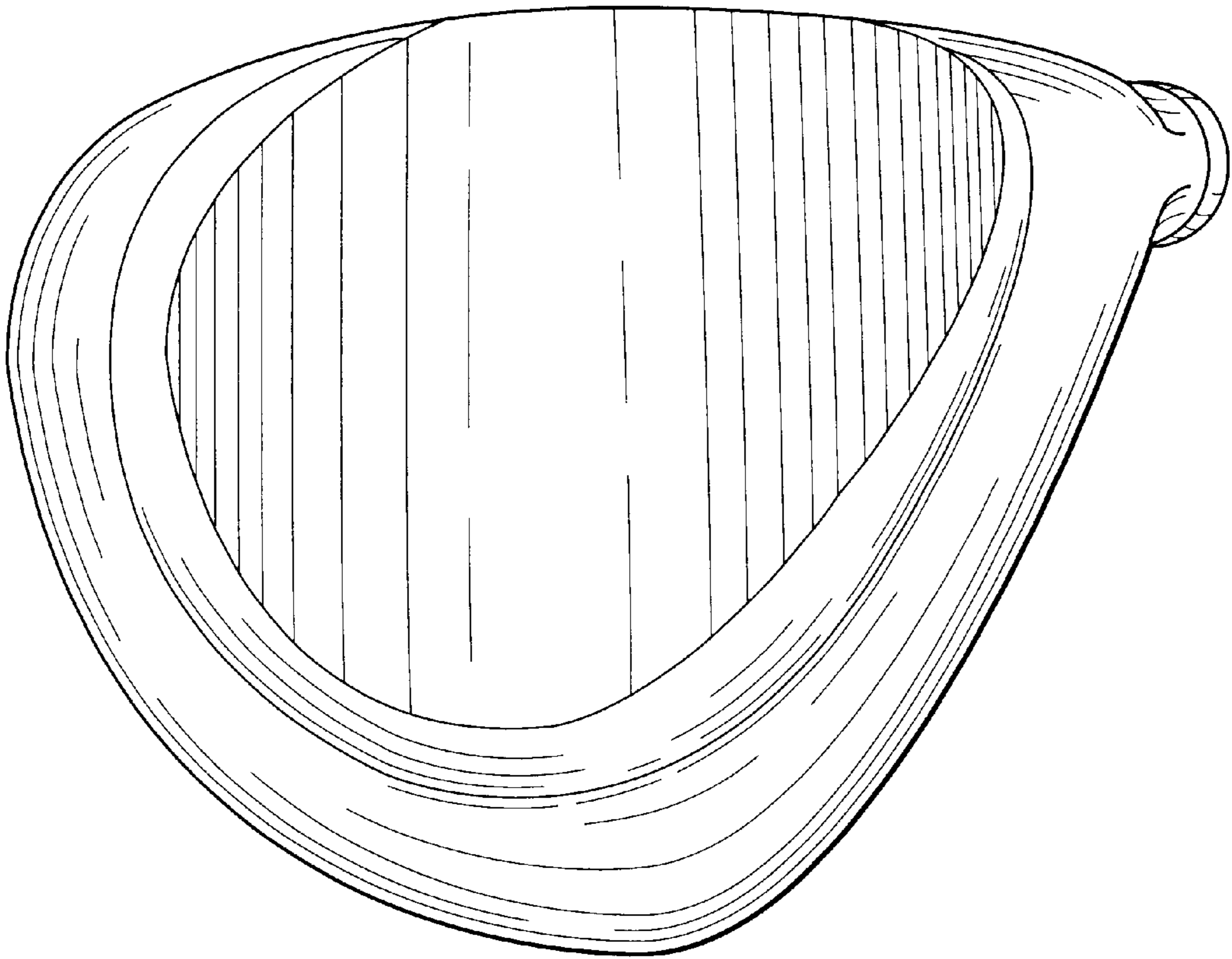

