FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

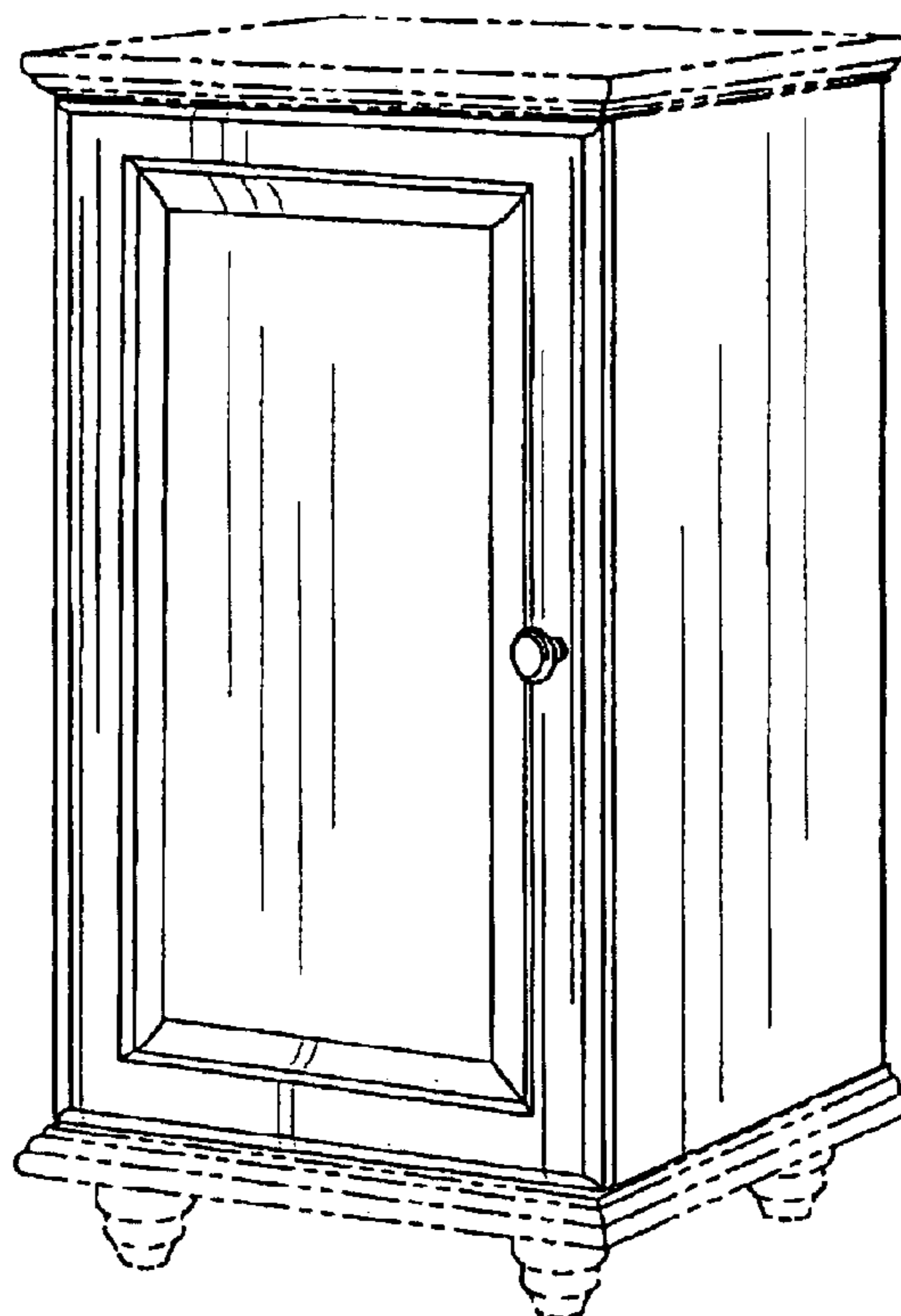
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