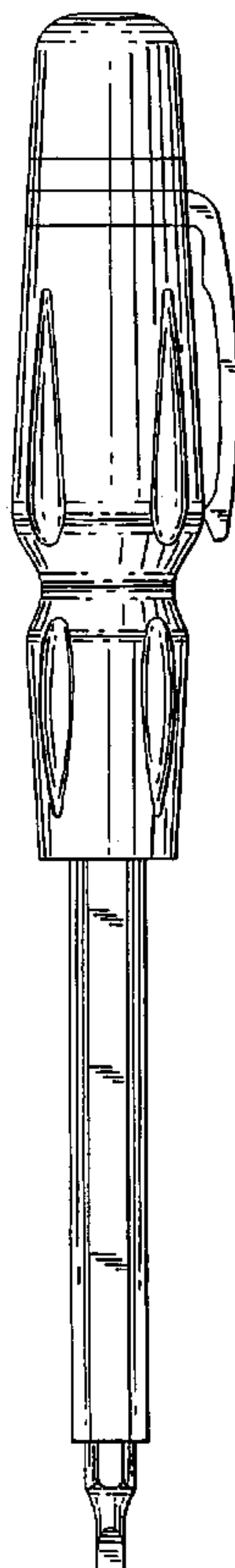
FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of the precision hand tool;

