(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for an implanting device, as  
shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the implanting device  
showing our new design, the portion of the drawings illus-  
trated by broken lines forming no part of the design sought  
to be patented;

FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof, the portion of the drawing  
illustrated by broken lines forming no part of the design  
sought to be patented;

FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof with the left side being a  
mirror image, the portion of the drawing illustrated by  
broken lines forming no part of the design sought to be  
patented.

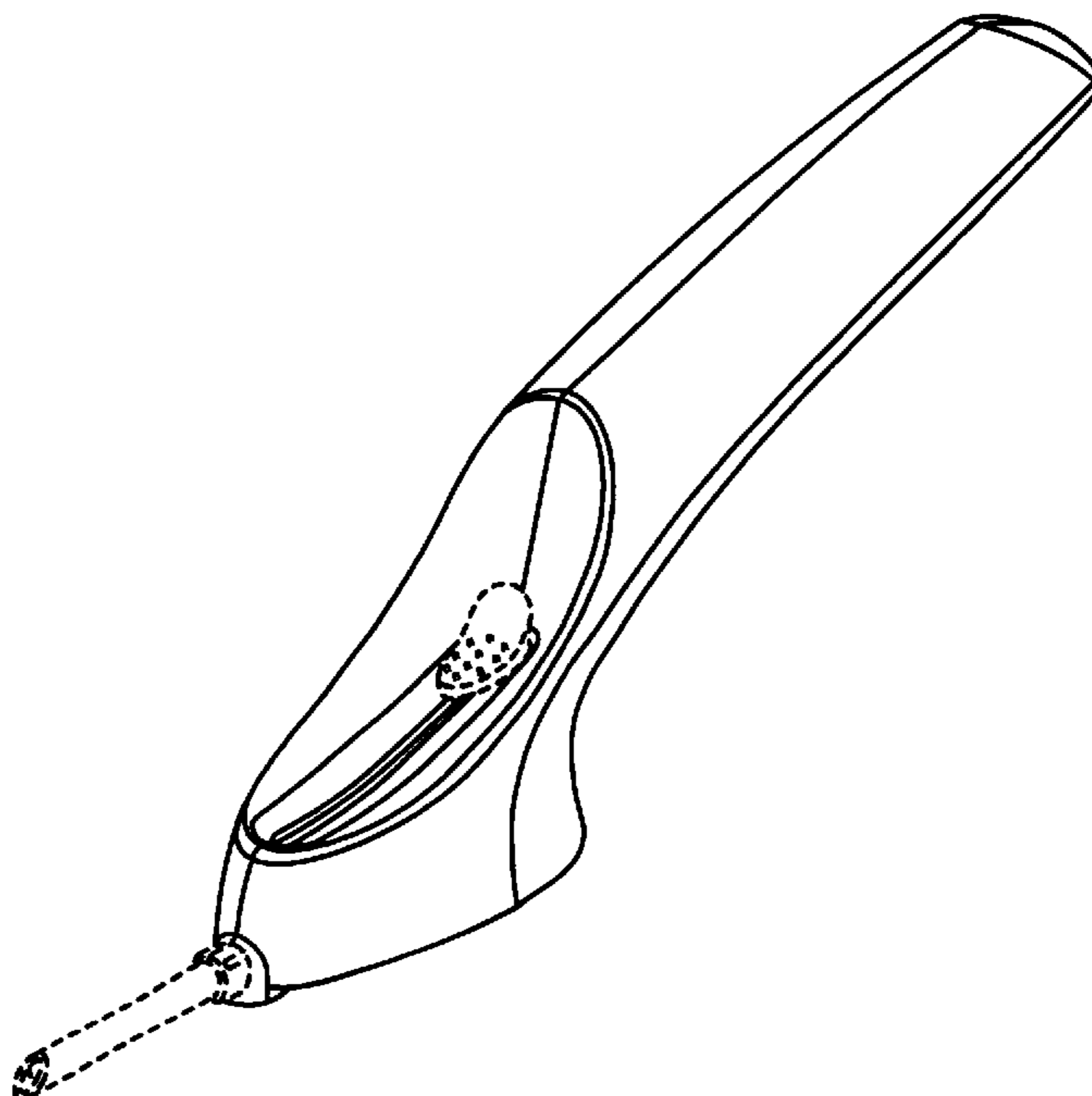
