FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof;

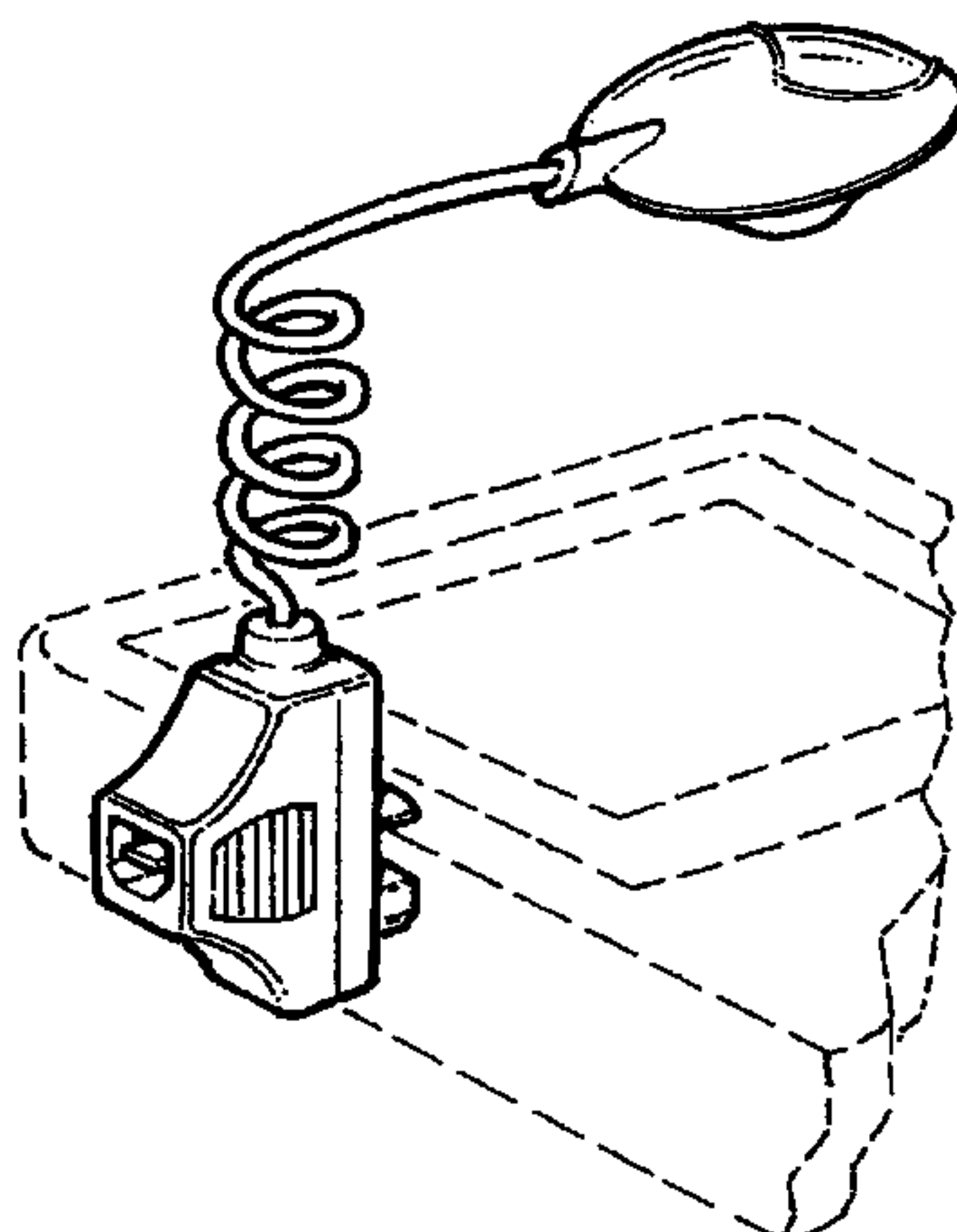