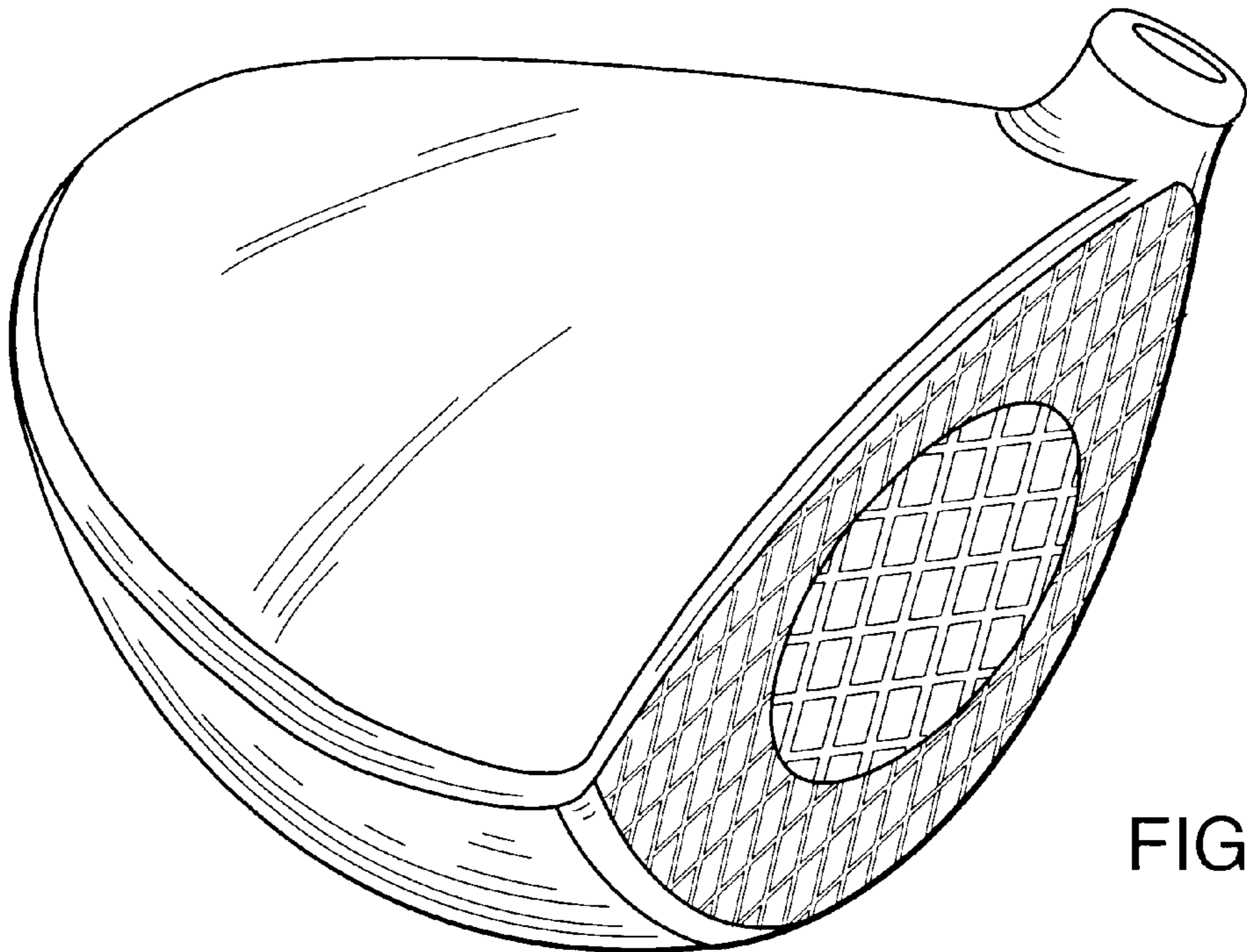

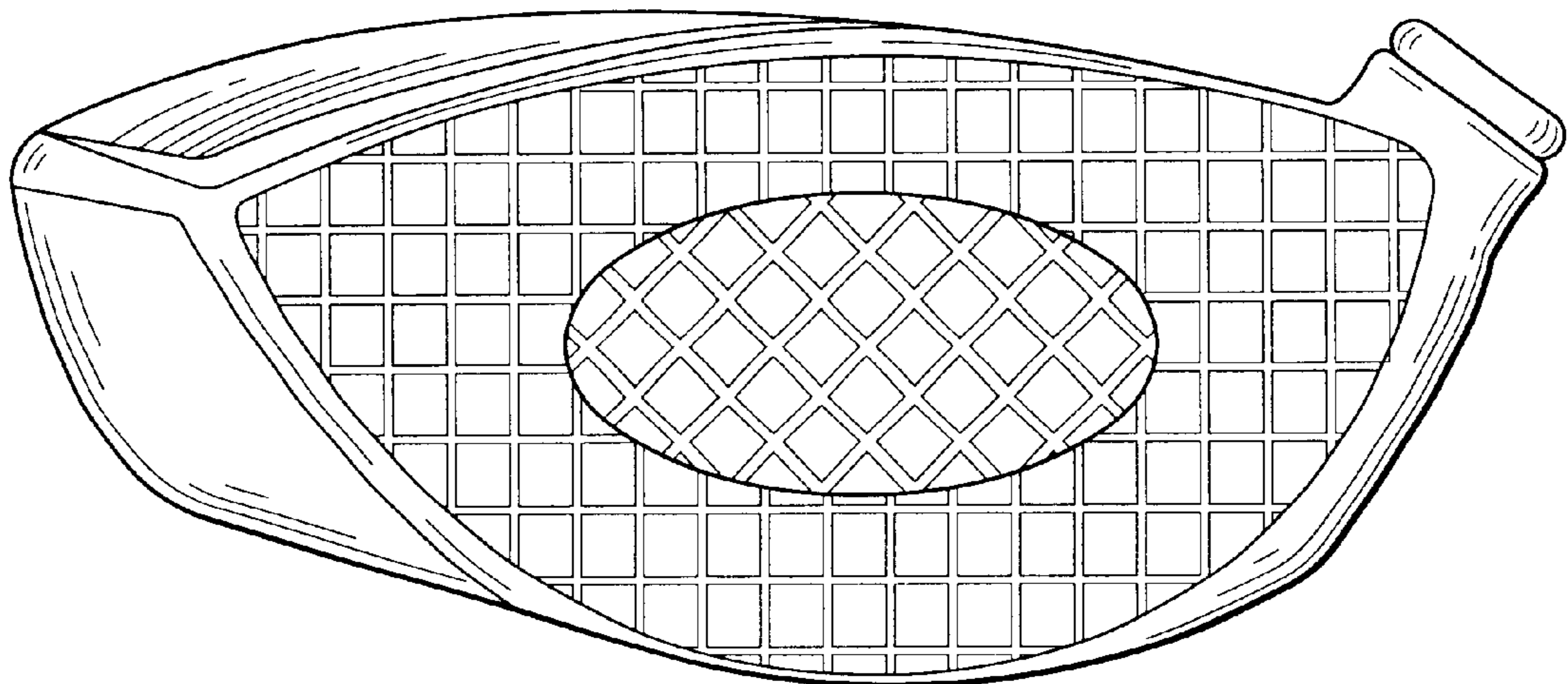

