The ornamental design for a cutlery set, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view as seen from the lower left of
a knife for the cutlery set of my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side being a mirror
image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a cross sectional view as taken along line 5—5 of
FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view as taken along line 6—6 of
FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view as taken along line 7—7 of
FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is a cross sectional view as taken along line 8—8 of
FIG. 3;

of FIG. 19;

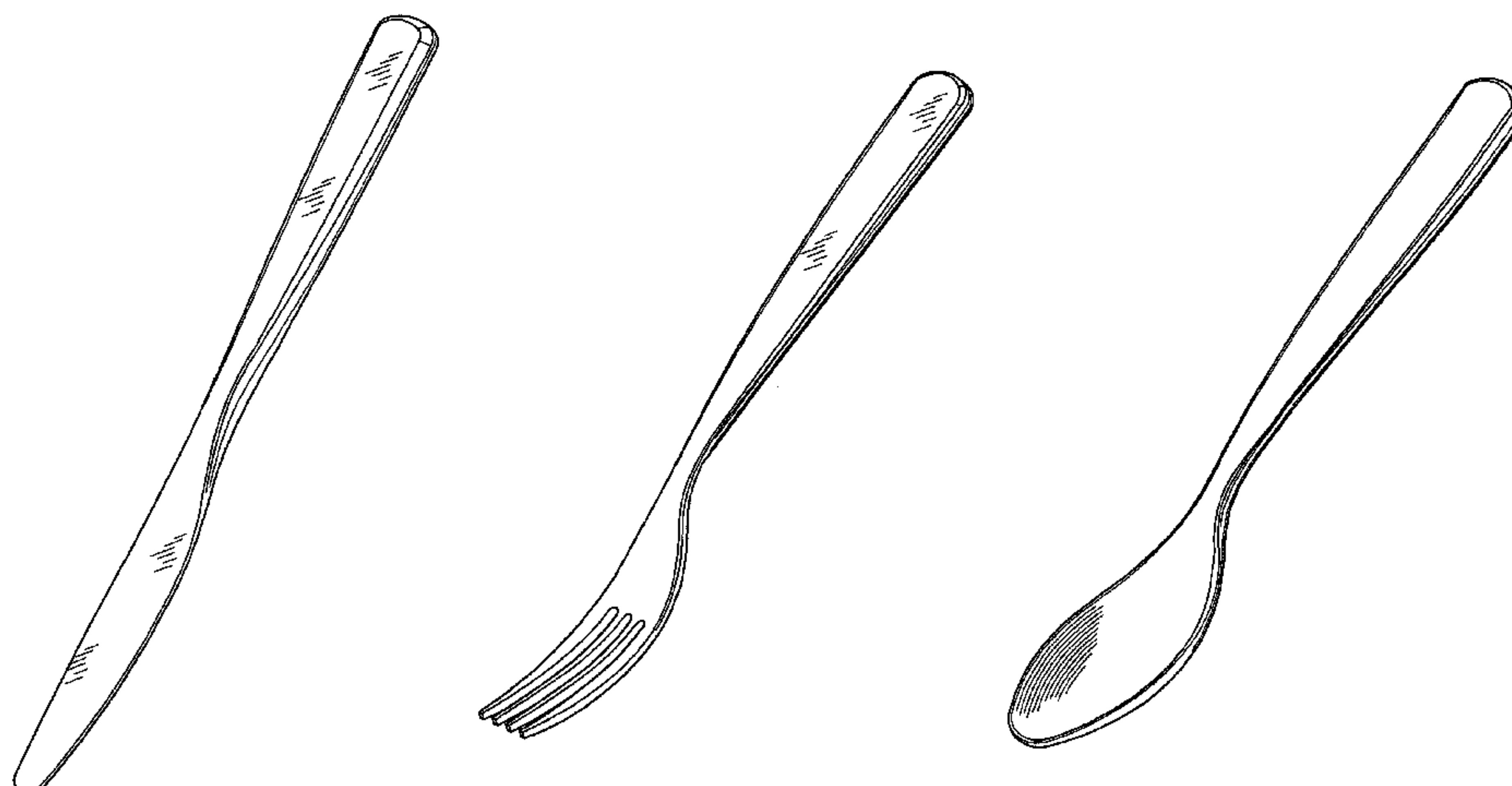
FIG. 21 is a cross sectional view as taken along line 21—21

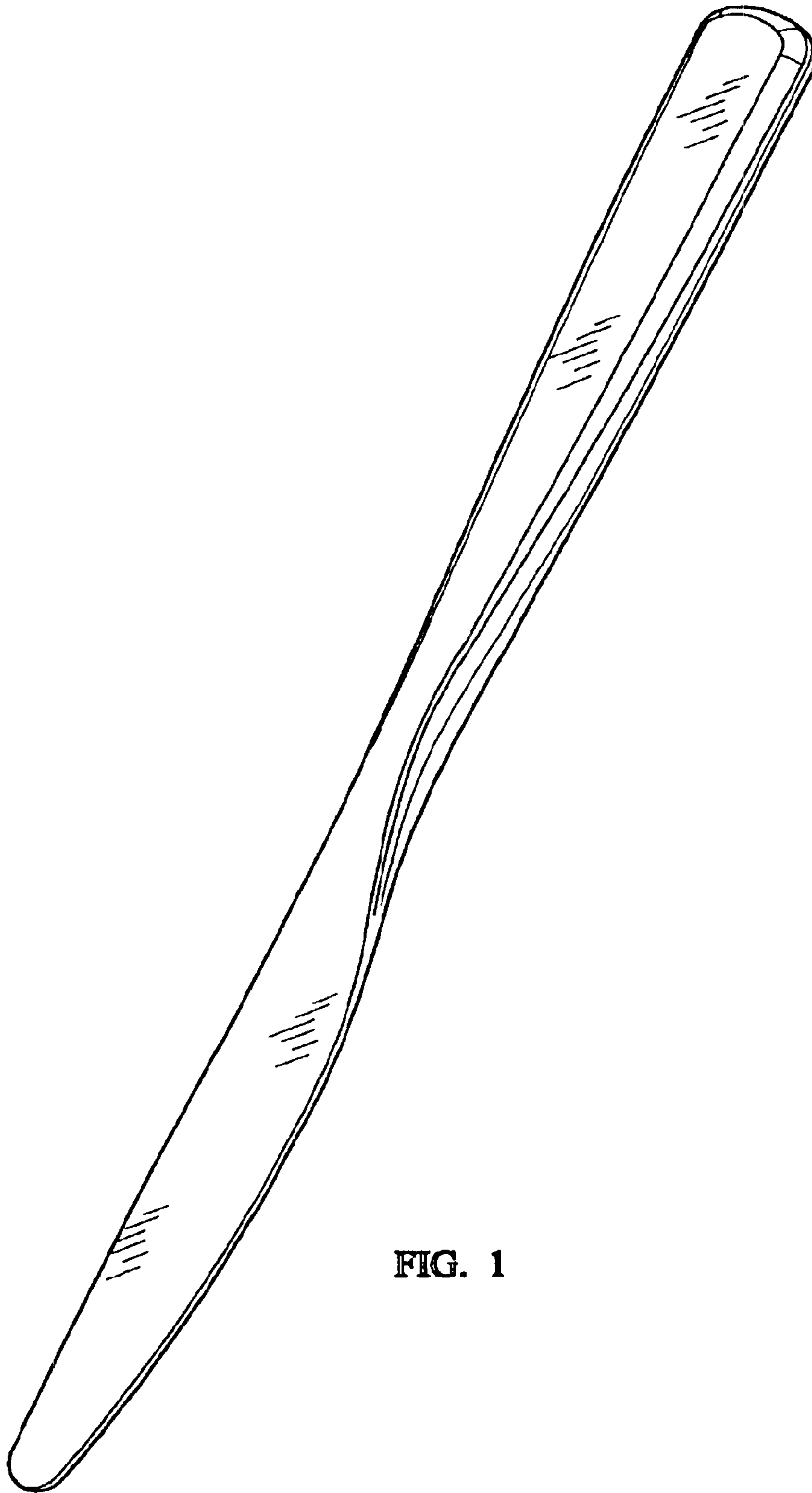