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a pass-through connector and plug of the light attachment for a portable electronic and computing device;

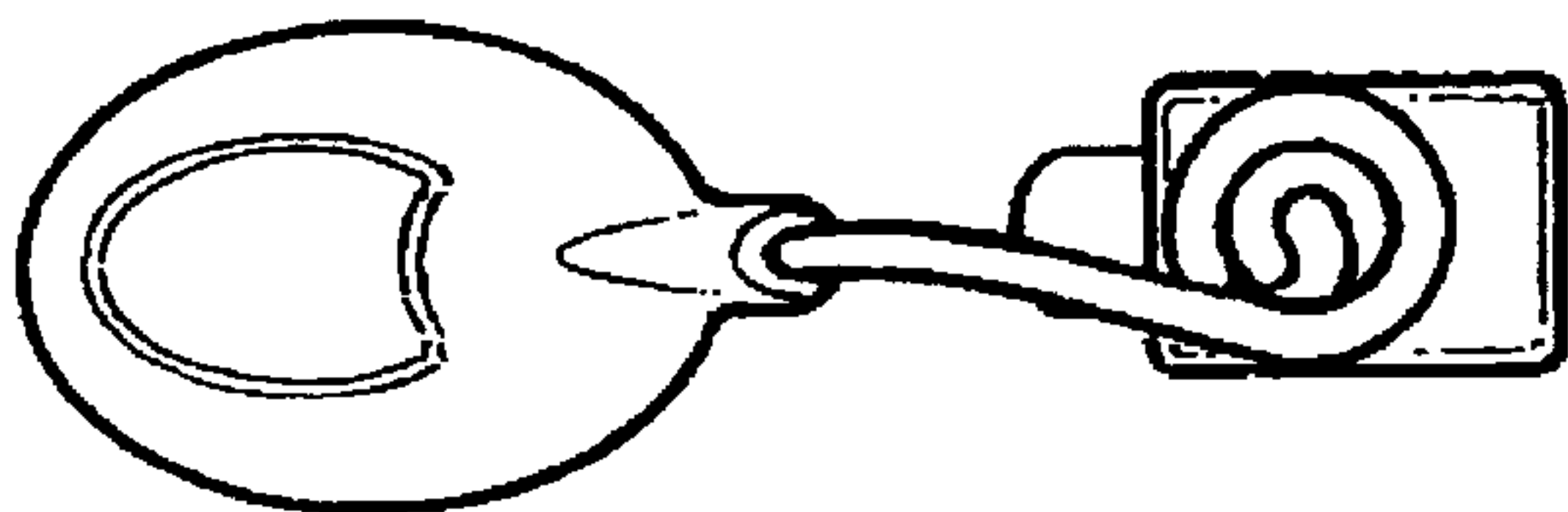
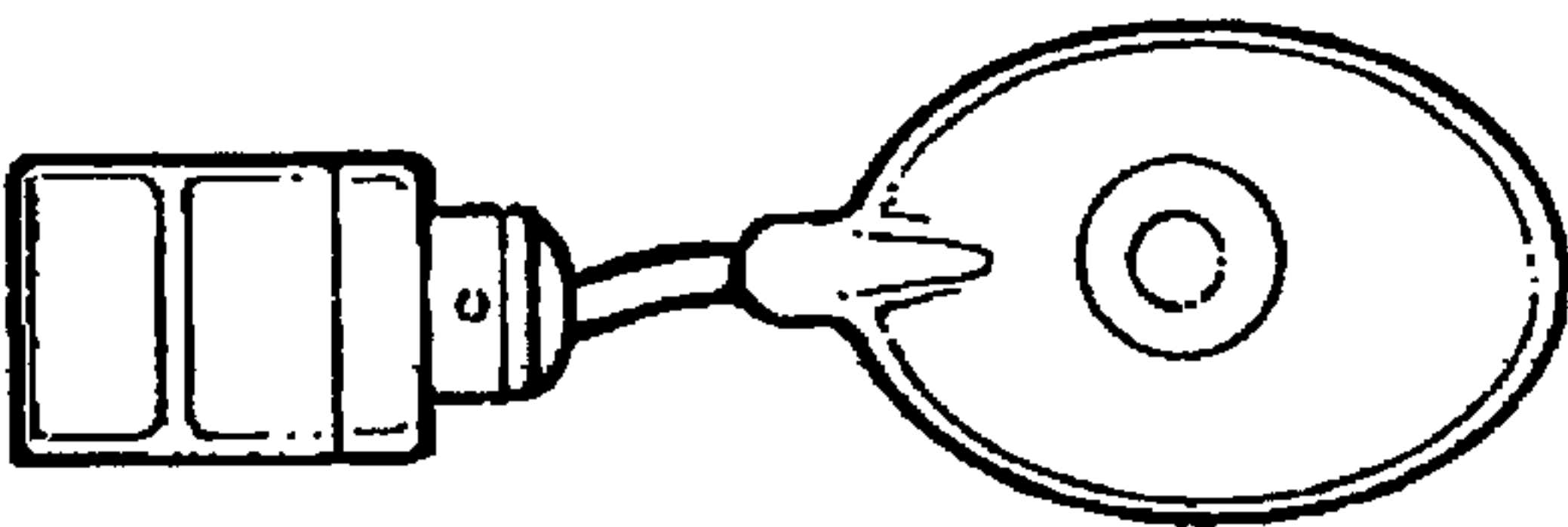
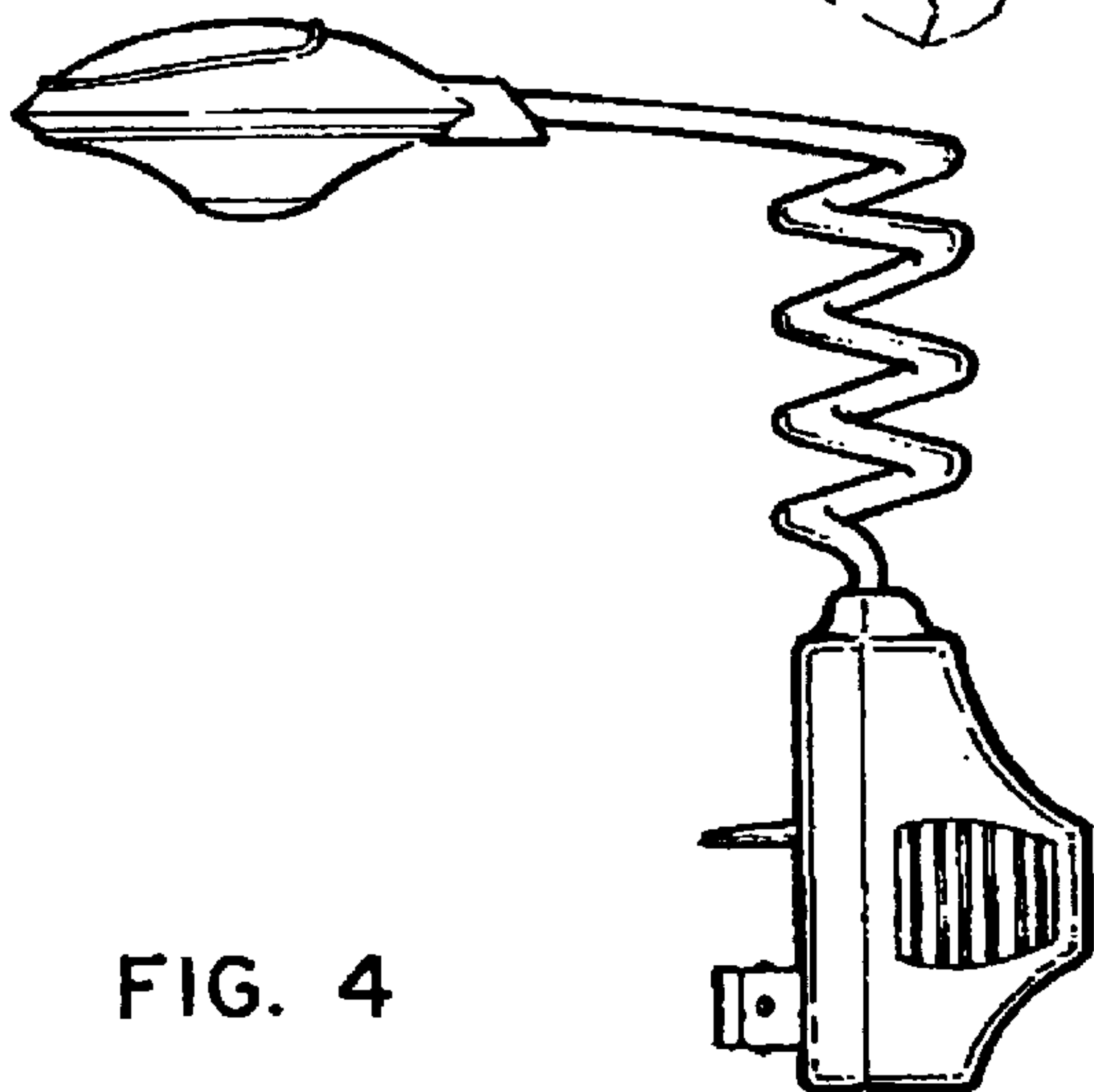