the opposite side being a

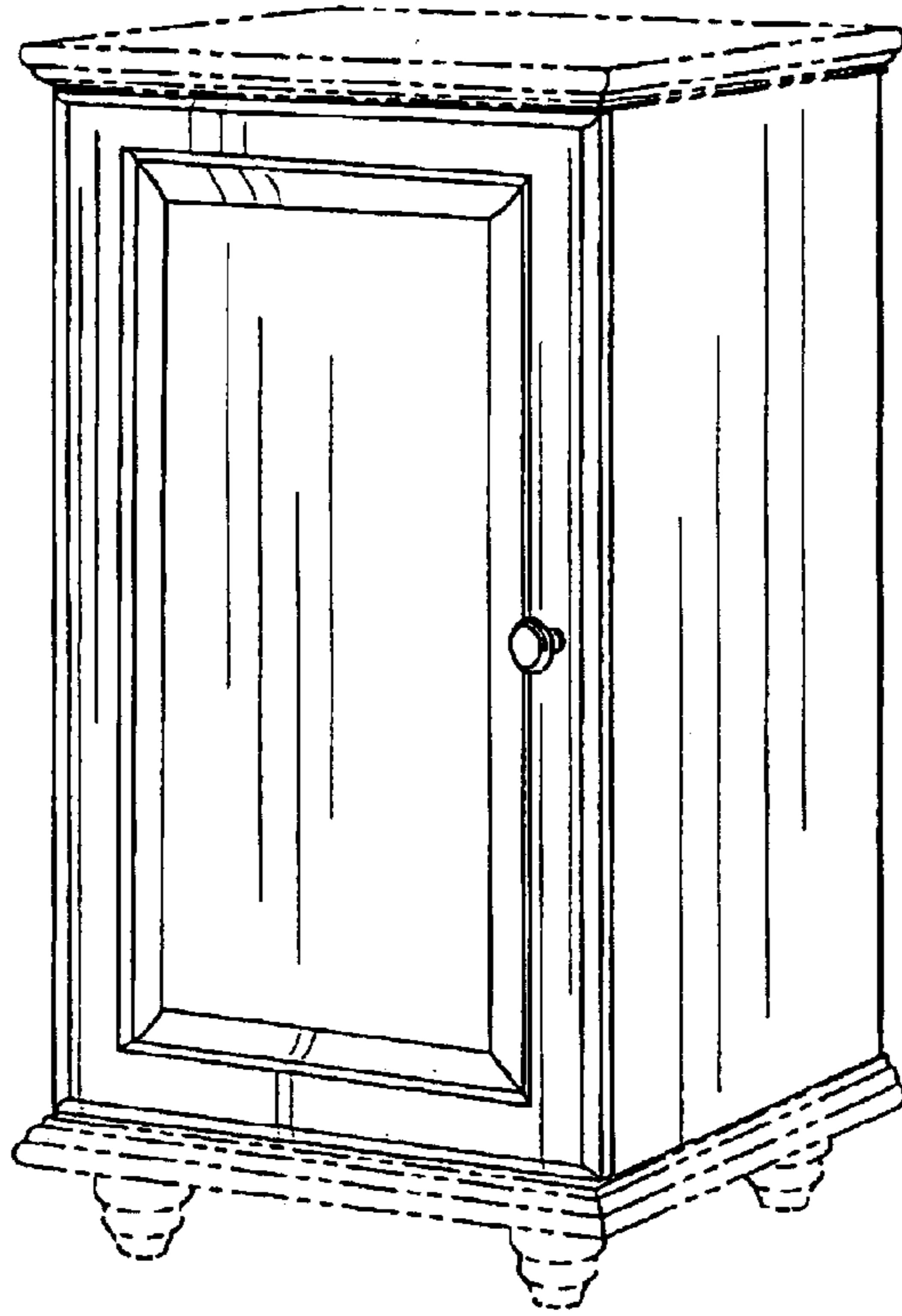

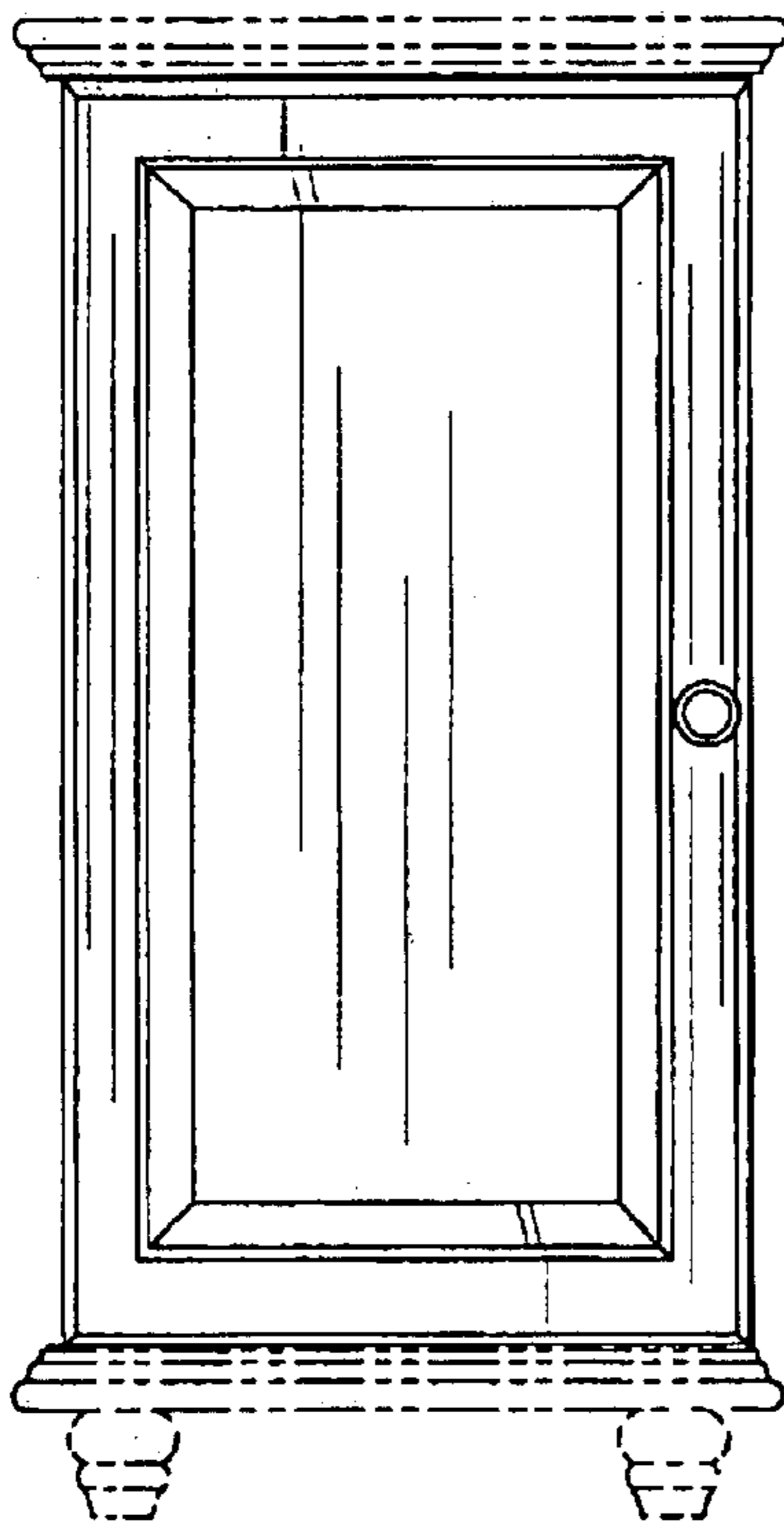

