DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front side perspective view of our new design for a raisable panel, wherein the raisable panel is partially drawn.

FIG. 7 is a top view thereof, wherein the raisable panel is fully drawn;

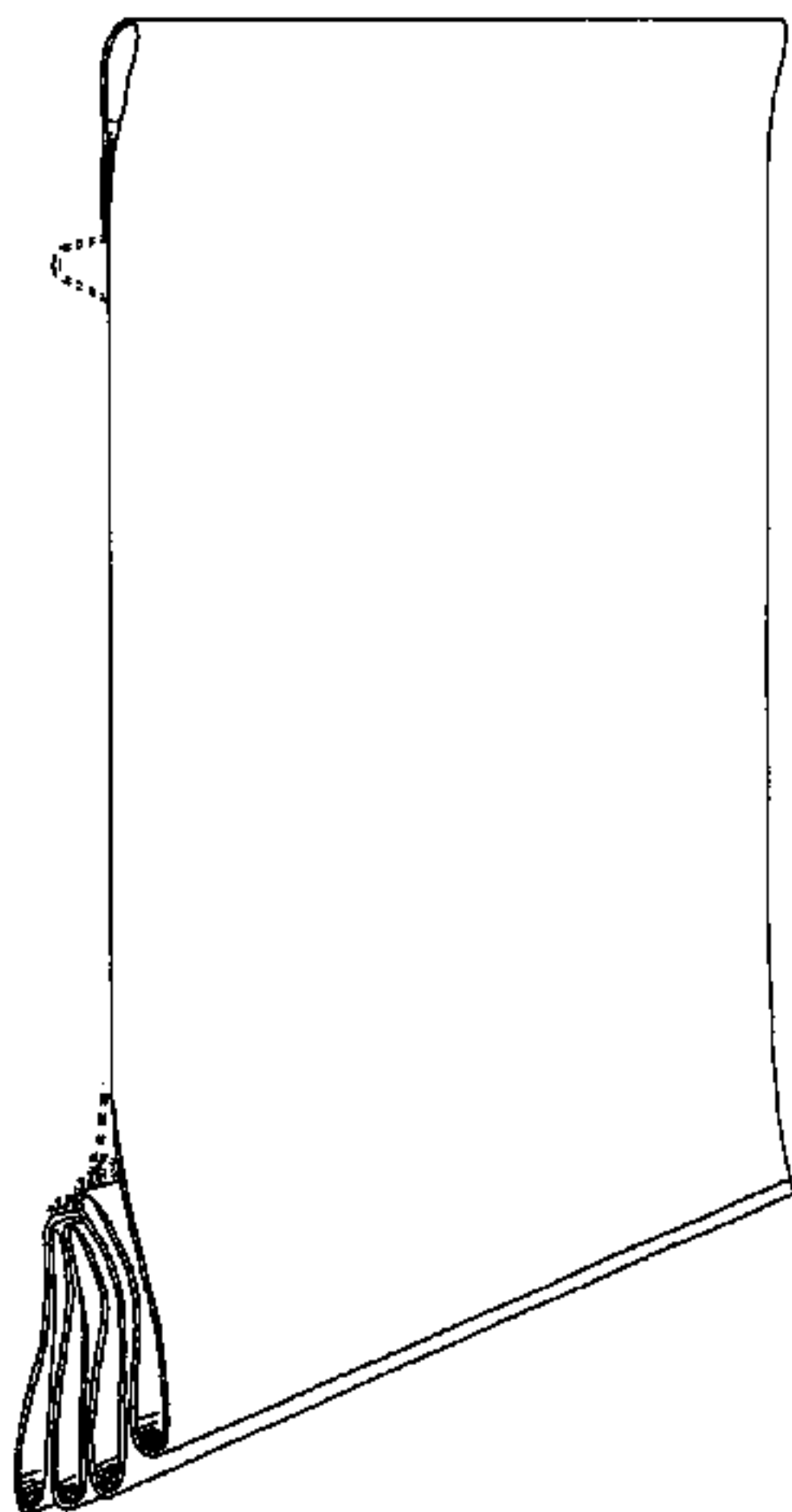
FIG. 8 is a bottom view