DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of our preferred embodiment new design for a furniture coaster.

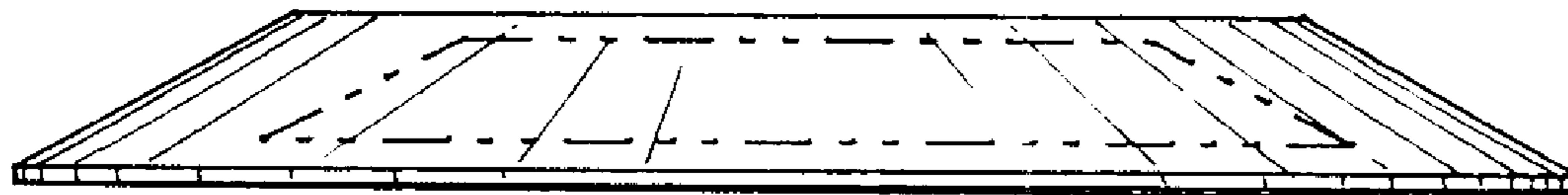
FIG. 2 is a back plan view of the coaster shown in FIG. 1.
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the coaster shown in FIG. 1, the dotted lines showing the area for a logo.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the coaster shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a right side plan view of the coaster shown in FIG. 1, wherein the left side plan view is a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a top perspective view of the coaster shown in FIG. 1, the dotted lines showing the area for a logo and a table leg. The broken line showing of a partial leg and a label is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

