The ornamental design of selected element of a boat, as shown and described.

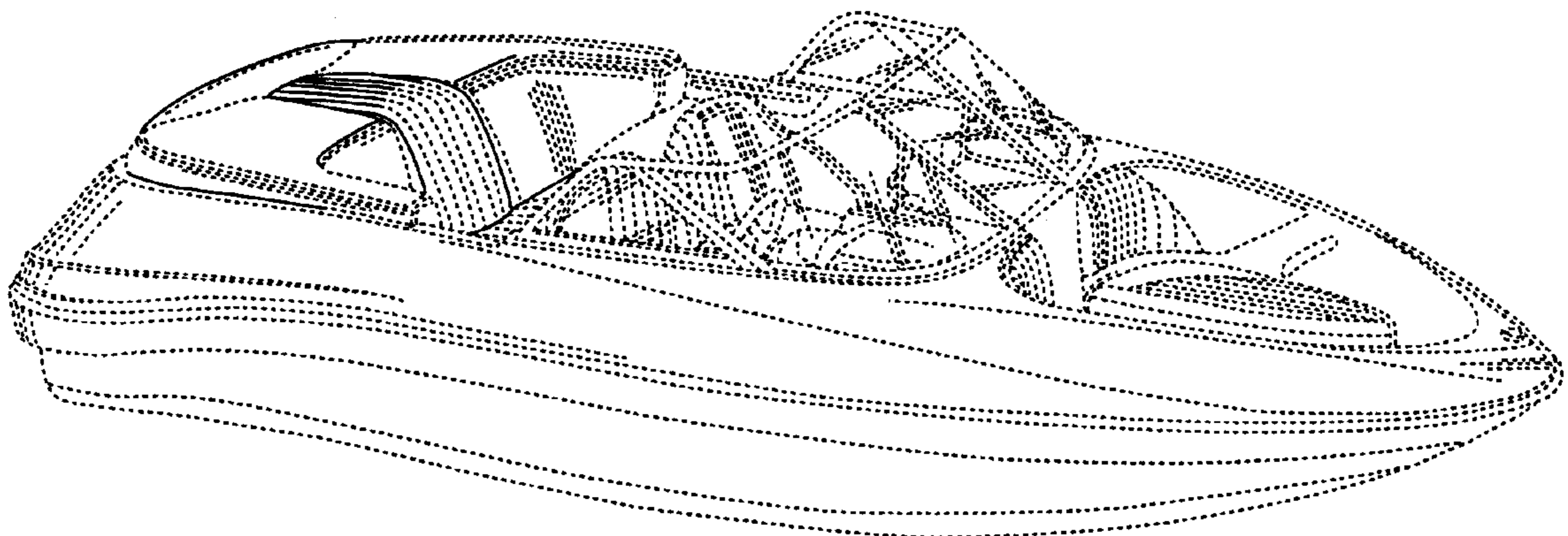