thereof, wherein the raisable panel is fully drawn;

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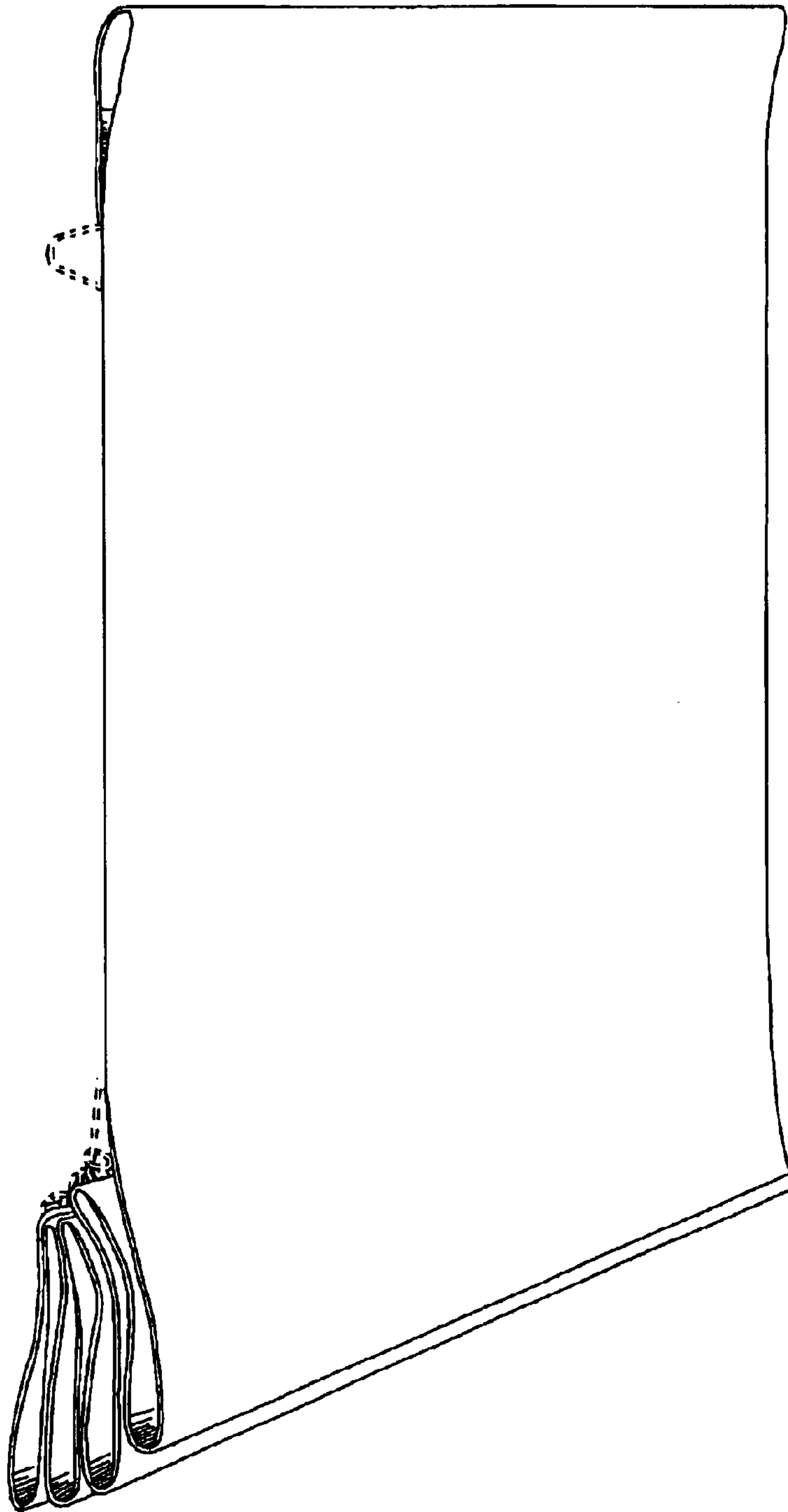

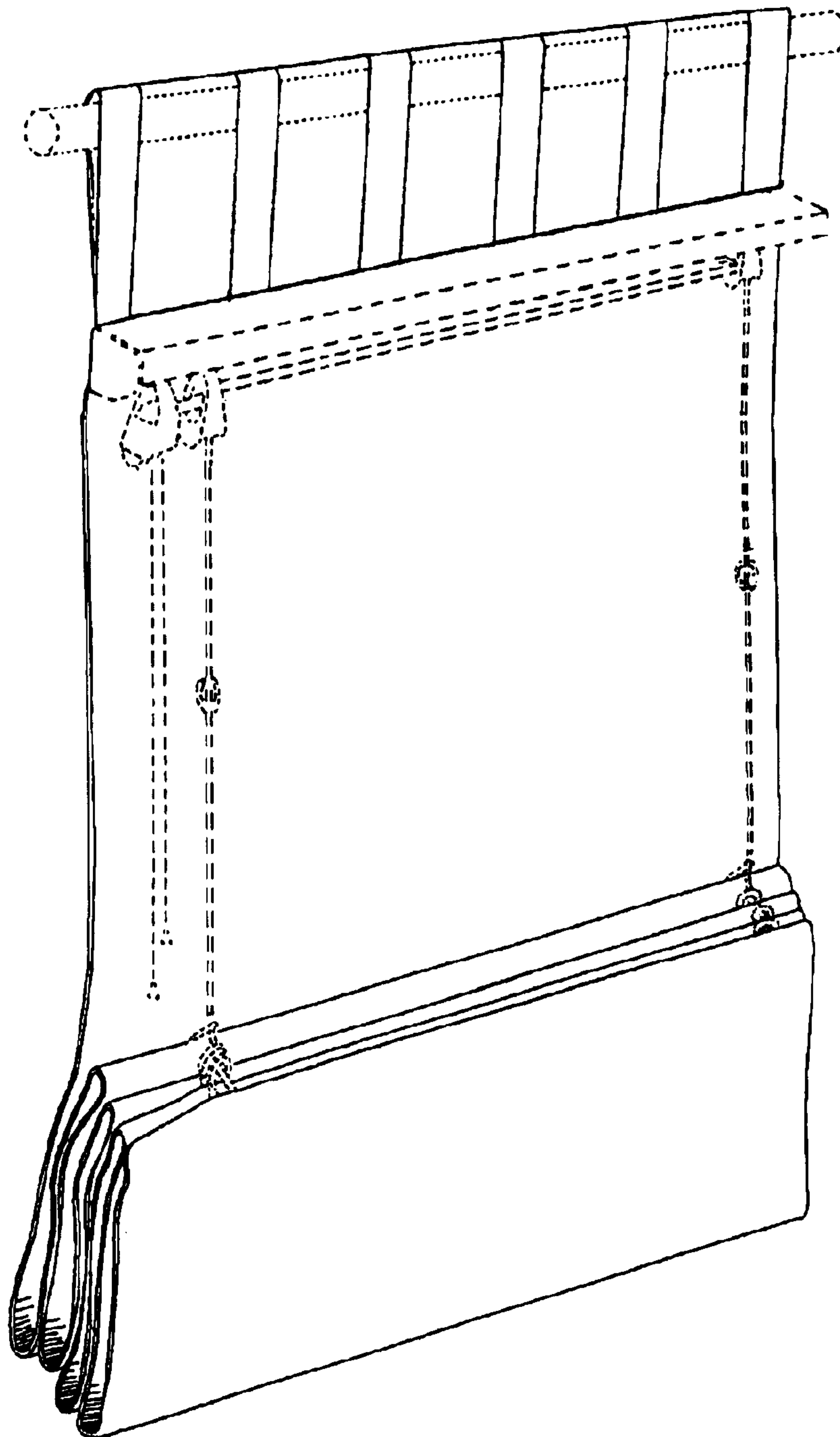

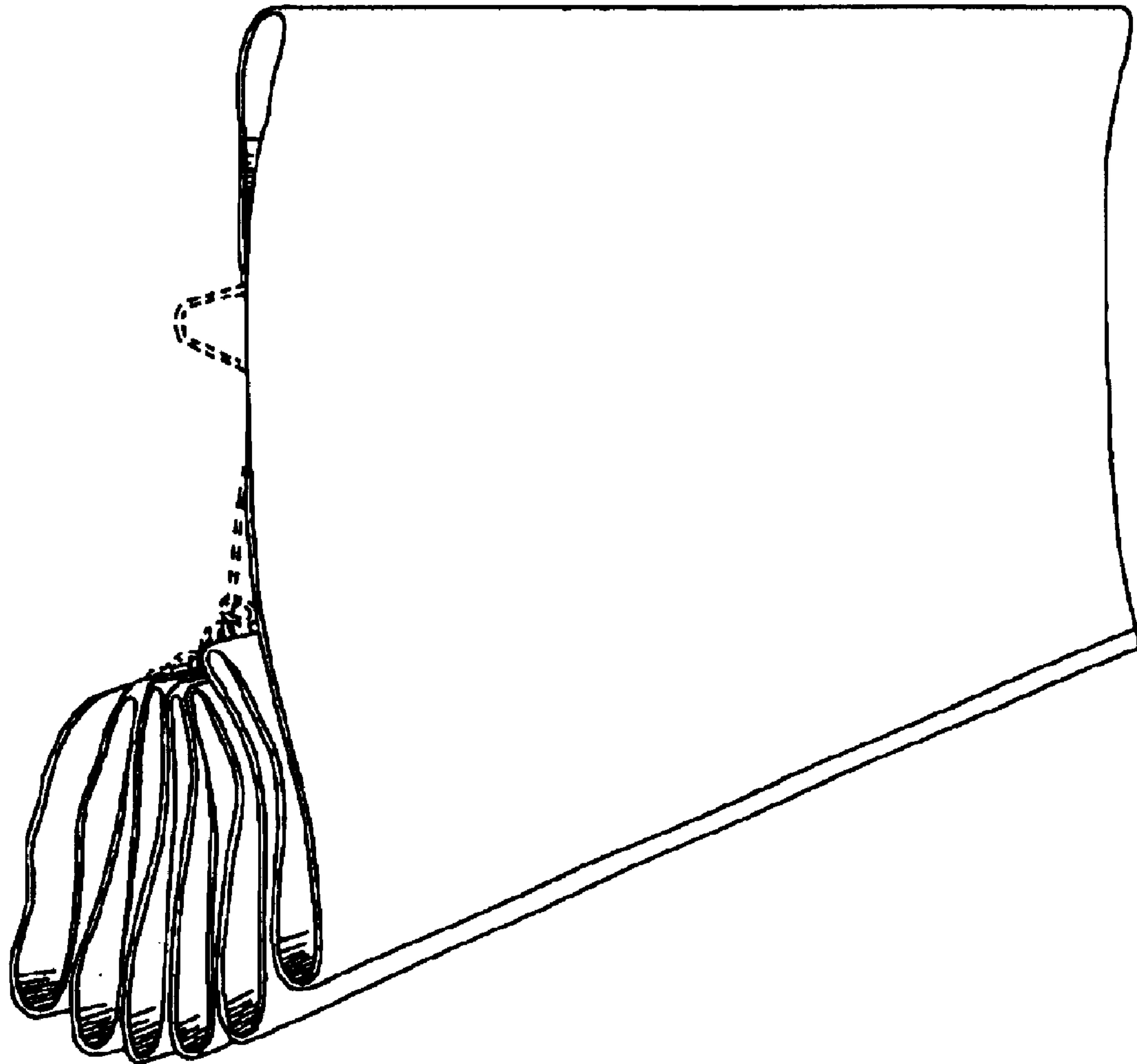