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof, the portion of the drawing

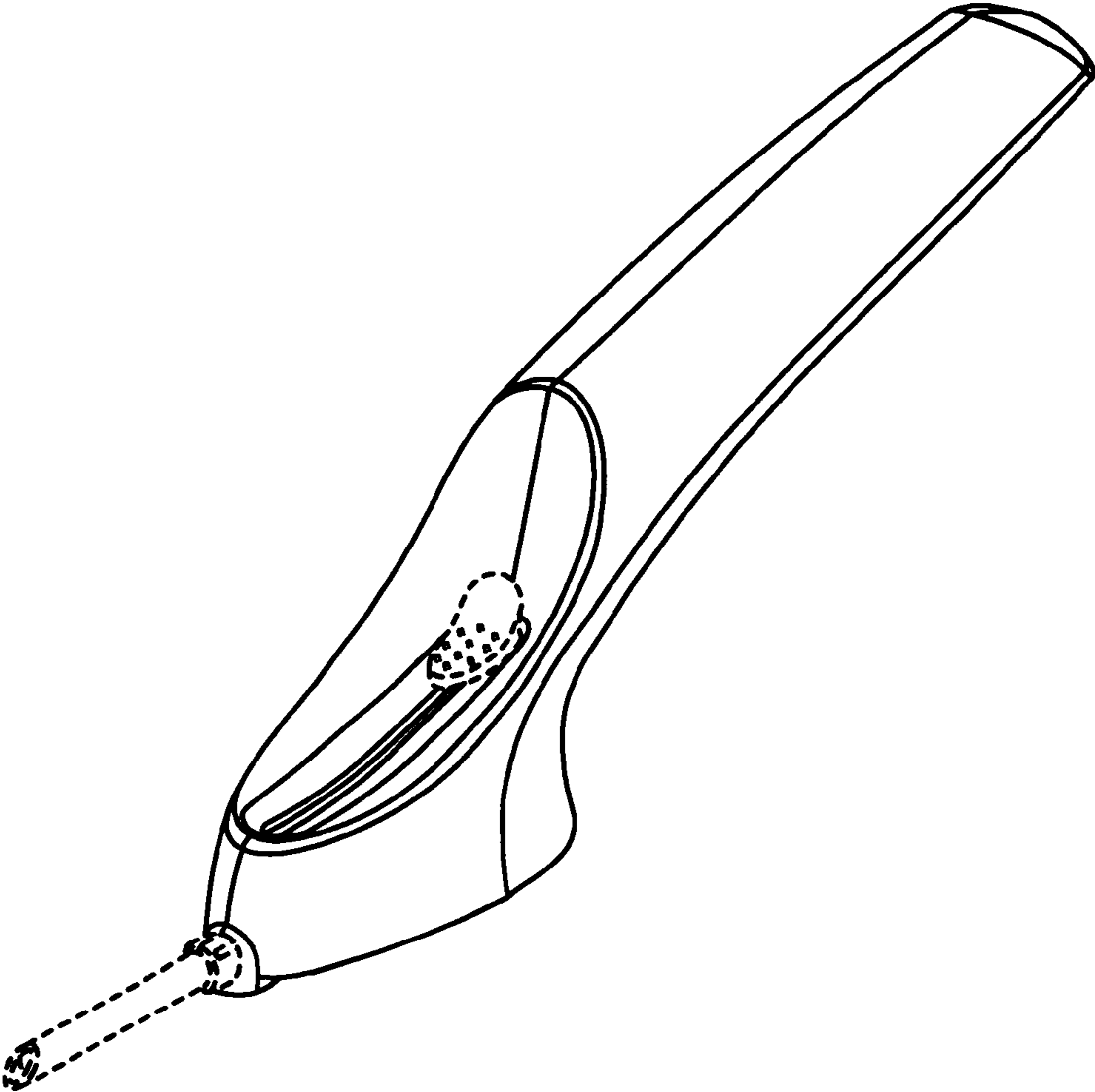

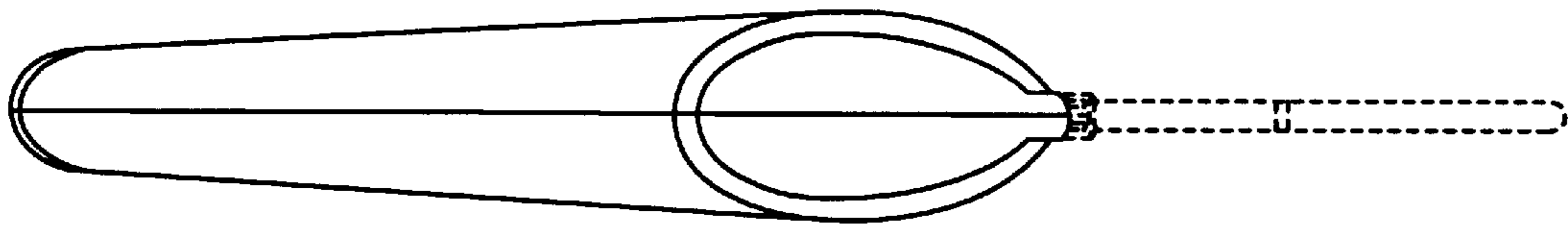

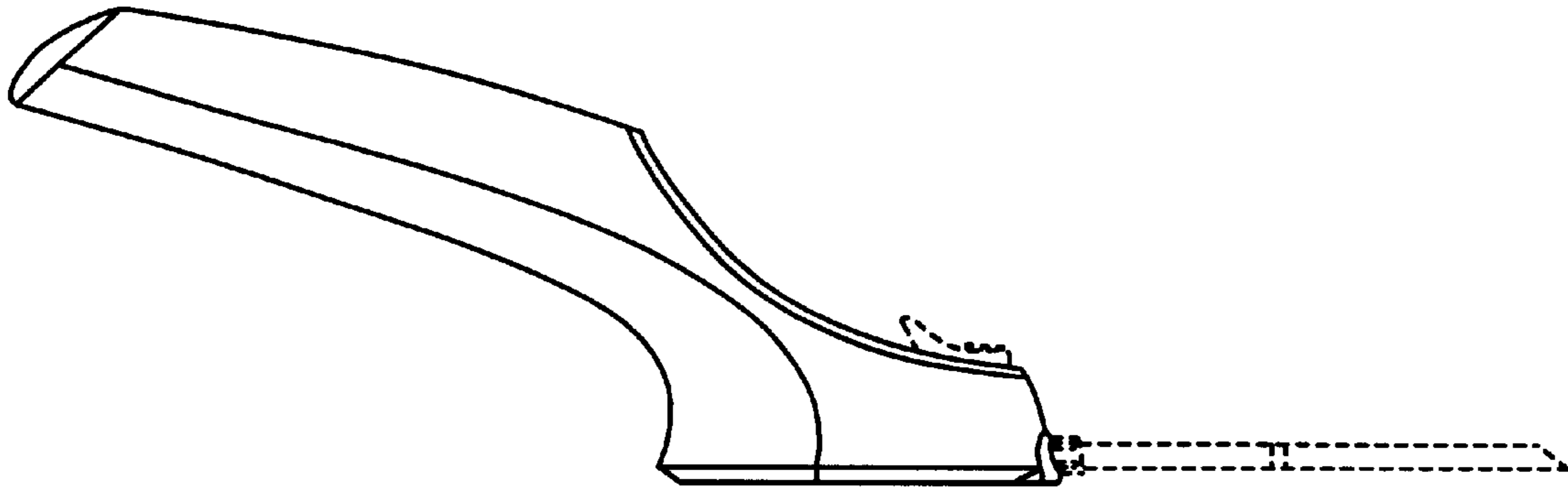

