The ornamental design for a floor lamp base, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 8 is a side view of the base shown in FIG. 7;

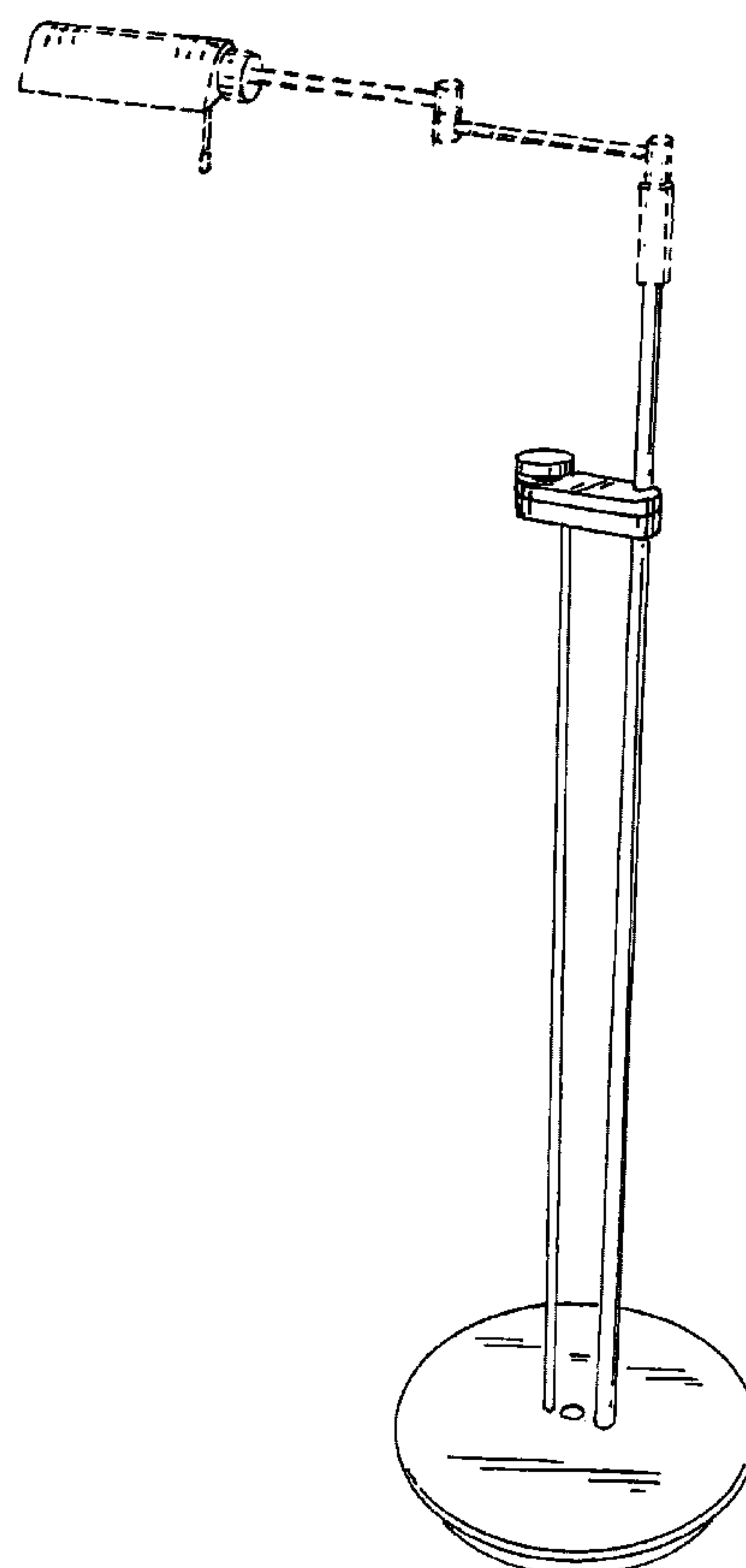
