being a mirror image thereof;

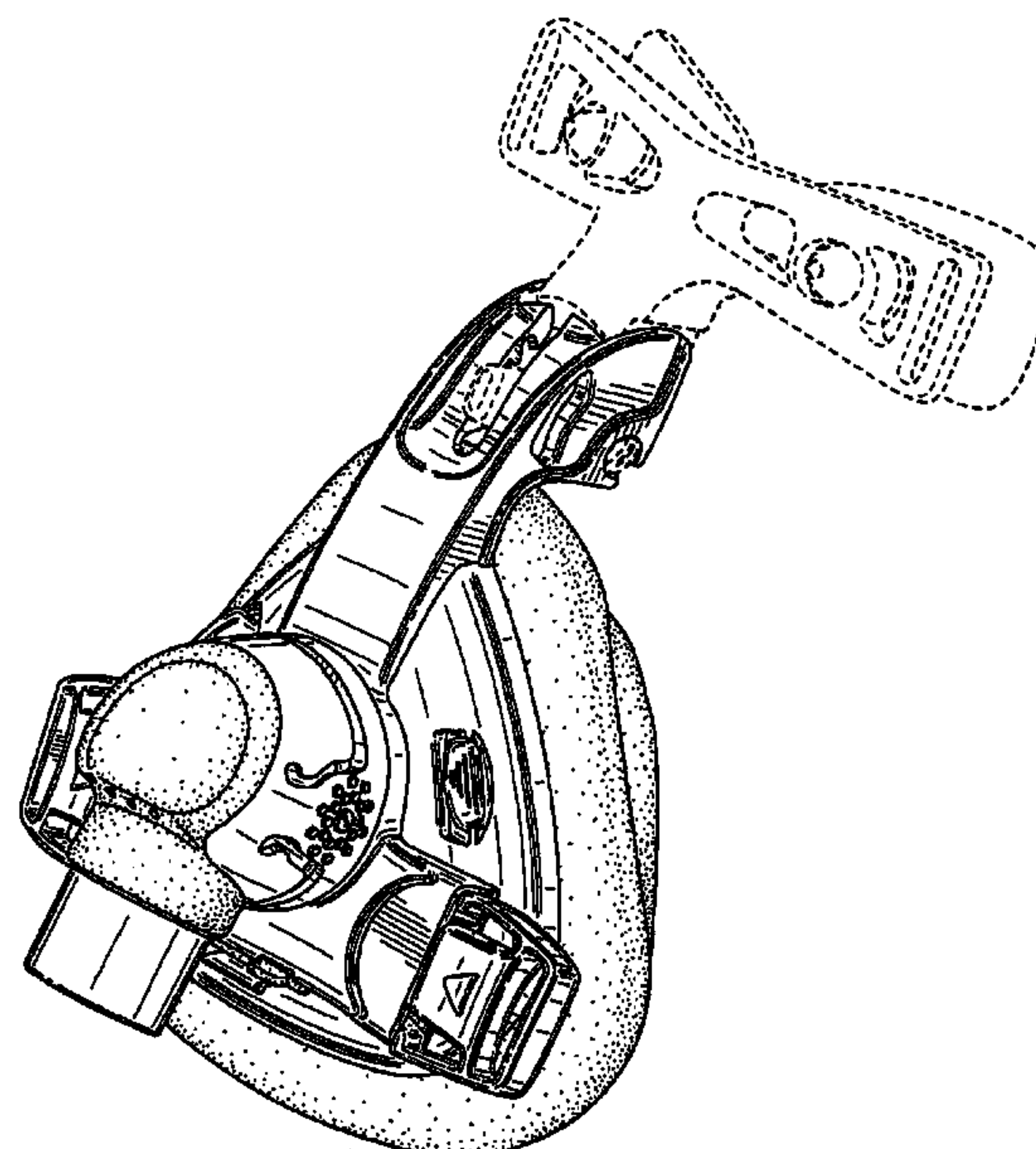
