(57) CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a stake with threadably removable, adhesive coated centerpiece for securing a gift or decoration to a potted plant or floral arrangement, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective exploded view of a stake with threadably removable, adhesive coated centerpiece for securing a gift or decoration to a potted plant or floral arrangement showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a reduced perspective view showing the stake with threadably removable, adhesive coated centerpiece for securing a gift or decoration to a potted plant or floral arrangement in use; the broken lines depict environmental structure for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
