FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken line showing of the personal digital assistant in FIG. 1 and FIG. 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design. The window covering the digital assistant is transparent.
