according to an embodiment of the invention.

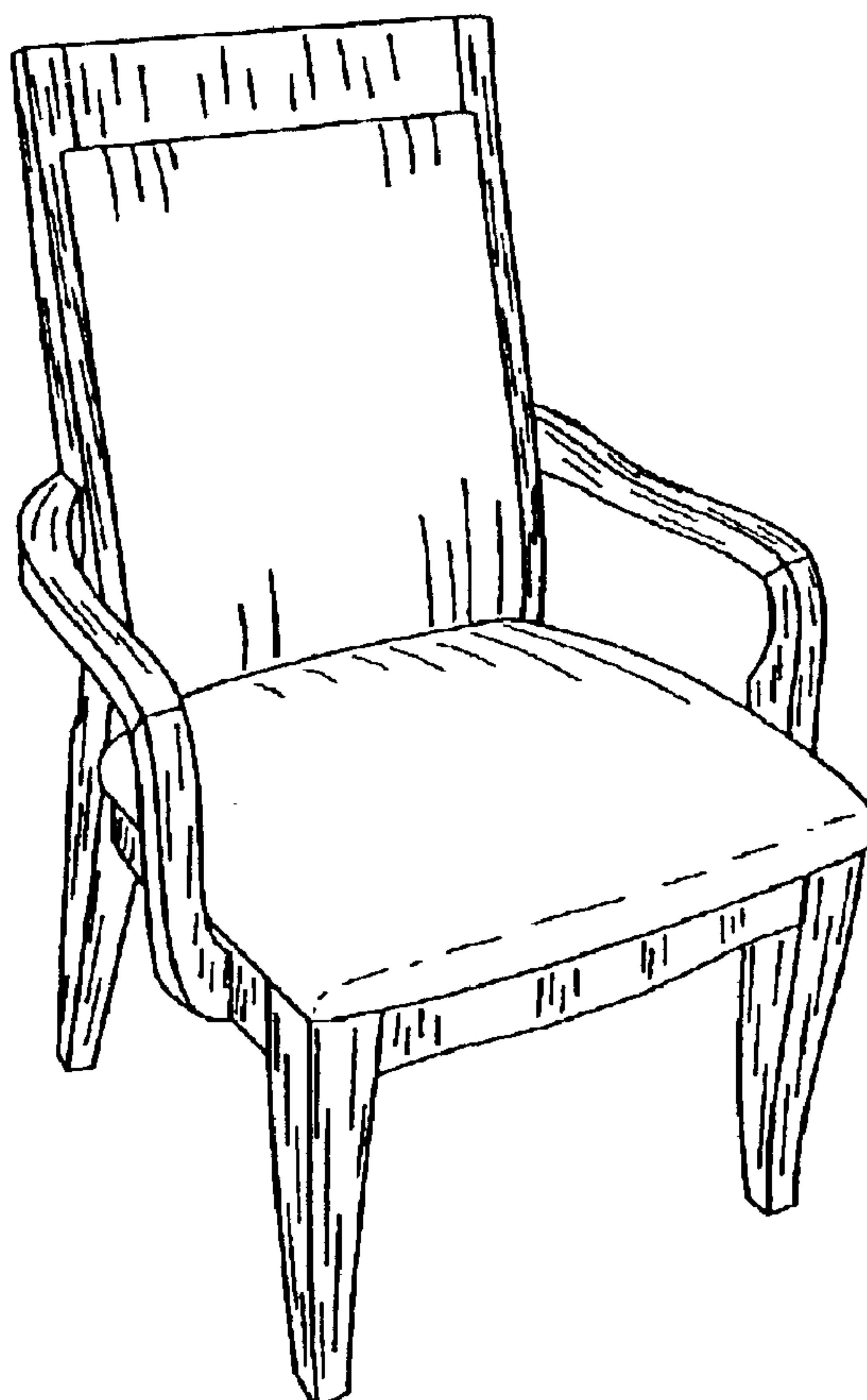
FIG. 2 is a front view of an arm chair