(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a handle for a bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a handle for a bag showing our new design as attached to a bag shown in broken lines;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

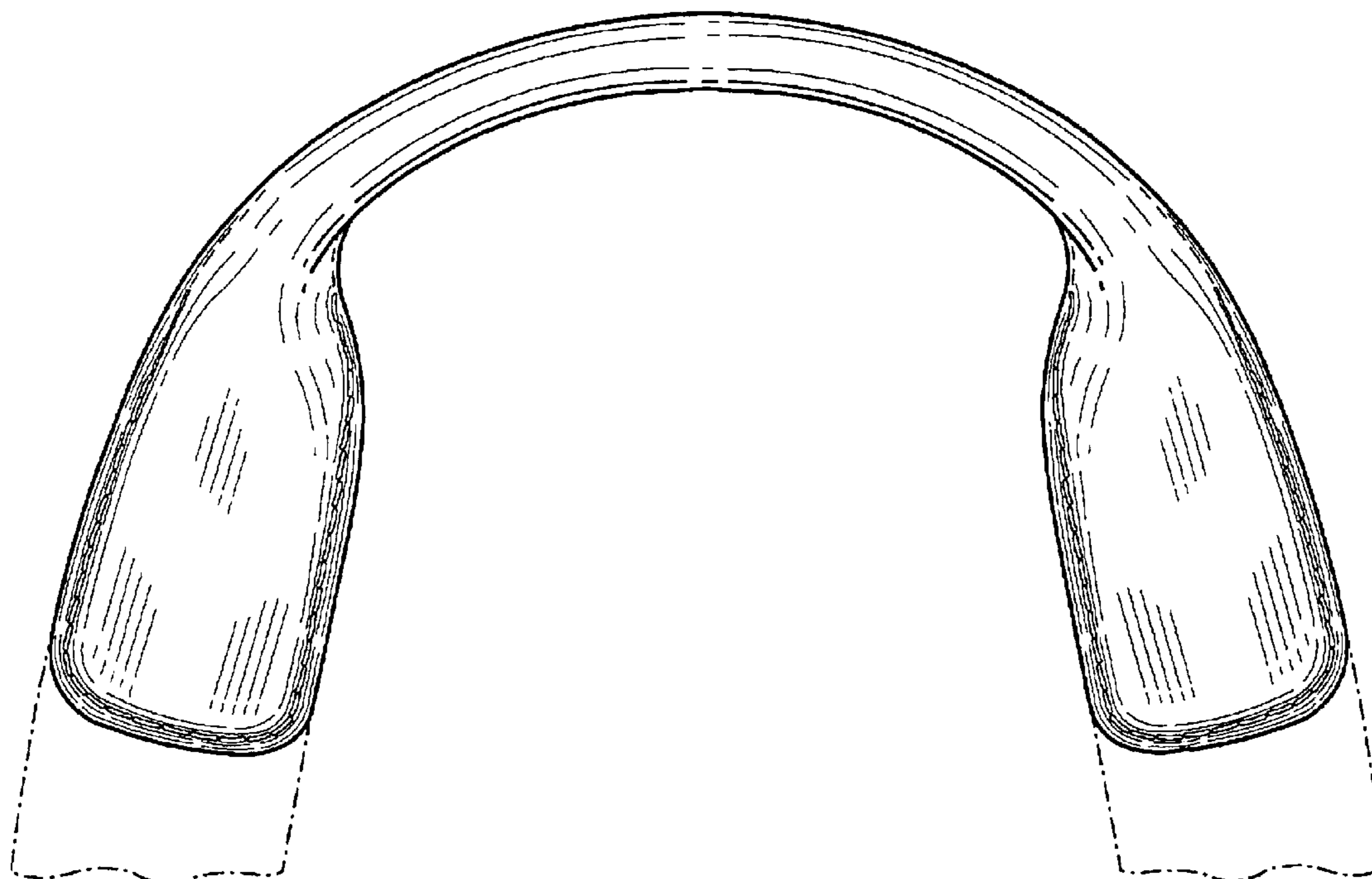
FIG. 3 is a top view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear view of the embodiment of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 5 is a right side view of the embodiment of FIG. 1, the left side view being the mirror image.

