(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stackable planter, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a stackable planter comprised of four trays and a cart in a stacked configuration; FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the planter shown in FIG. 1 with wheels attached to the cart shown in broken line for illustration purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 3 is a side view of the planter shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is top view of the planter shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top perspective view of a tray in the planter shown in FIG. 1 having a center portion with a bottom therein, the tray being shown separately for ease of illustration;

FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view of the tray shown in FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a side view of the tray shown in FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a top view of the tray shown in FIG. 5;

FIG. 9 is a top perspective view of a tray in the planter shown in FIG. 1 having a center portion without a bottom therein, the tray being shown separately for ease of illustration;

FIG. 10 is a bottom perspective view of the tray shown in FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a top view of the tray shown in FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is a top perspective view of the cart in the planter shown in FIG. 1, the cart being shown separately for ease of illustration;

FIG. 13 is bottom perspective view of the cart shown in FIG. 12;

FIG. 14 is a side view of the cart shown in FIG. 12;

FIG. 15 is top view of the cart shown in FIG. 12;

FIG. 16 is a top perspective view of the stackable planter shown in FIG. 1 with spikes attached to the cart shown in broken line for illustration purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 17 is a side view of the planter shown in FIG. 16;

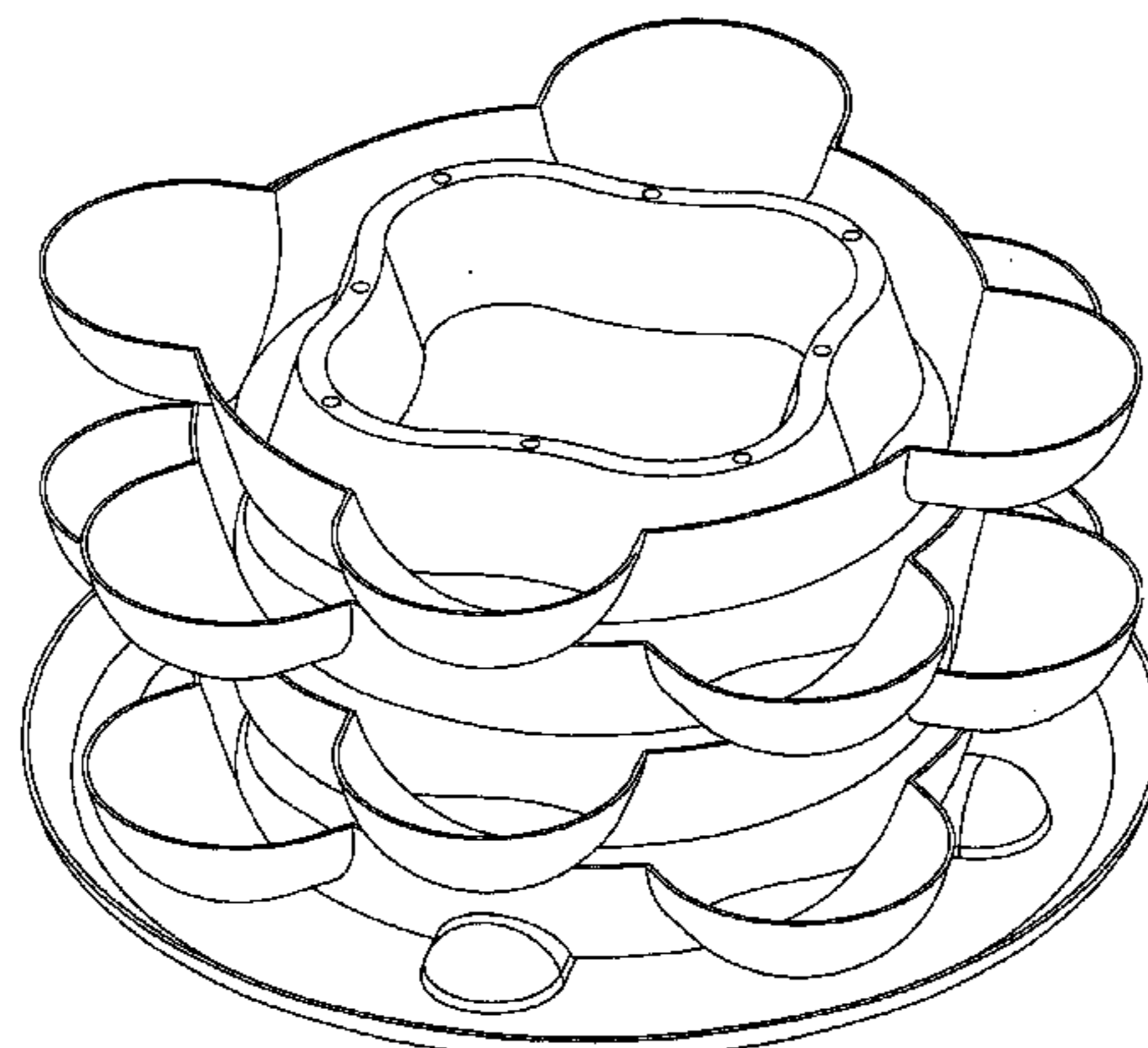
FIG. 18 is a top perspective view of a stackable planter with four trays as shown in FIG. 1 is an alternative terraced configuration;

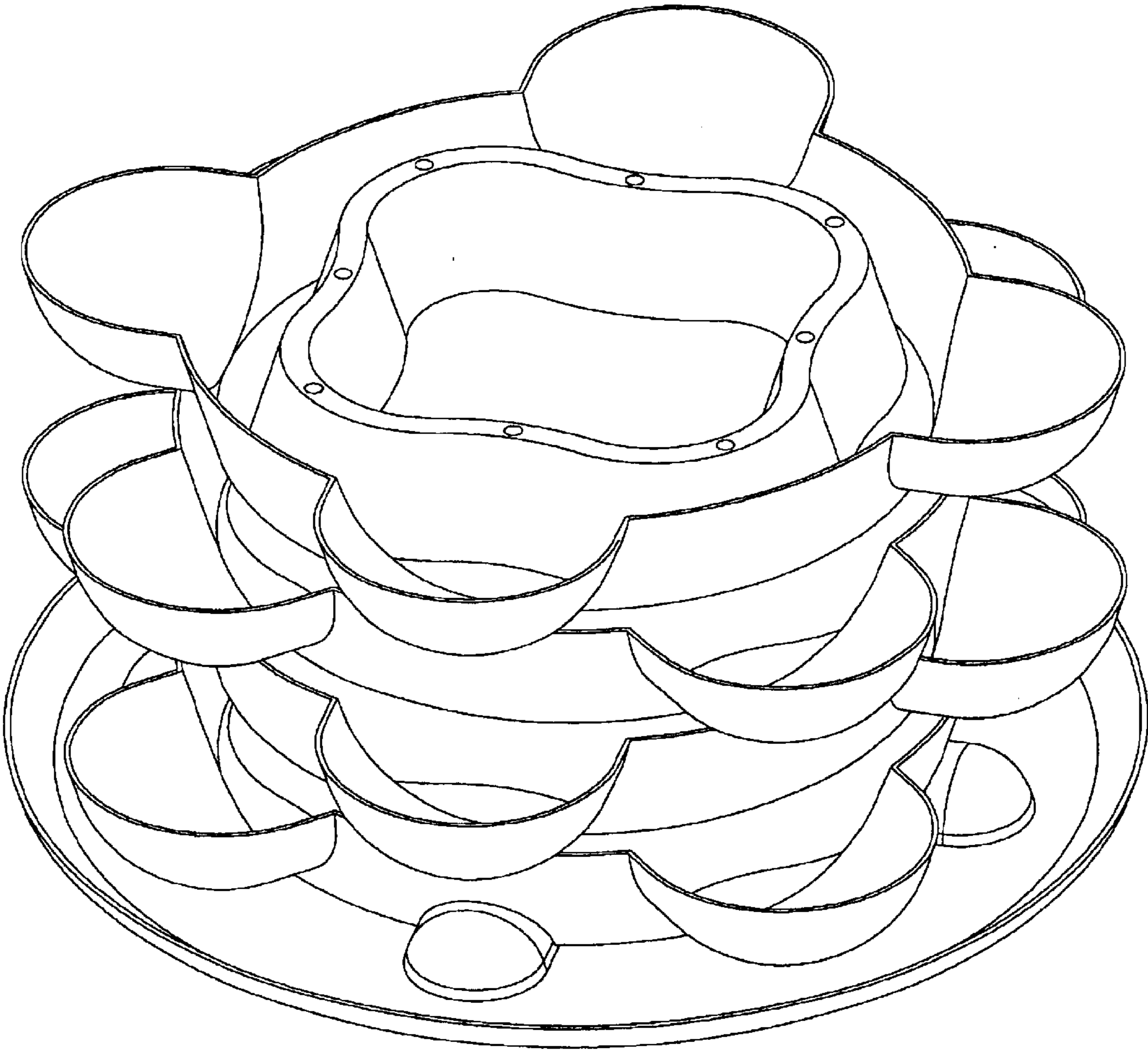
FIG. 19 is a side view of the stackable planter shown in FIG. 18;

FIG. 20 is a top perspective view of the stackable planter with four trays as shown in FIG. 1 in a collapsed configuration; and,