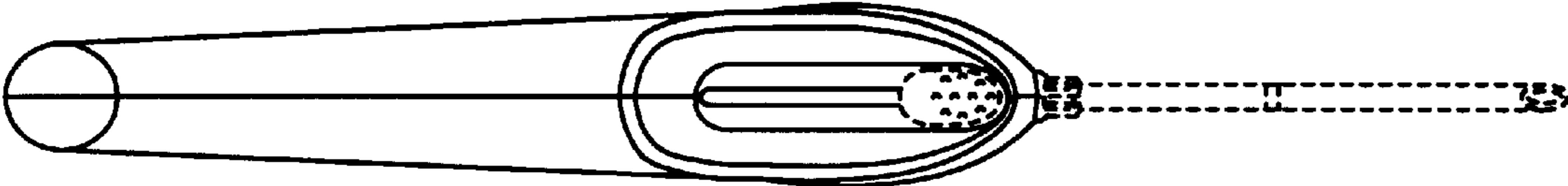

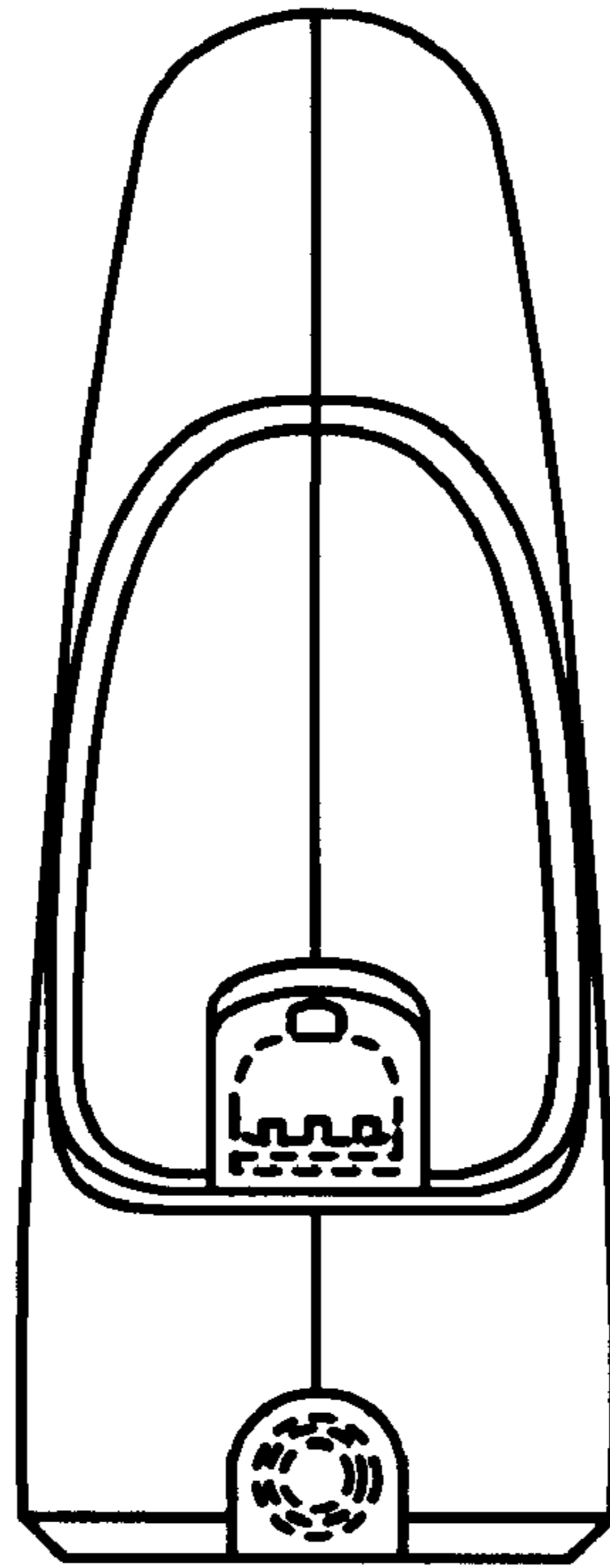

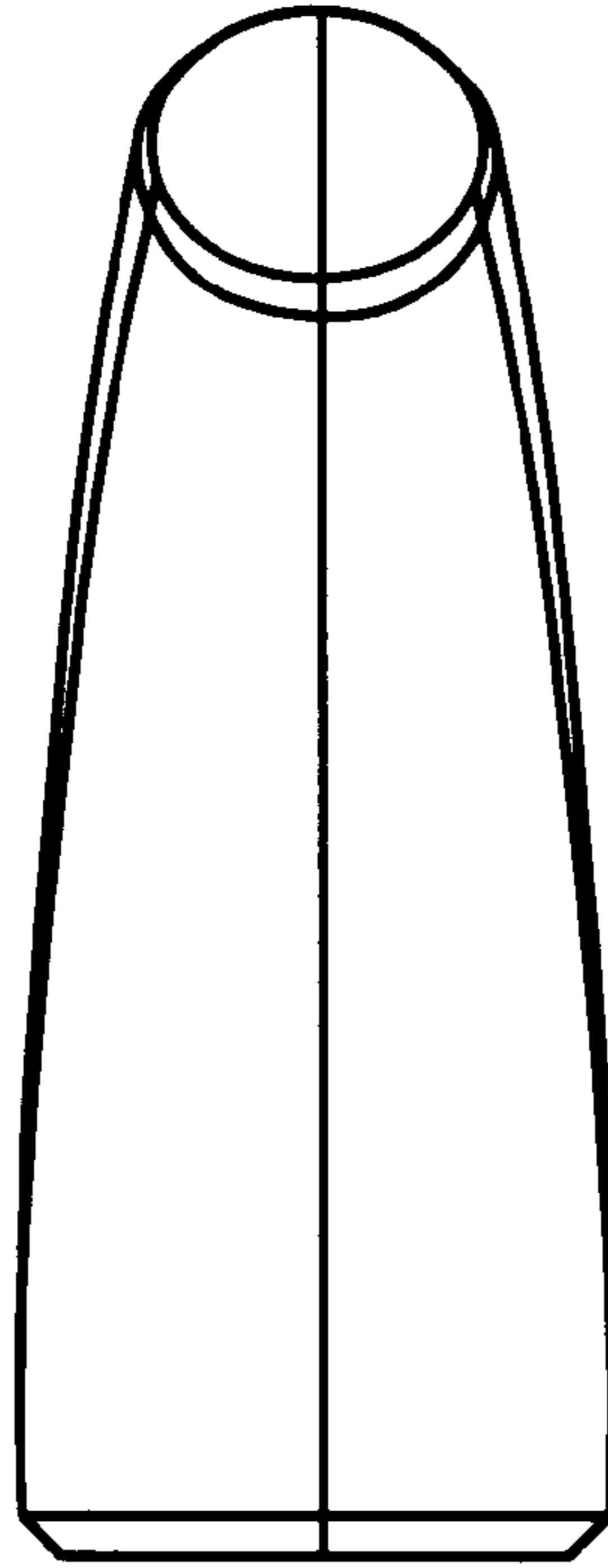

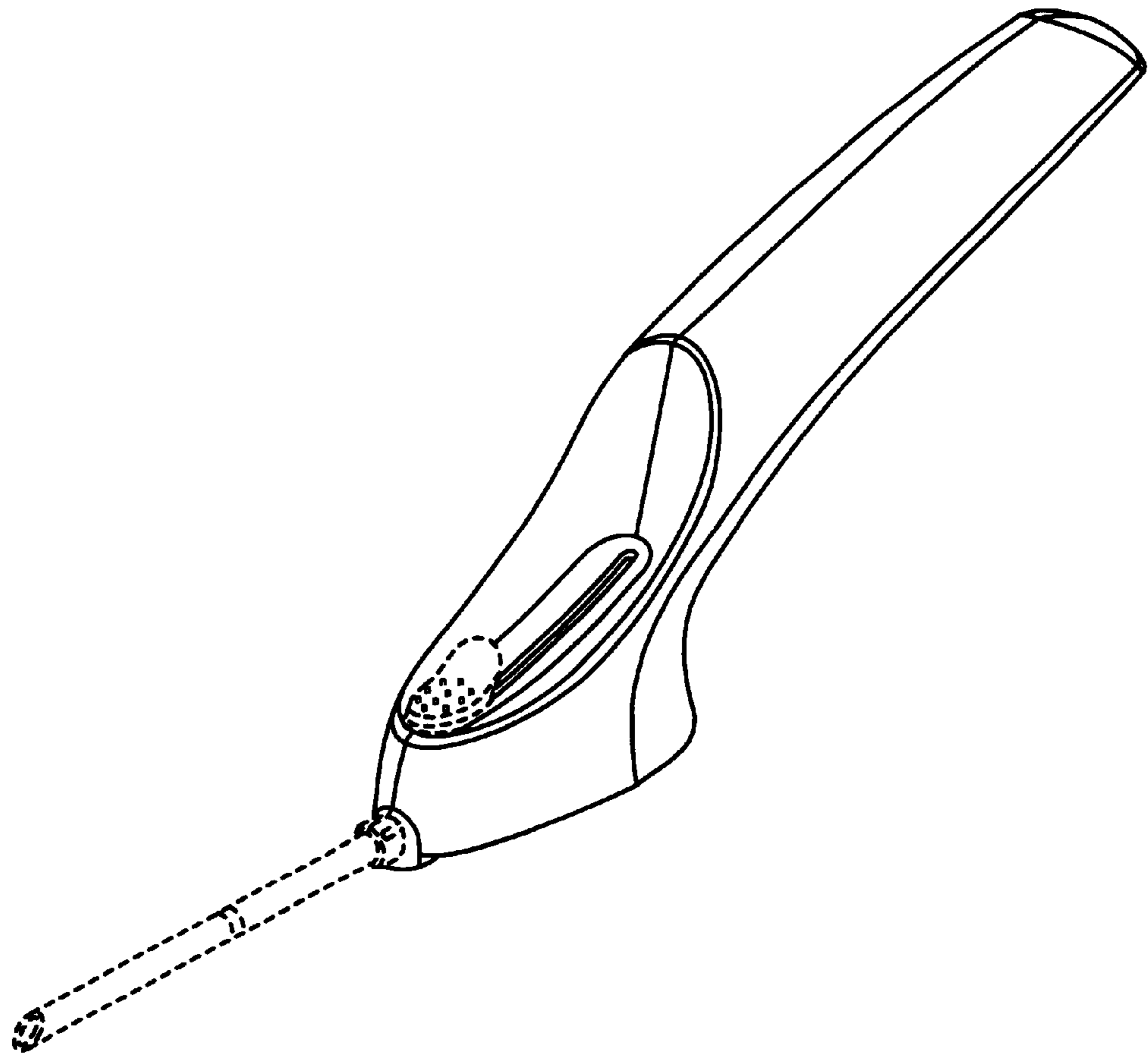
