The ornamental design for a furniture nut, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is an enlarged perspective view of a furniture nut in which are visible two of four bores that are equally spaced around the rim.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a furniture nut;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of a furniture nut shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 4 is a vertical sectional view of a furniture nut taken on line 1—1 of FIG. 2.