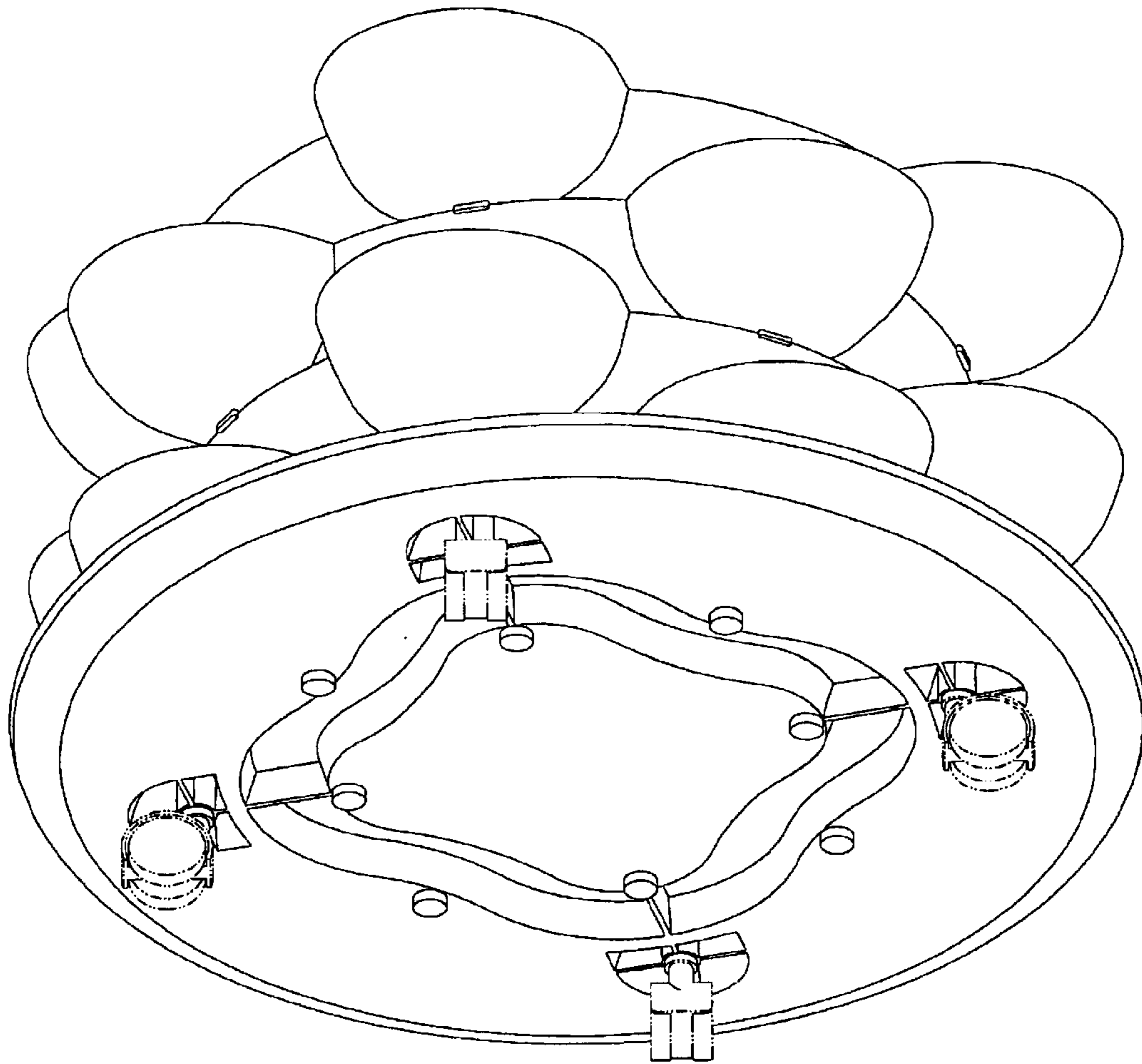
FIG. 21 is a side view of the stackable planter shown in FIG. 20.