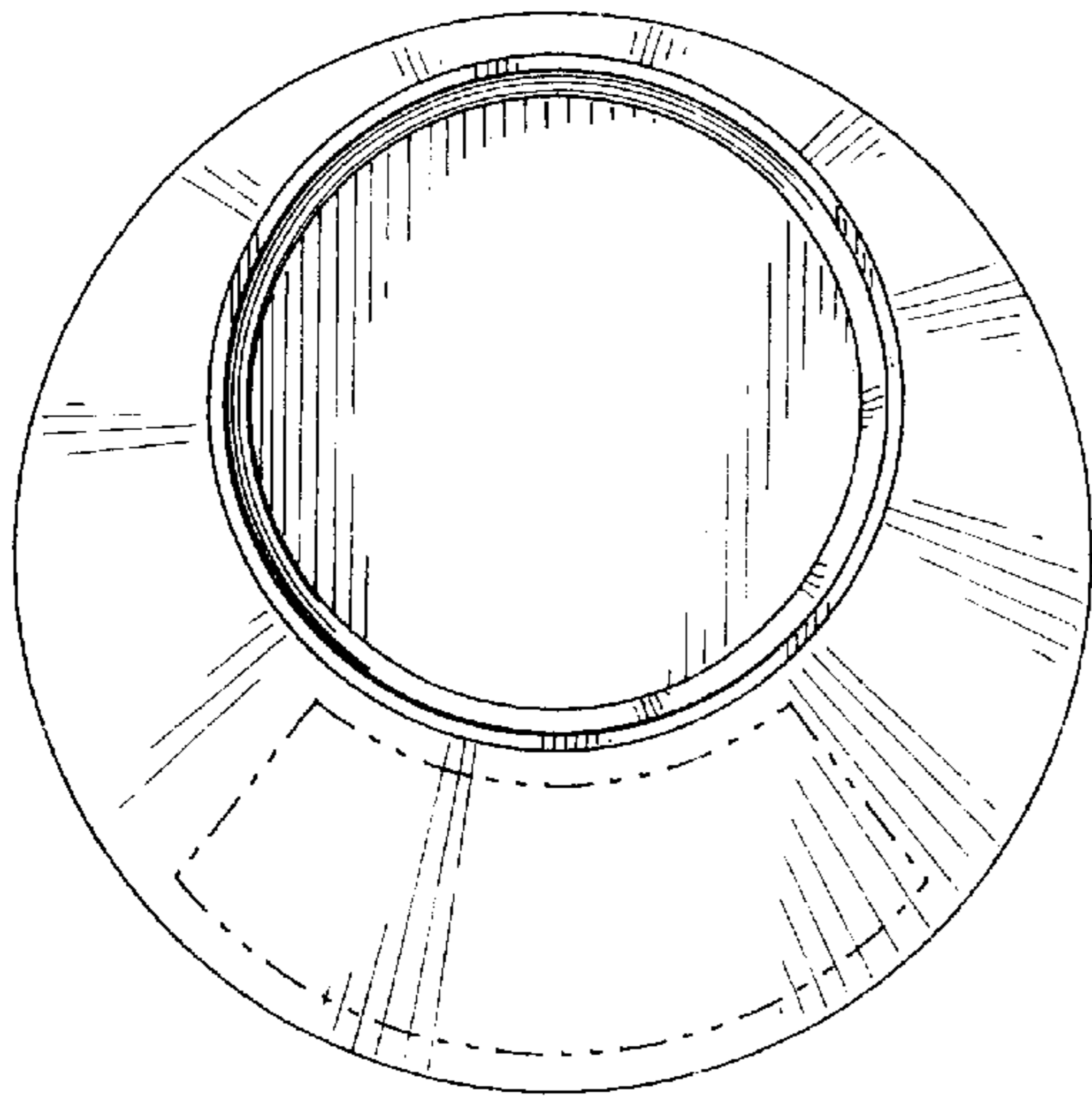

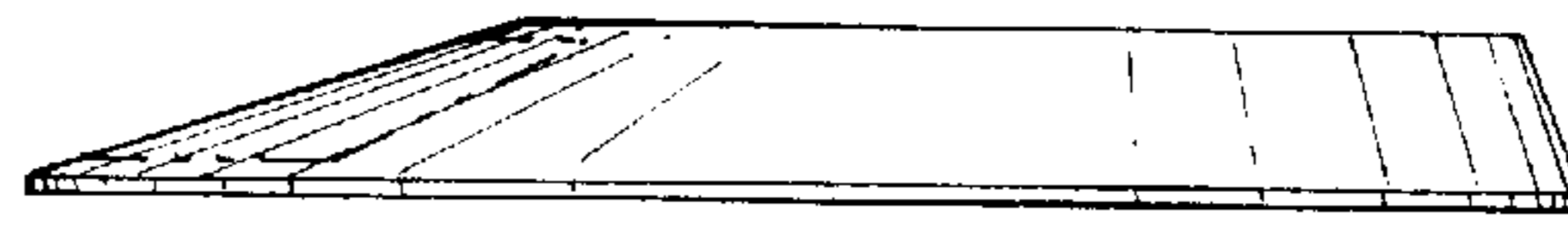

