FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the device shown in FIG. 1.

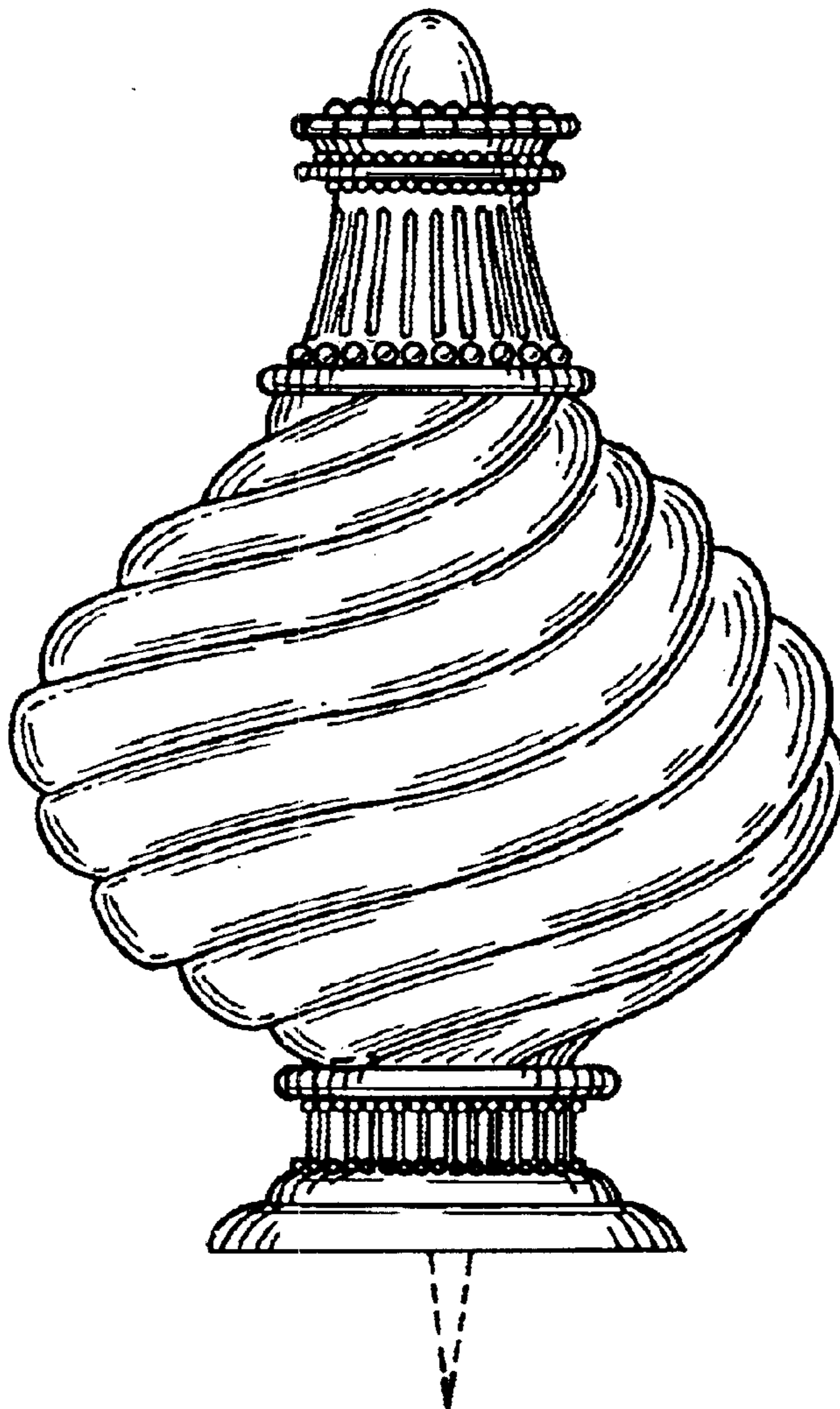