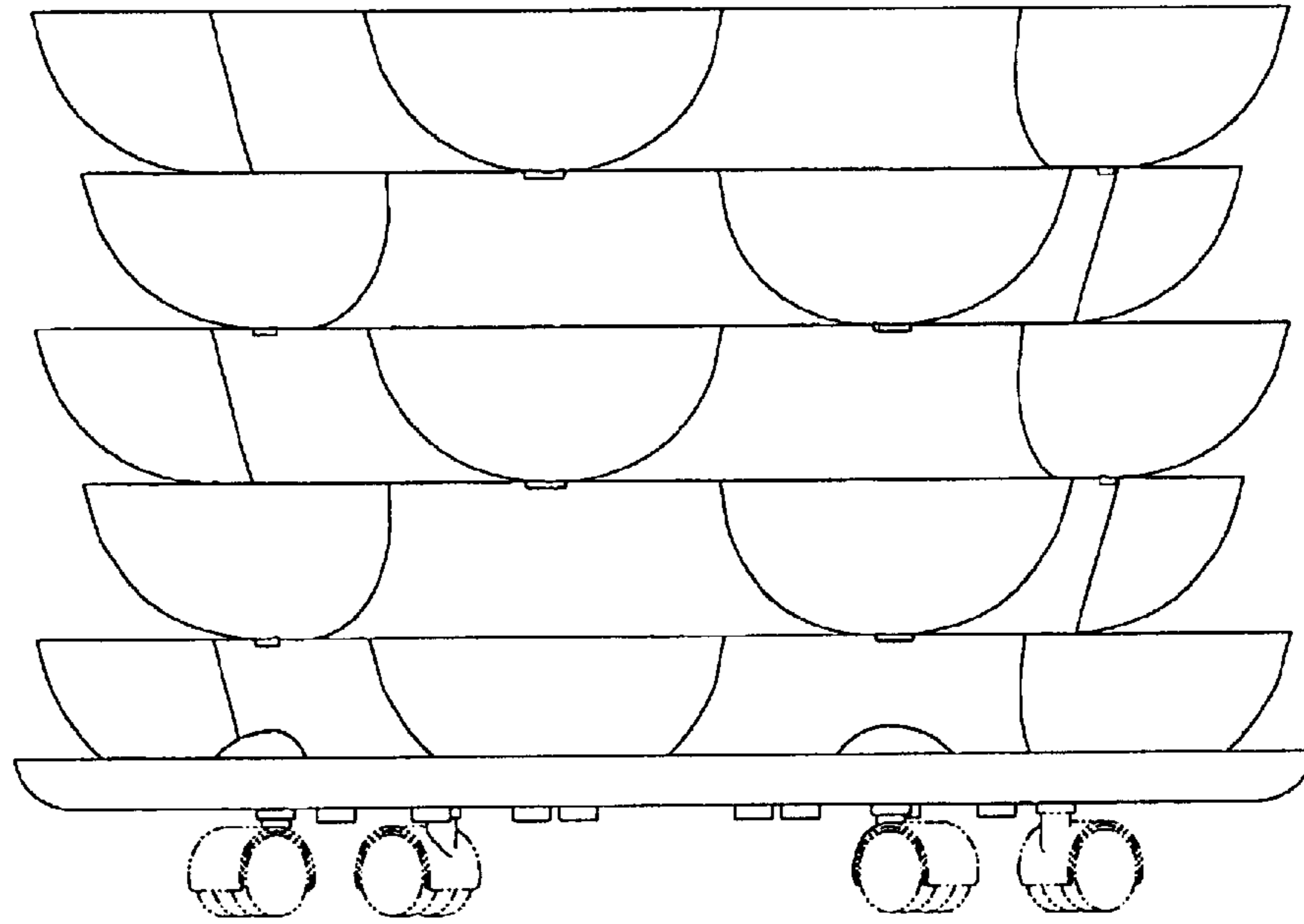




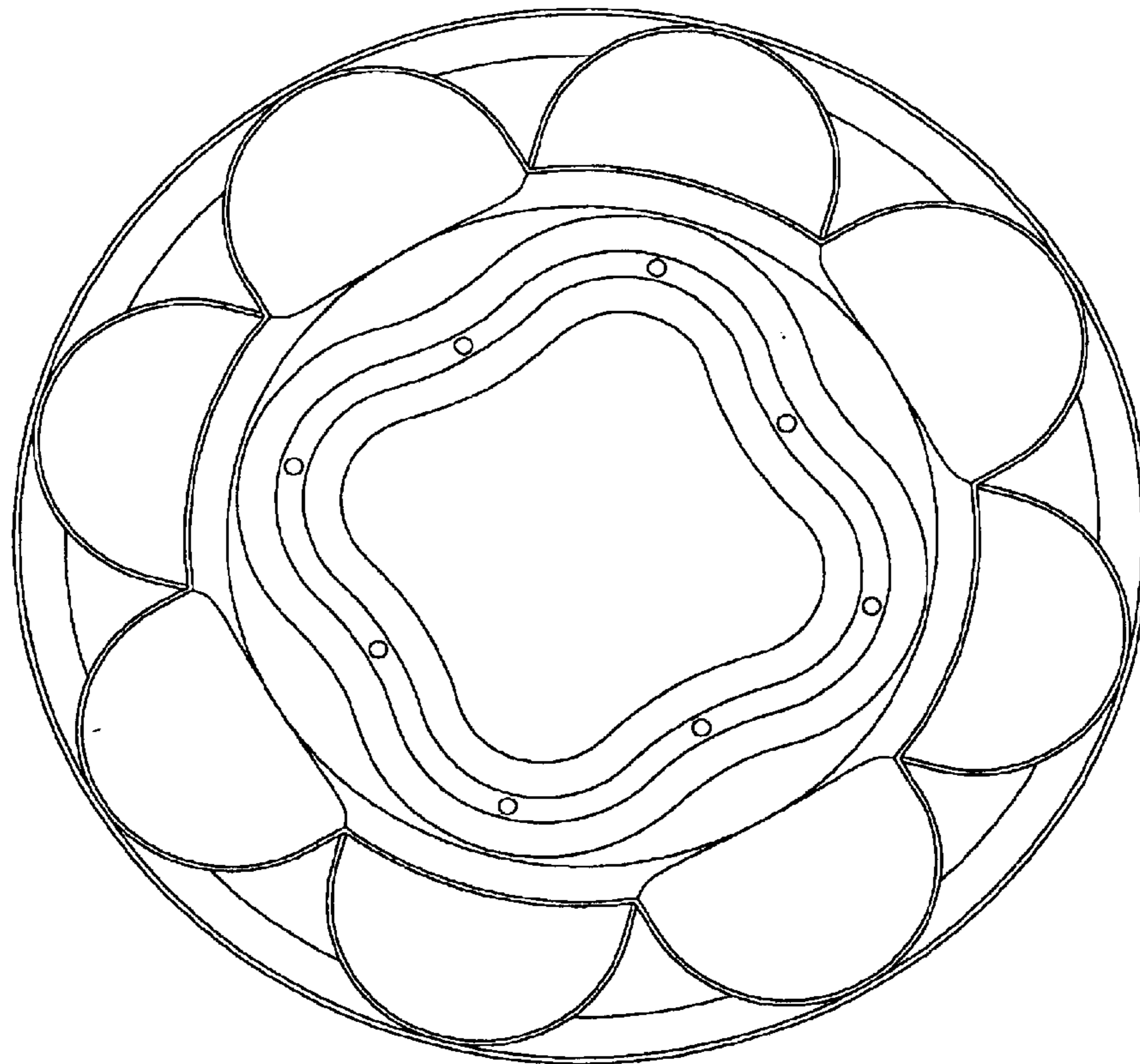

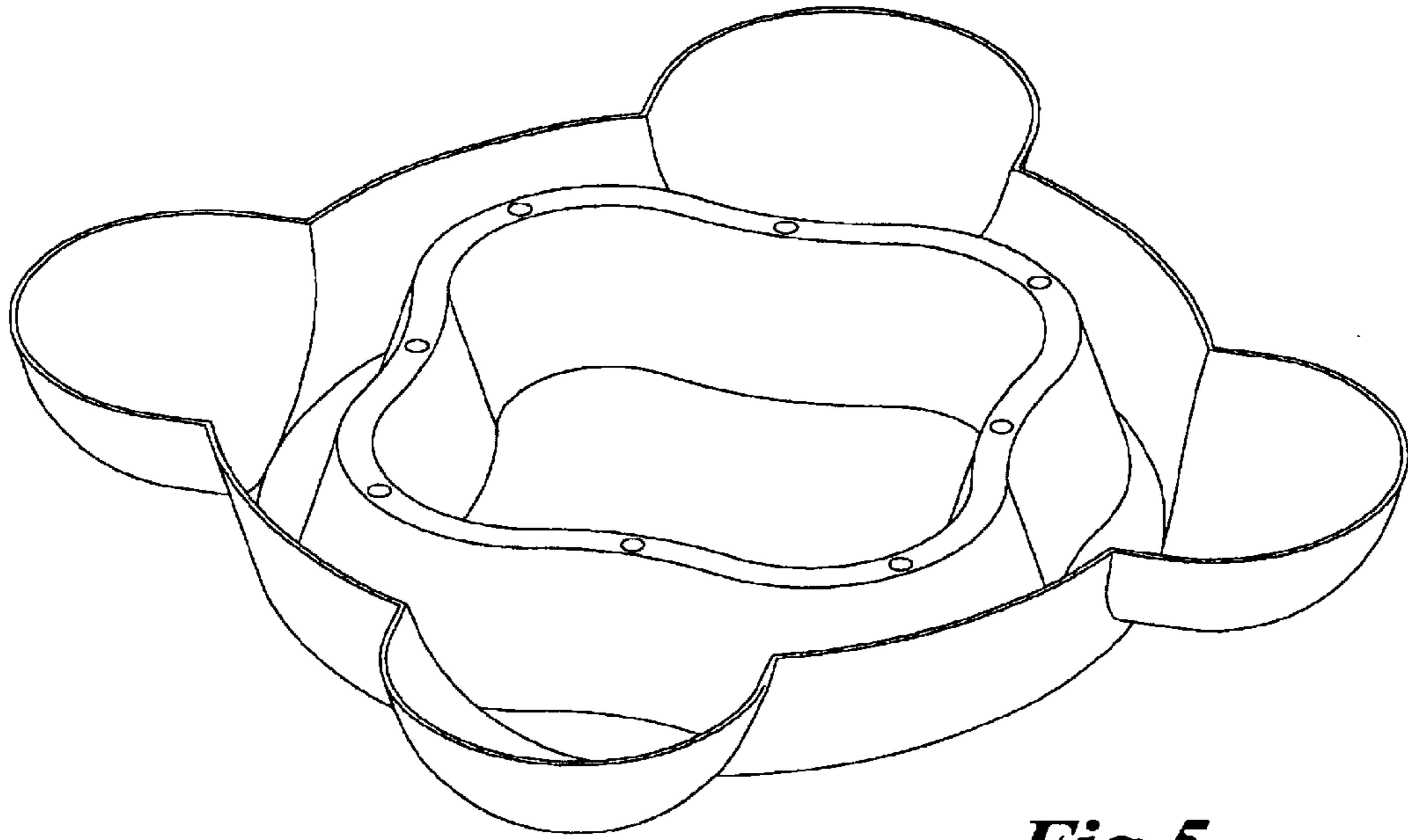