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,

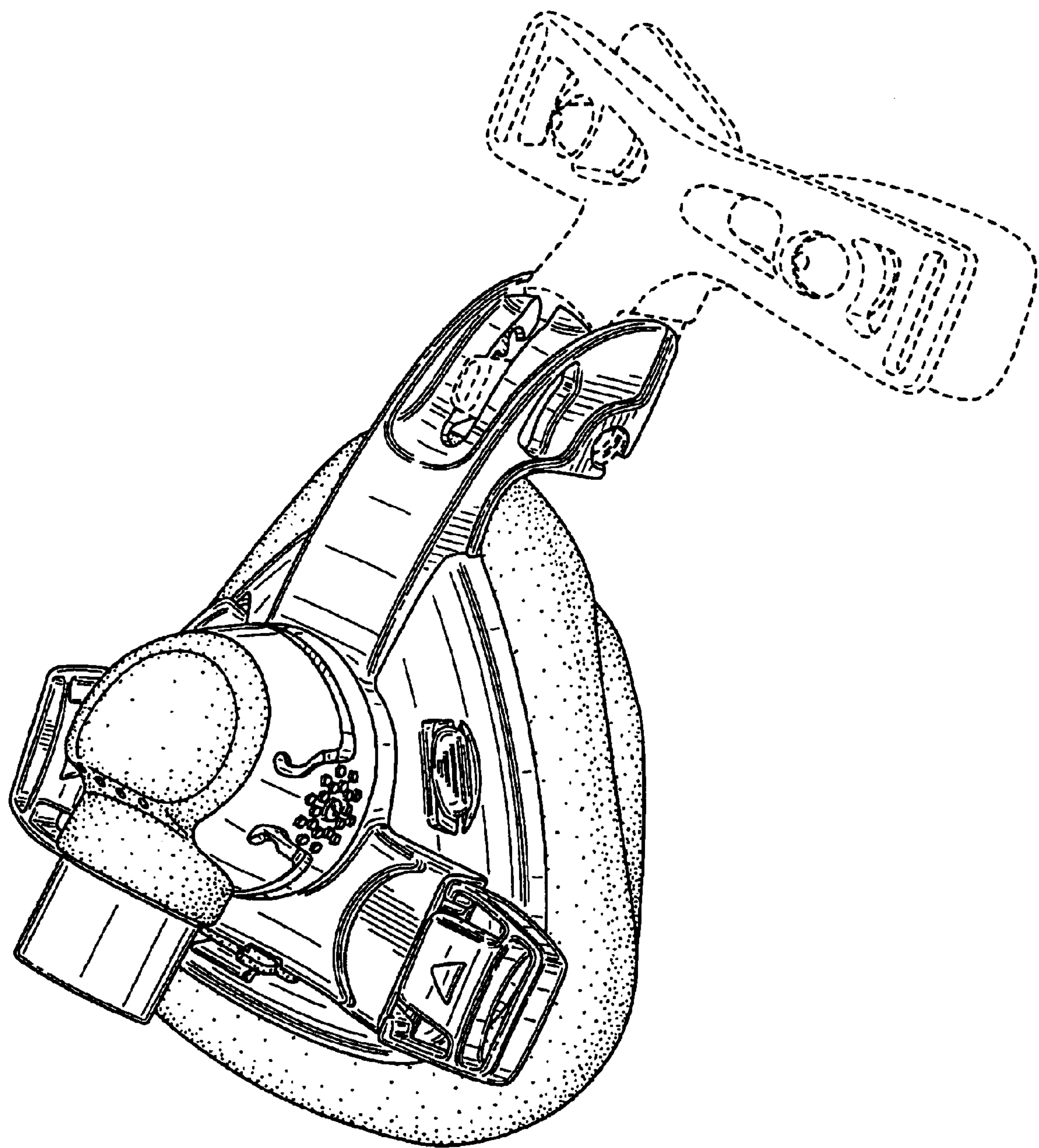