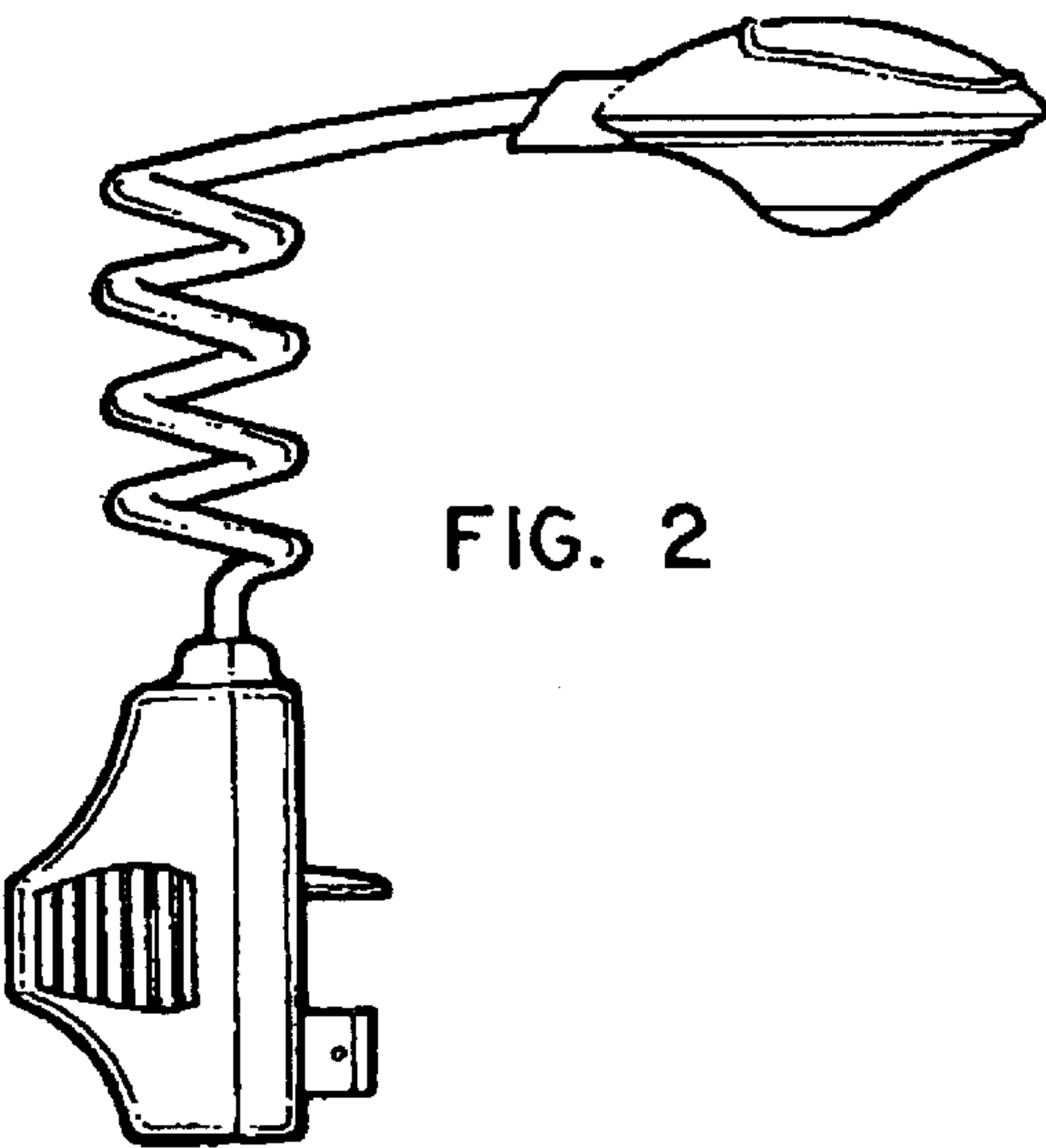
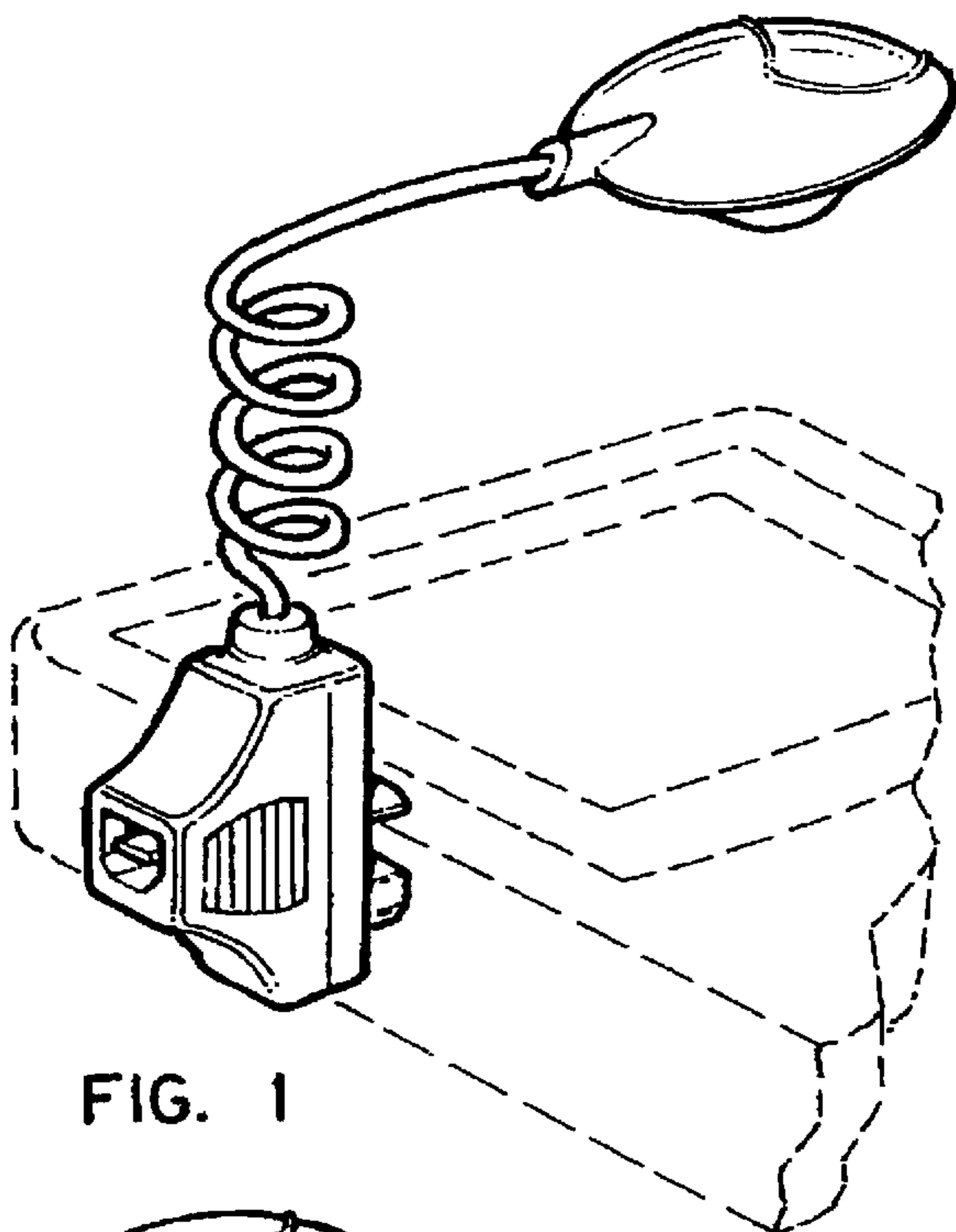


