(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a spout, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left, top, front perspective view of a spout
embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side
elevational view being a mirror image of the left side shown;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line representations of a hole in FIGS. 1 and 5,
and of mounting structure in FIG. 6, are for the purpose of
illustration only, and form no part of the claimed design.

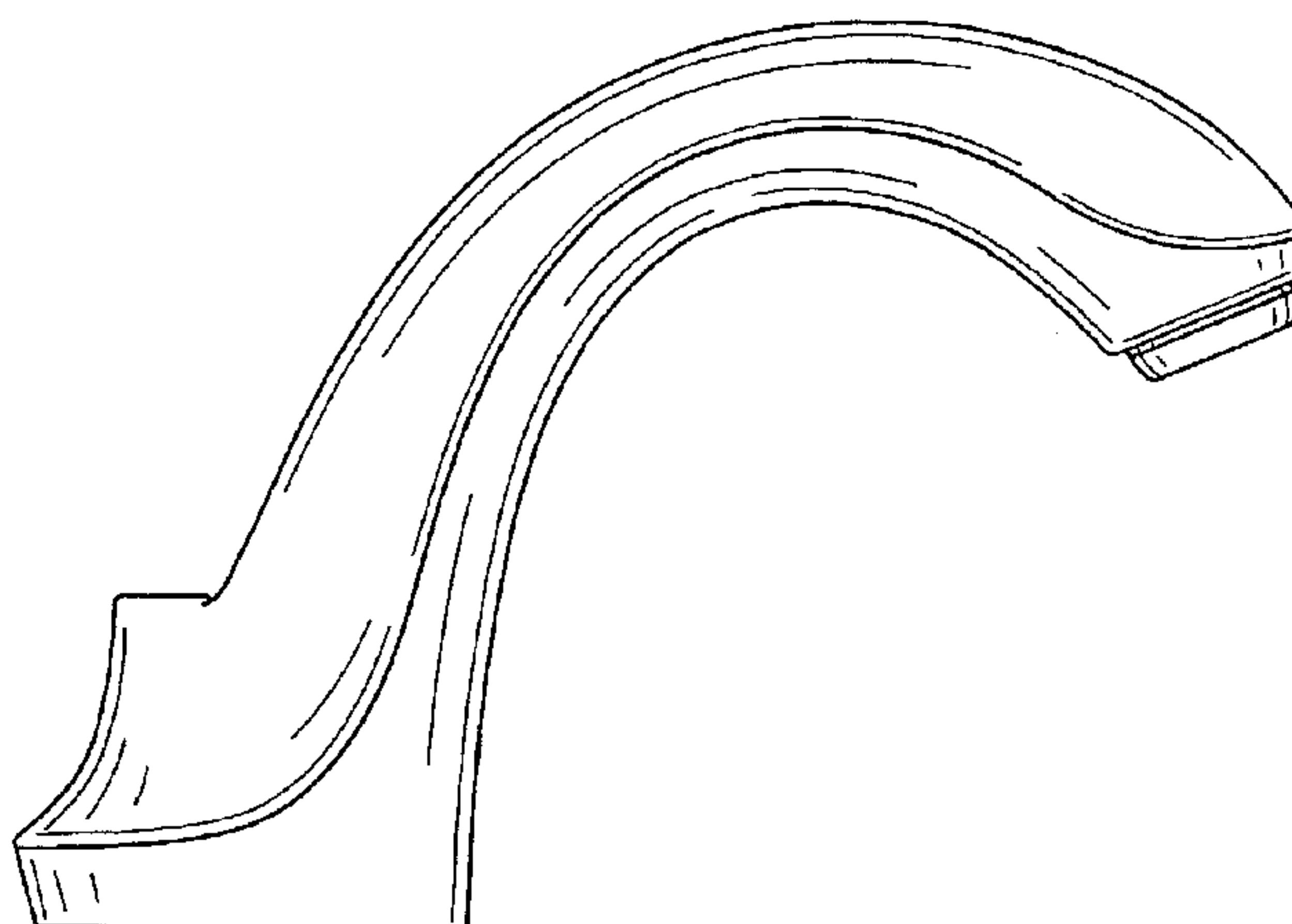
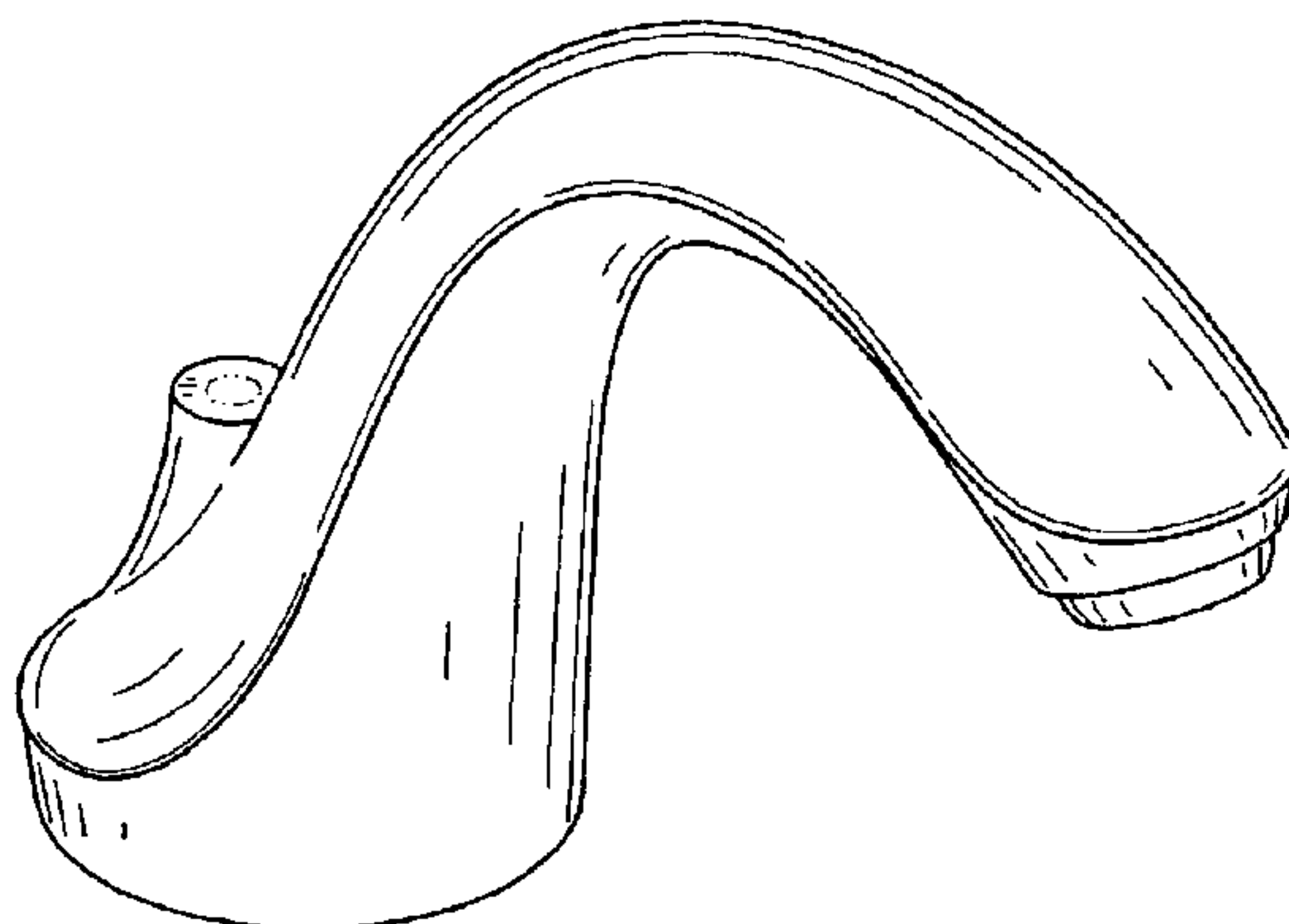