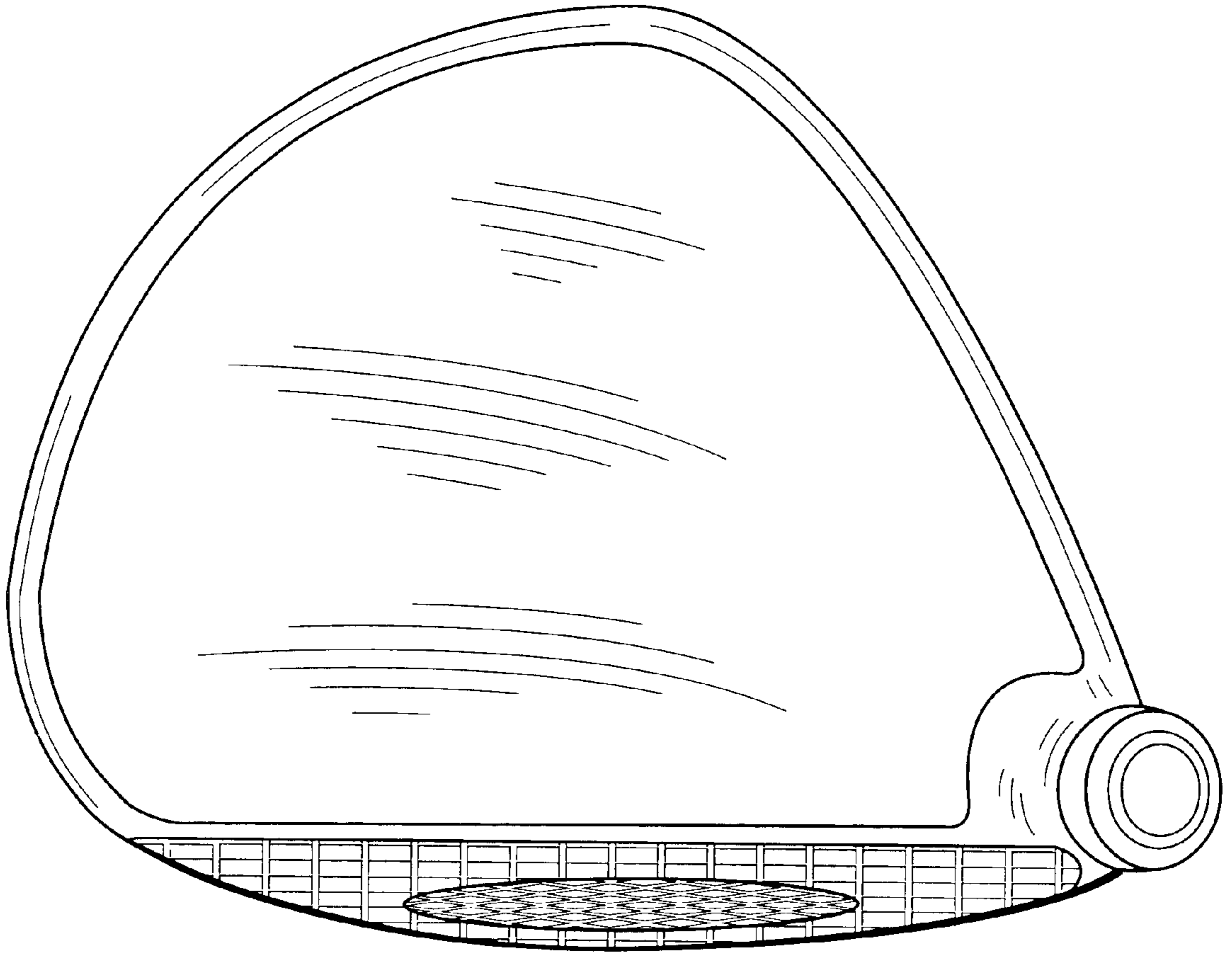