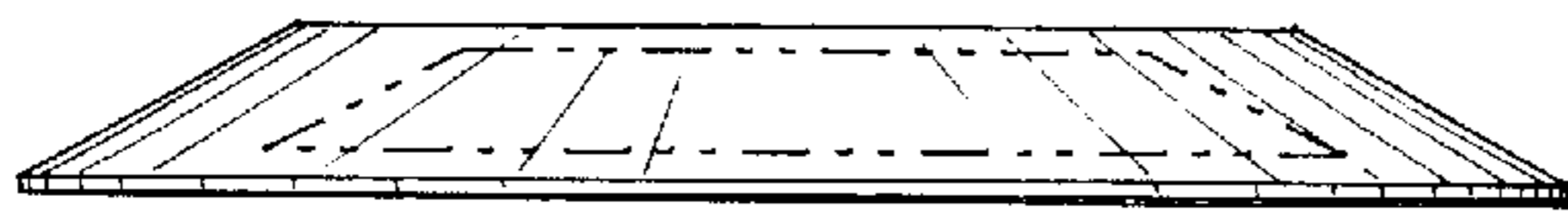

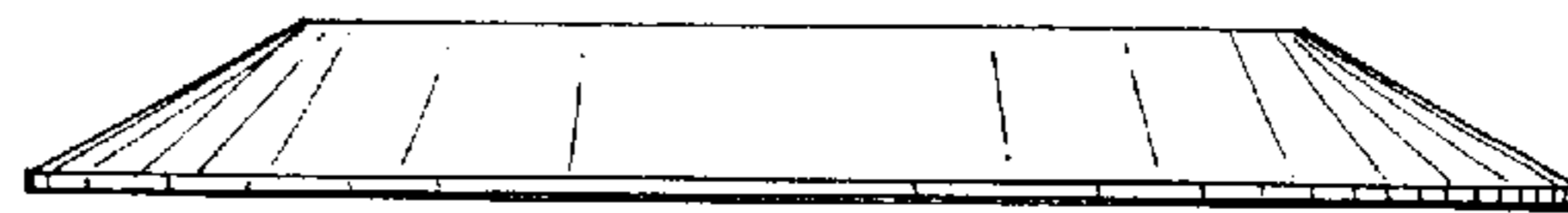