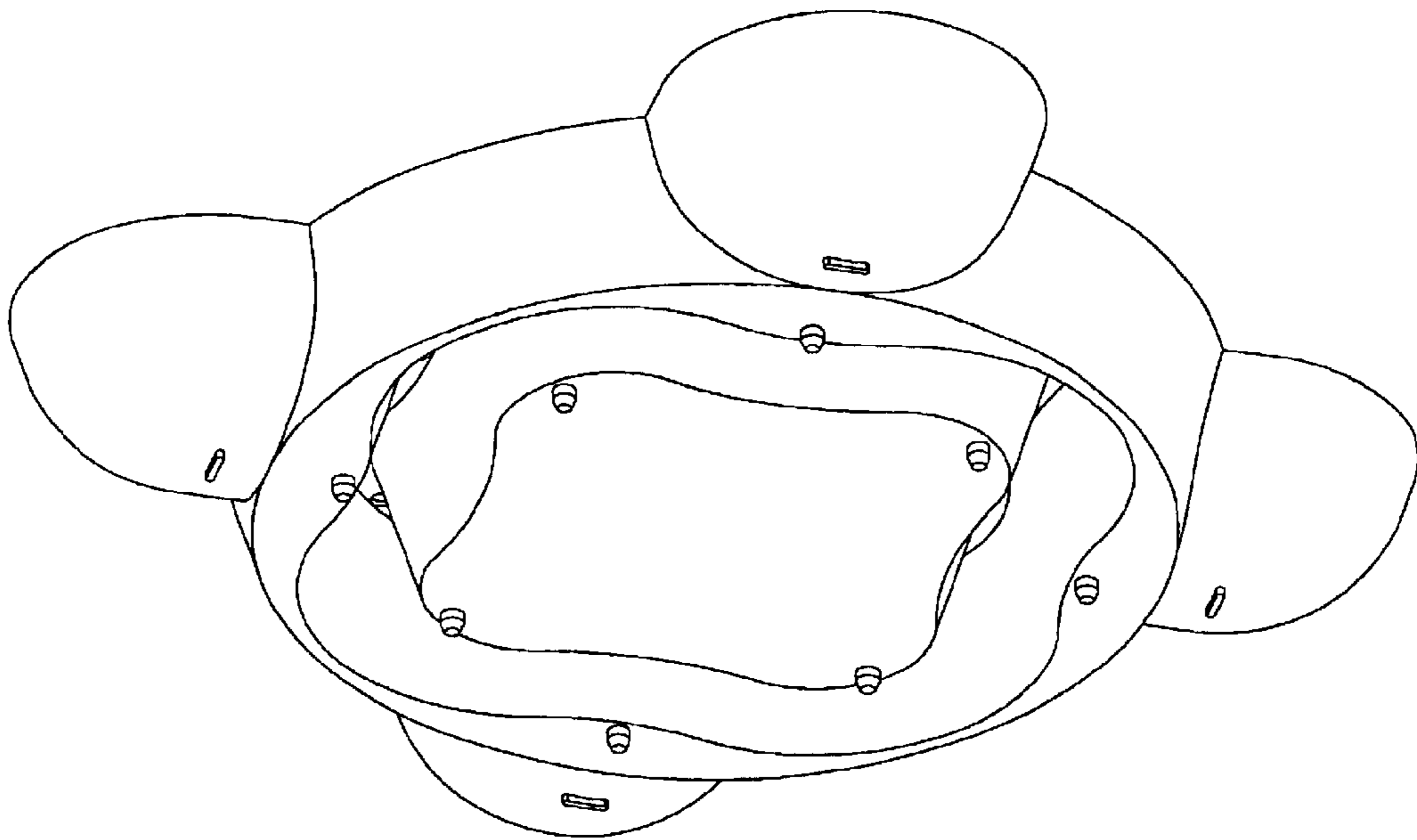

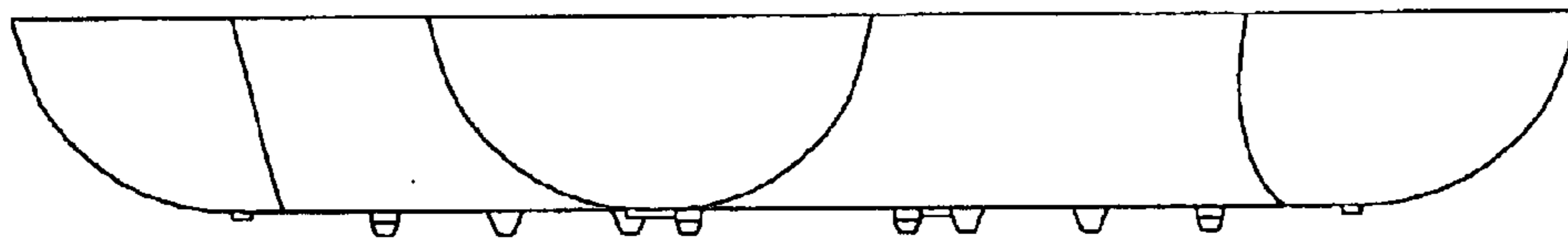

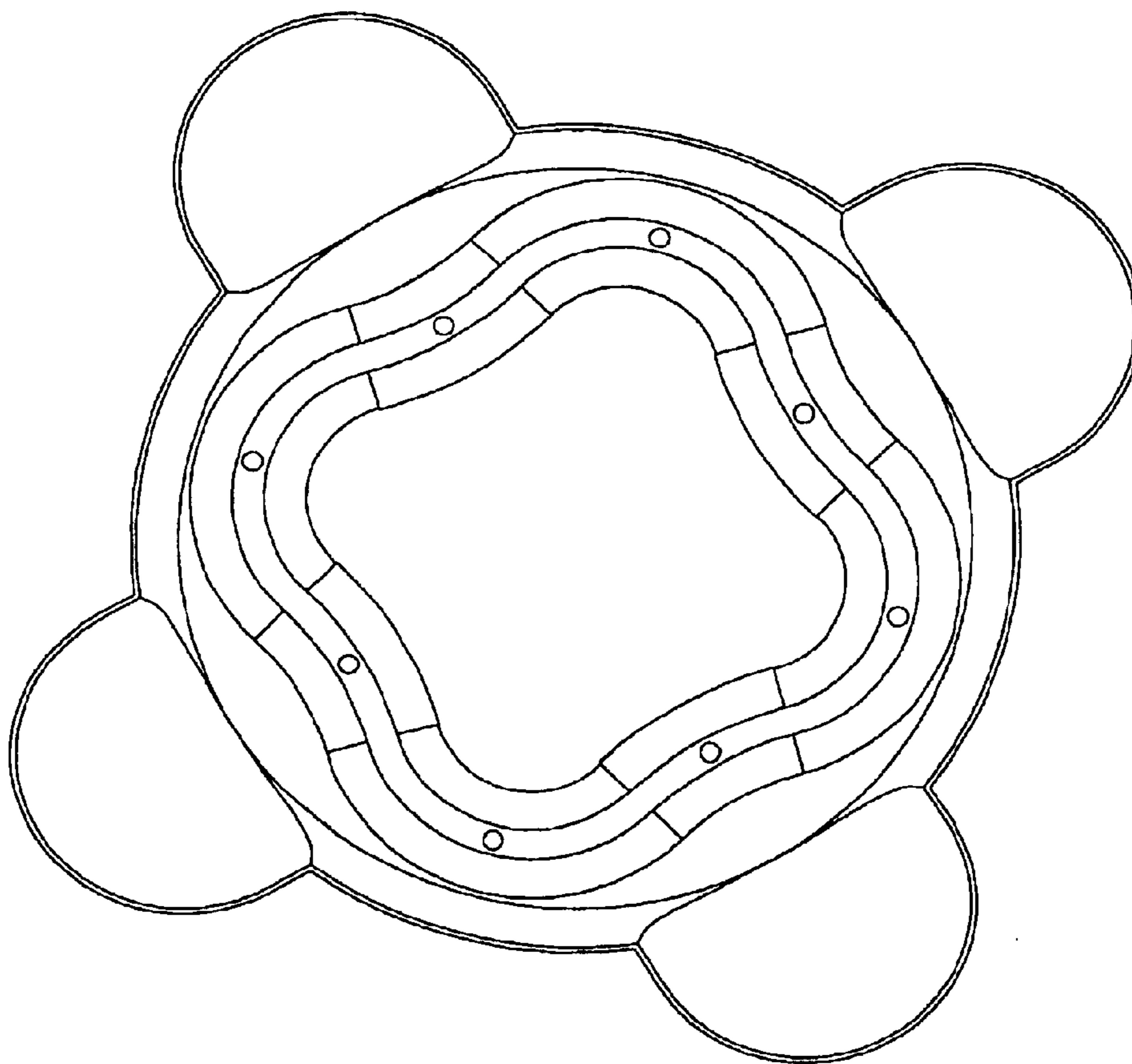