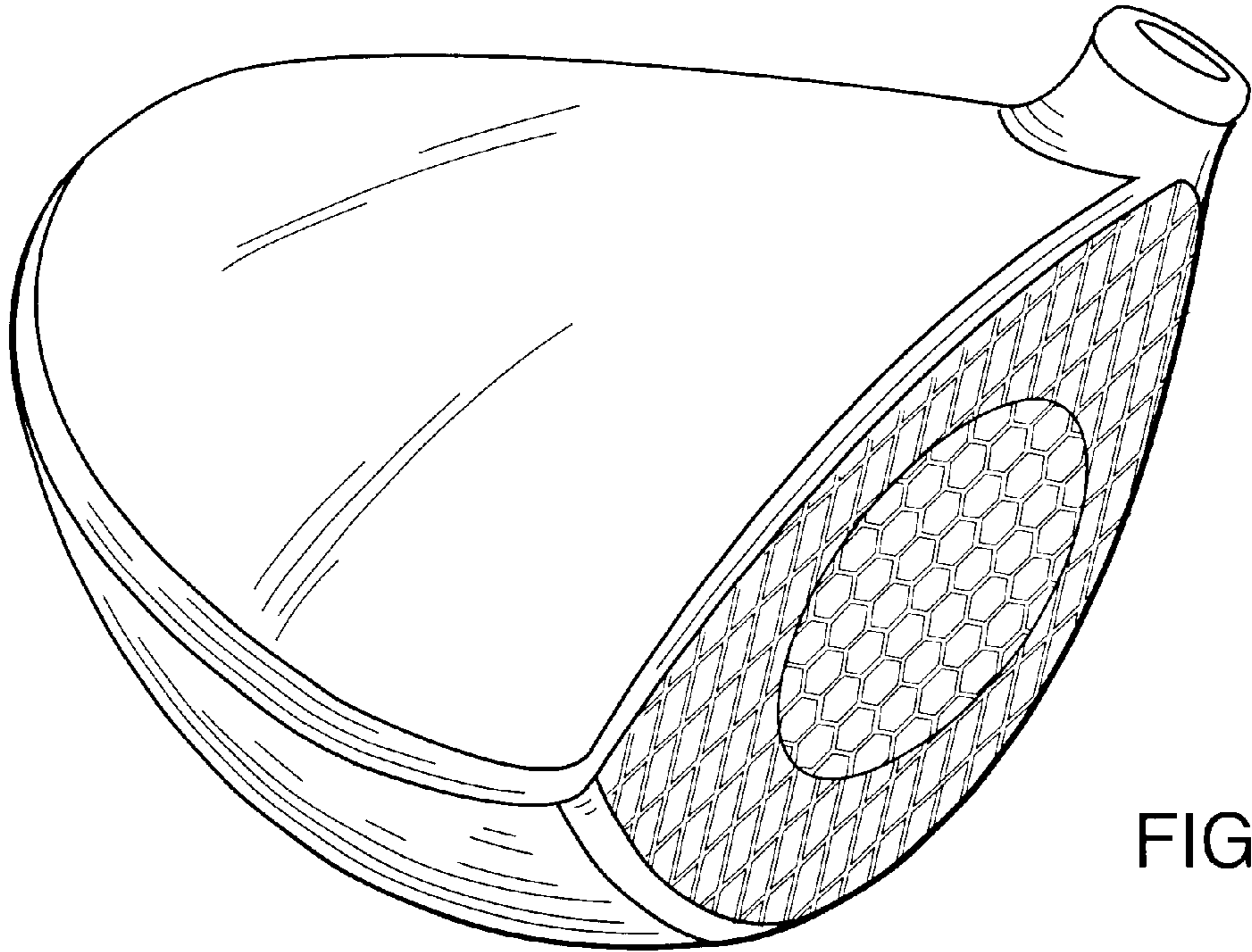