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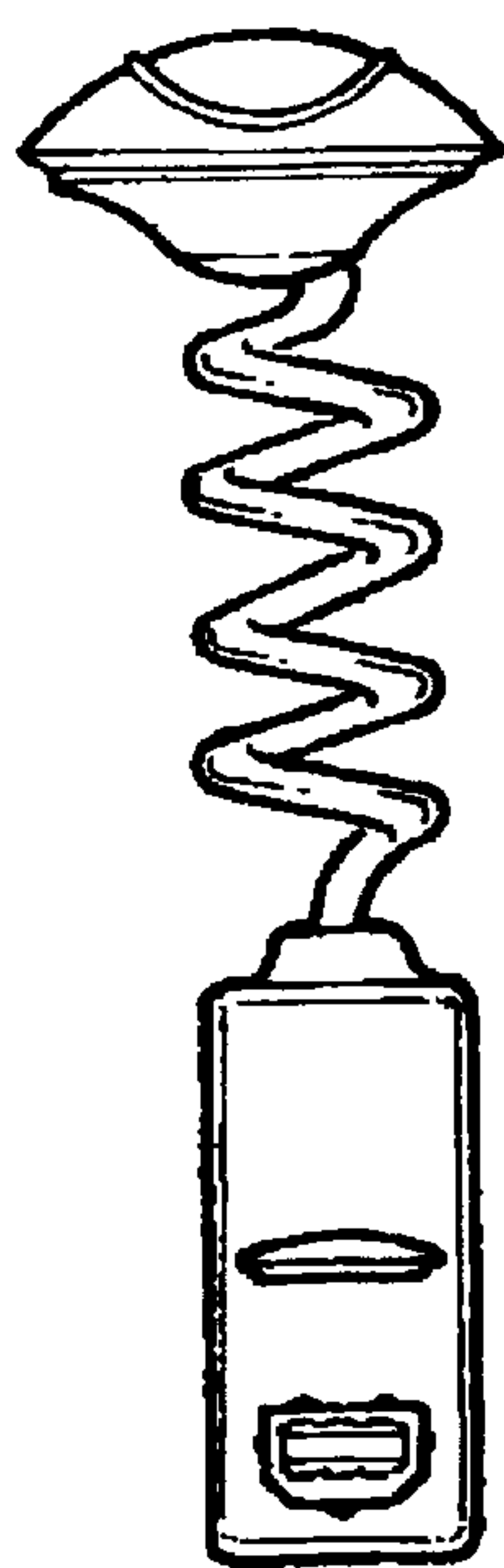