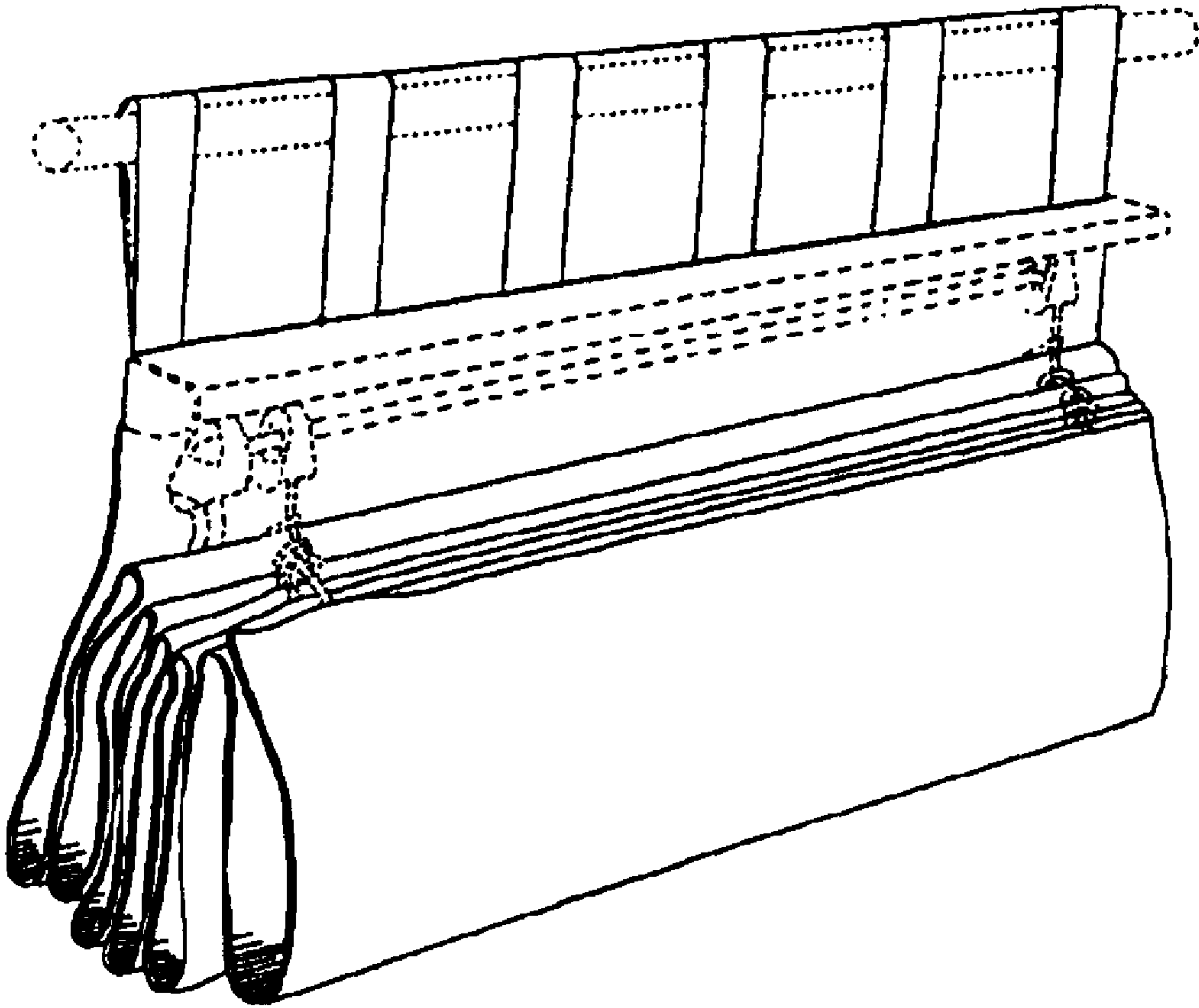

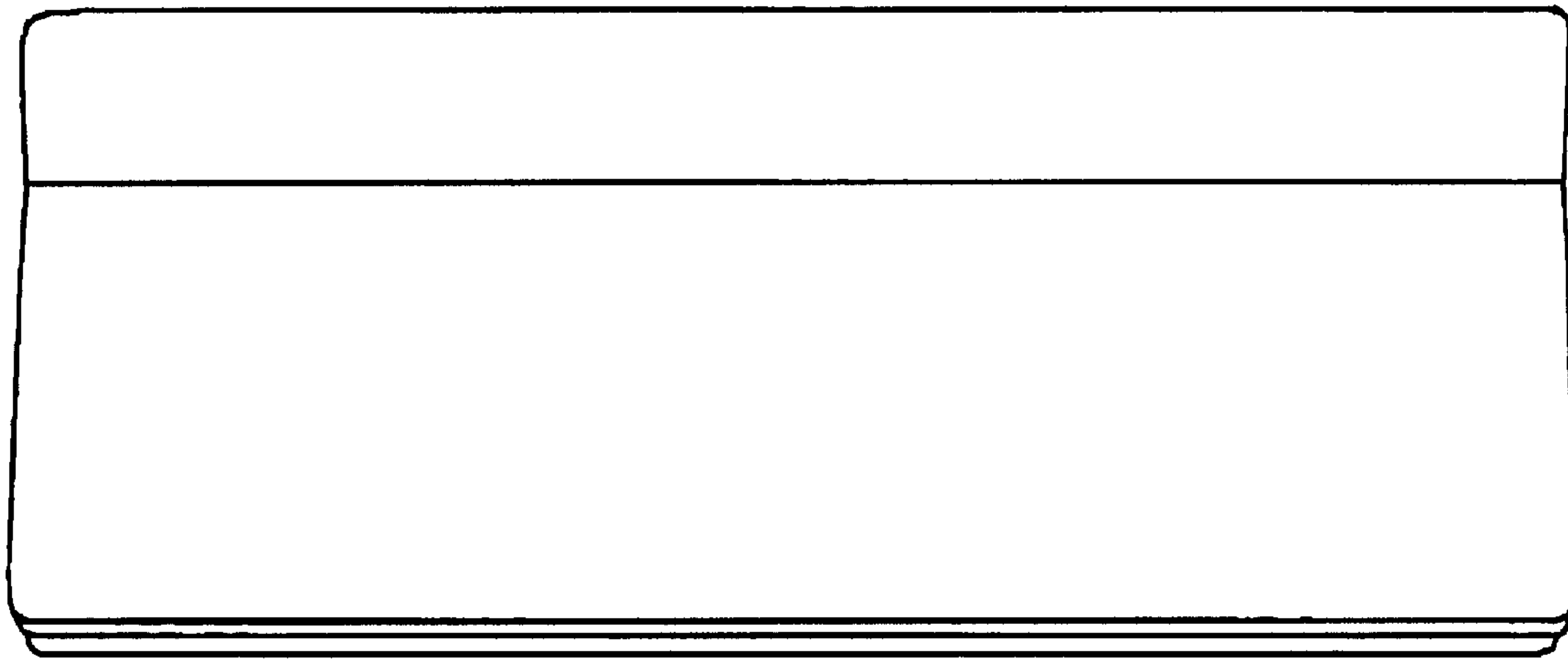