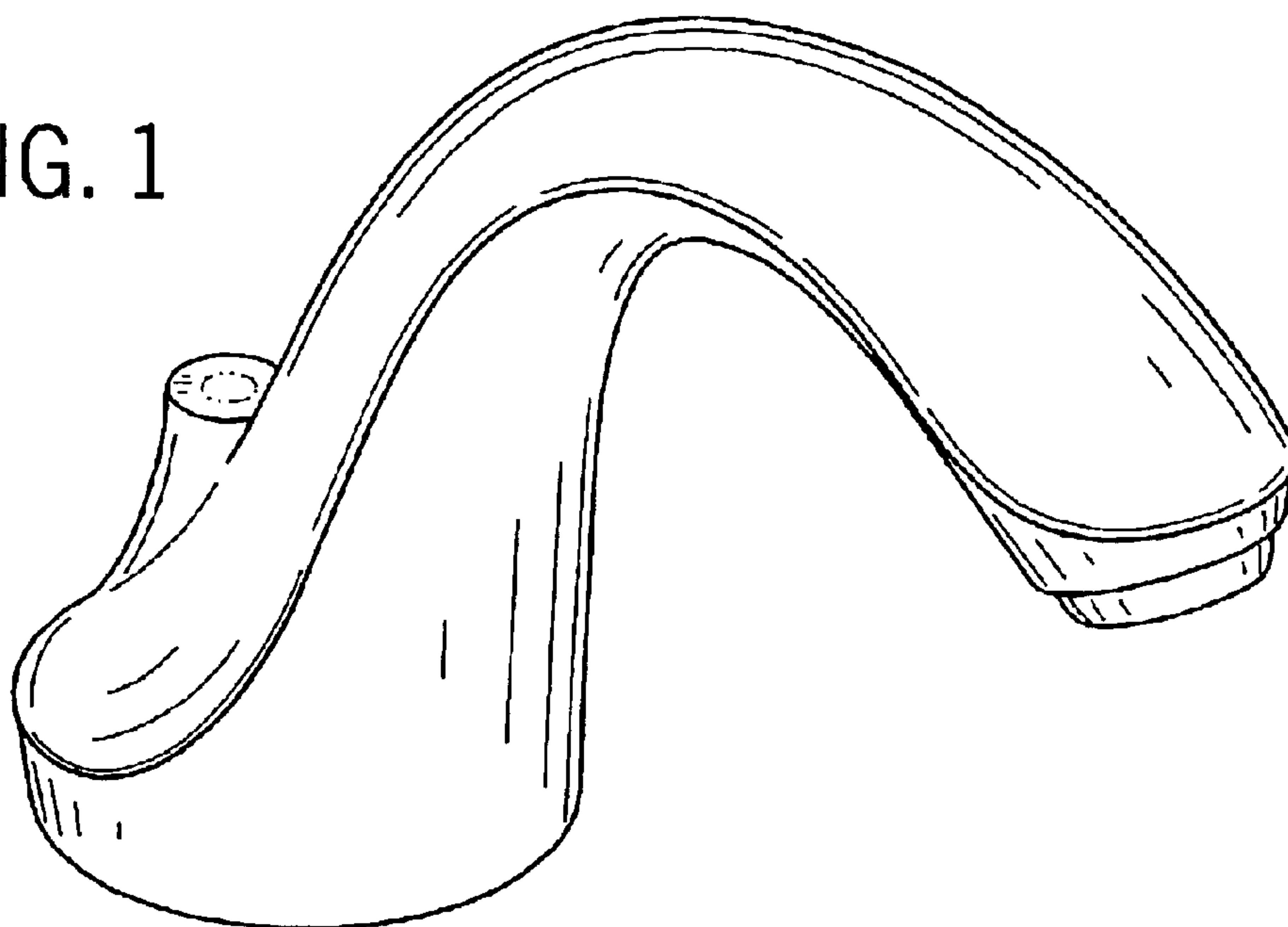
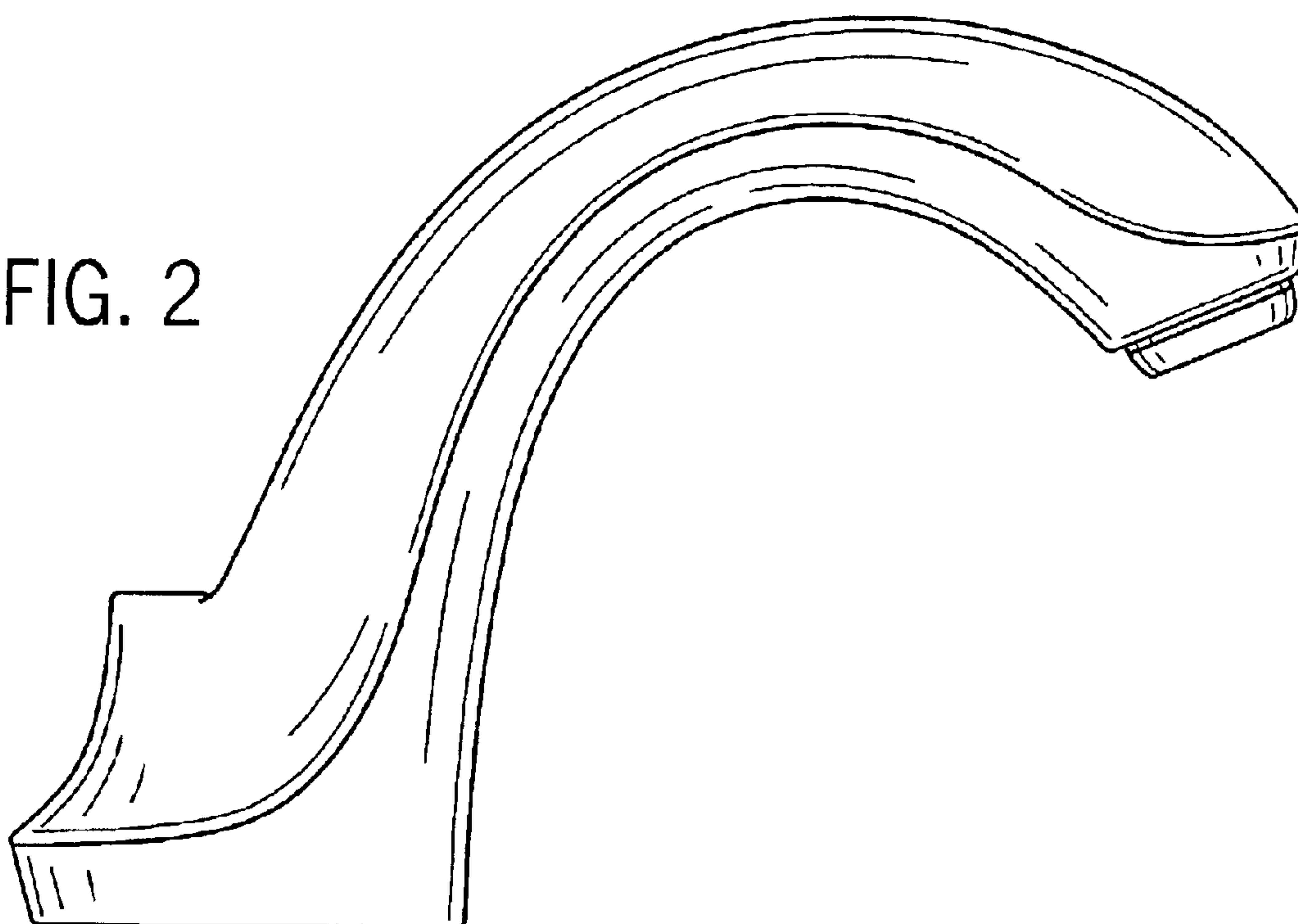

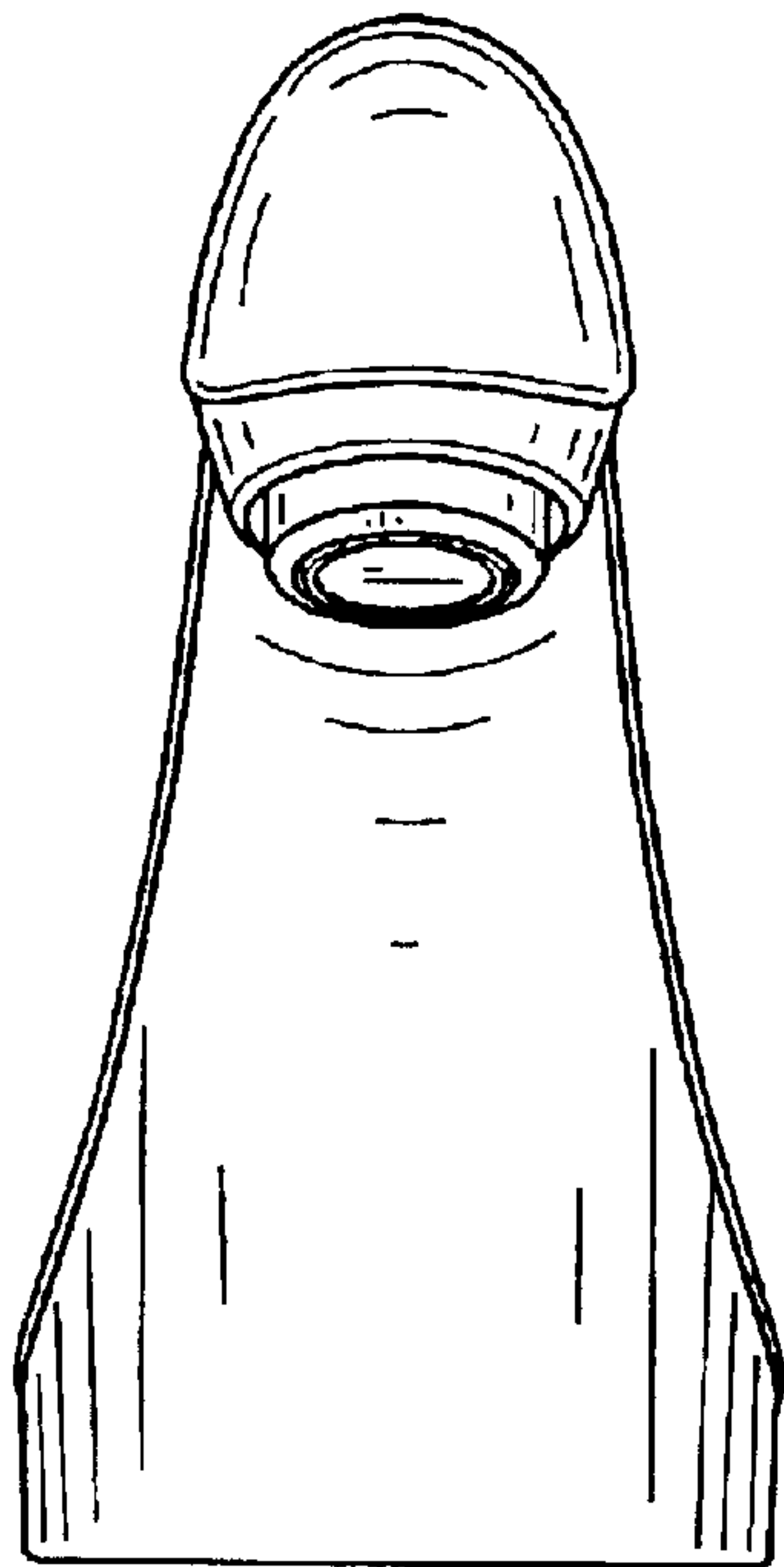