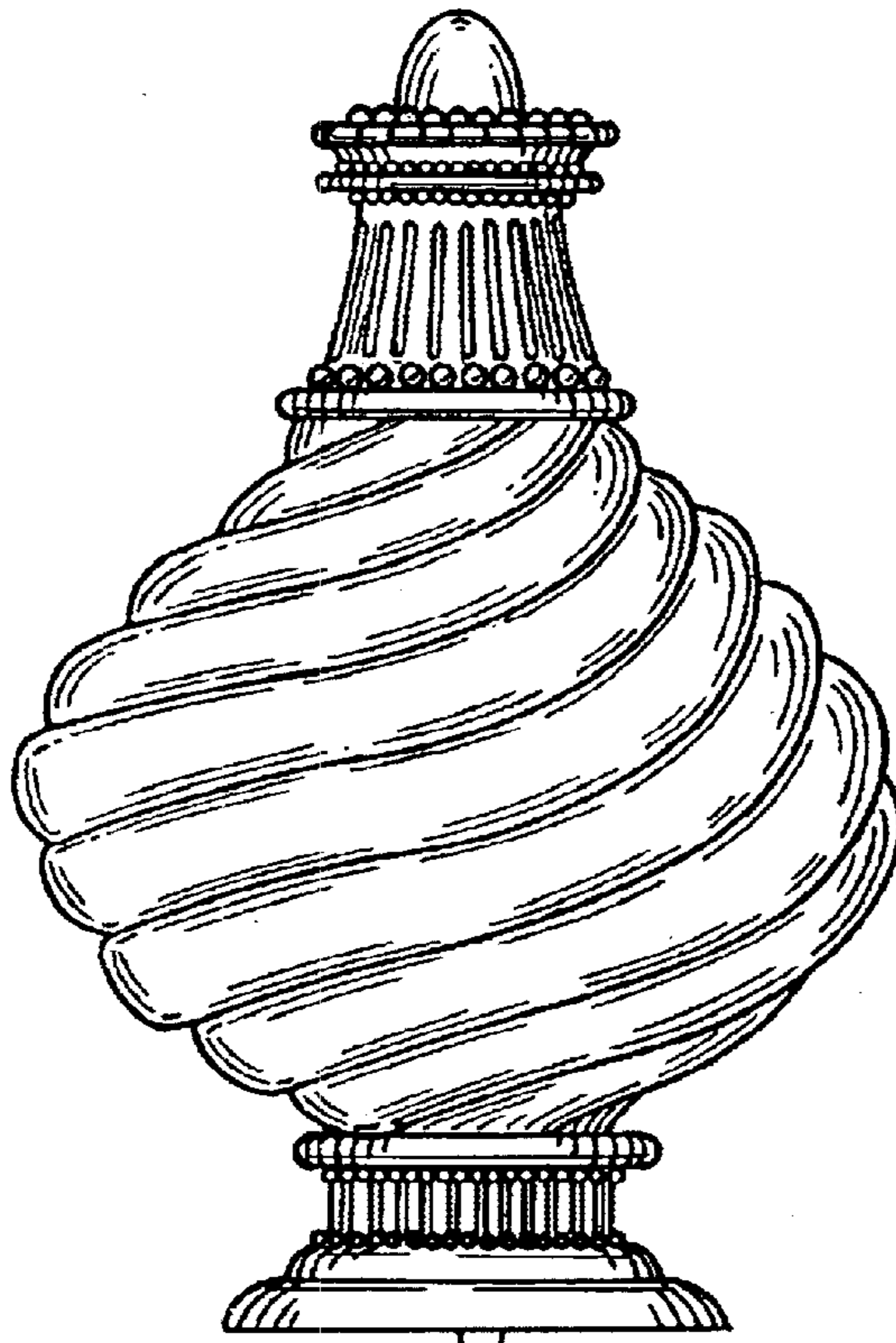

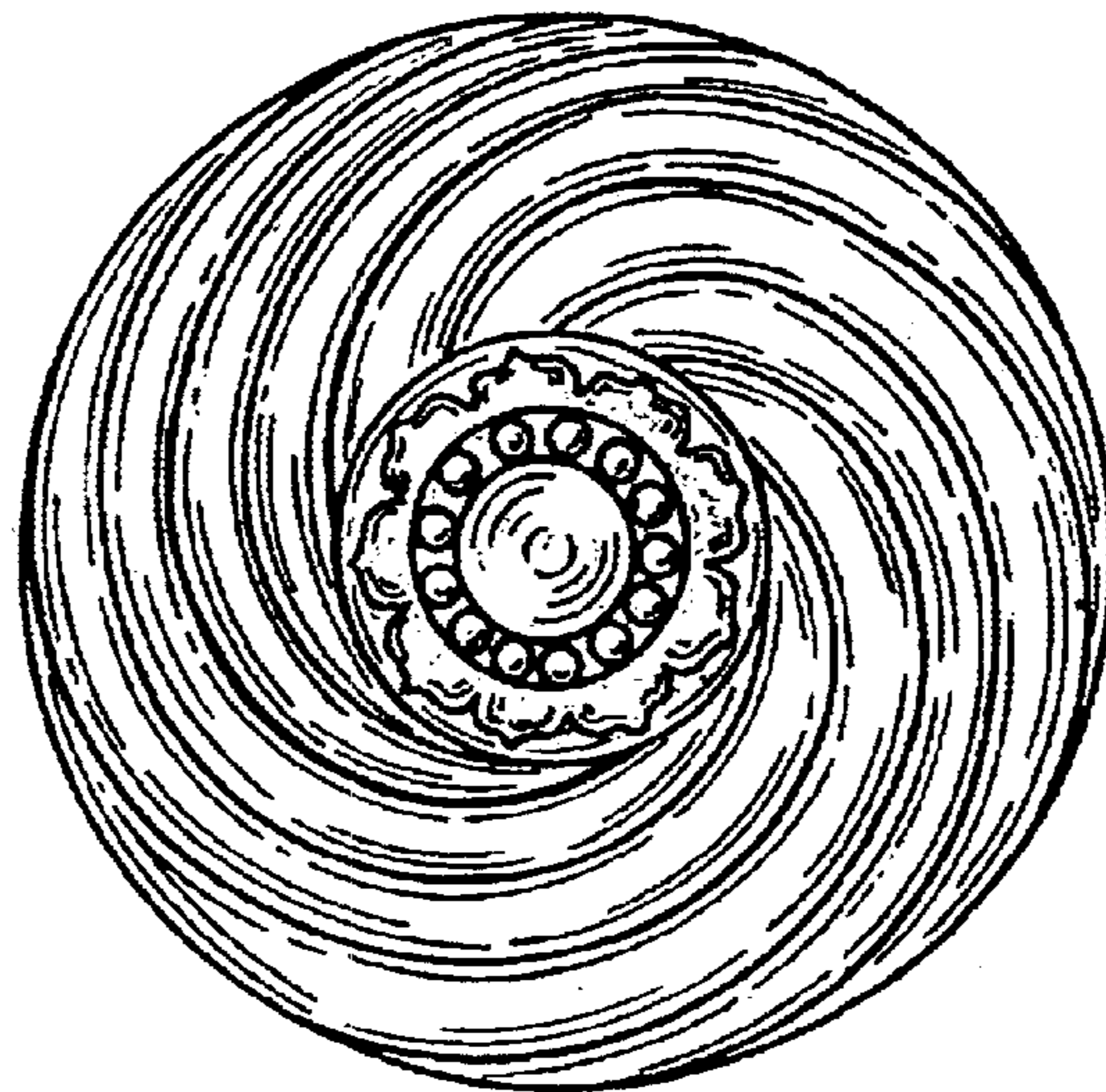