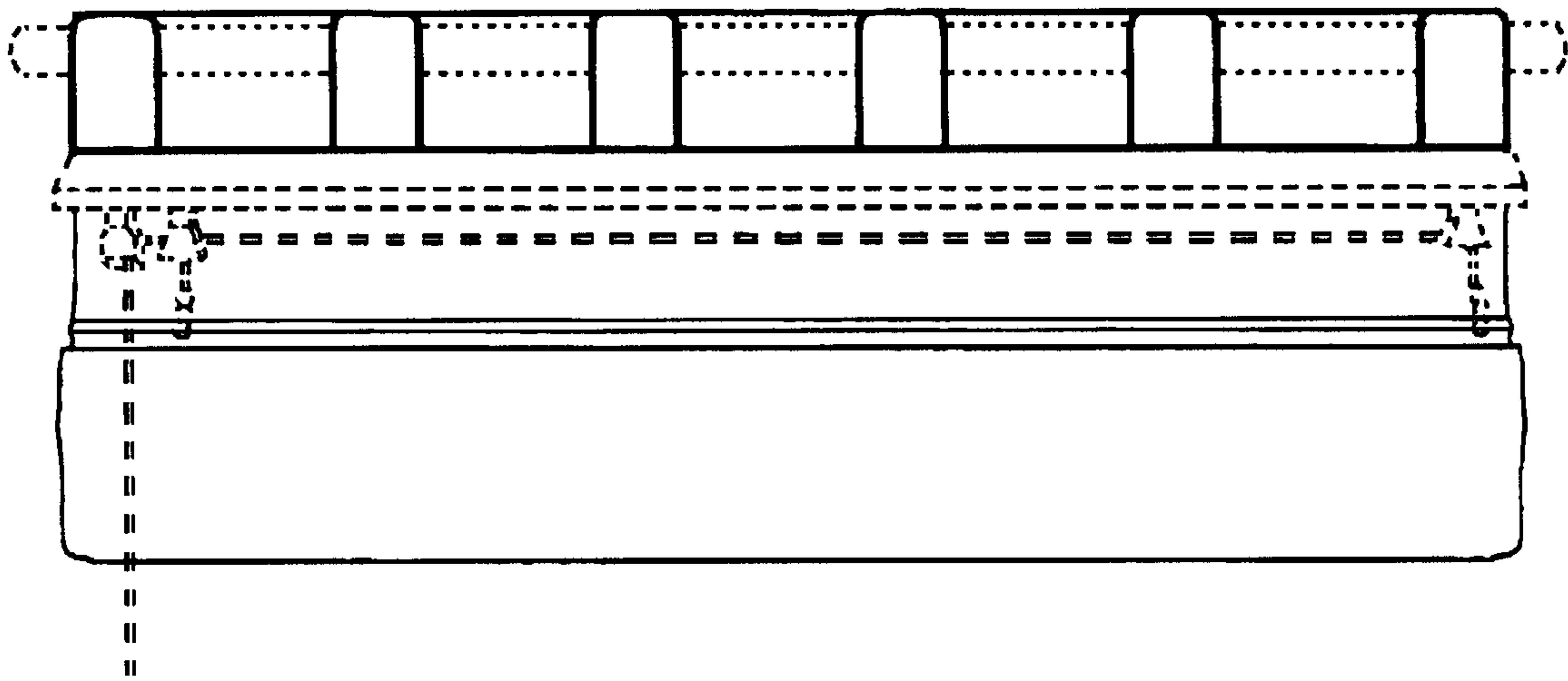

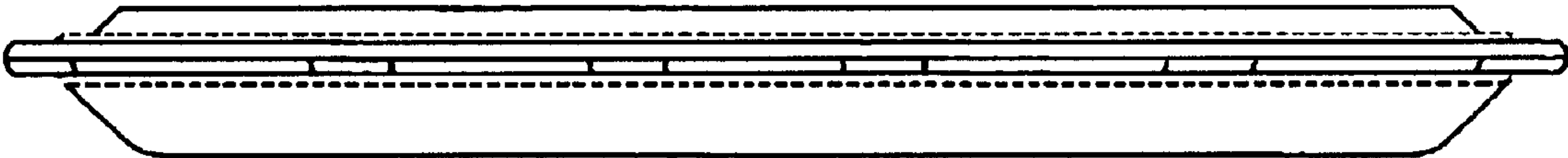

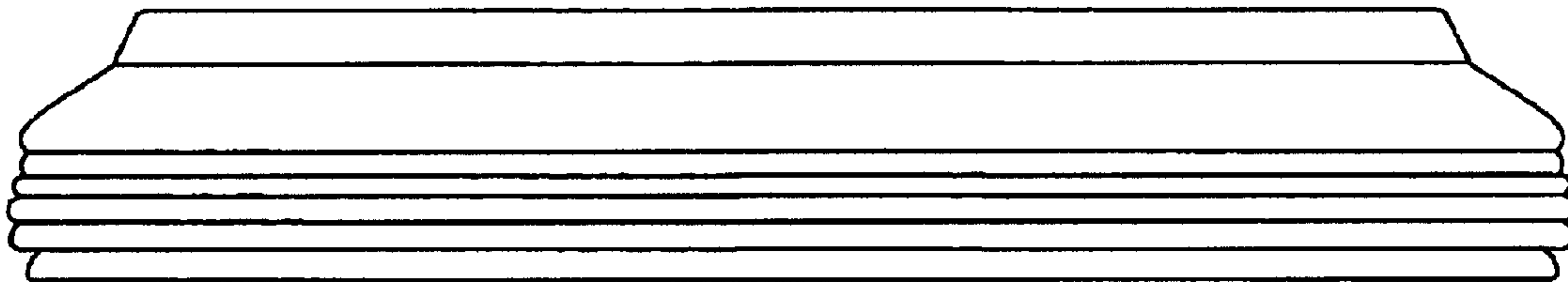