The broken lines are provided for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. In addition, the portions of the handle for a bag that are not shown in the drawings, if any, do not form any part of the claimed design.

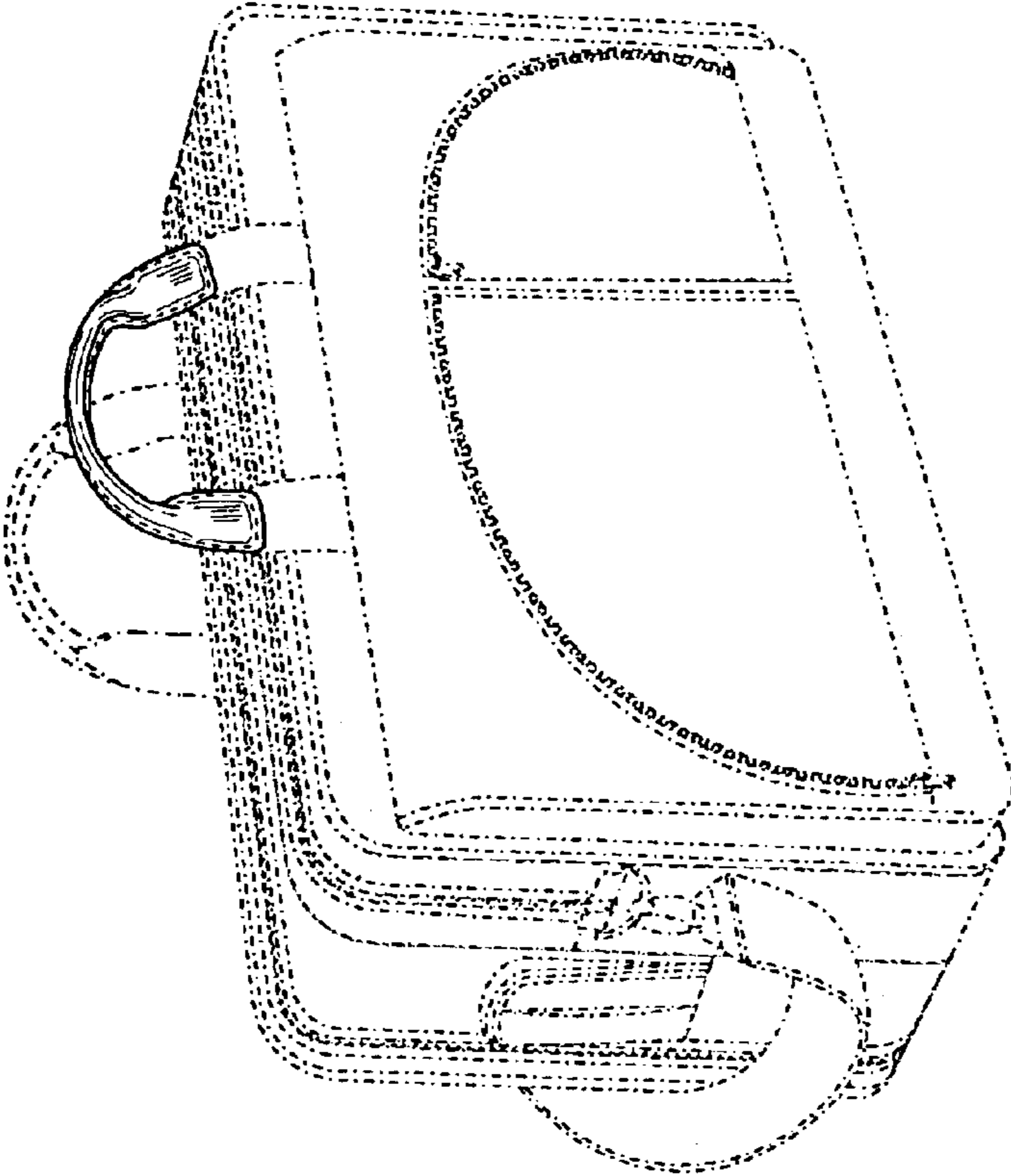