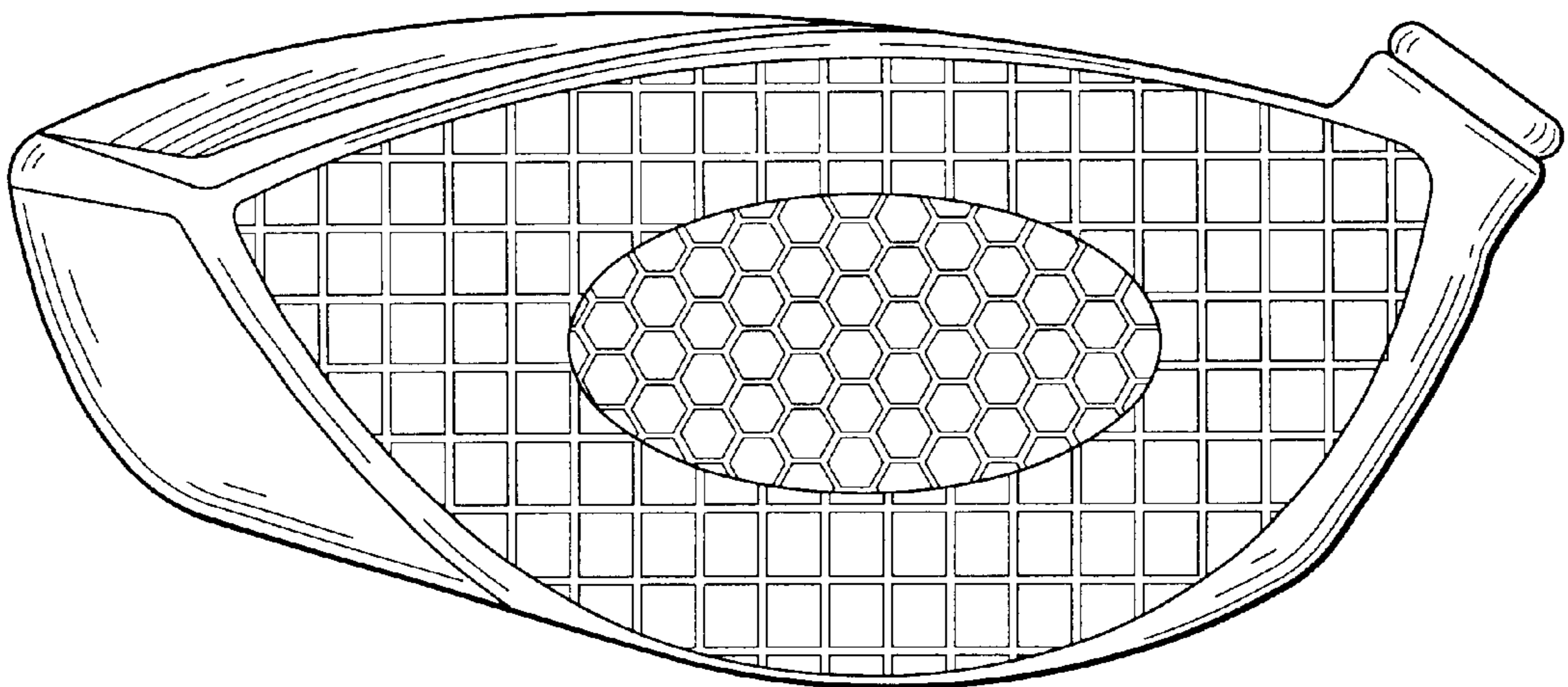