FIG. 9 is a rear view thereof; and,

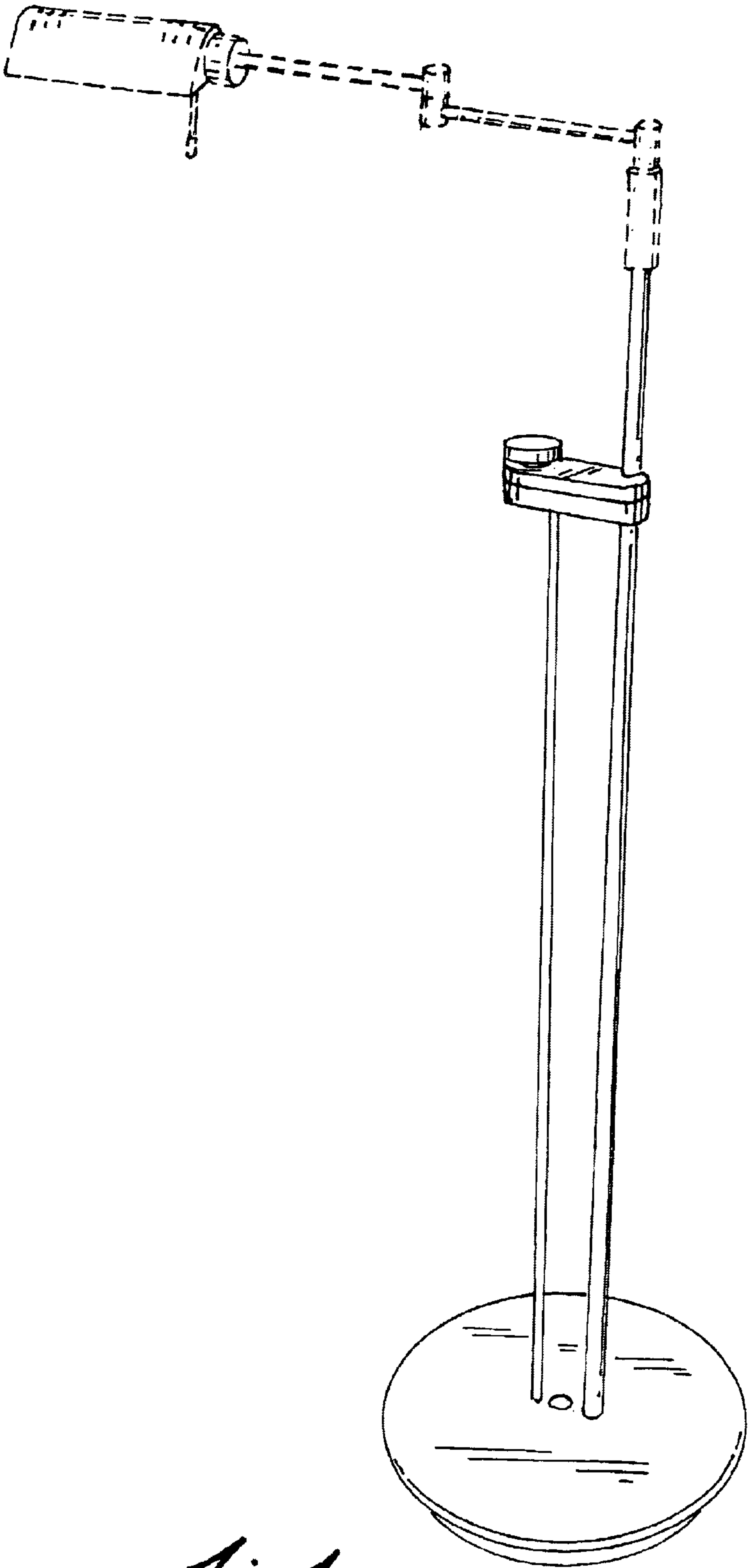