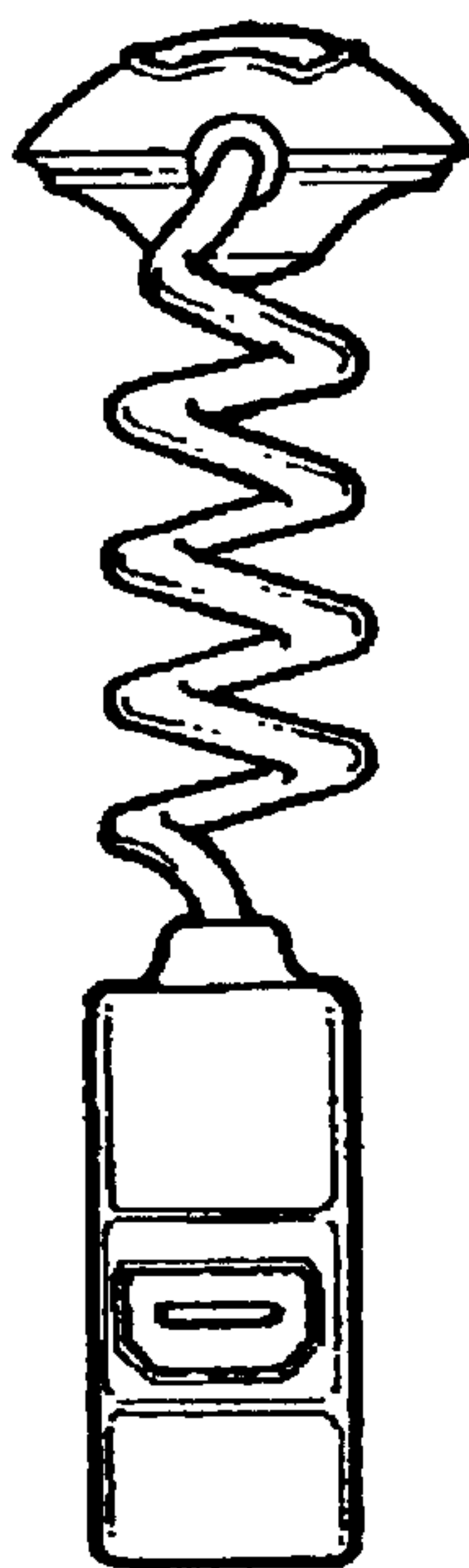

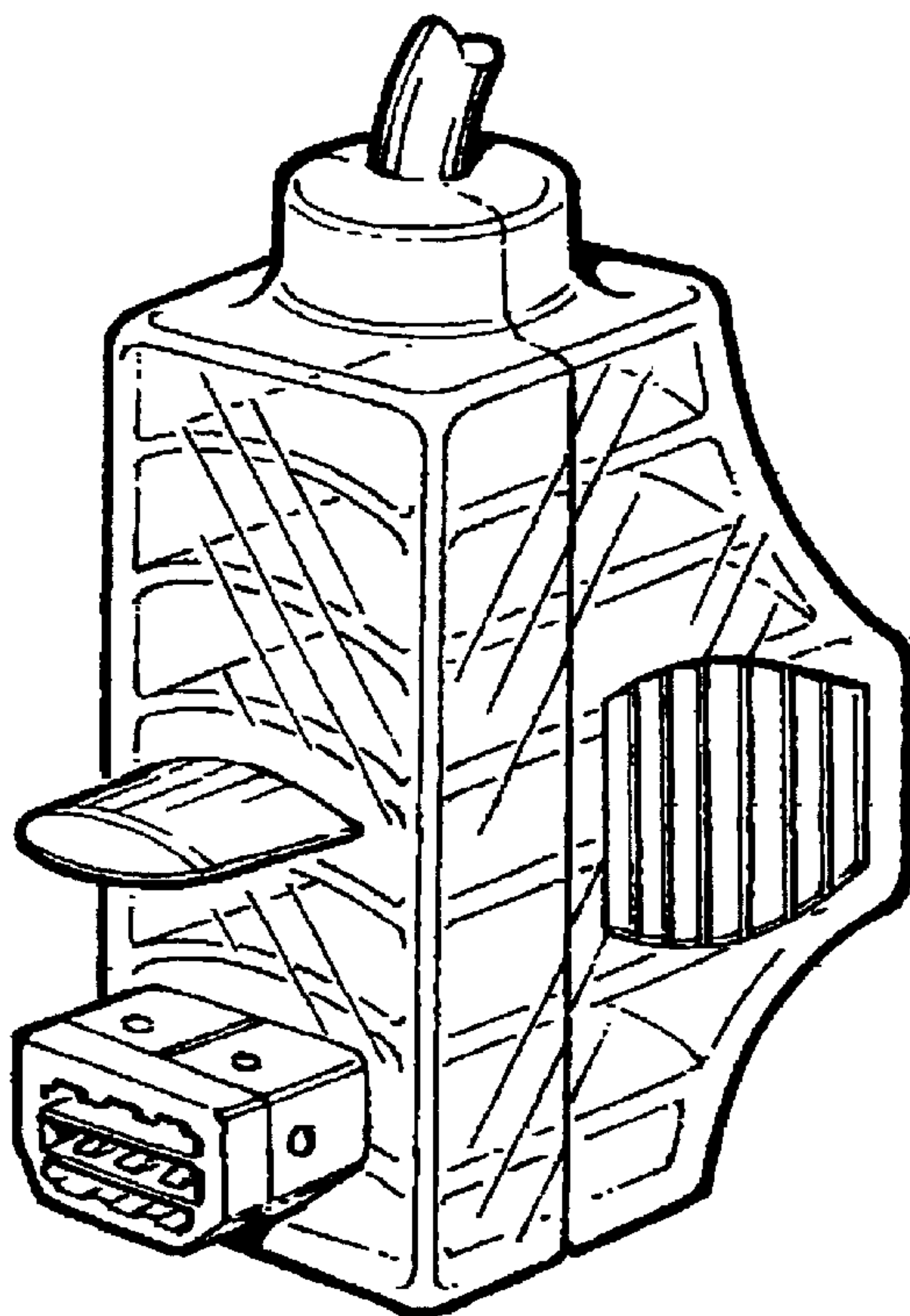