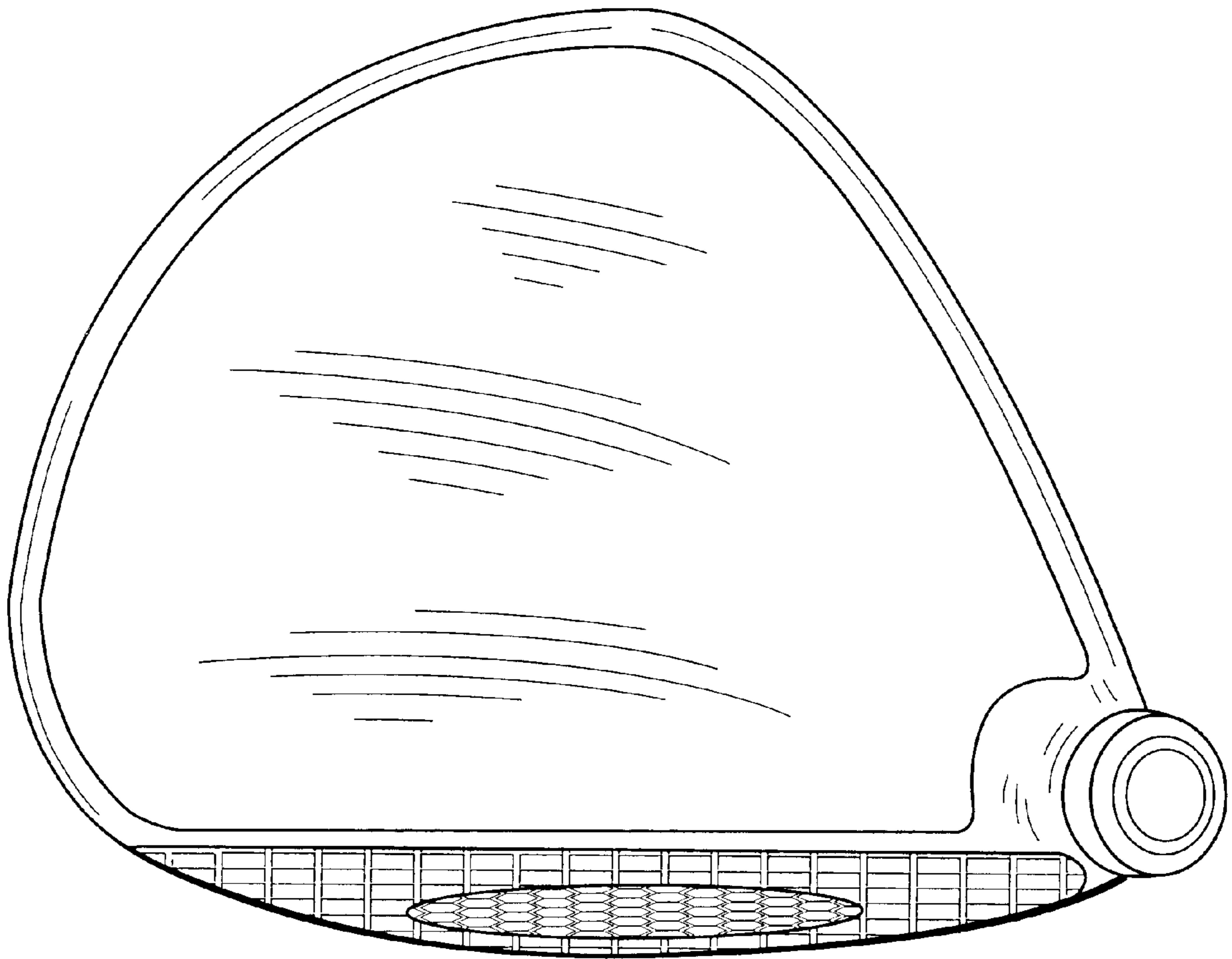