according to an

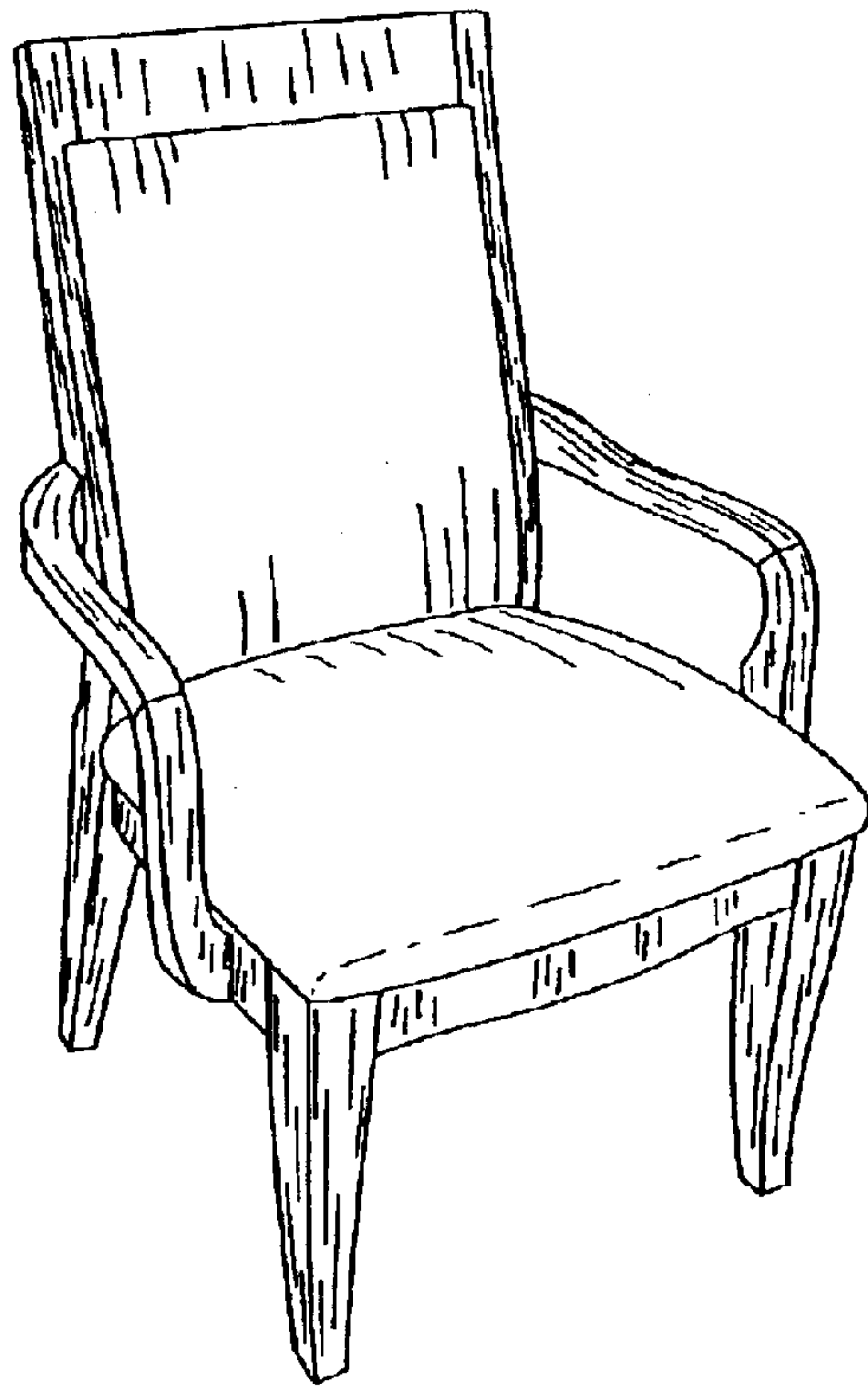