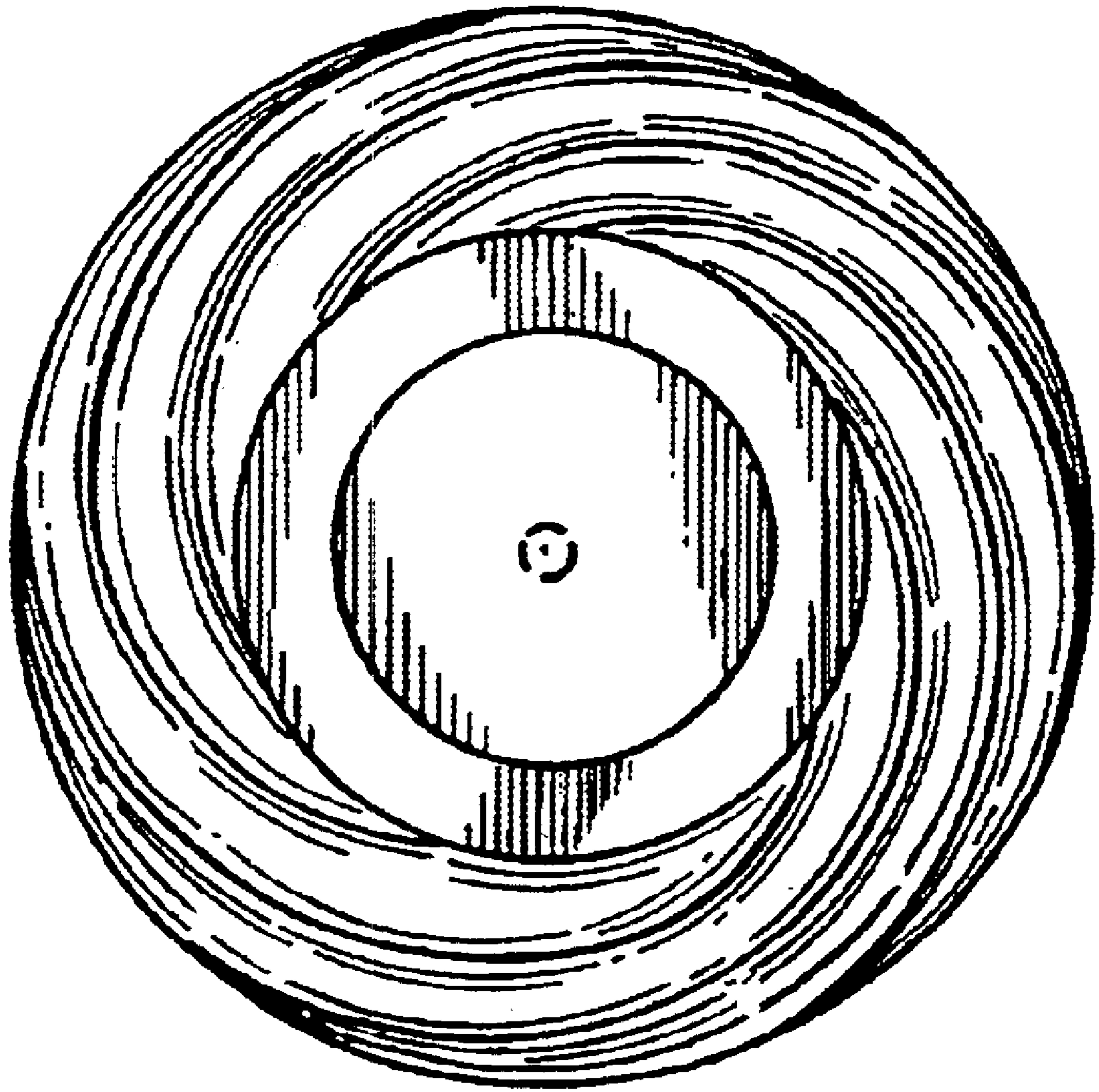