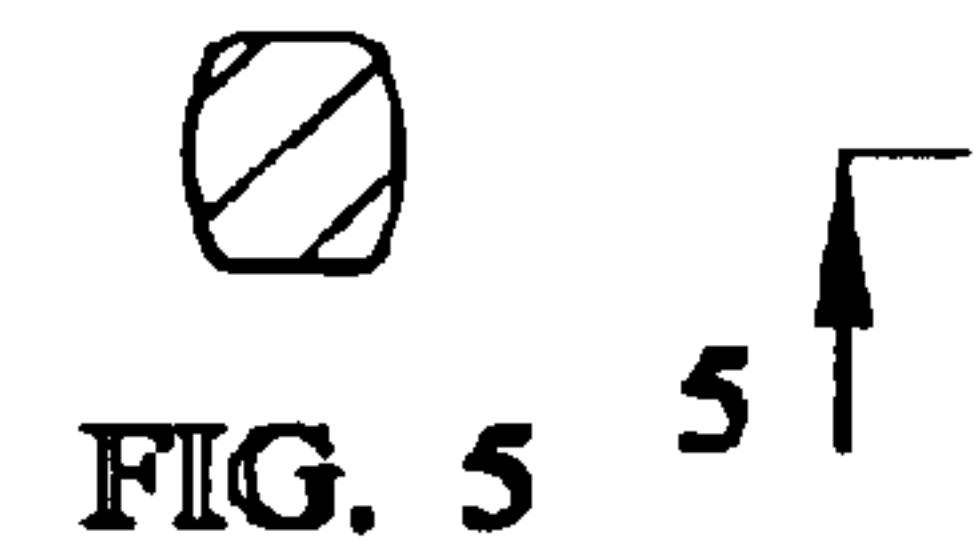

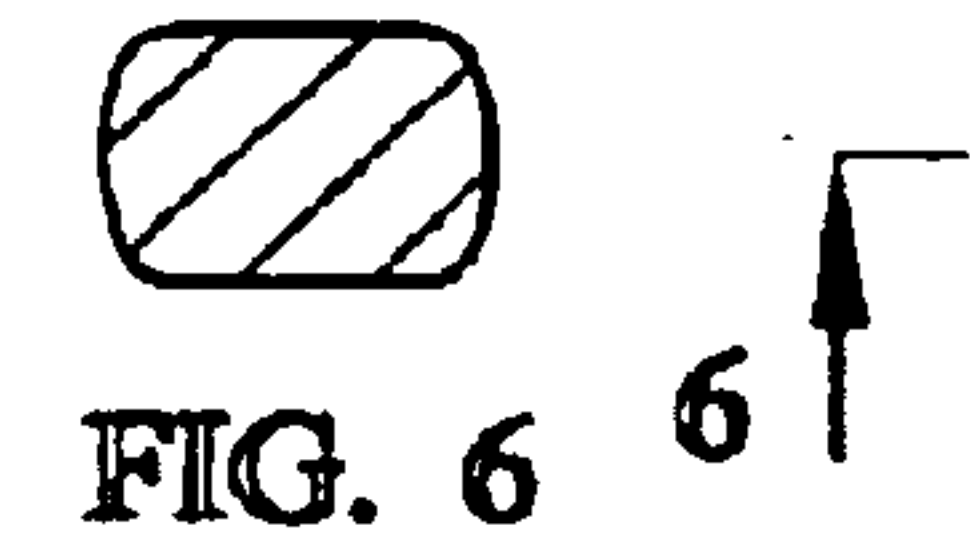

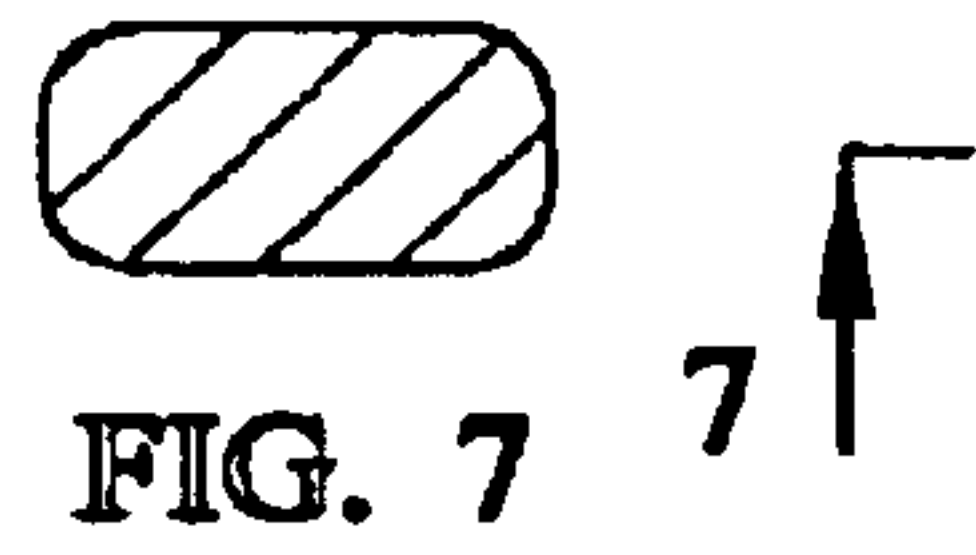

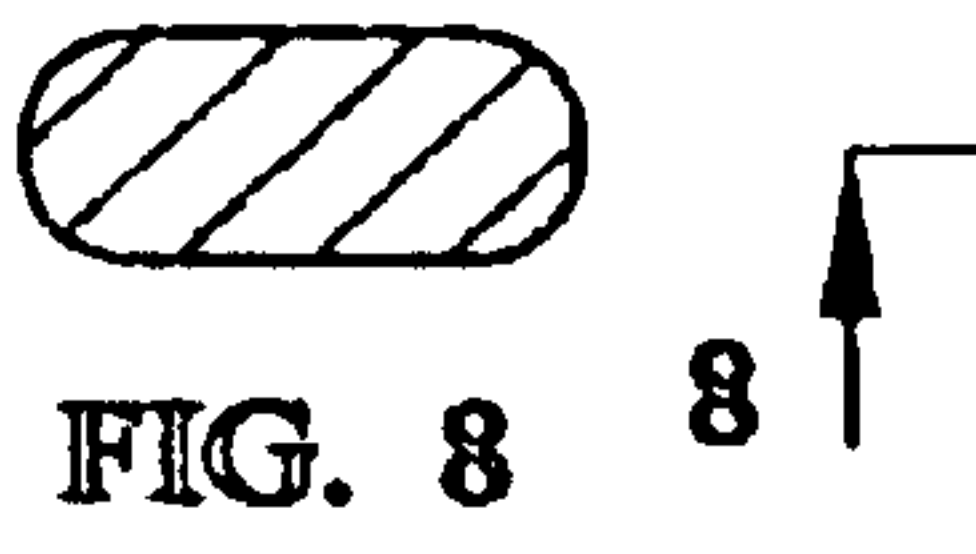