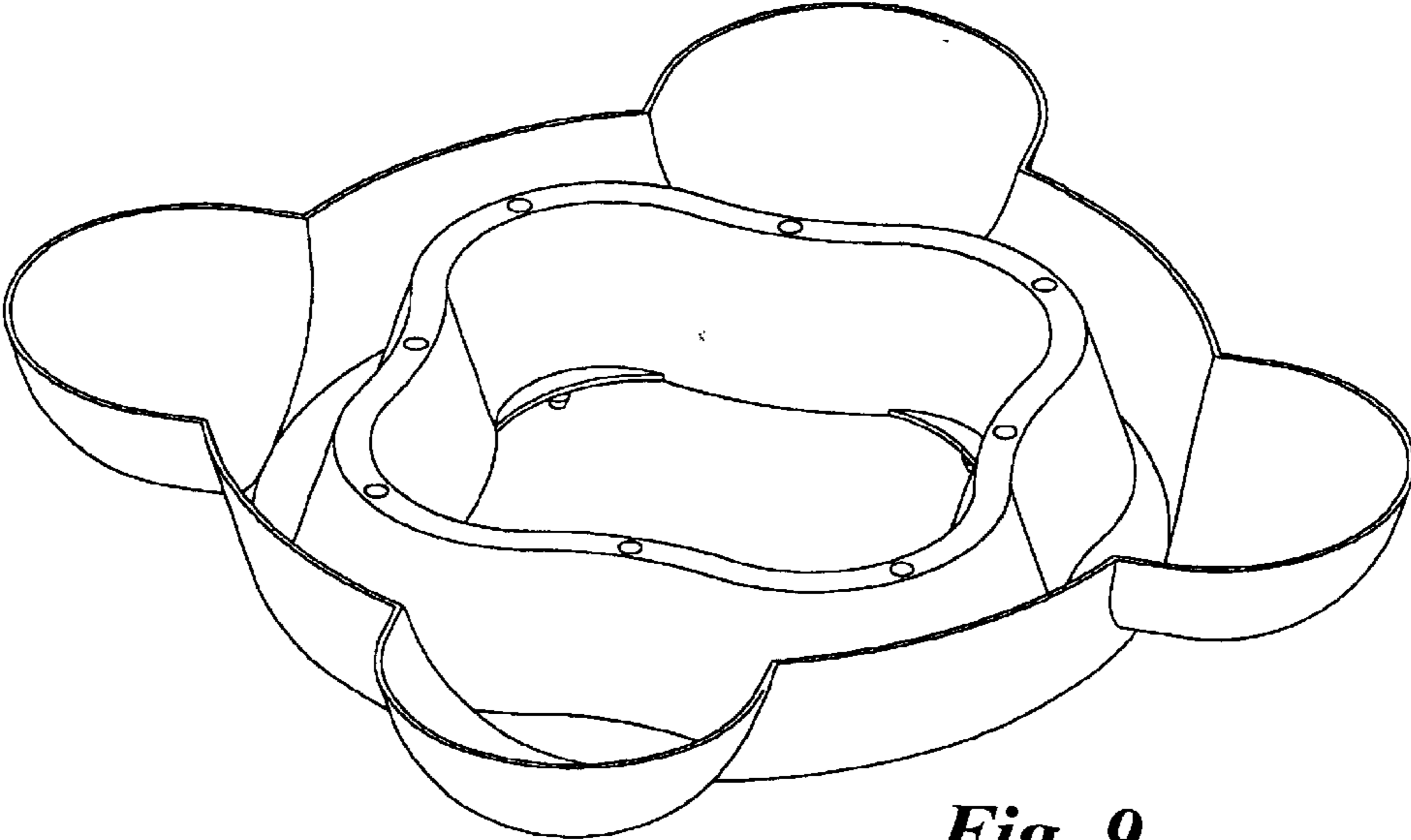

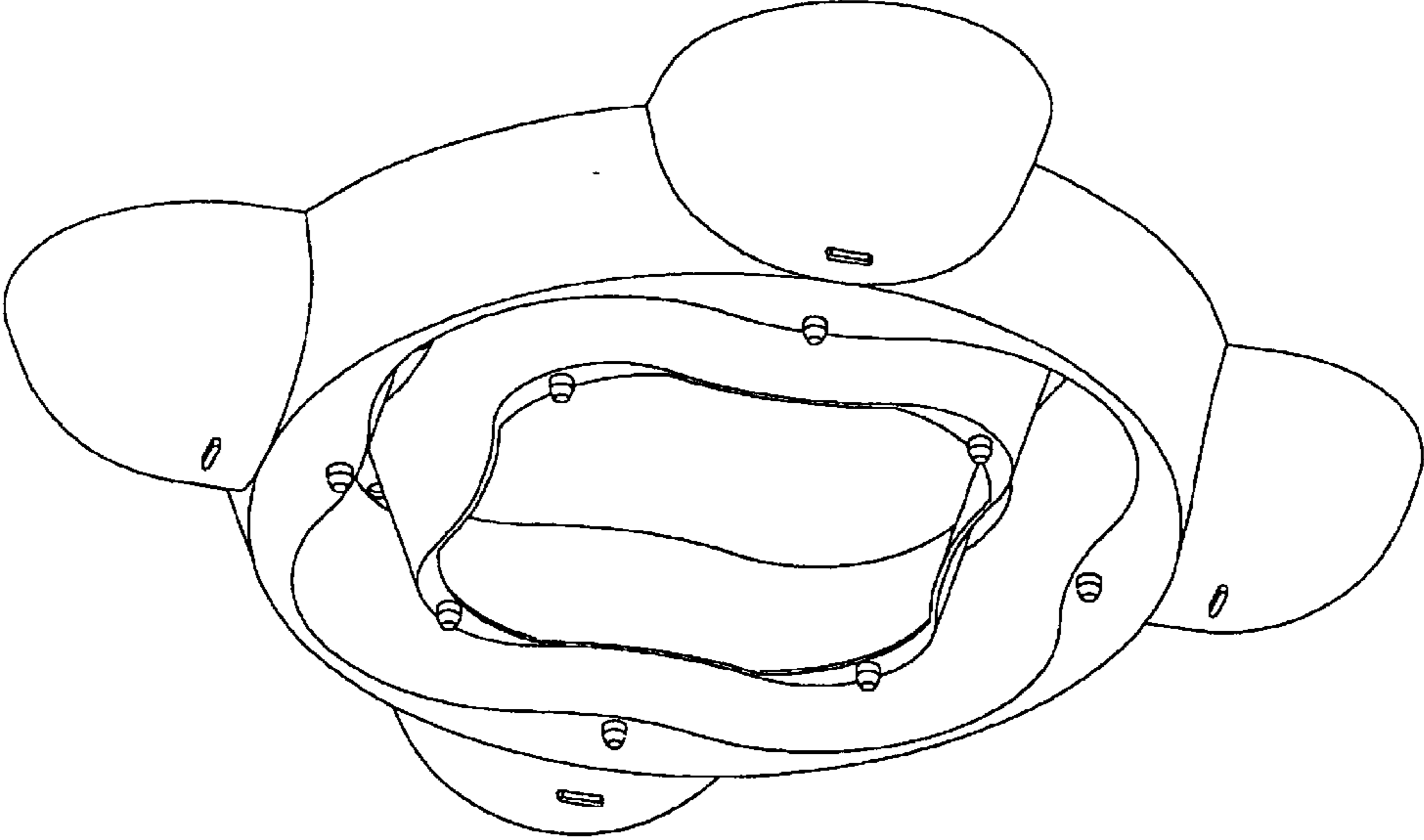

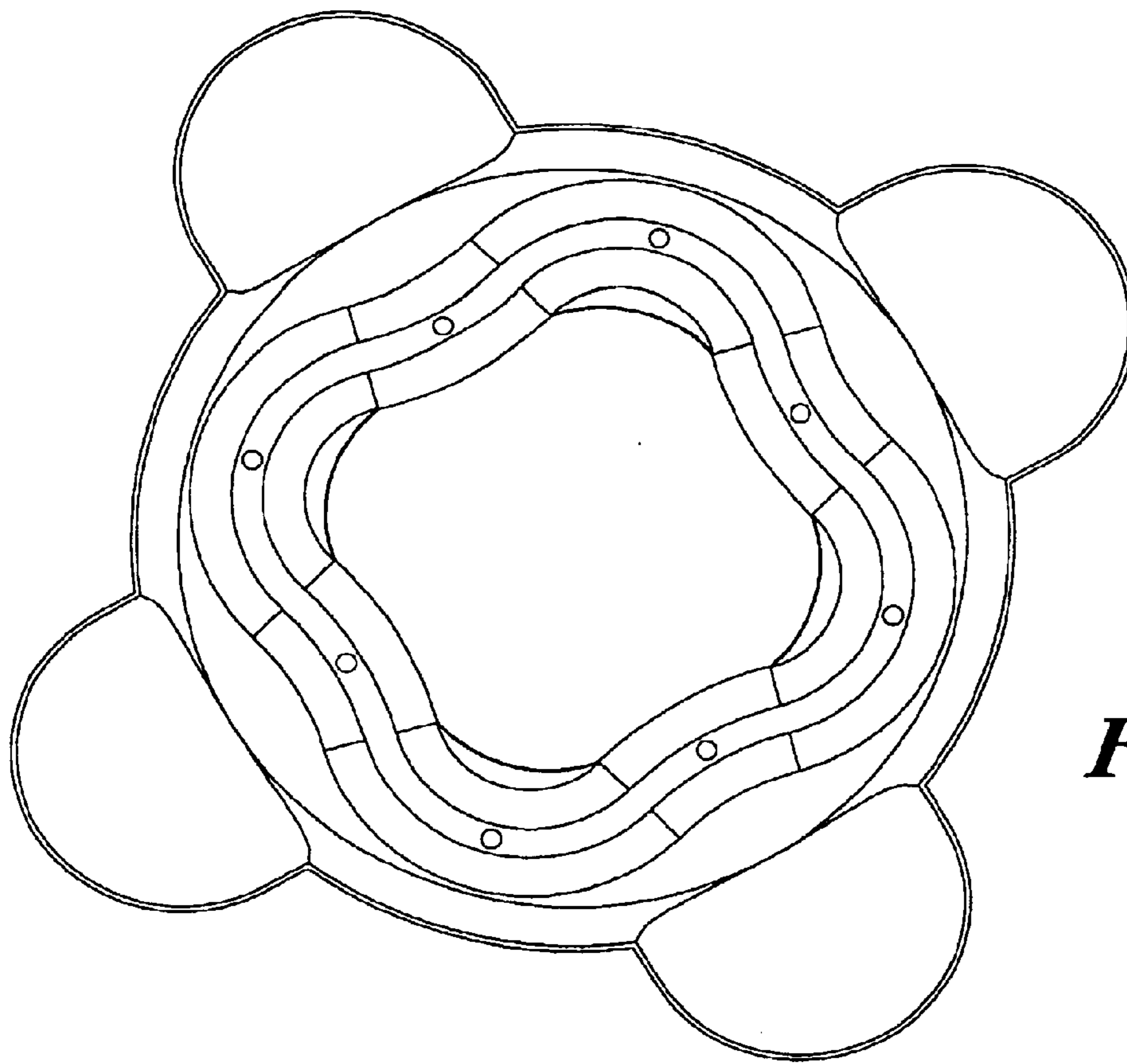

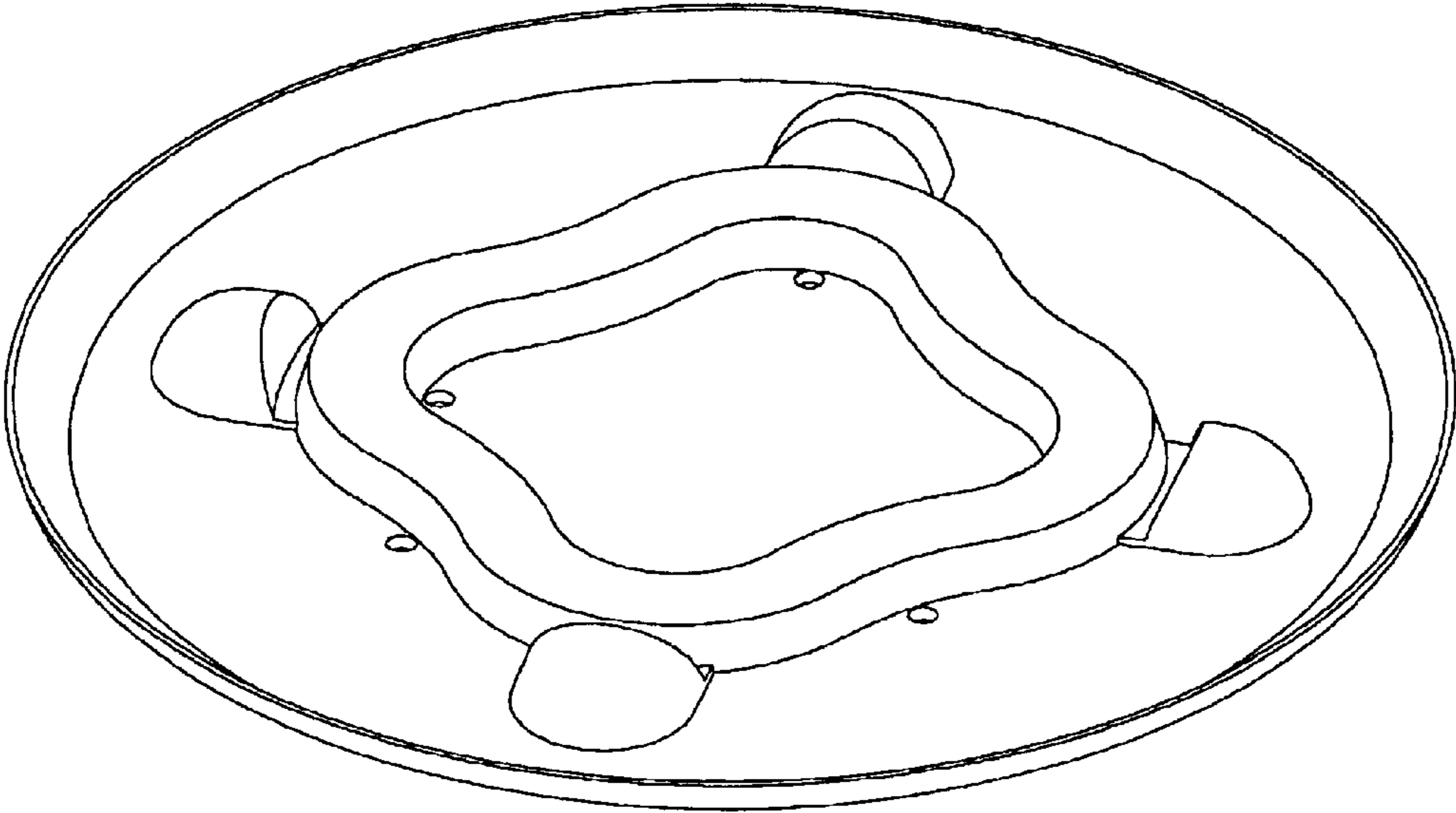

