FIG. 1 is a top right perspective view of a pair of wire grates for a cooking appliance, showing our new design;FIG. 2 is a upper right perspective view of the wire grate of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the wire grate of FIG. 1, with the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the wire grate of the invention;FIG. 5 is a right elevational view of the wire grate of FIG.1, with the left elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the wire grate of FIG. 1. The broken lines in FIG. 1 showing a portion of a cooking appliance is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed invention.