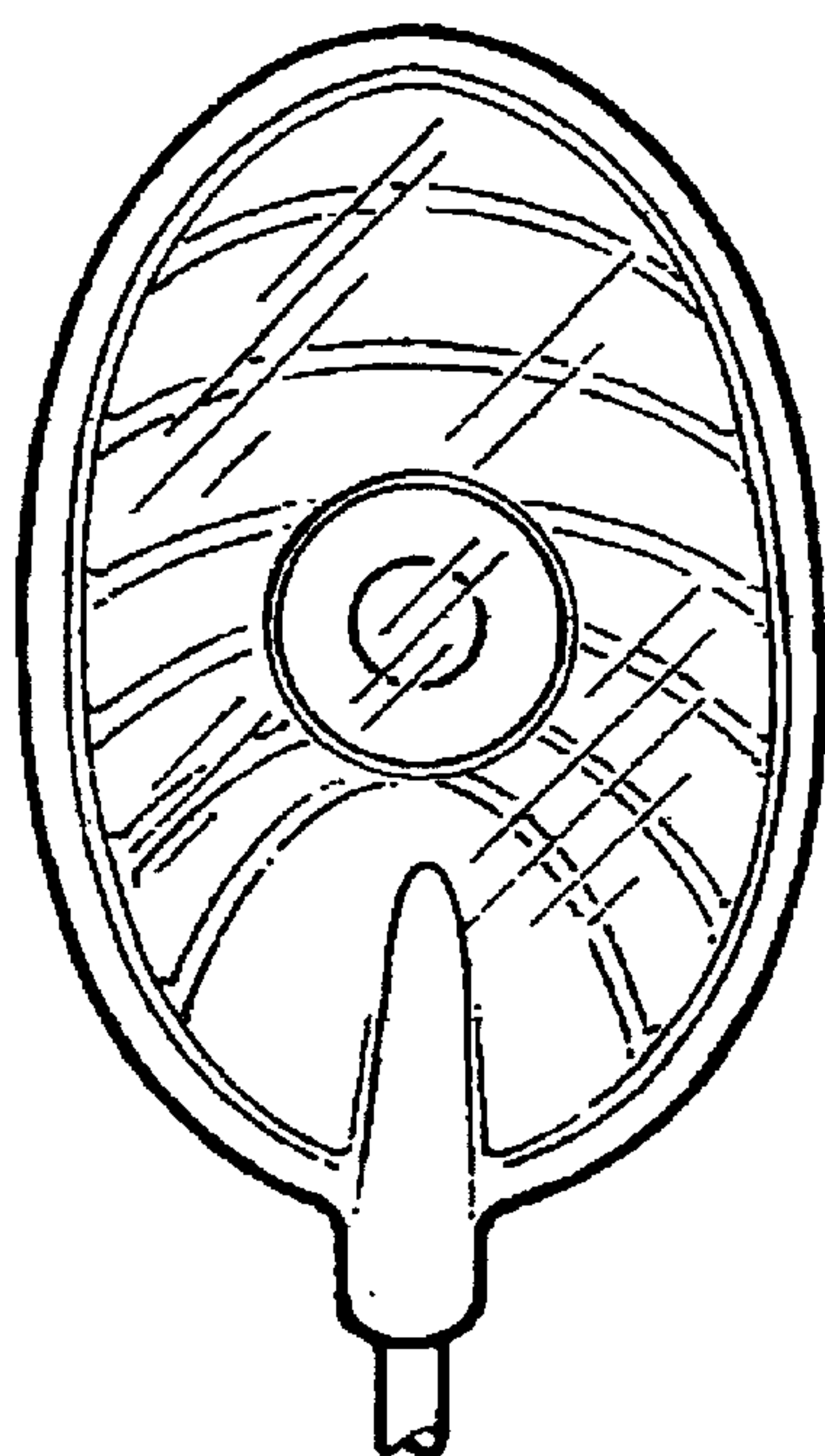

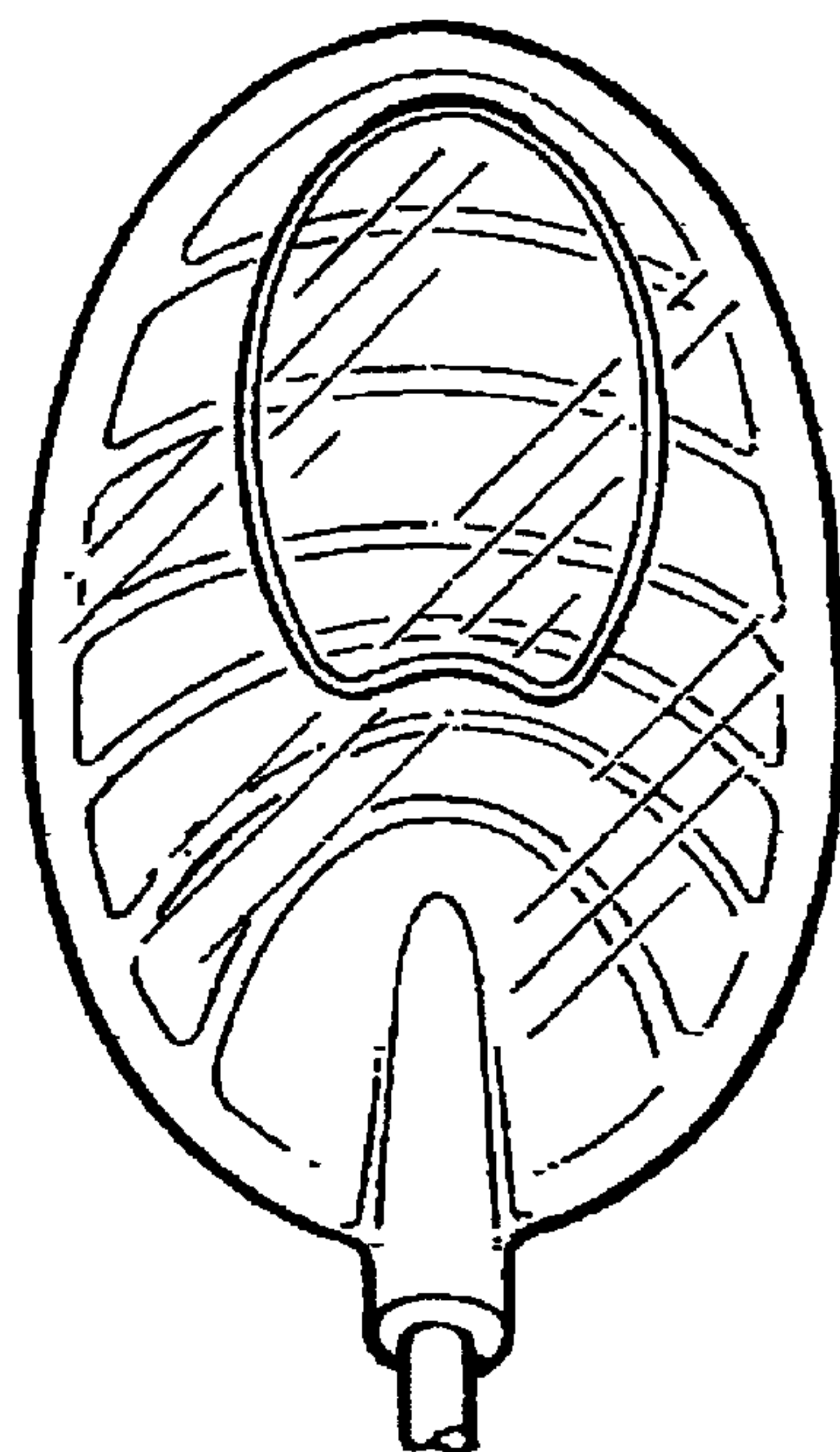