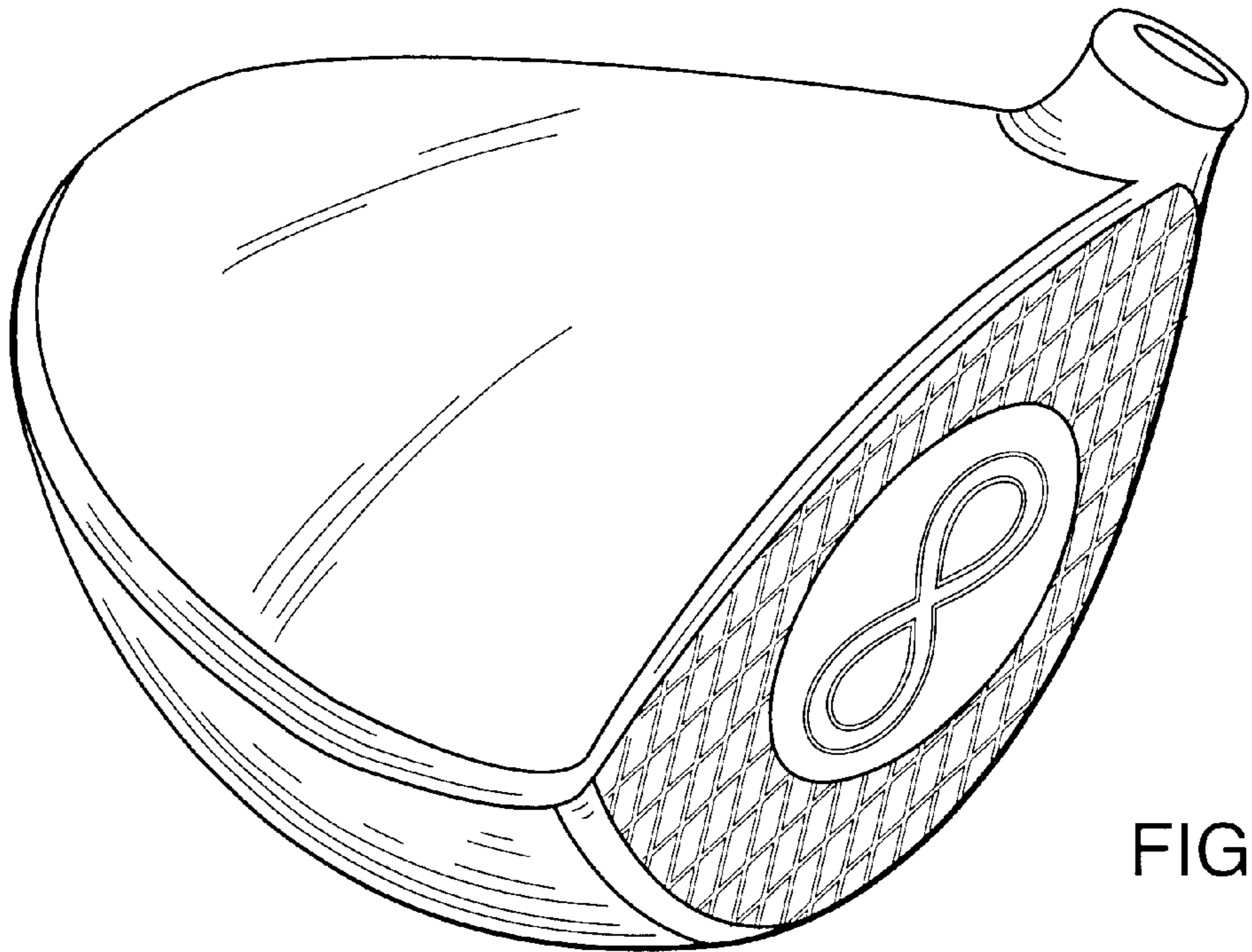

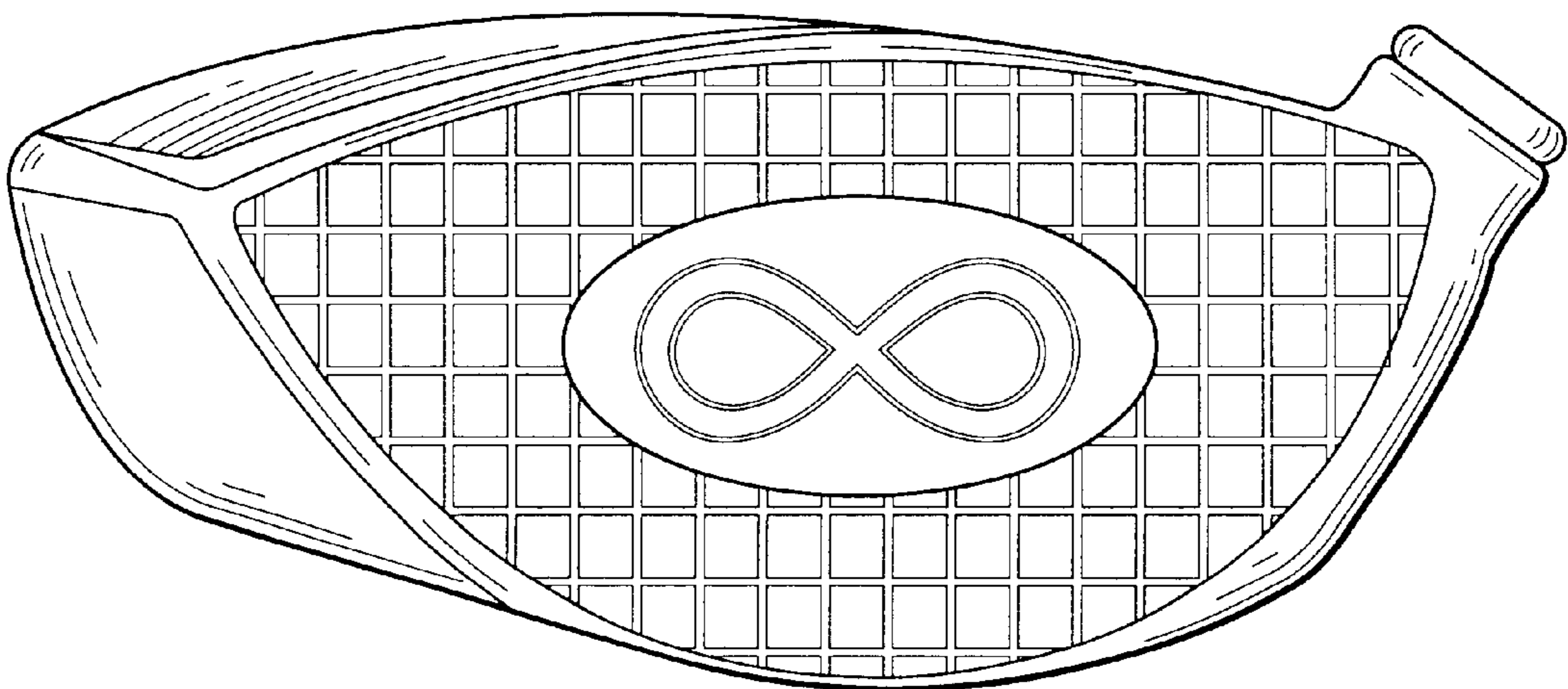

