(57)**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined coin bank and snack food container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined coin bank and snack food container in accordance with my design;
- FIG. 2 is a front view of the combined coin bank and snack food container of FIG. 1;
- FIG. 3 is a right side view of the combined coin bank and snack food container of FIG. 1;
- FIG. 4 is a back view of the combined coin back and snack food container of FIG. 1;
- FIG. 5 is a top view of the combined coin bank and snack food container of FIG. 1;
- FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the combined coin bank and snack food container of FIG. 1; and,
- FIG. 7 is a top view of the base of the coin bank and combined snack food container of FIG. 1, with the ball, that is removable from the base, removed.