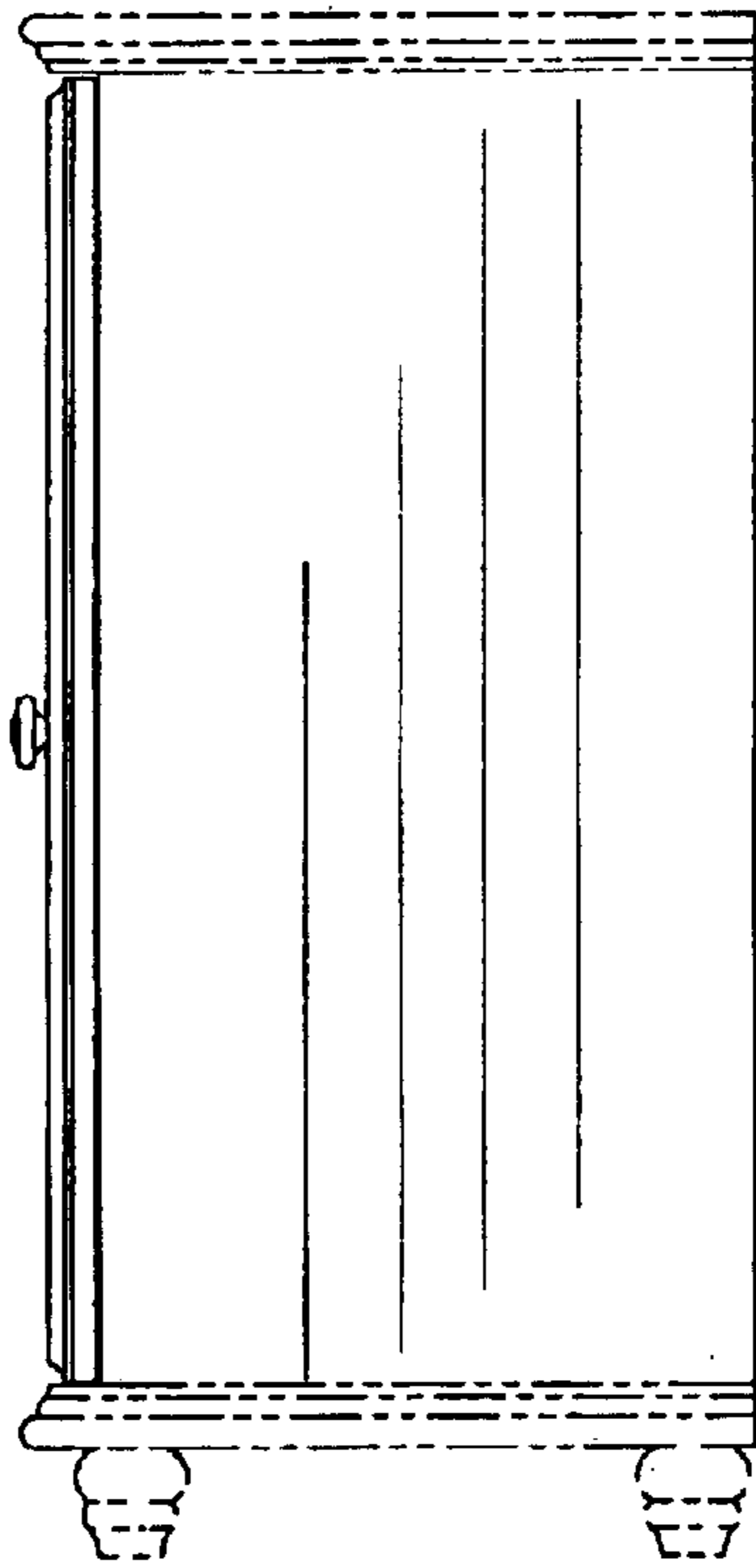