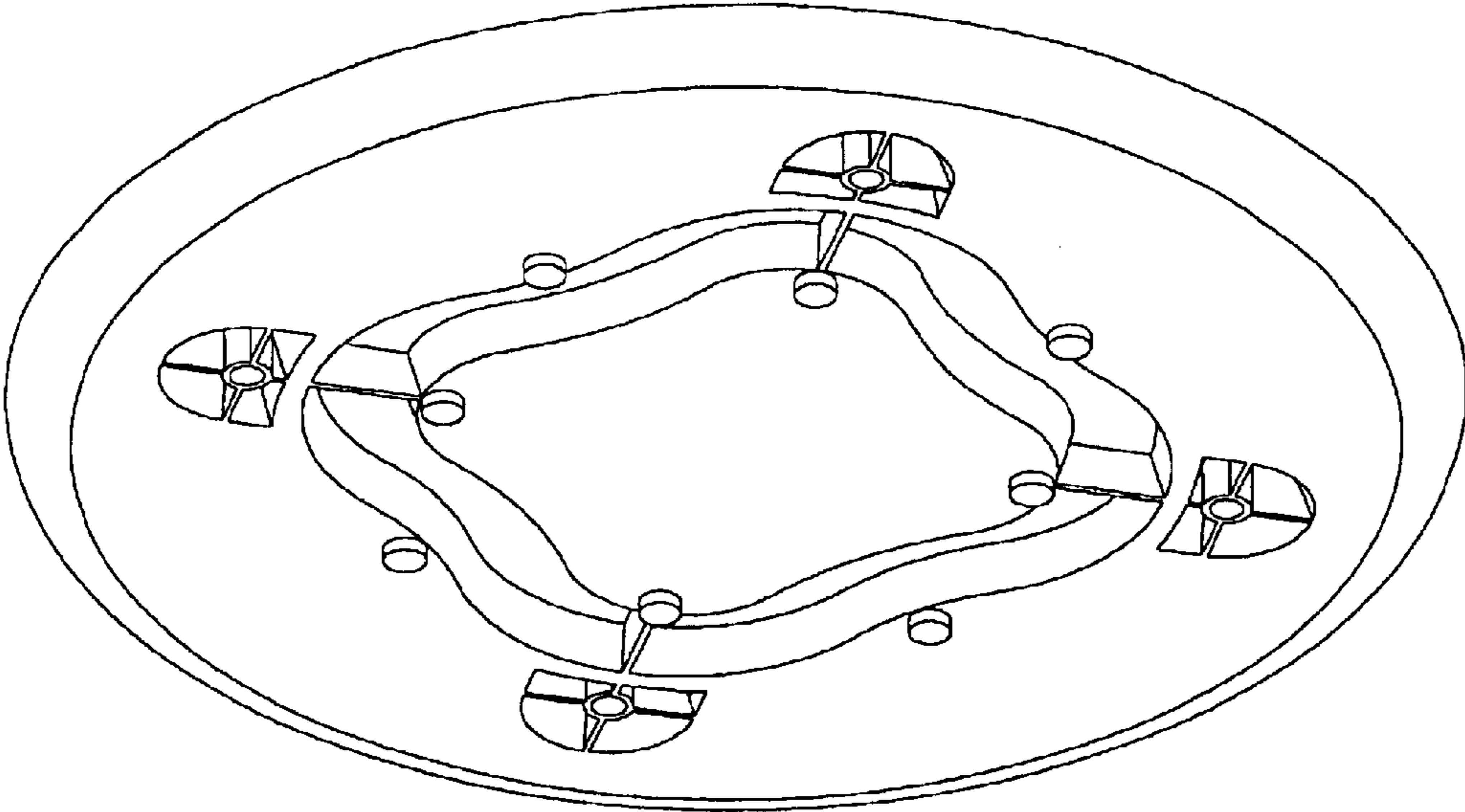


***Fig. 11.***

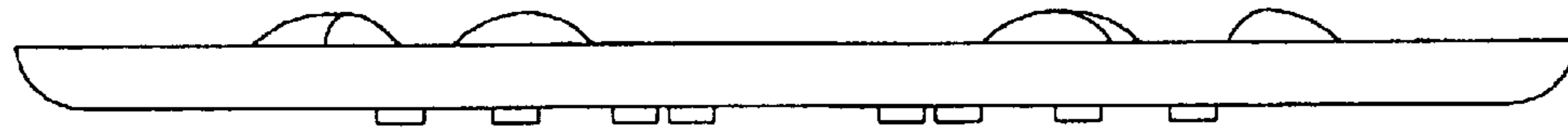




