(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for shoe liner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a left shoe liner showing my new design, the bottom plan view being a mirror image;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a right shoe liner, the bottom plan view being a mirror image;

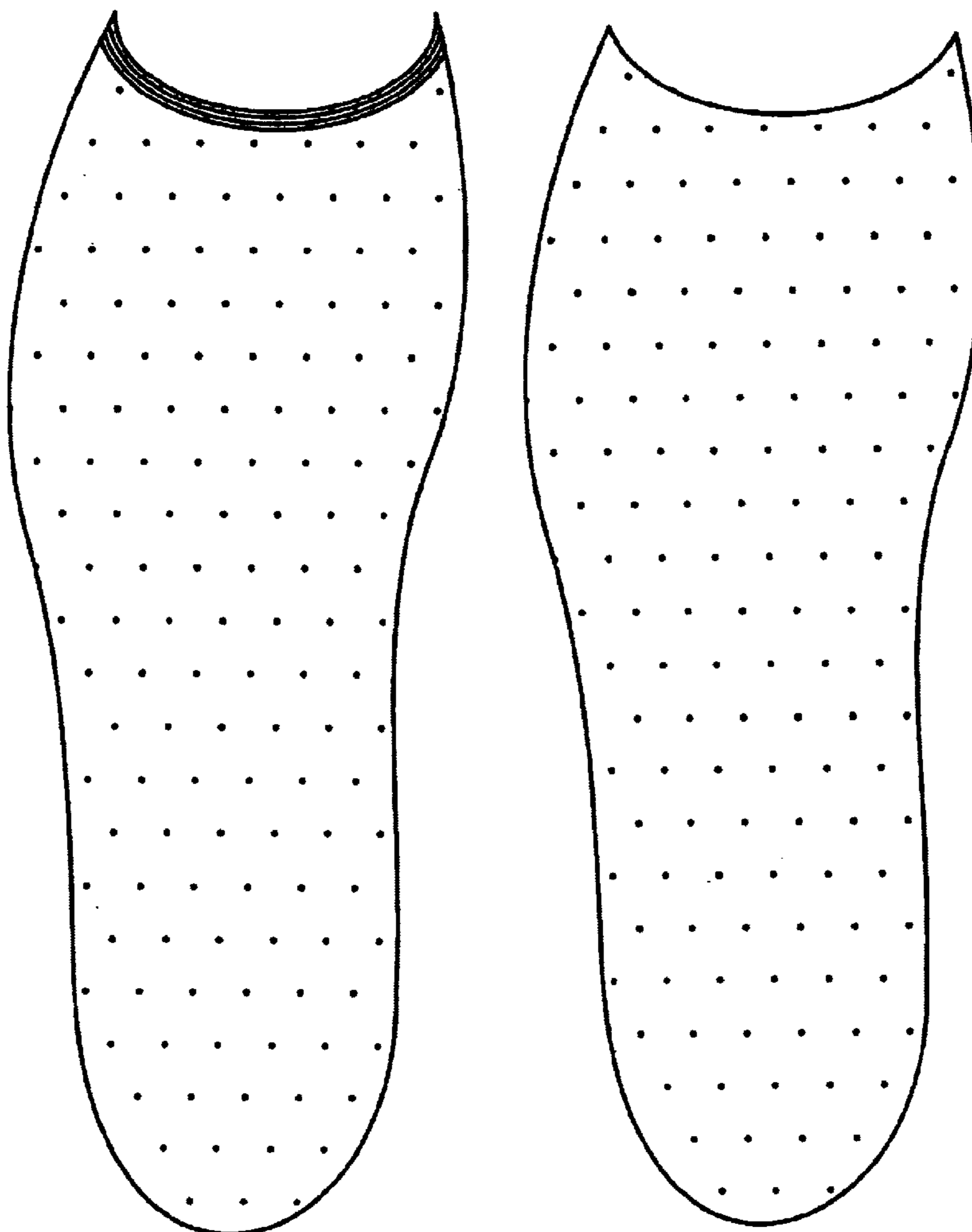
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, taken in the direction of the arrow 3 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1, the bottom plan view being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of FIG. 2, the bottom plan view being a mirror image; and,

FIG. 6 is a side elevational thereof view taken in the direction of the arrow 6 in FIG. 5.