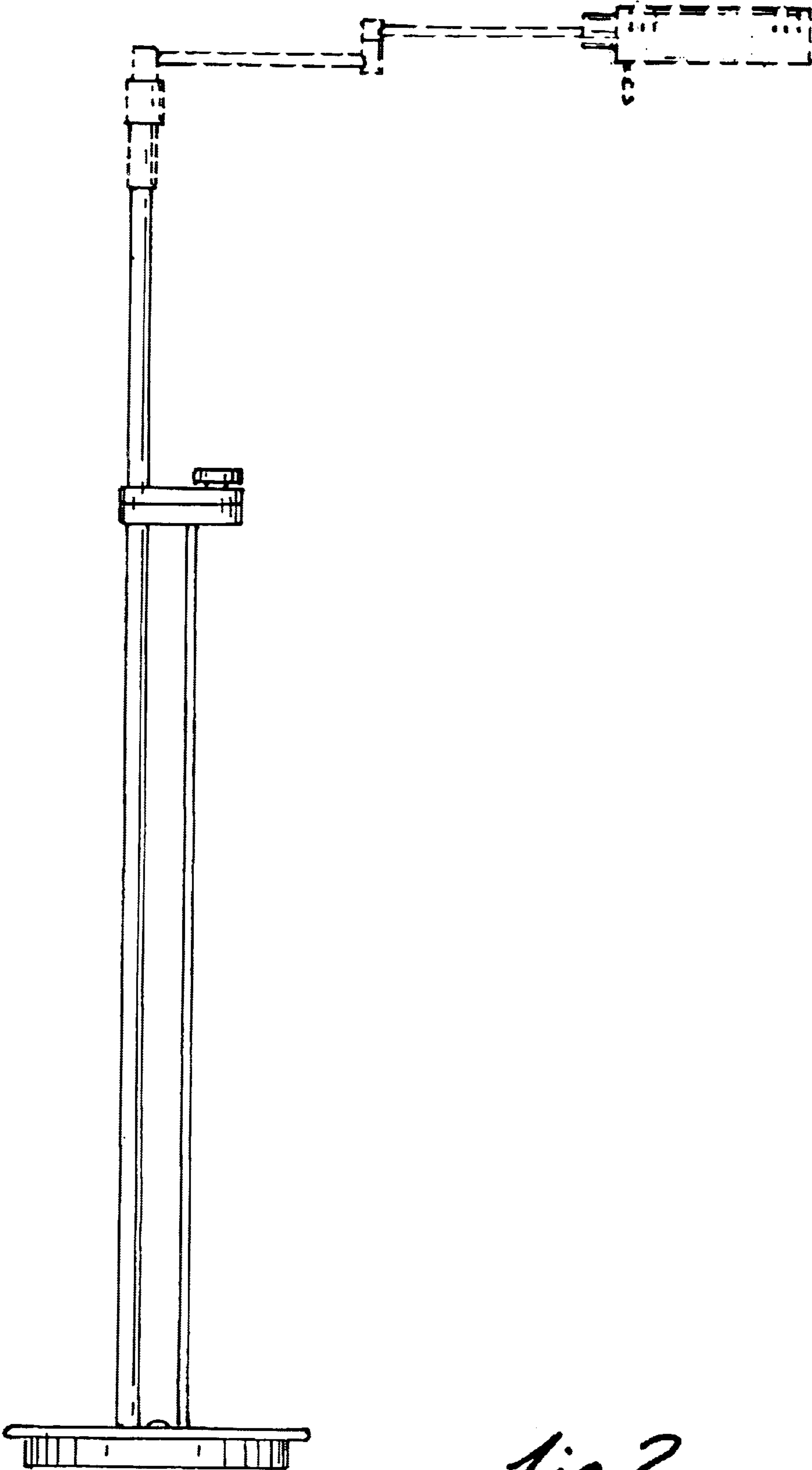

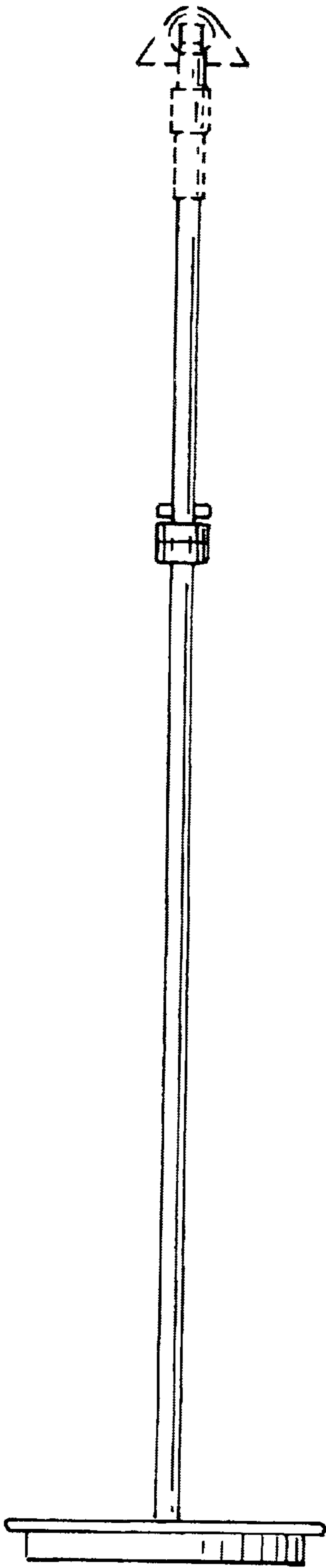