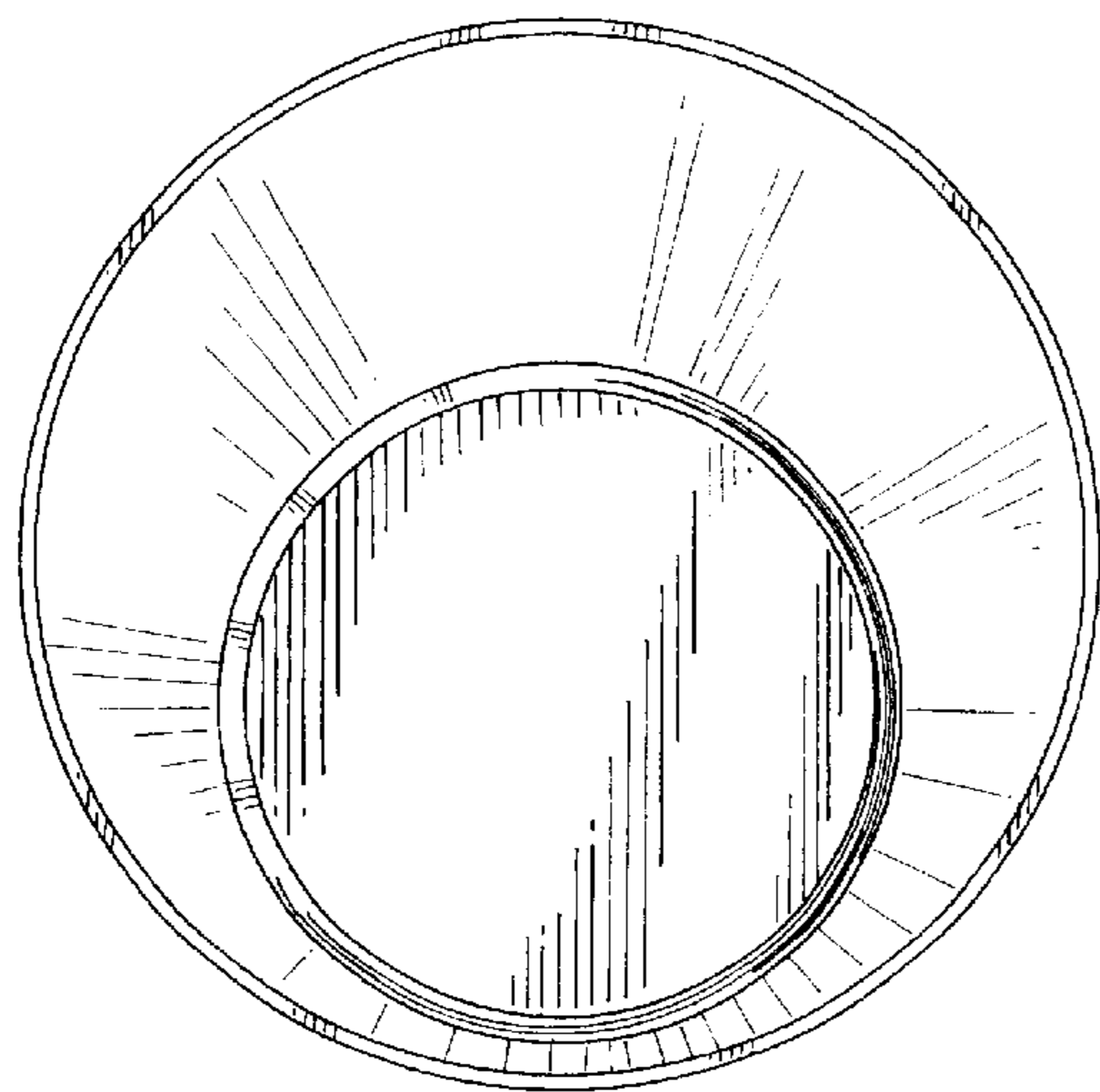

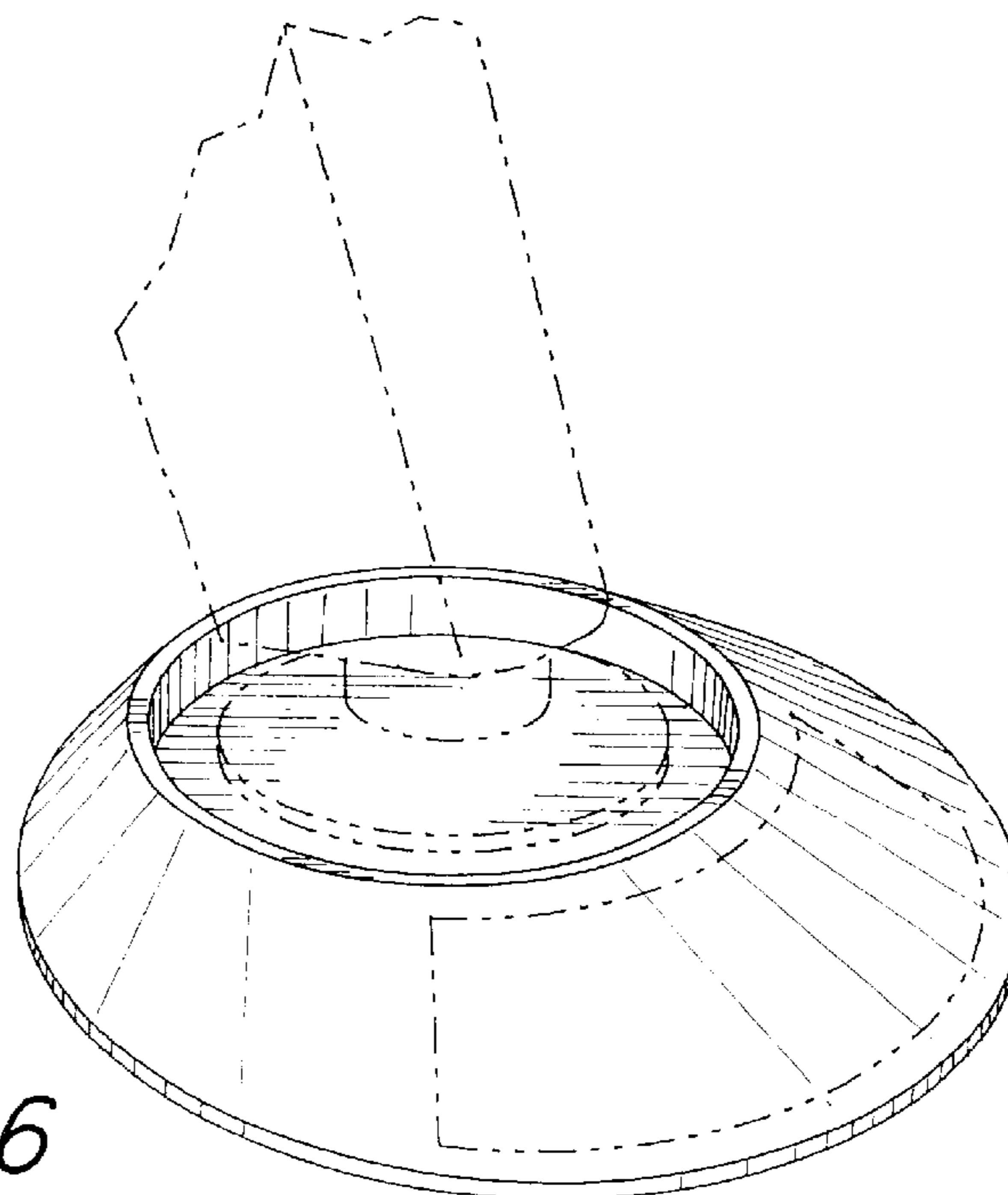