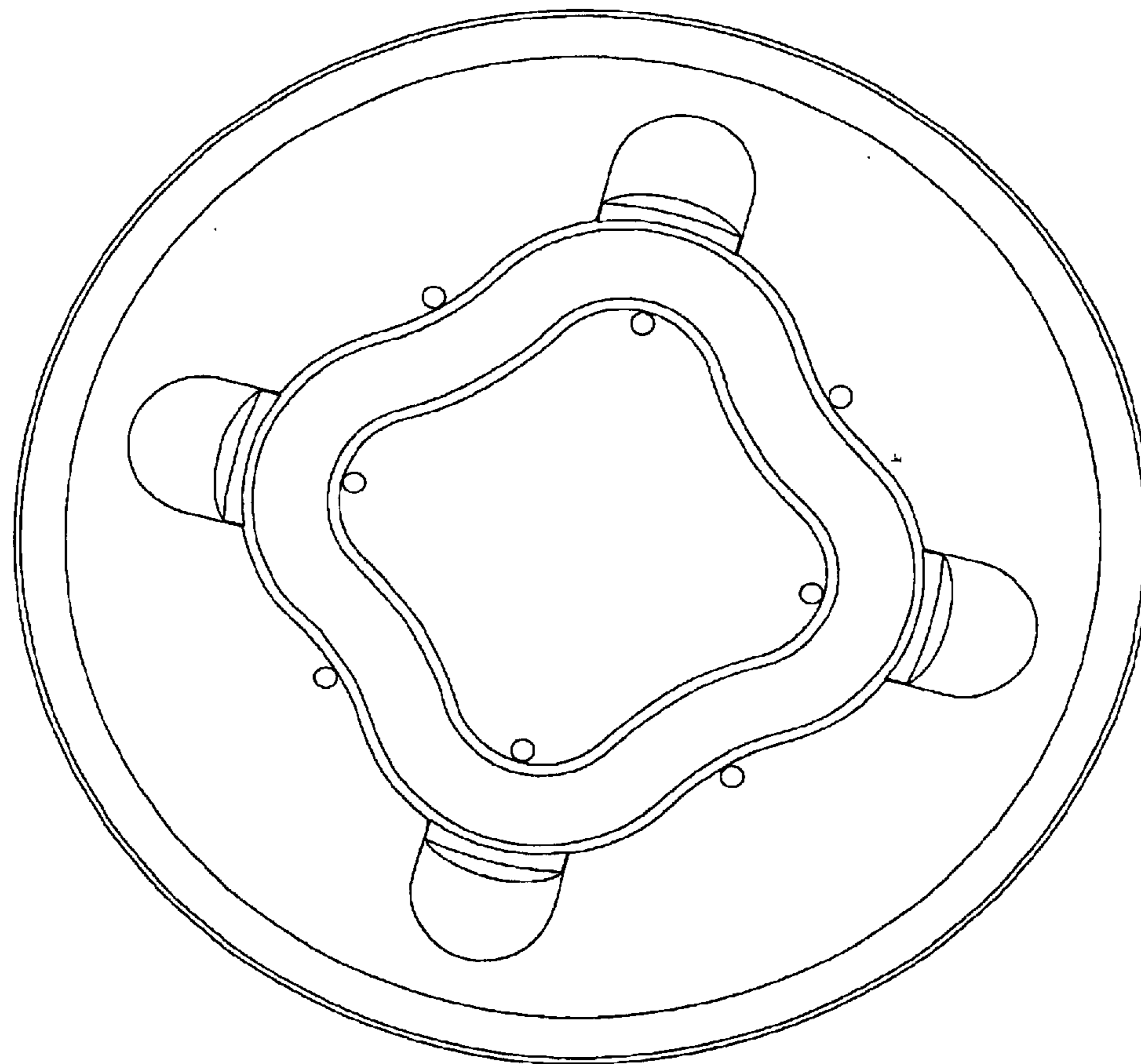

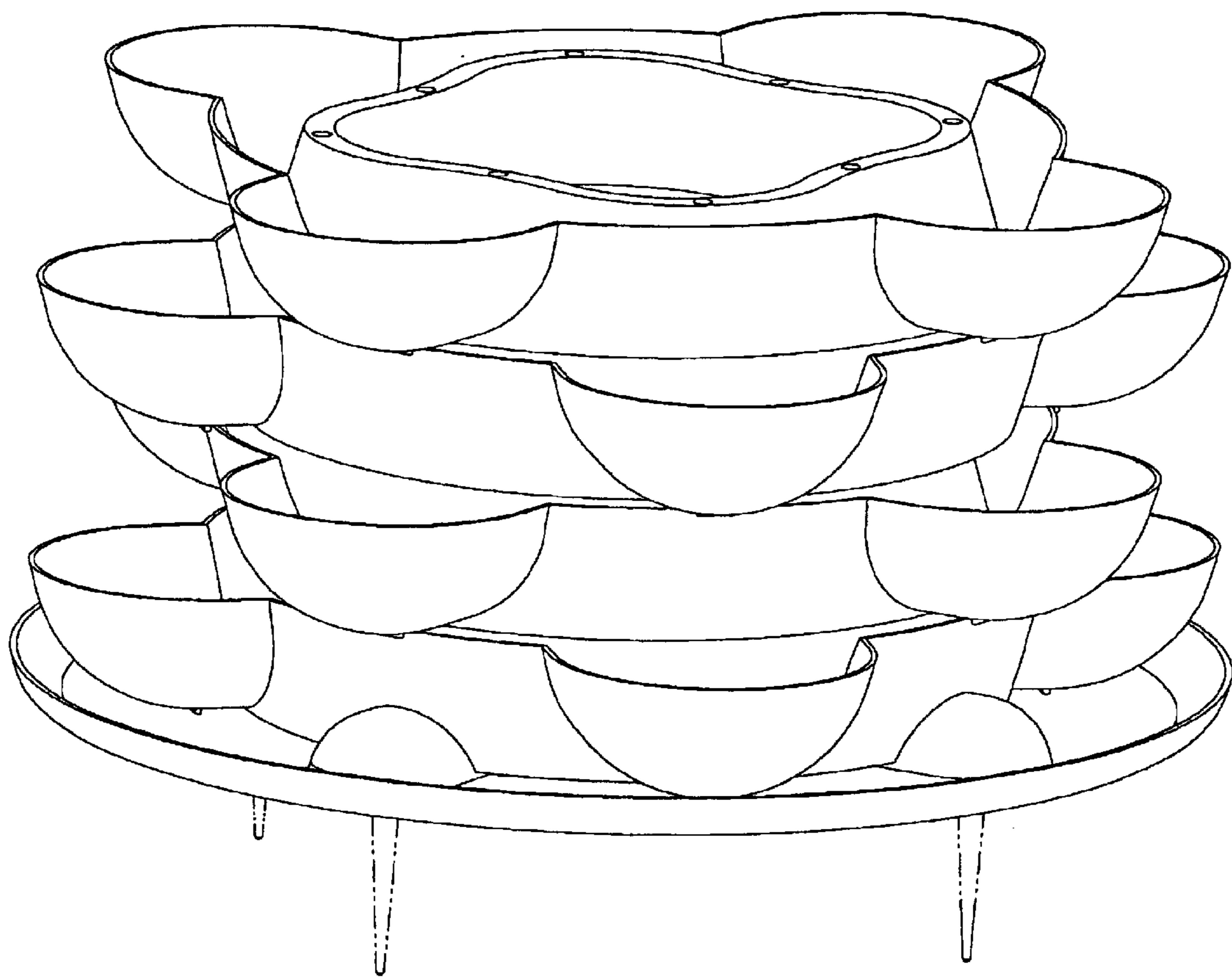

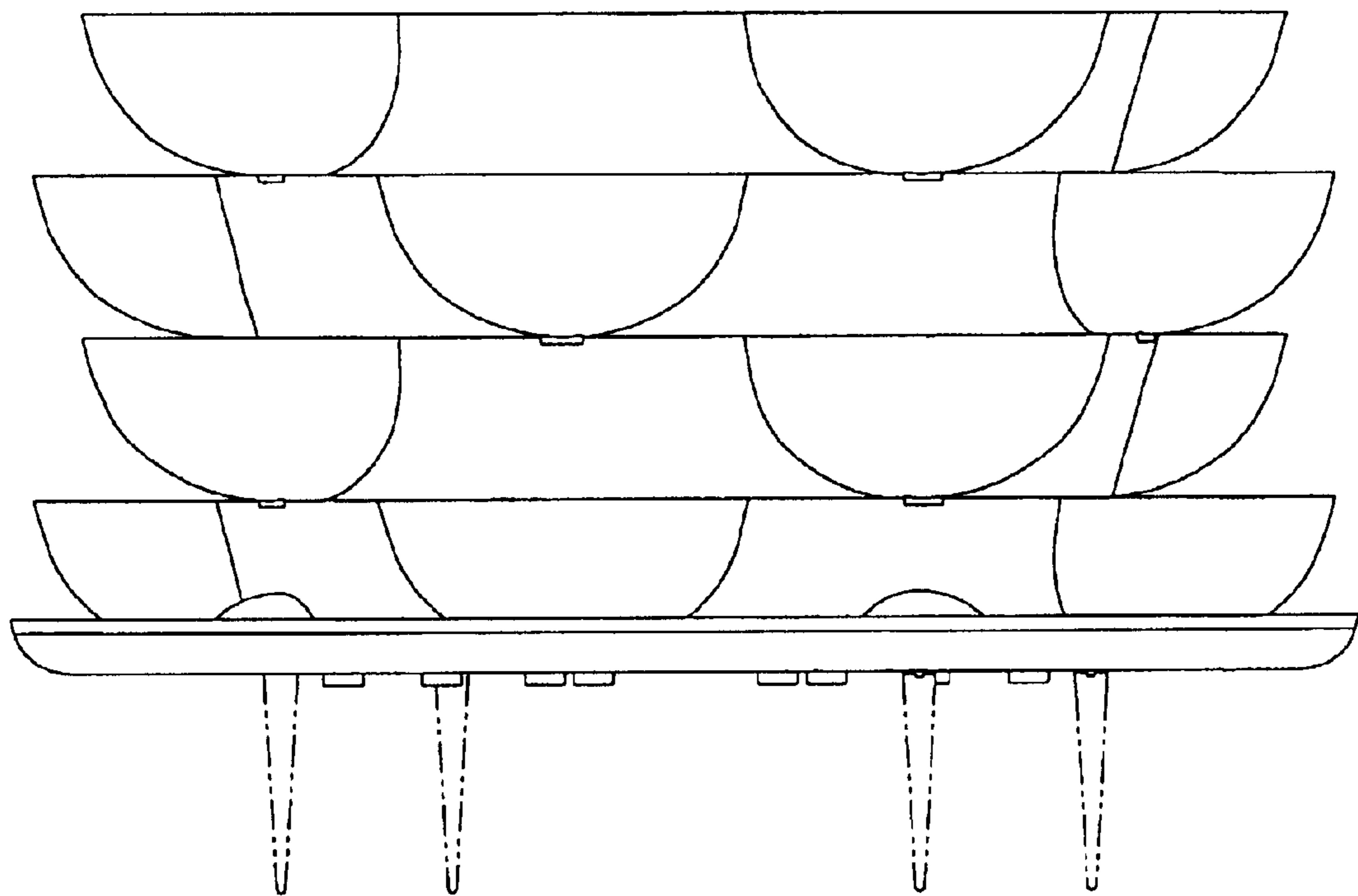

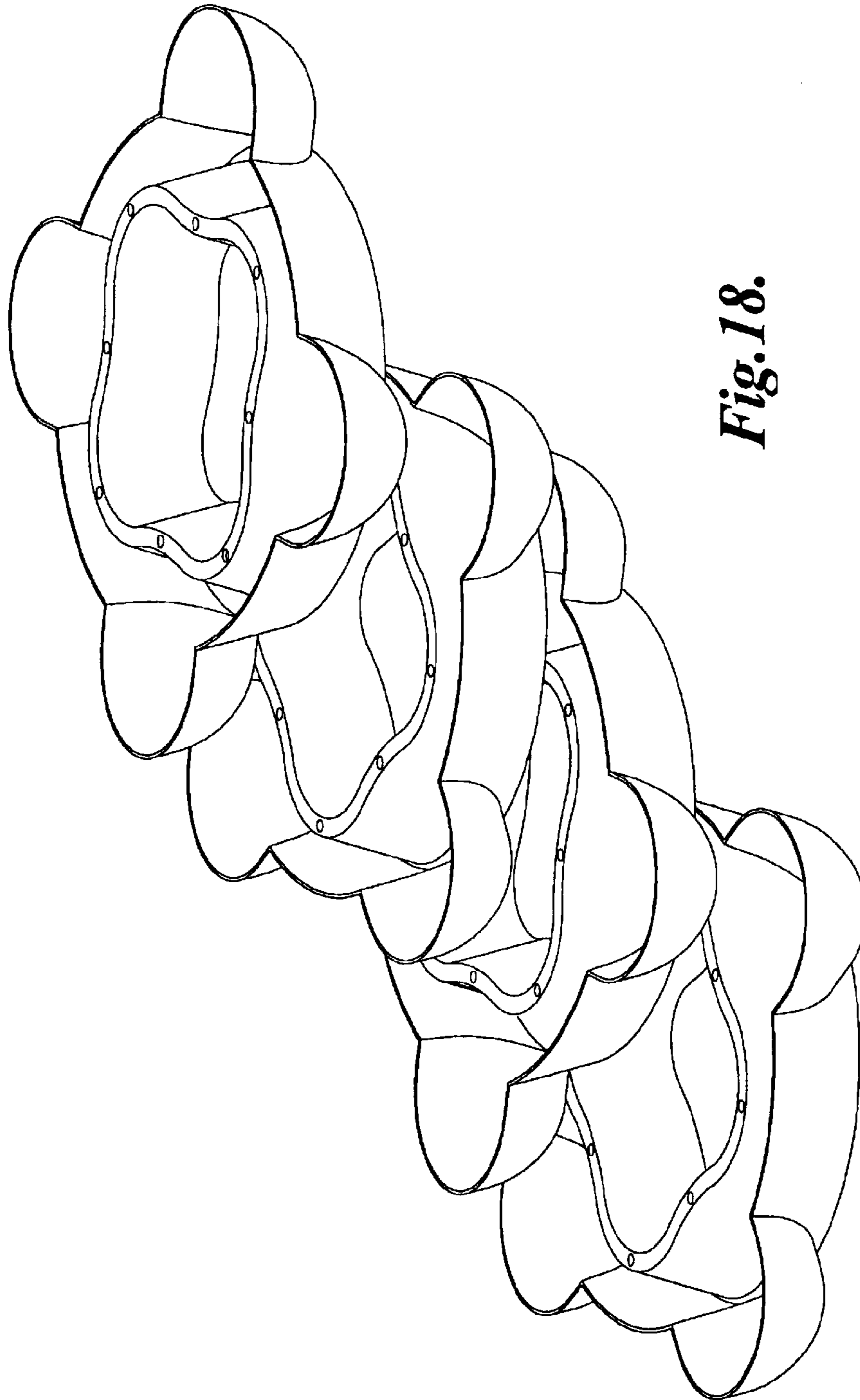