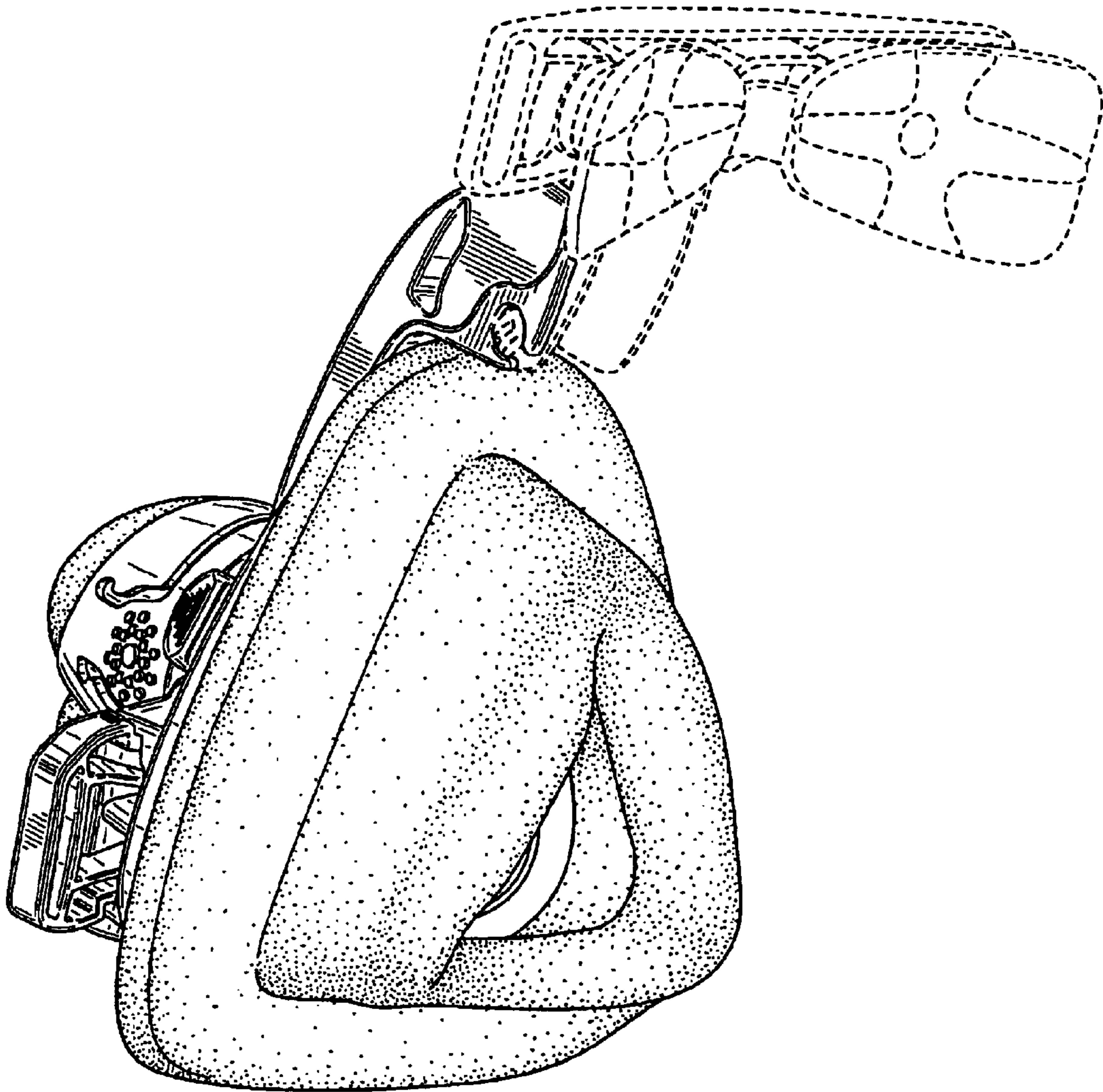

