DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view, according to the present invention;

FIG. 2 is an end elevational view;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.

The blade is broken away in FIGS. 1, 3, 4 and 5 to indicate indeterminate length and its appearance is understood to repeat throughout the length of the blade.

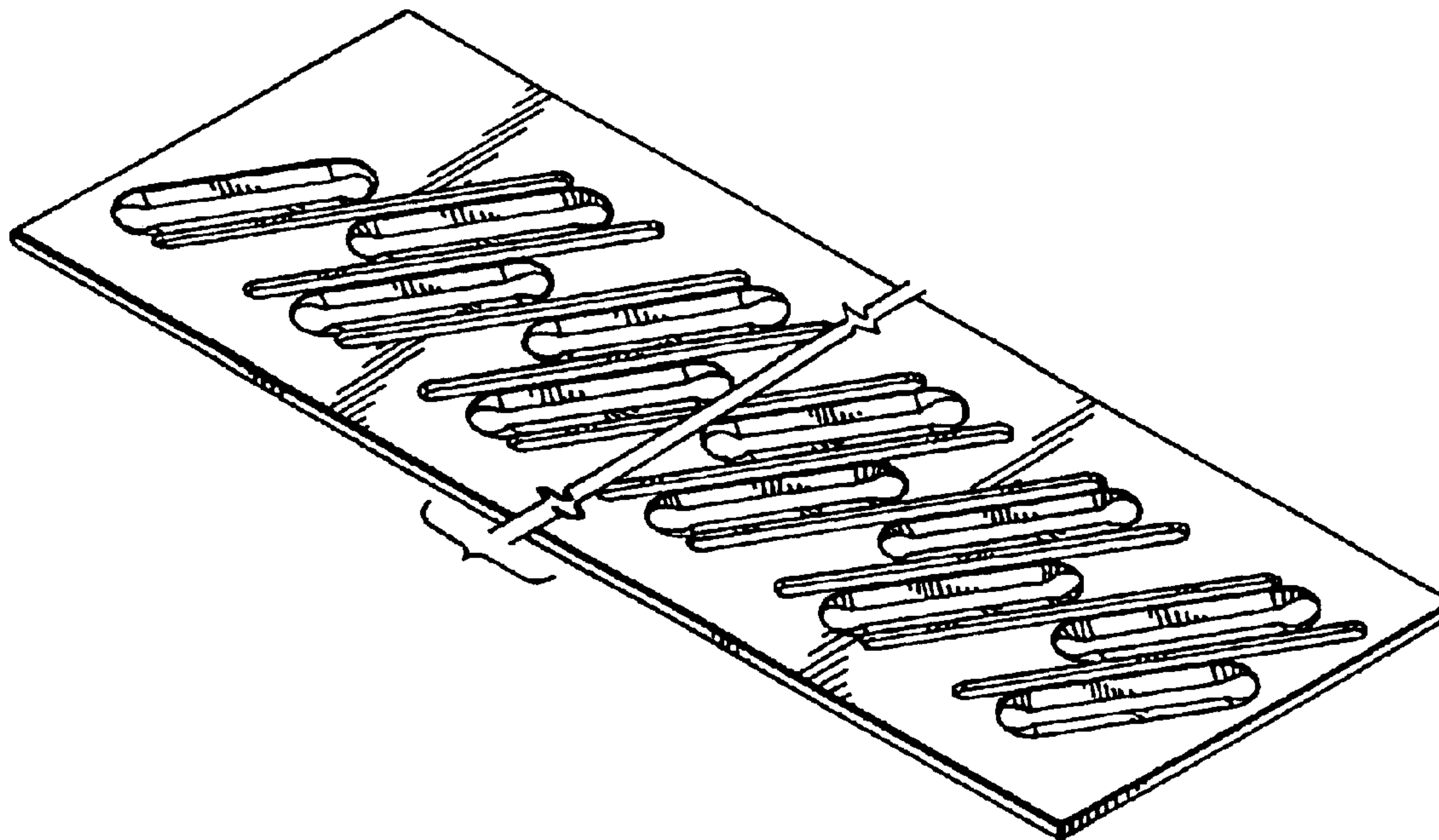

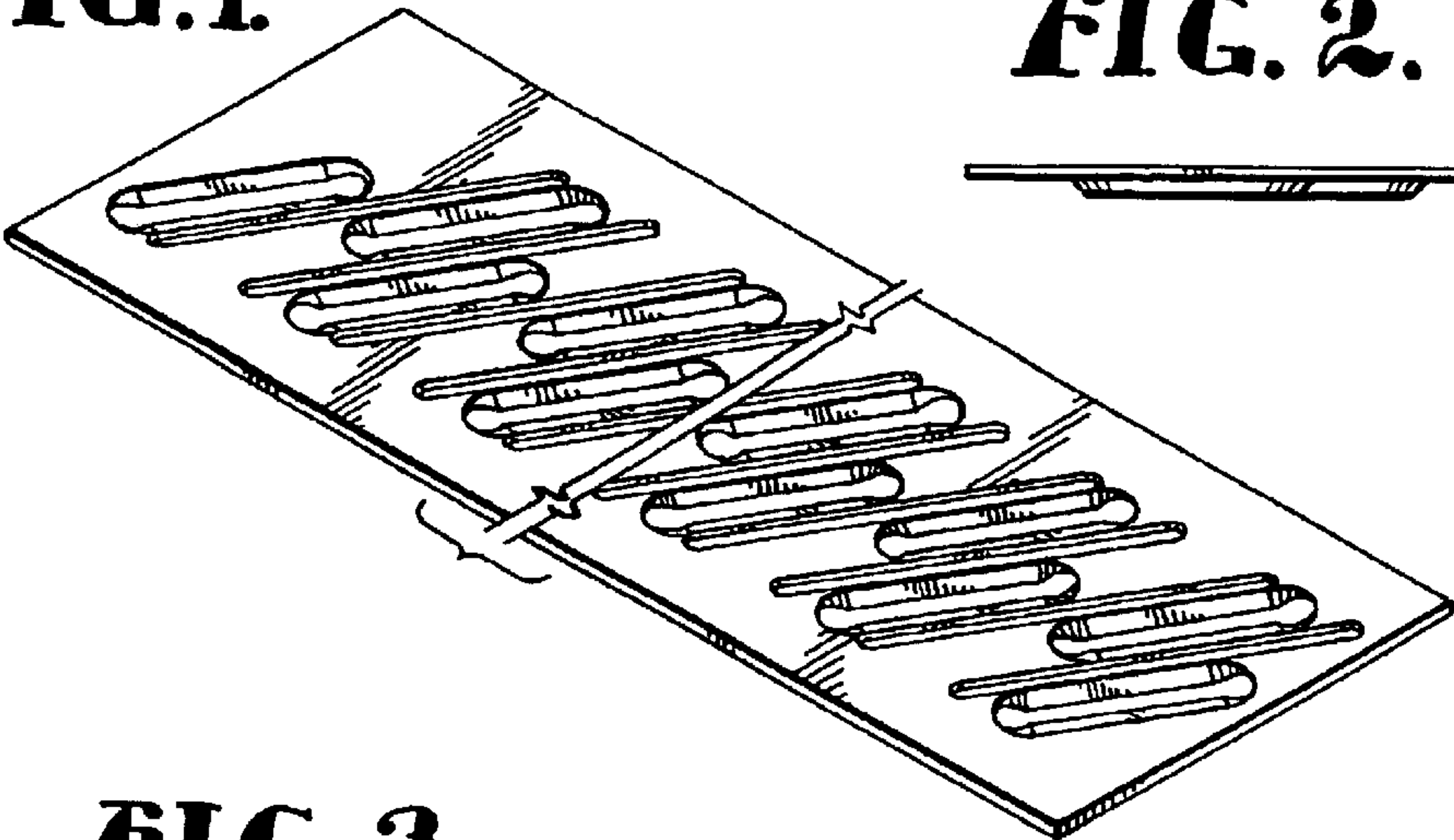

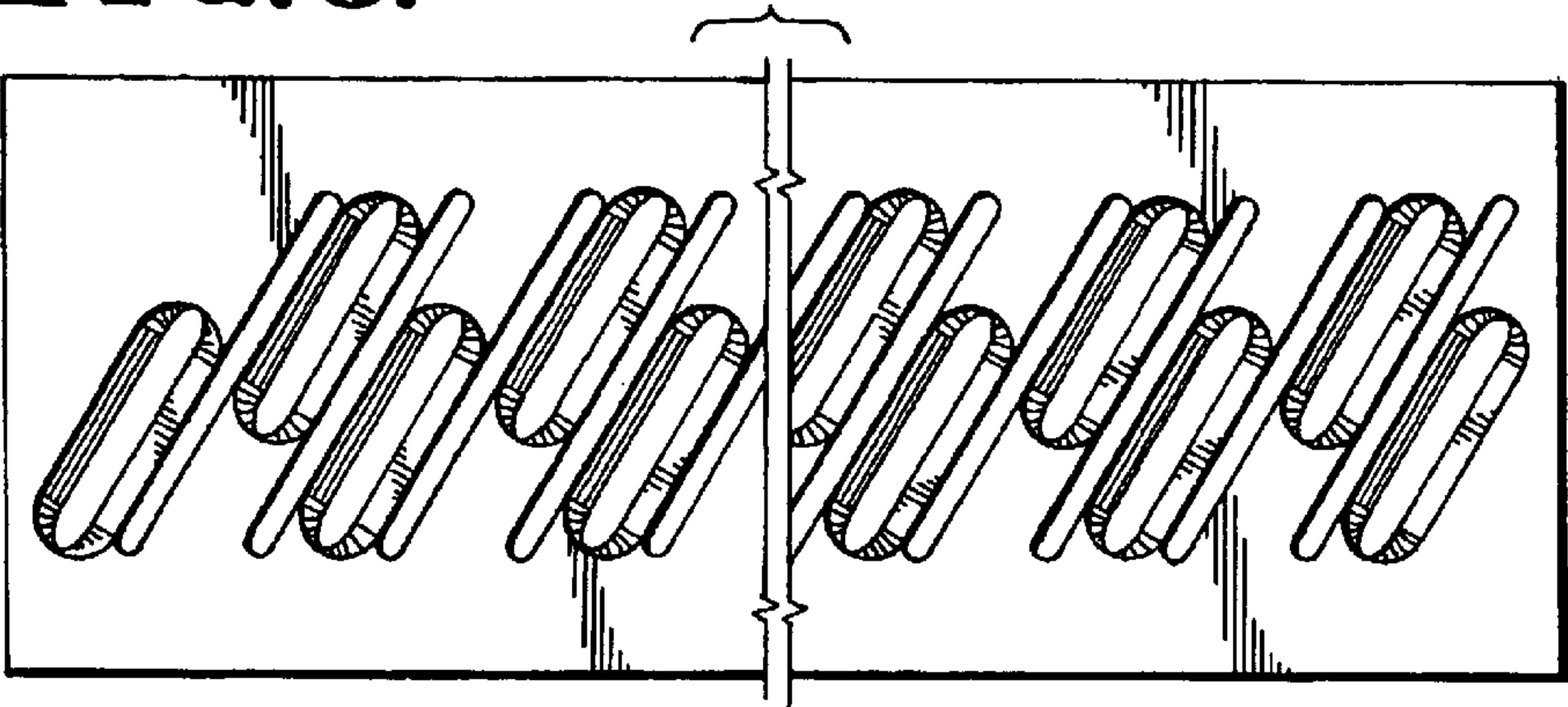
