CLAIM

The ornamental design for a grate for a grill, as shown, described and illustrated herein.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a grate for a grill, showing our new design, the bottom view being the same; and,FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of one side thereof, the rear and other side elevational views being the same.In FIGS. 1 and 2, the dashed lines in the figures represent environmental subject matter and form no part of the claimed design, and the dotted lines represent the borders between claimed subject matter and unclaimed environmental subject matter and unclaimed design.