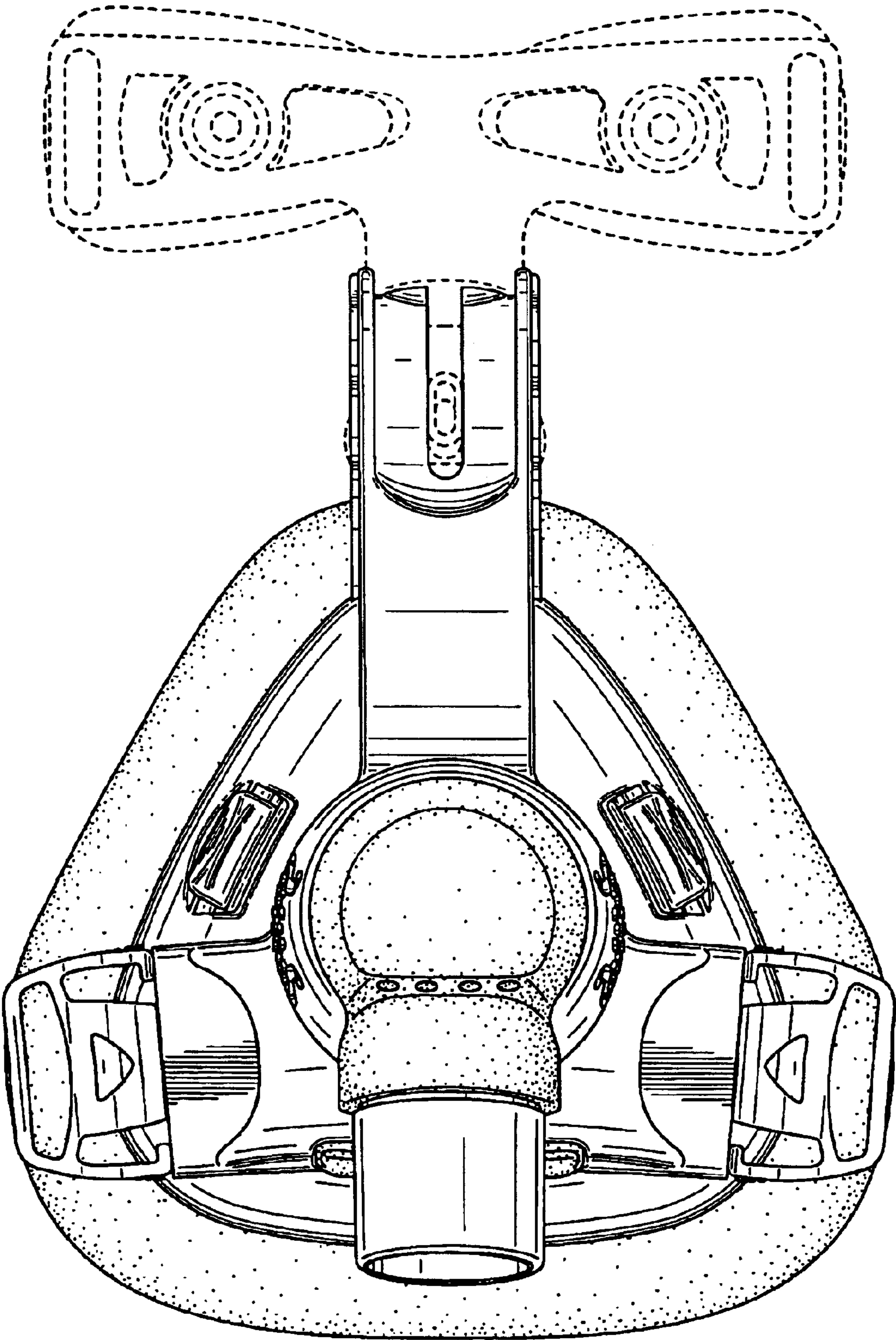