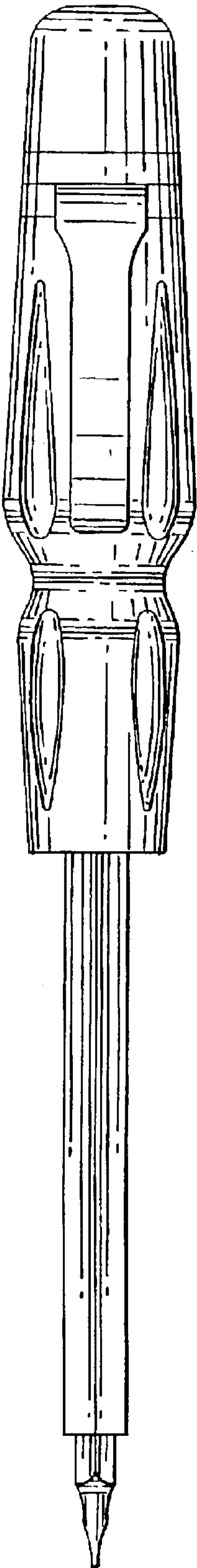

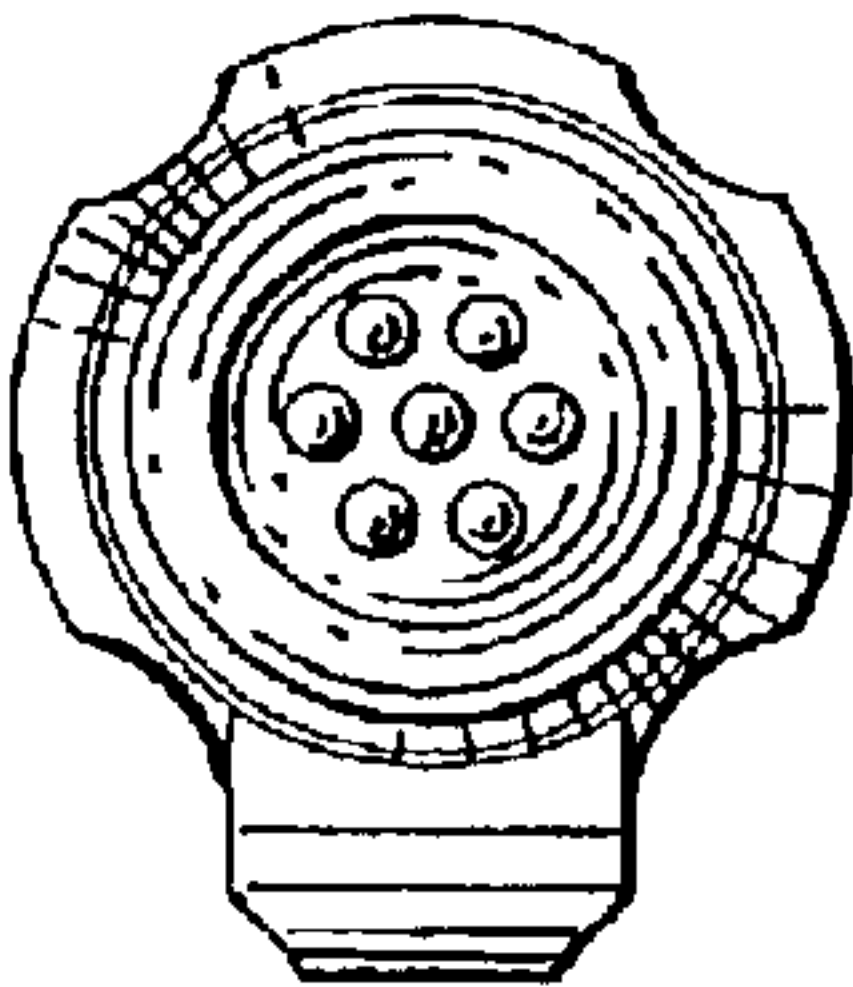

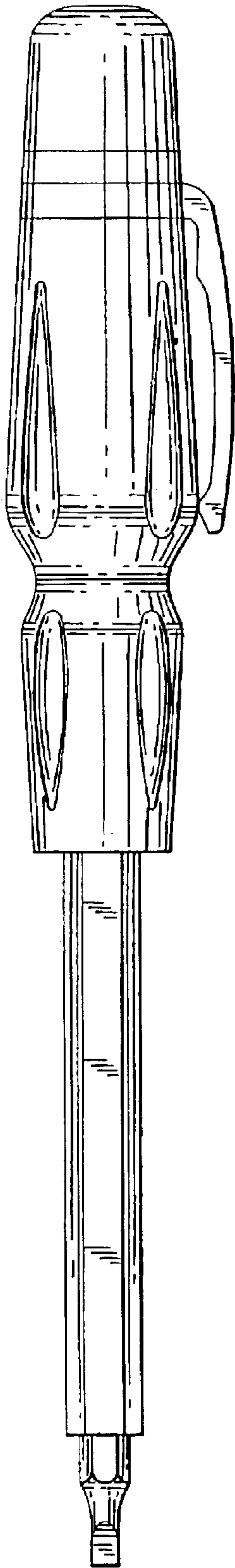

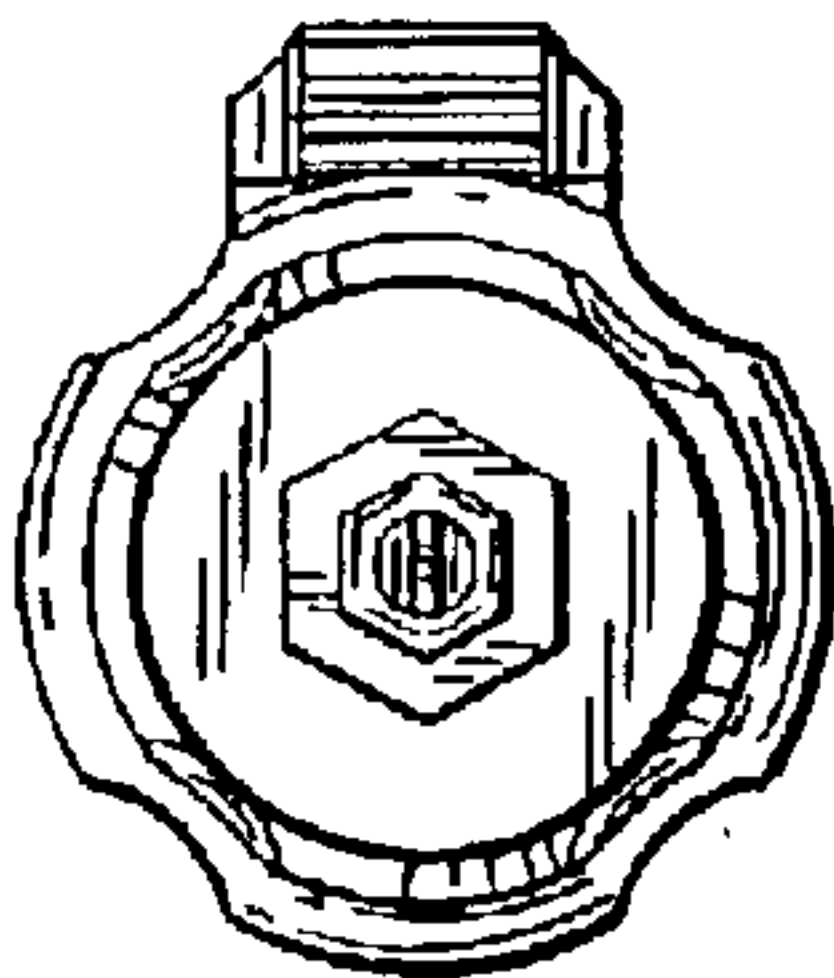

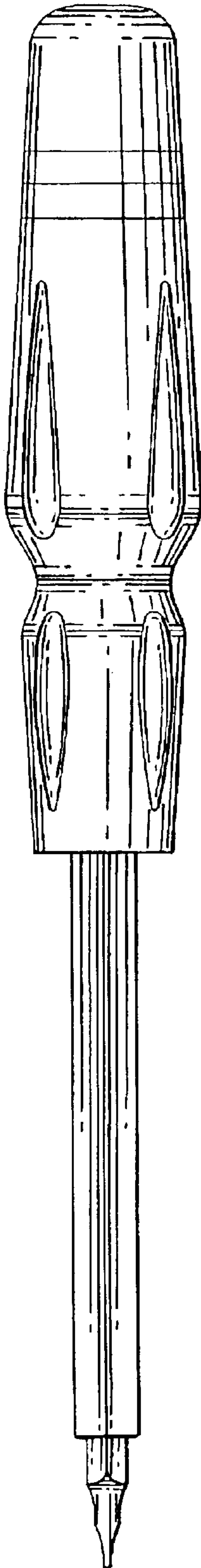