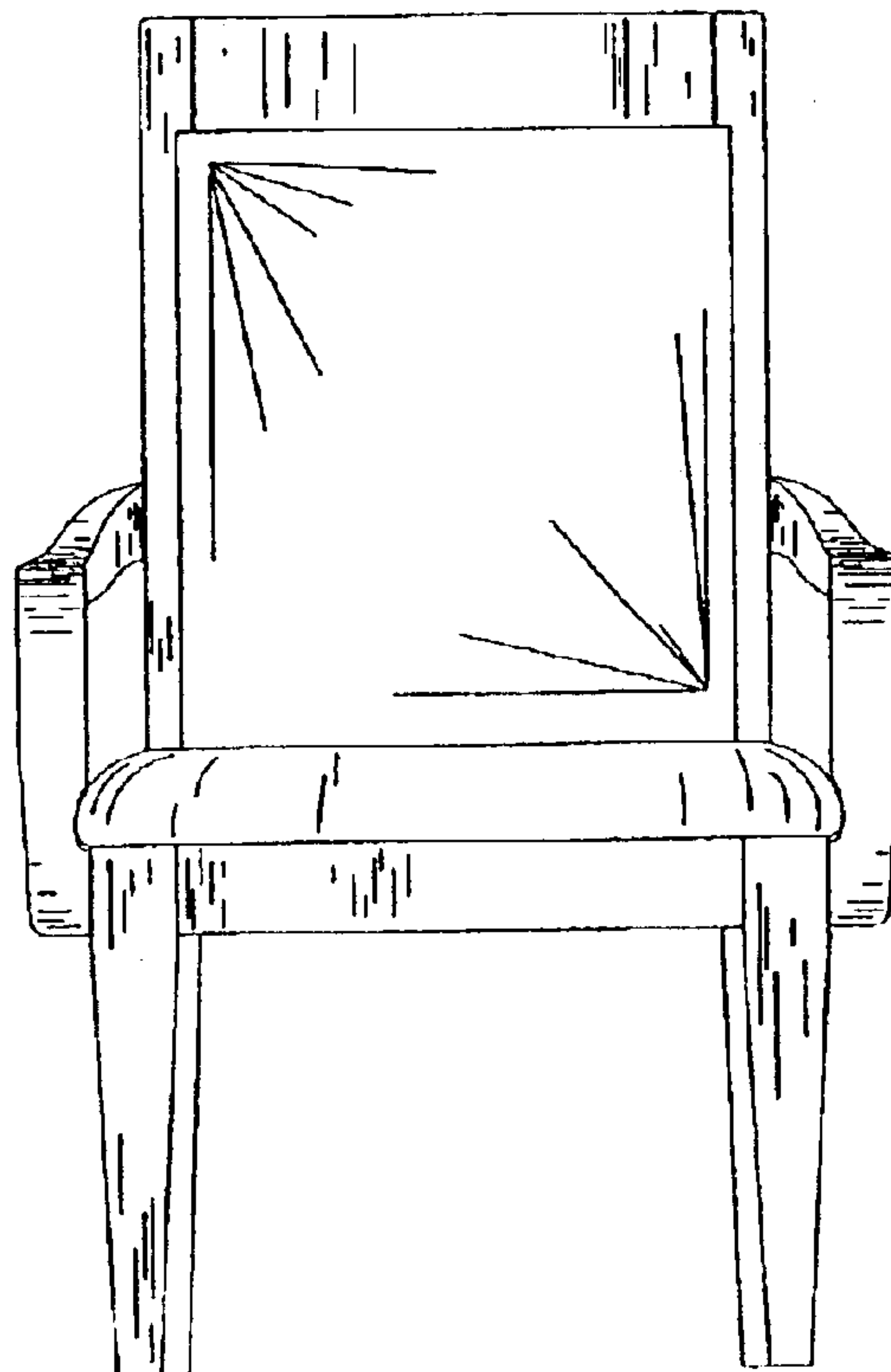