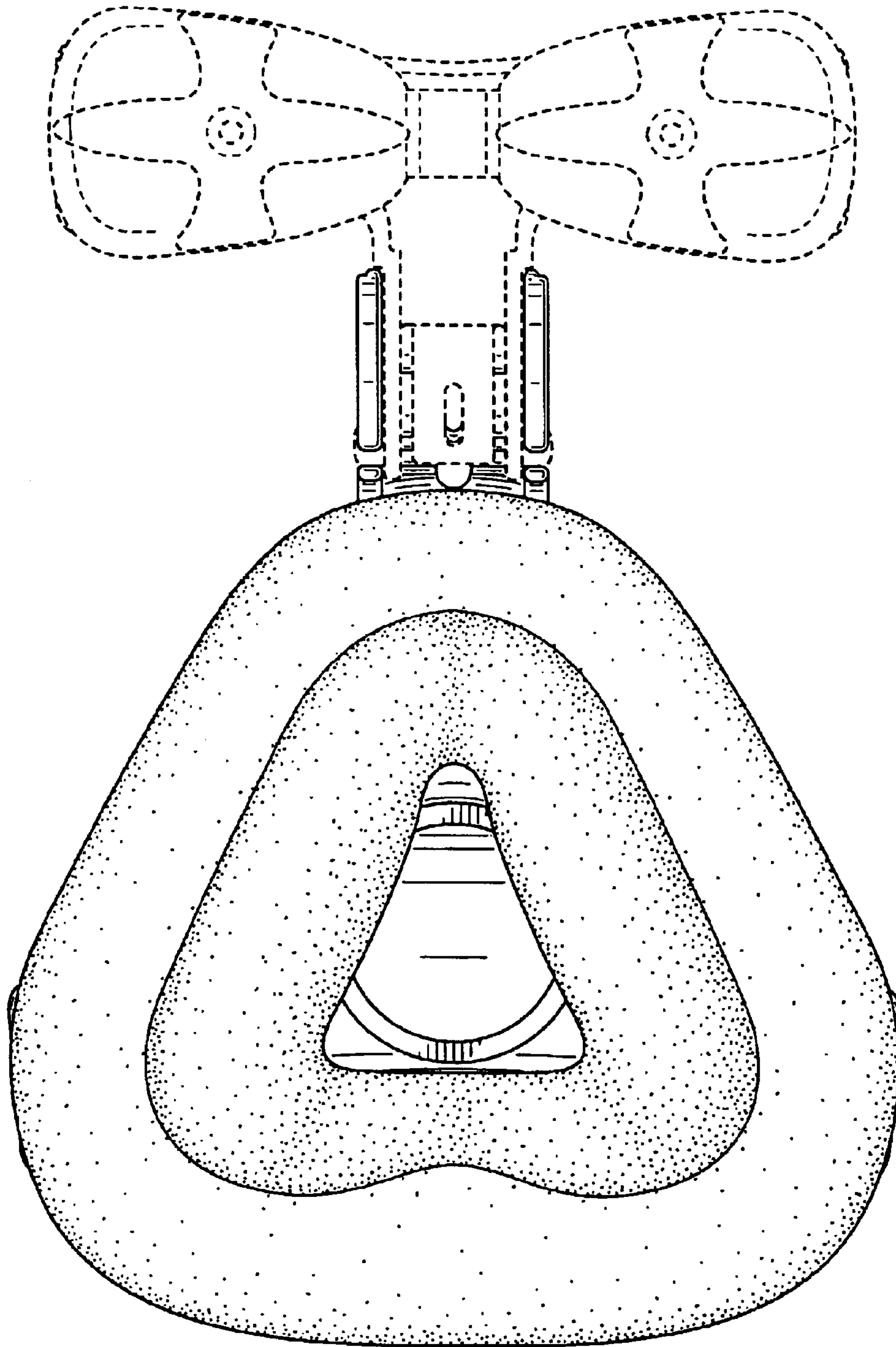