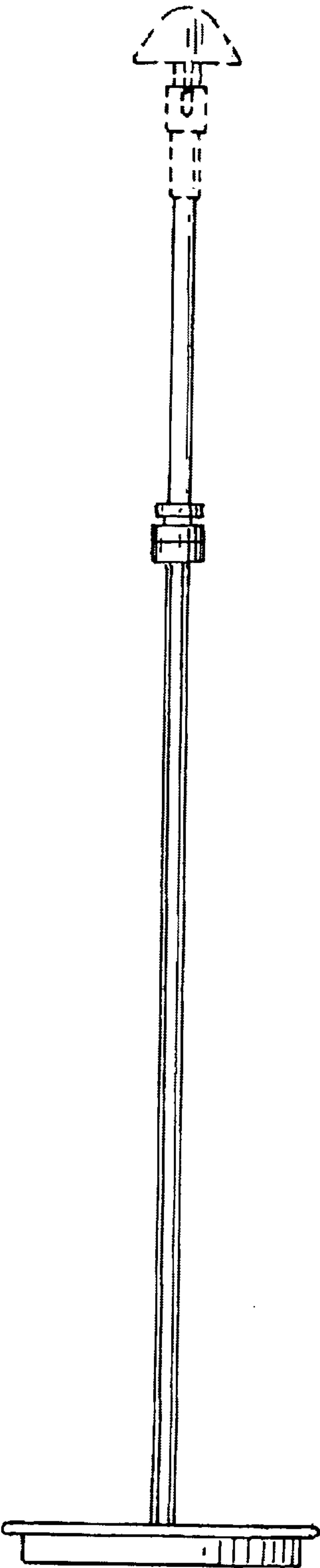

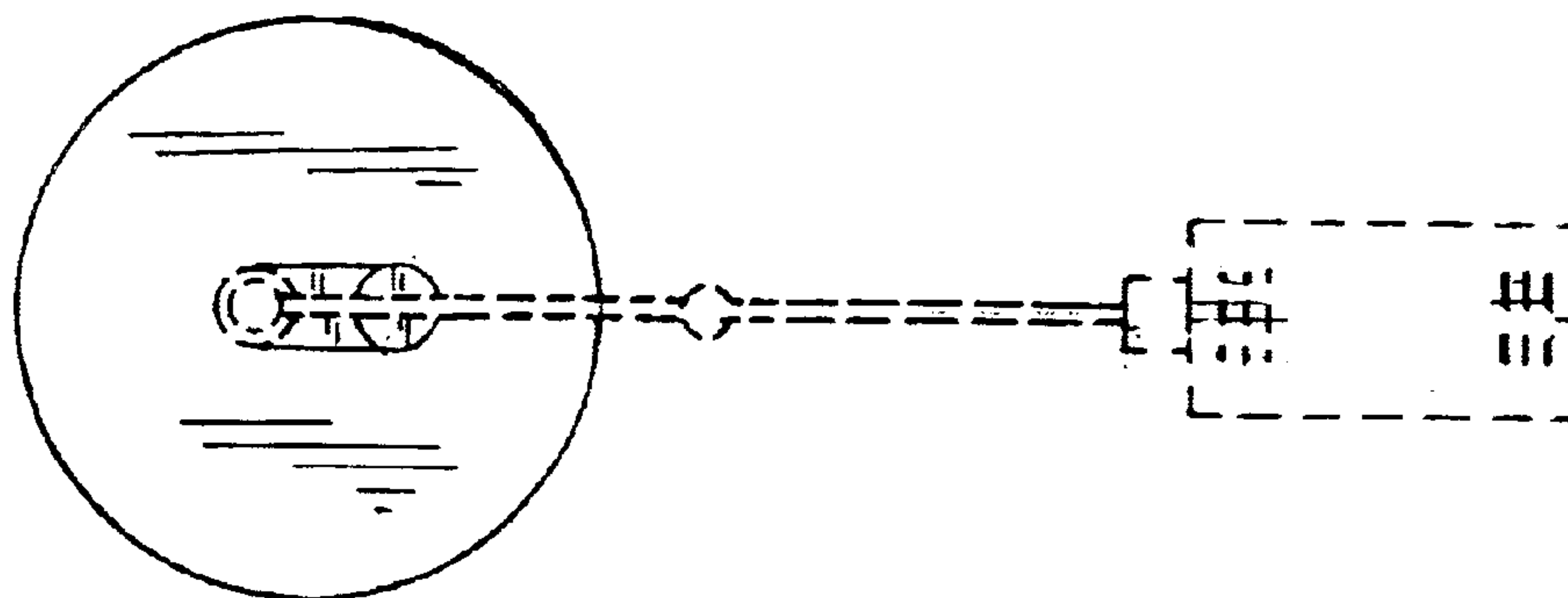

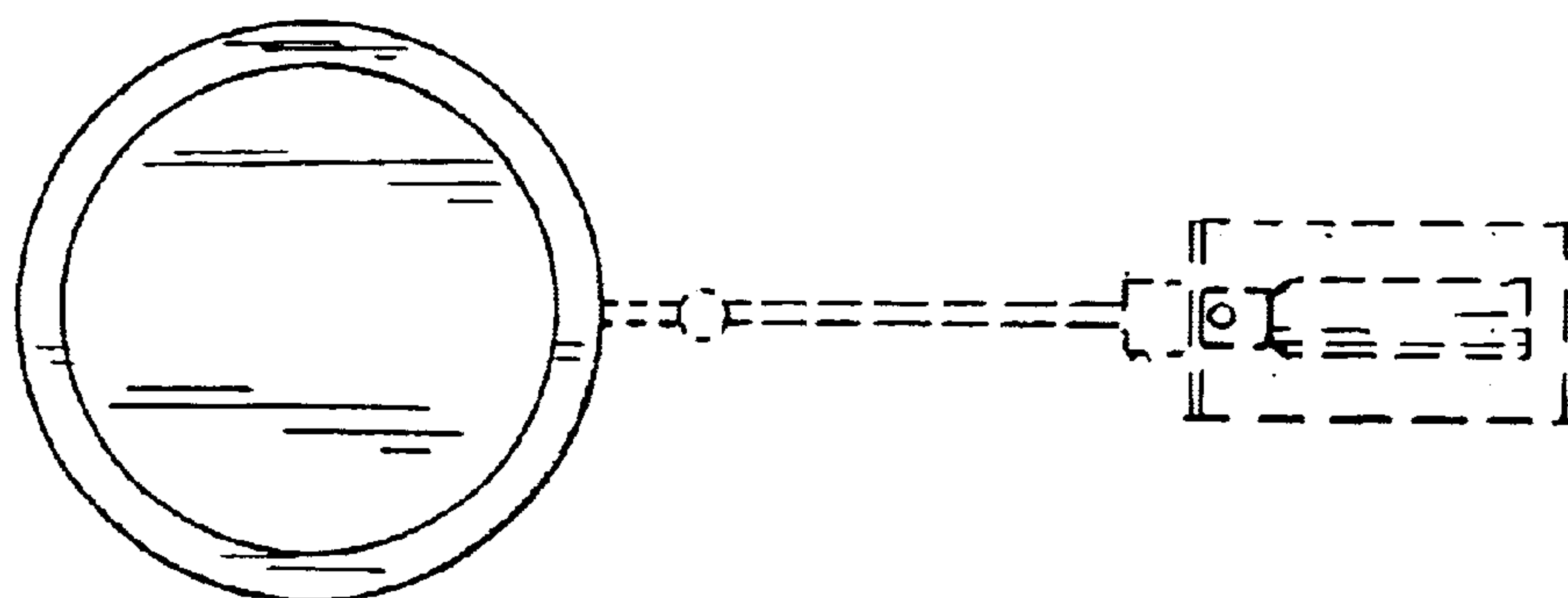