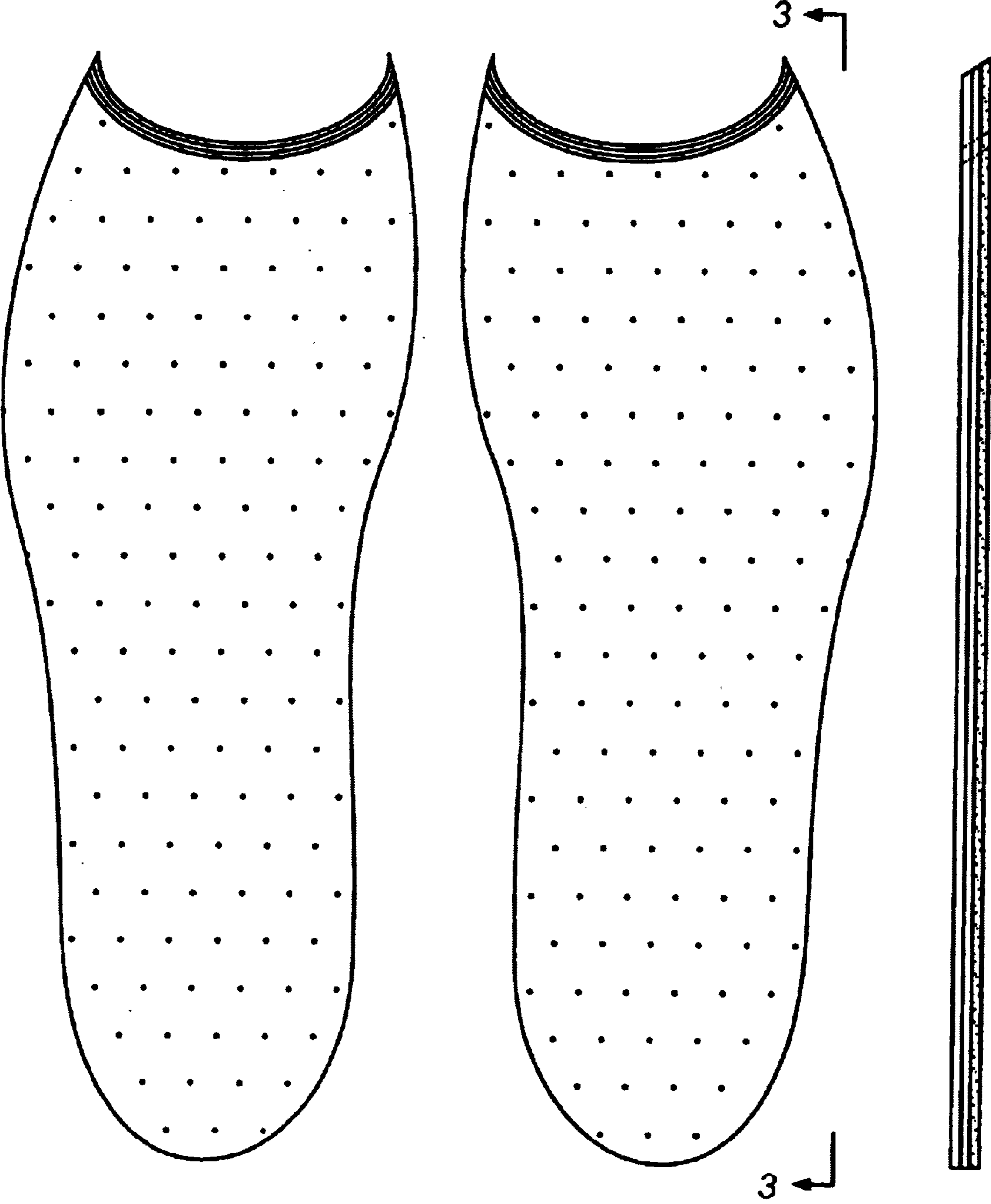