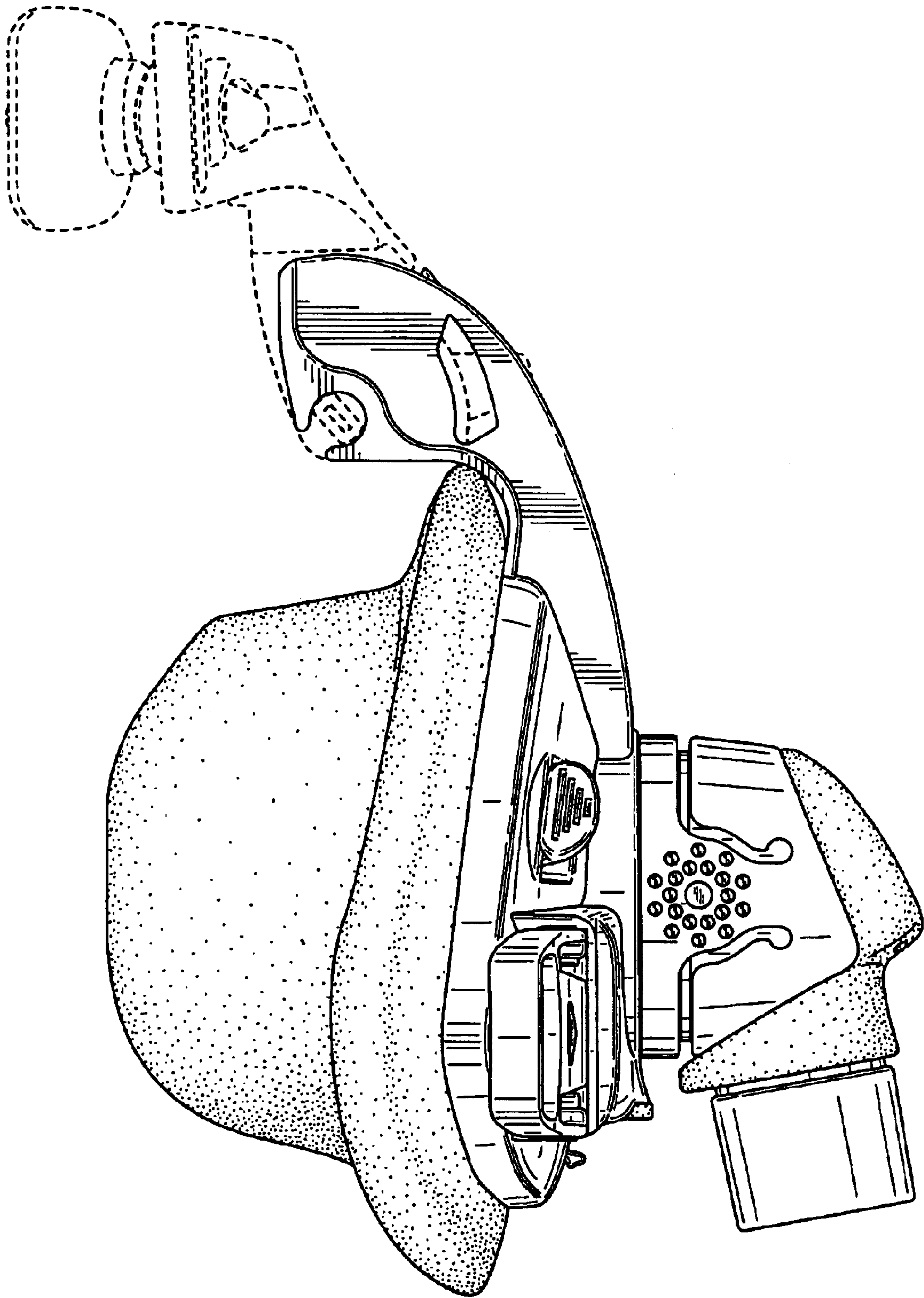

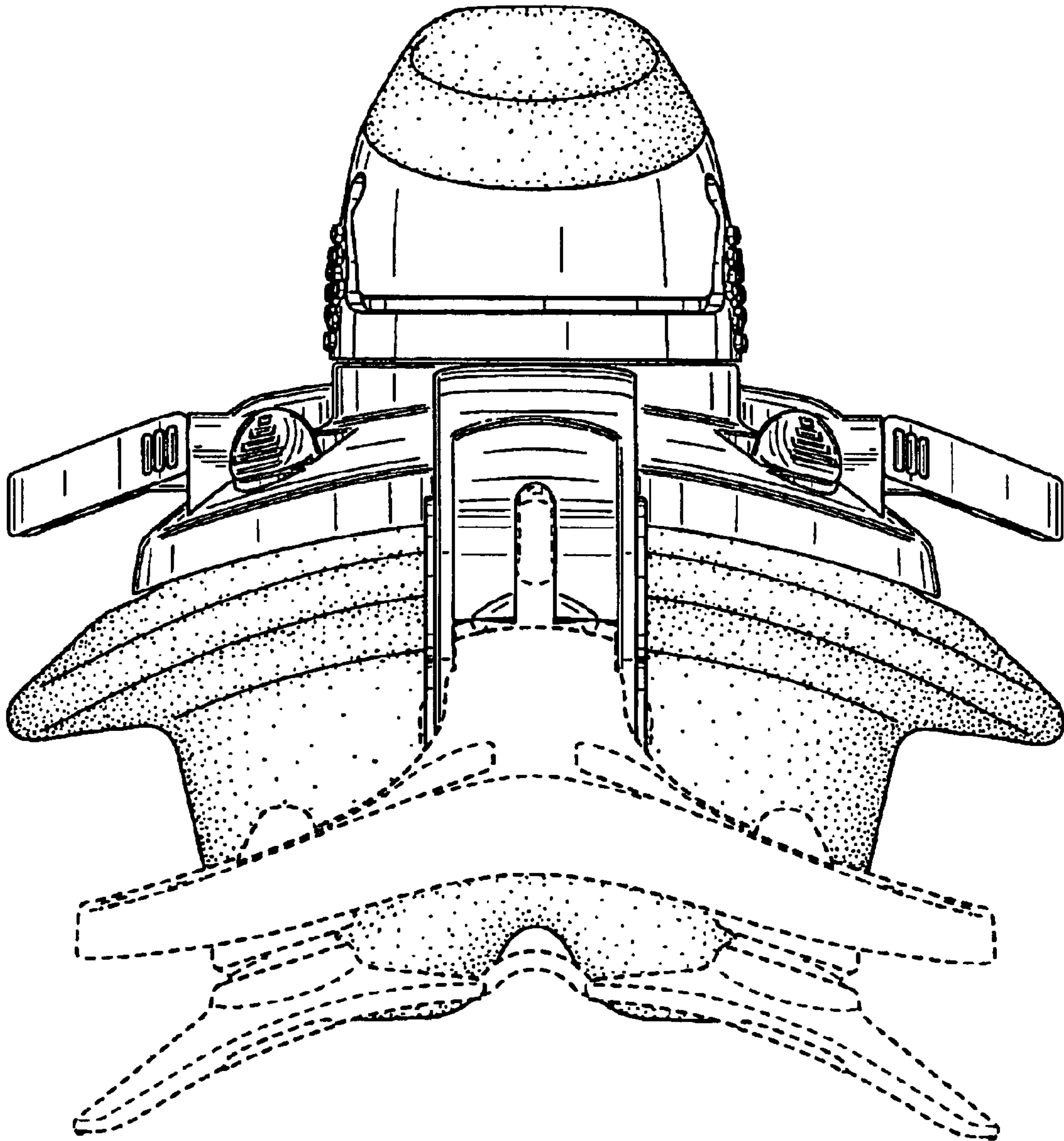