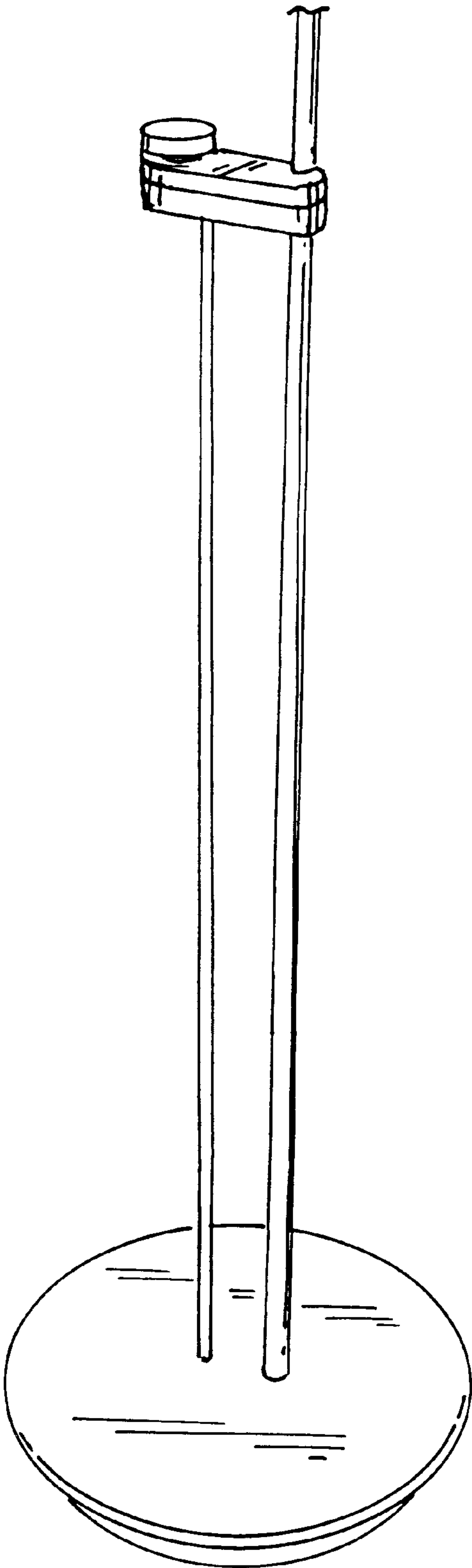

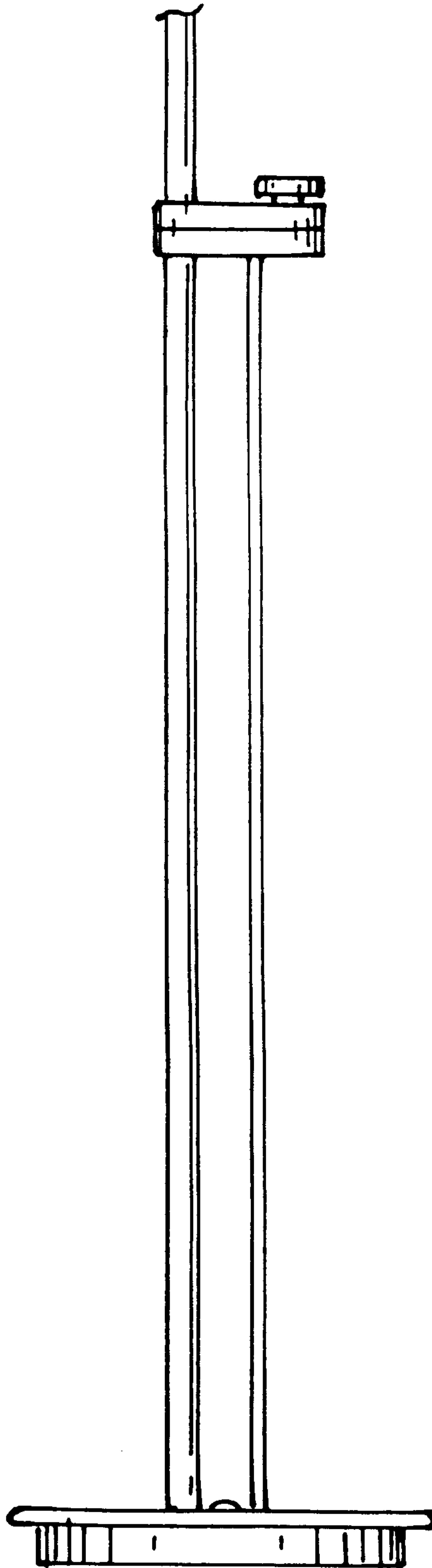