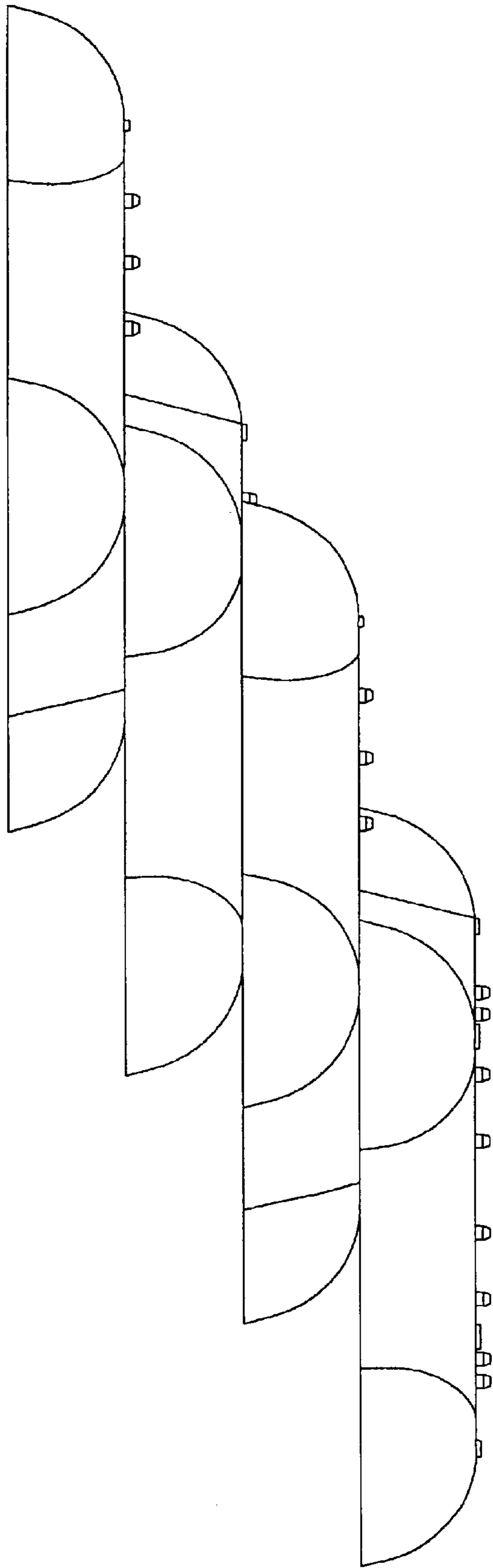

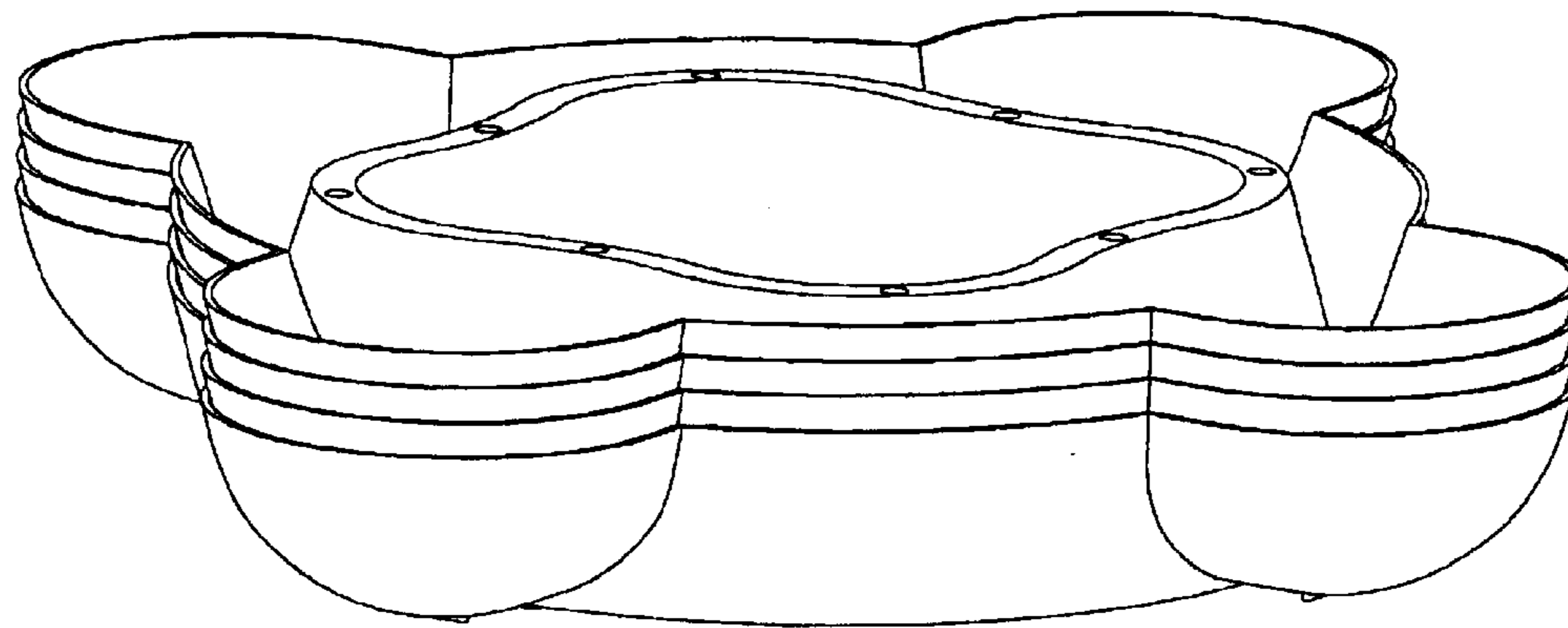

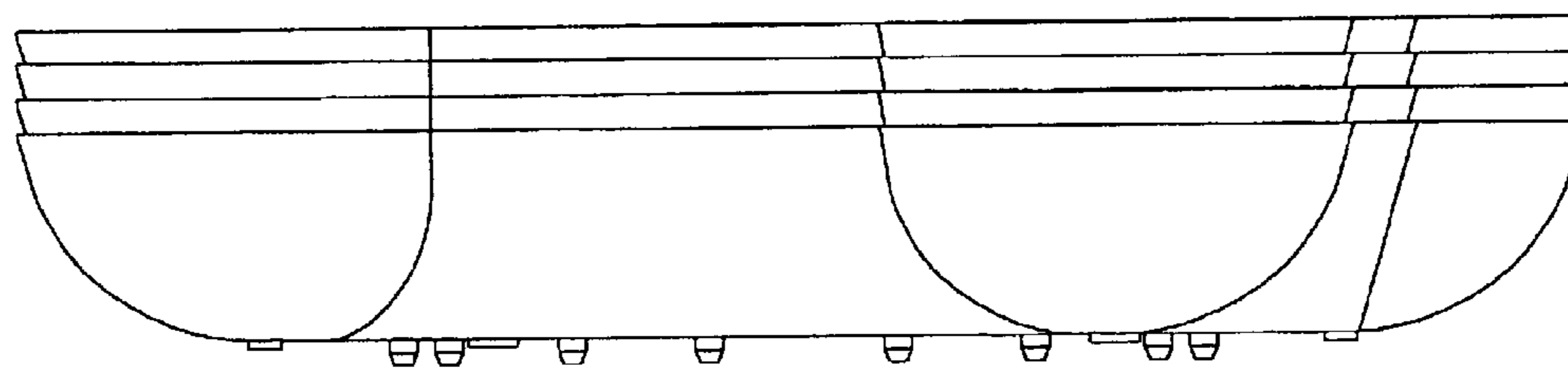