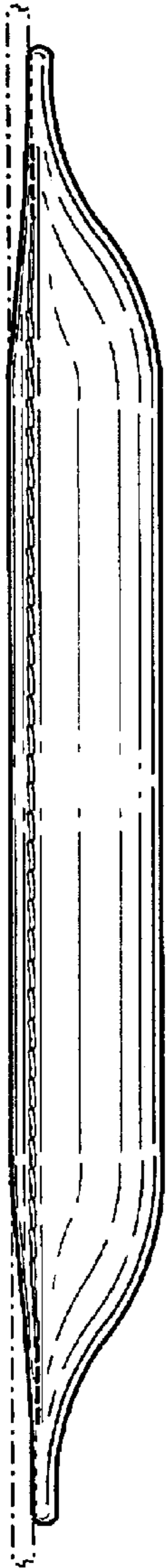

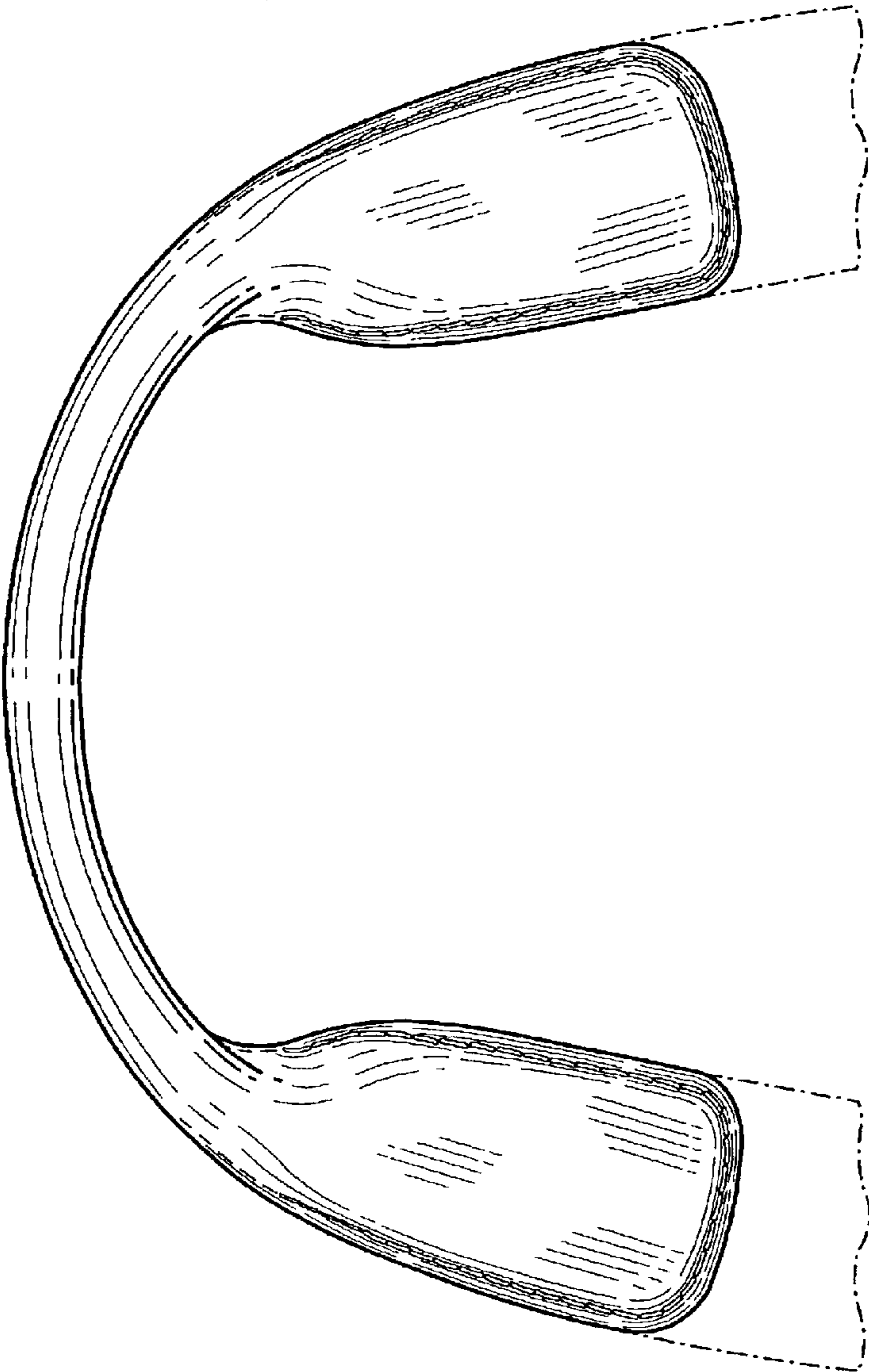

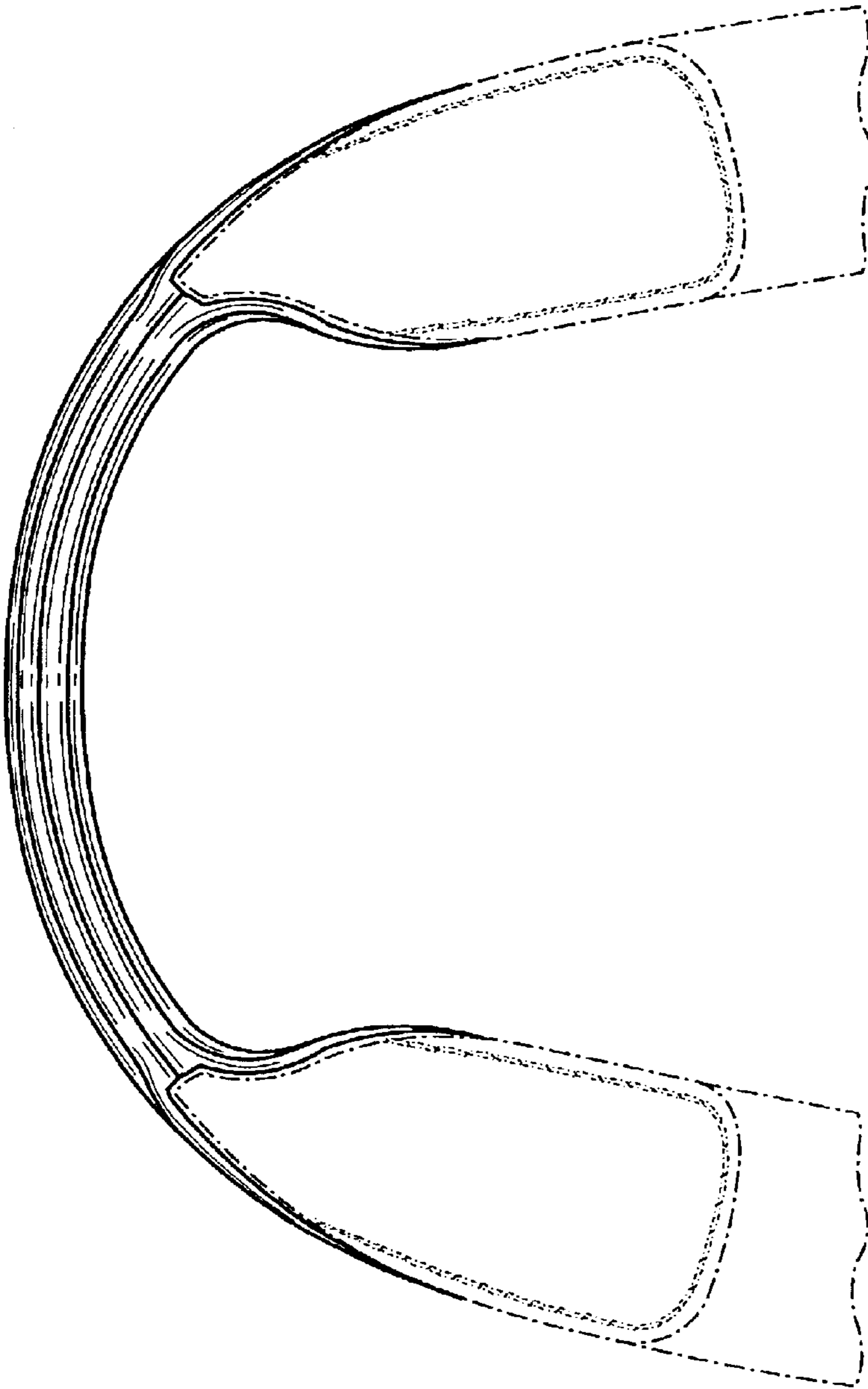