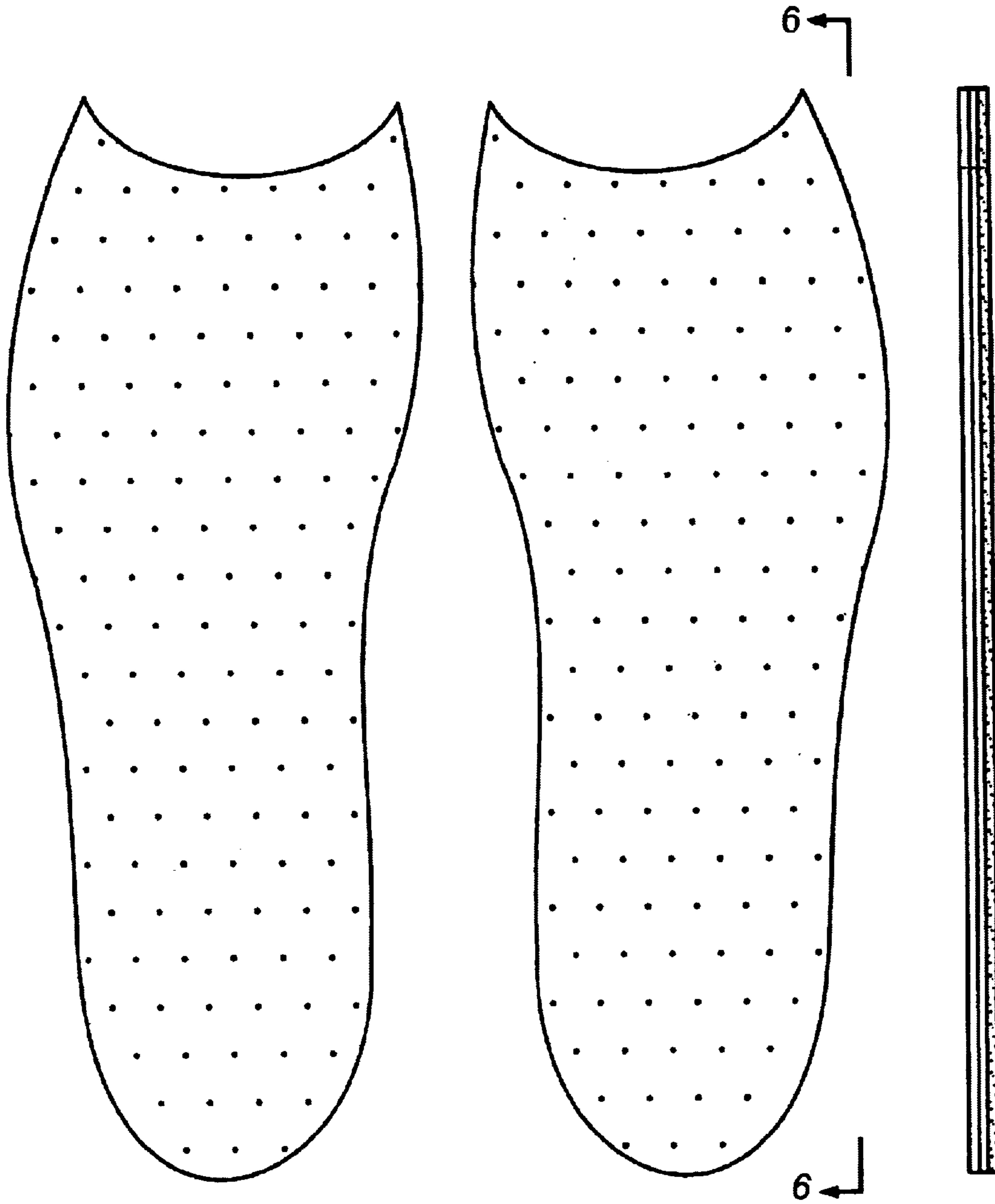