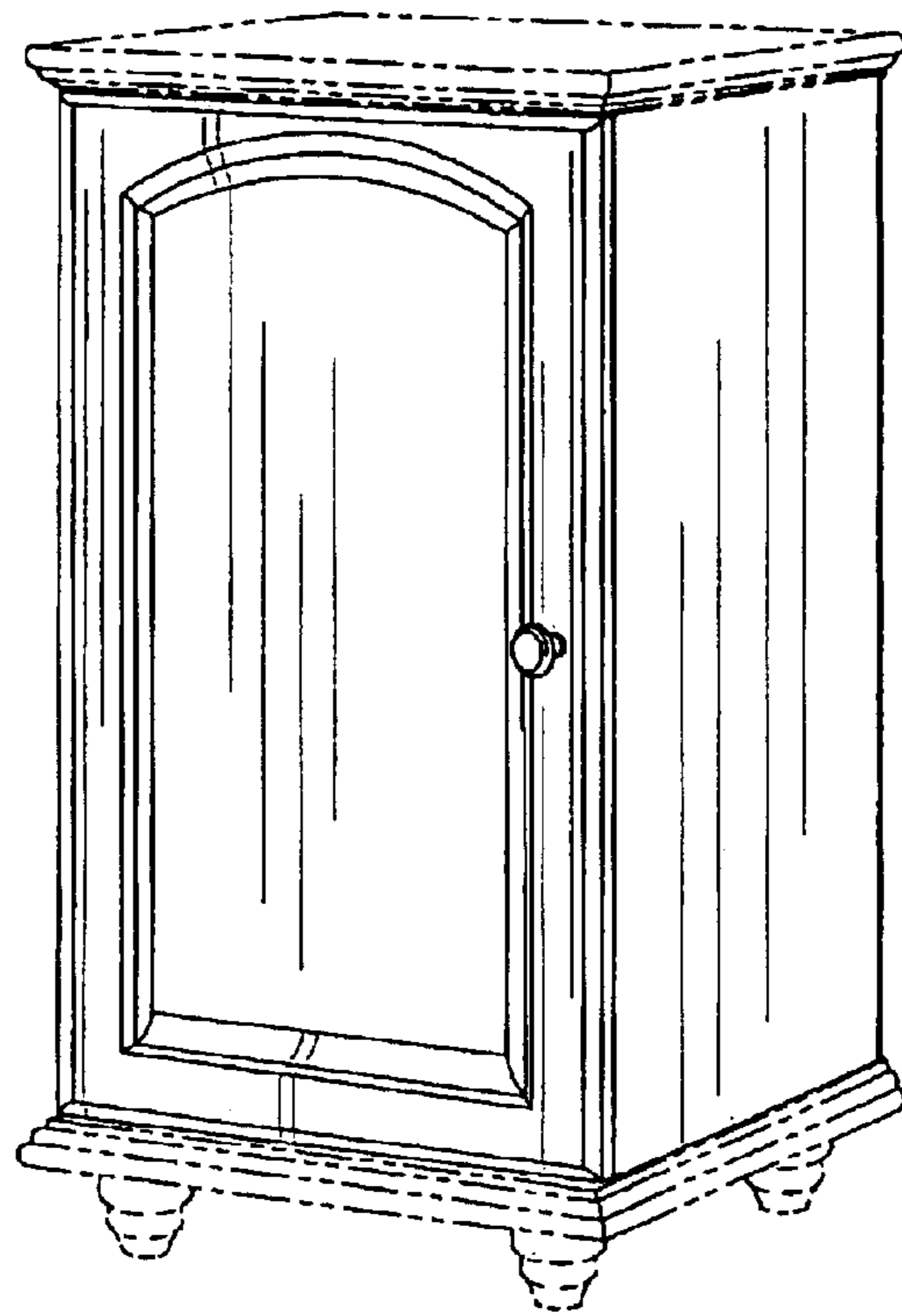

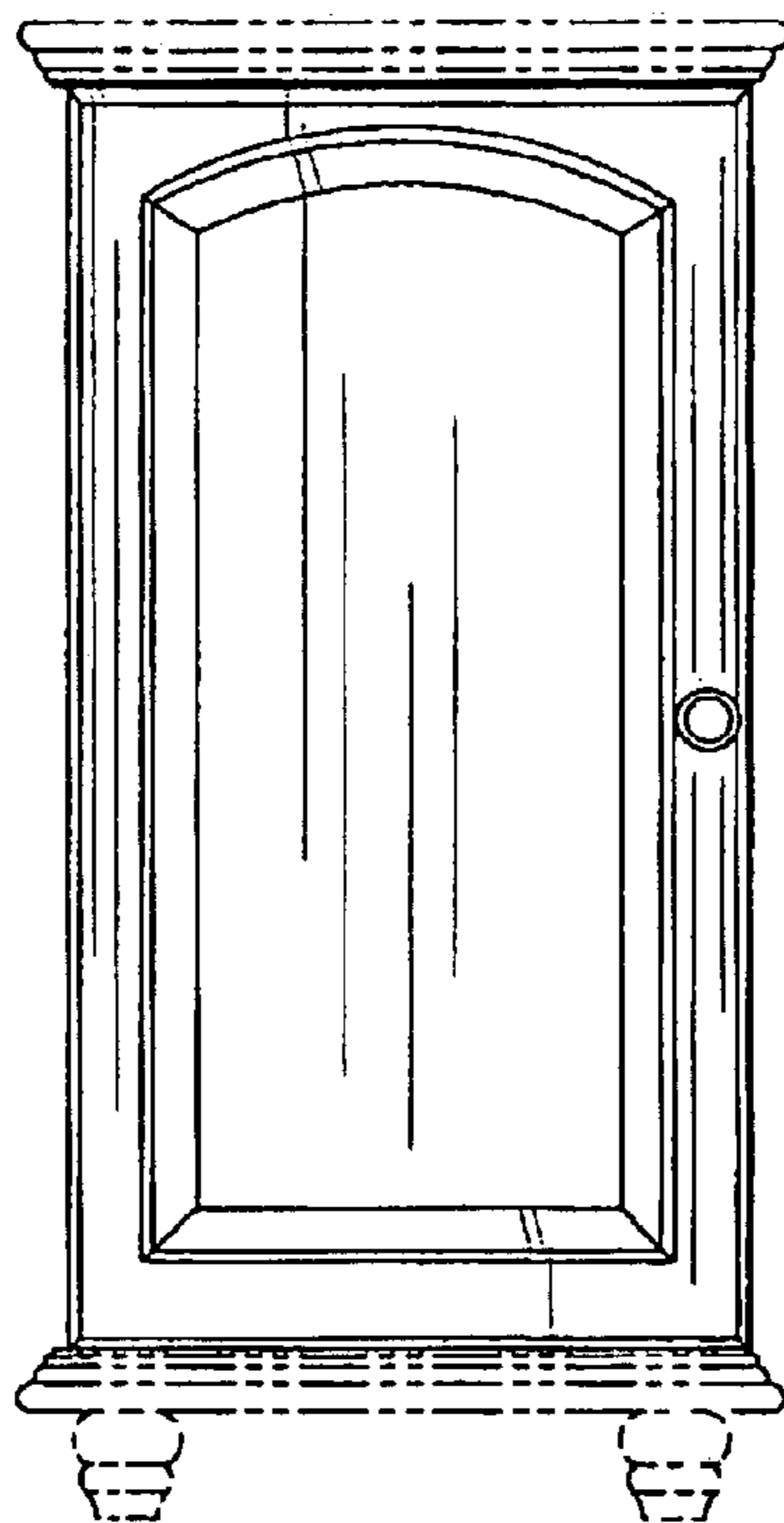