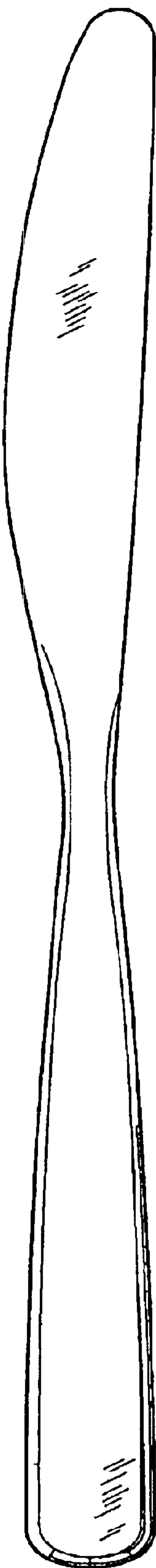

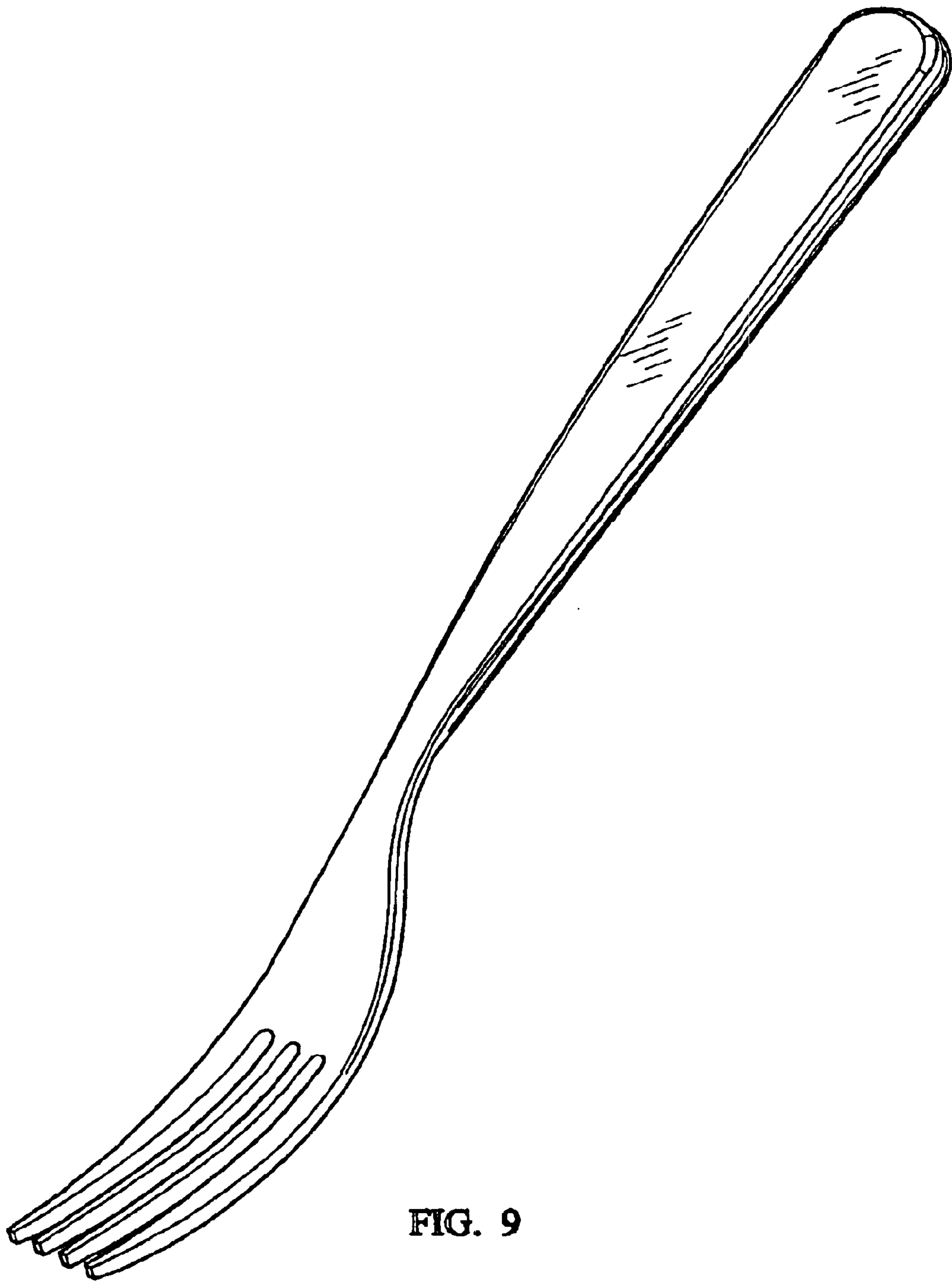
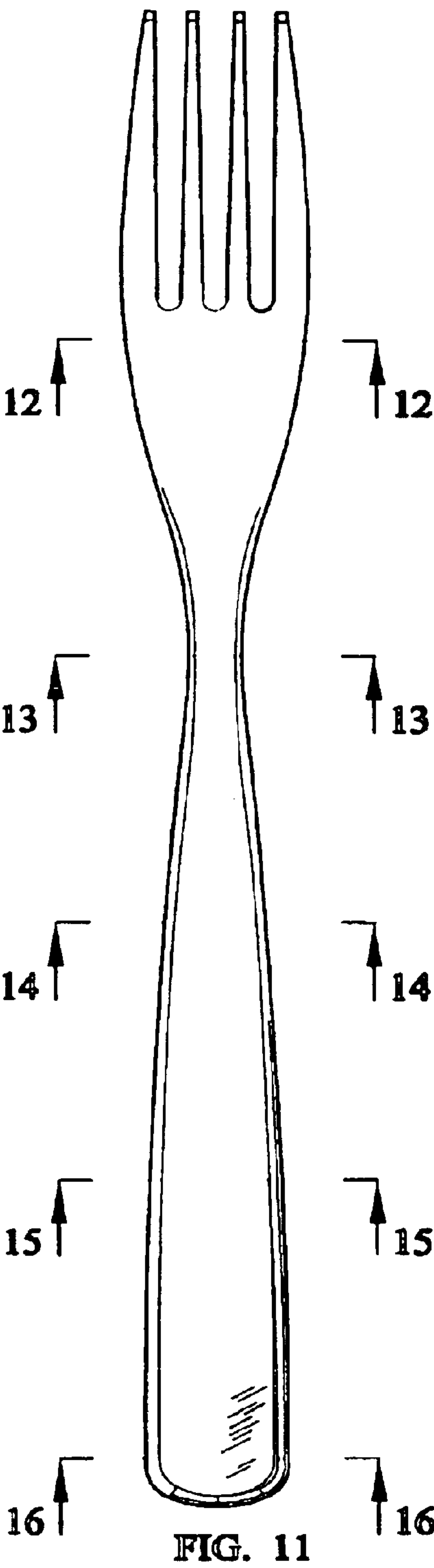
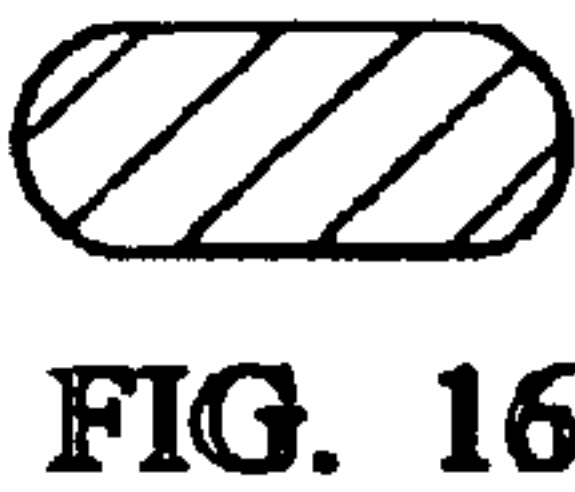