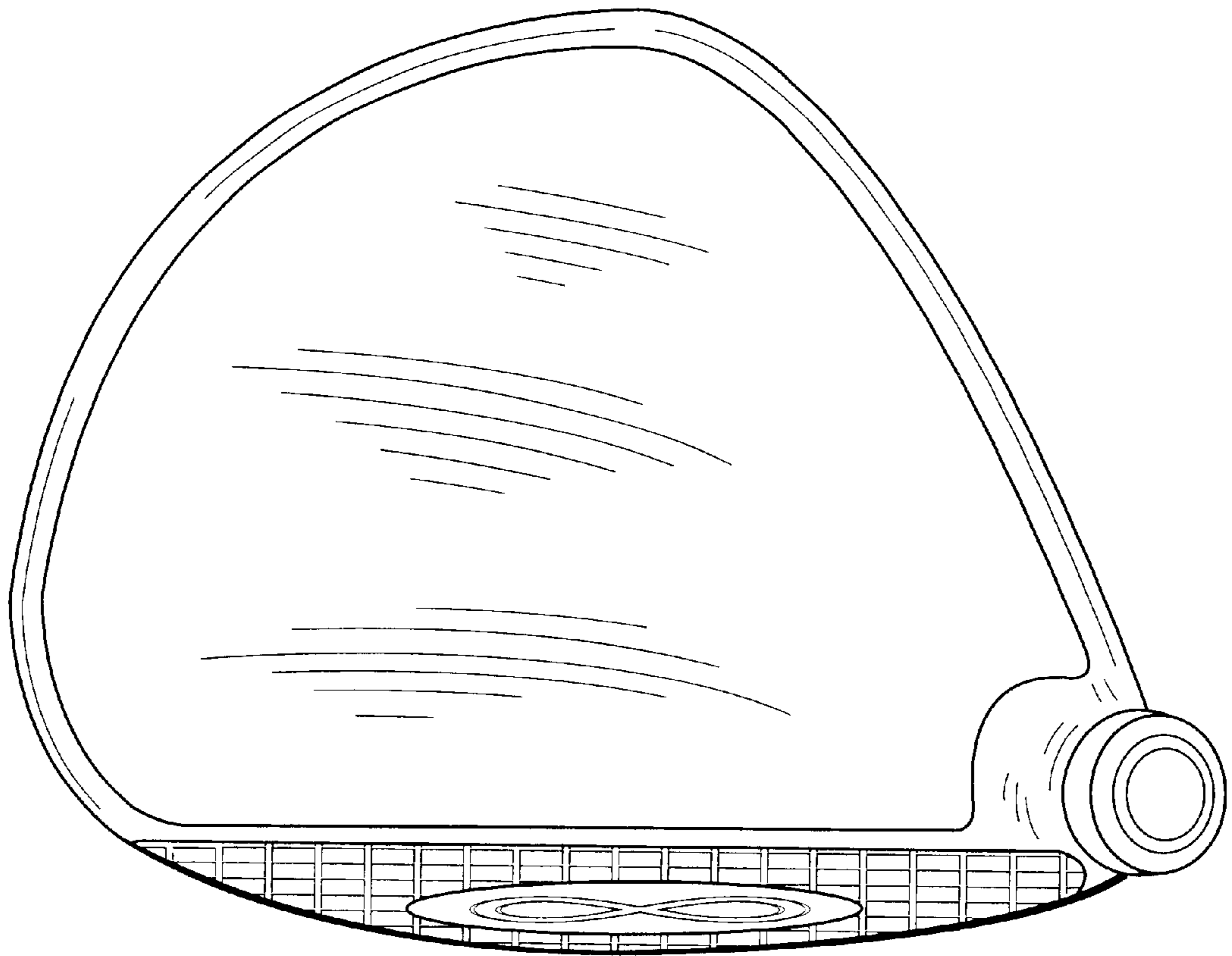