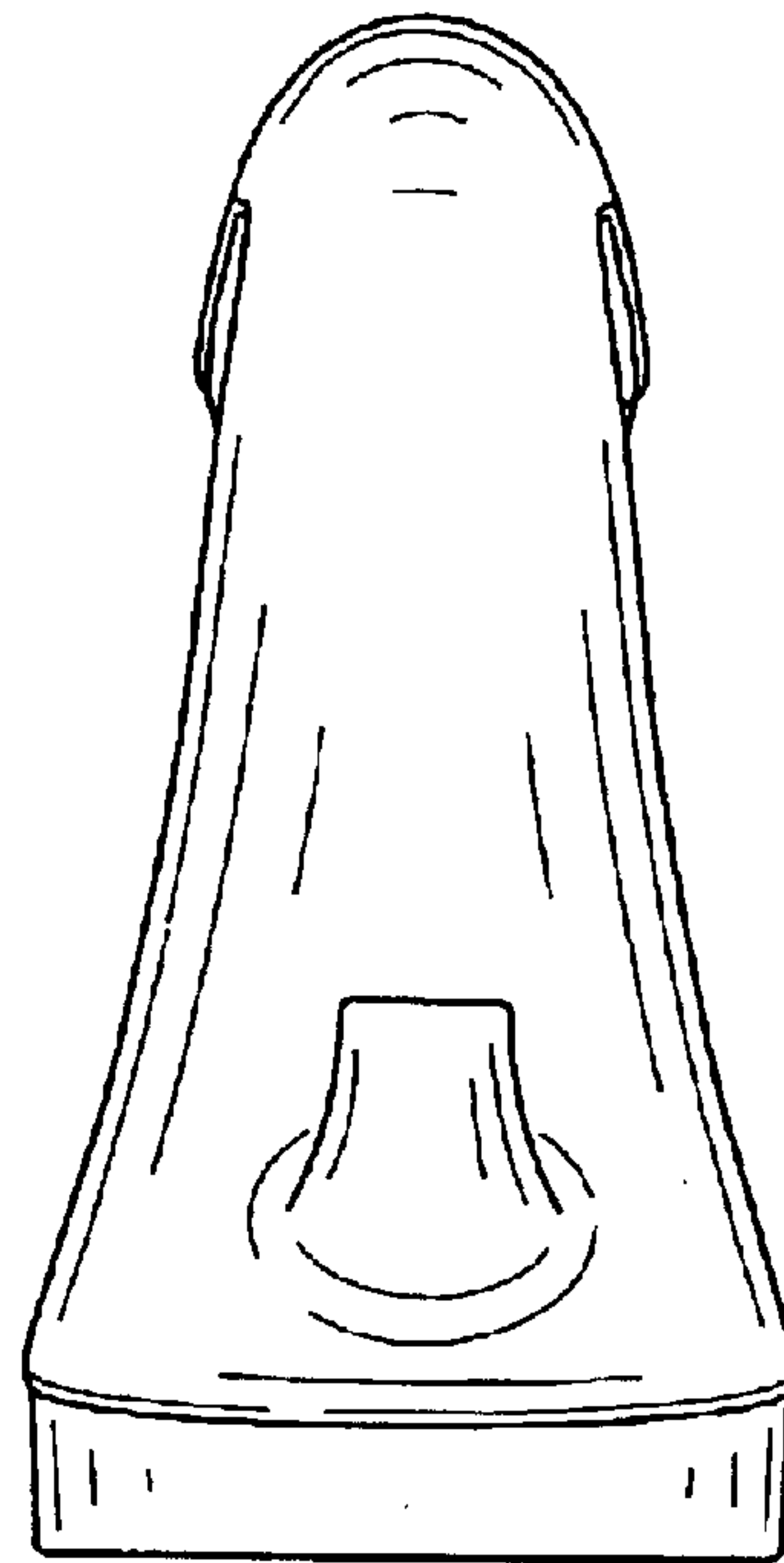

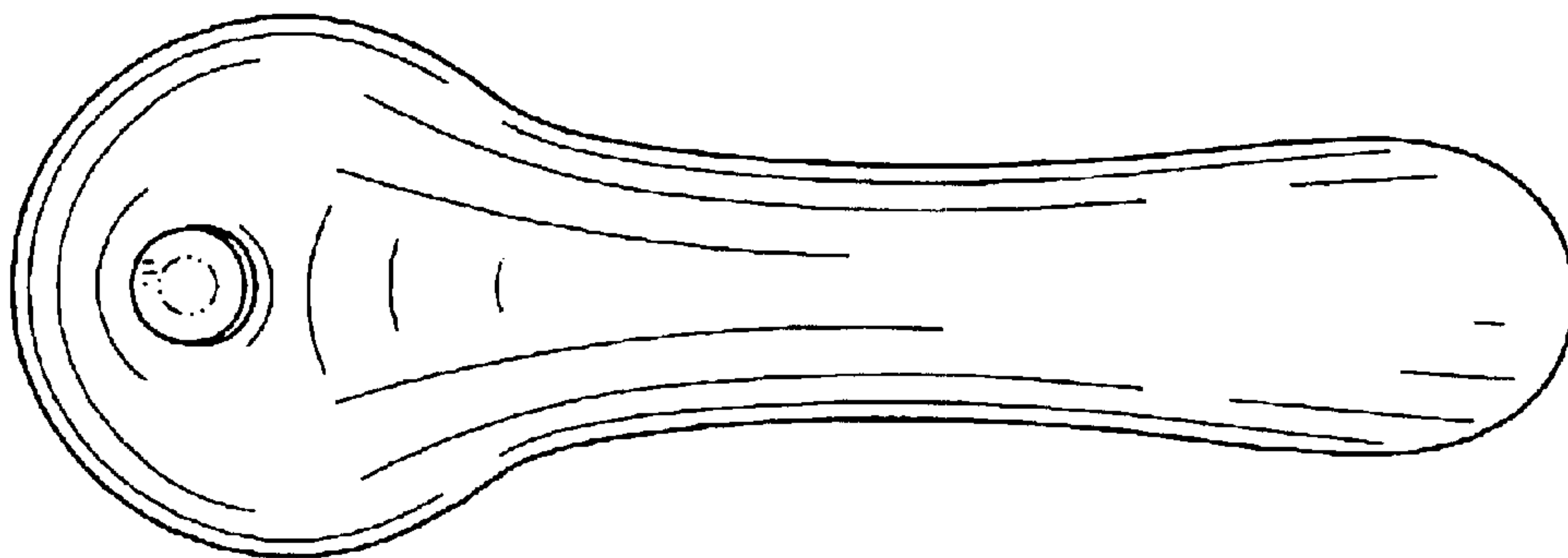

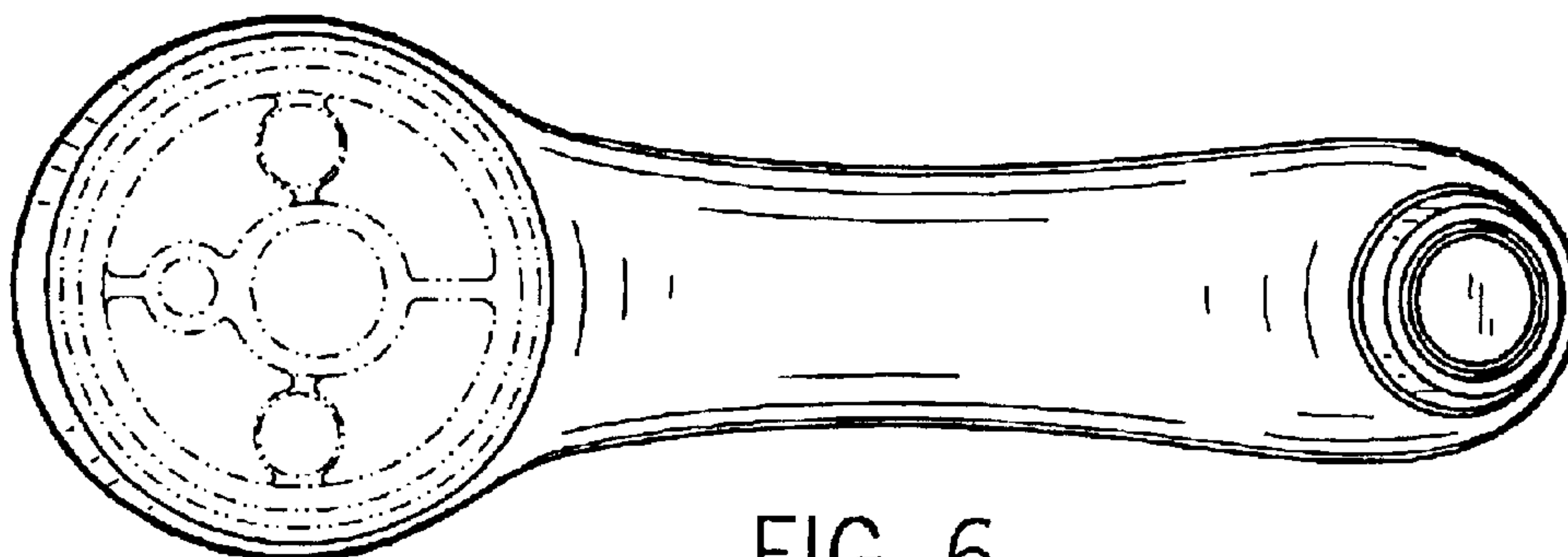