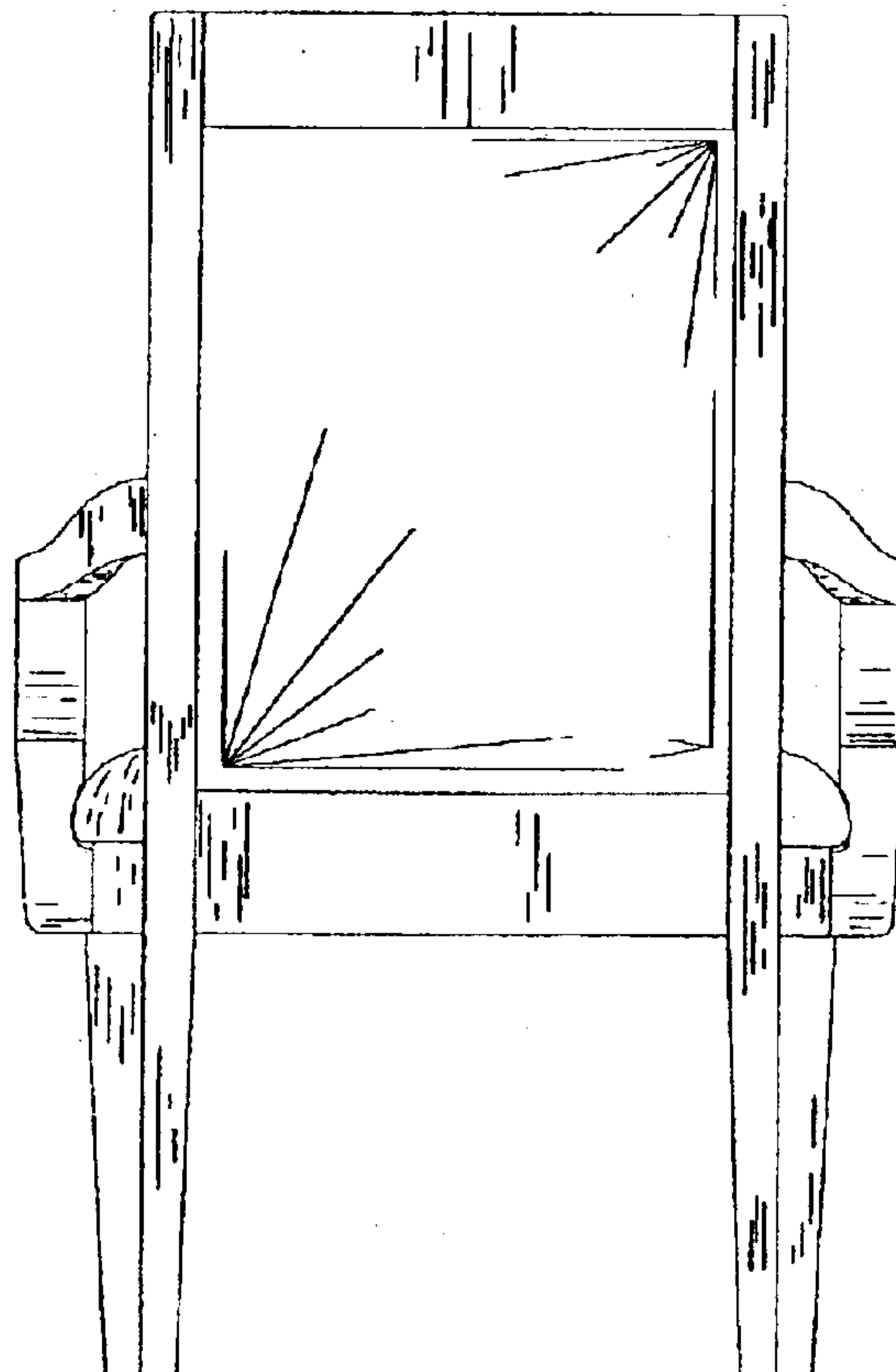
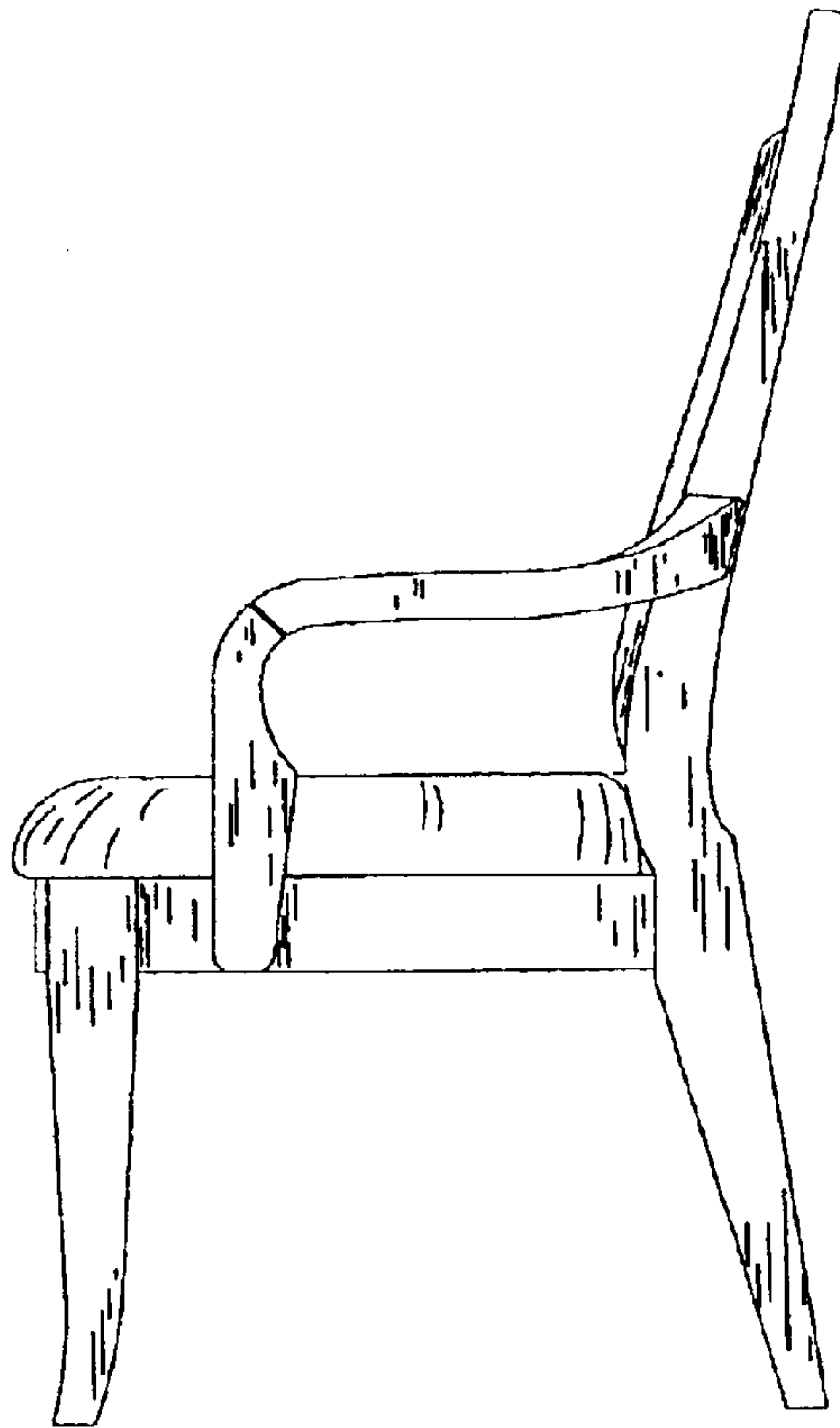