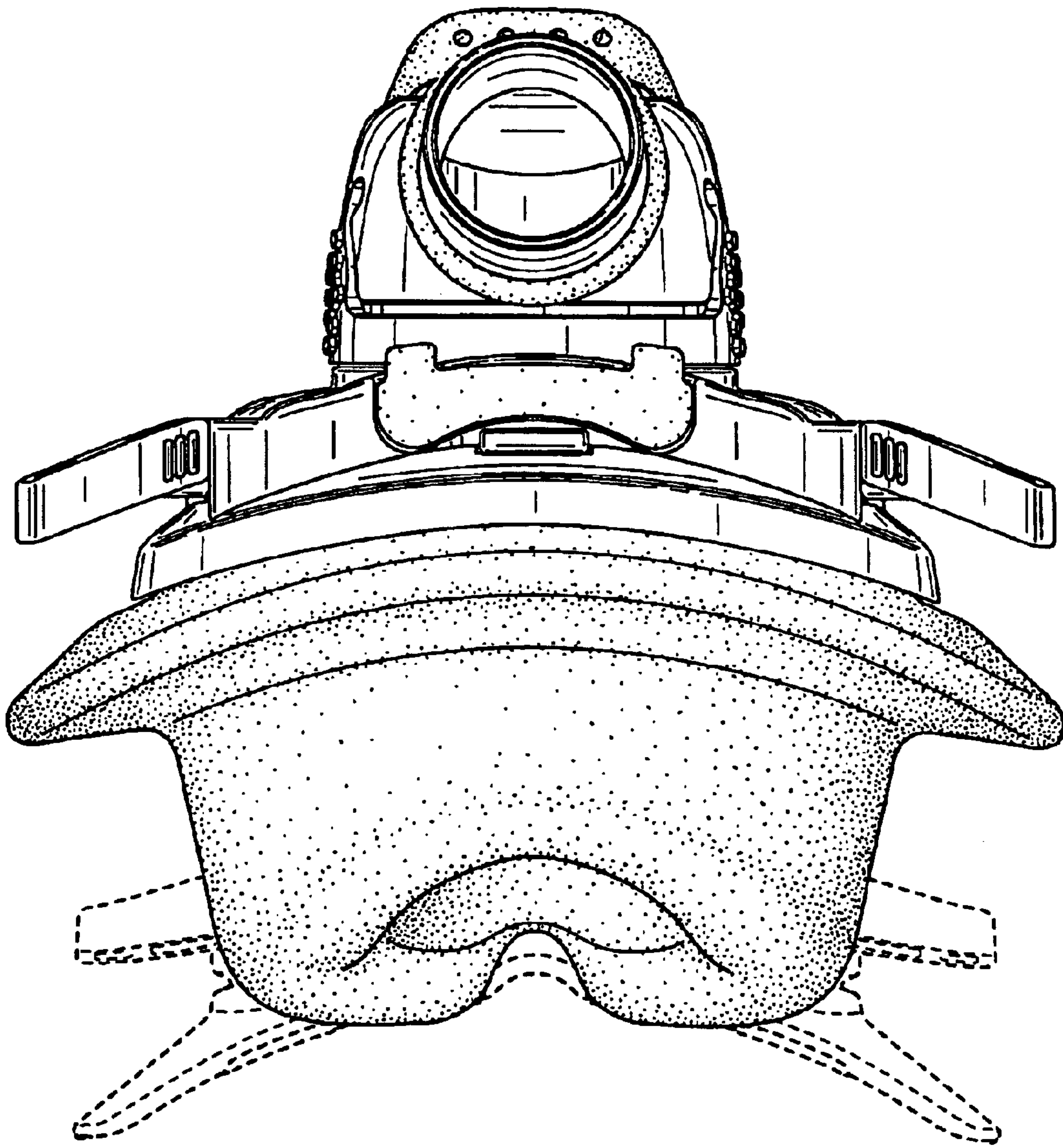