DESCRIPTION

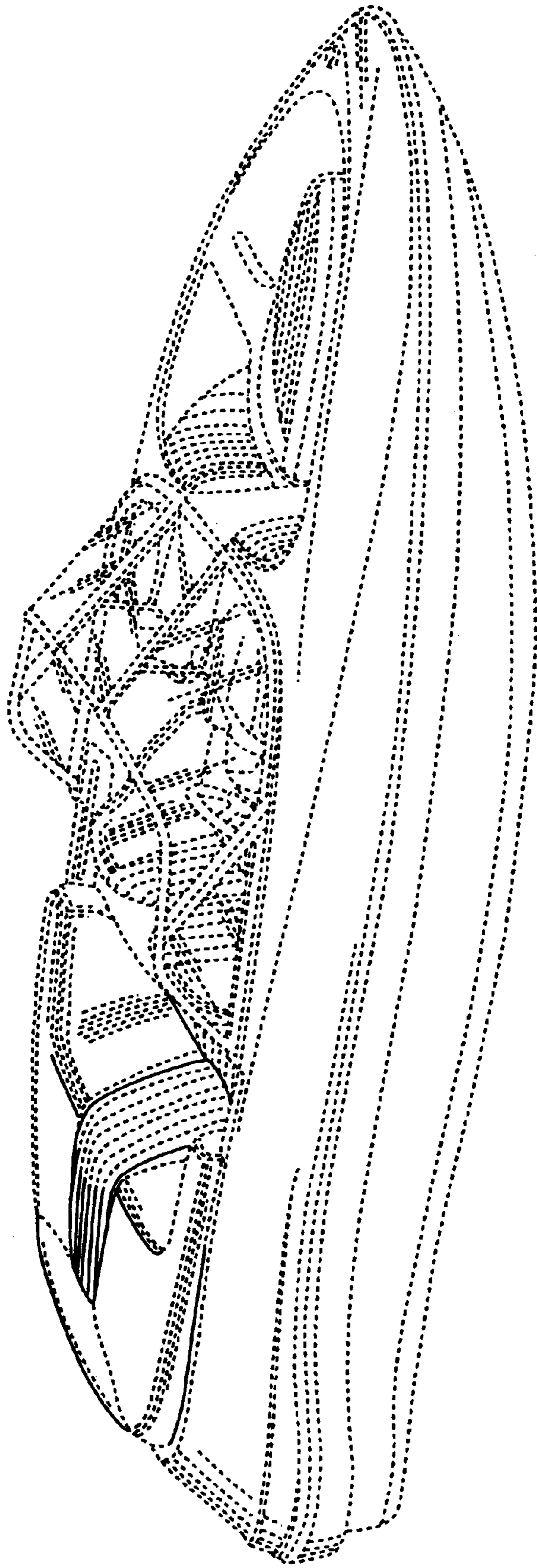

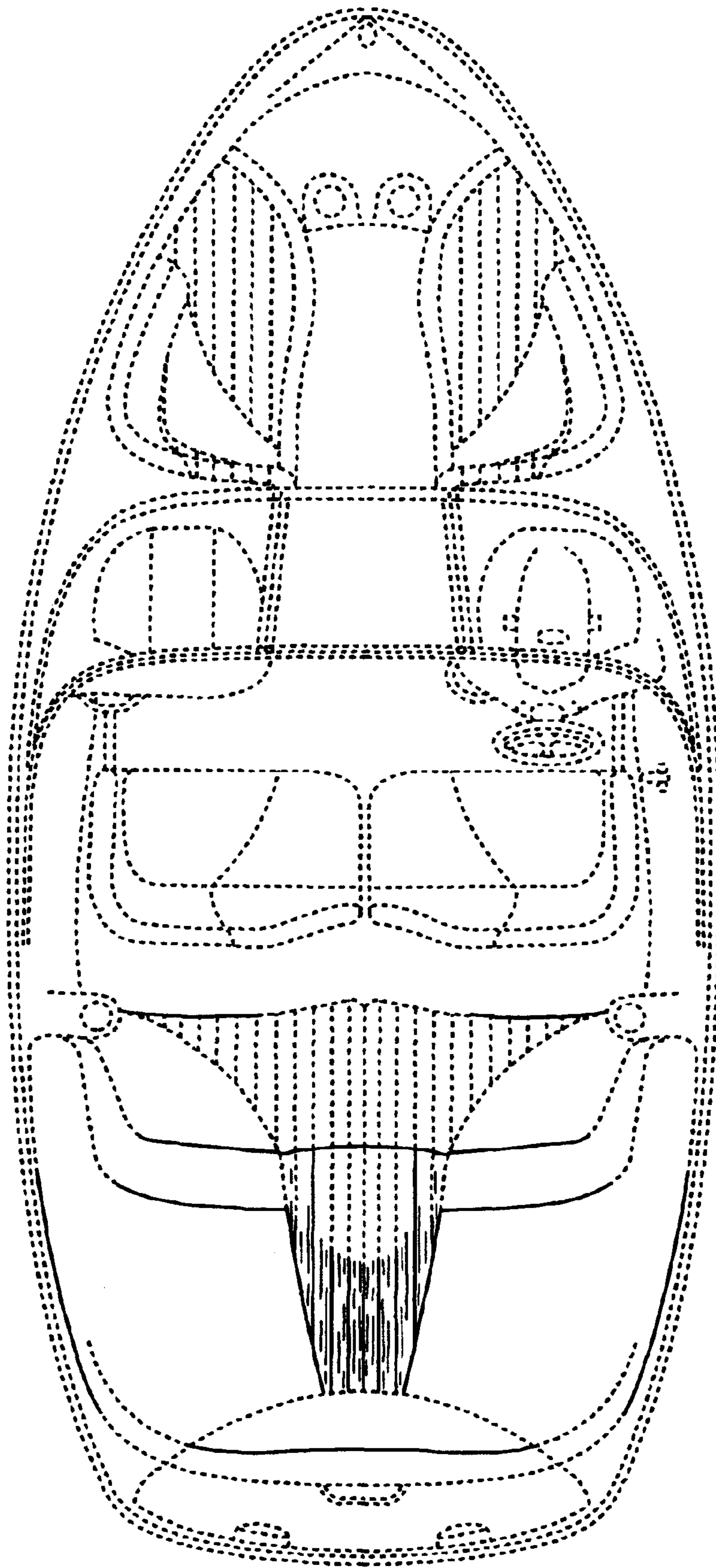