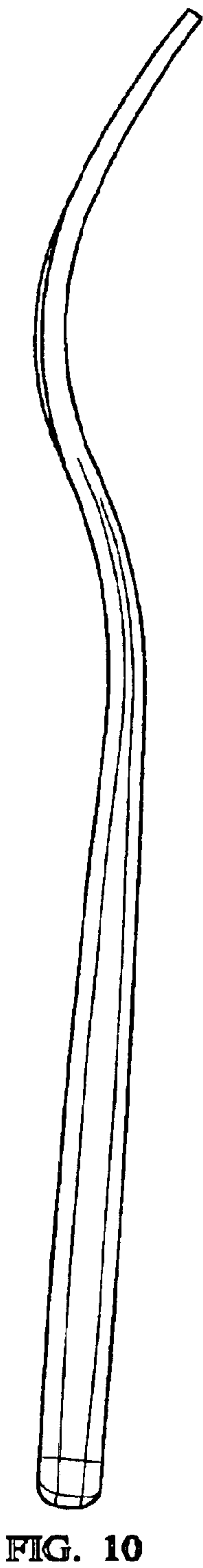

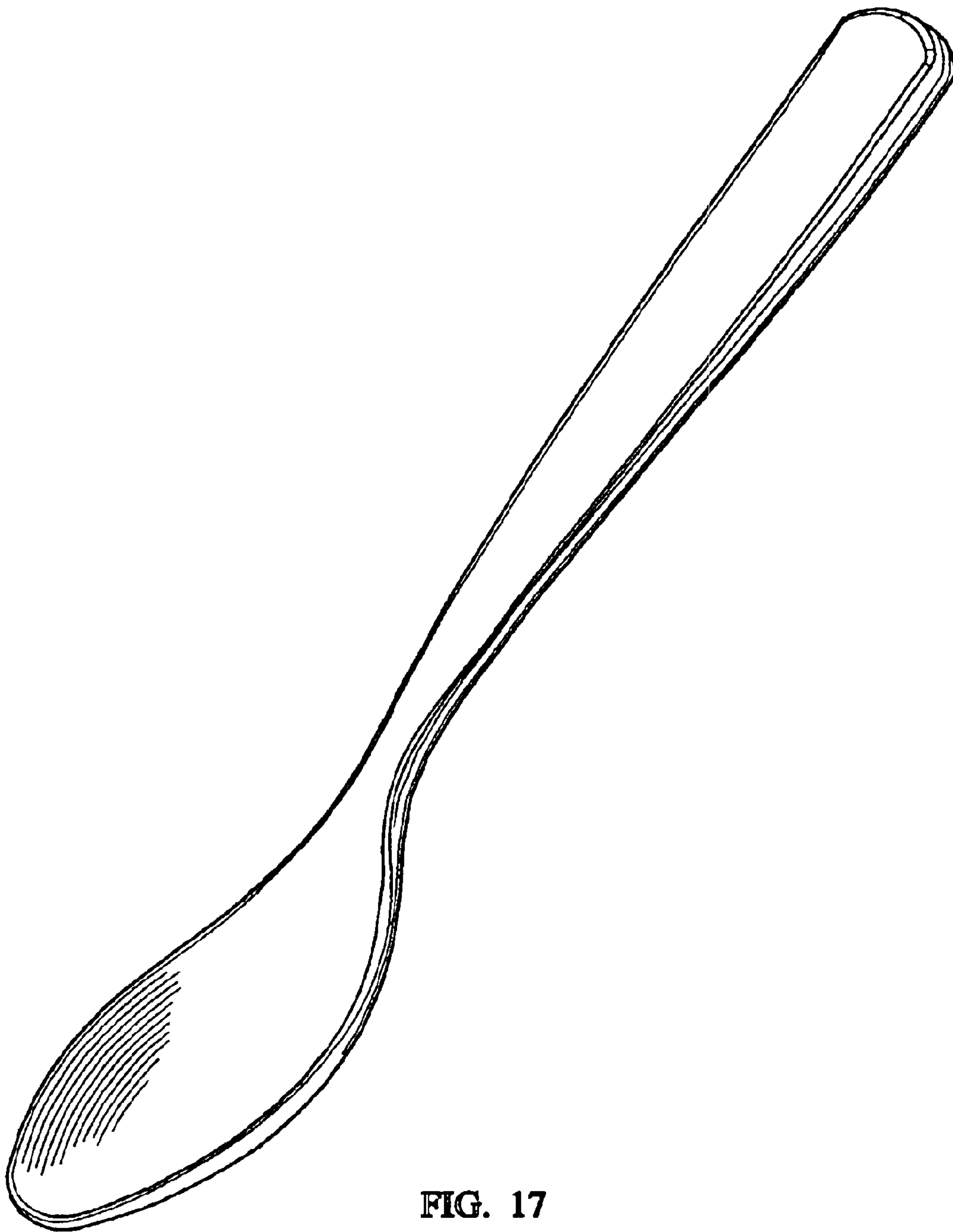

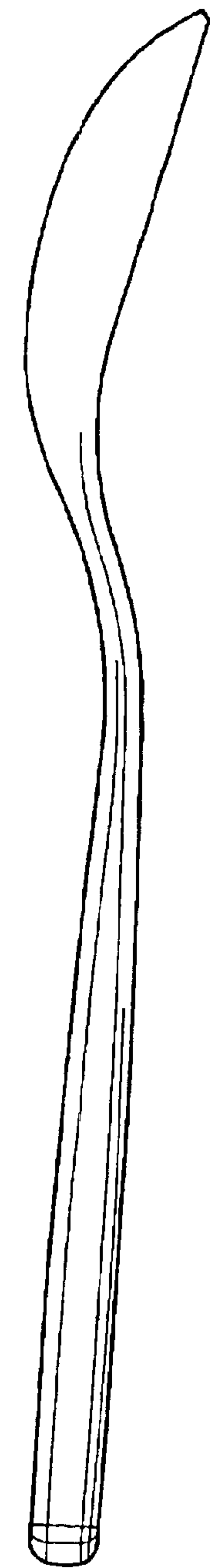

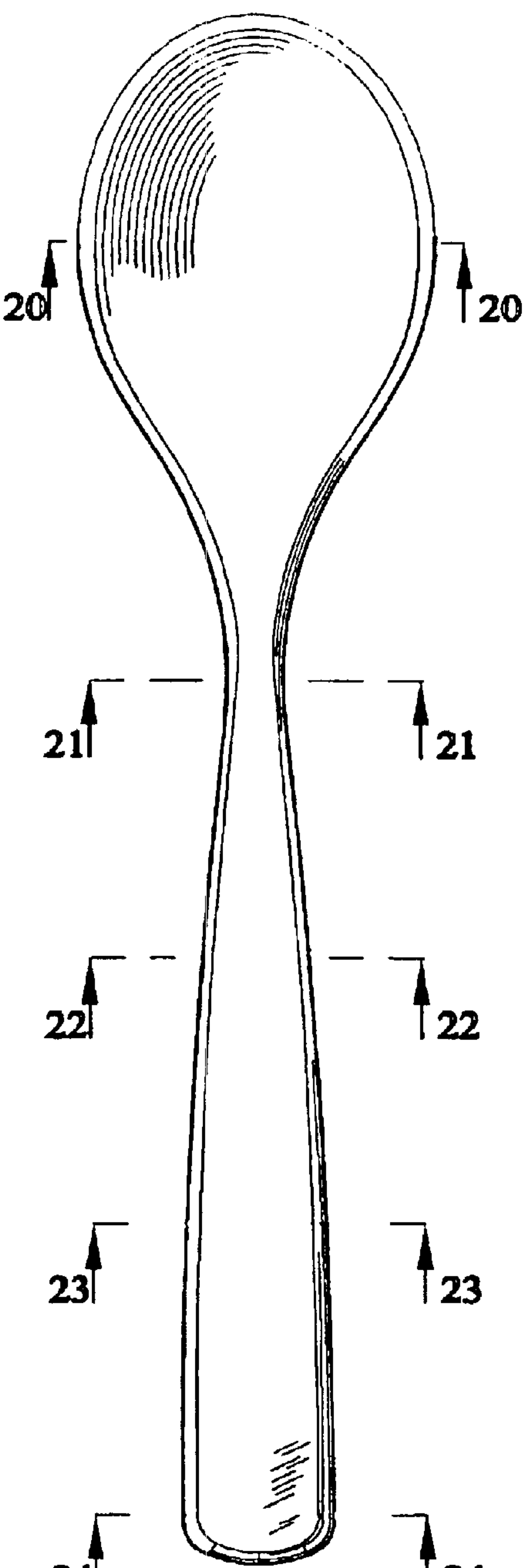
