(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for an eyeglass clip with photo holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a preferred embodiment of the eyeglass clip with photo holder, with the integral photo holder removed.

FIG. 2 is a top view of a preferred embodiment of the photo holder portion of the eyeglass clip with photo holder;

FIG. 3 is a top view of a preferred embodiment of the eyeglass clip with photo holder, in the closed position, with the integral photo holder installed.

FIG. 4 is a side view of a preferred embodiment of the eyeglass clip with photo holder, with the integral photo holder attached and in a pivoted open position.

FIG. 5 is a side view of a preferred embodiment of the eyeglass clip with photo holder, with the integral photo holder attached and in the closed position; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of a preferred embodiment of the eyeglass clip with photo holder.


FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the eyeglass clip with photo holder, in the closed position—the broken line showing of environment being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 8 is a top view of an alternative preferred embodiment of the eyeglass clip with photo holder, designed to hold a sliding top cover.

FIG. 9 is a top view of an alternative preferred embodiment of a sliding top cover for the eyeglass clip with photo holder. FIG. 10 is a top view of an alternative preferred embodiment of the eyeglass clip with photo holder, with a sliding top cover installed; and,

FIG. 11 is a perspective view of the eyeglass clip with photo holder, with a sliding top cover in the closed position—the broken line showing of environment being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design. The broken line showing of environment is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

