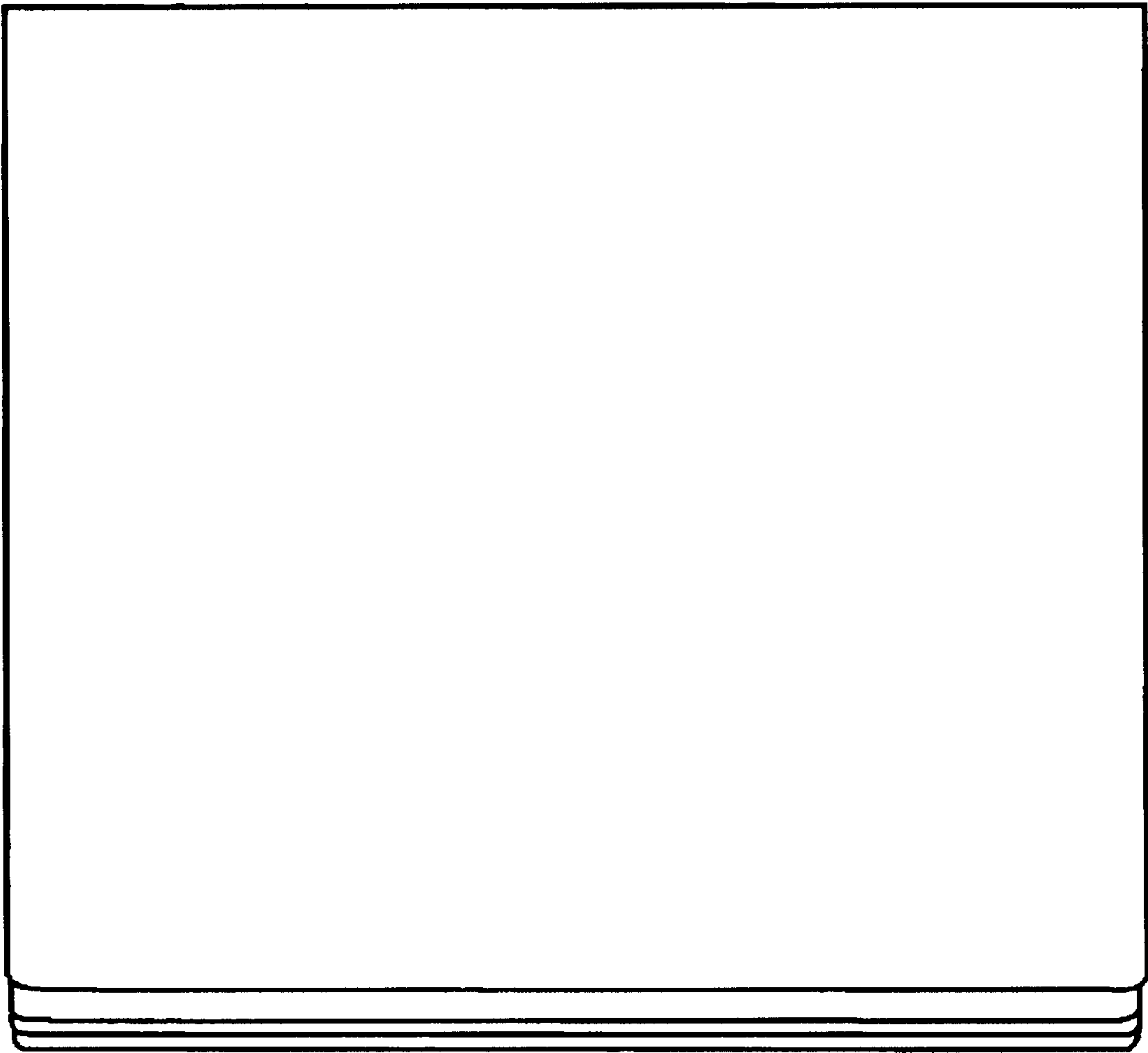

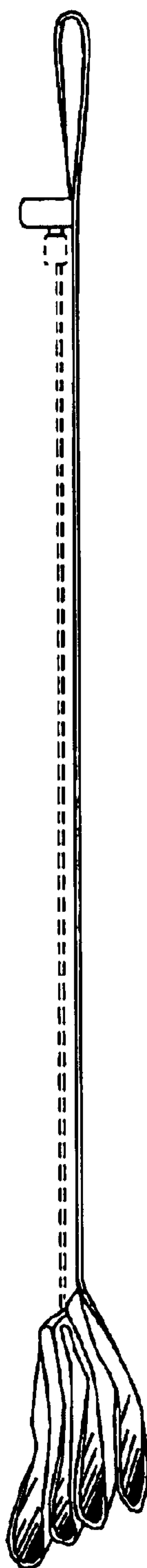