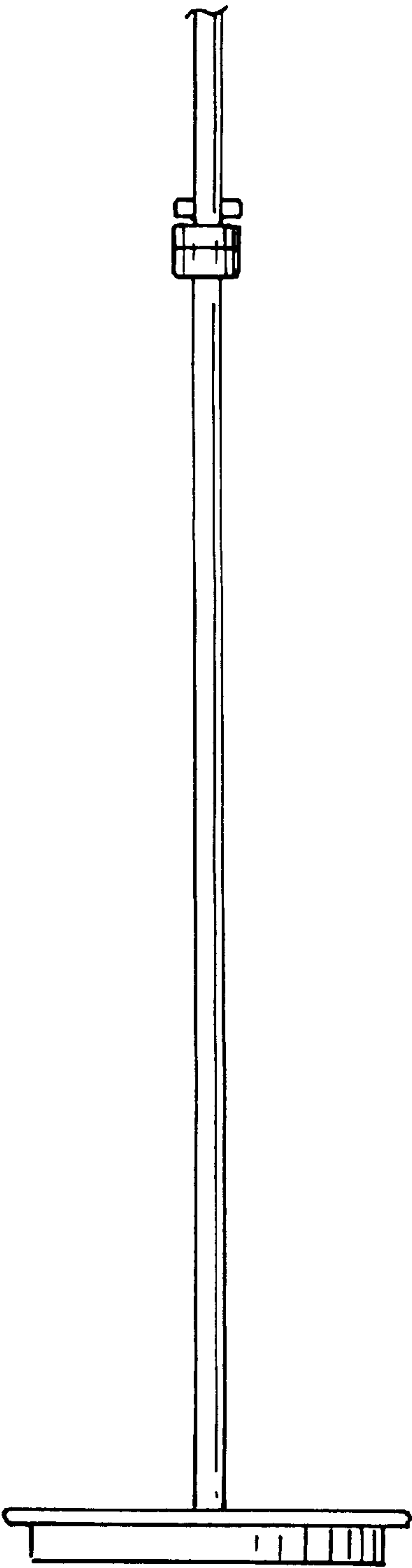

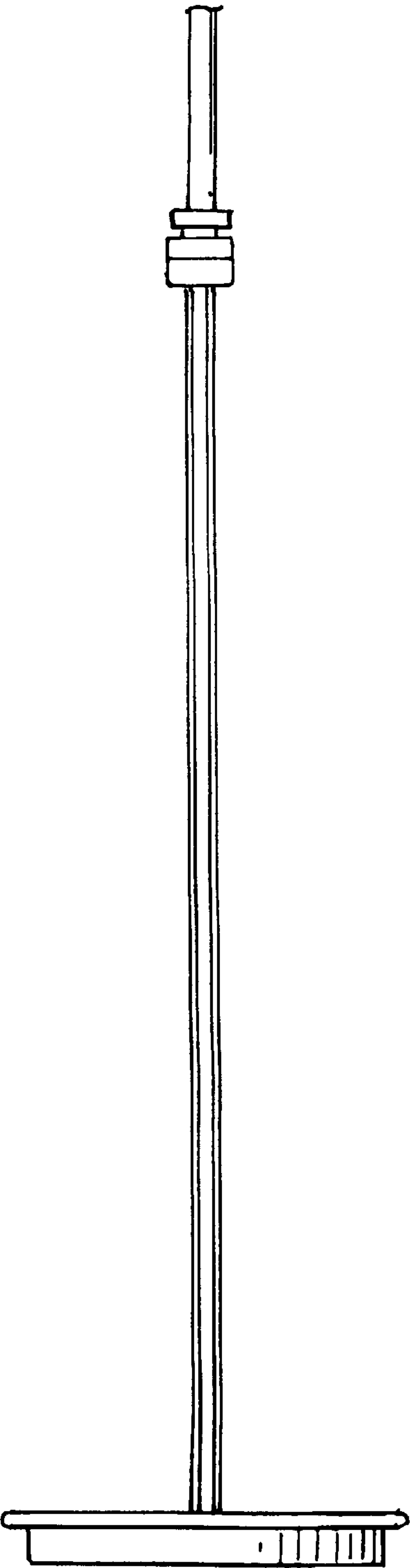
