The ornamental design for a golf club support and accessory holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf club support and accessory holder of the present invention;
- FIG. 2 is front elevational view of the golf club support and accessory holder of the present invention;
- FIG. 3 is rear elevational view of the golf club support and accessory holder of the present invention;
- FIG. 4 is a first side elevational view of the golf club support and accessory holder of the present invention;
- FIG. 5 is a second side elevational view of the golf club support and accessory holder of the present invention;
- FIG. 6 is a top view of the golf club support and accessory holder of the present invention; and,
- FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the golf club support and accessory holder of the present invention.
